FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image.

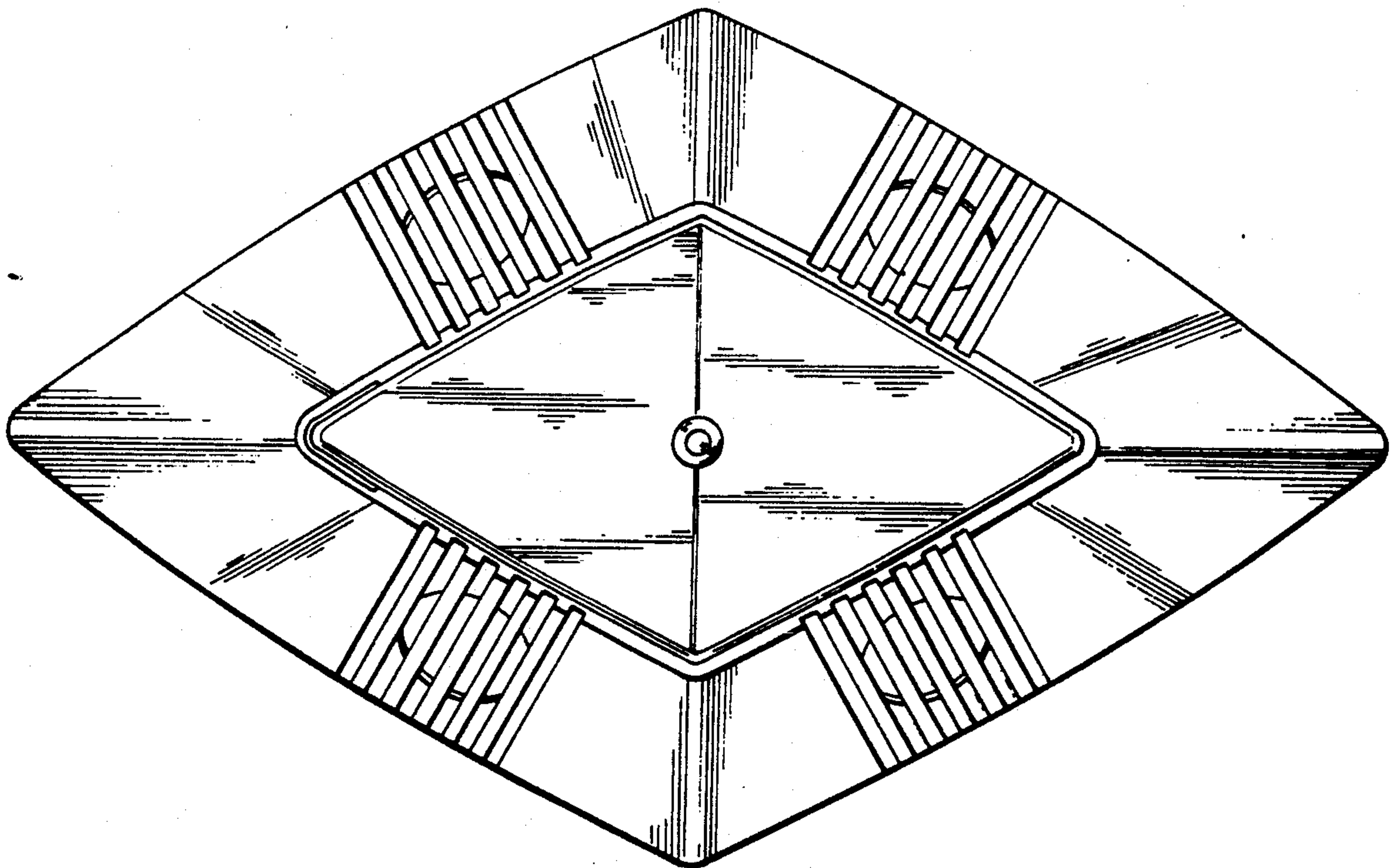

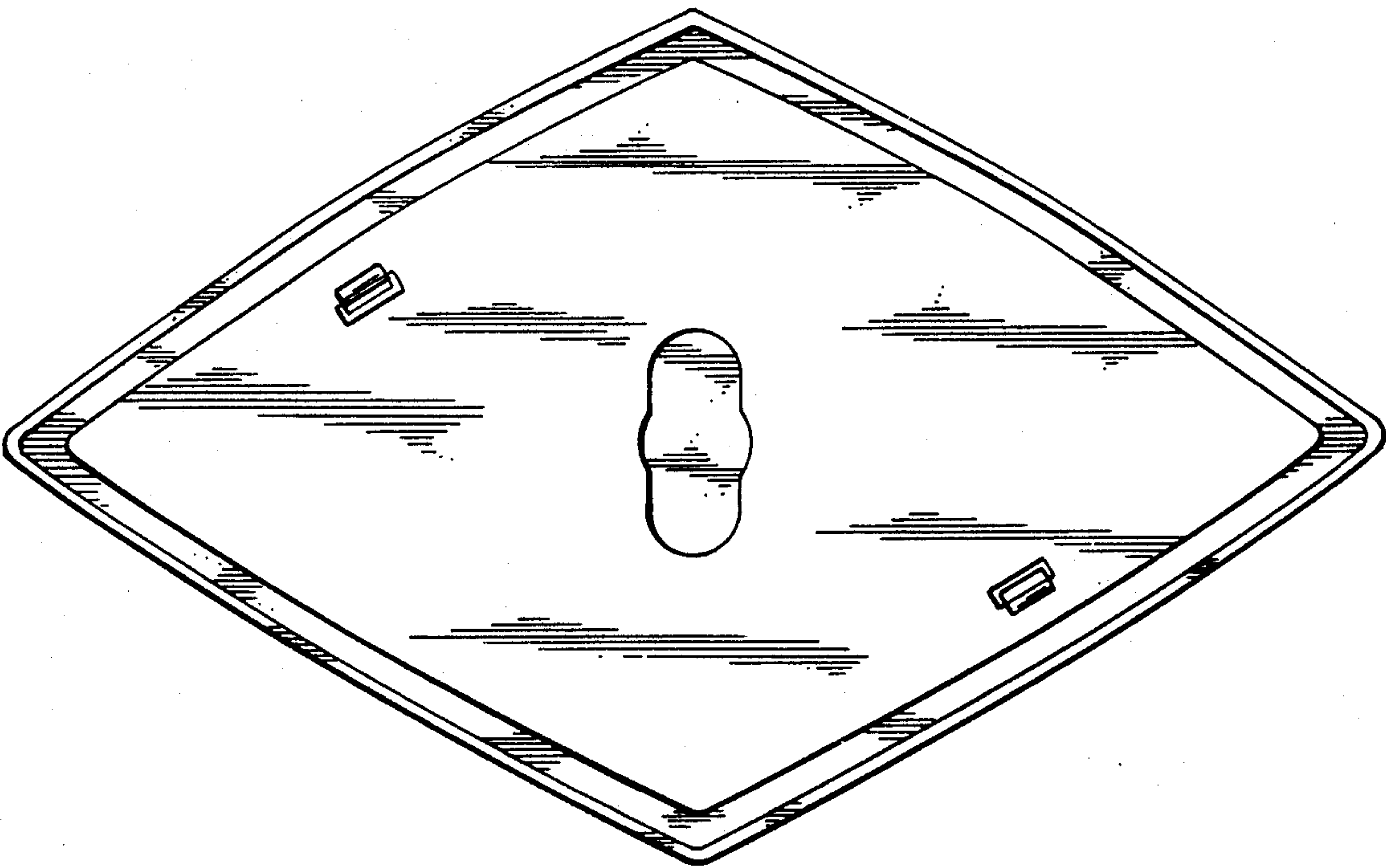
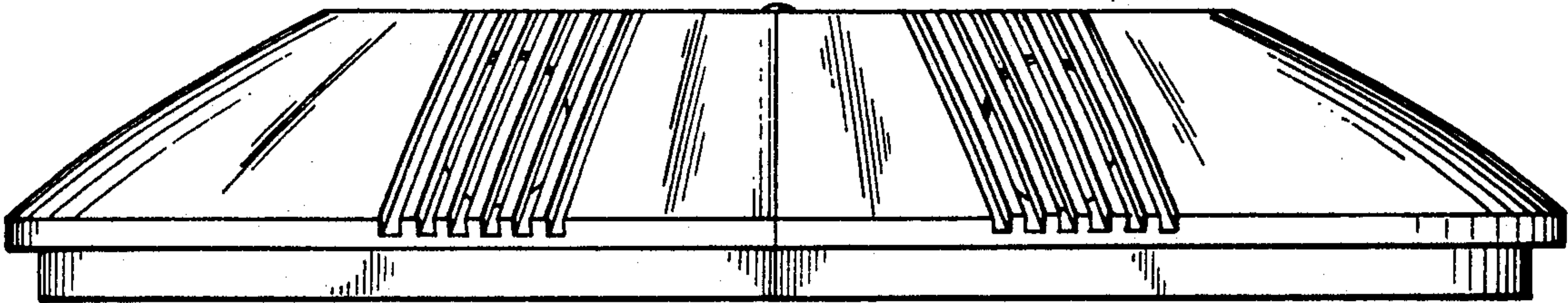

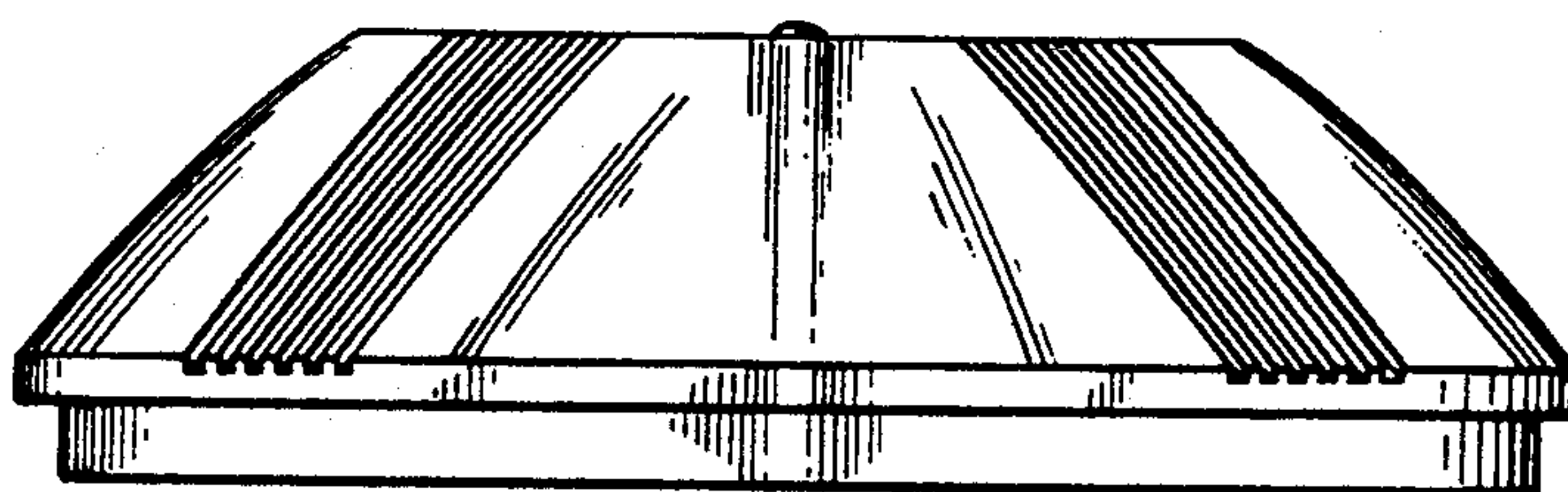
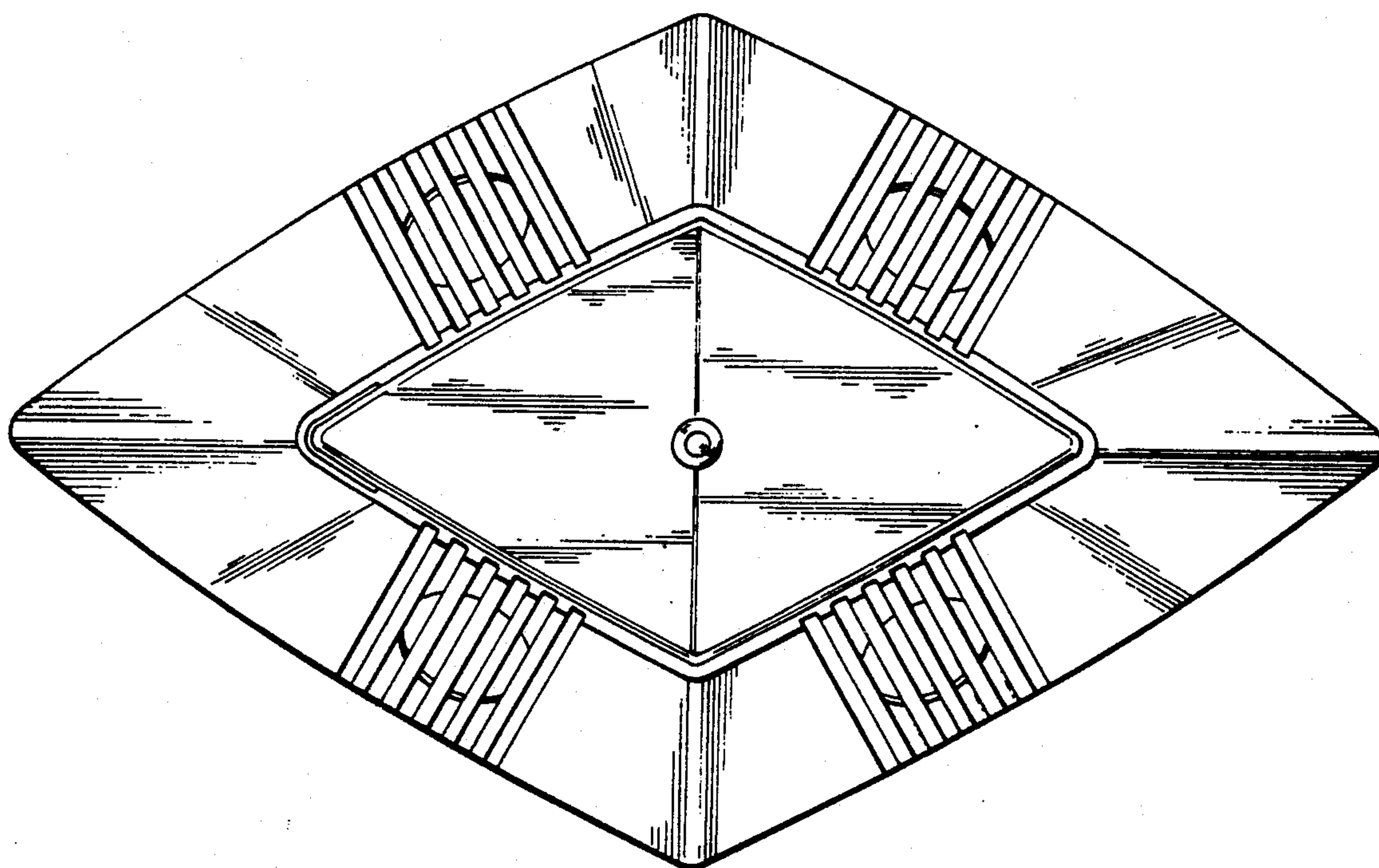
