The legible matter is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claim.

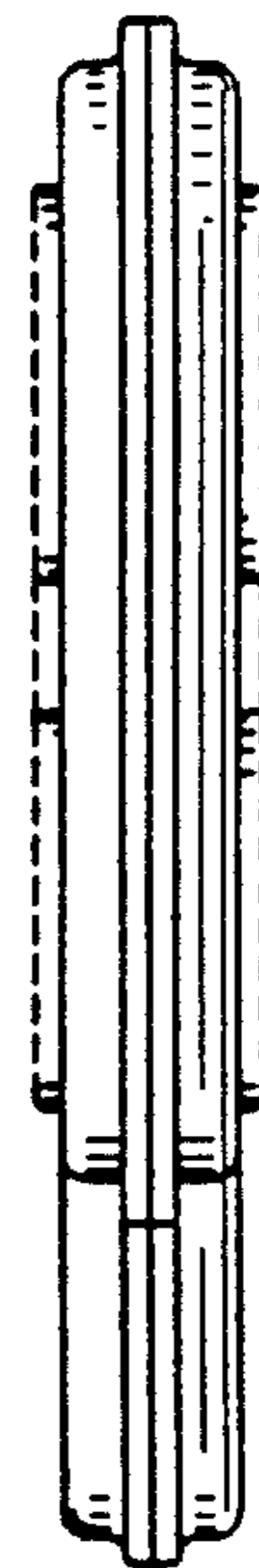
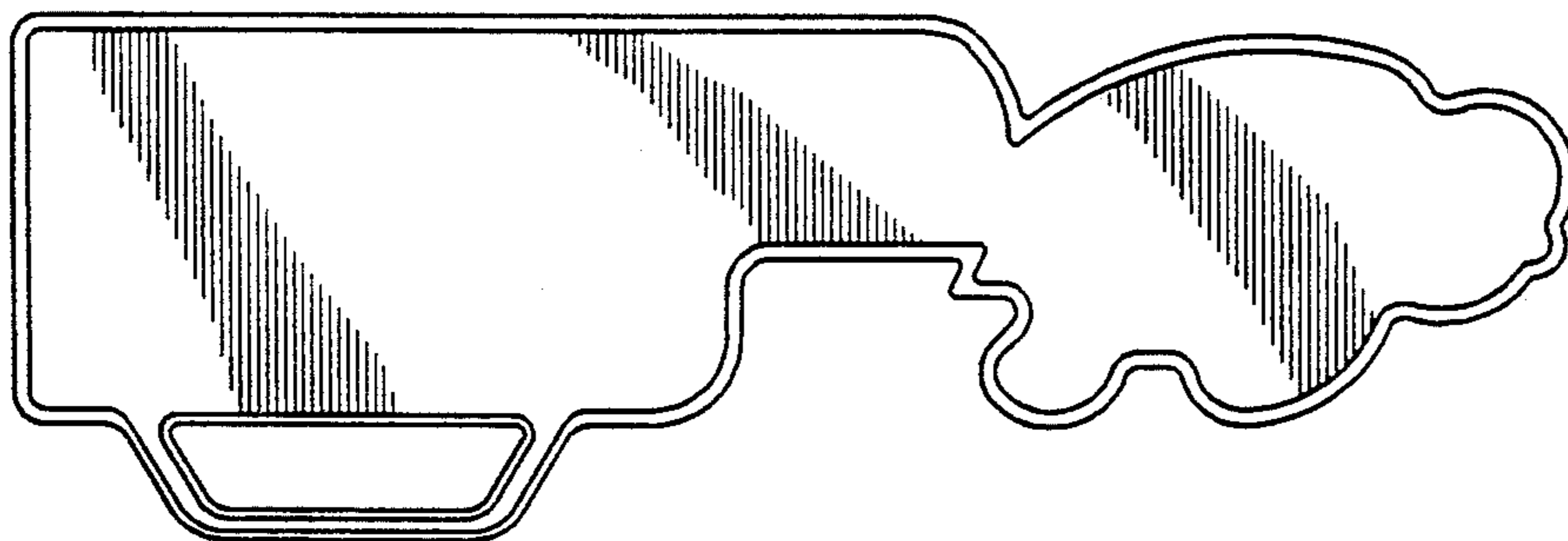

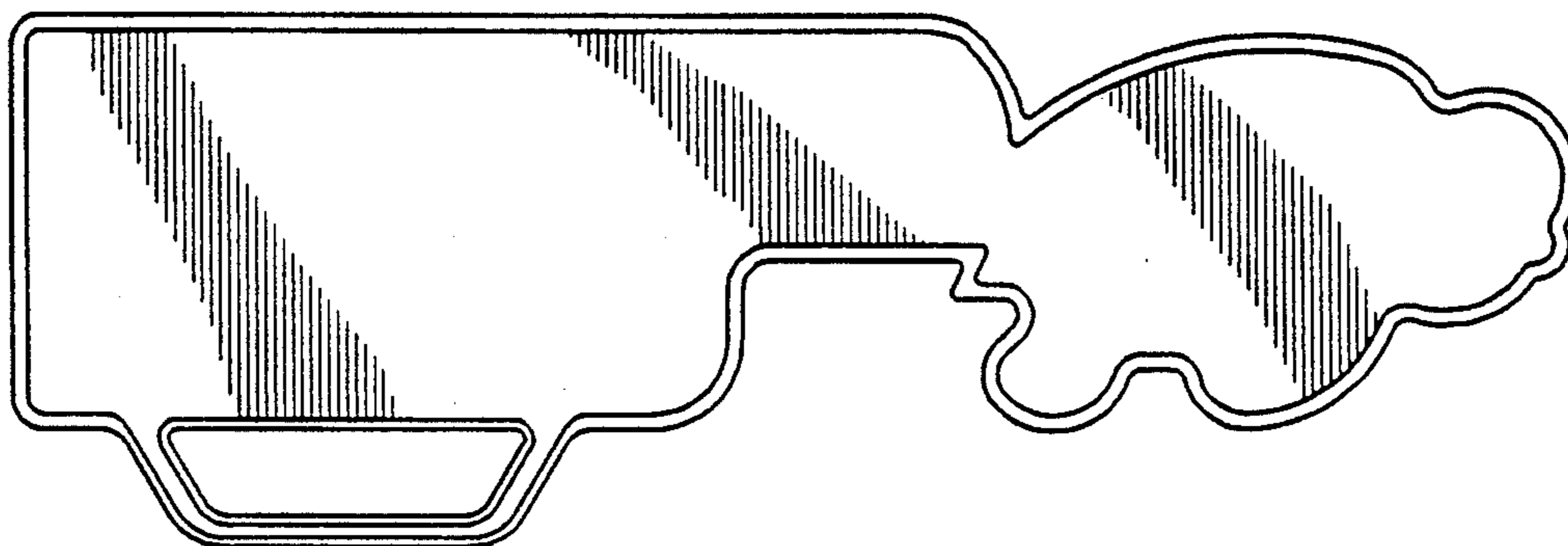

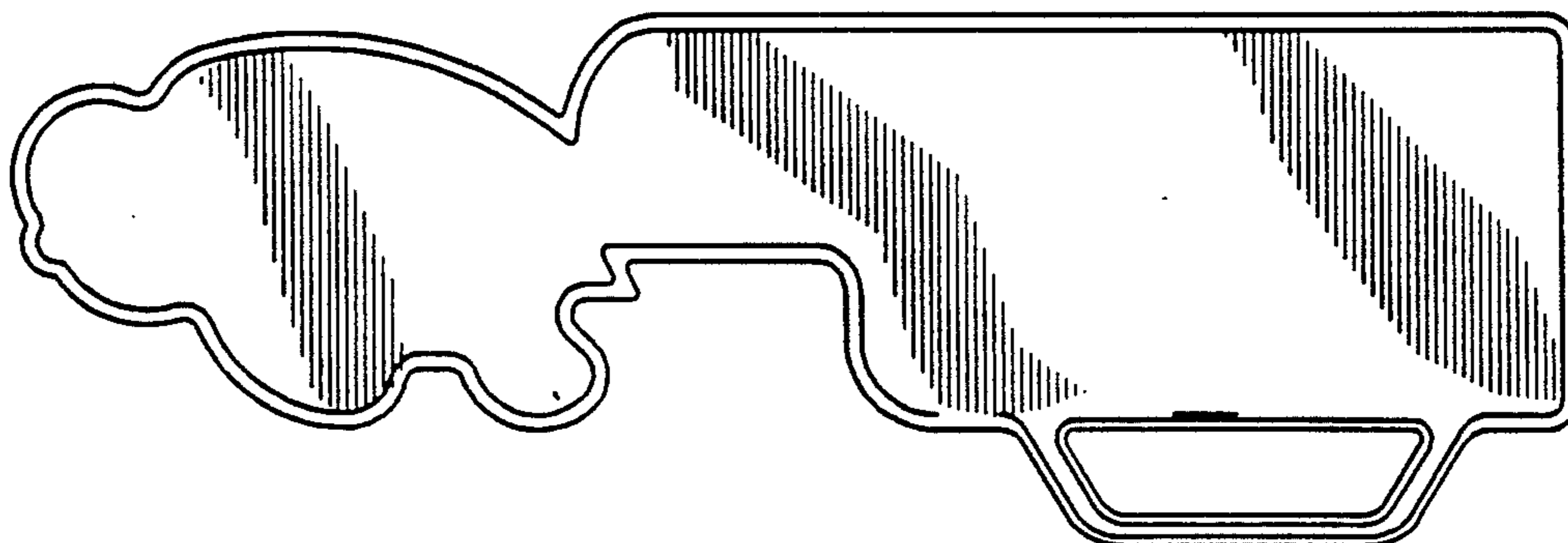

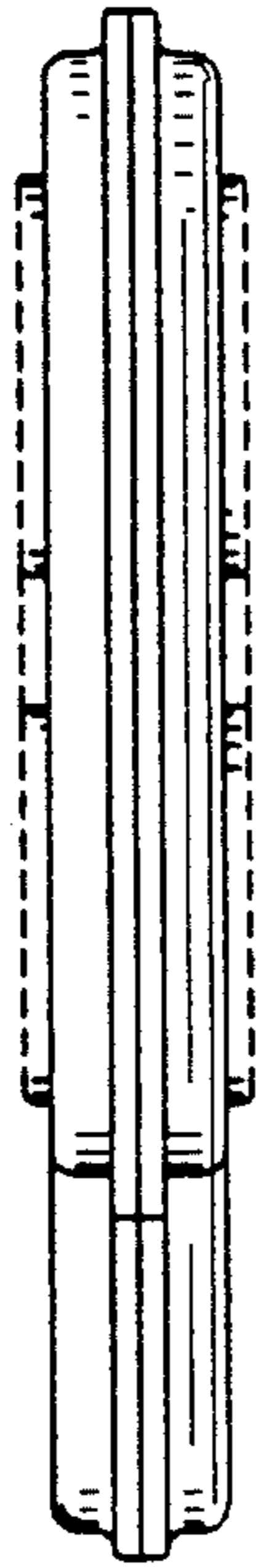

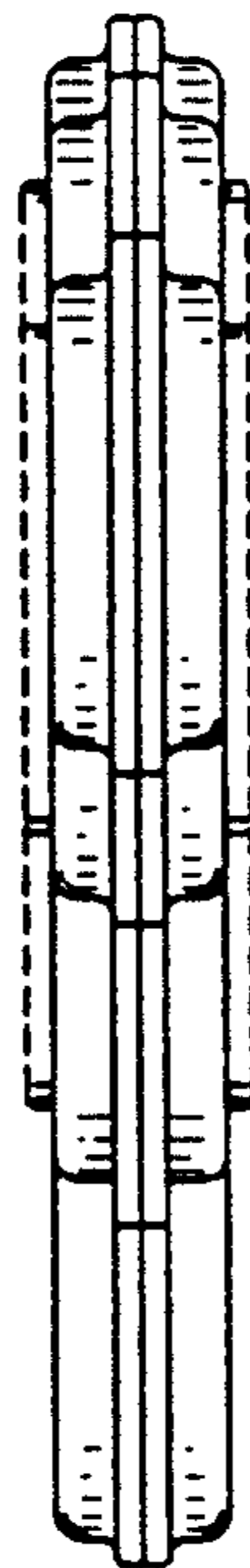
