strap for a sandal showing our new design;

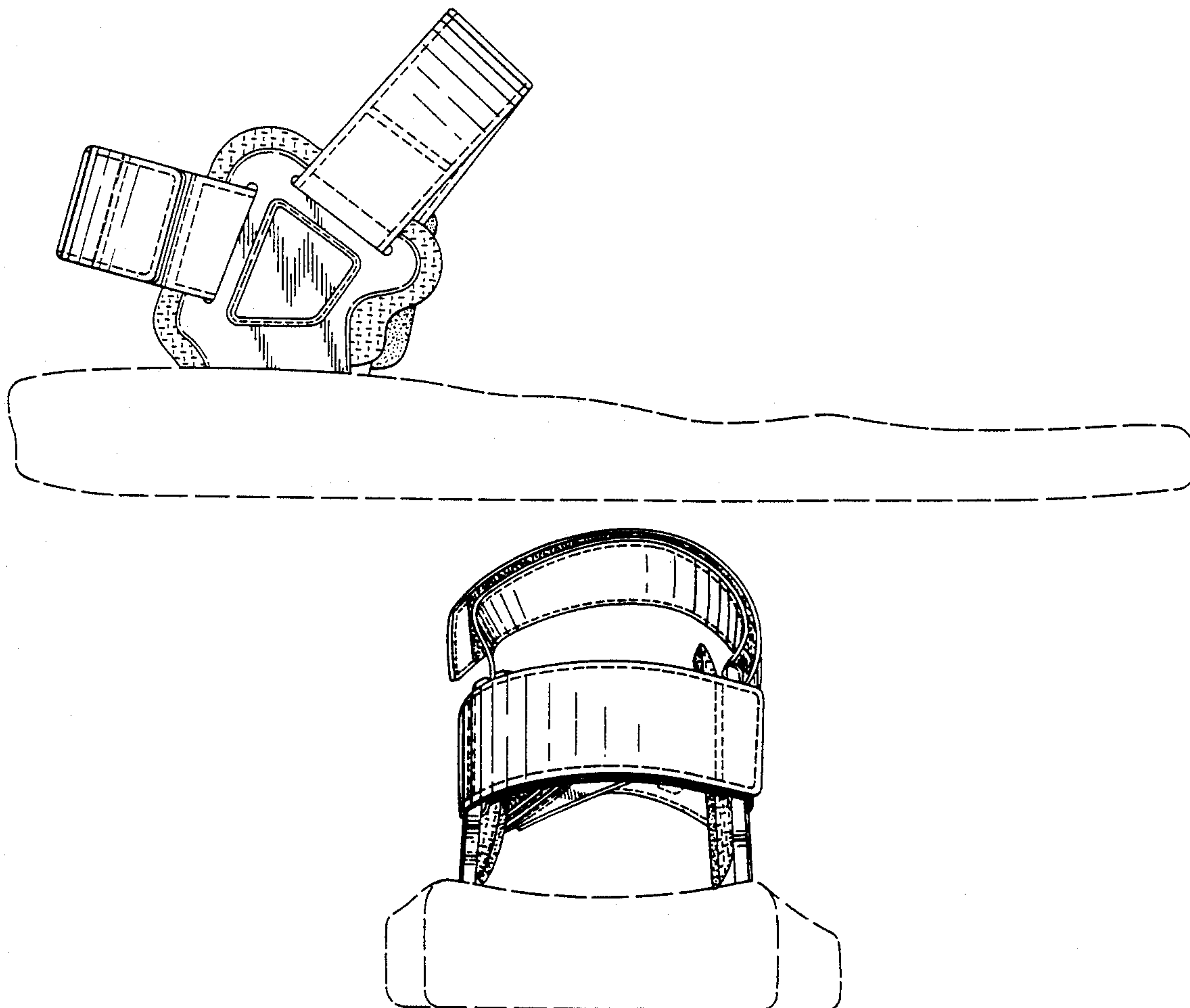
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the
back strap shown in FIG. 1;

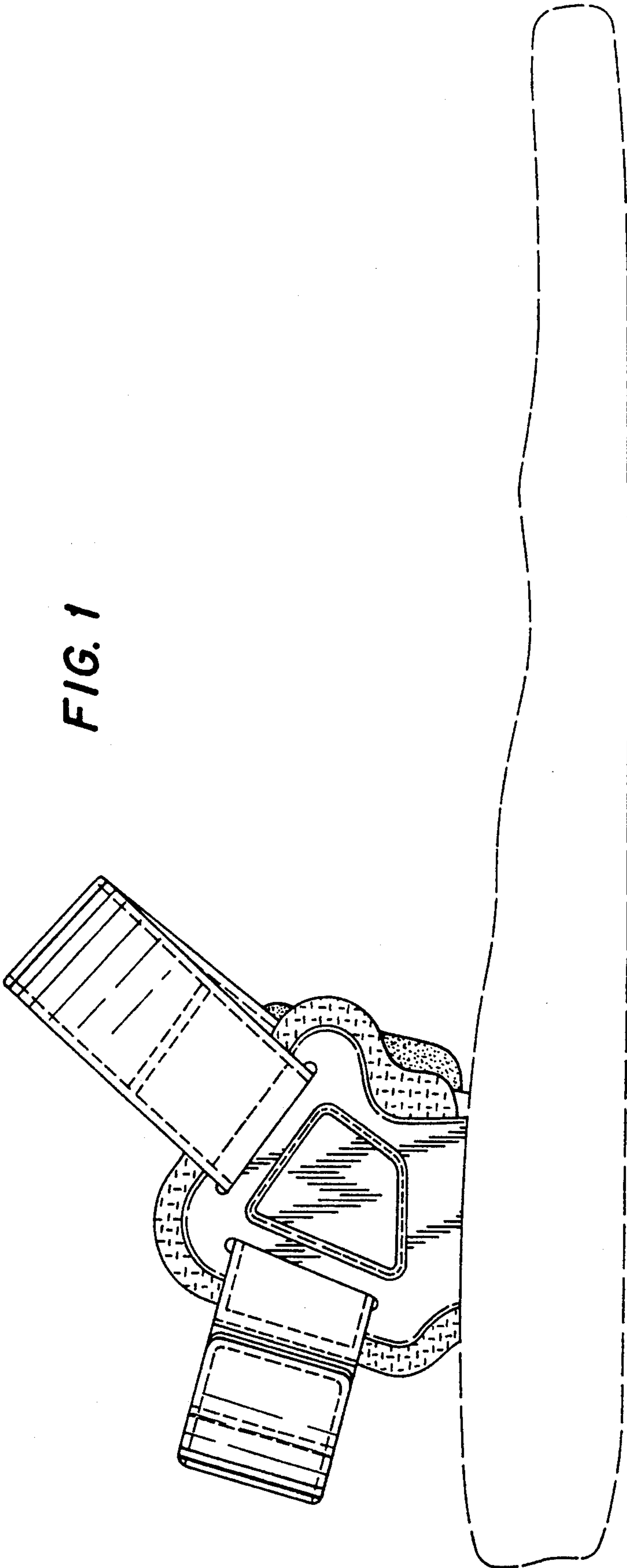
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the back strap shown in

trative purposes and from no part of the claimed design.





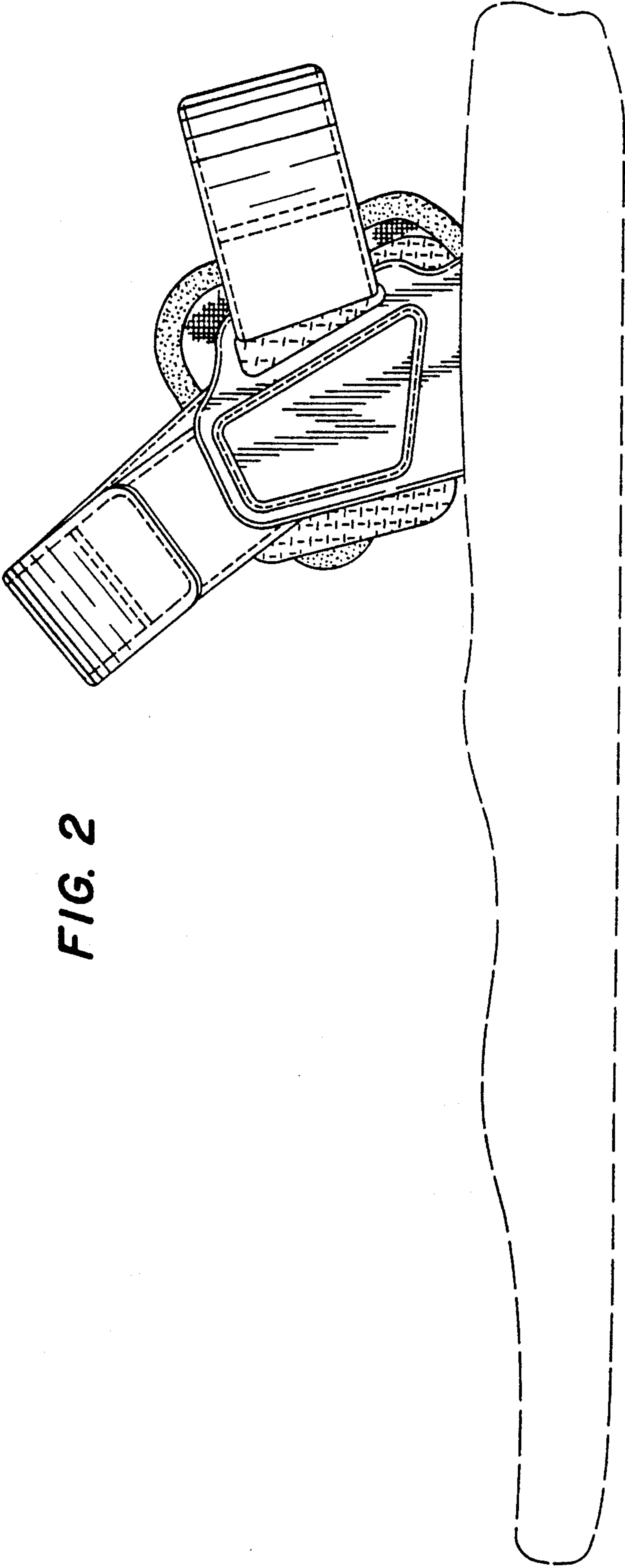

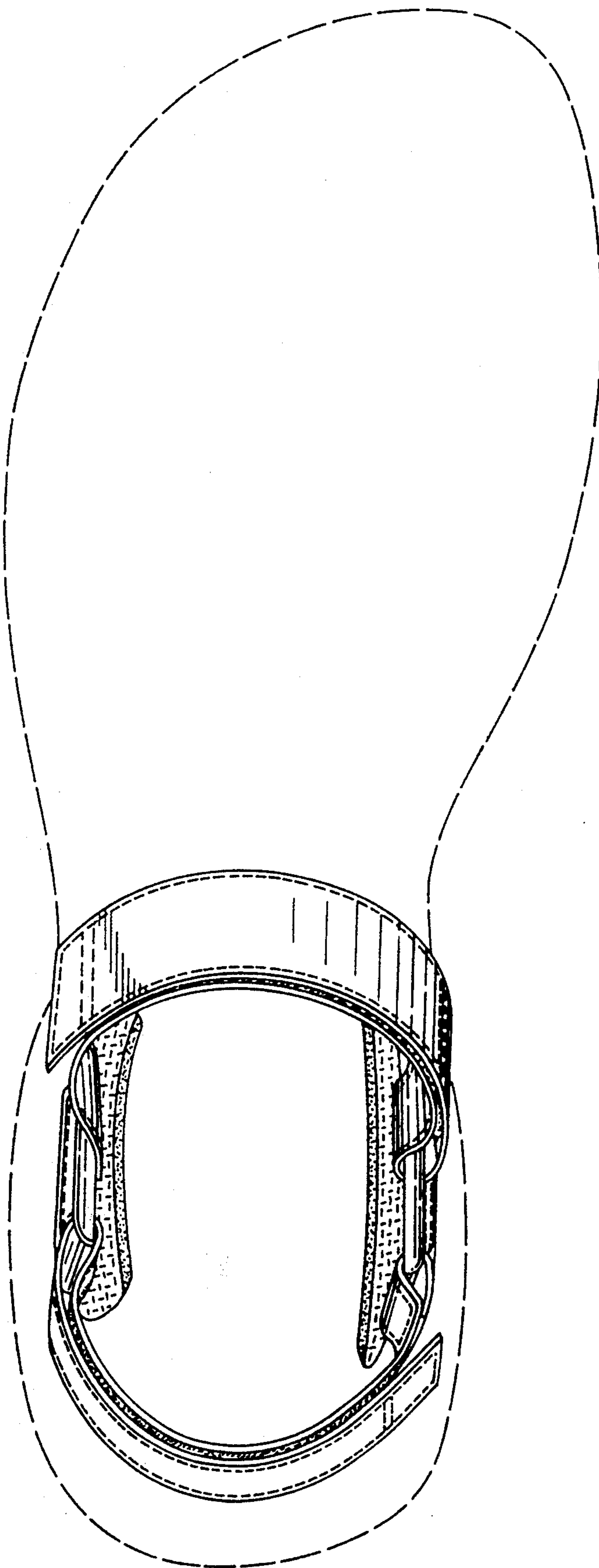

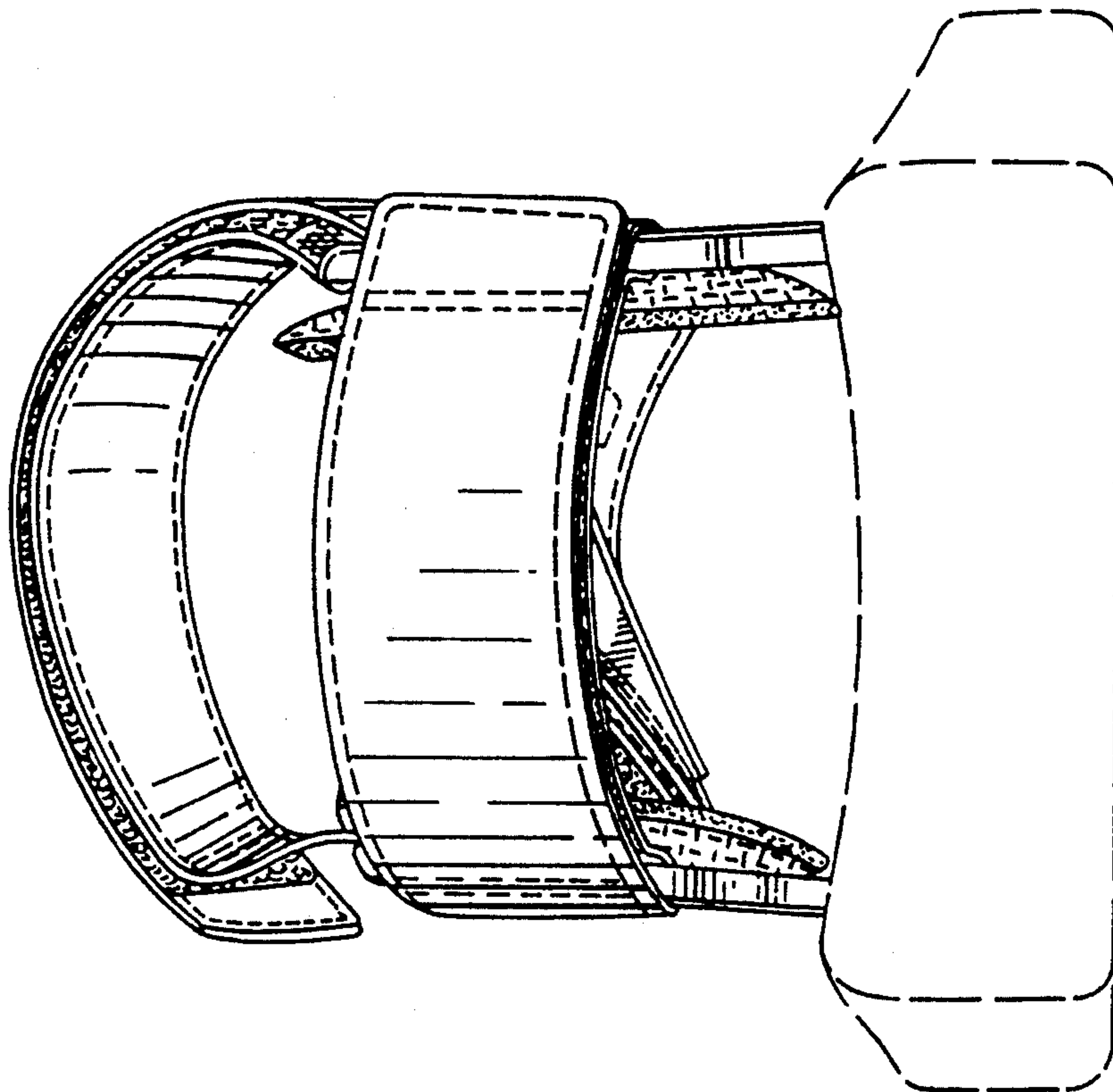
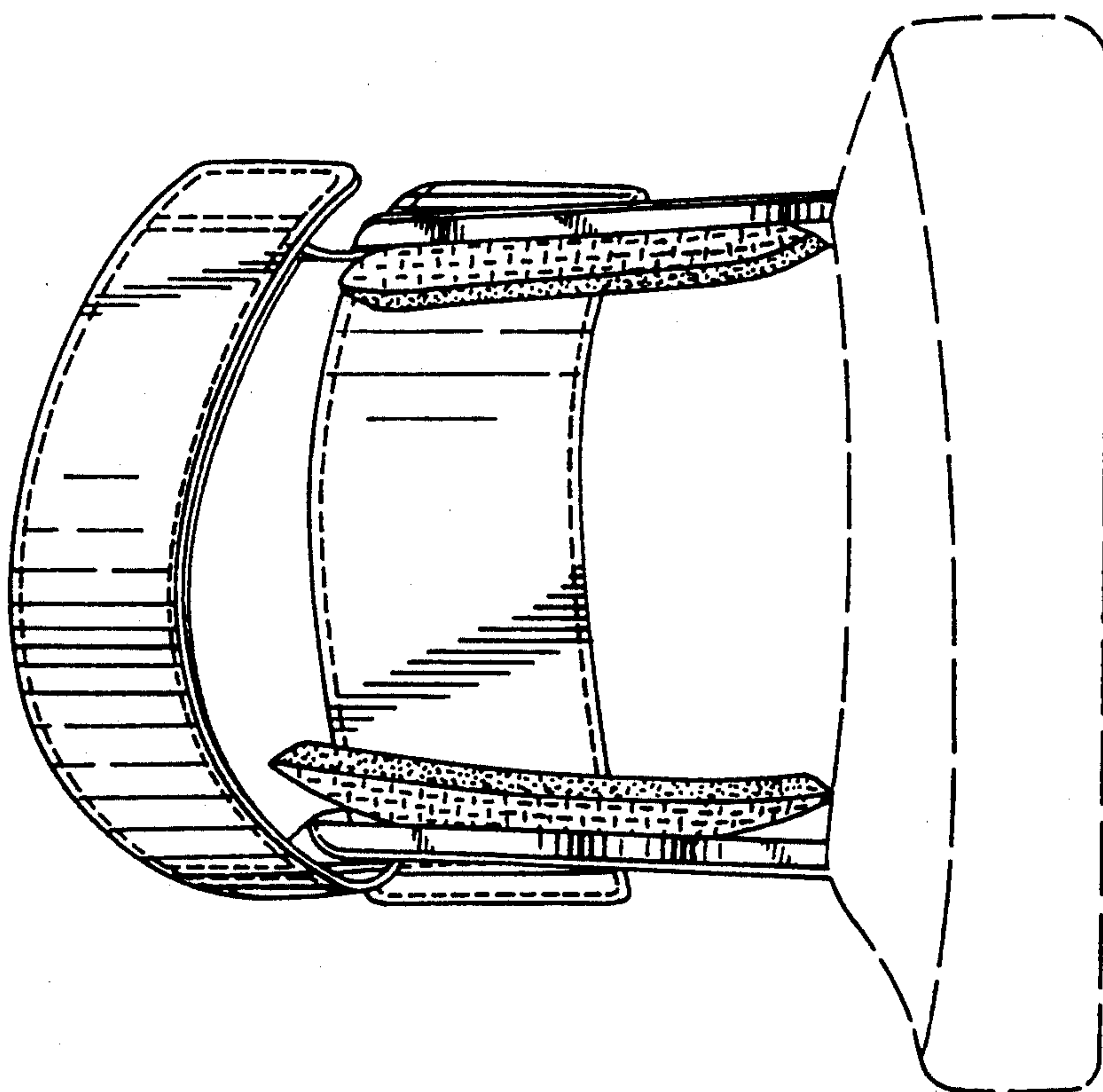
