DESCRIPTION

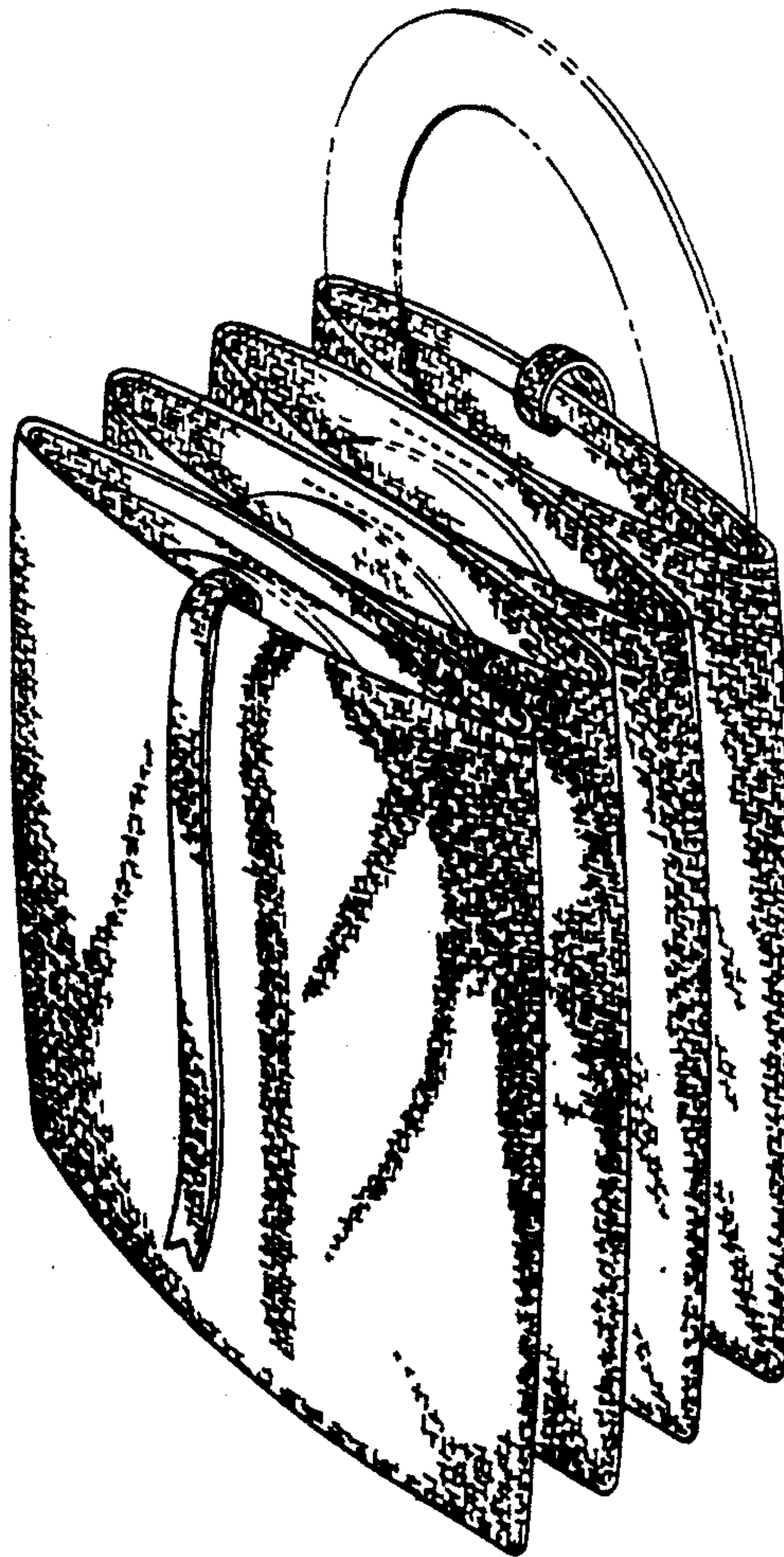
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a storage container for china plates showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side is a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end is a mirror image; and,

FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof, the broken line showing of the plate is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



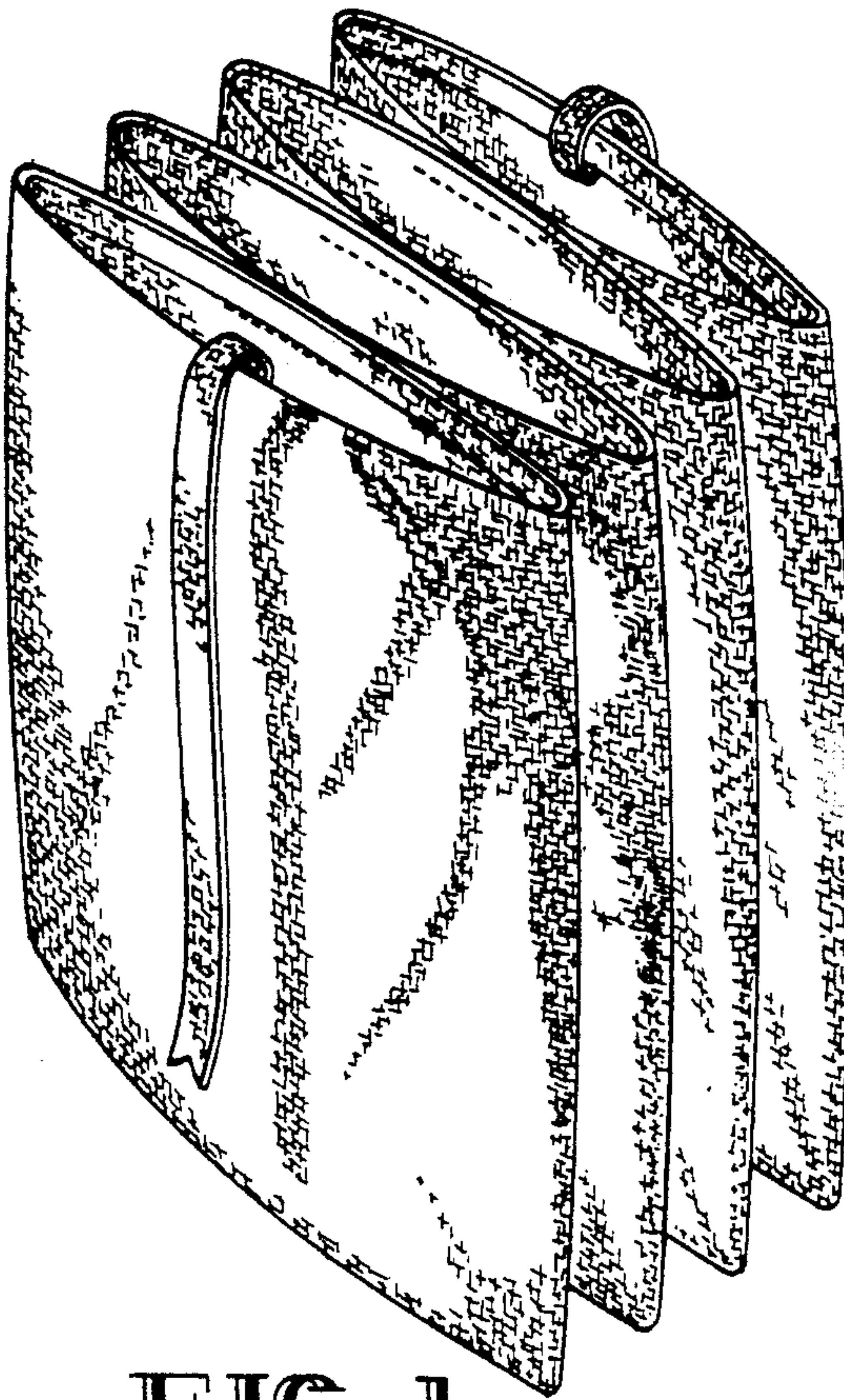

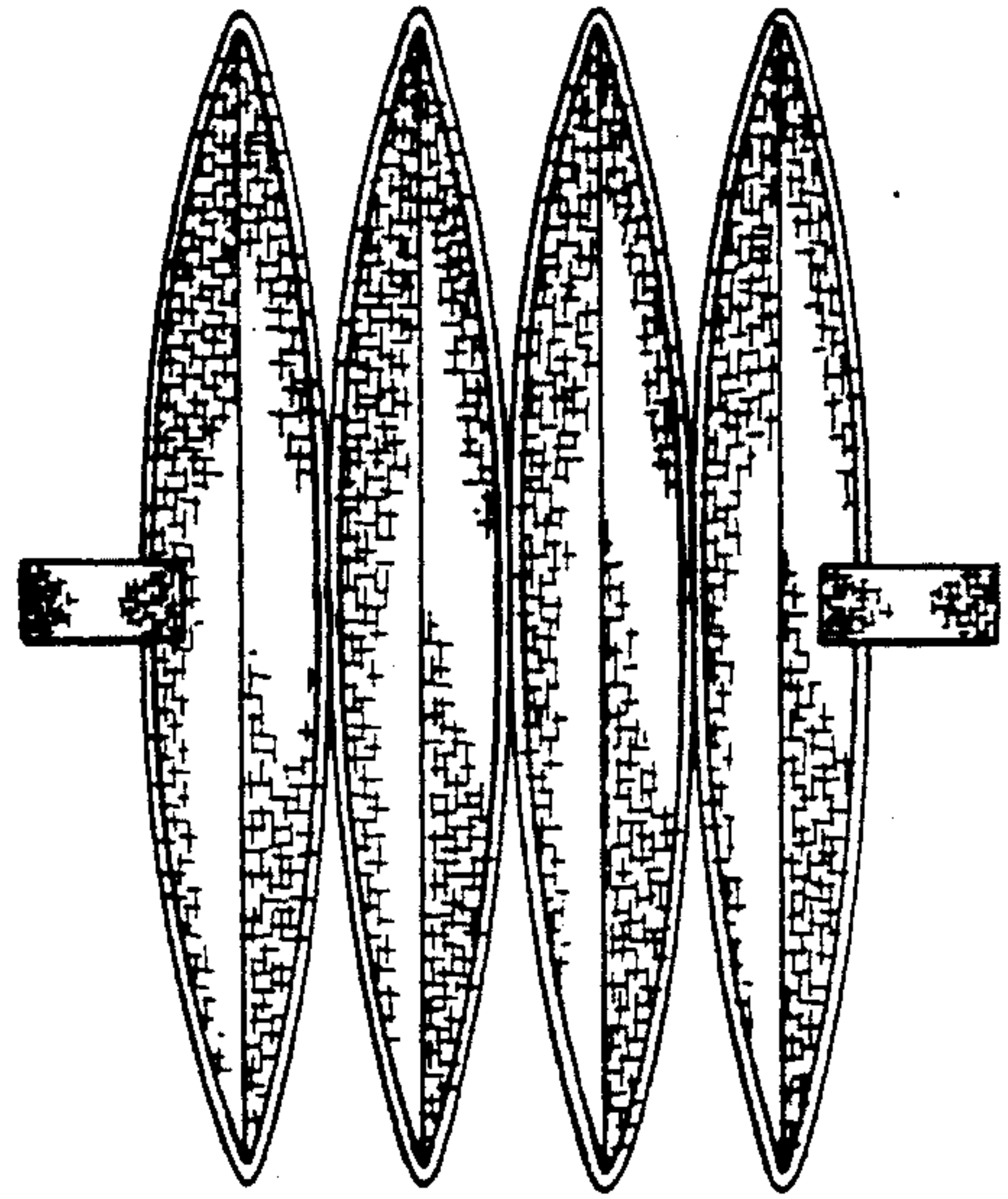

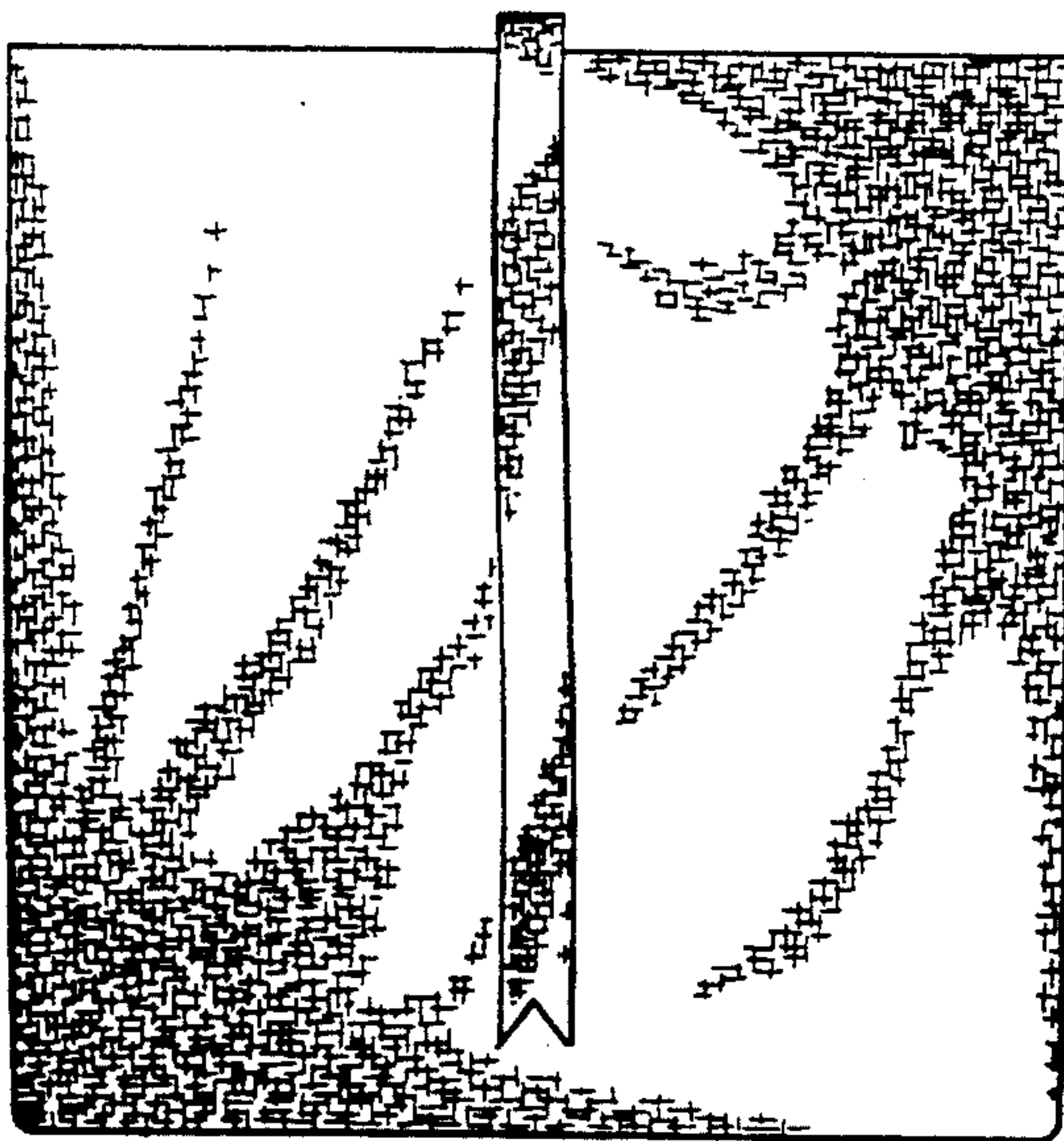

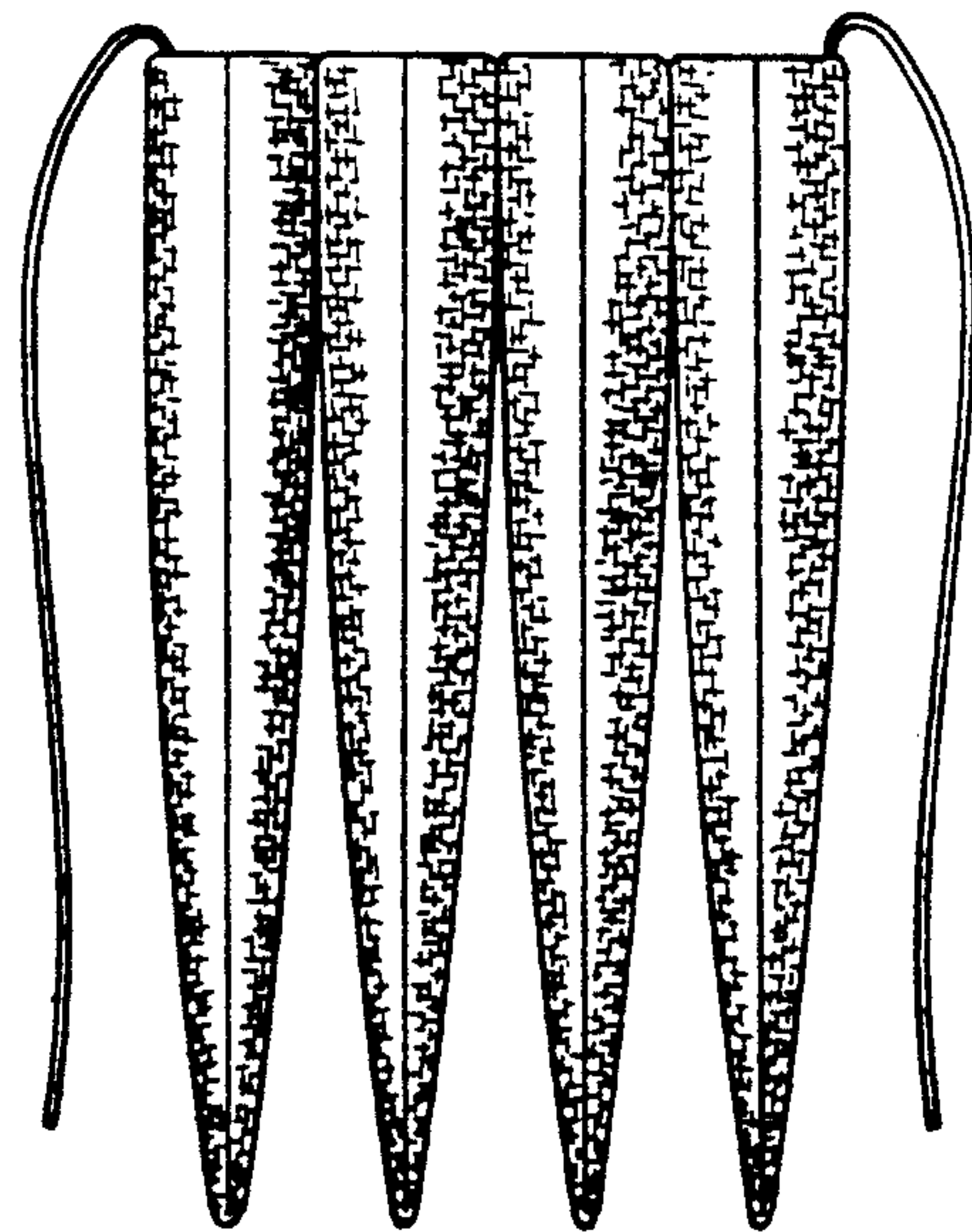

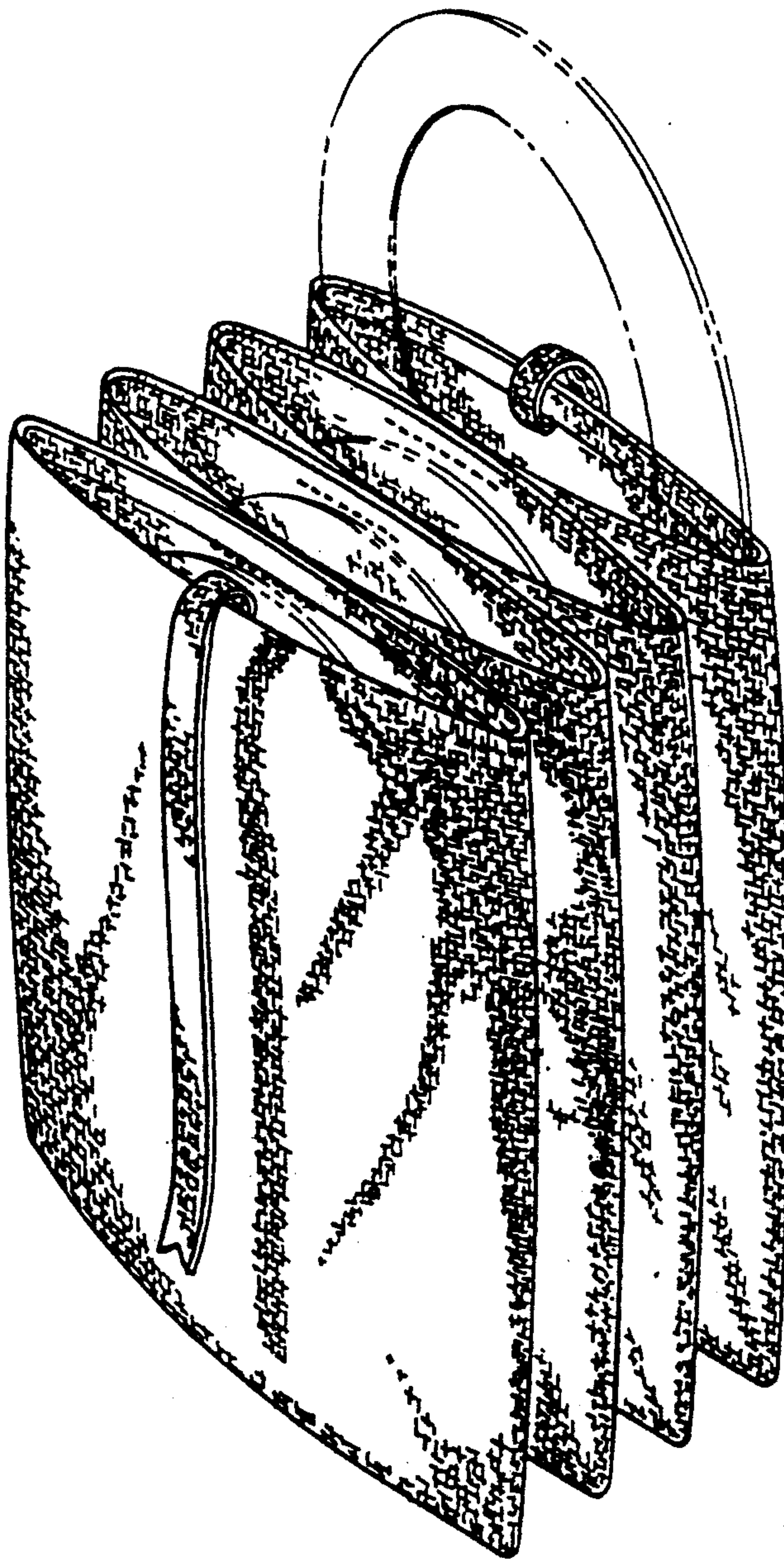
