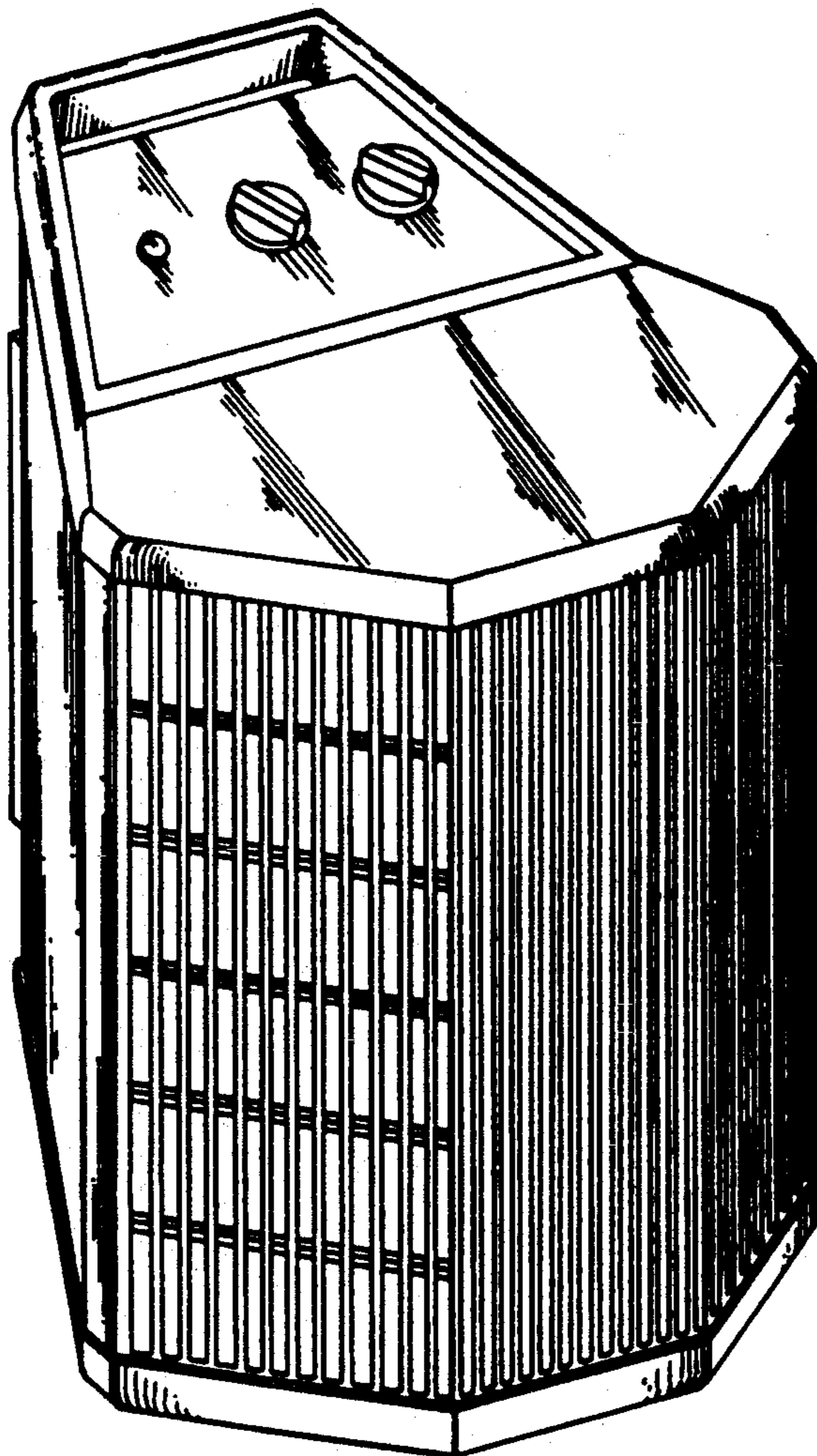

The ornamental design for a heater fan, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a heater fan showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of that shown.



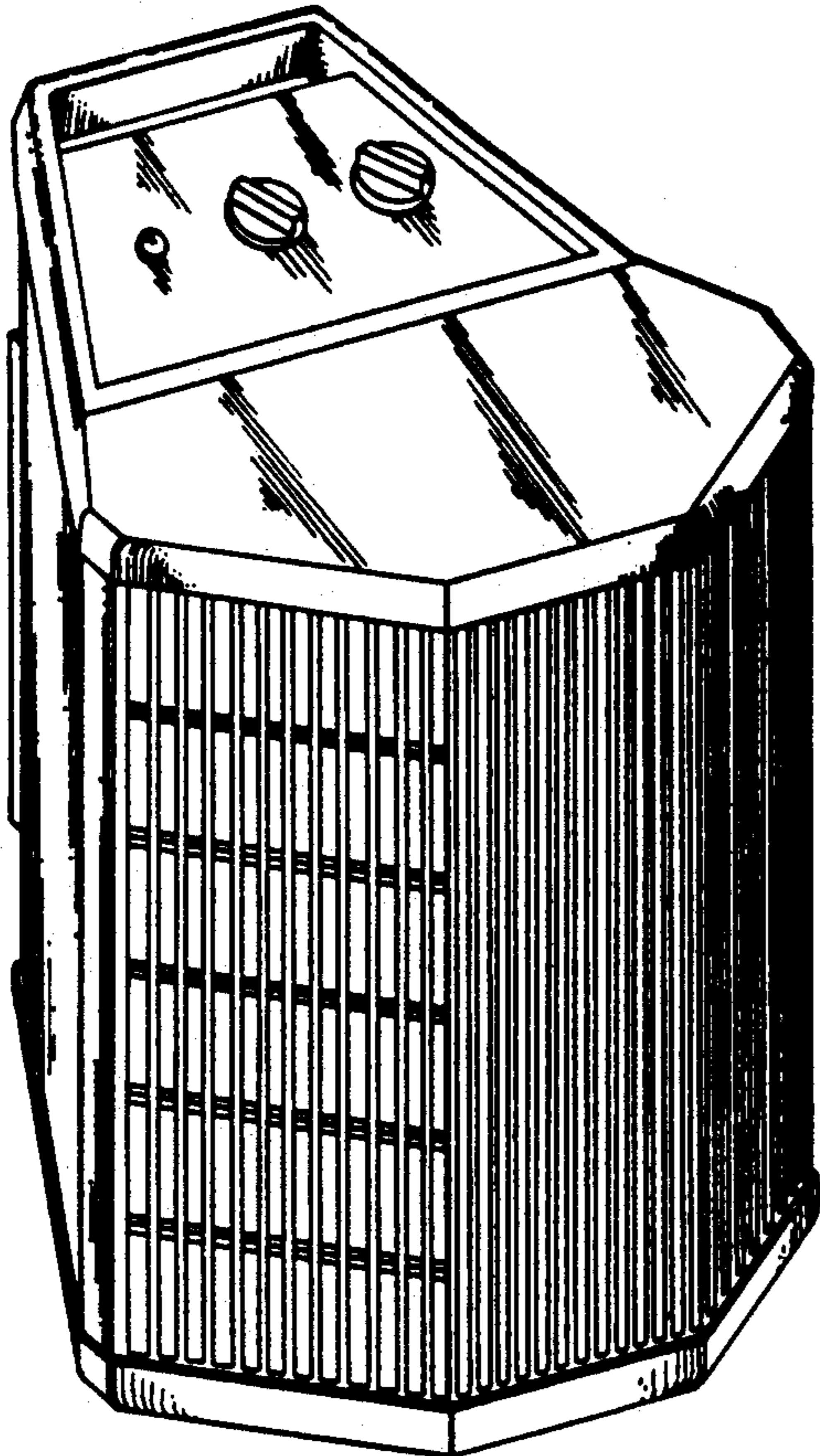

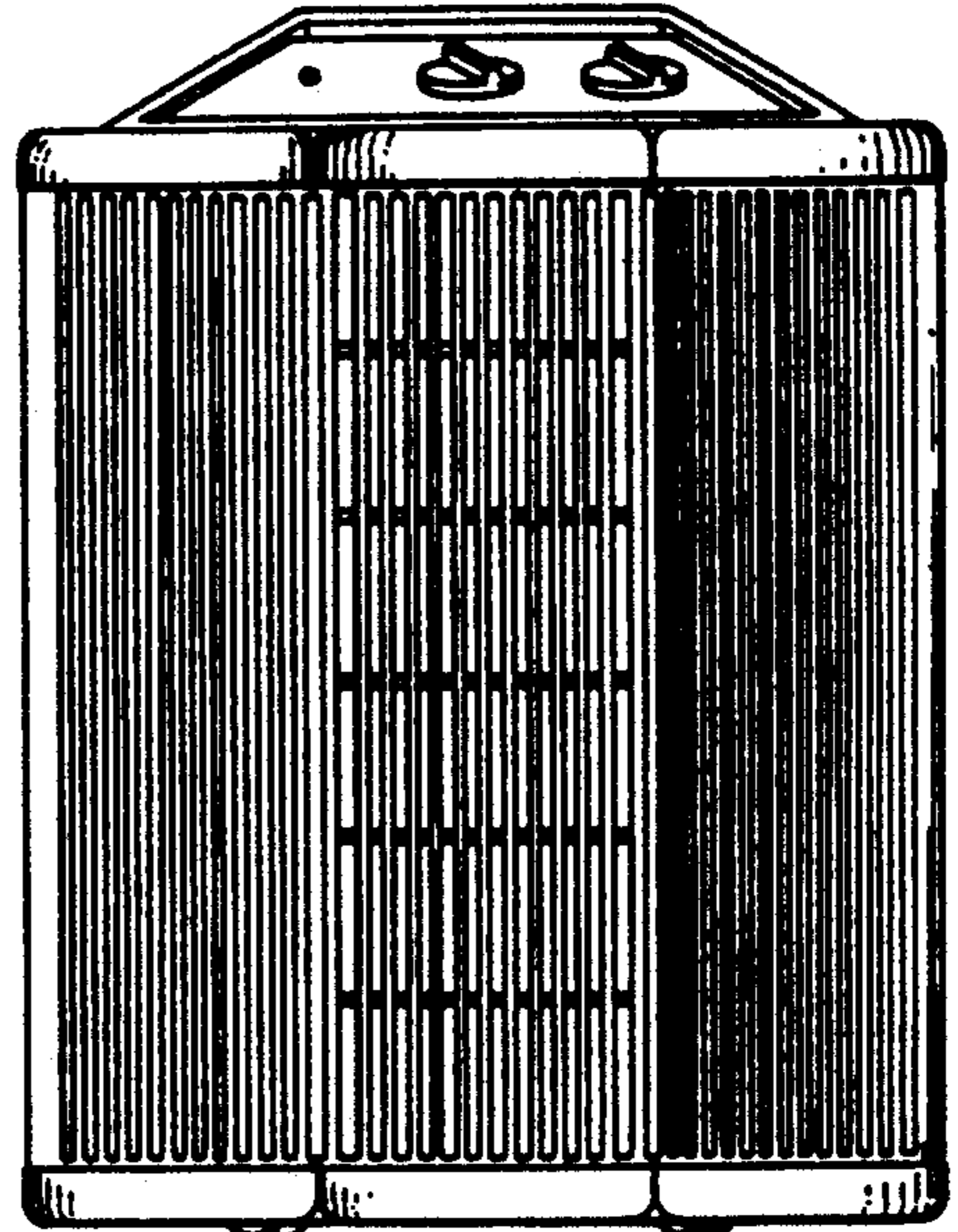

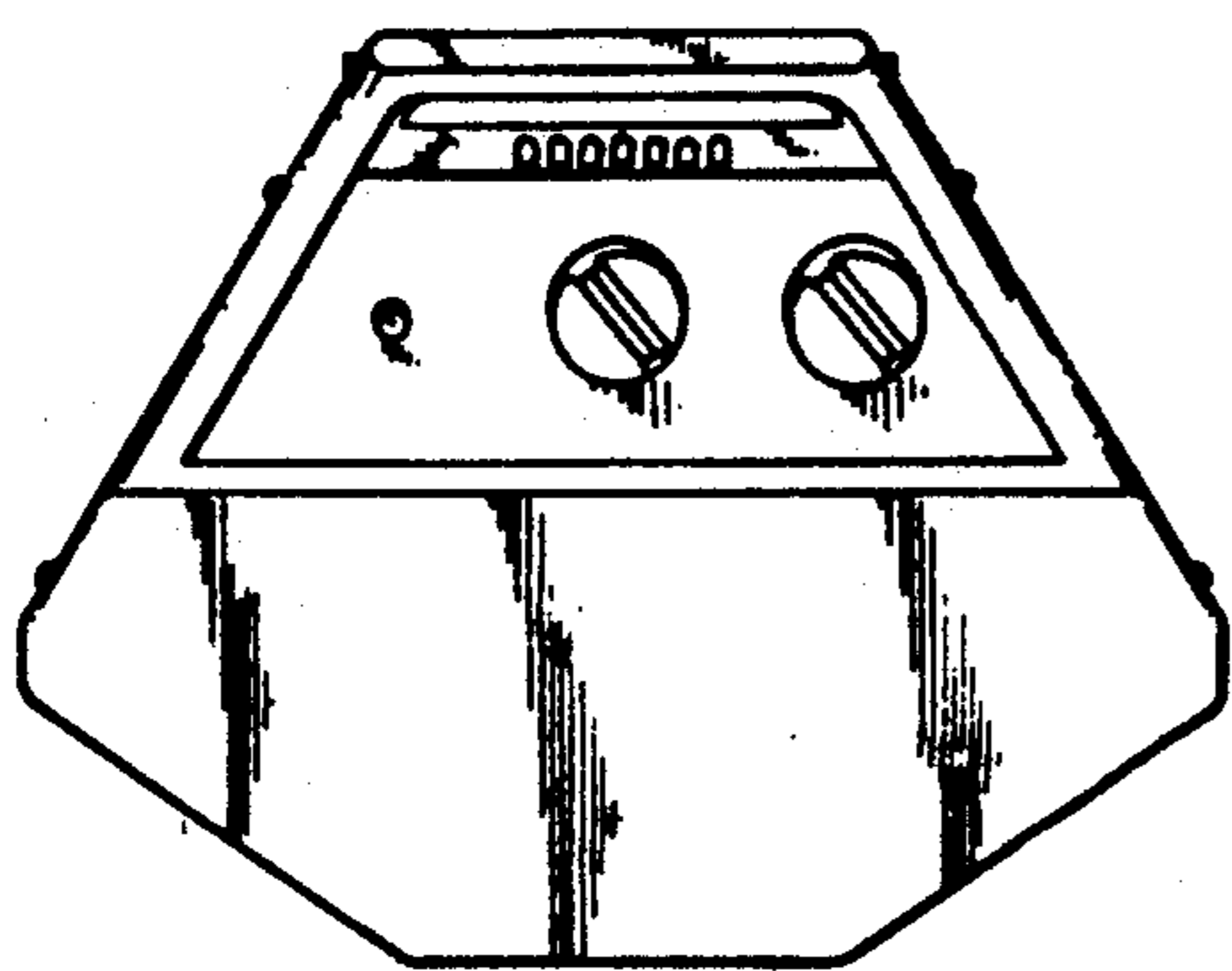

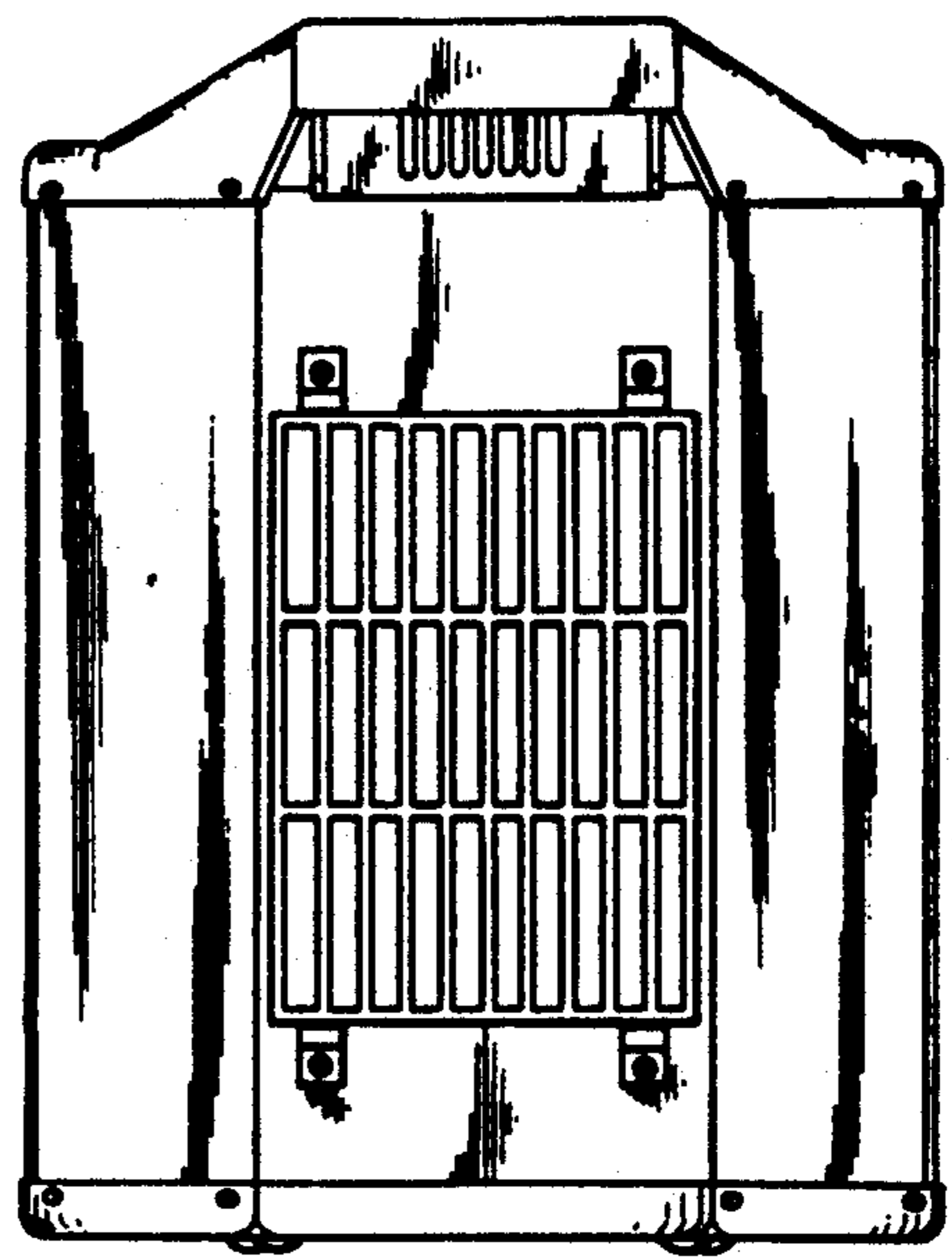

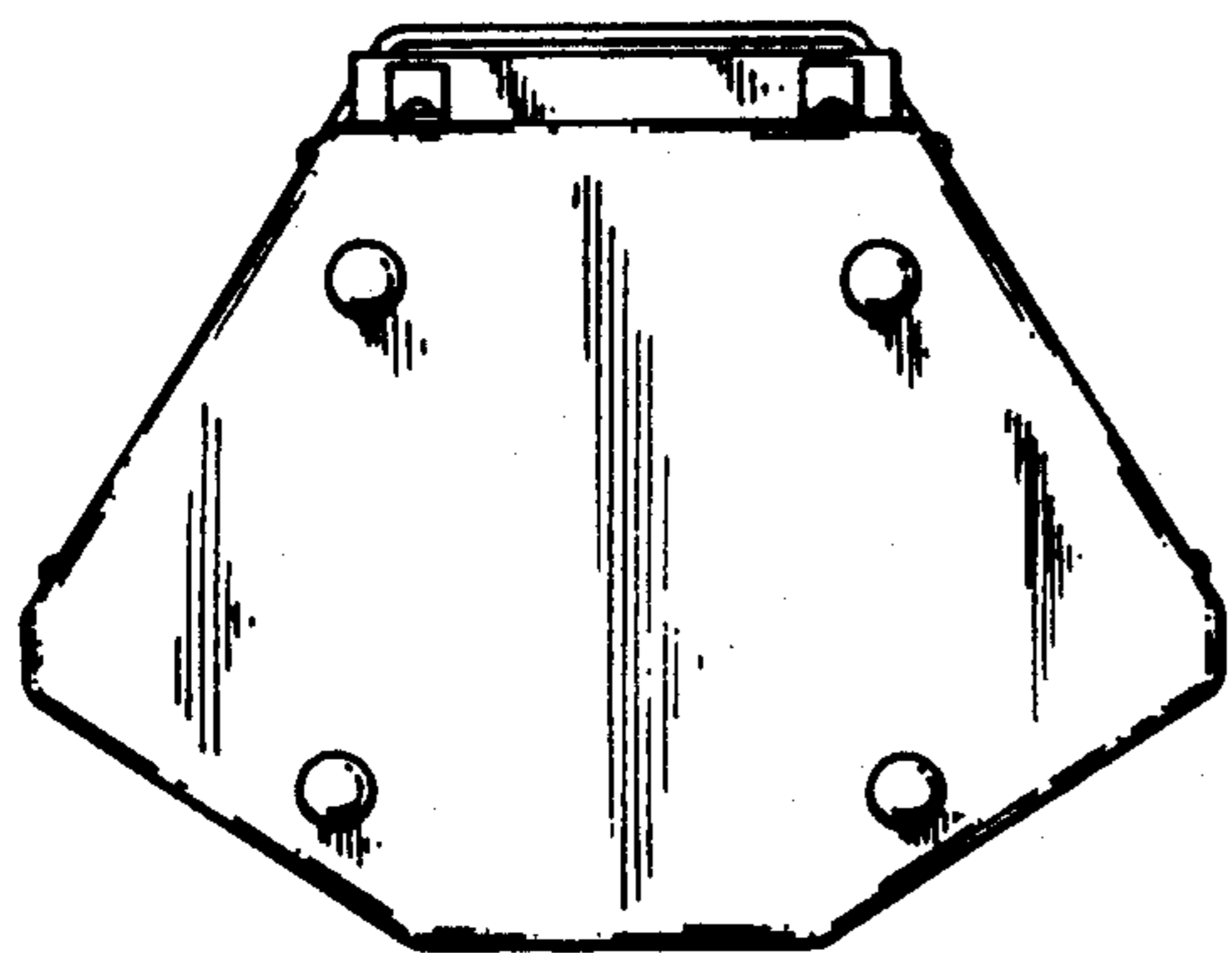

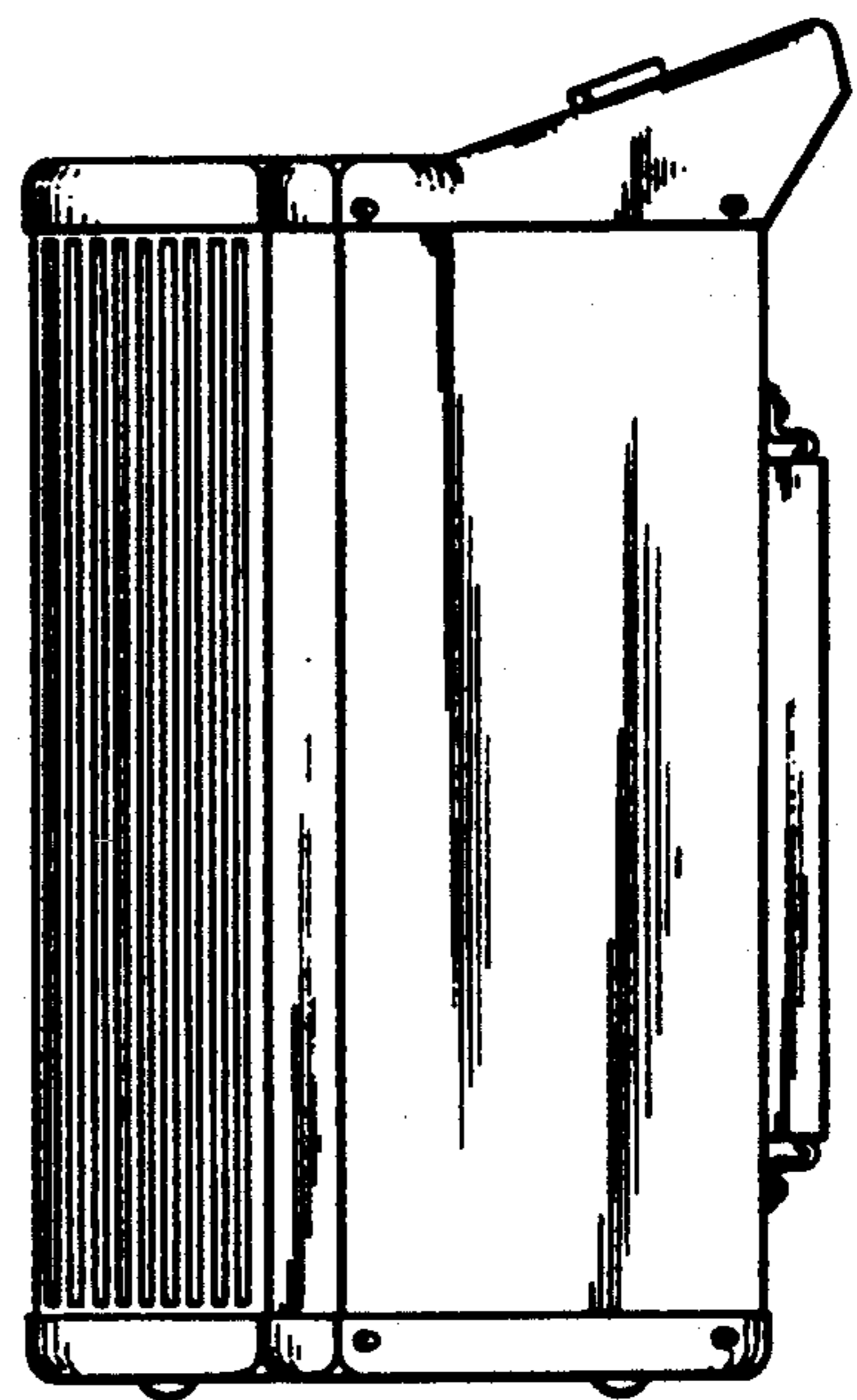
