FIG. 1 is a perspective view of my design for a foldable beach chair and accessory tote of the present invention, and illustrating the design in open position;




FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the foldable beach chair and accessory tote design in open position;


FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the design in open position;


FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the top portion of the design illustrated in FIG. 1 in open position;







