FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a storage bin showing our new design;

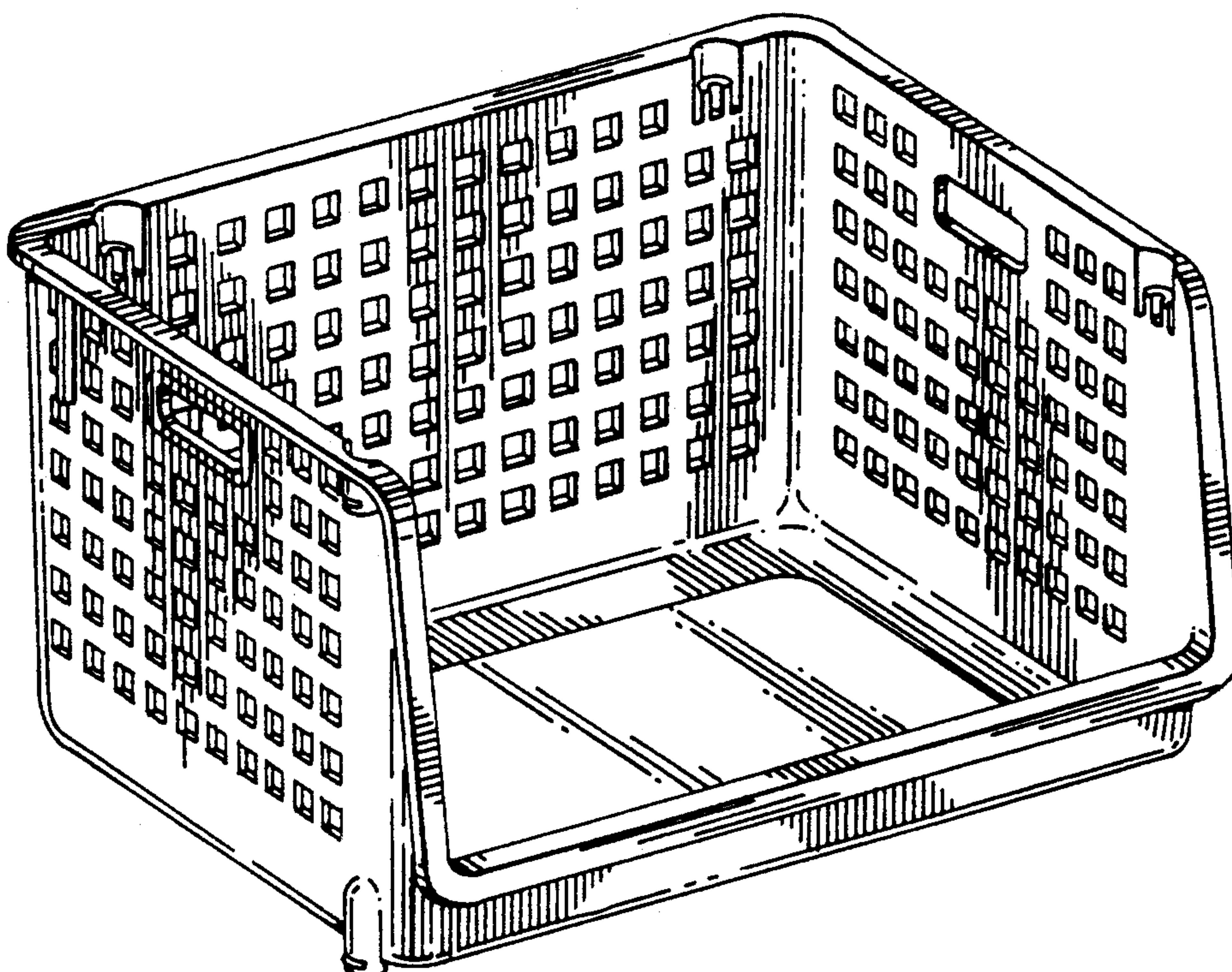
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof showing the side opposite to that which is shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



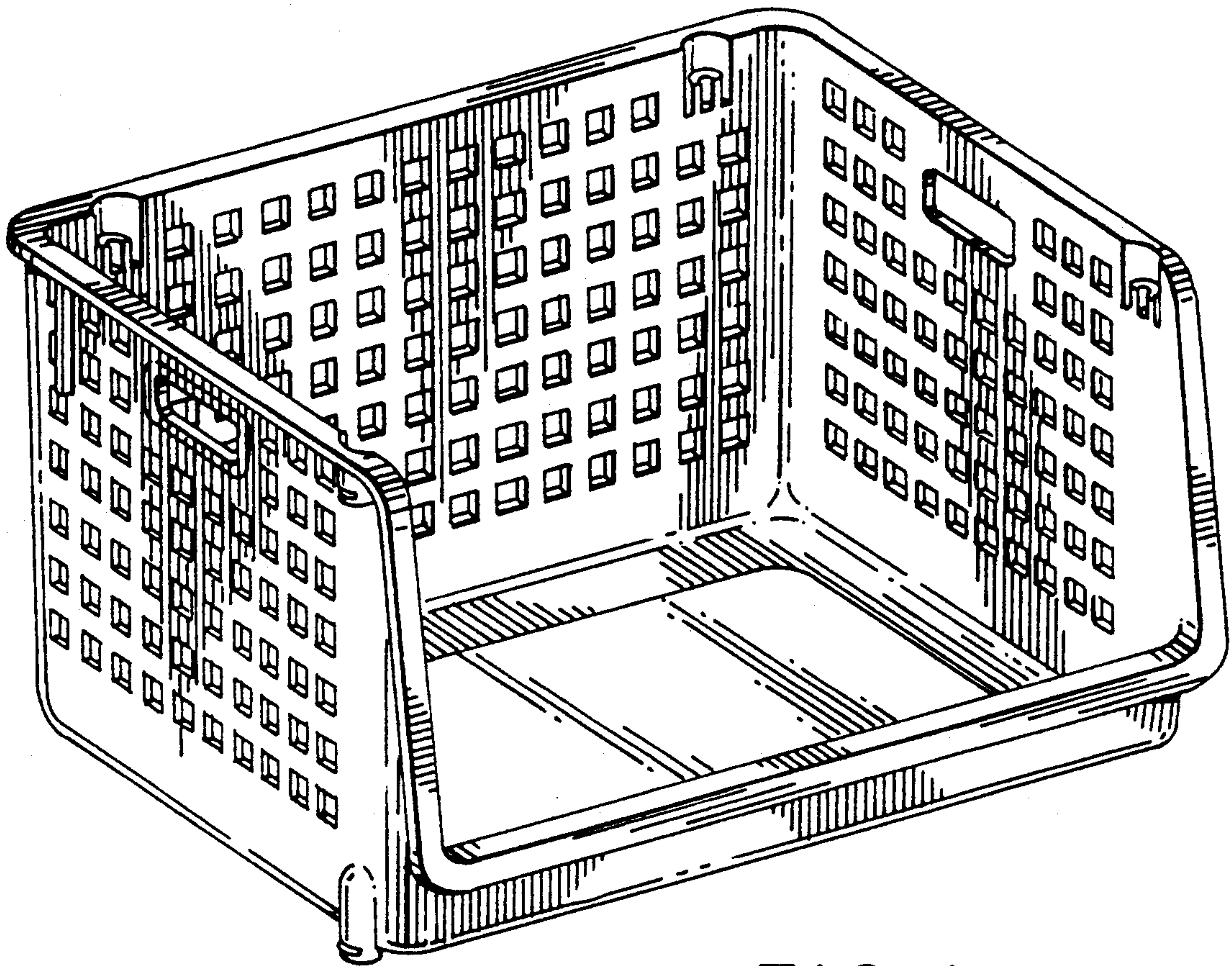

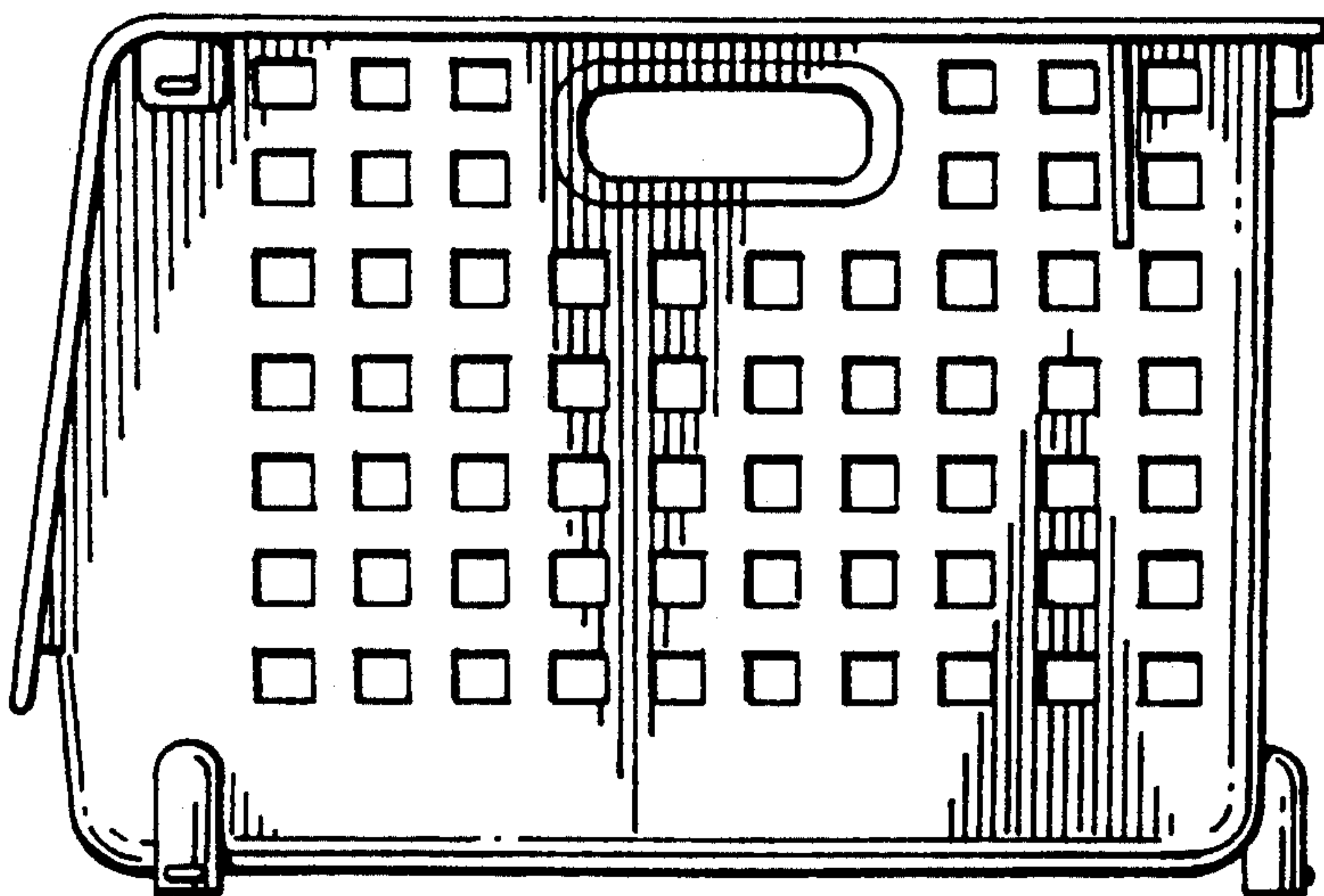

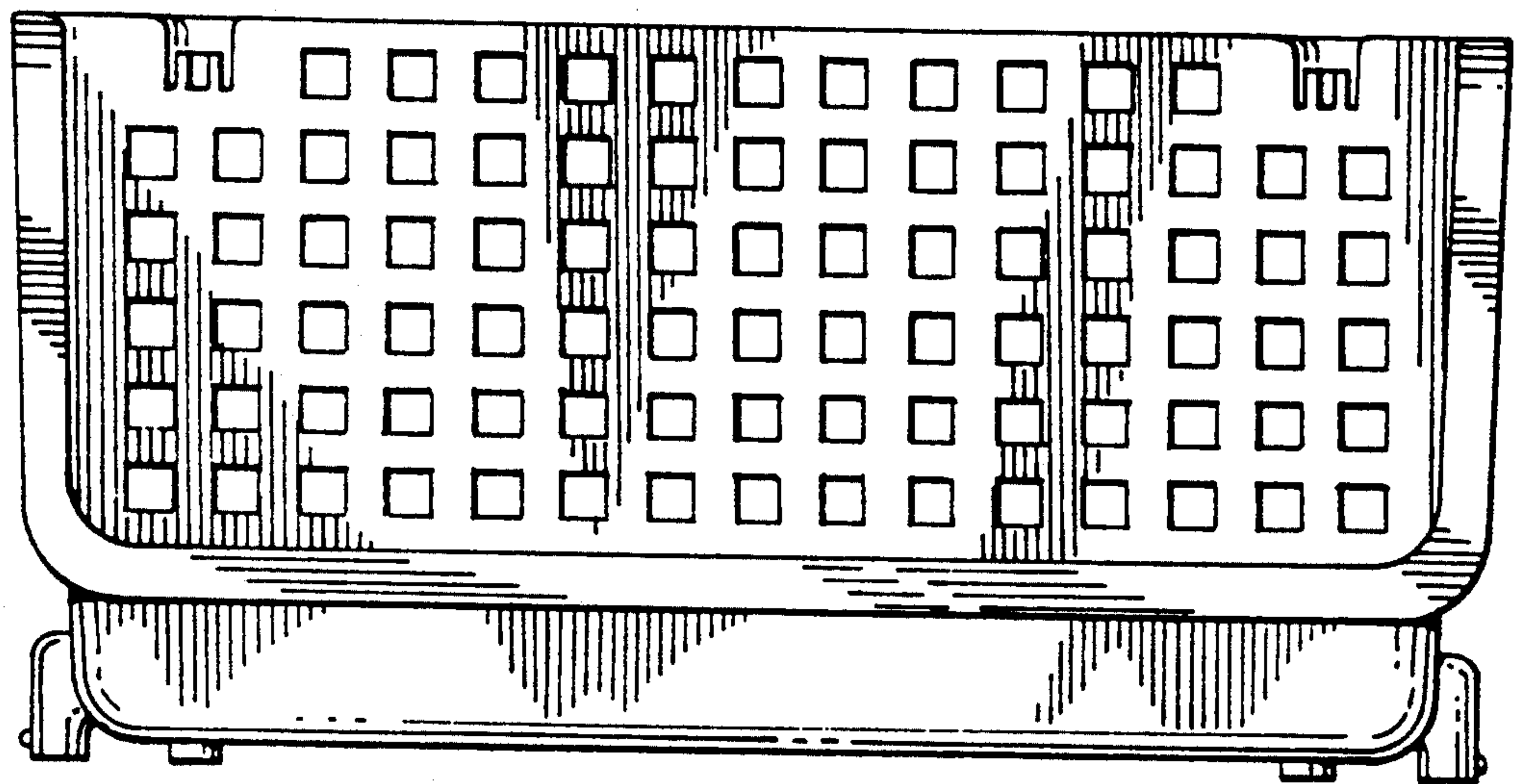

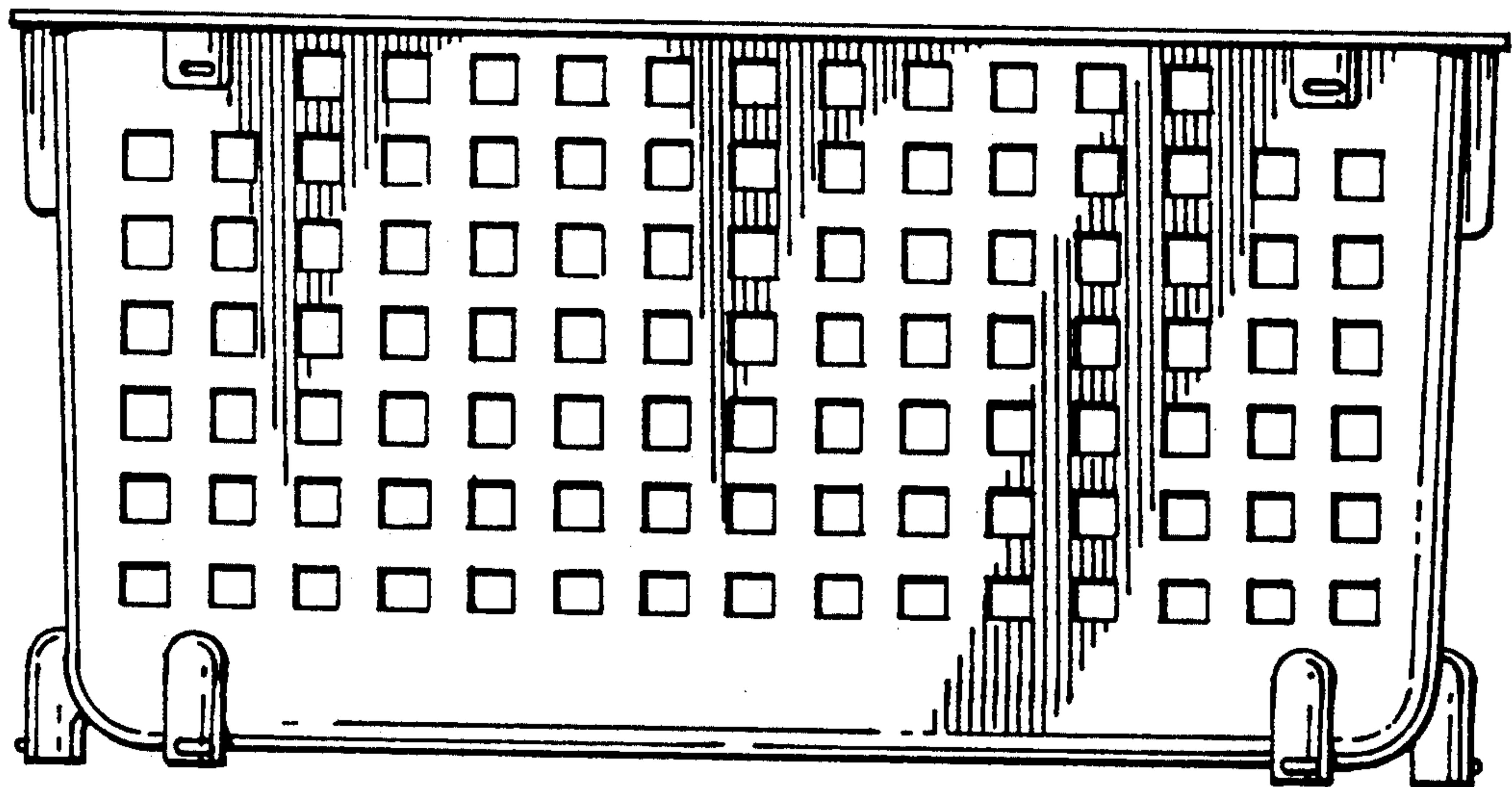

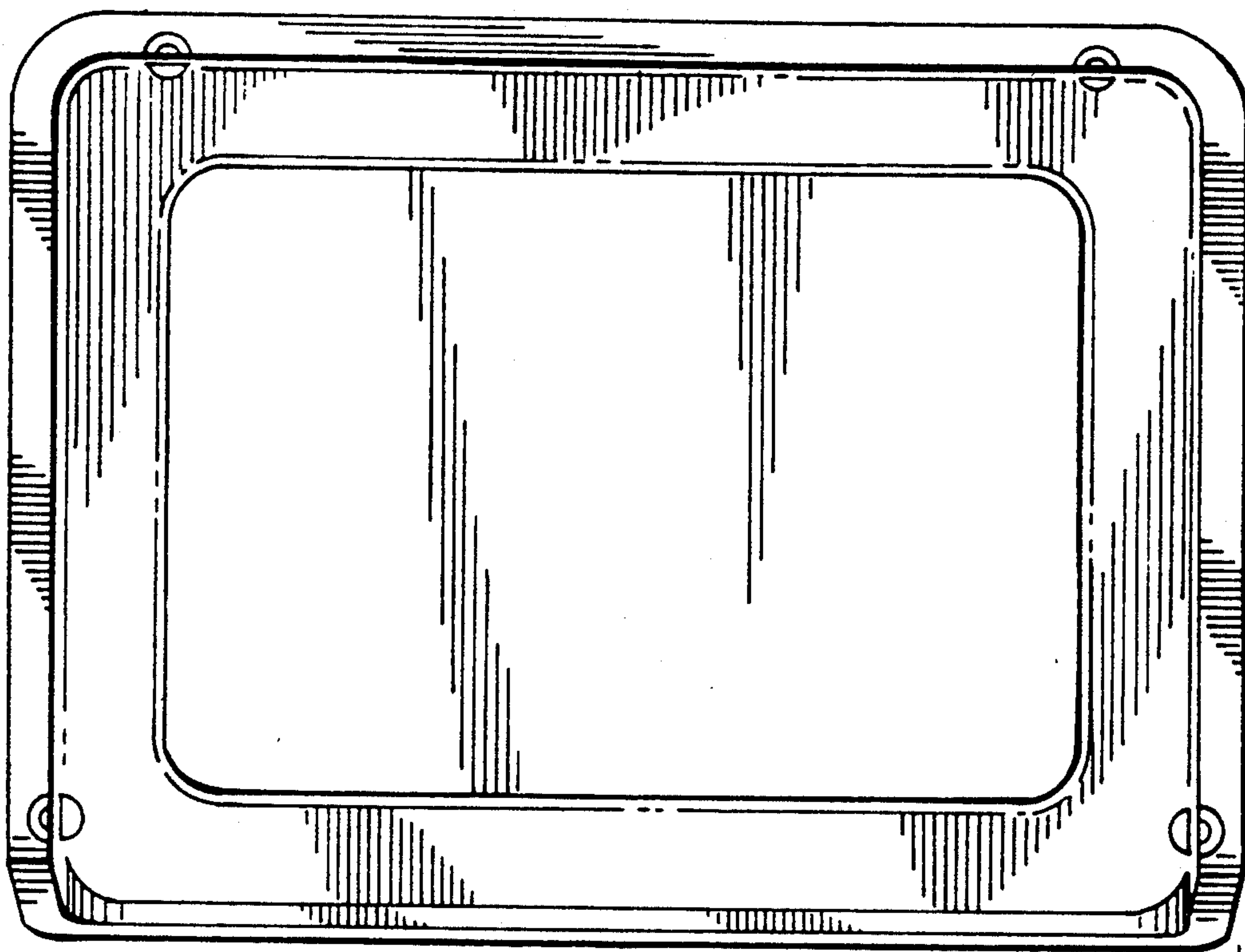

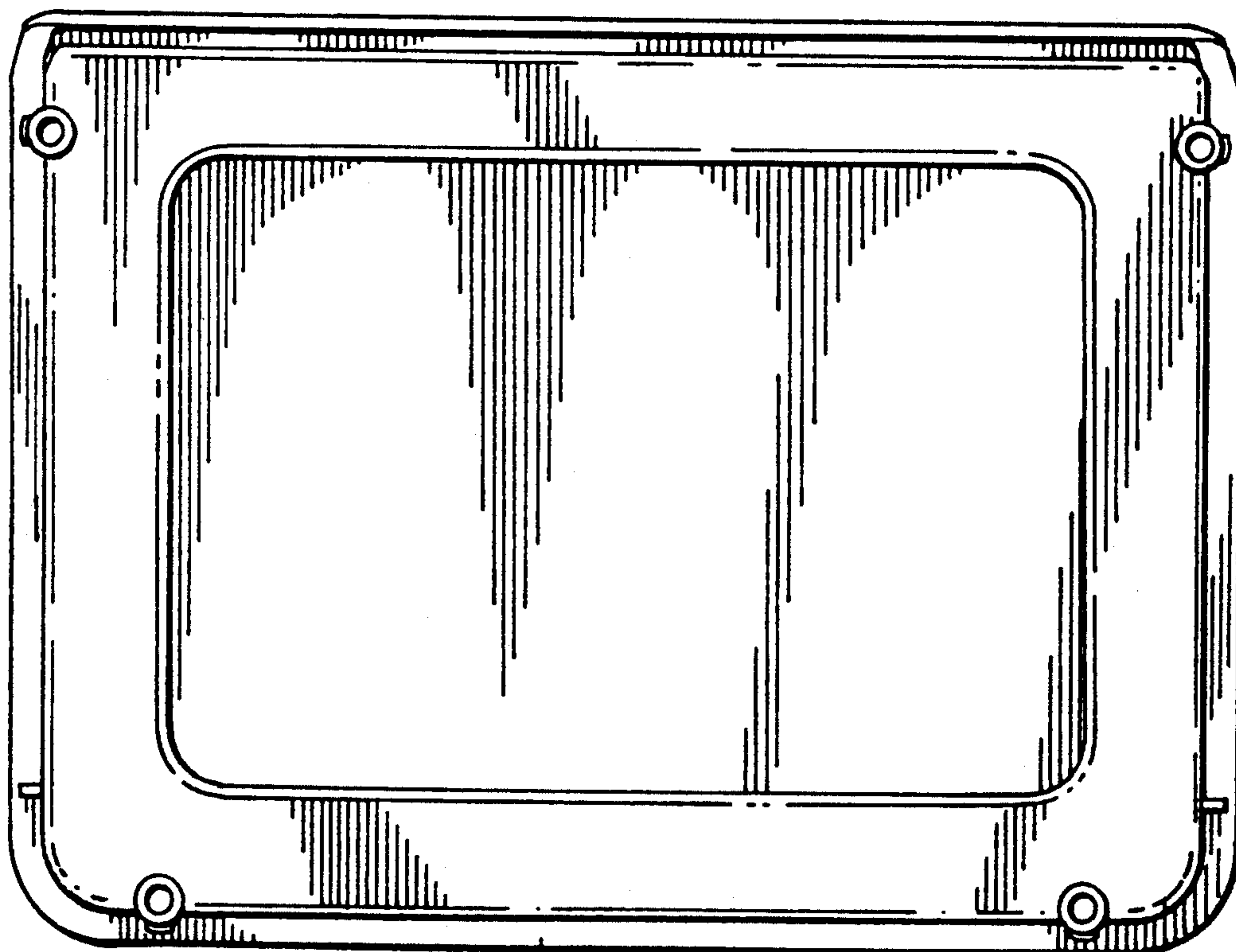
