FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view thereof;

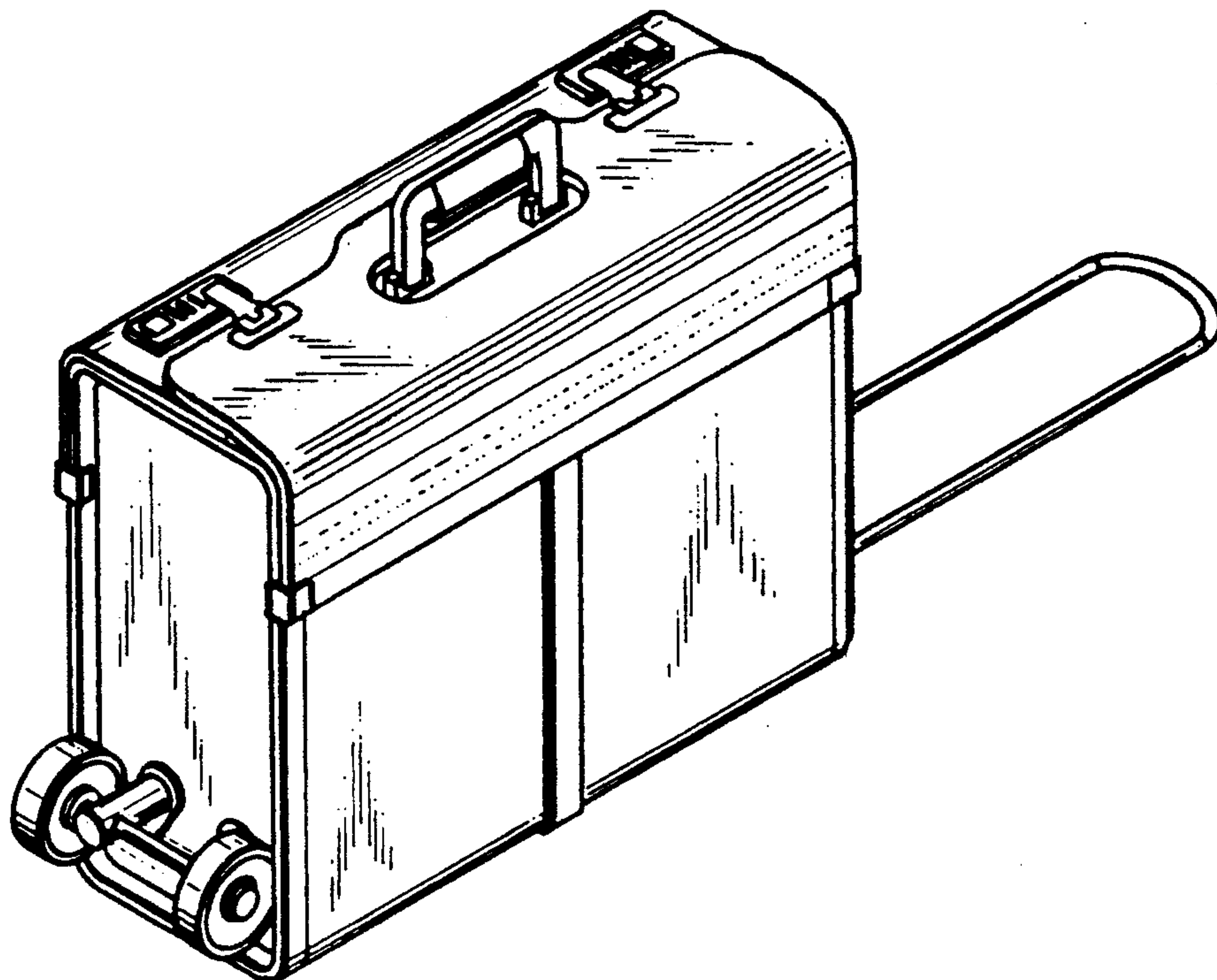
FIG. 17 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 21 is an opposite side elevational view thereof.



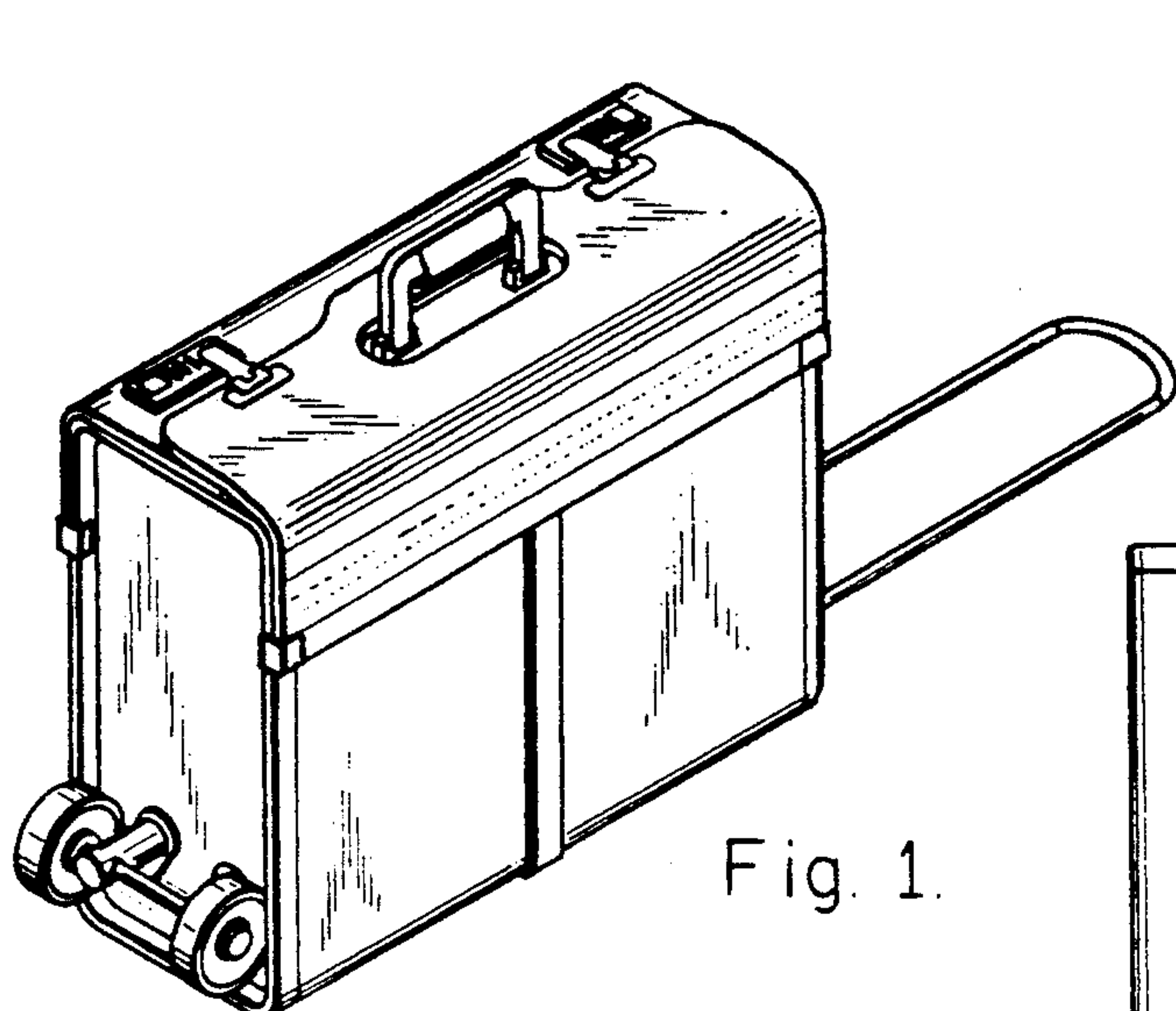

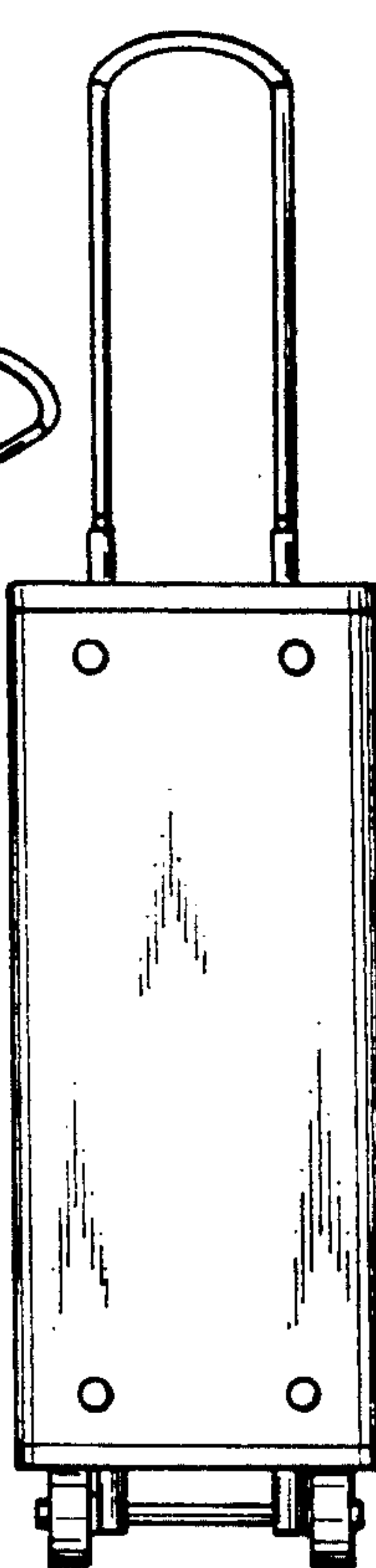

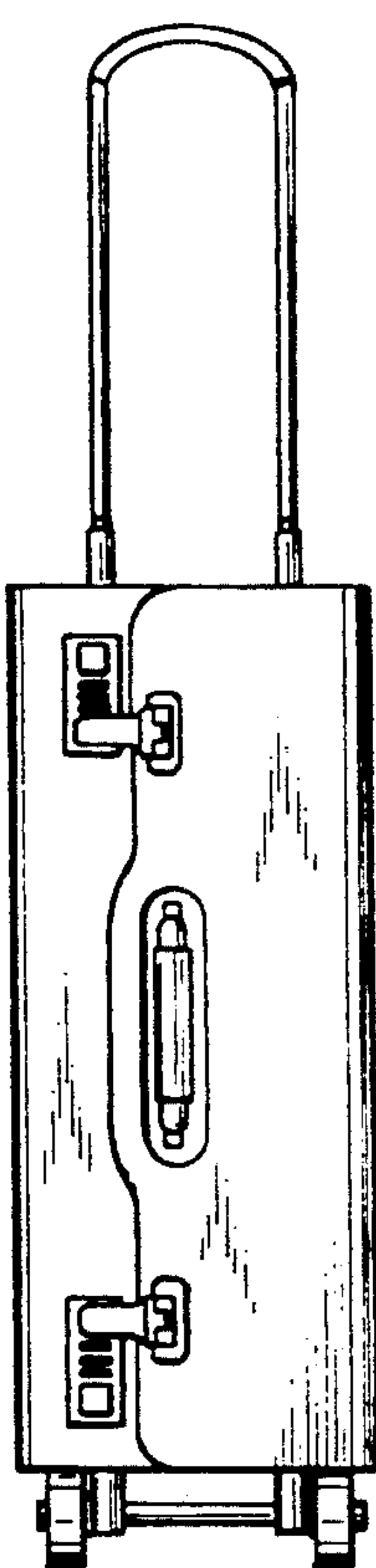

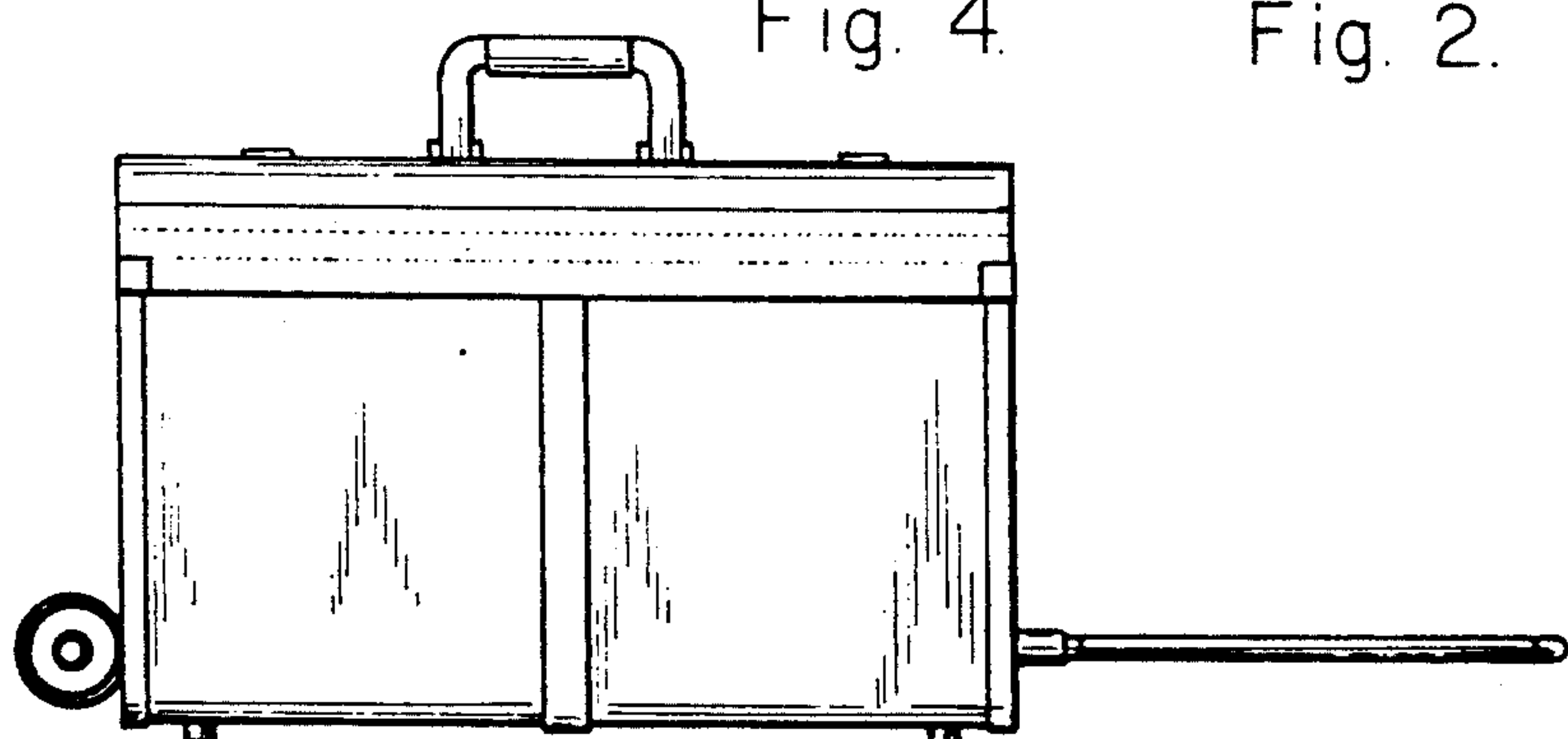

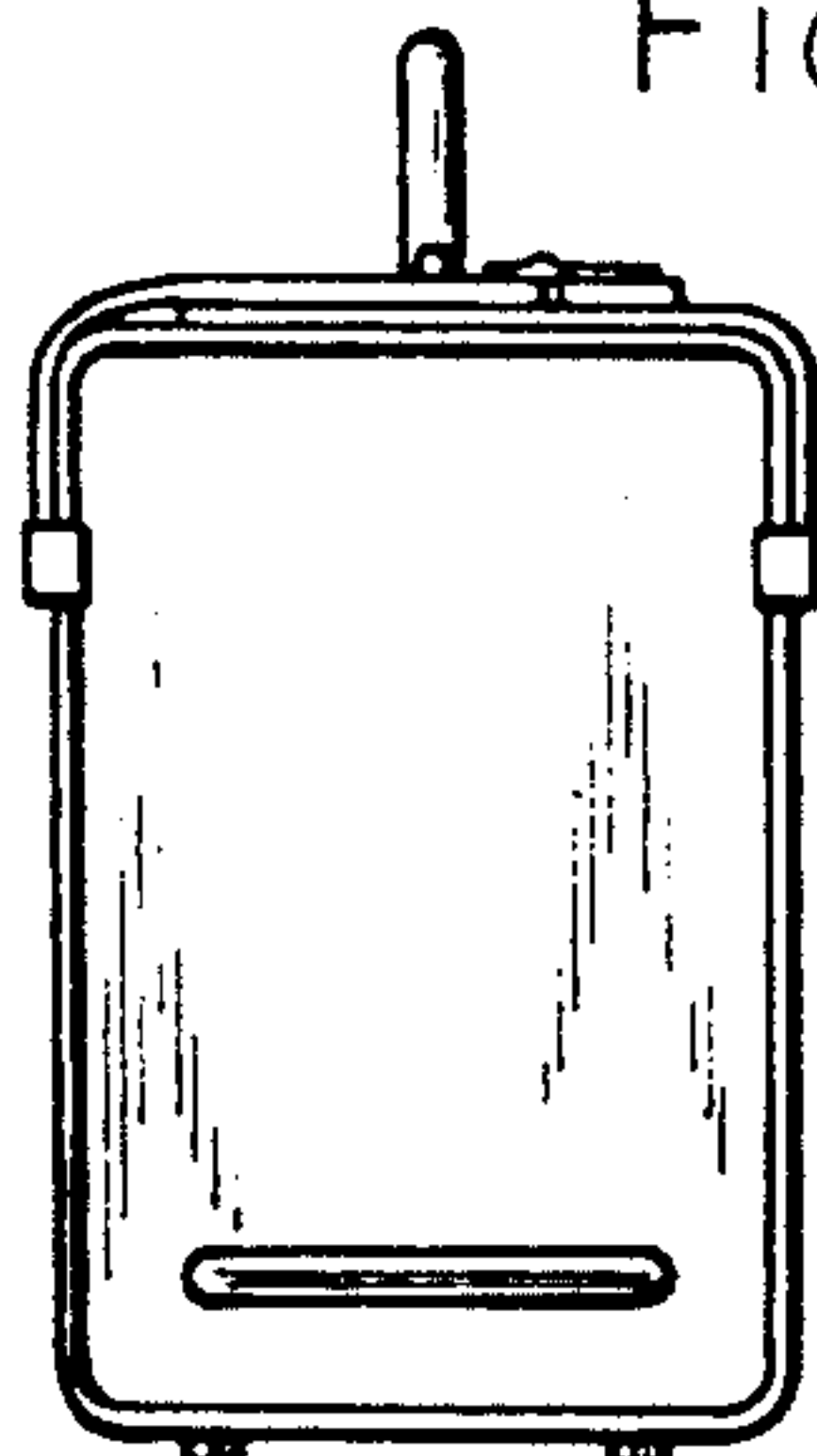

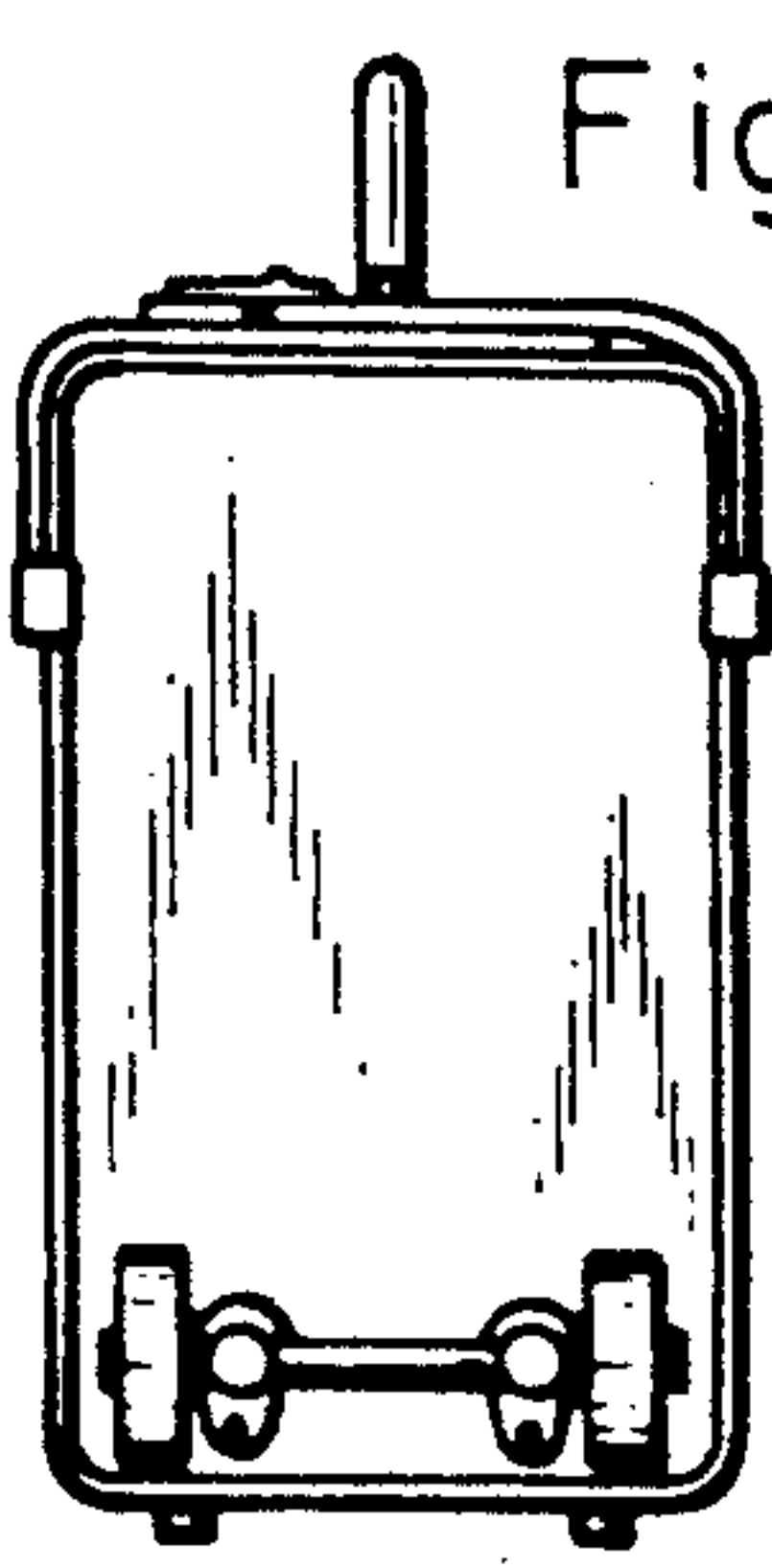

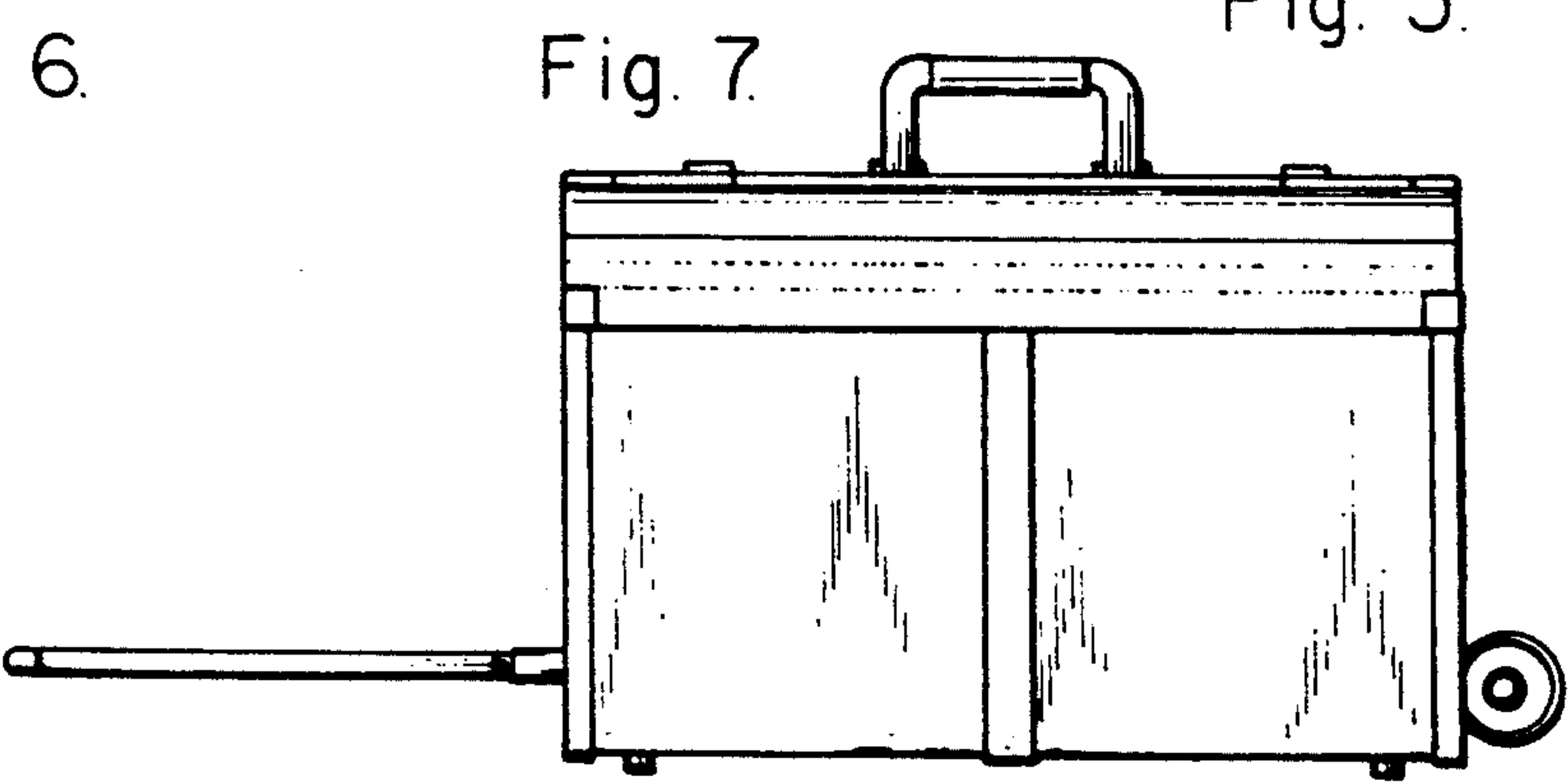

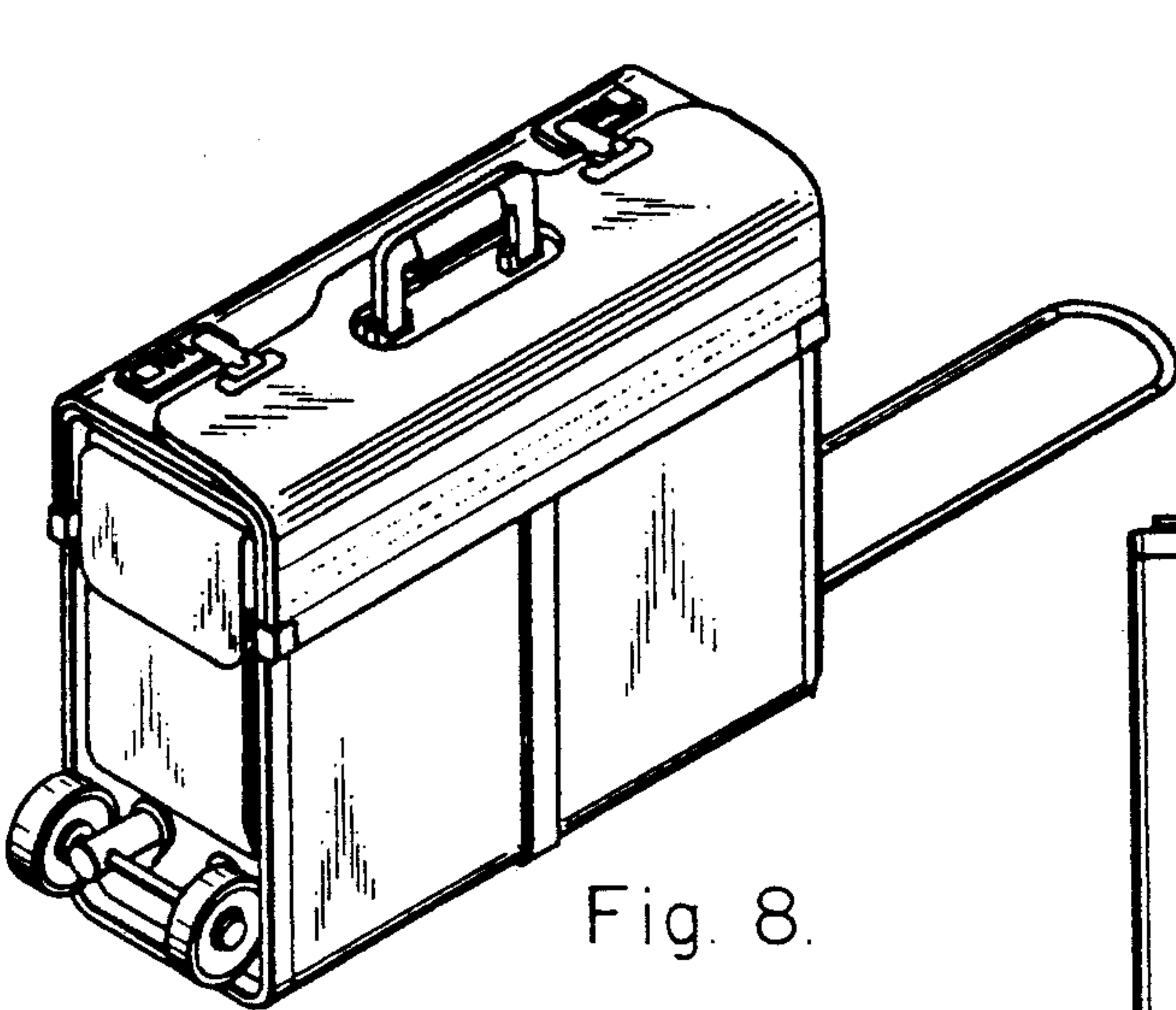

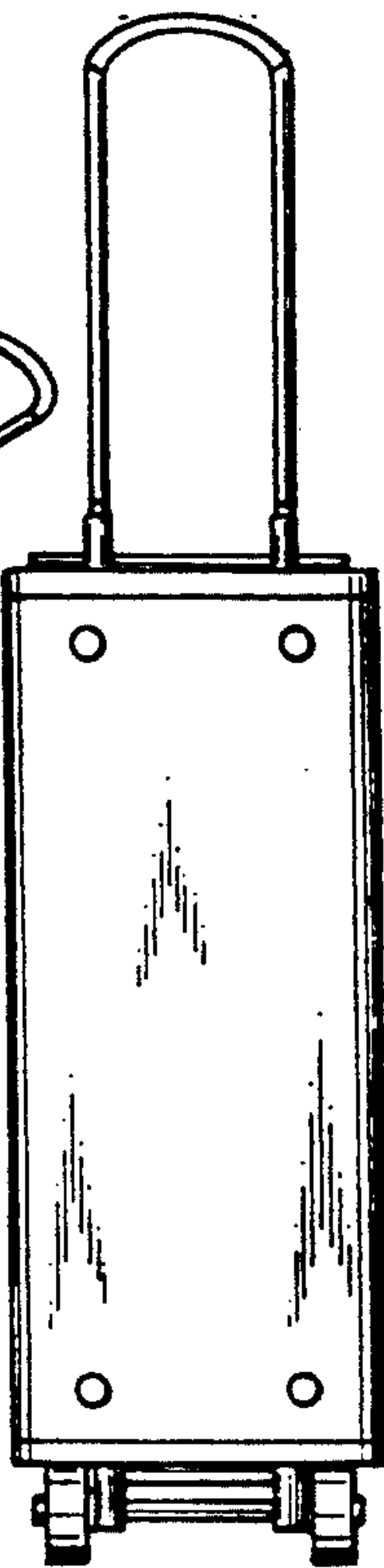

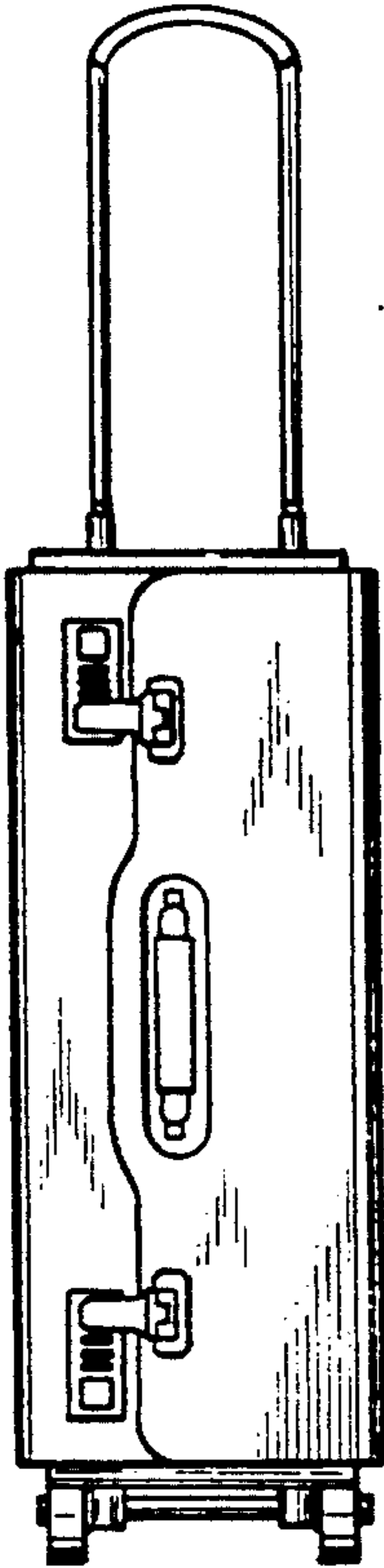

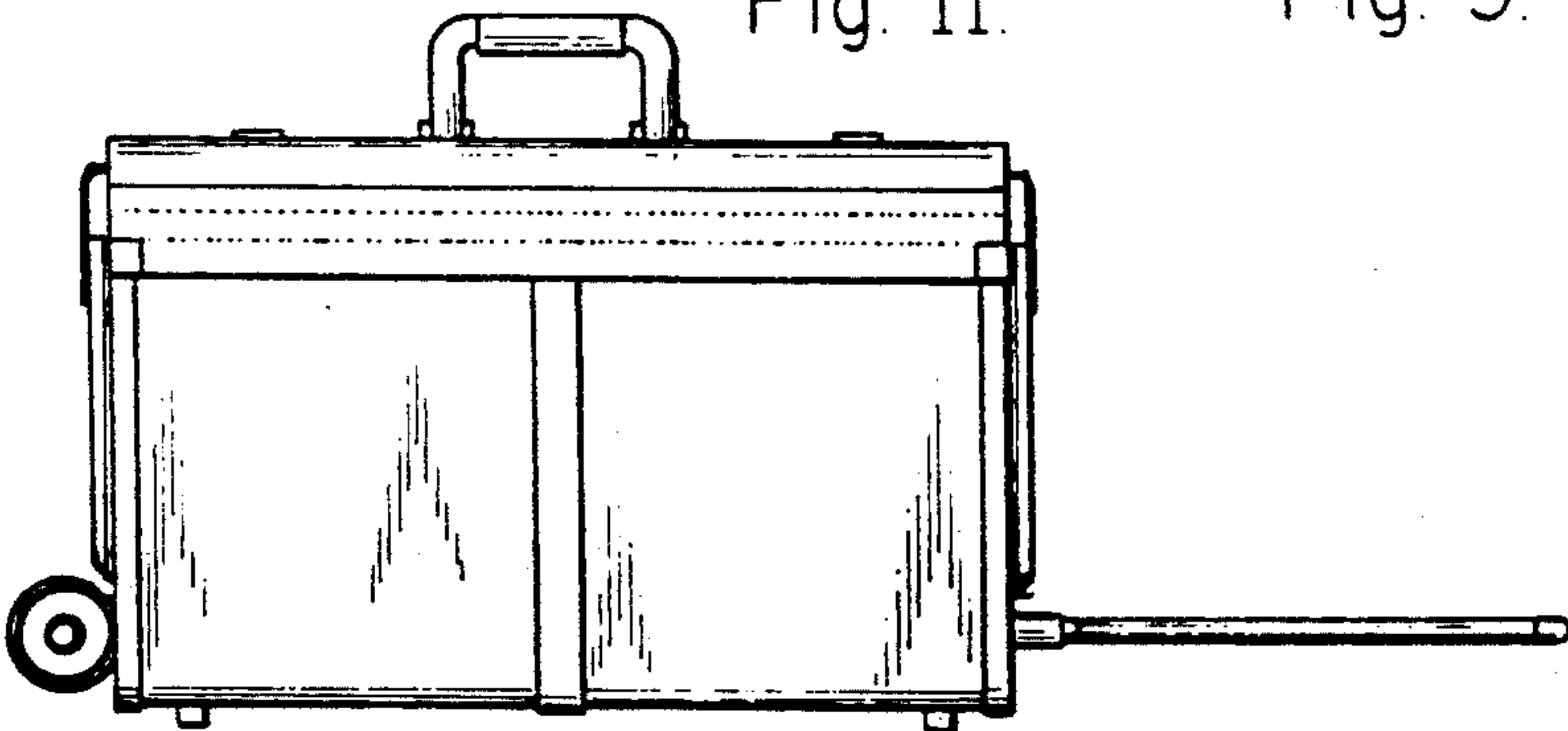

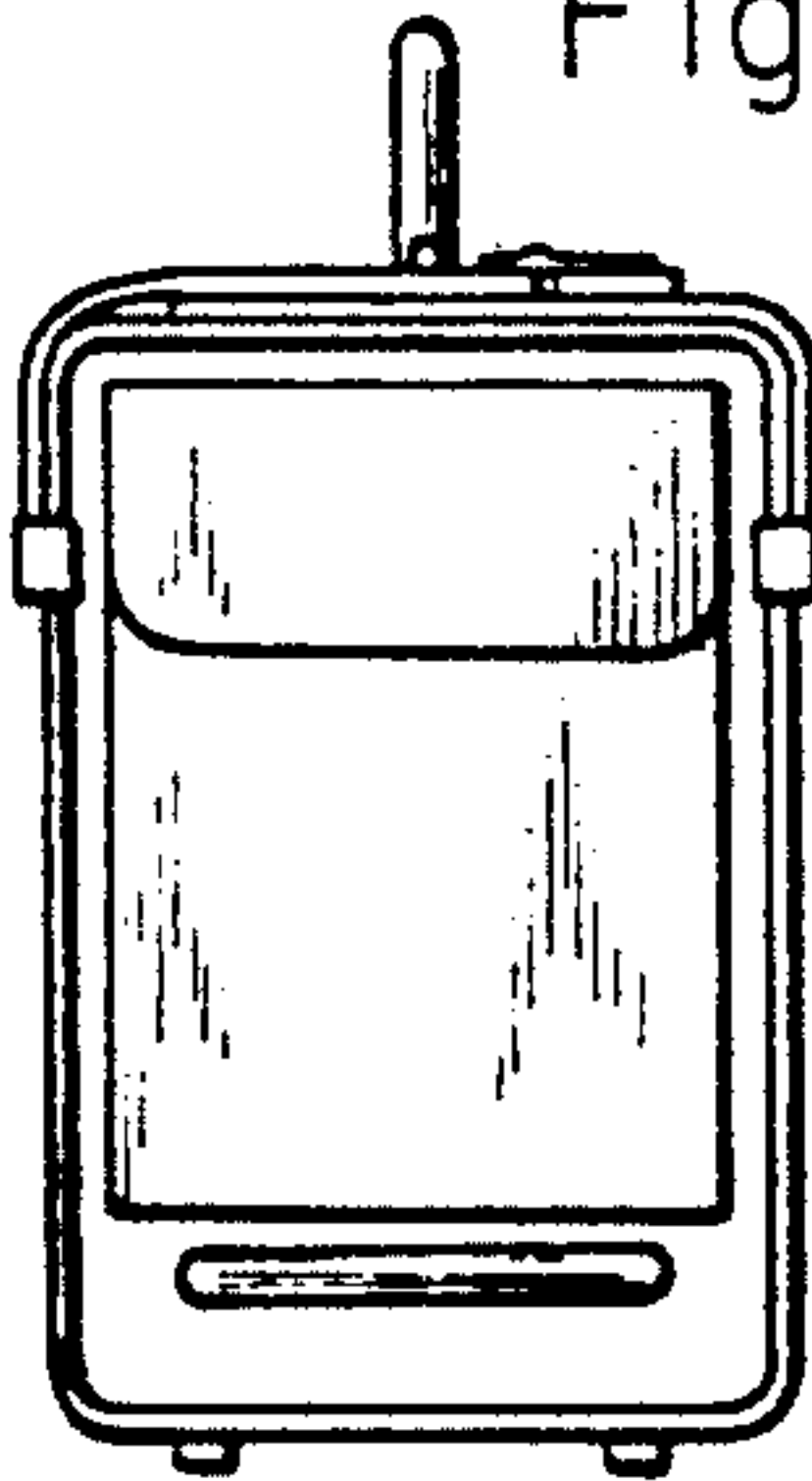

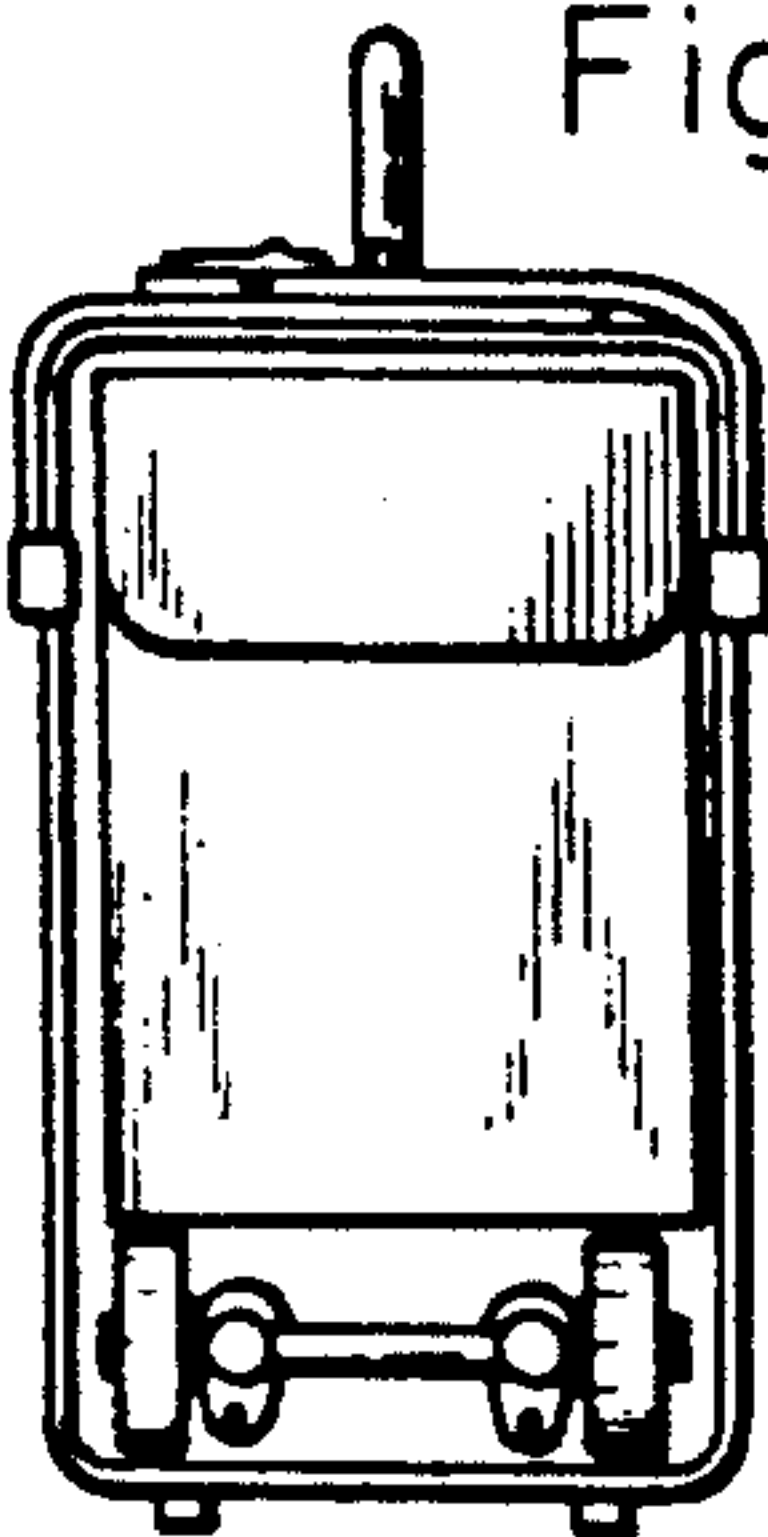

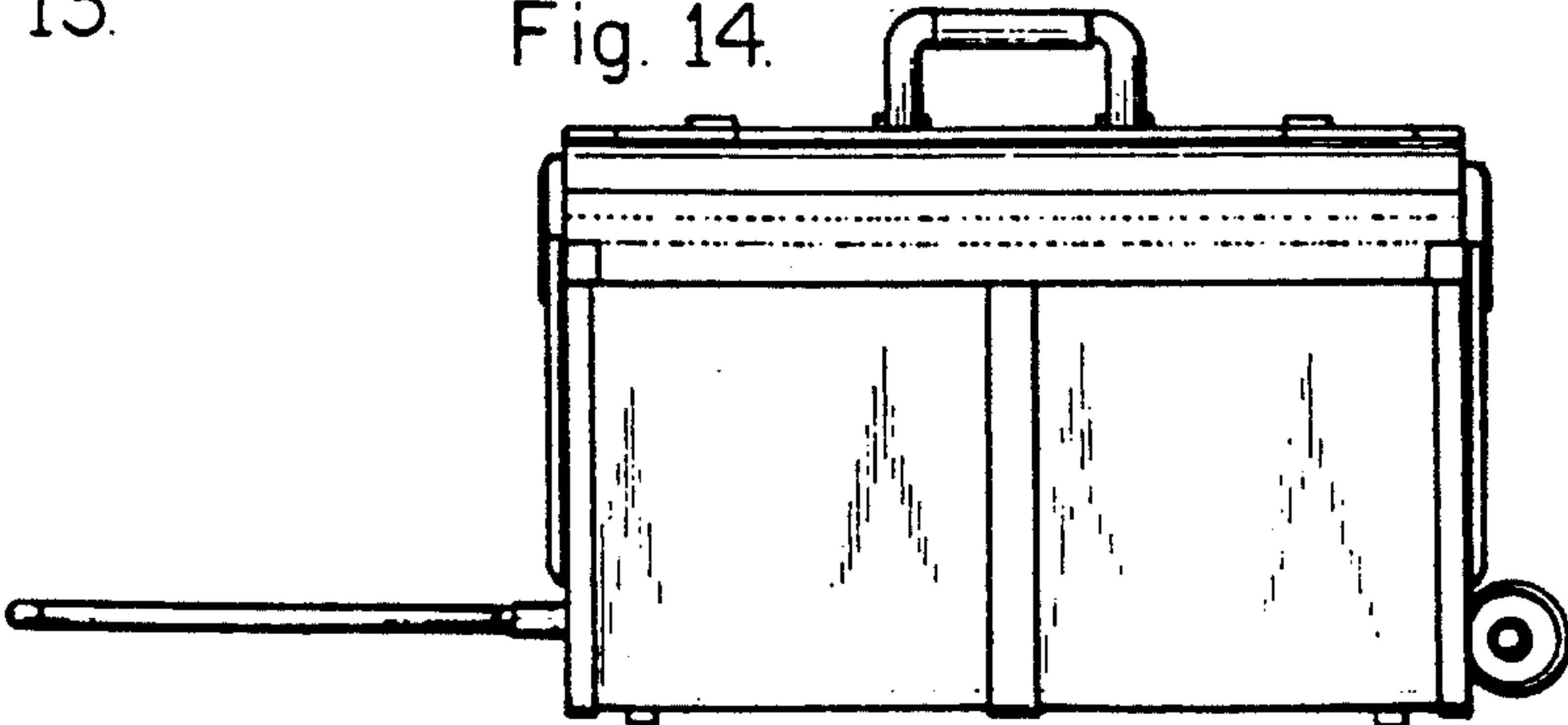

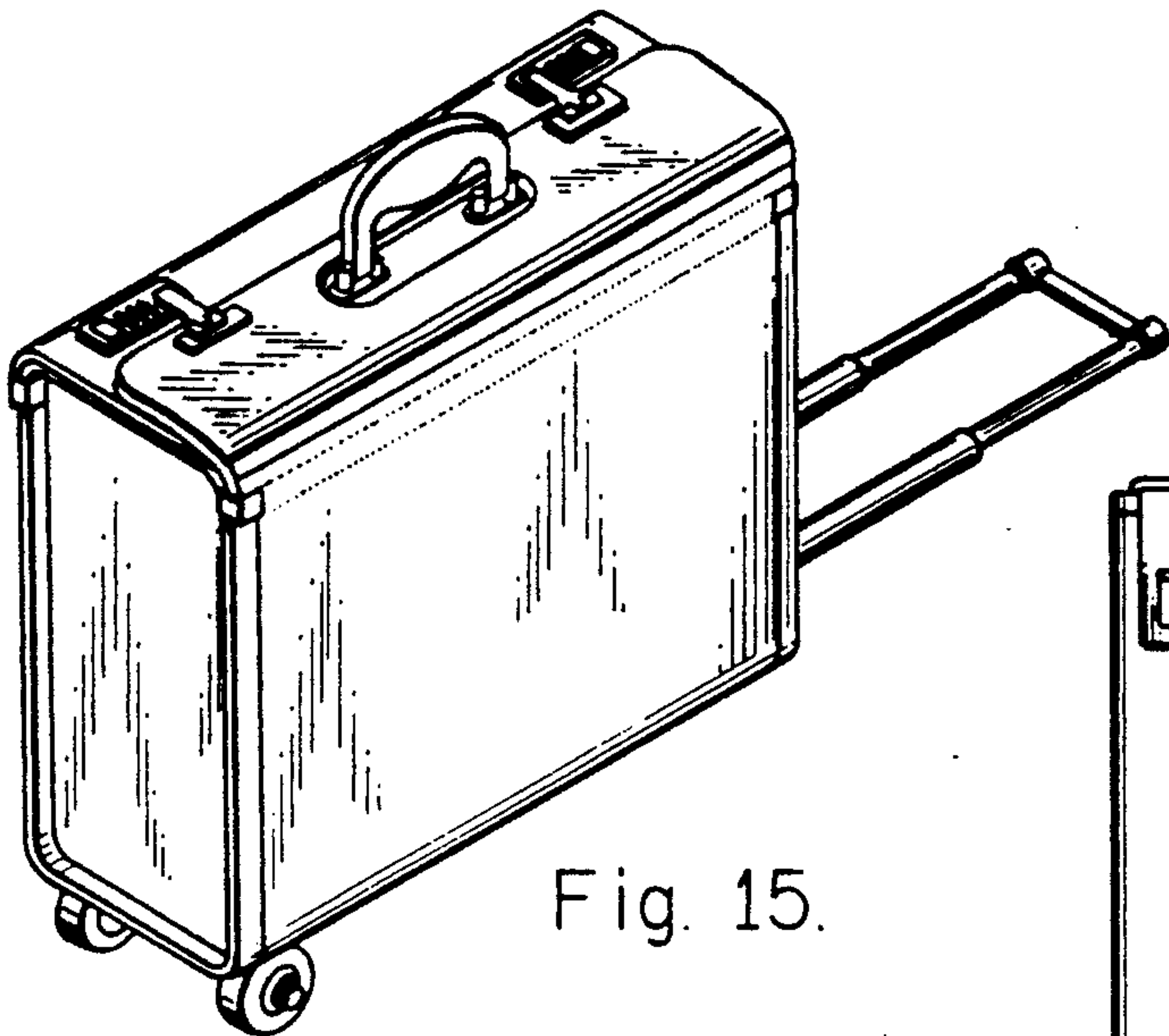

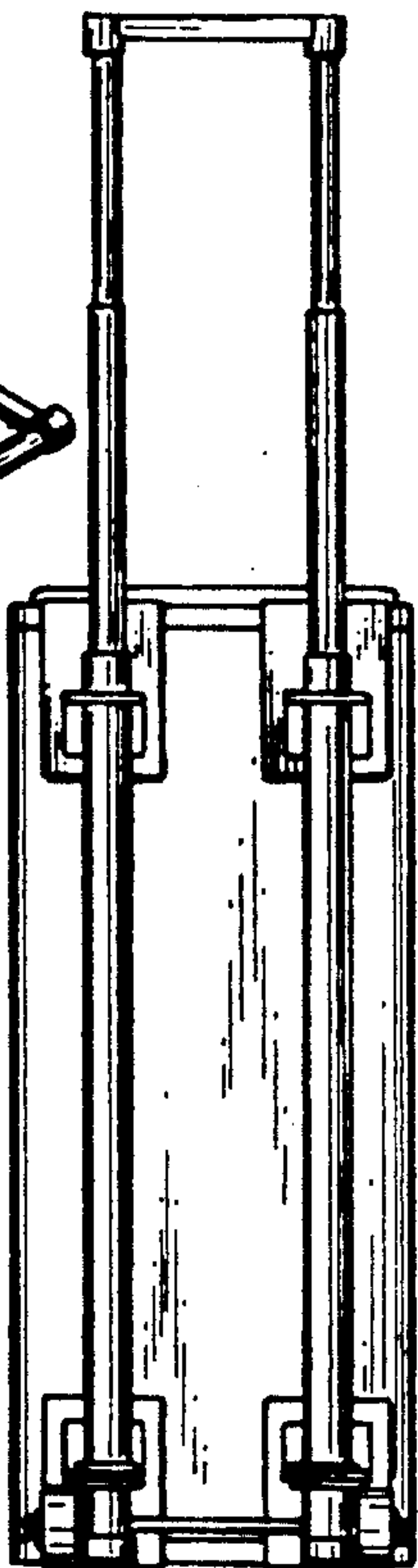

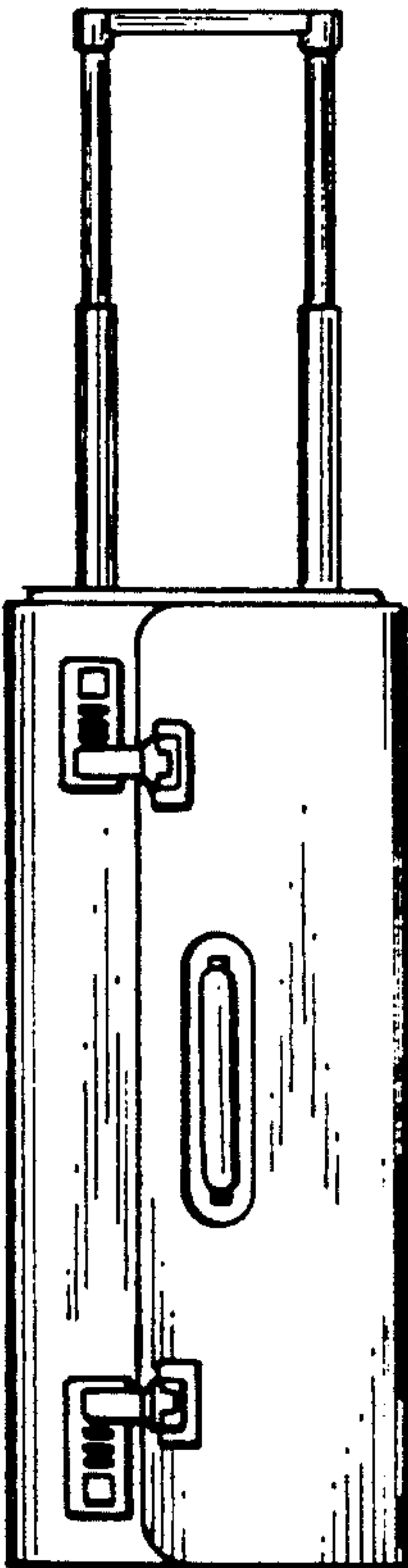

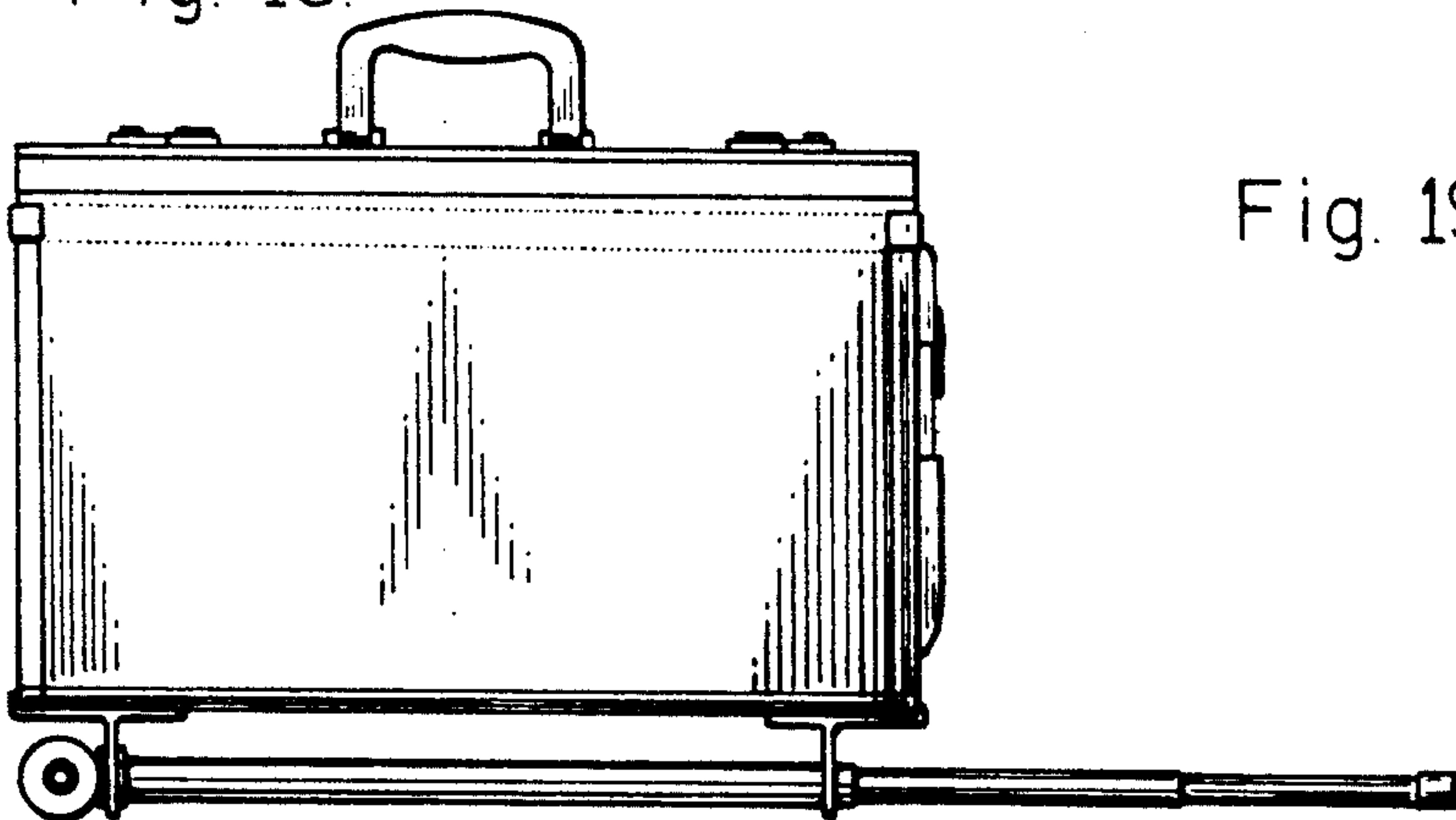

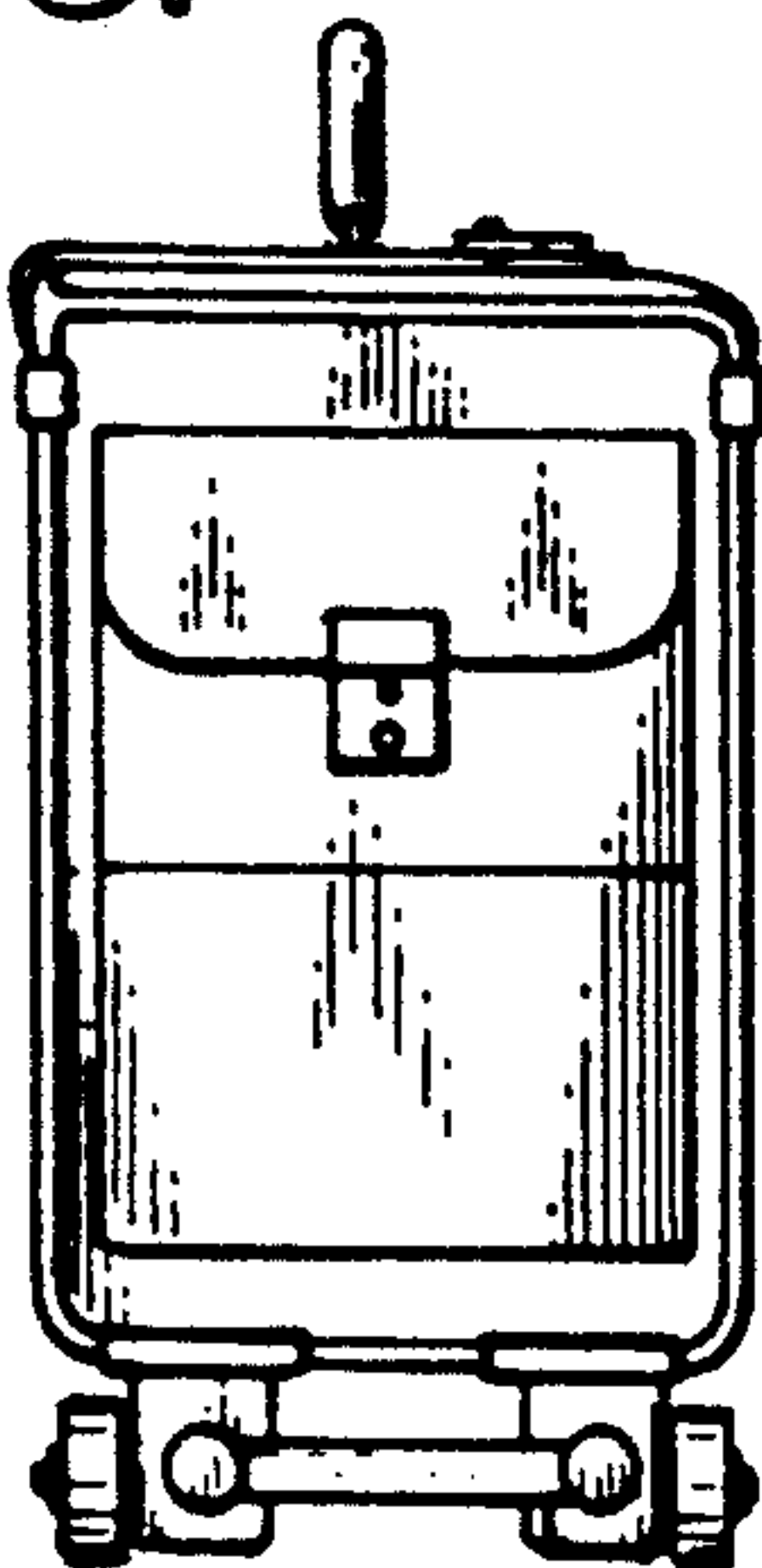
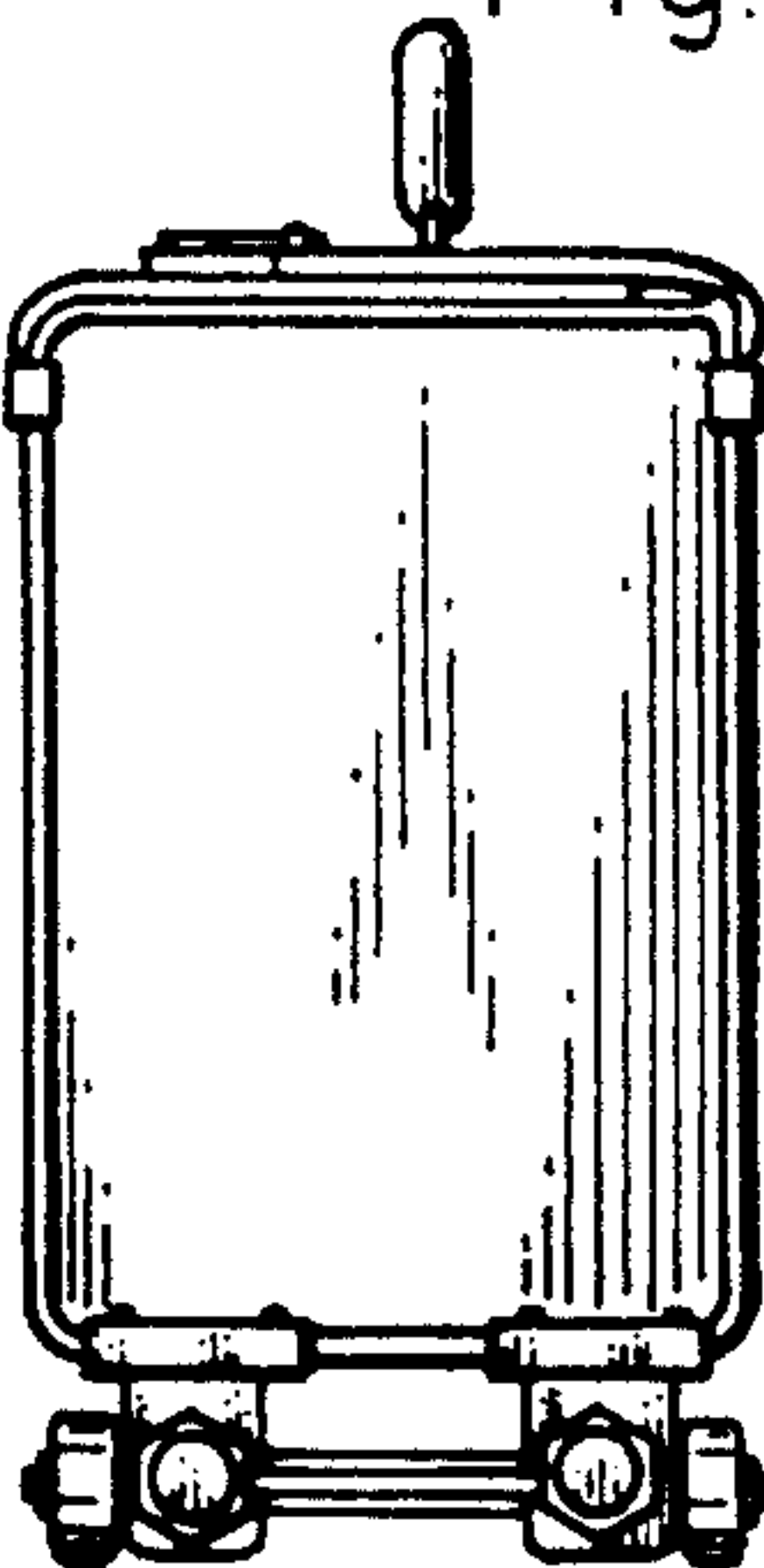
