[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a condiment dispenser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a condiment dispenser showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof; in which the condiment dispenser is shown in use with peppercorns contained therein, the peppercorns being shown for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;


FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof of FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof of FIG. 6;

FIG. 10 is a side elevational view thereof of FIG. 6 showing the condiment dispenser in use with salt crystals therein, the salt crystals being shown for illustrative purposes and forming no part of the claimed design.





















