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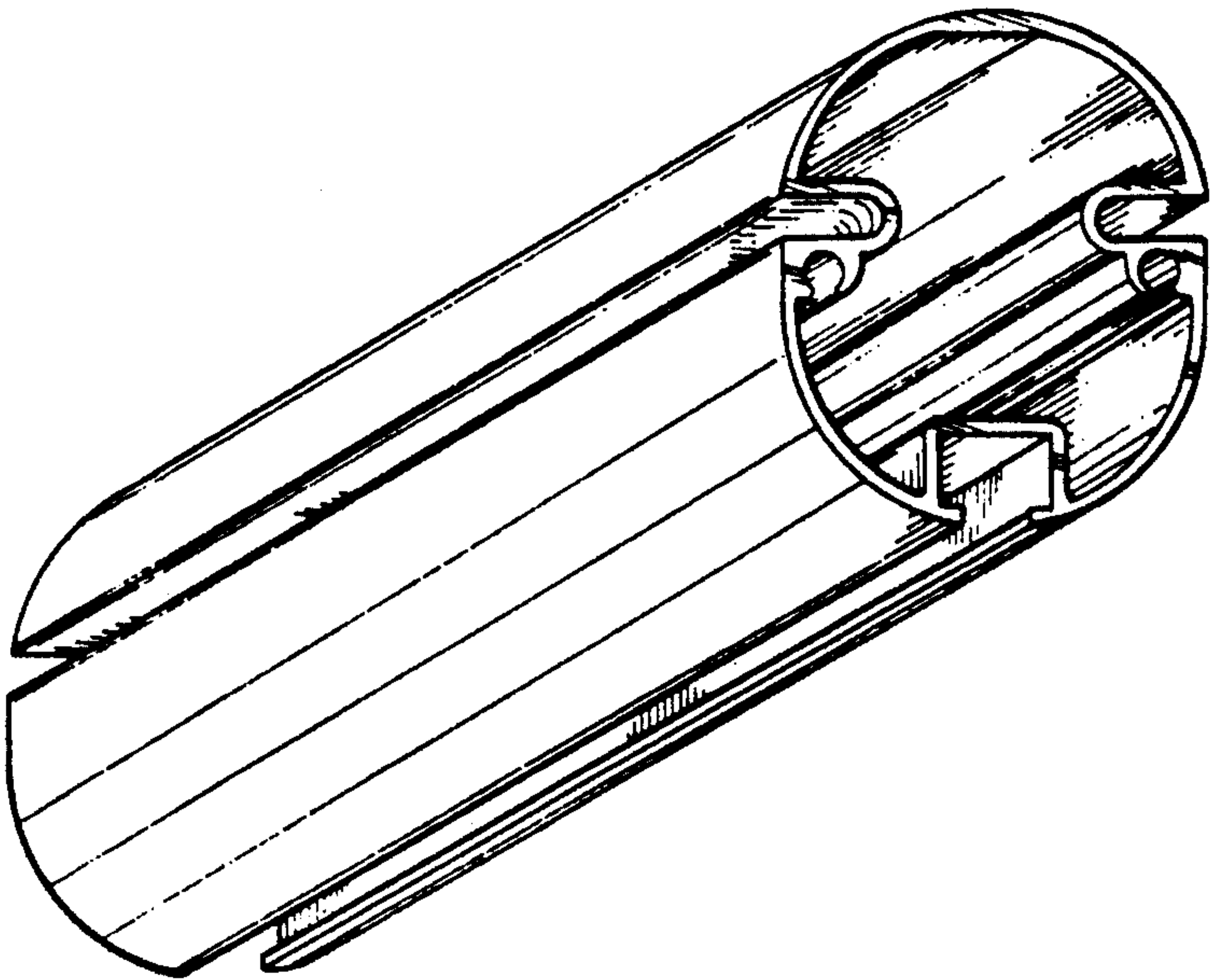

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a fragmentary bottom perspective view of a frame extrusion for awnings, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a fragmentary top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a fragmentary side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a fragmentary bottom plan view thereof.



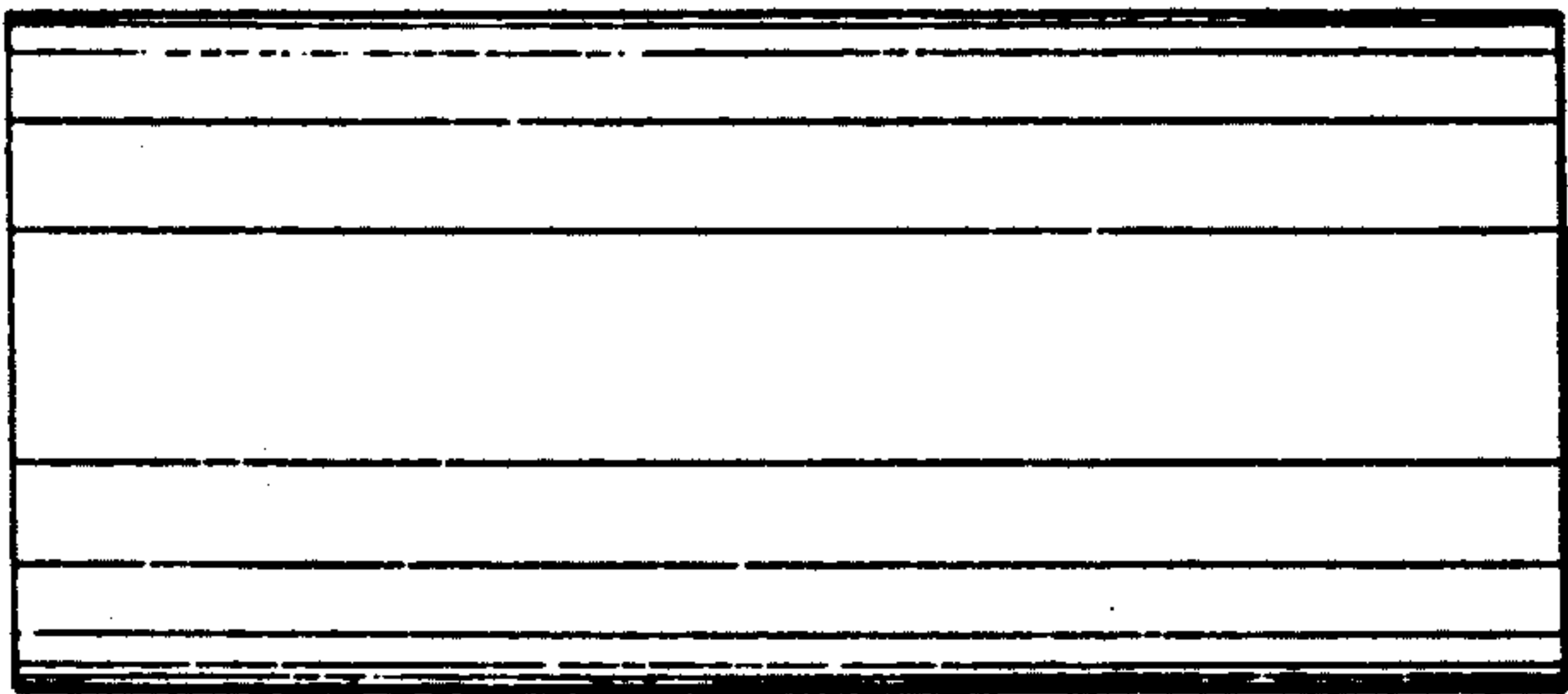
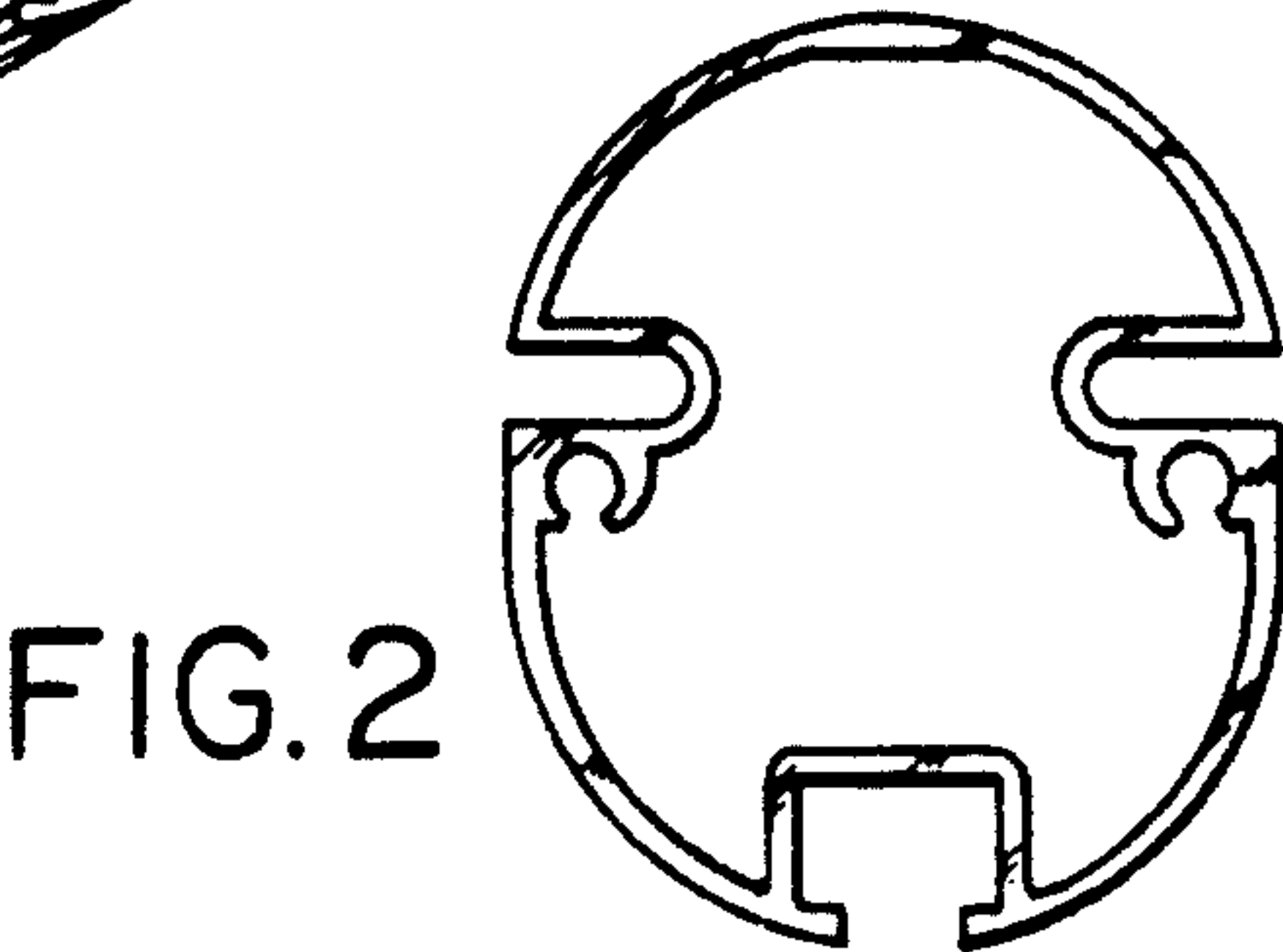
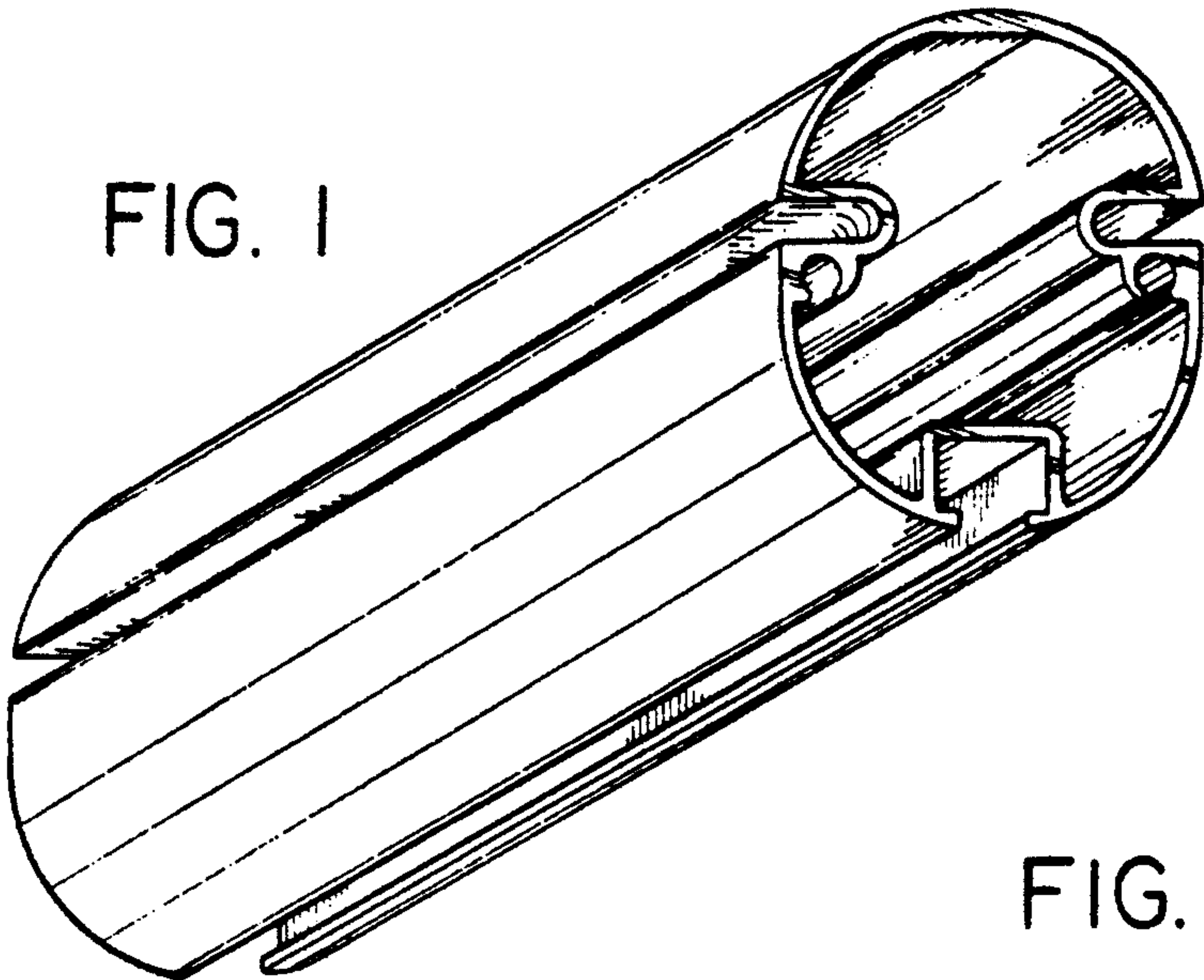

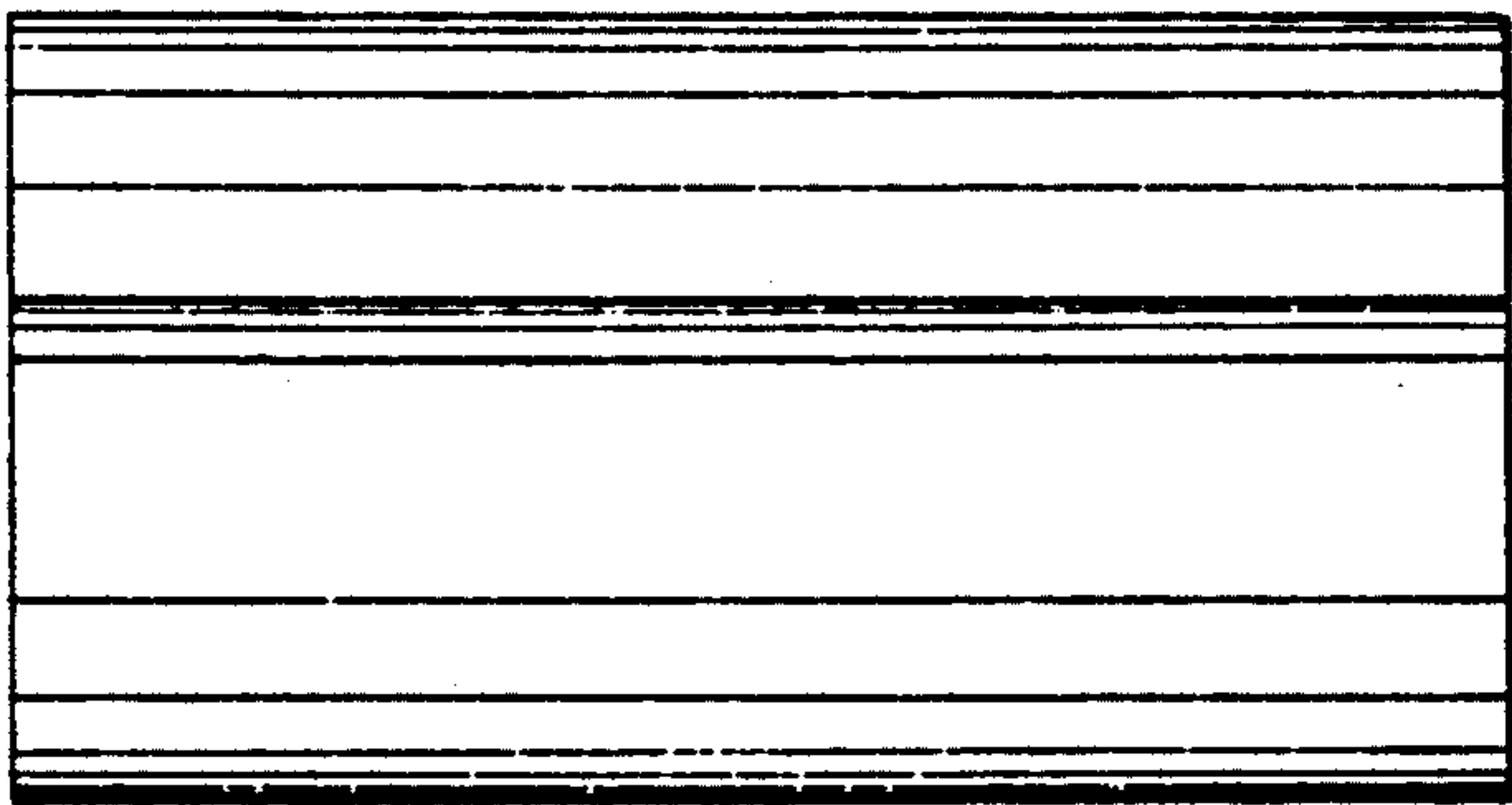

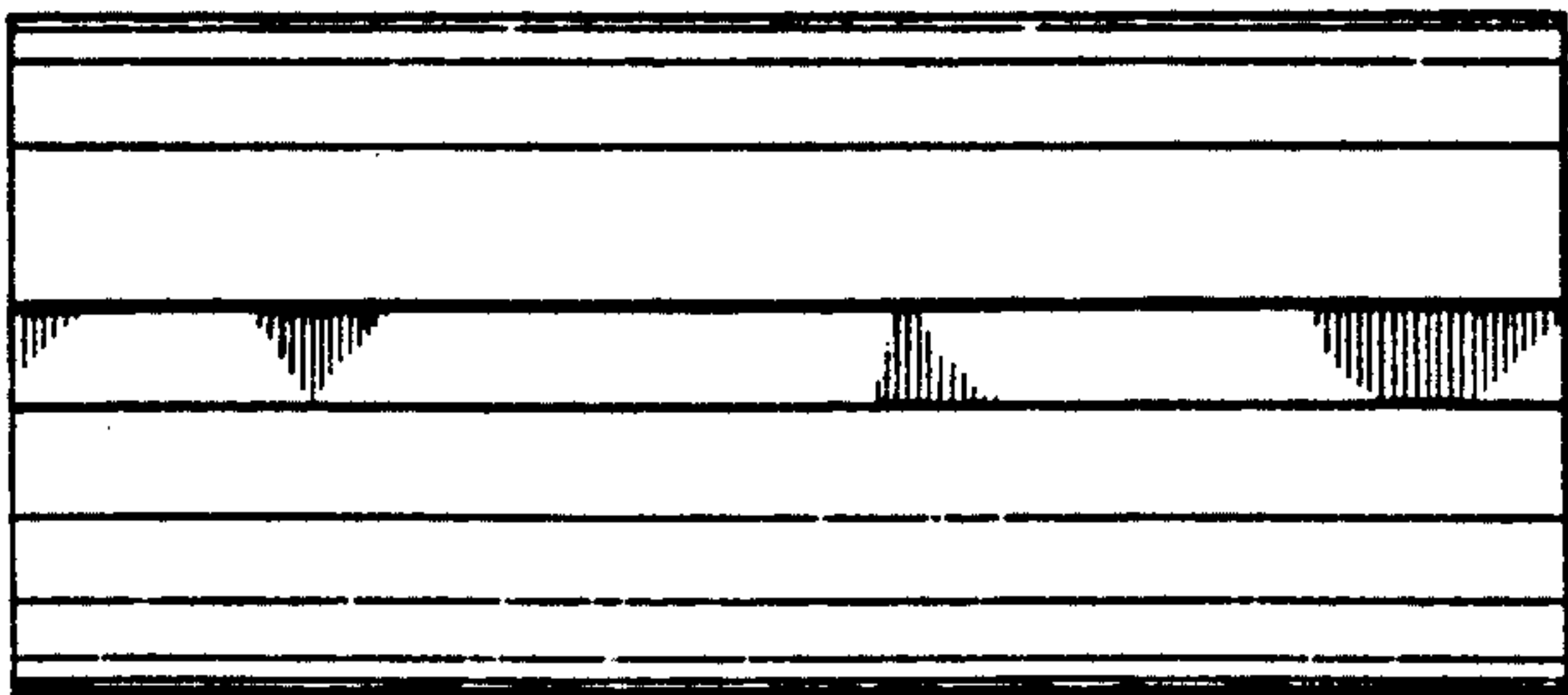
