## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 15 is a perspective view of a chair, showing a fourth embodiment of my new design.

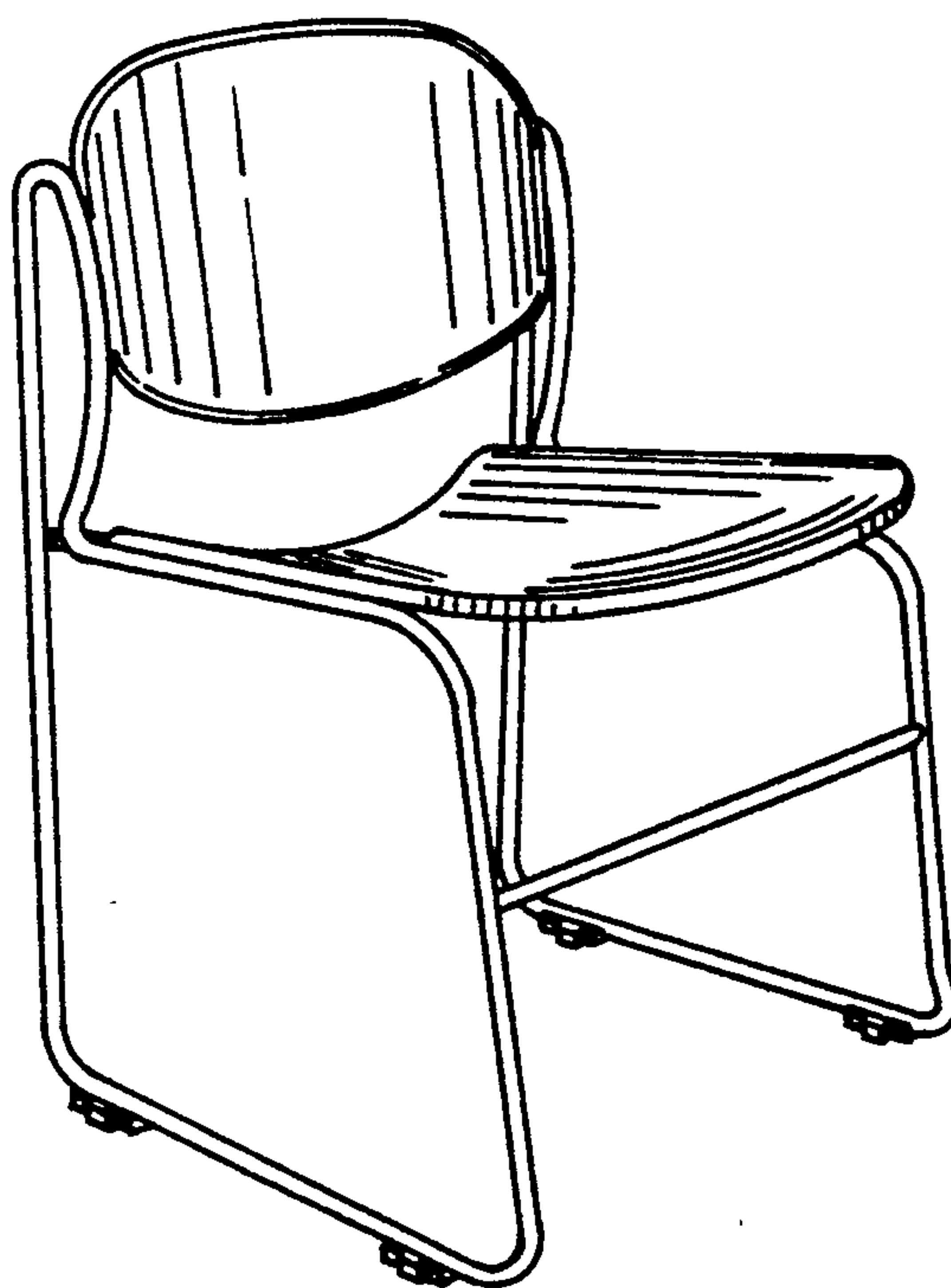

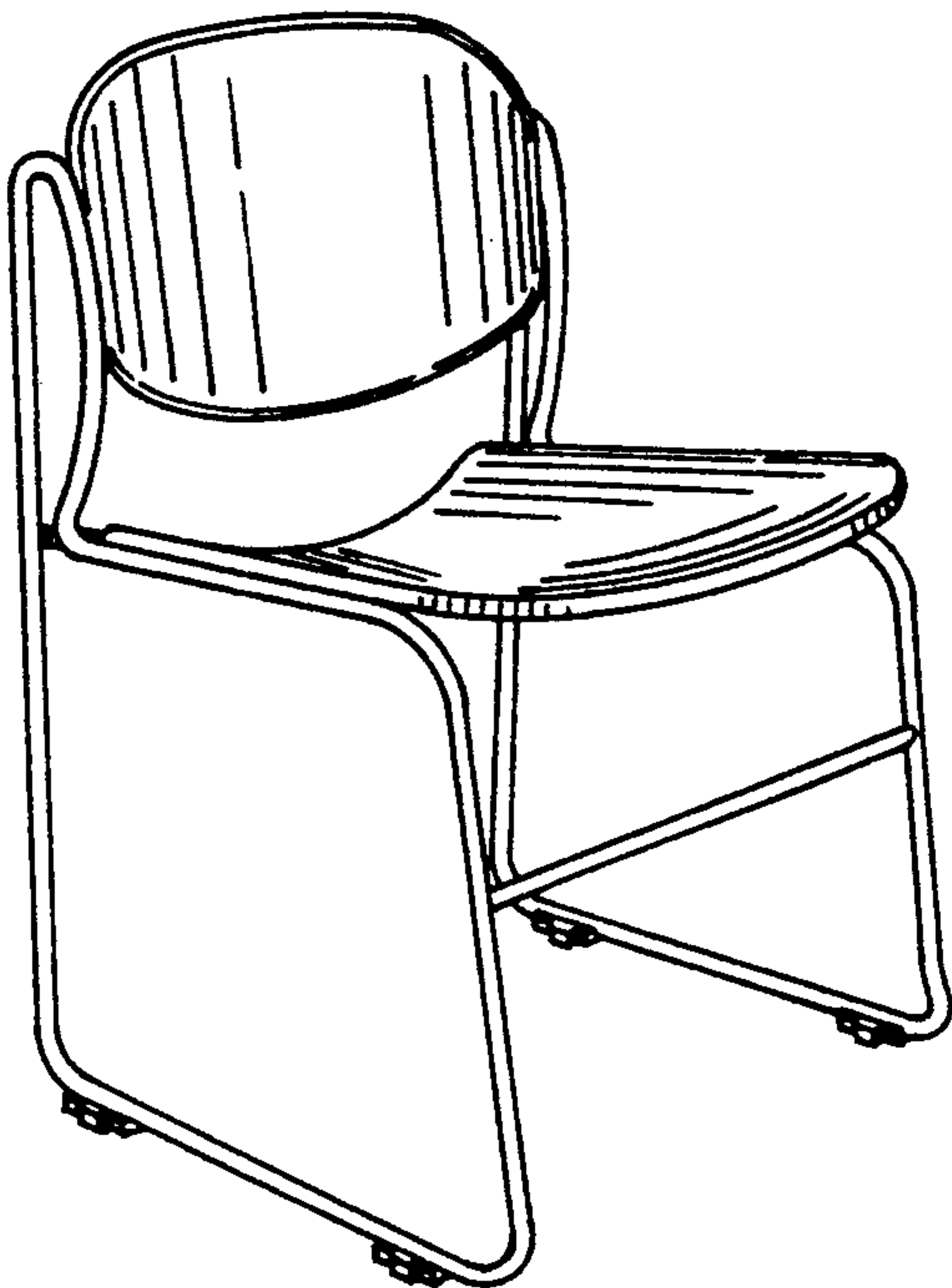

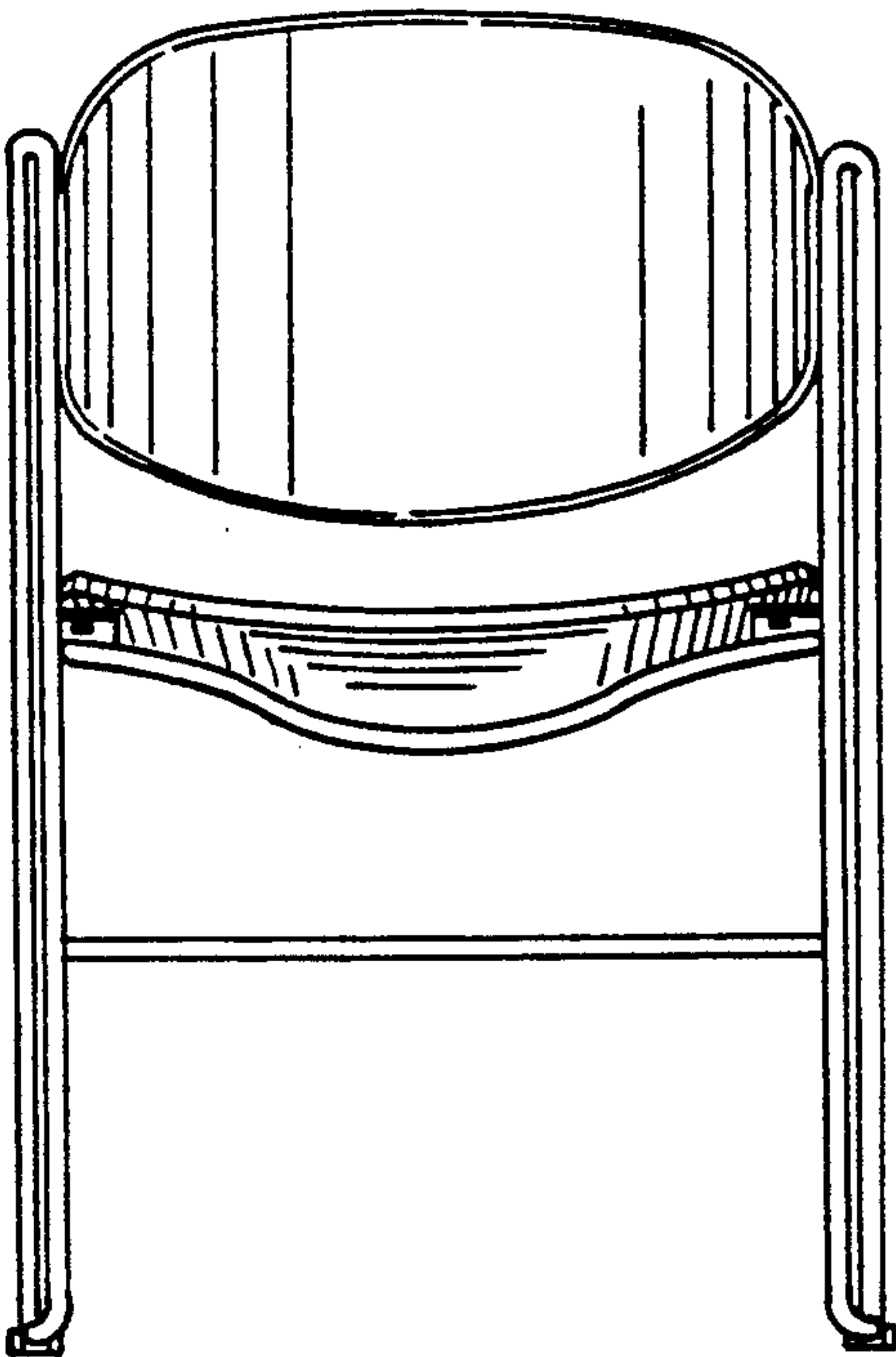

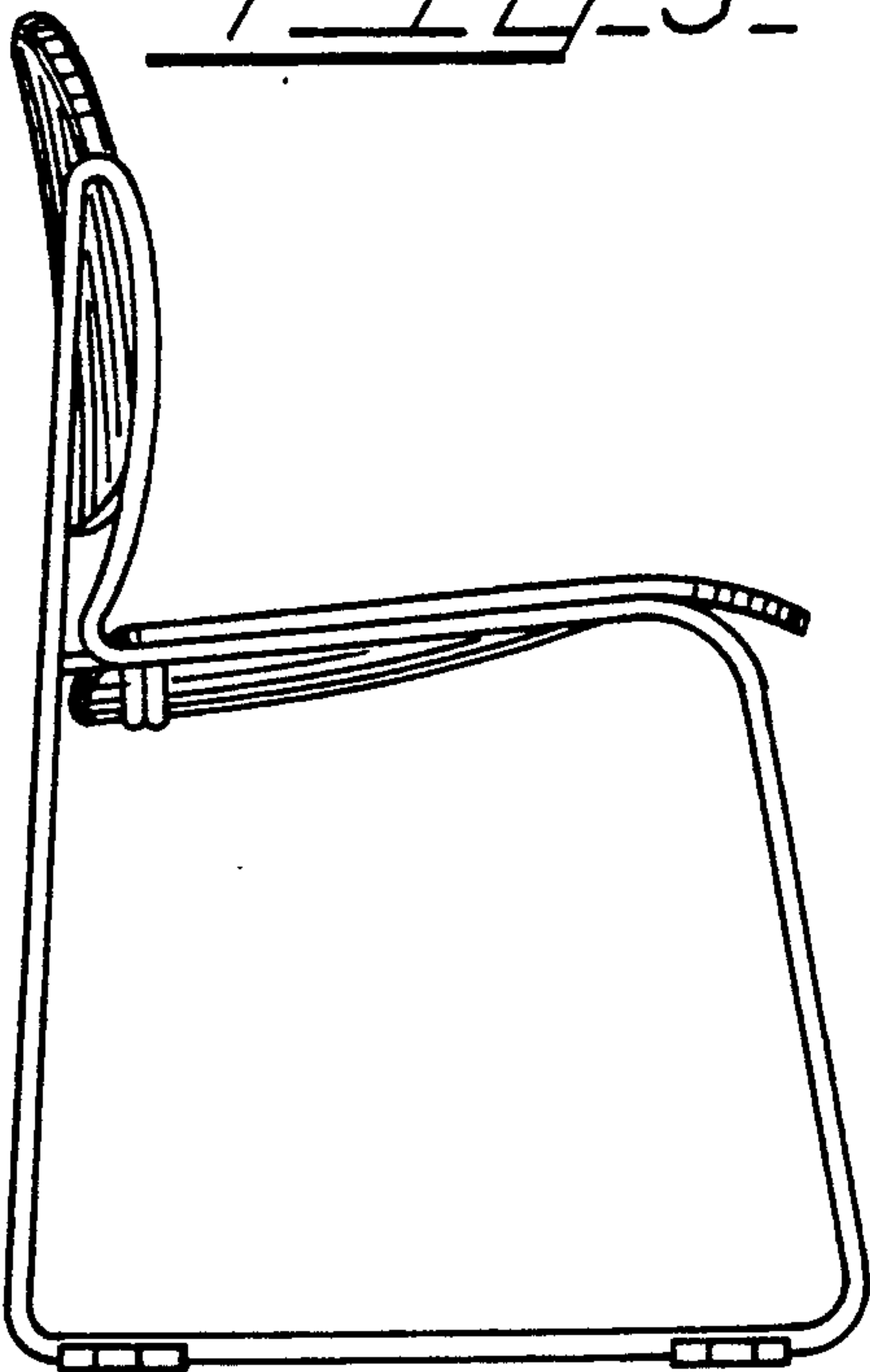

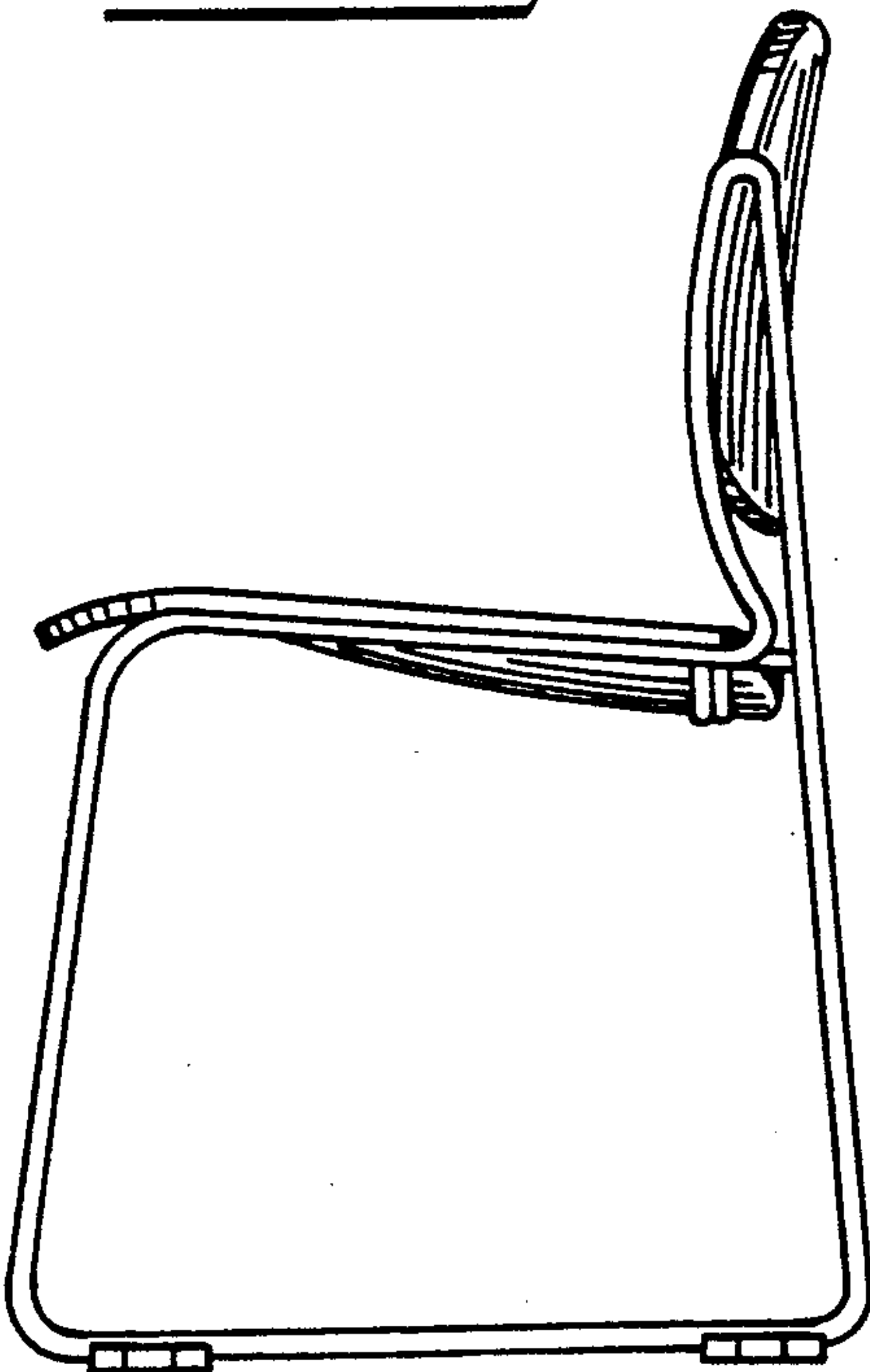

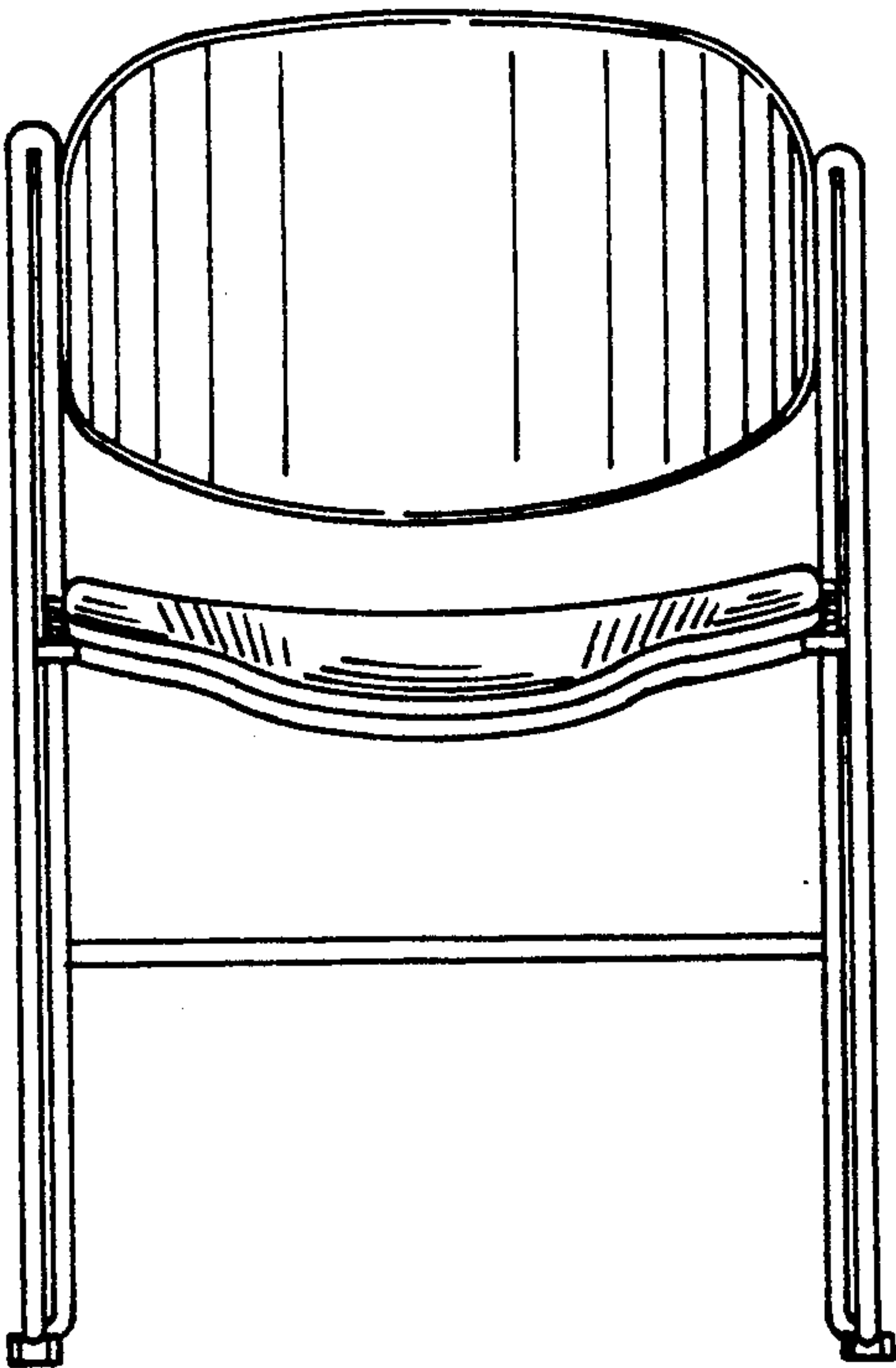

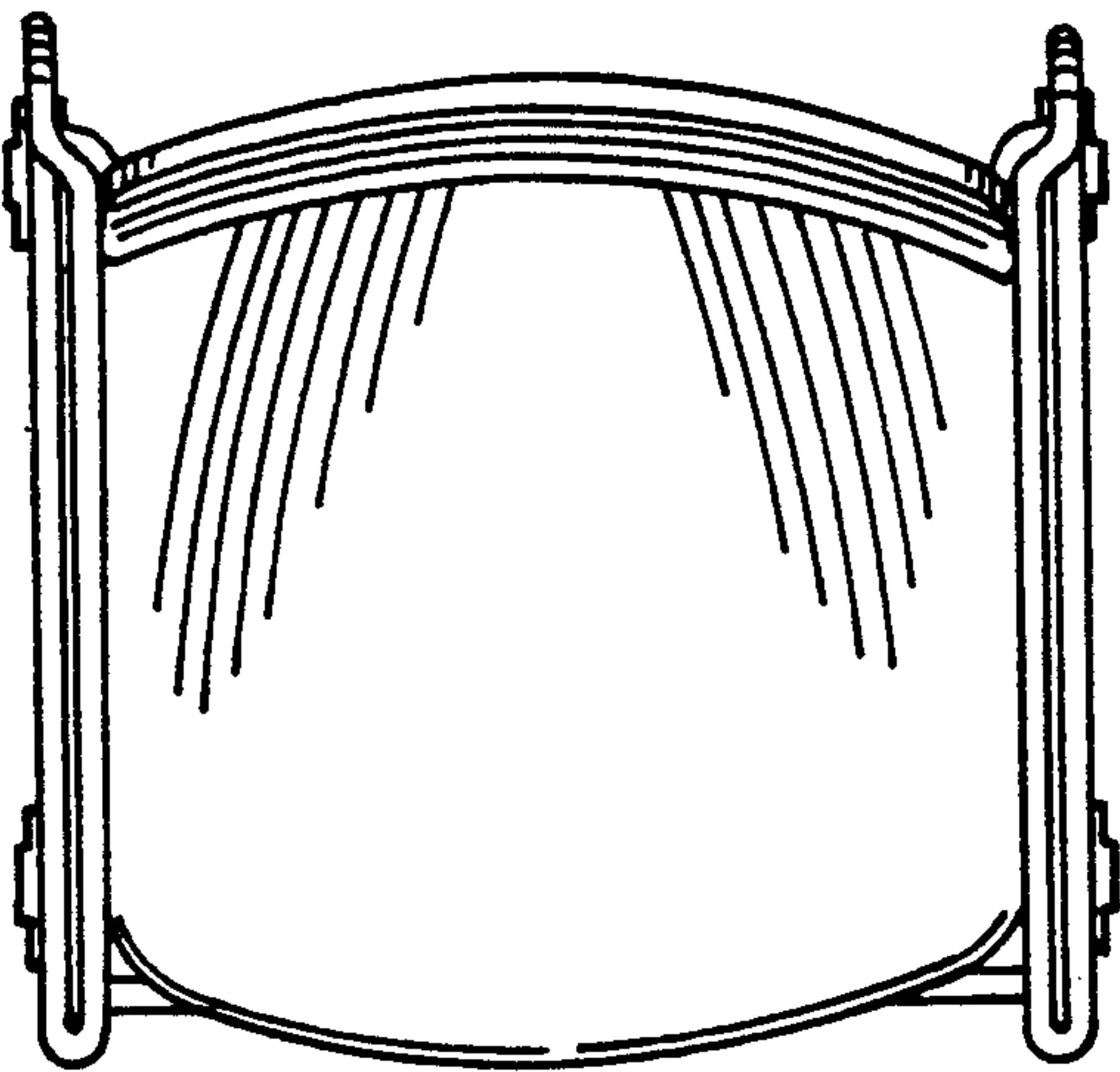

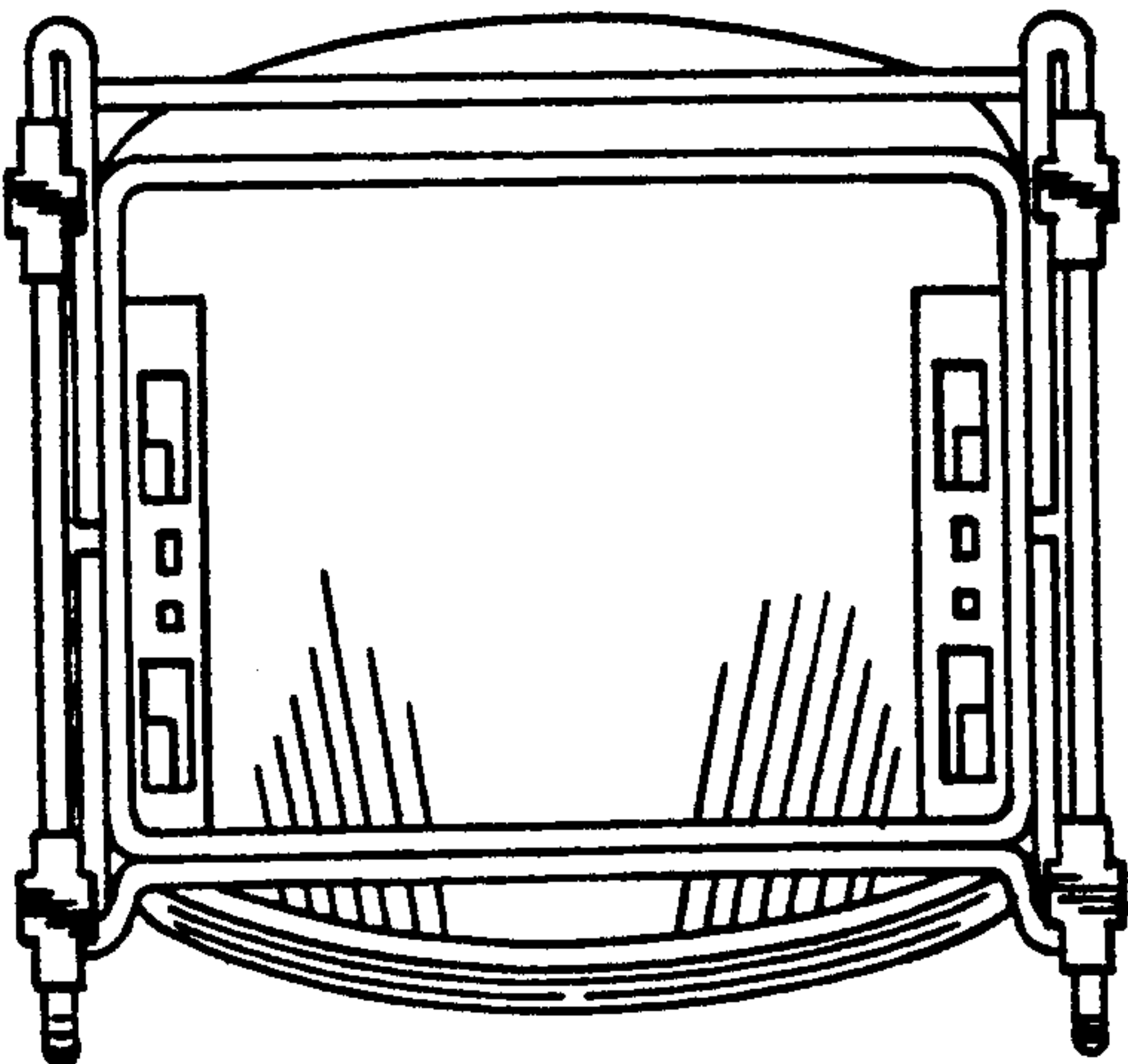

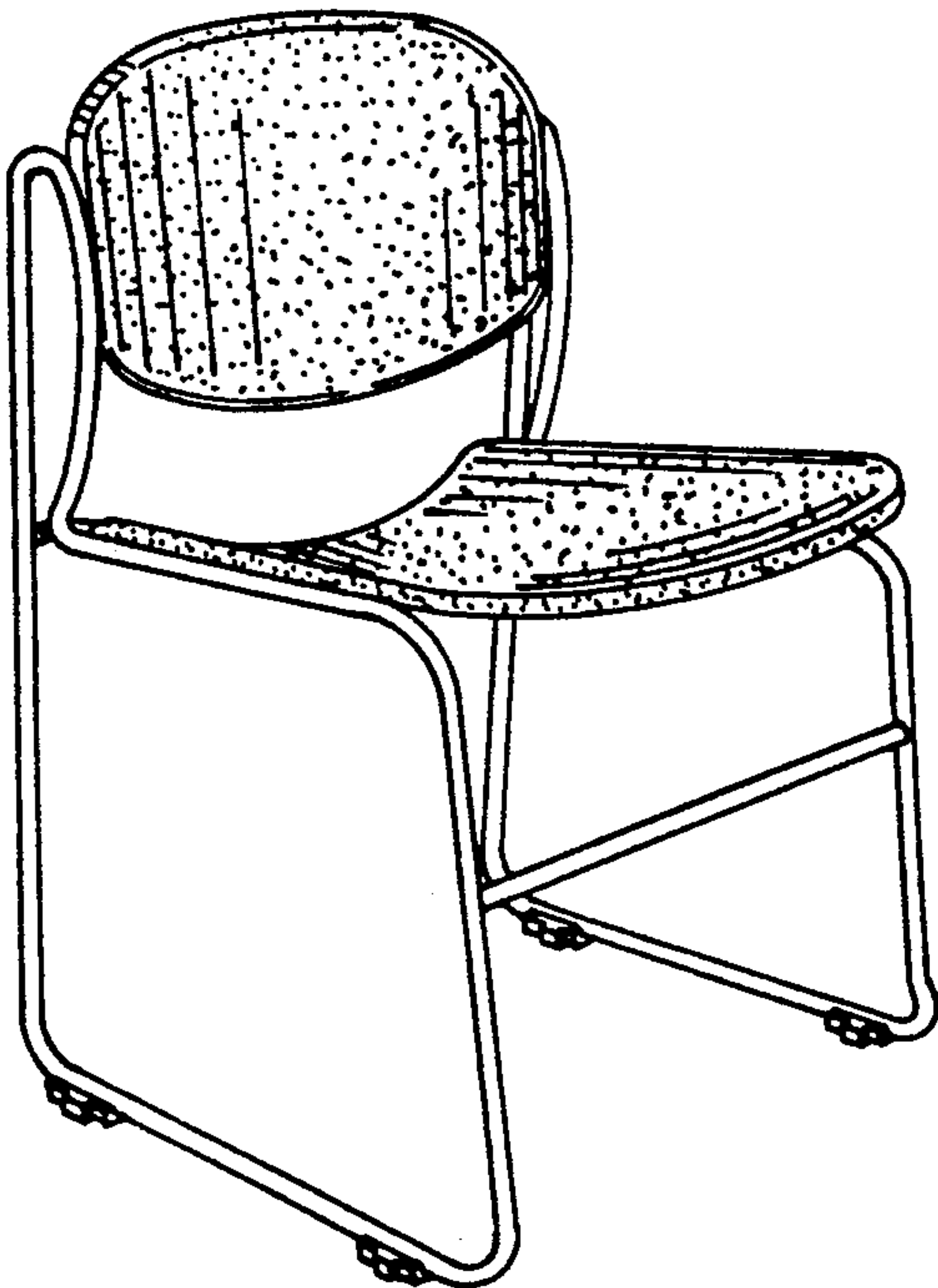

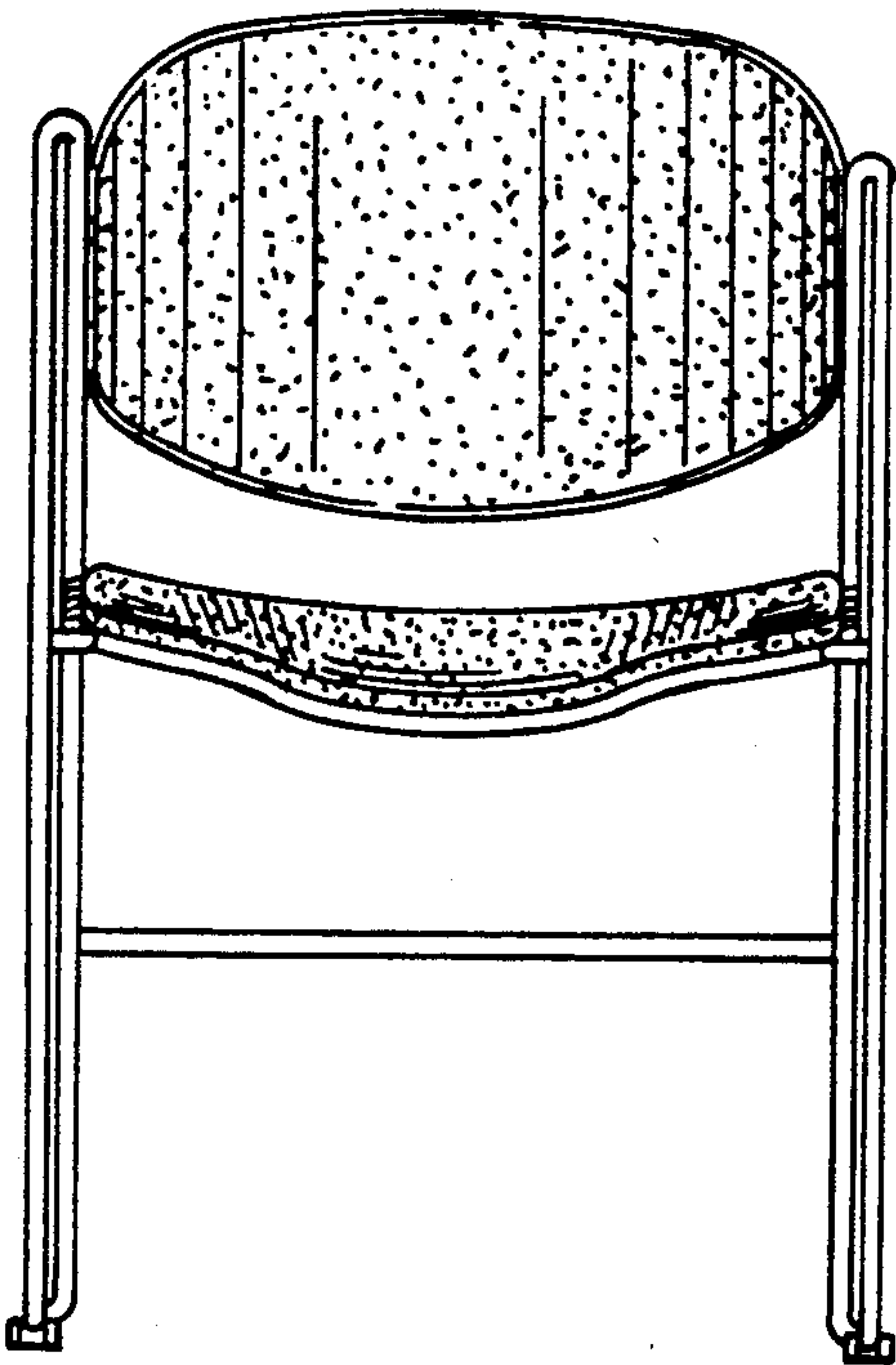

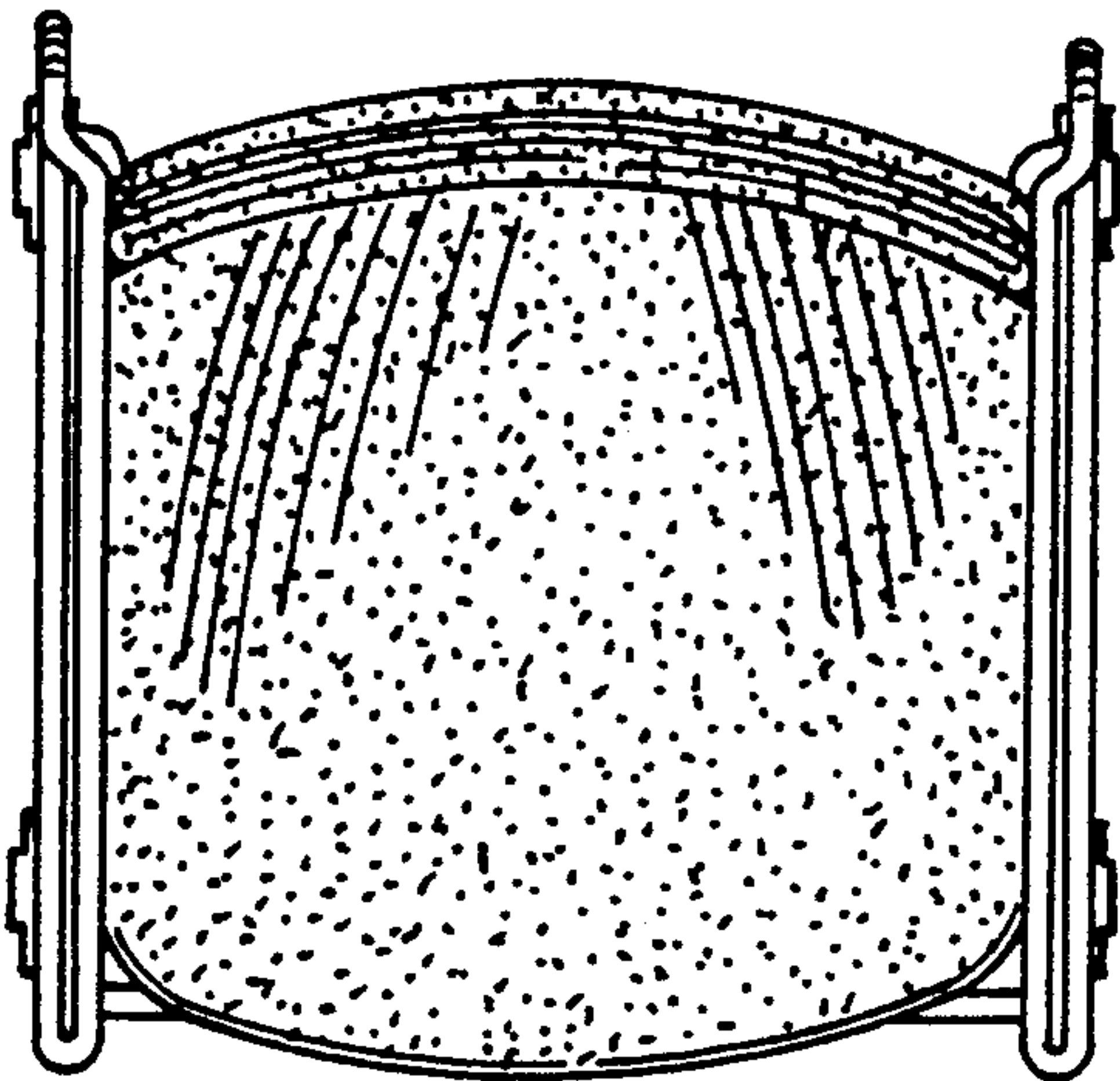

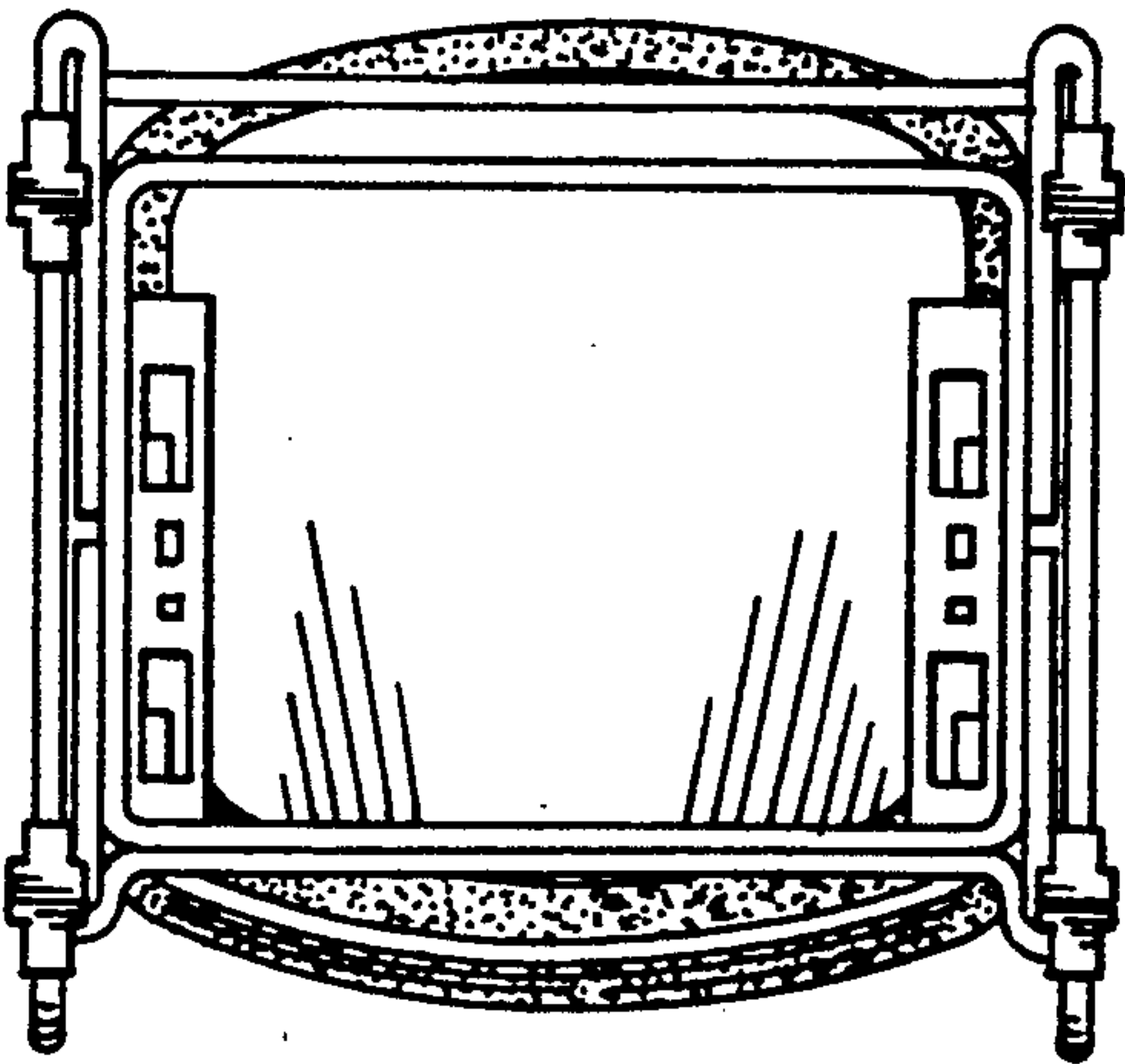

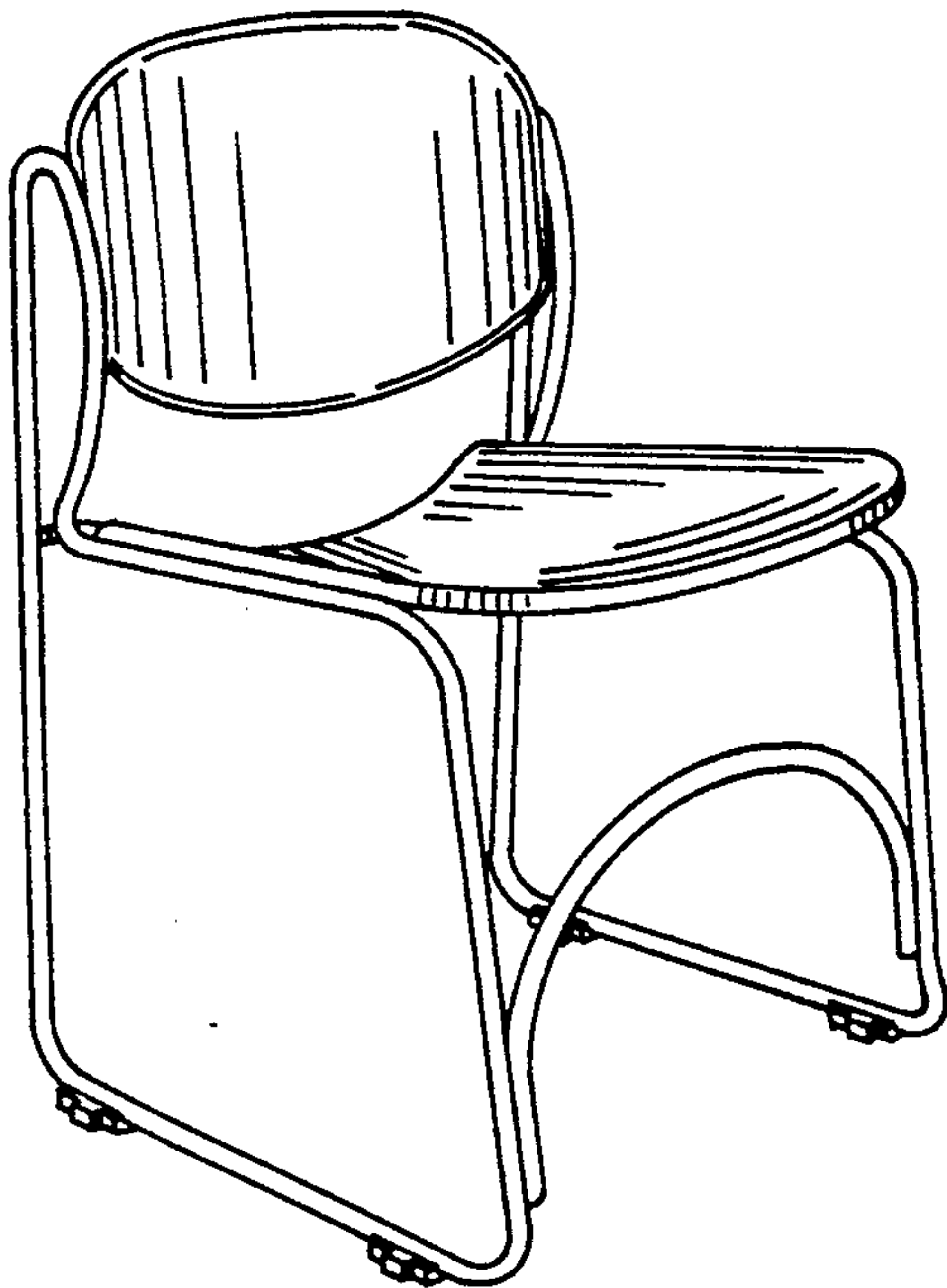

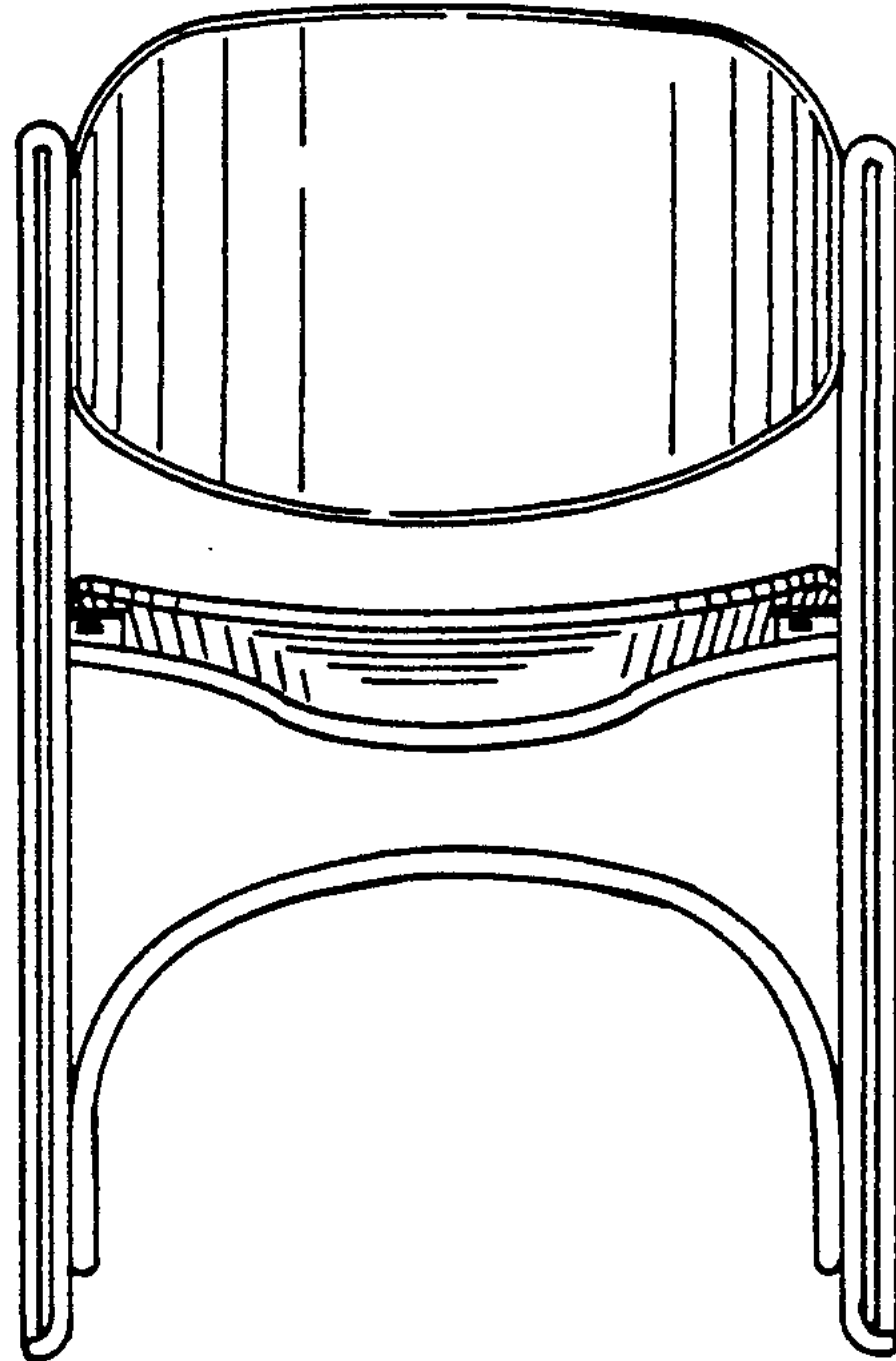

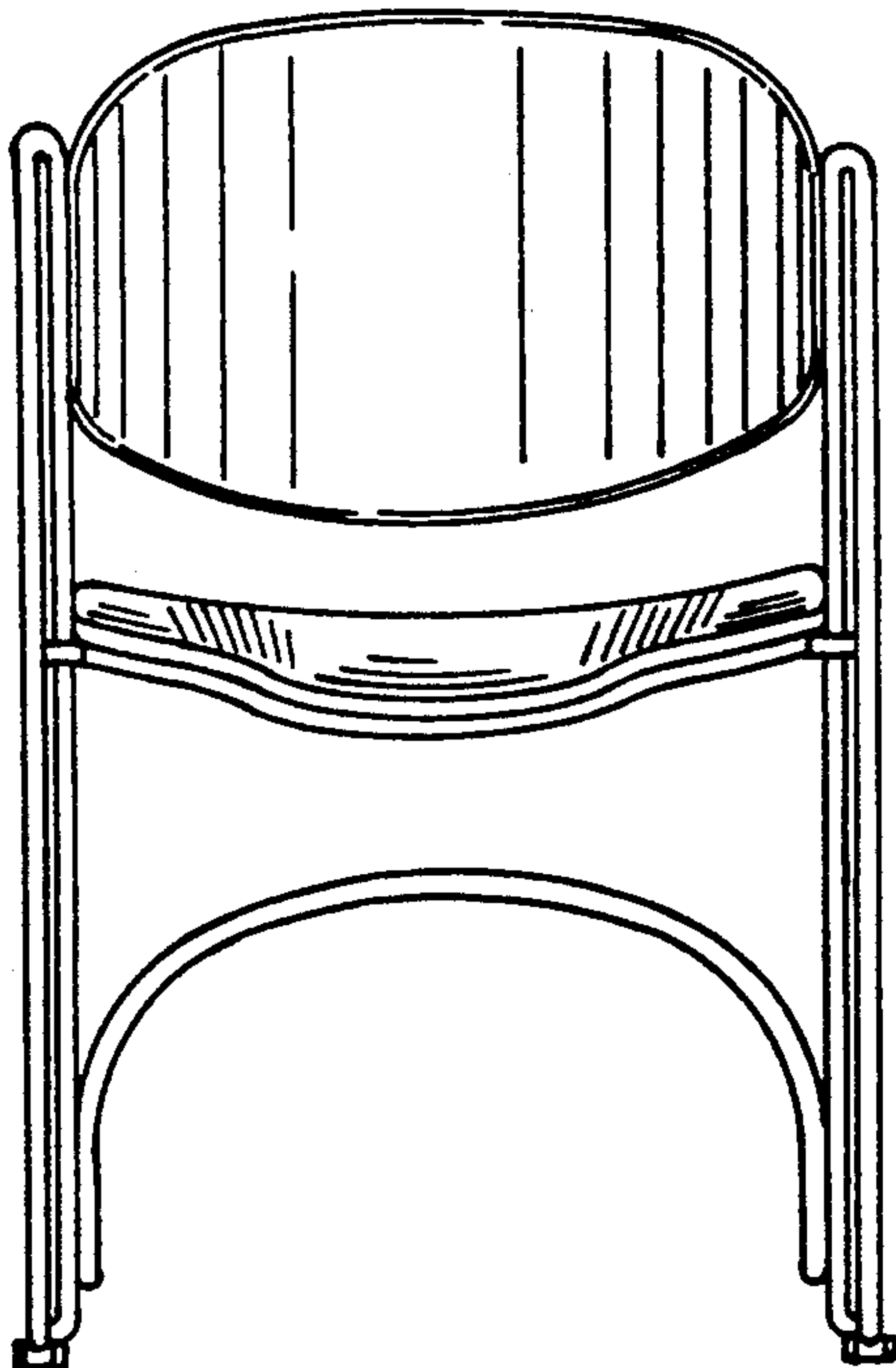
