[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined dimmer switches and cover plate, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined dimmer switches and cover plate showing our new design, the broken line showing of the switch housing being for illustrative purpose only;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

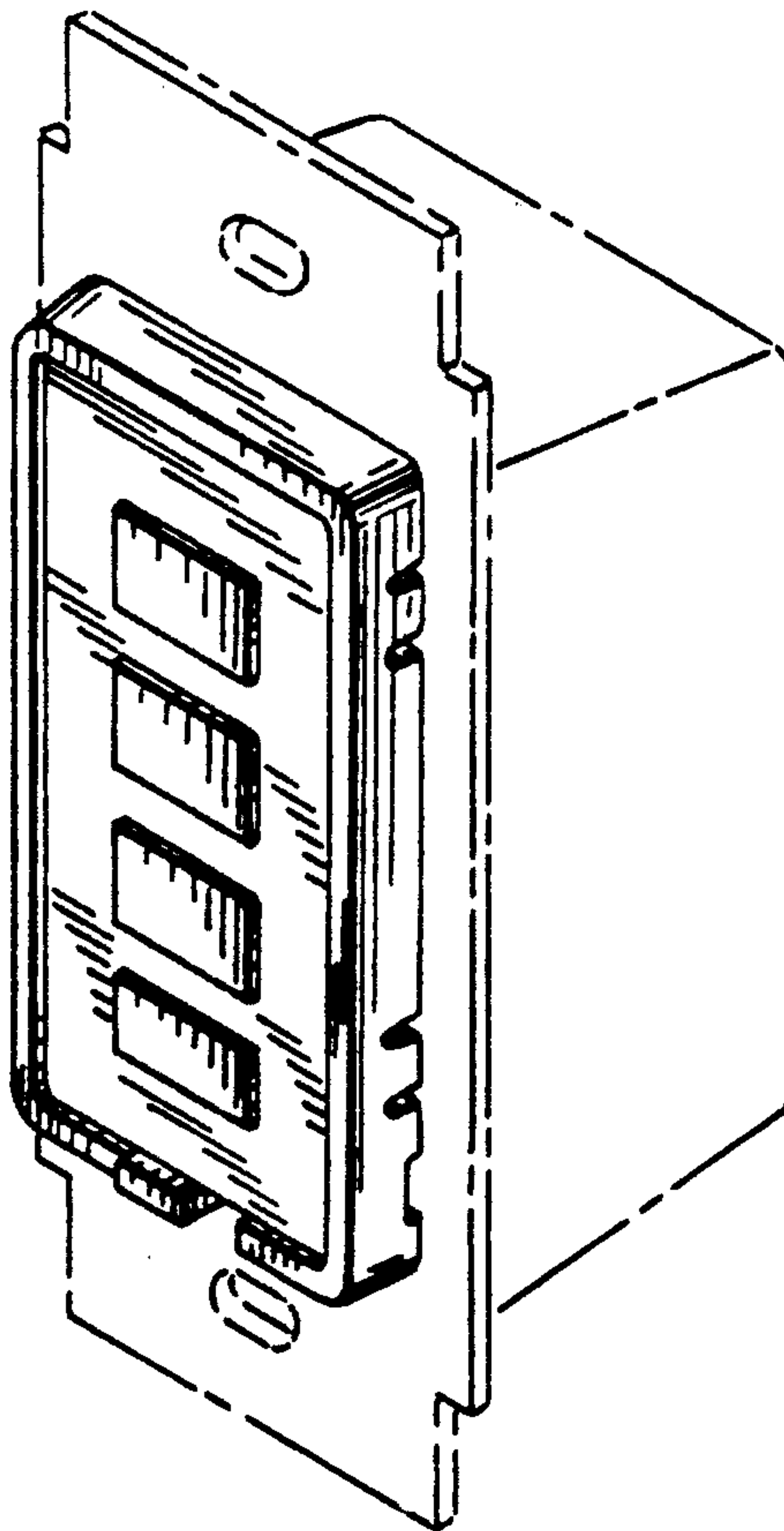

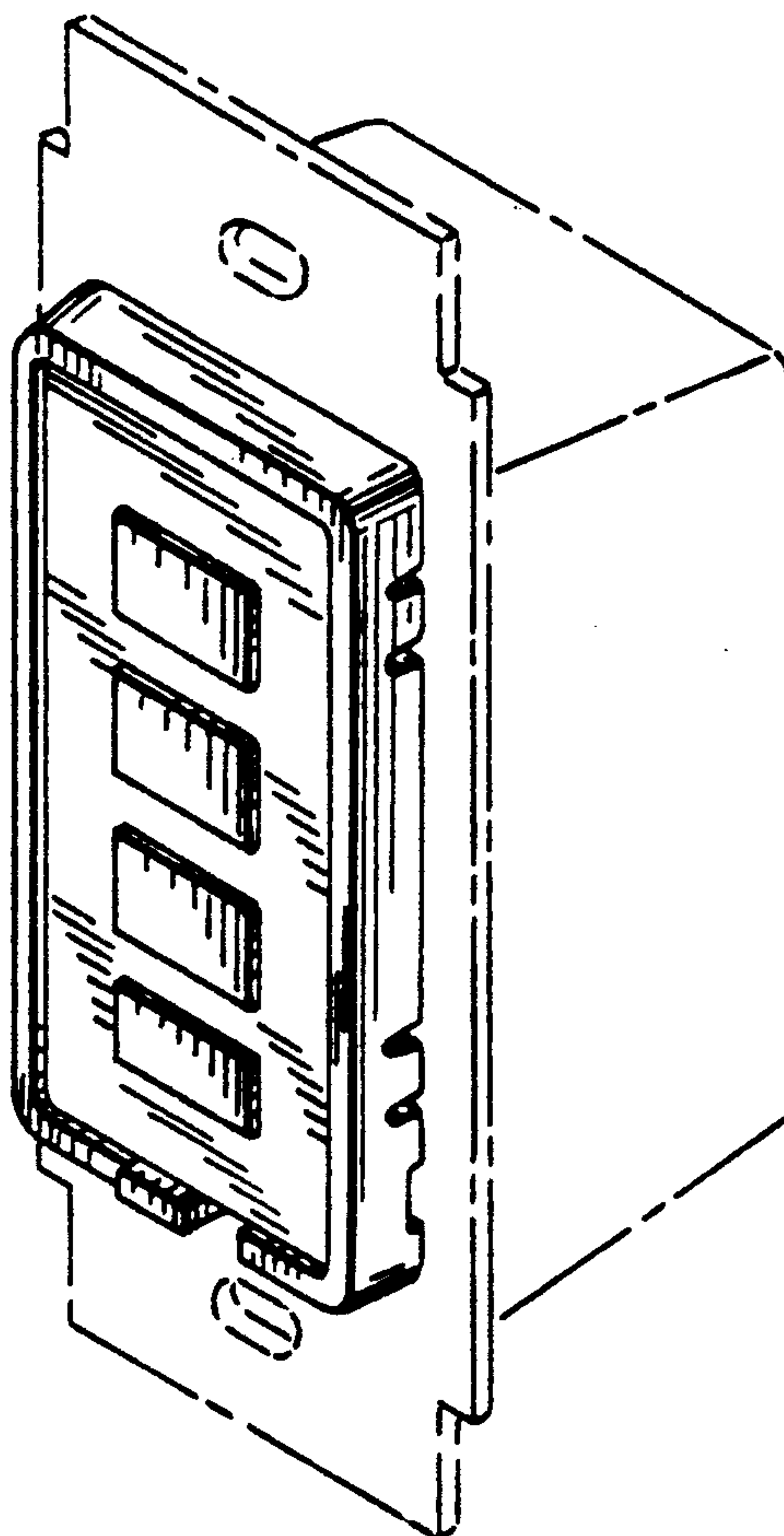

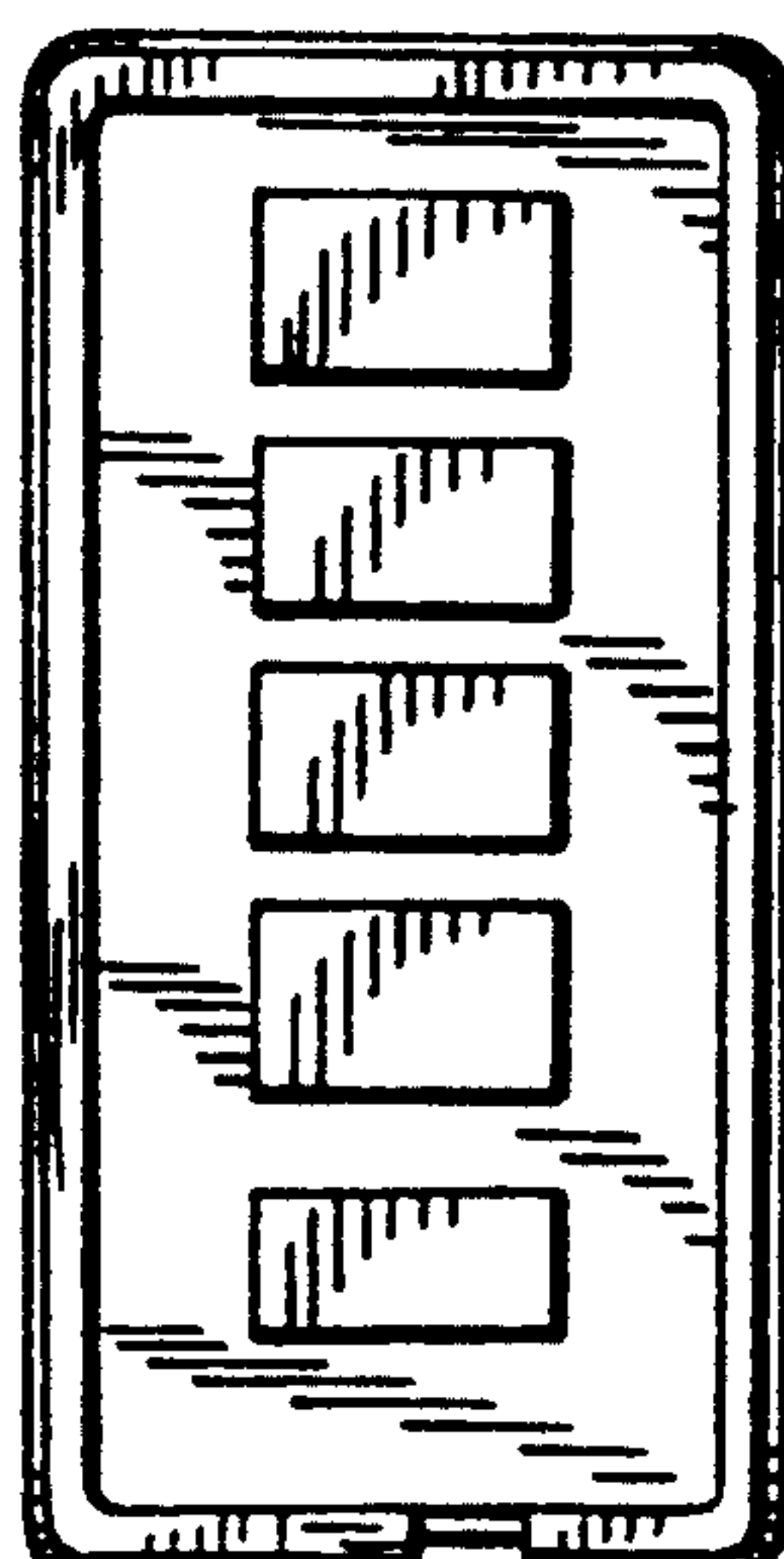

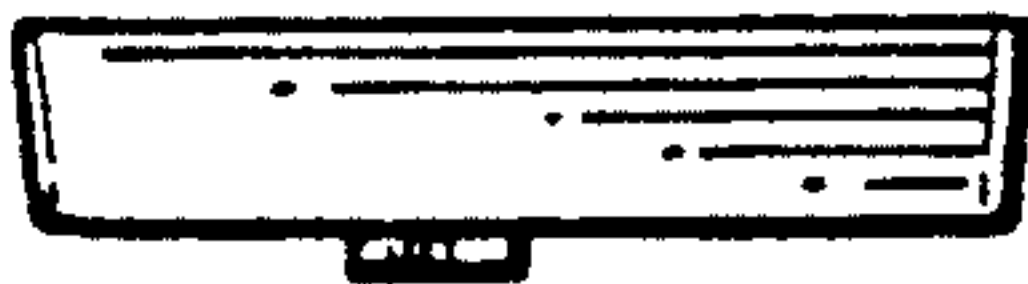

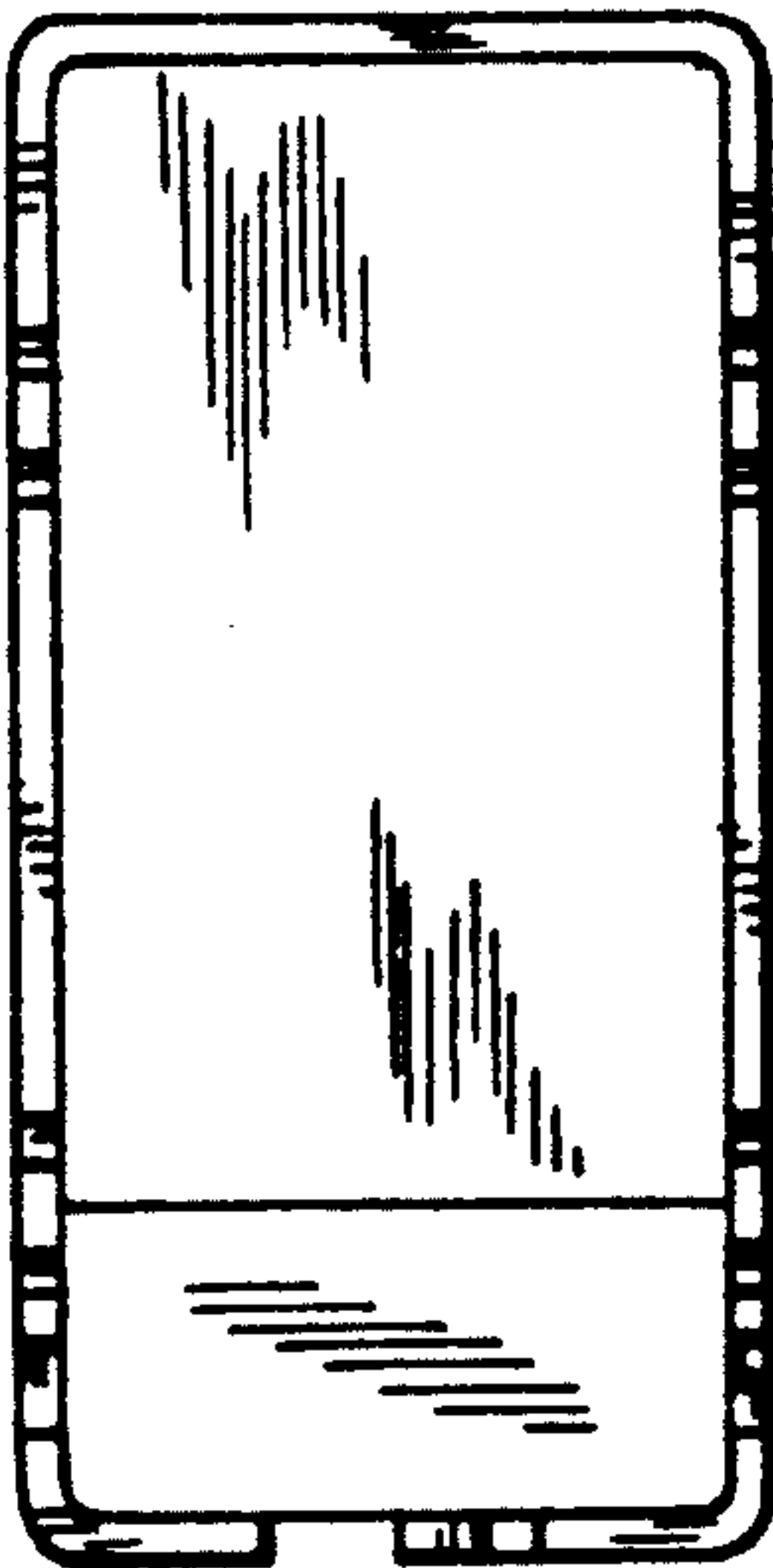
