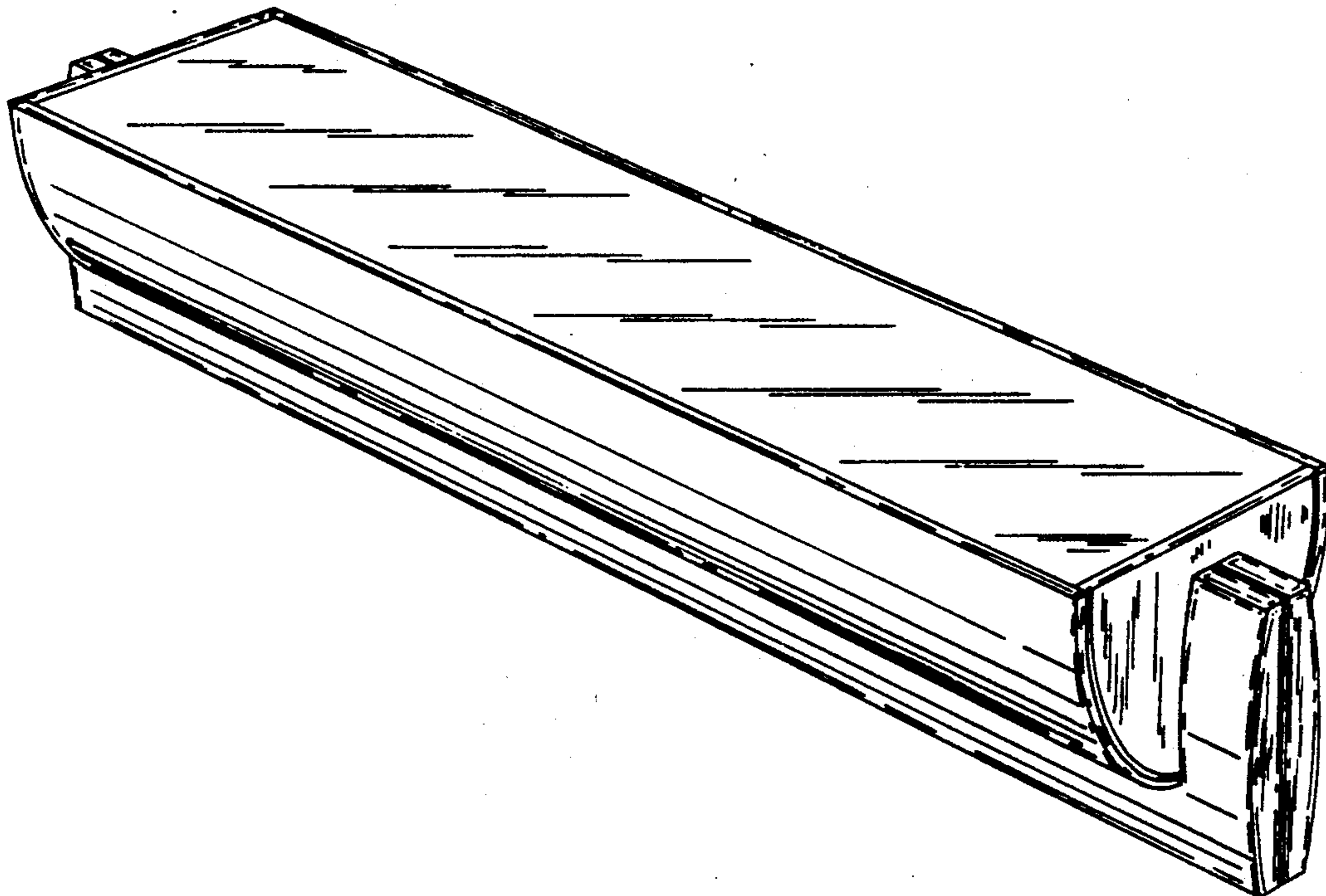

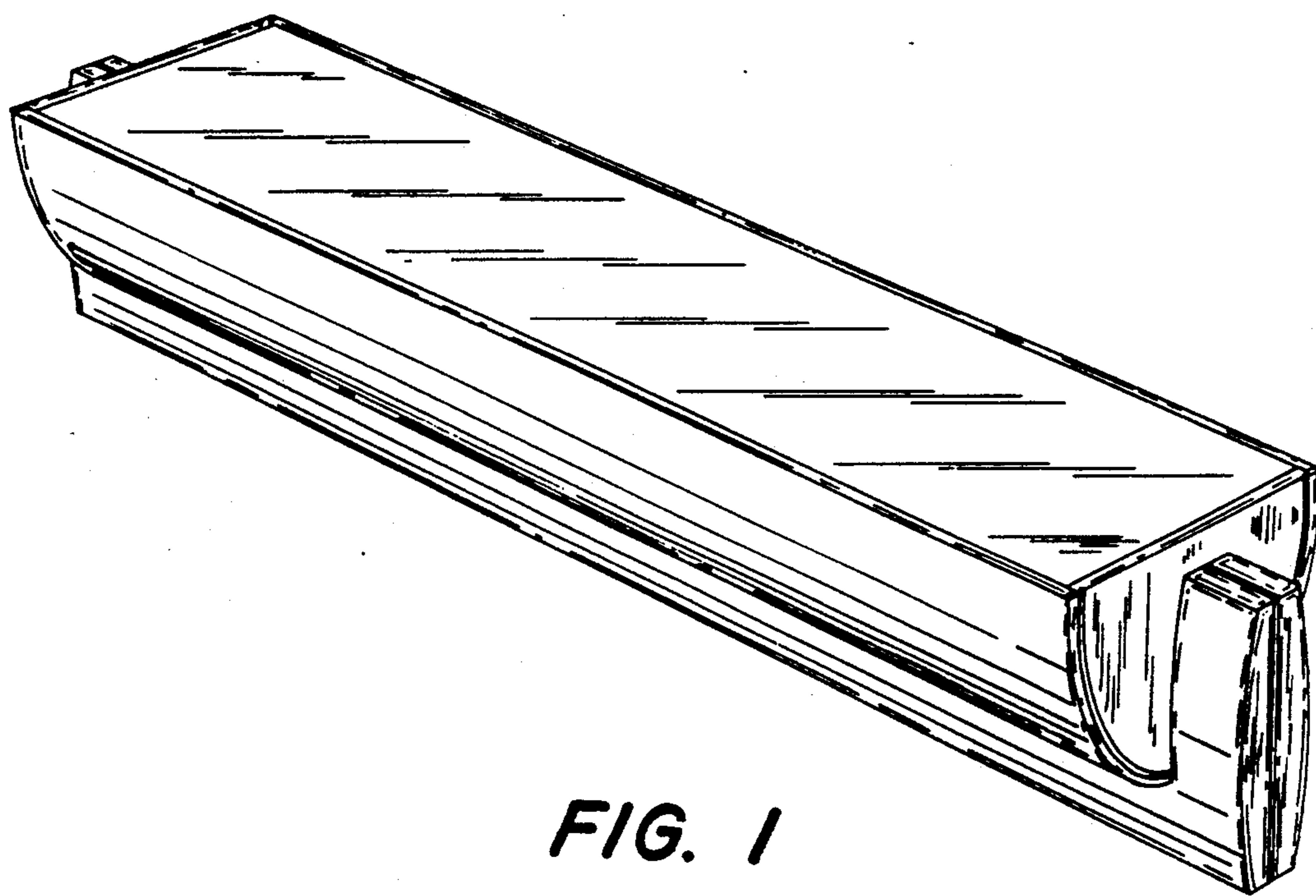
## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a suspended luminaire, as shown.

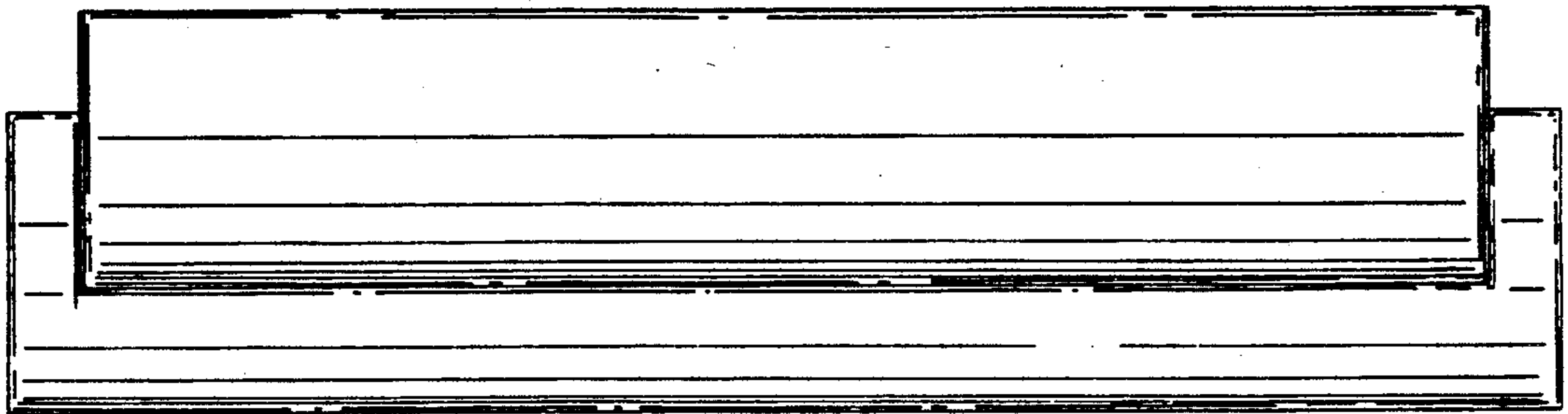
## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

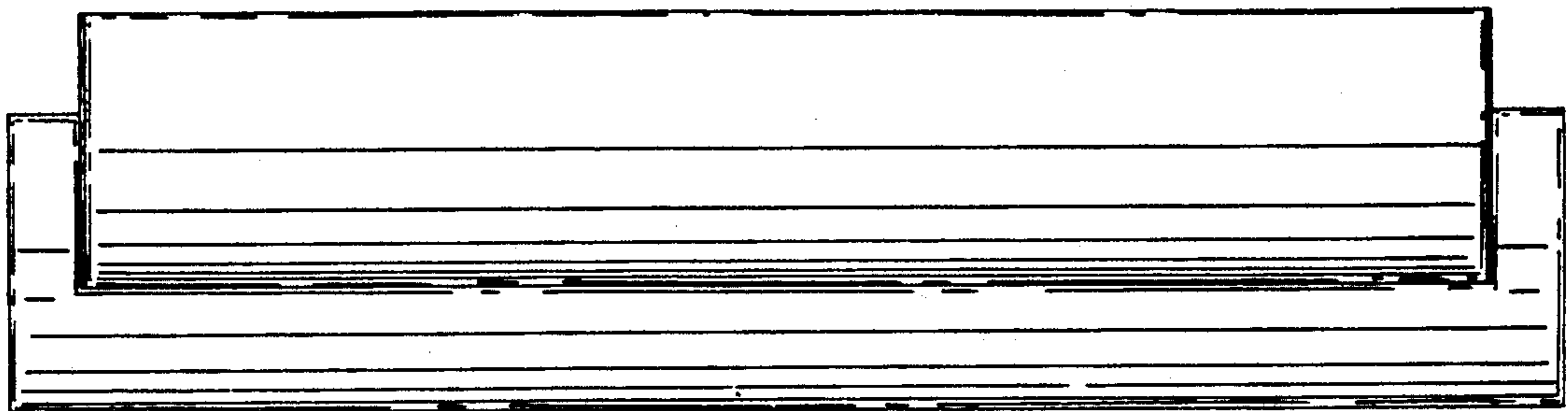




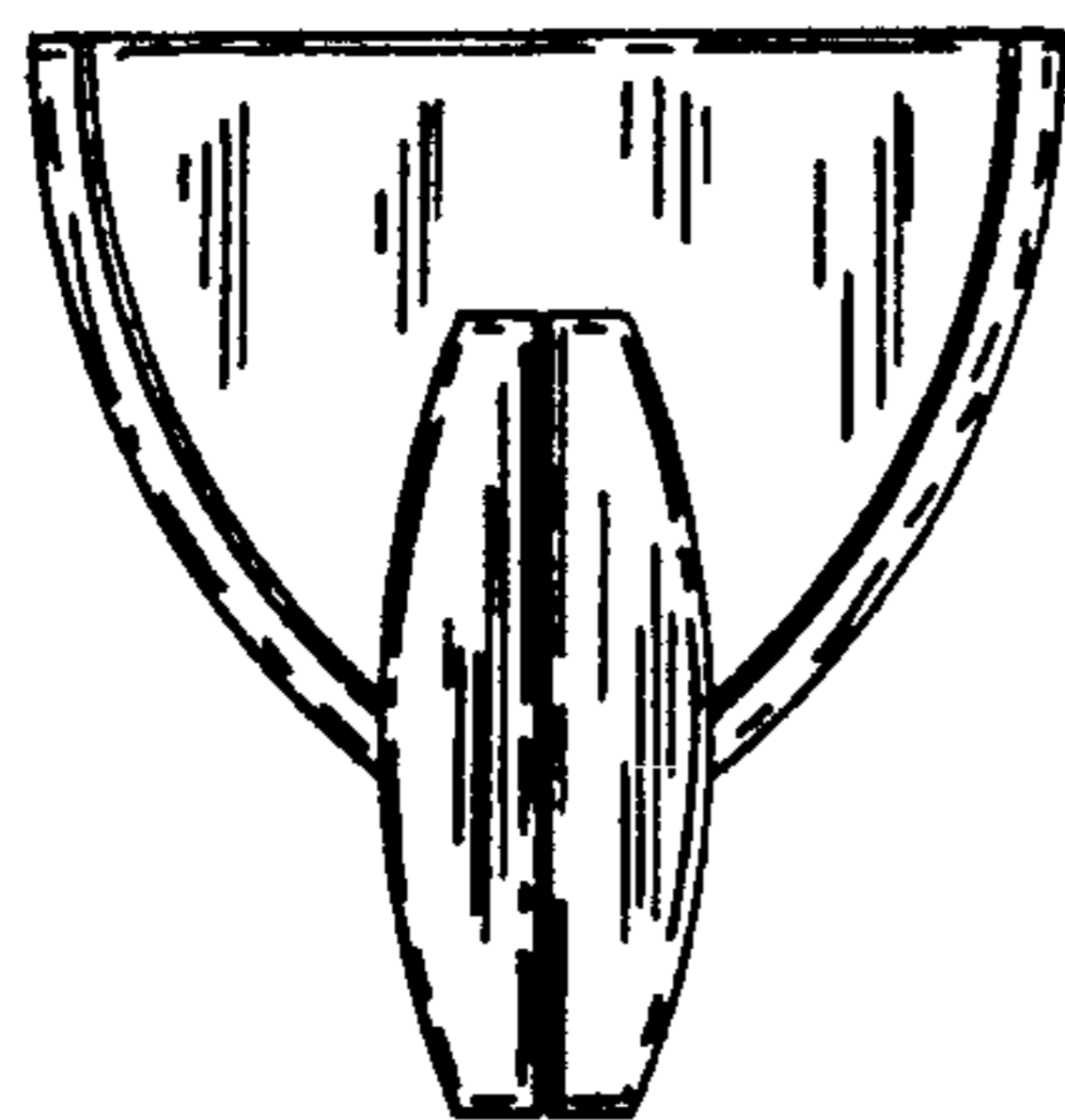

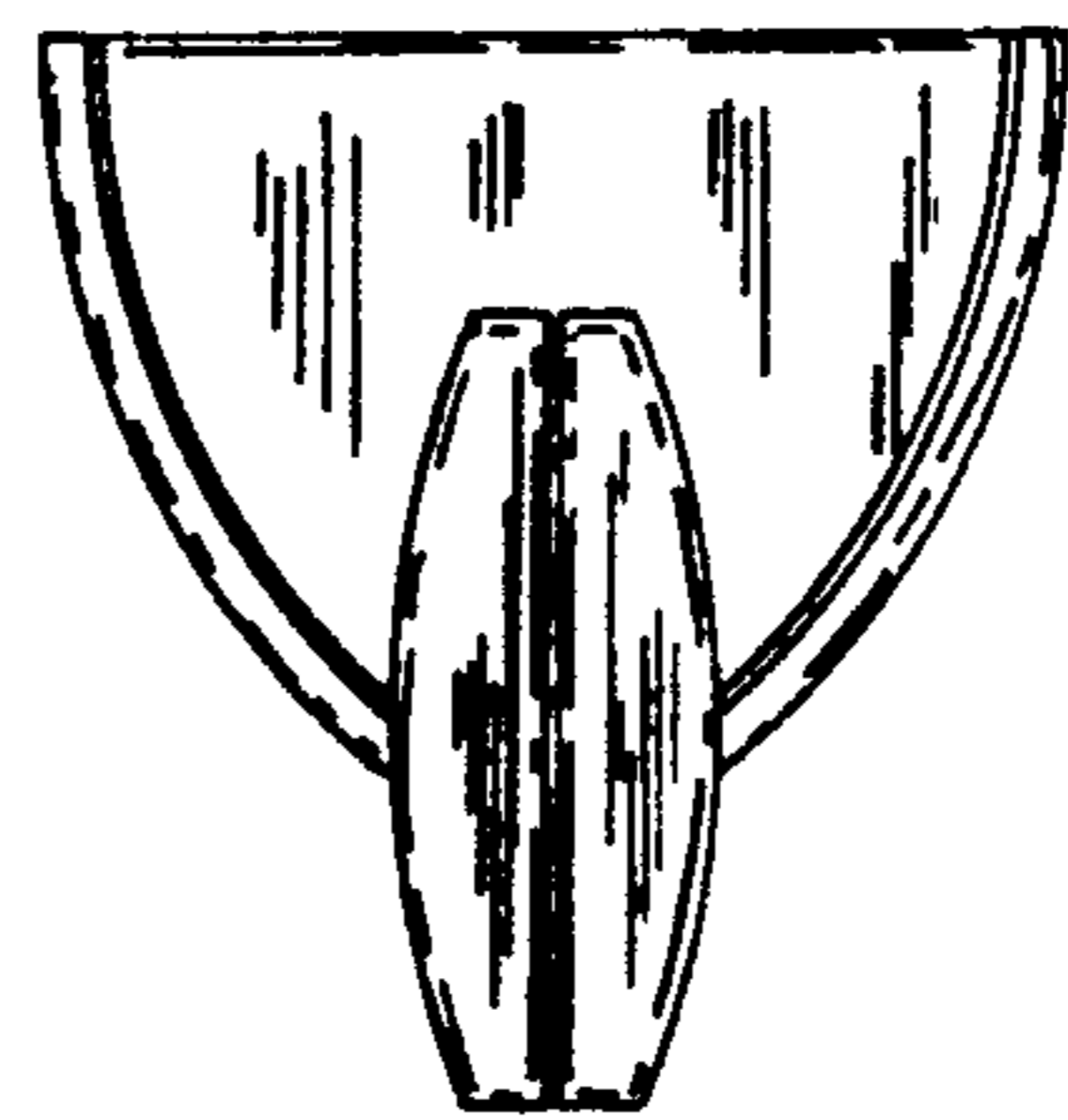

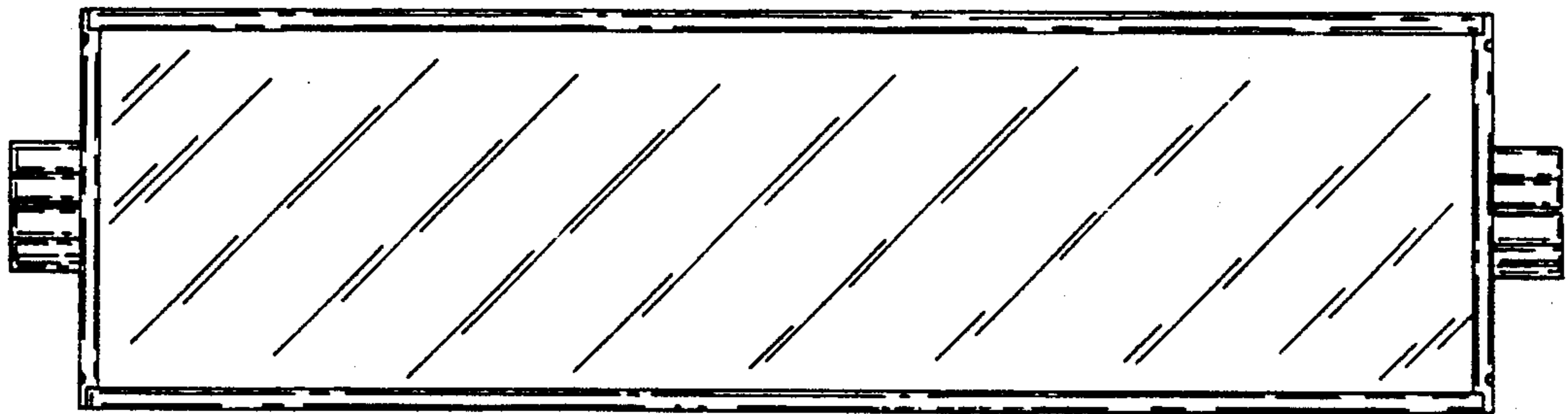

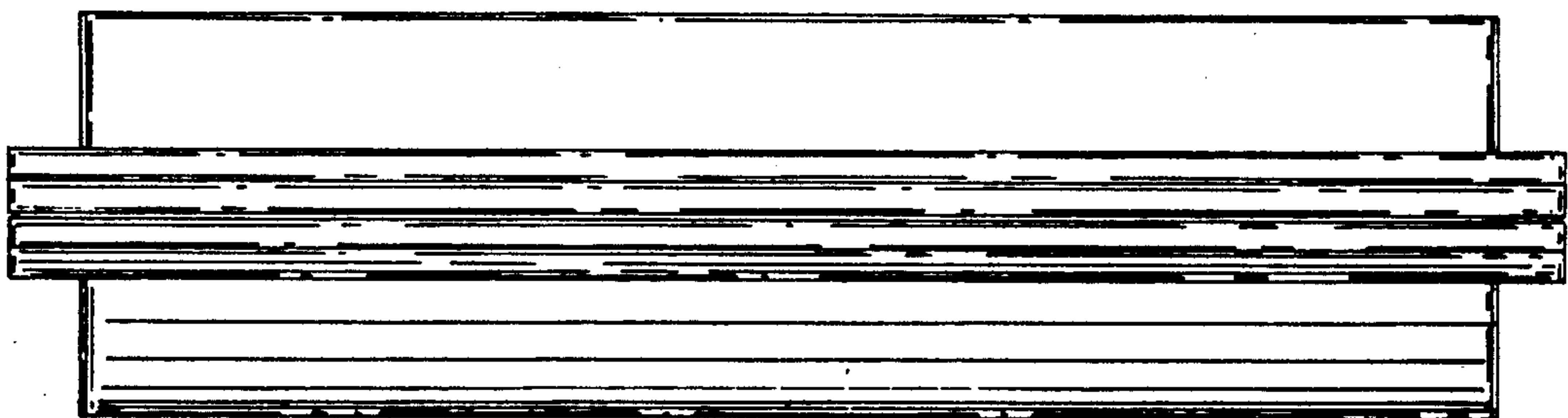
