[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an infant mobile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an infant mobile showing our new design, the toys shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1, the toys shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only, the difference residing in the removal of the attaching clips;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the support arm, shown separately for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view of the cross-piece, shown separately for clarity of illustration;

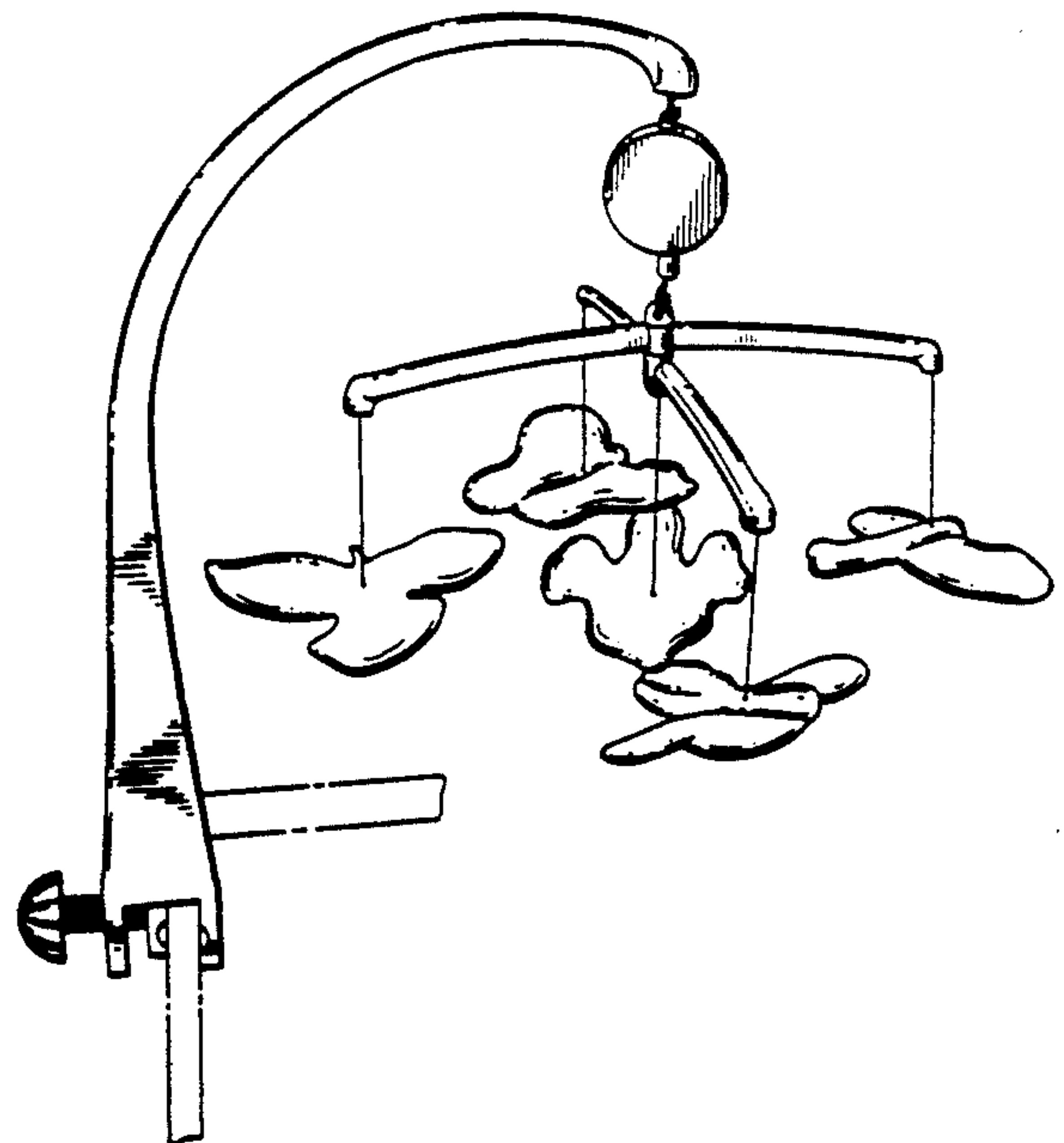
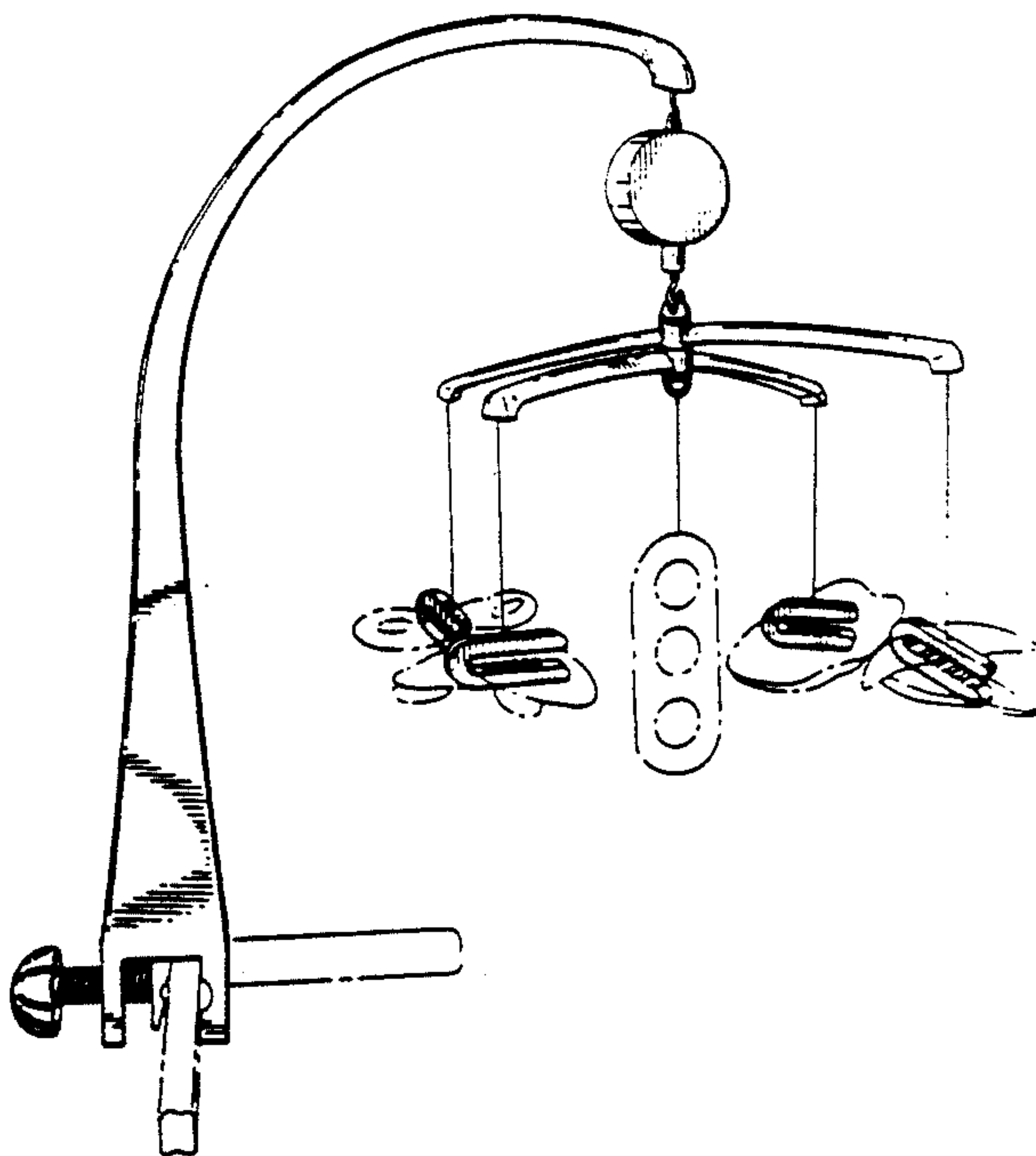
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of a clip, shown separately and partially broken way for clarity of illustration, the string shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 5.



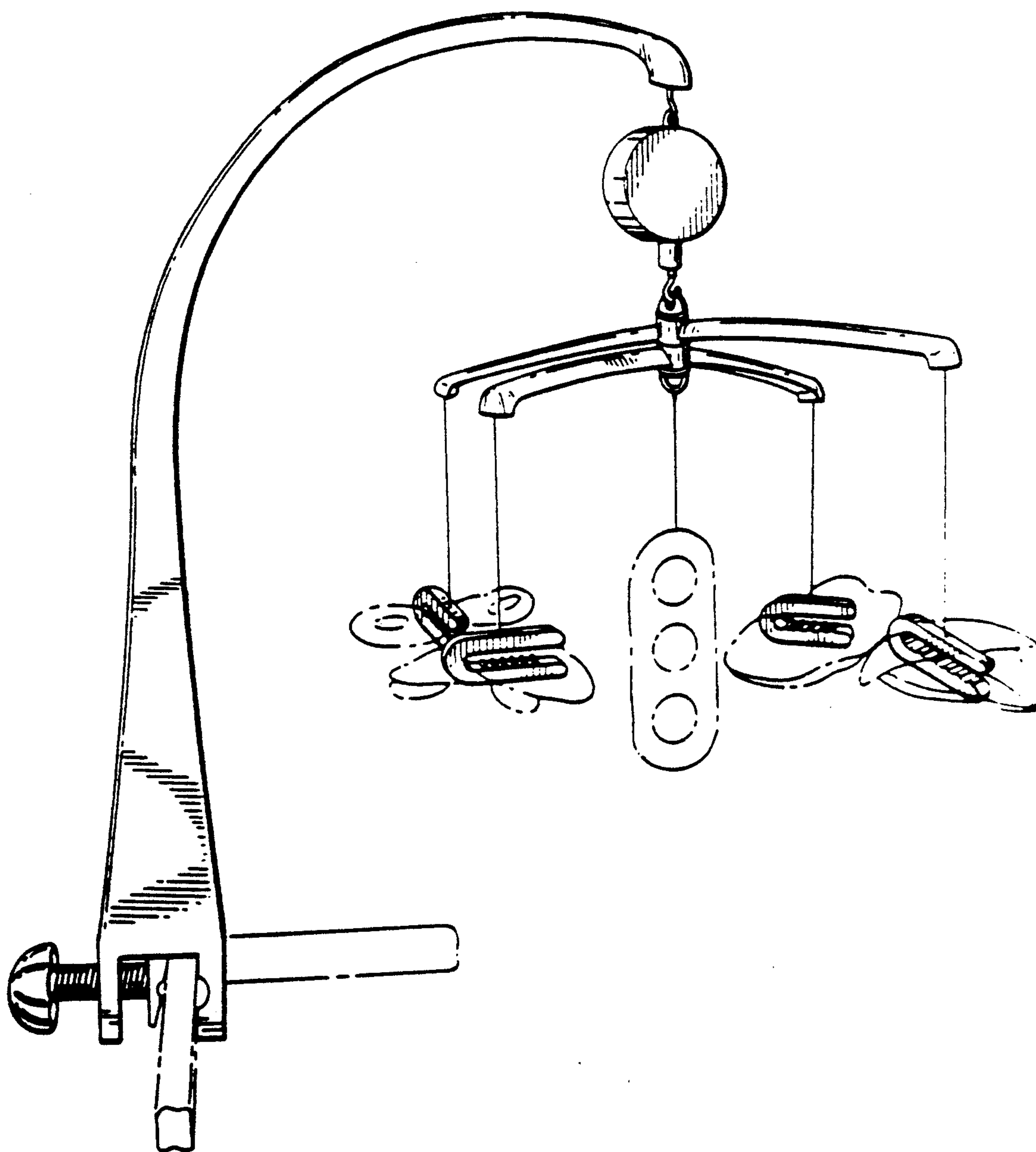

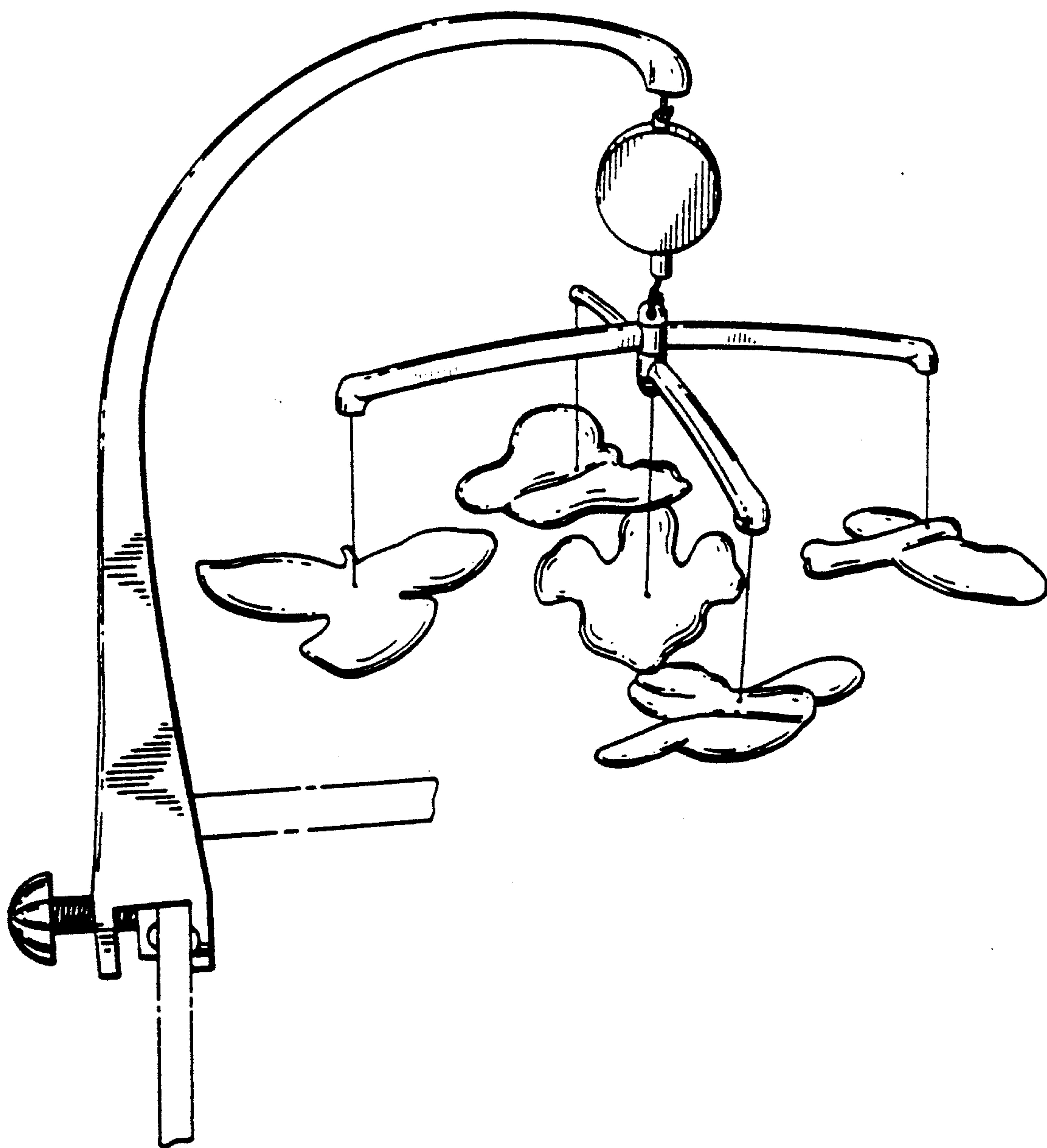

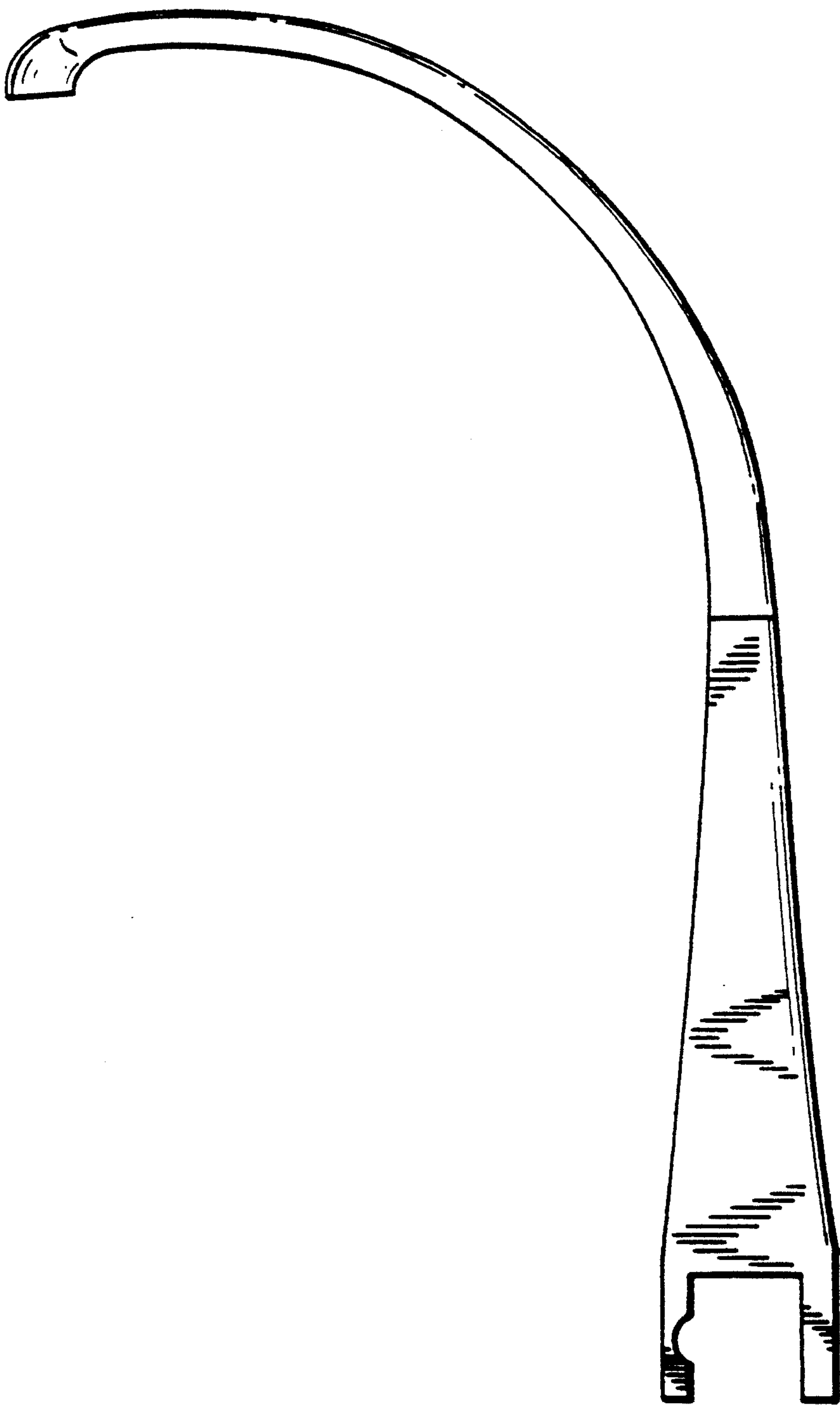

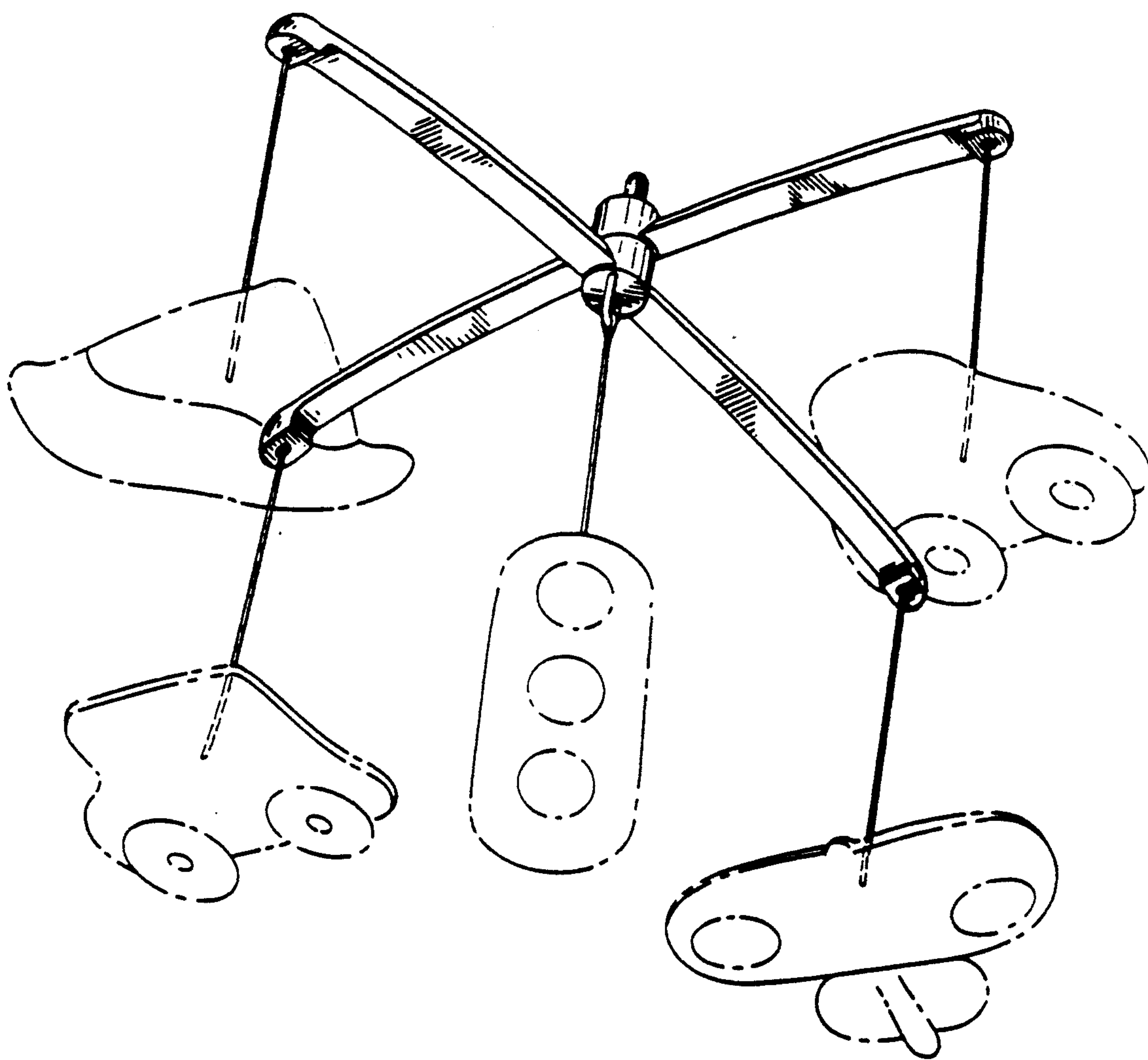

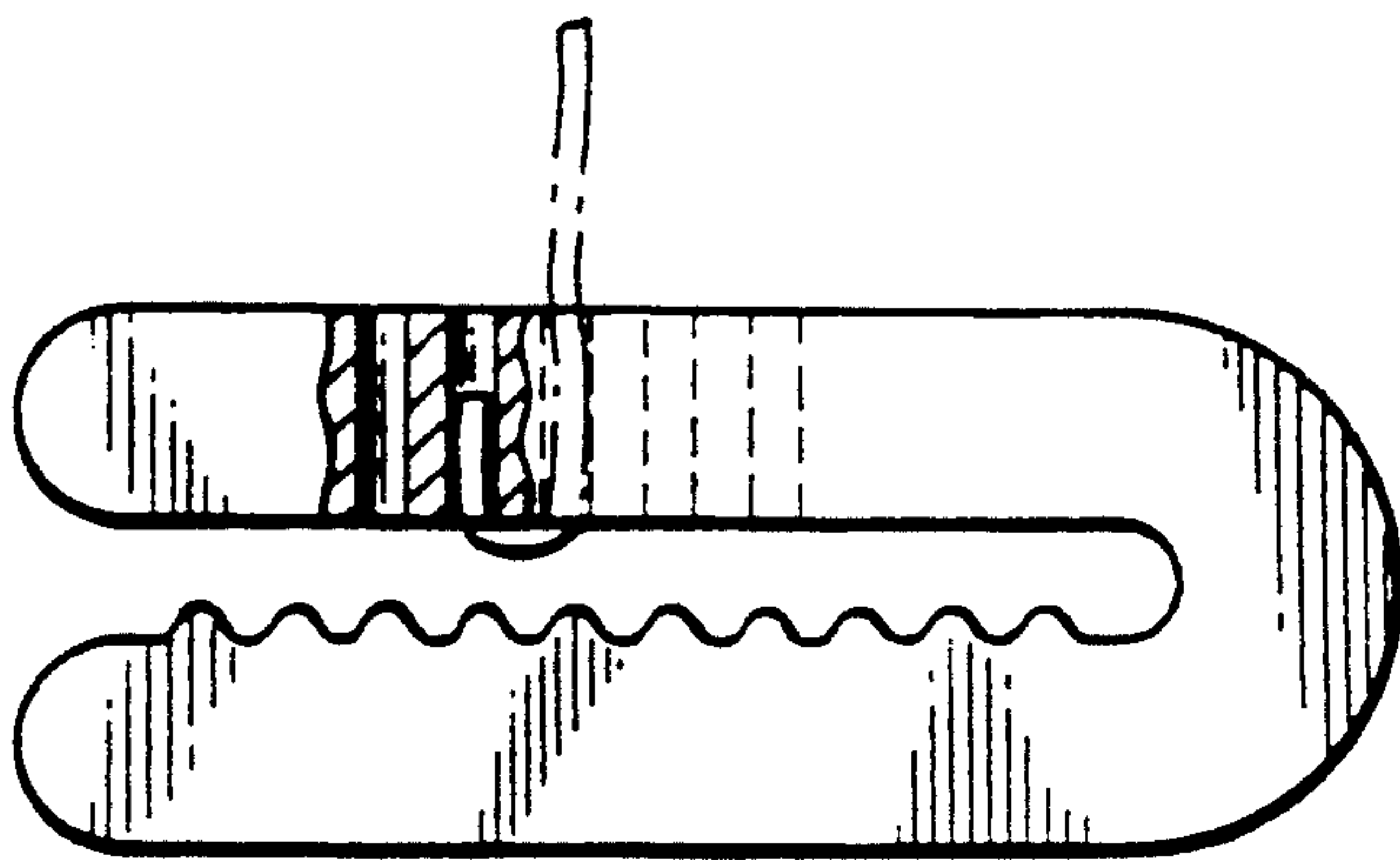
