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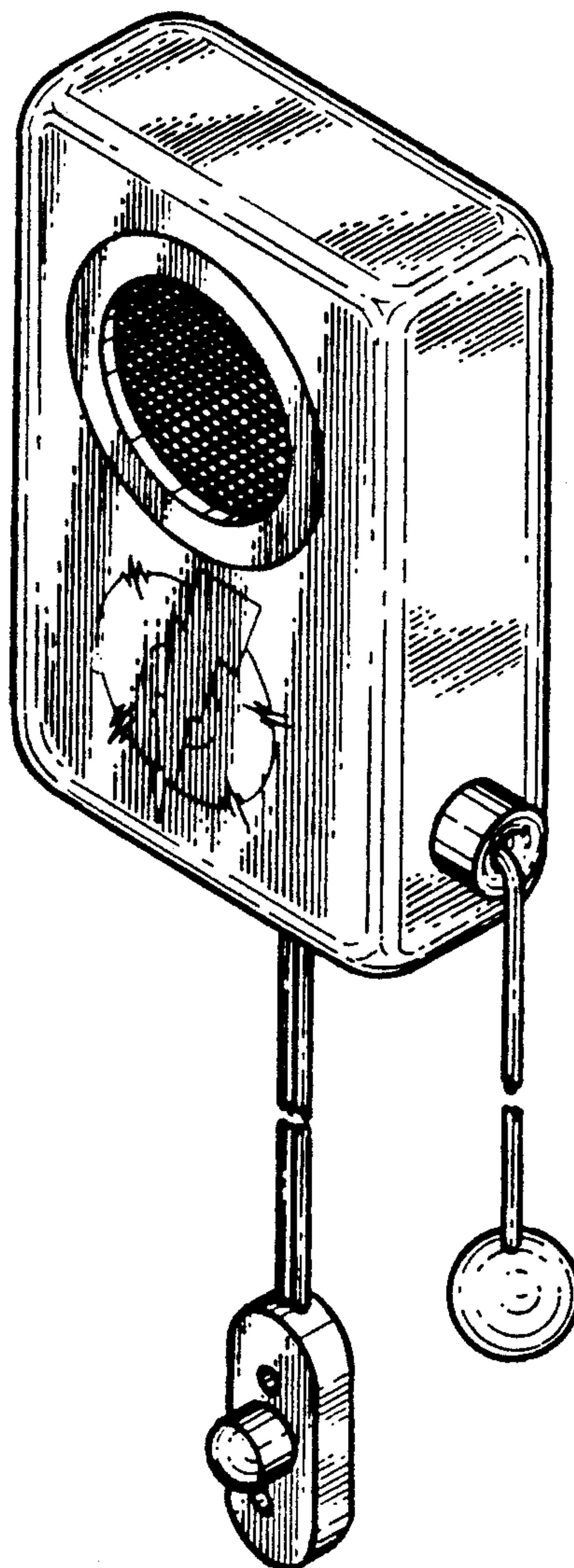

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a burglar alarm showing our new design, with the cords broken away in the center to indicate indeterminate length;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.



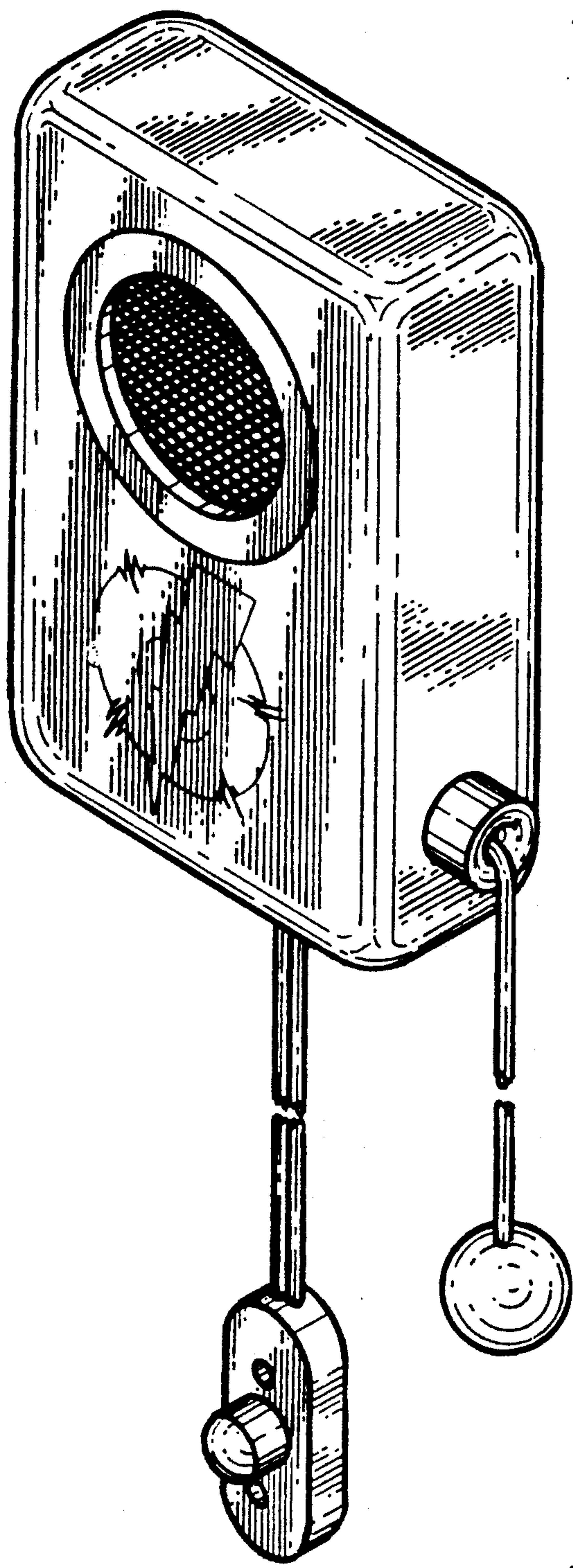

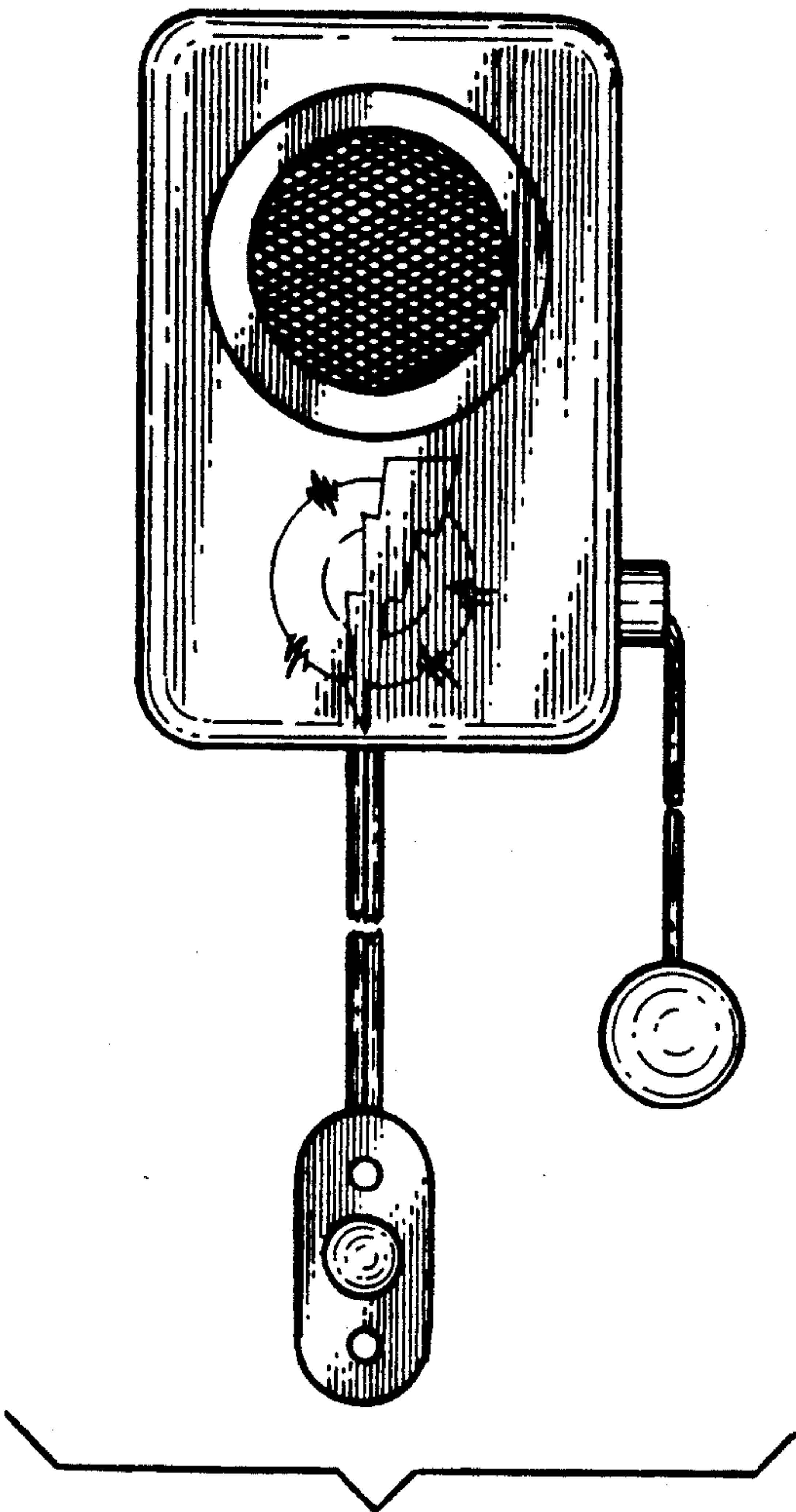

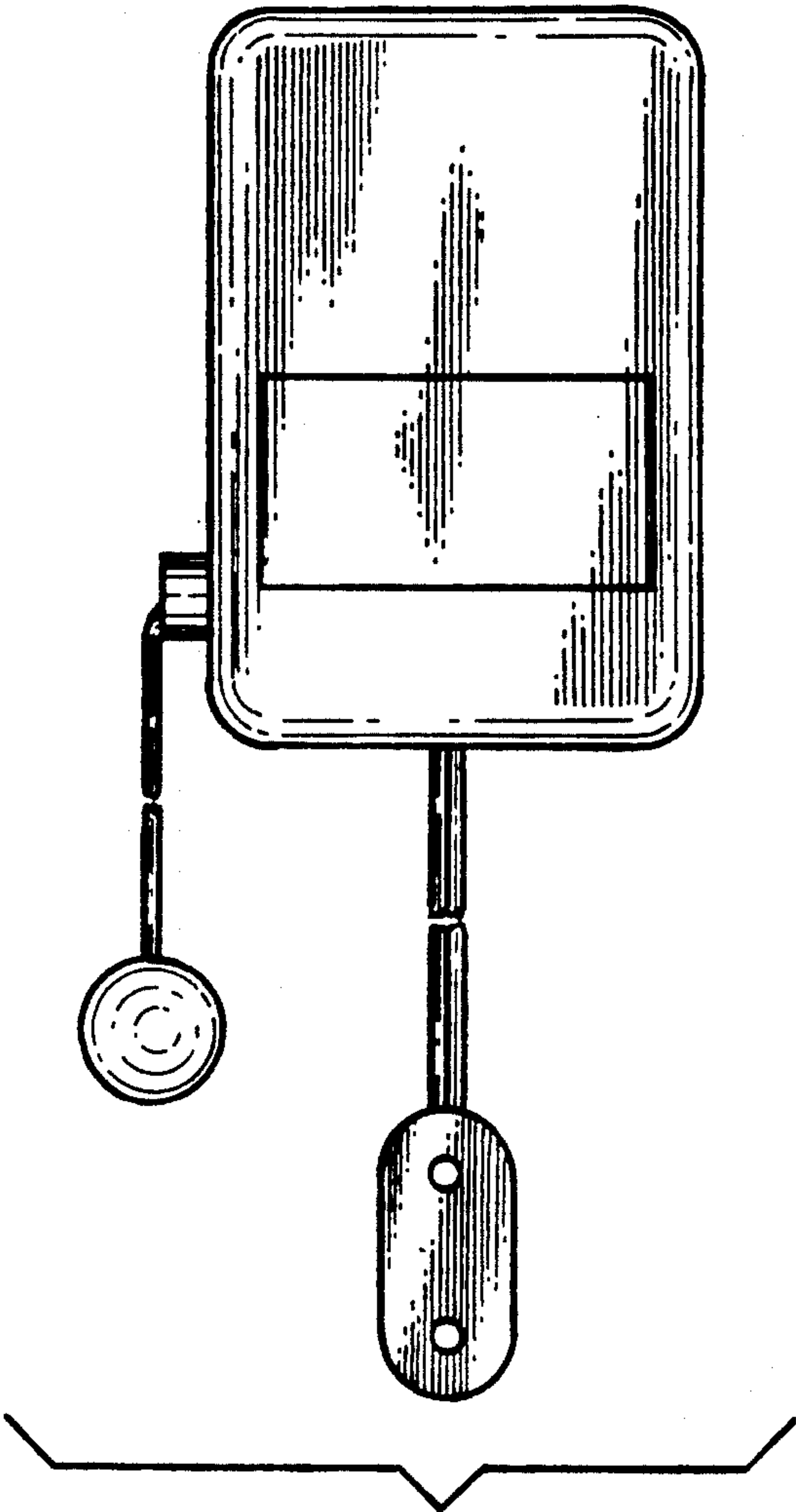

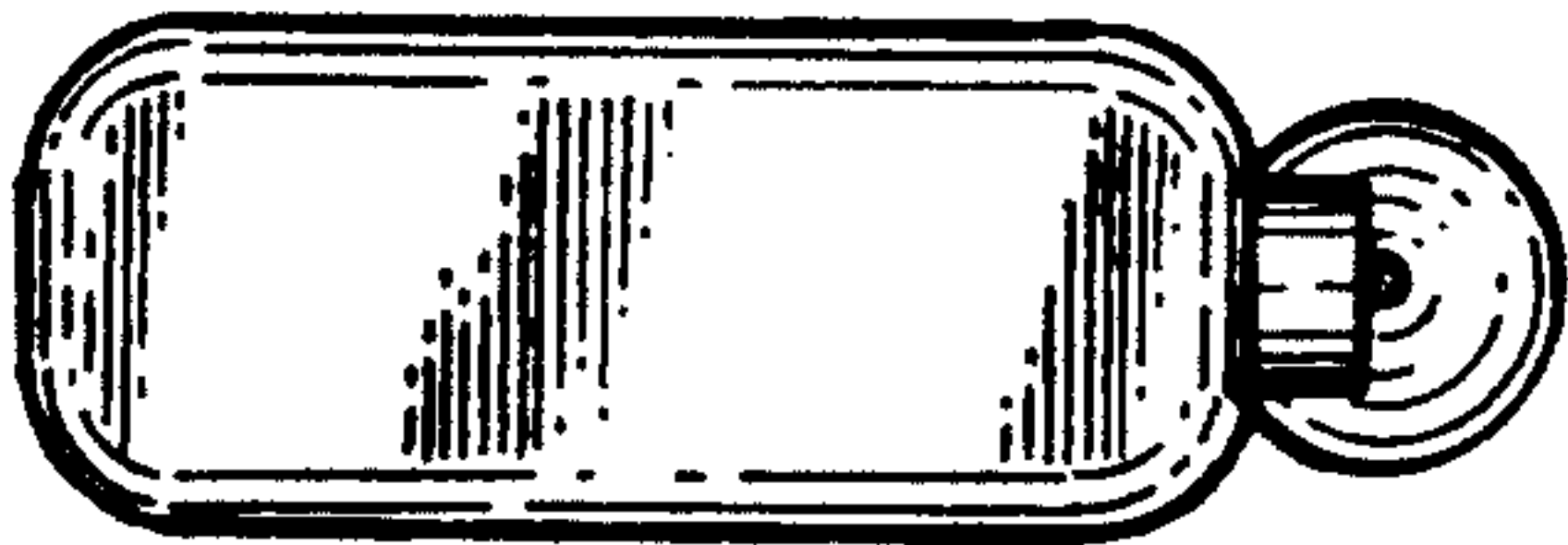

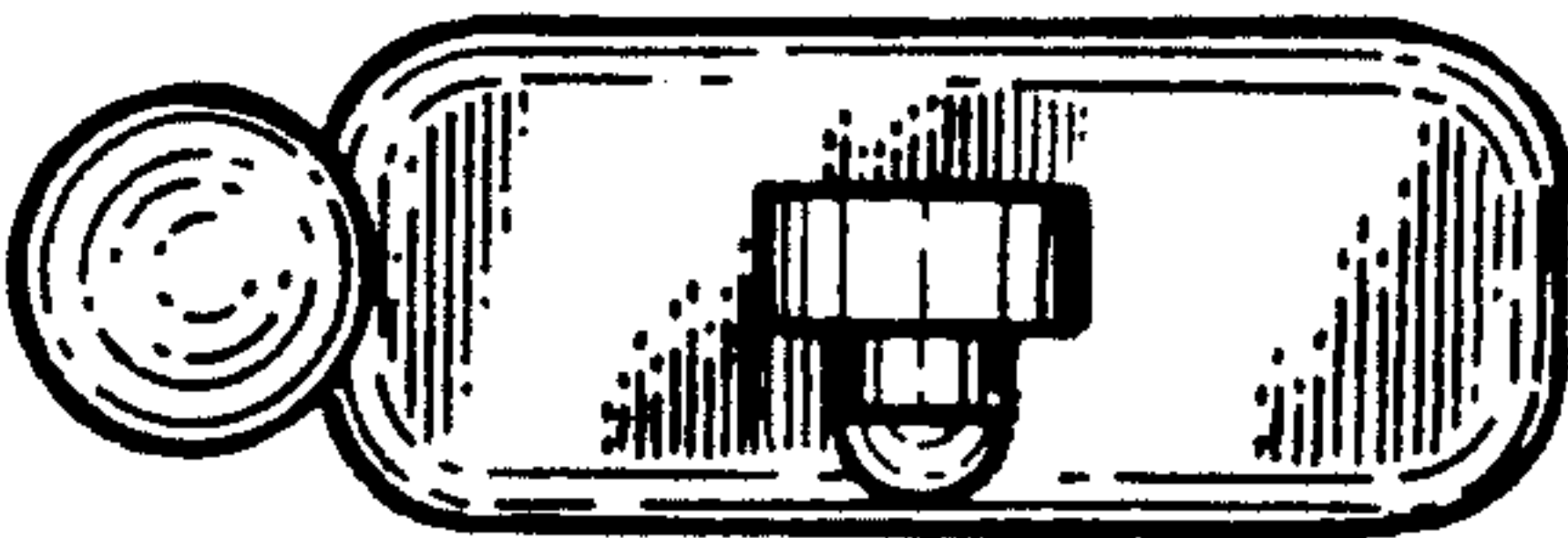

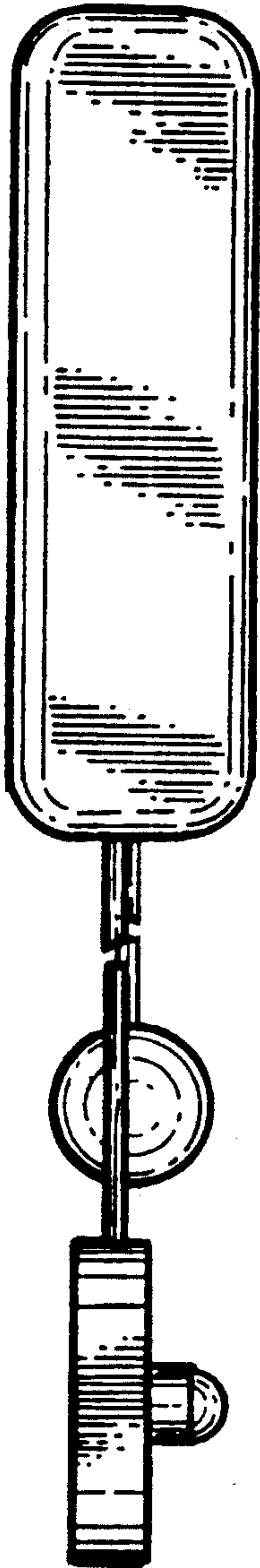

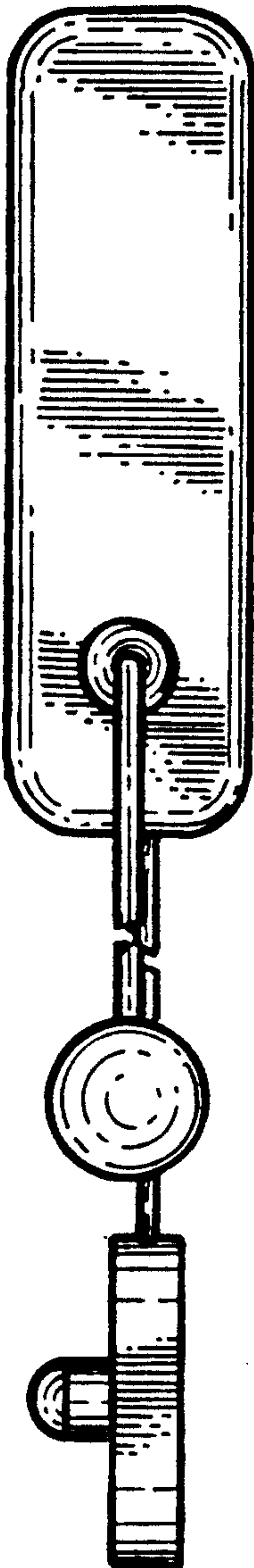
