FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a baseball game counter showing my new design;

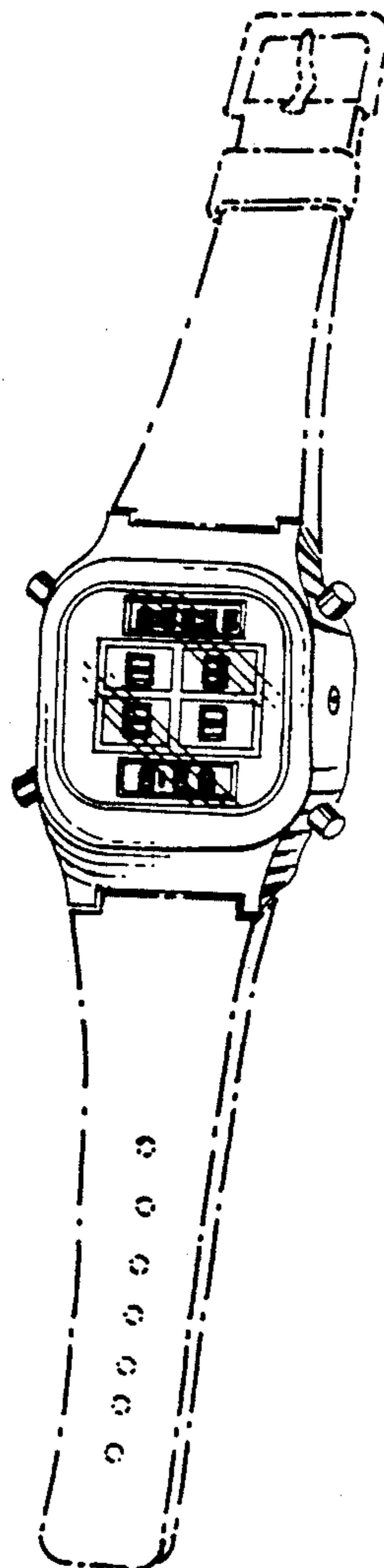
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

The broken line showing of a wriststrap is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



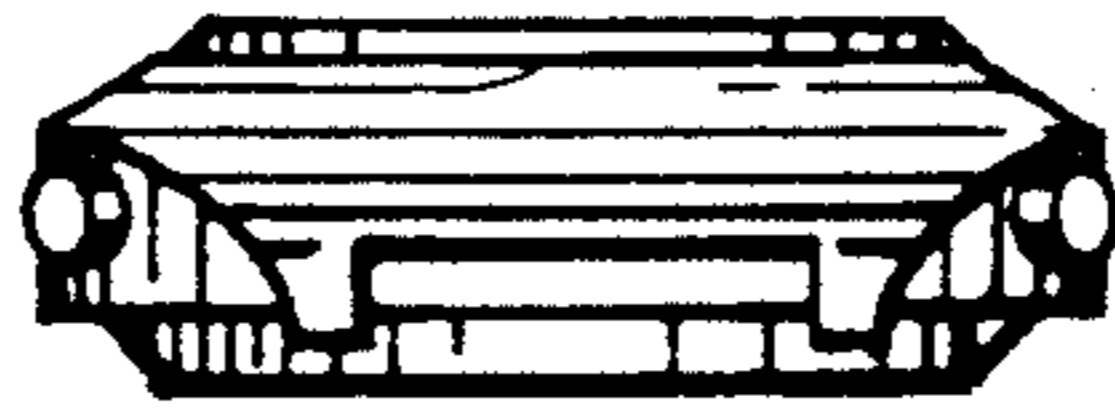
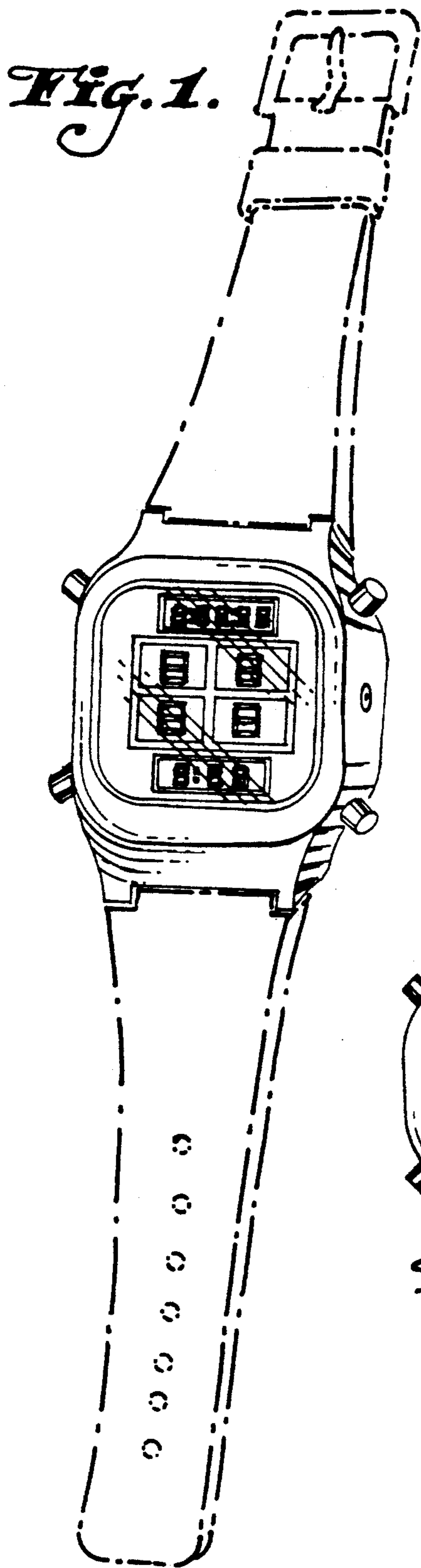

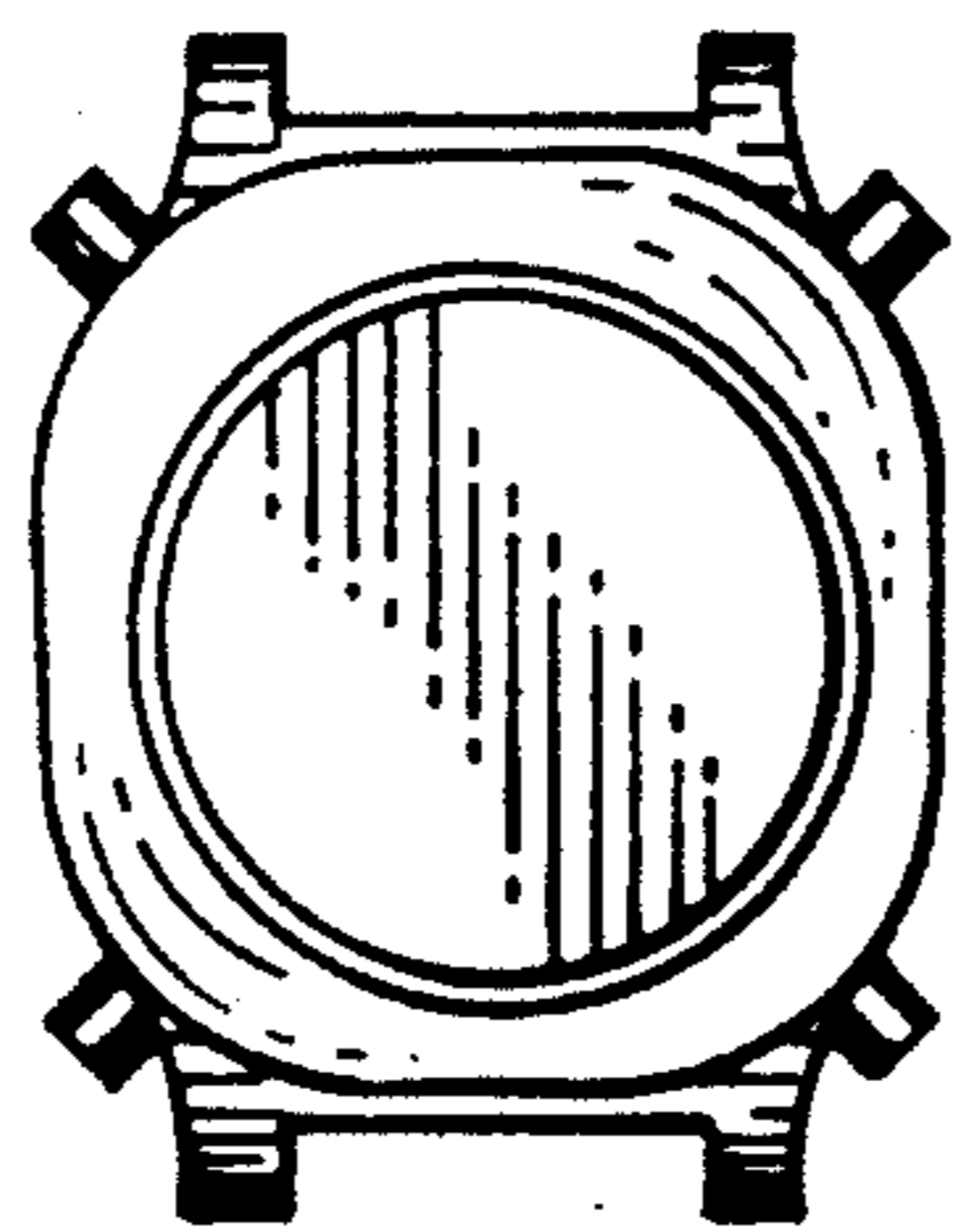
