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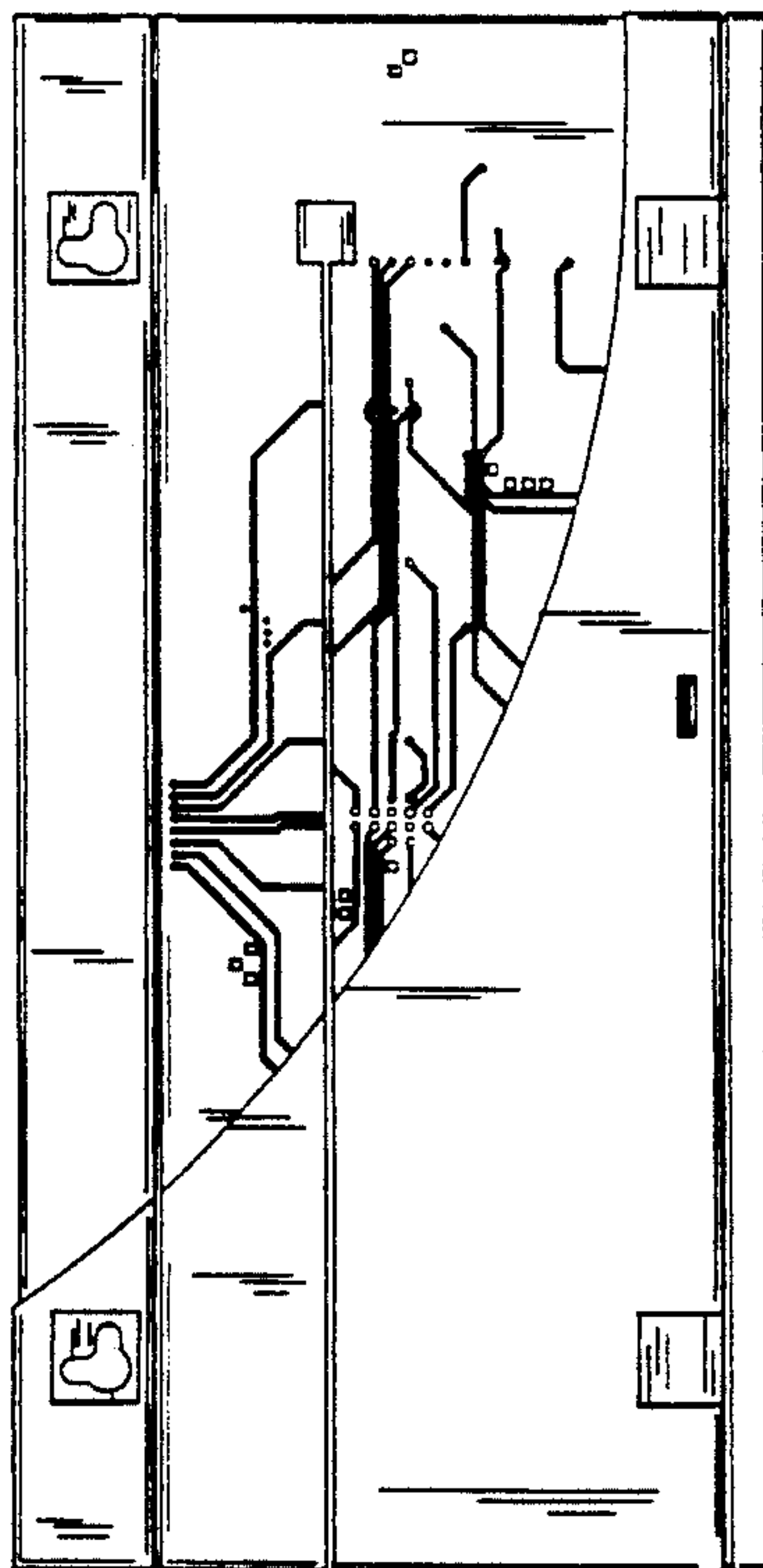
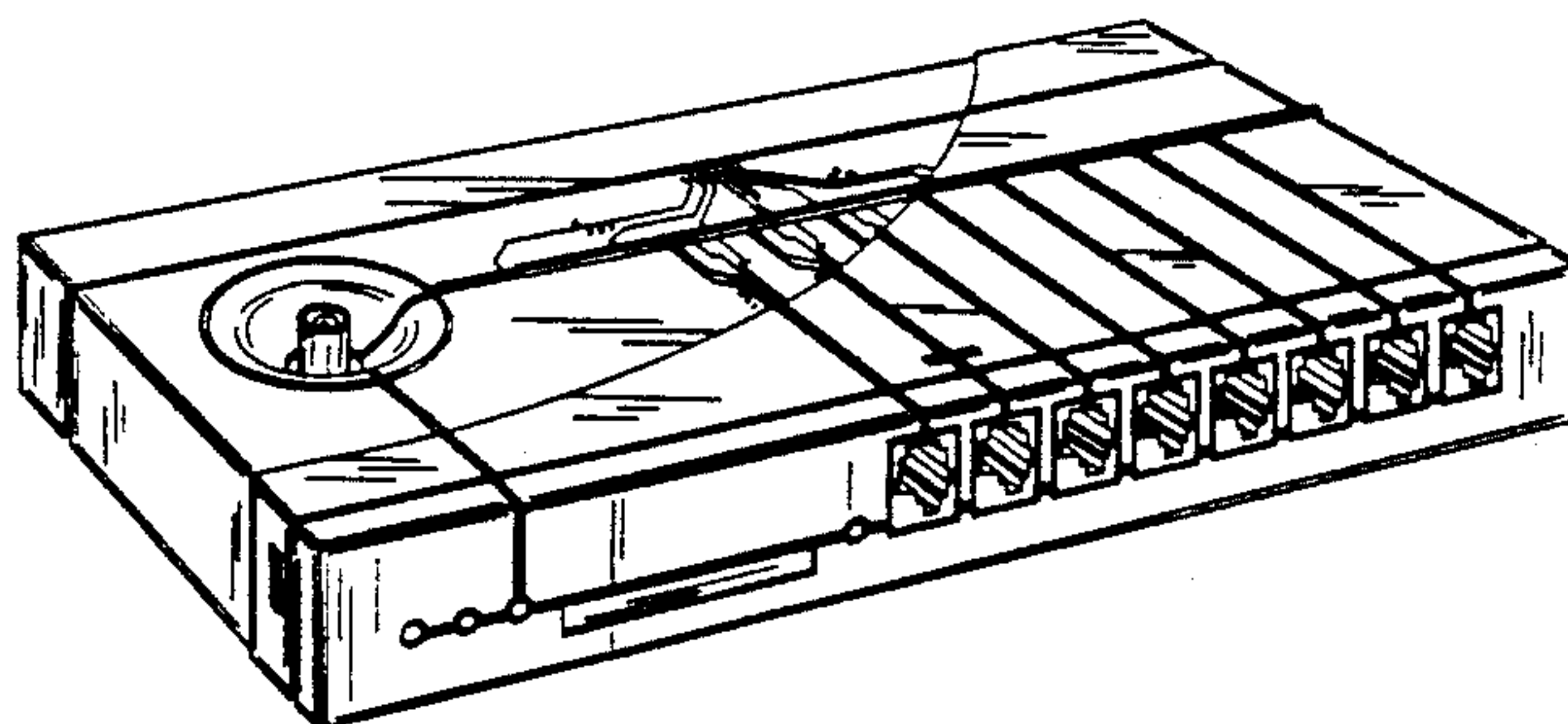

FIGS. 2-7 are drawn on an enlarged scale.



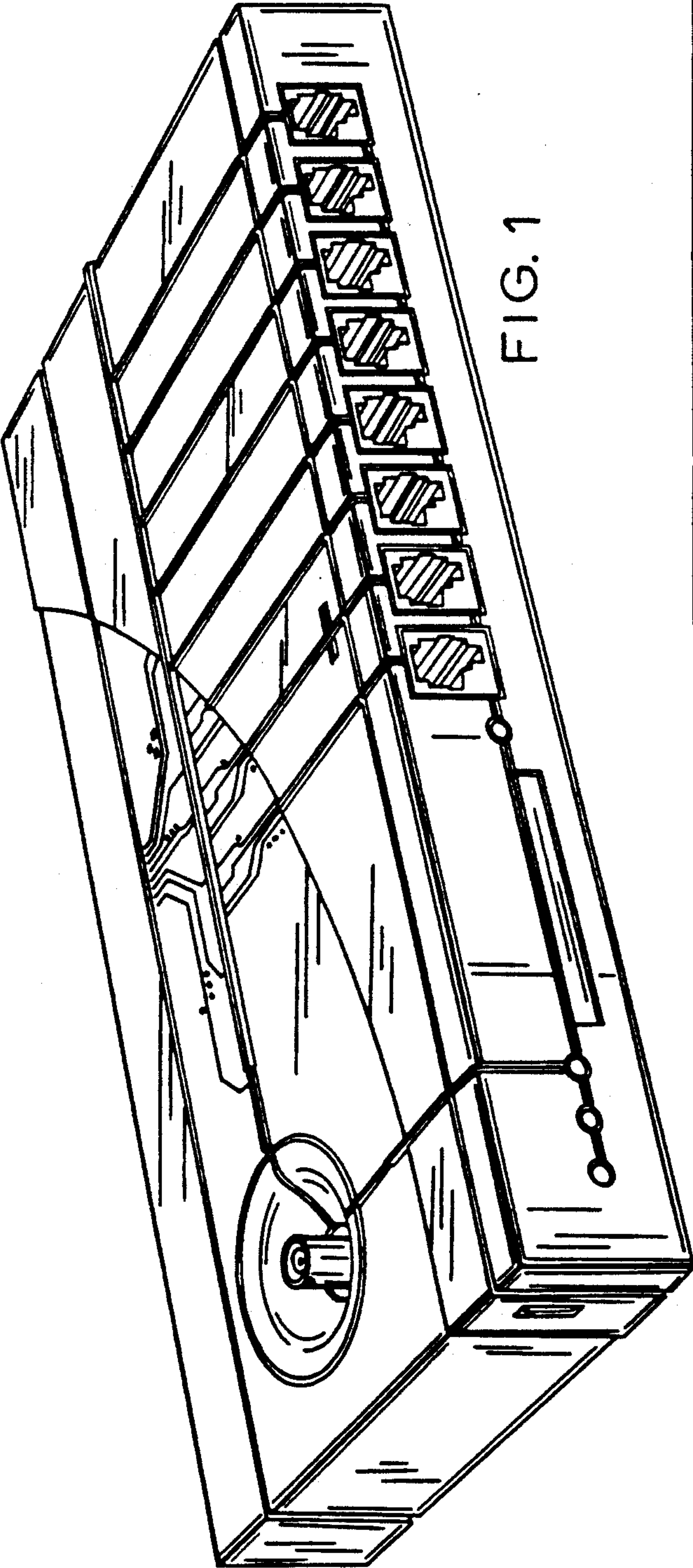

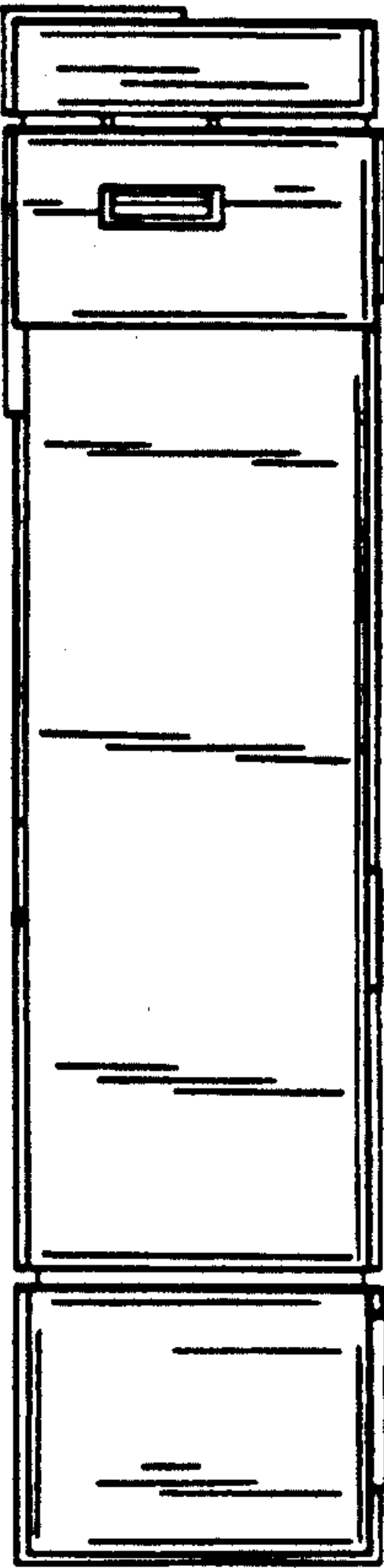

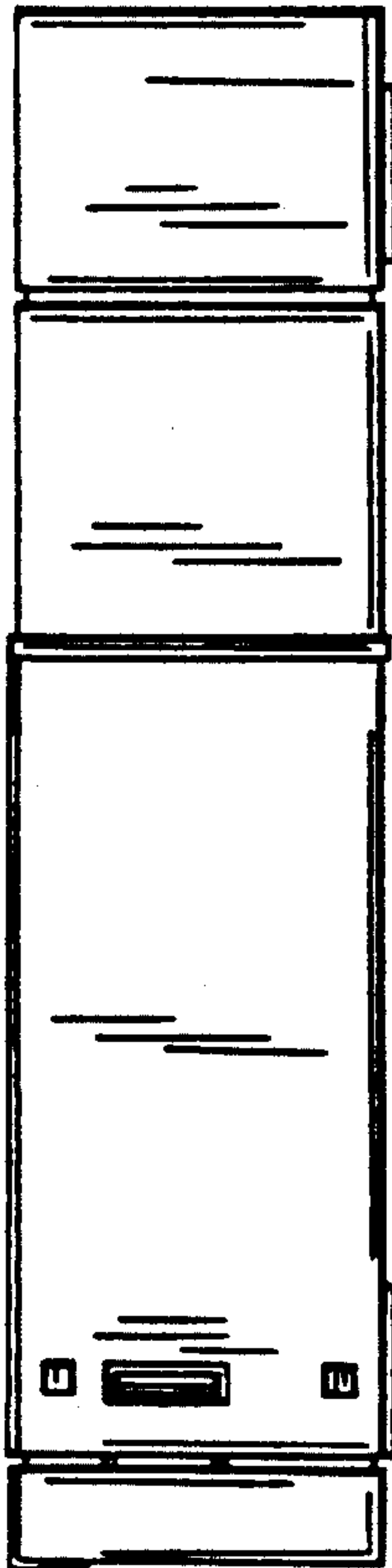

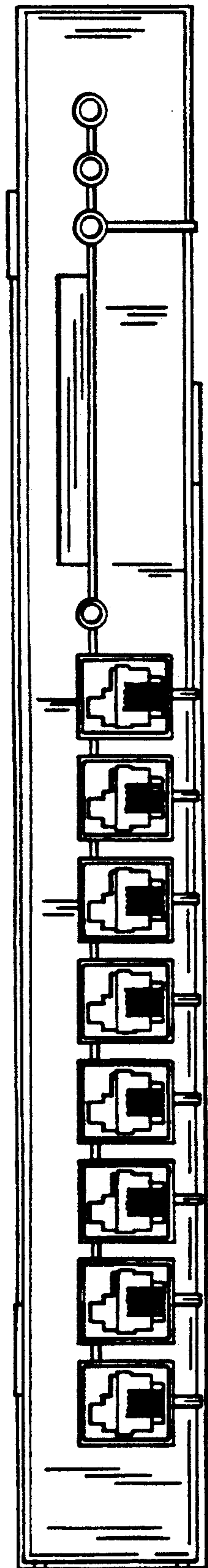

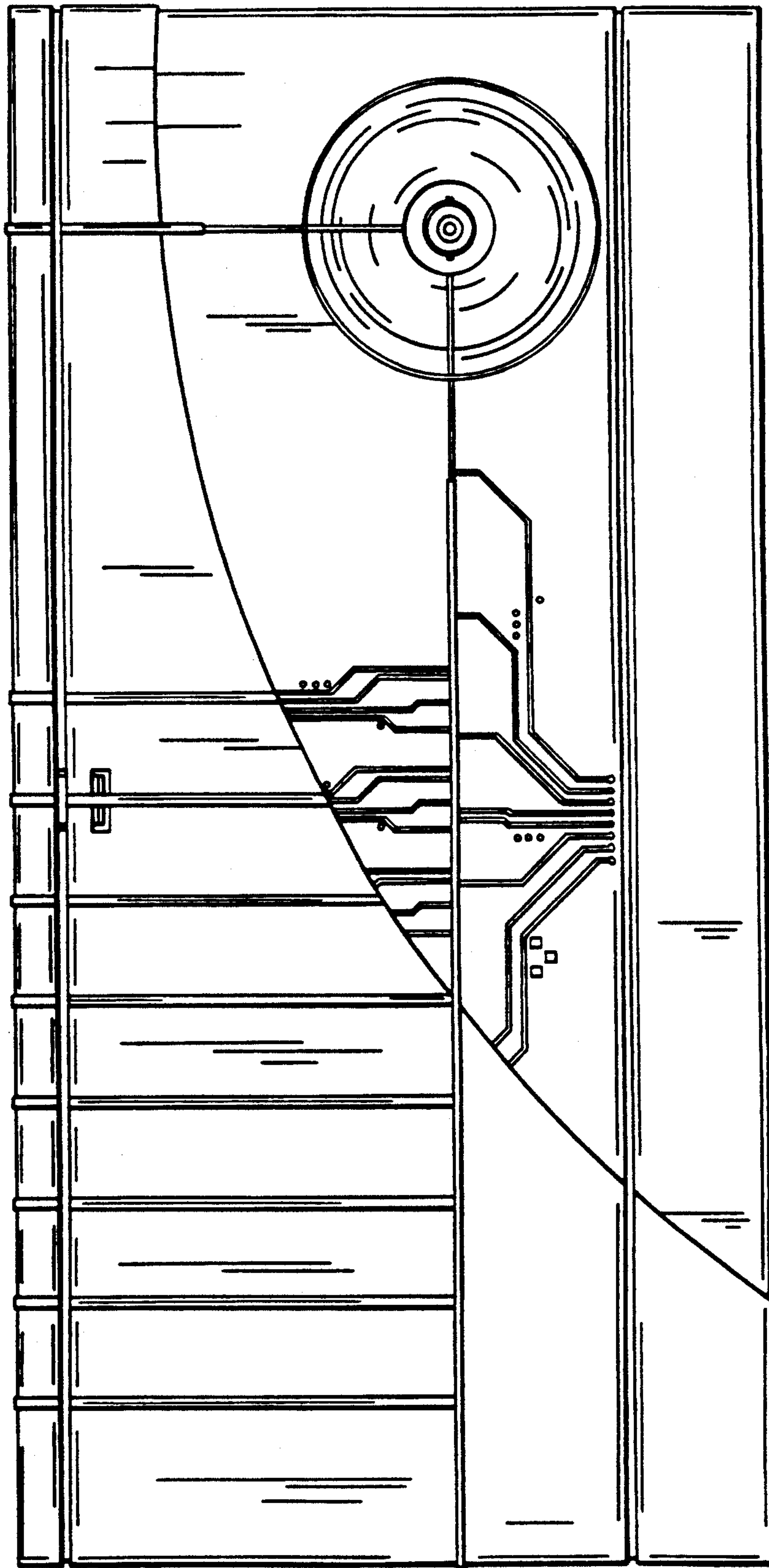

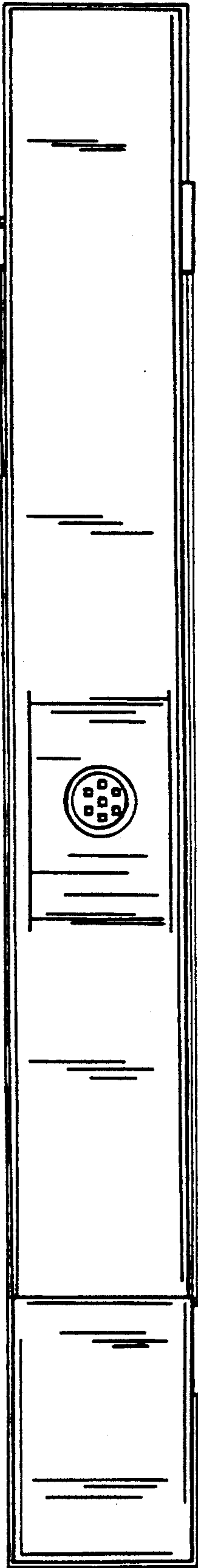

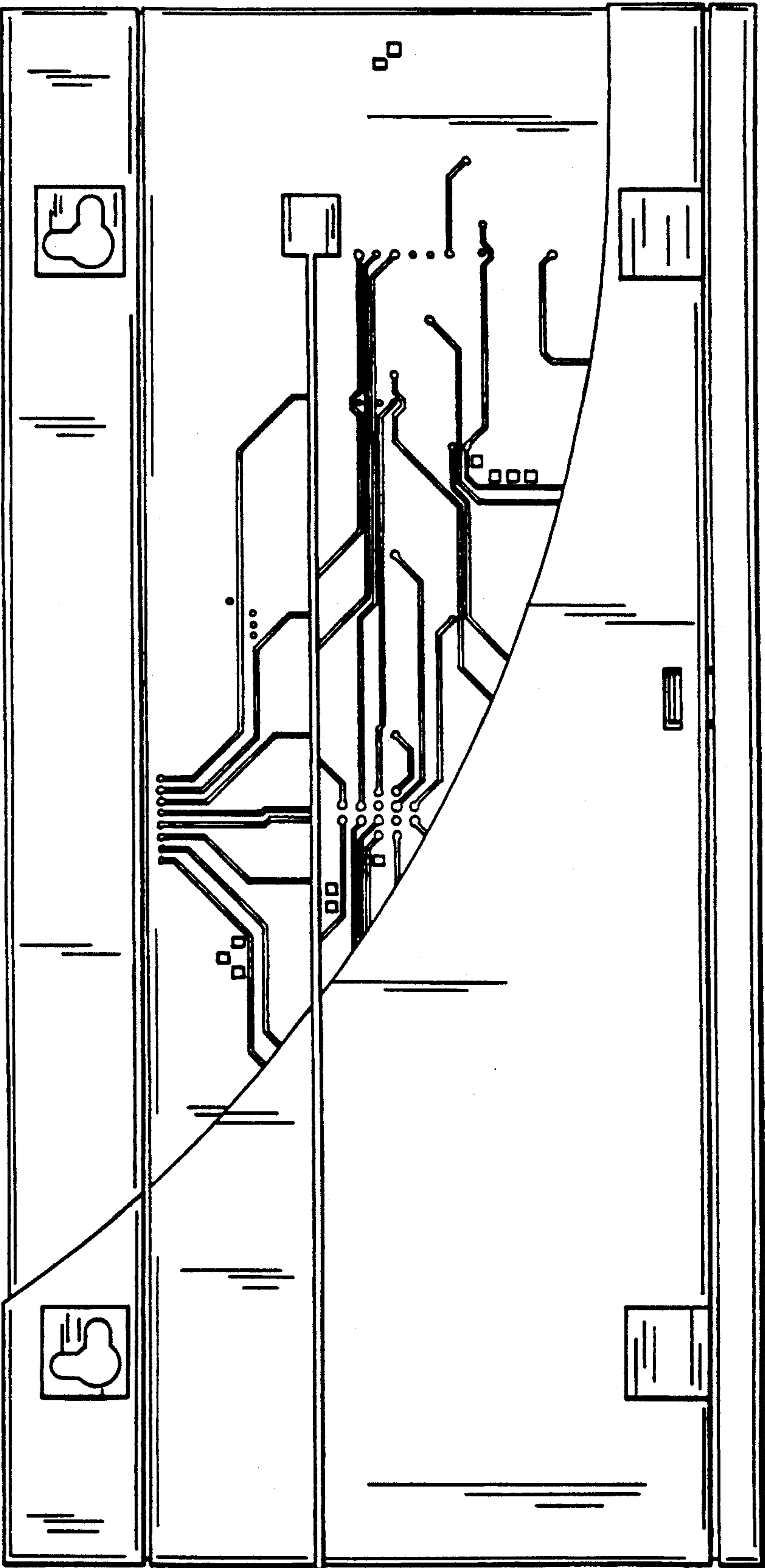
