[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a carrying bag for board games and accessories substantially, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a carrying bag for board games and accessories showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of one side thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the other side thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is an end view thereof; the other end view being a mirror image;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view in a separated position of one of four accessories pouches contained within the side pockets of the carrying bag;

FIG. 8 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a side elevation view of a second pouch;

FIG. 10 is a side elevation view of a third pouch;

FIG. 11 is a side elevation view of a fourth pouch;


FIG. 12 is a side elevation view of the outer side of the pouch shown in FIG. 7, the undisclosed sides of the pouches shown in FIGS. 9-11 being identical;


FIG. 13 is a top plan view of the pouch shown in FIG. 7, the undisclosed tops of the pouches shown in FIGS. 9-11 being identical;


FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view of the pouch shown in FIG. 7, the undisclosed bottoms of the pouches shown in FIGS. 9-11 being identical;

FIG. 15 is an end view of the pouch shown in FIG. 7, the other end being a mirror image thereof, and the undisclosed ends of the pouches shown in FIGS. 9-11 being identical; and,

FIG. 16 is an exploded perspective view of the carrying bag and four accessories pouches normally contained within the side pockets of the carrying bag.





