FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a mailbox showing our new design;

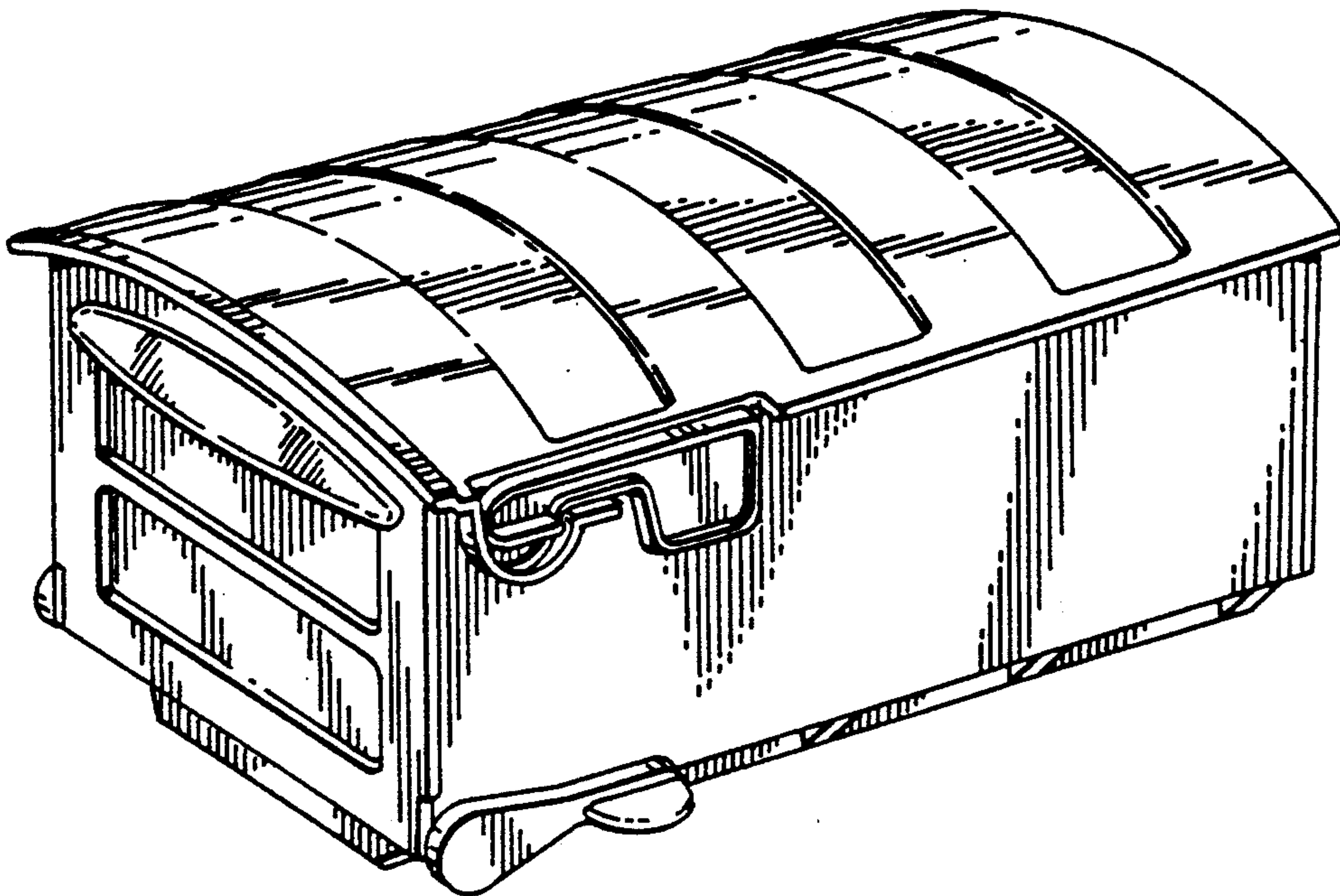
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



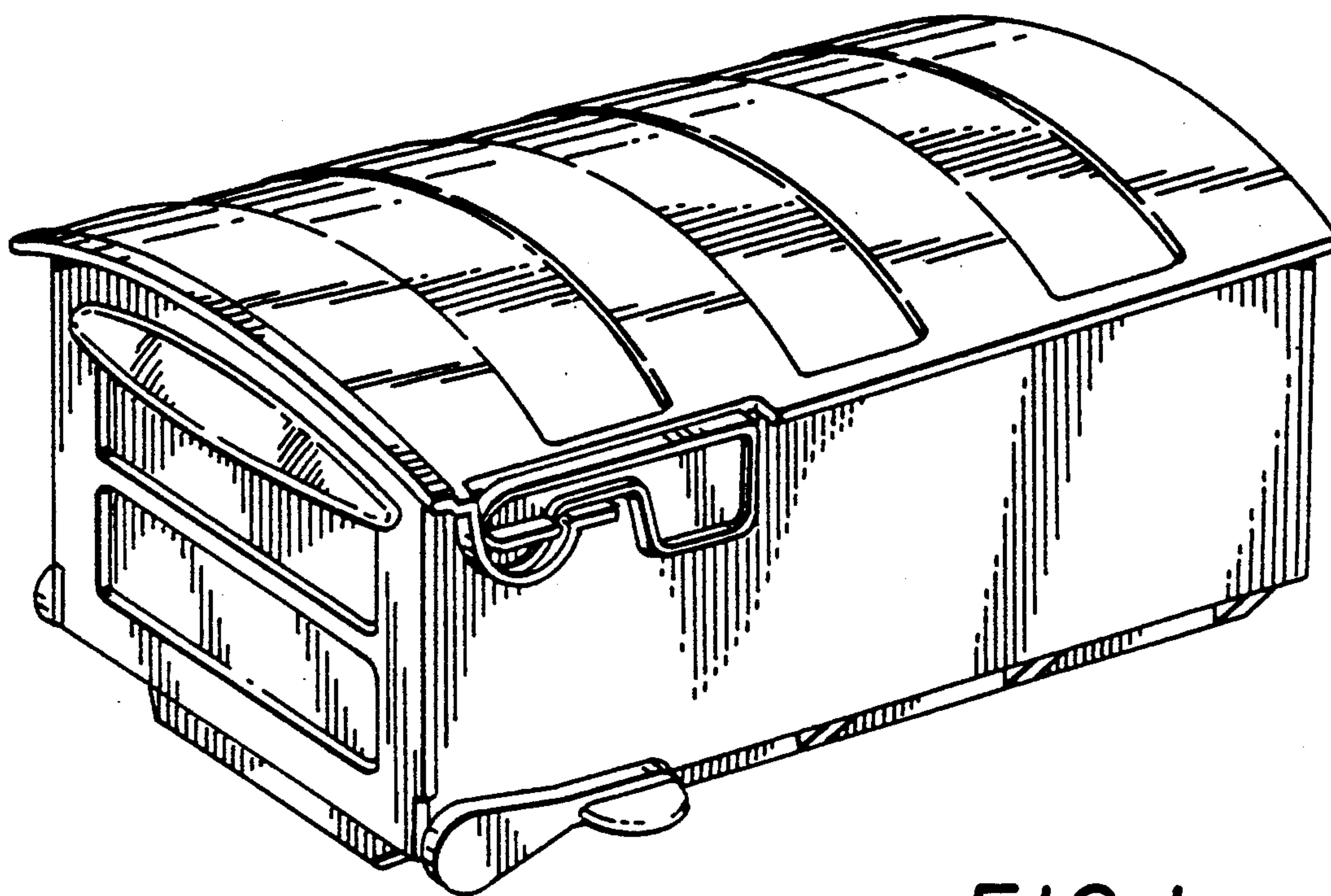

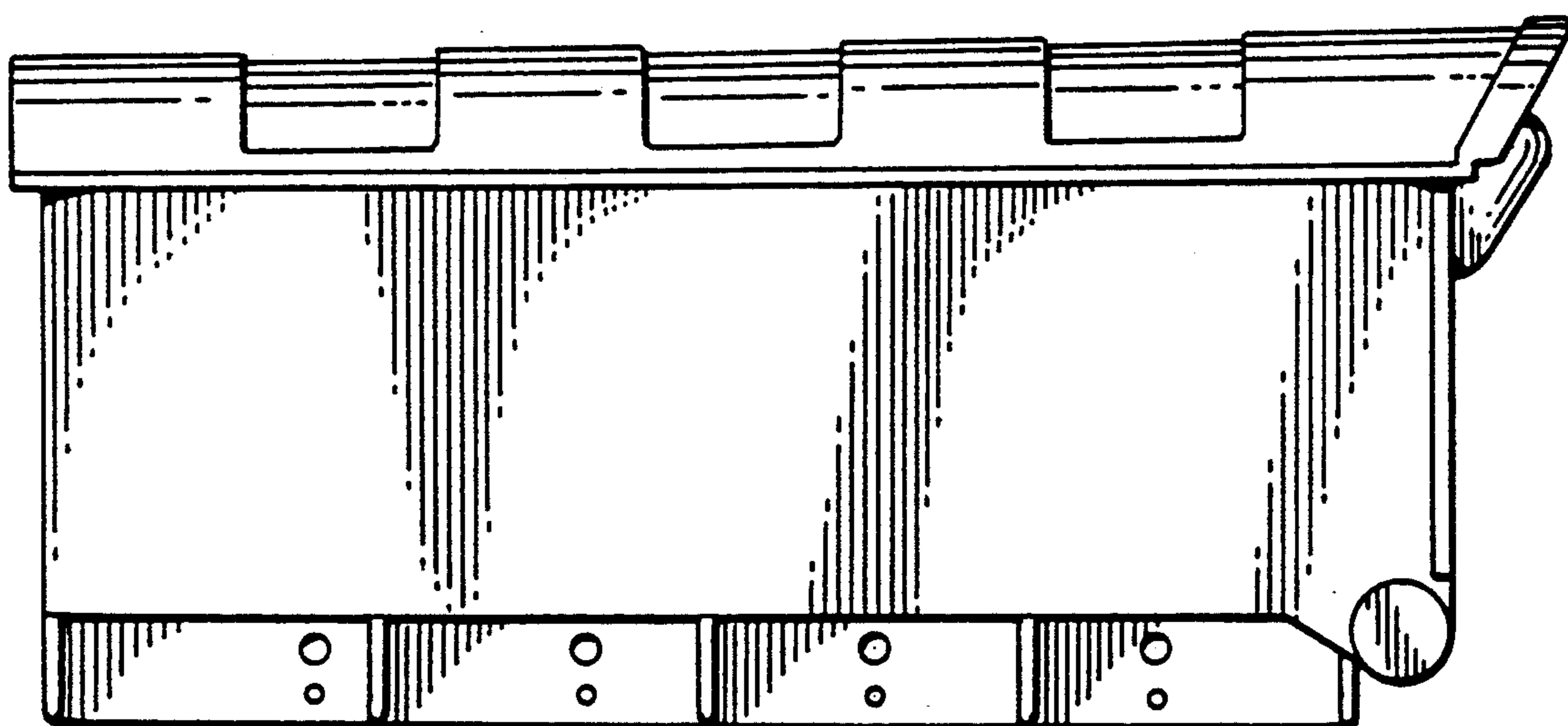

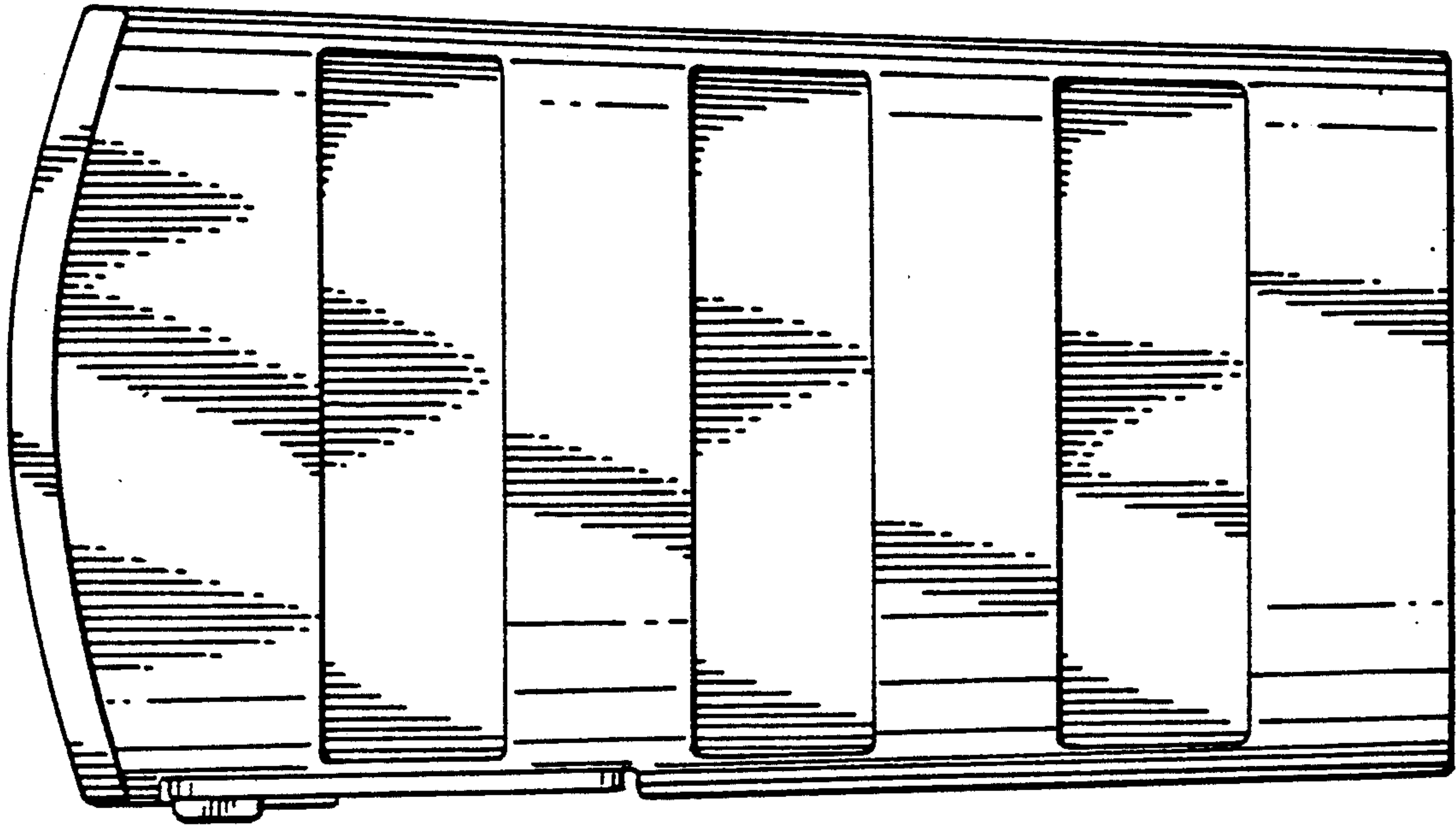

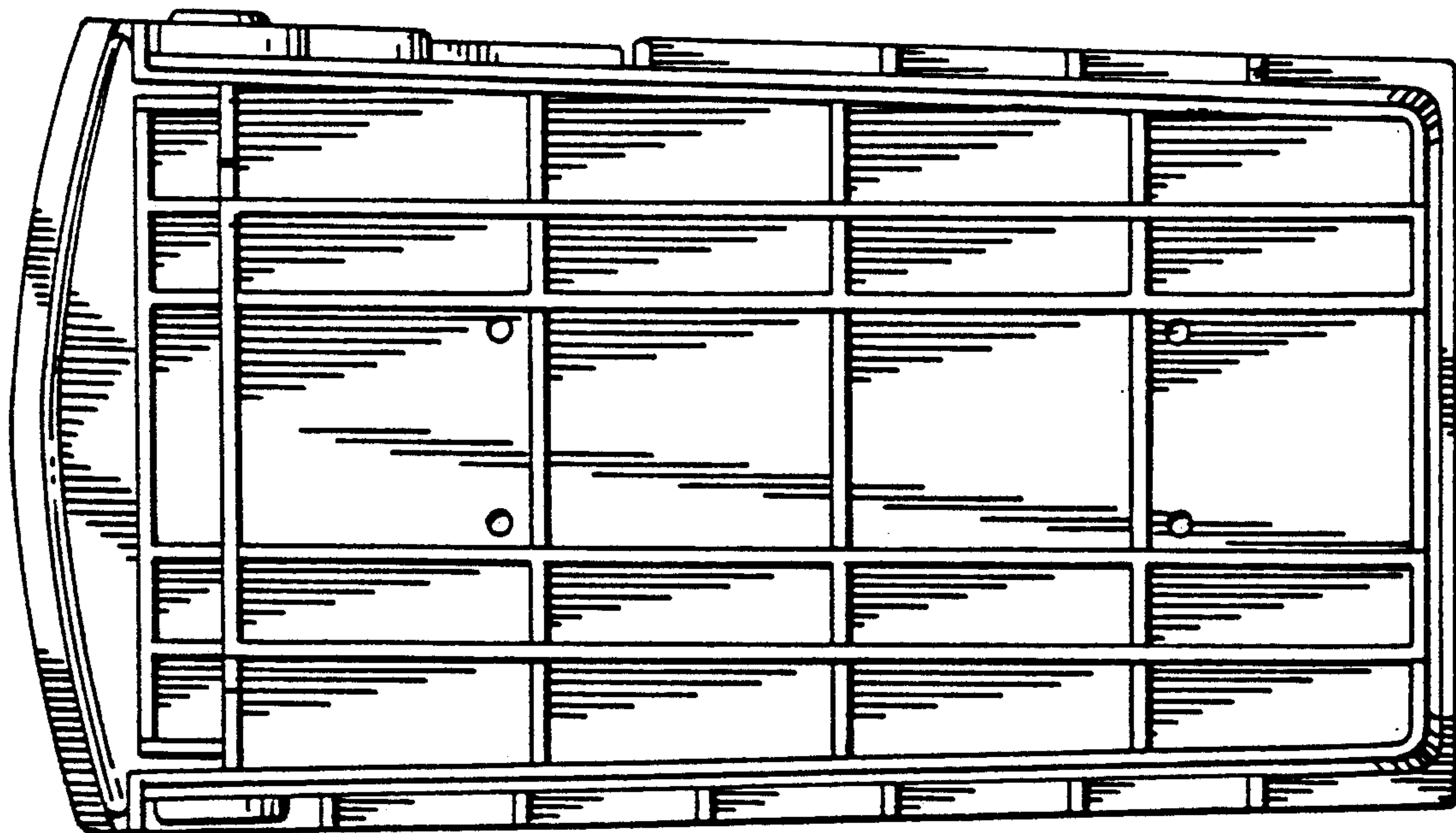

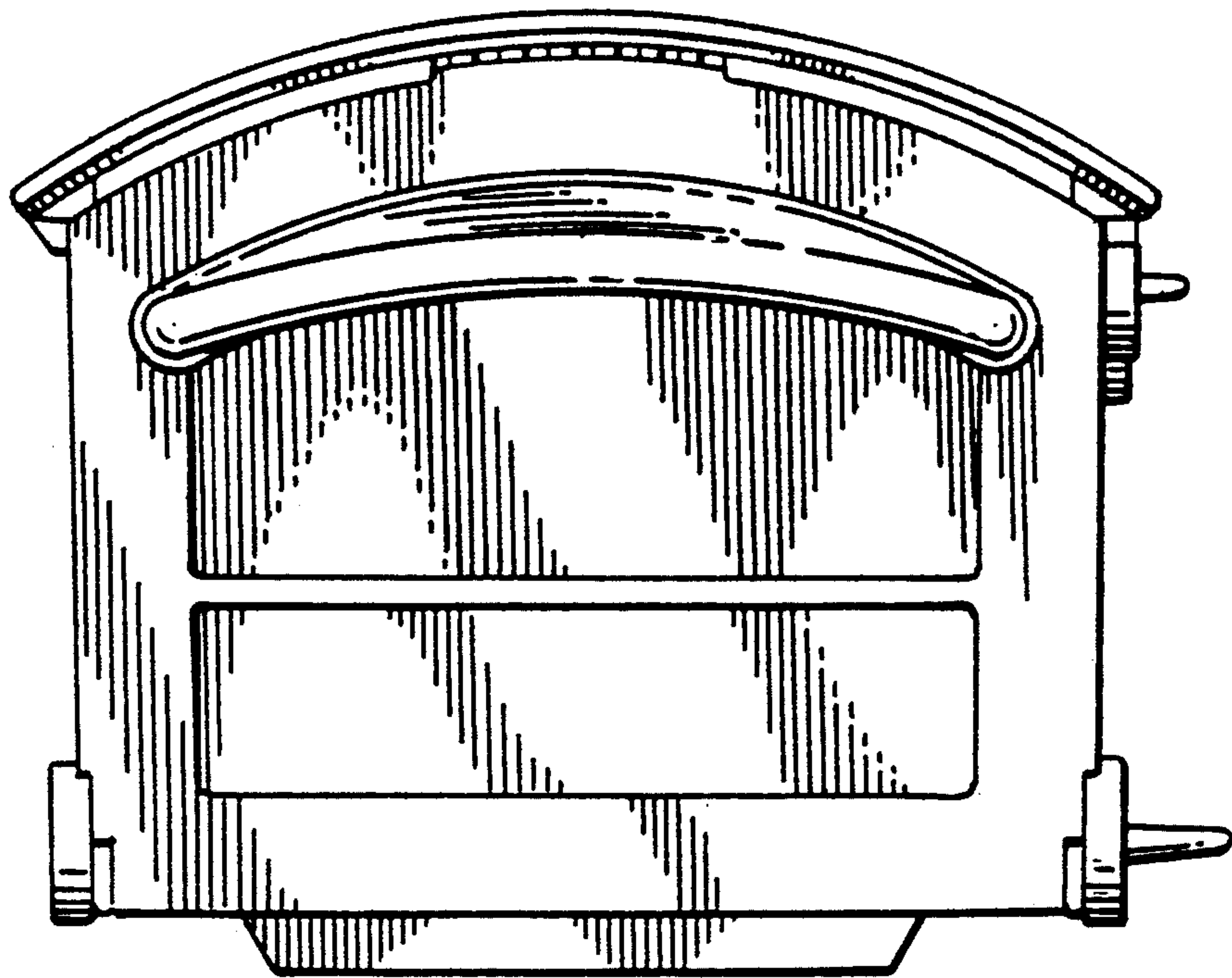

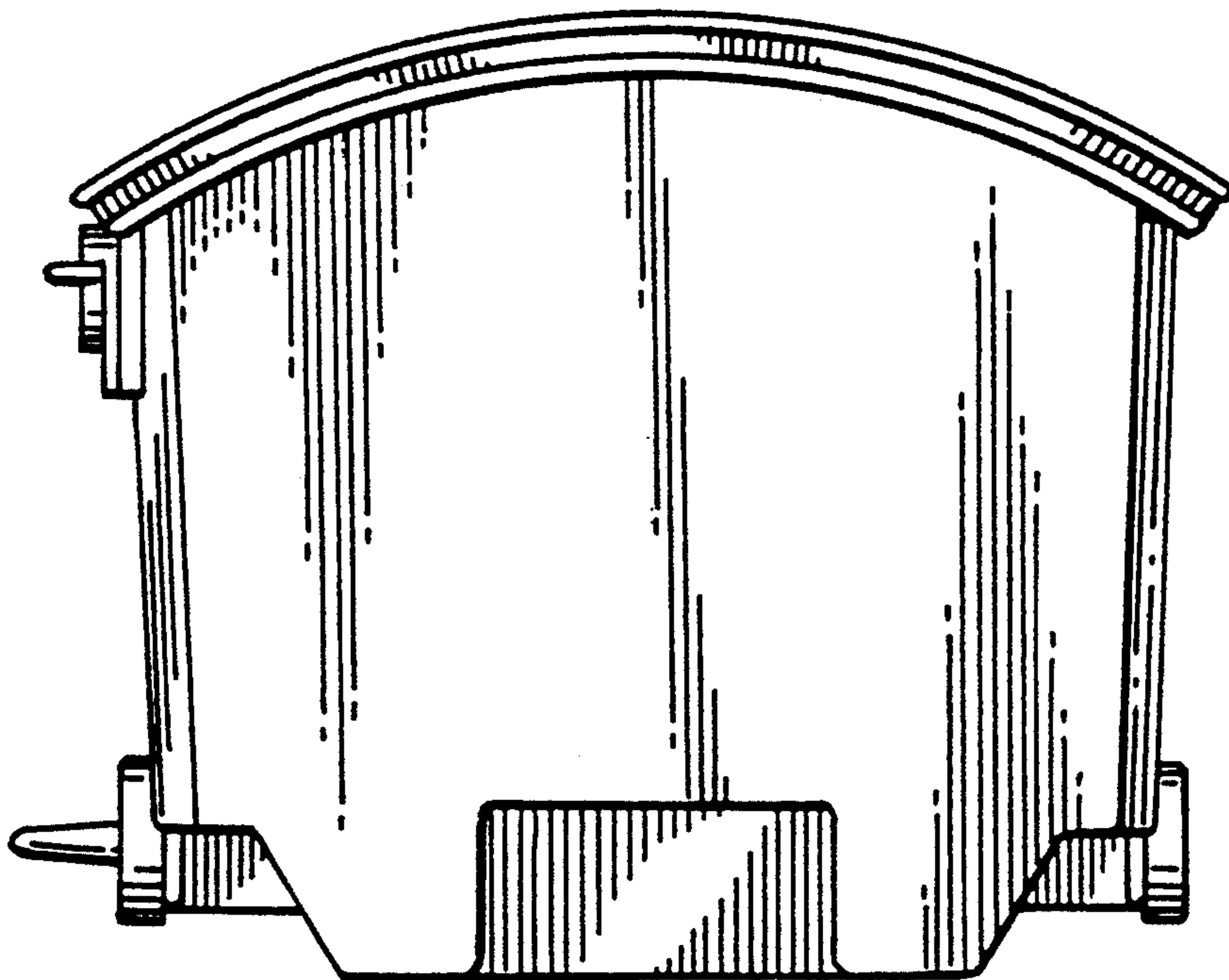
