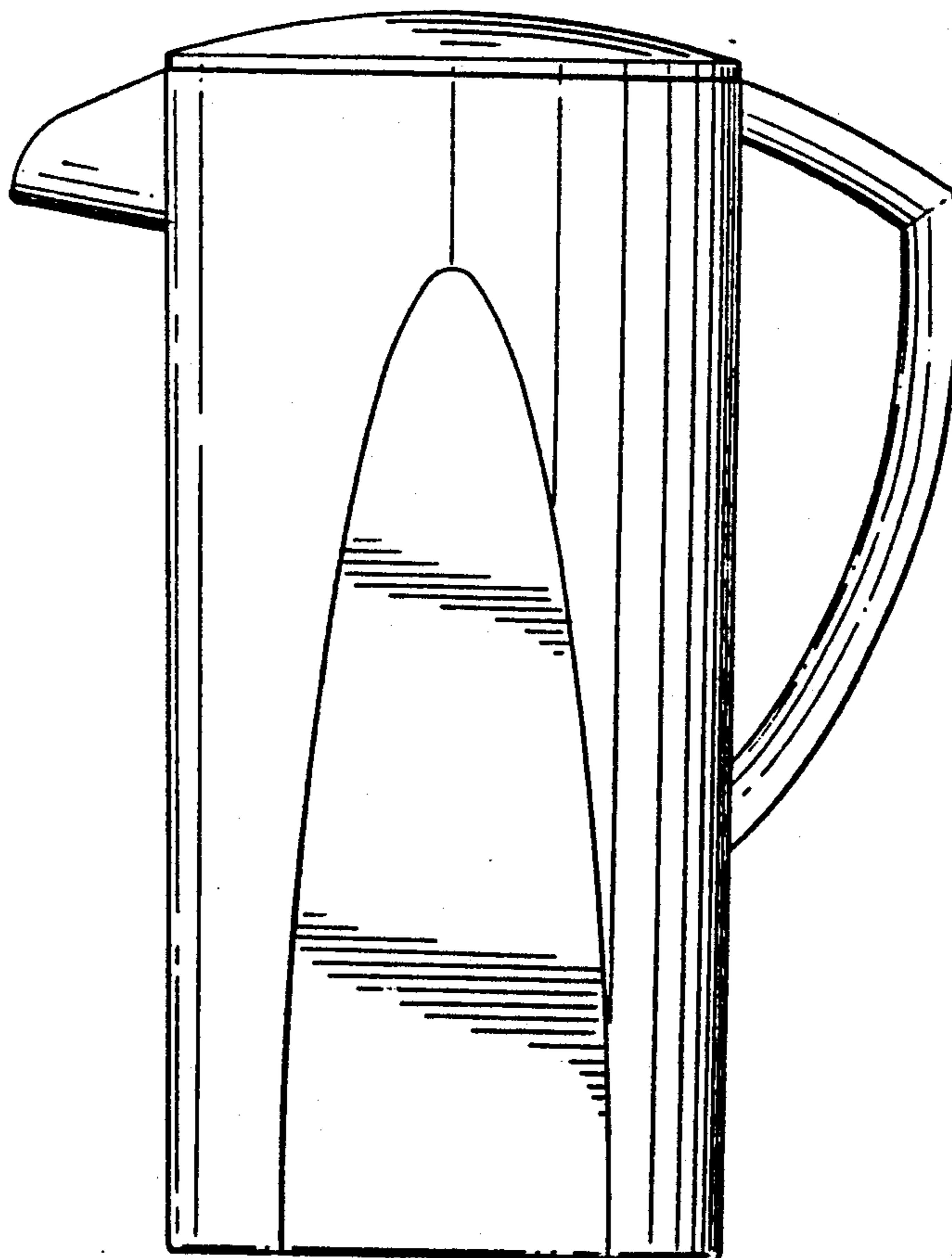

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the pitcher; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the pitcher; FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the pitcher; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the pitcher; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the pitcher.



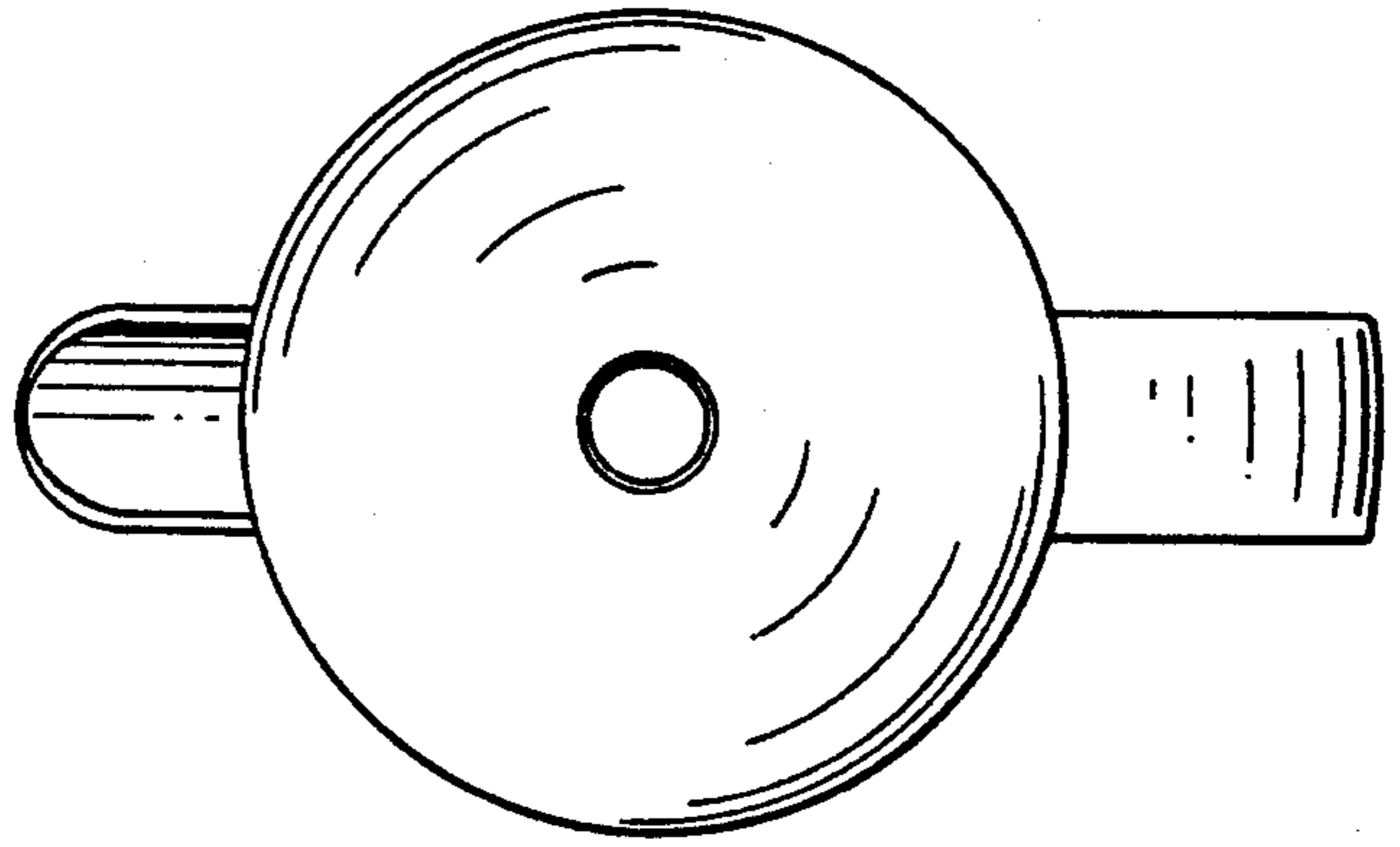

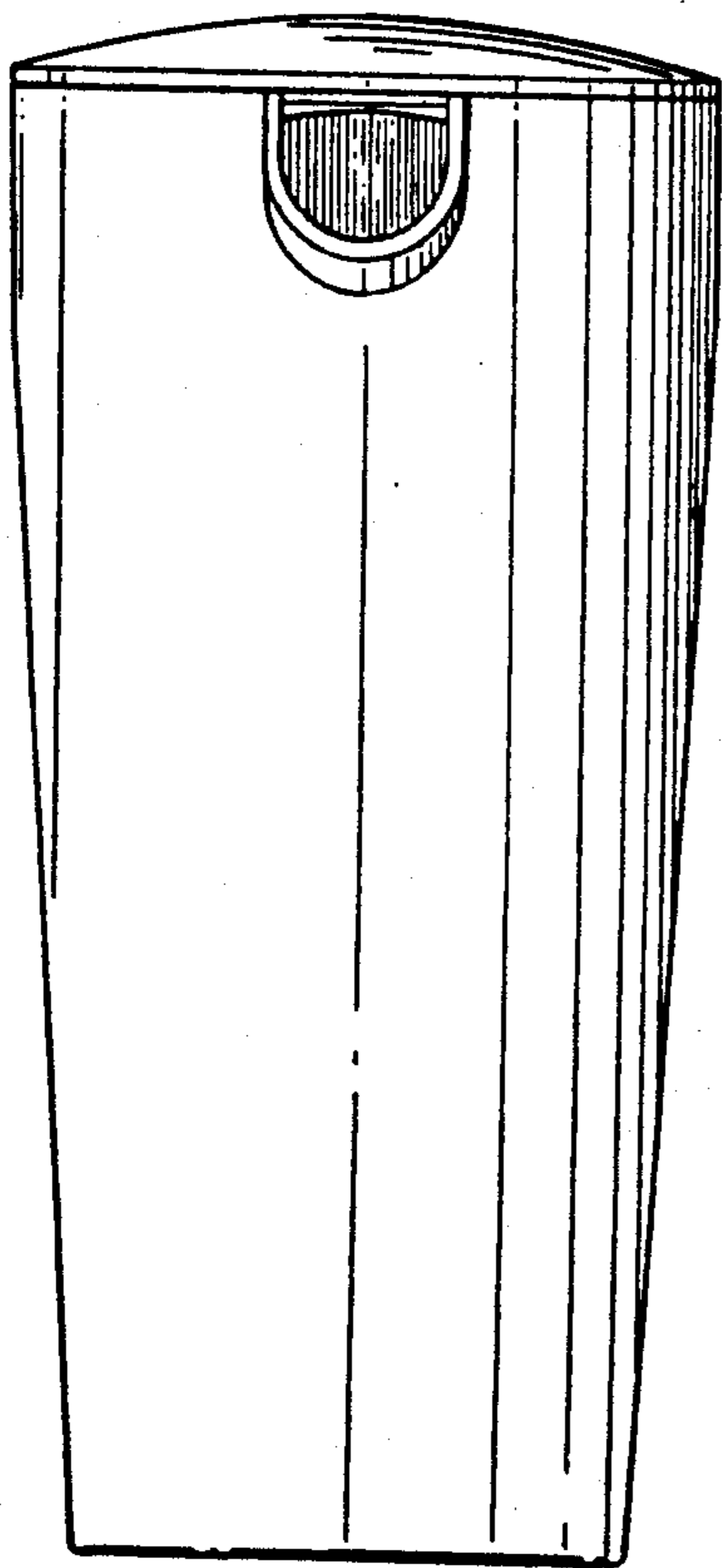

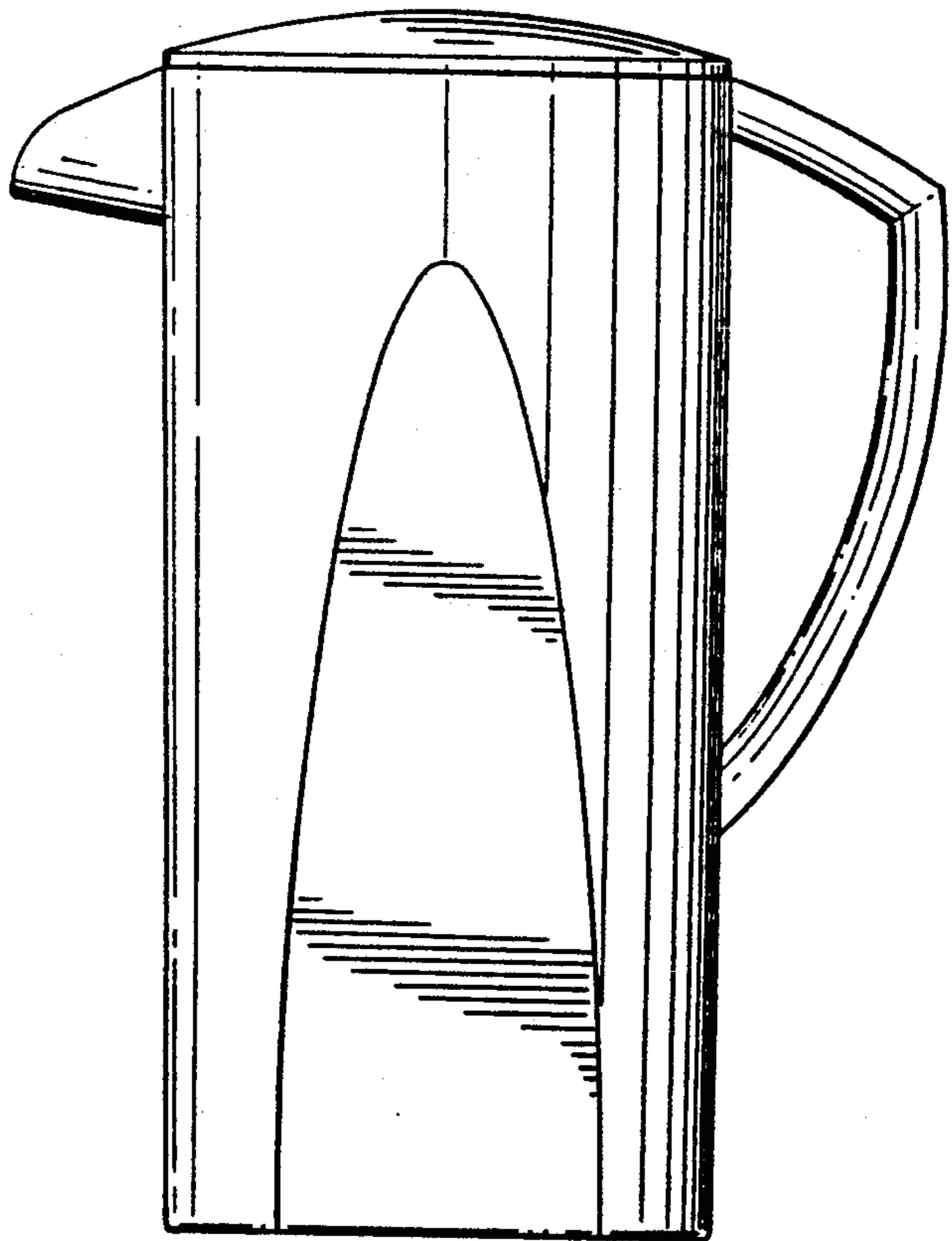

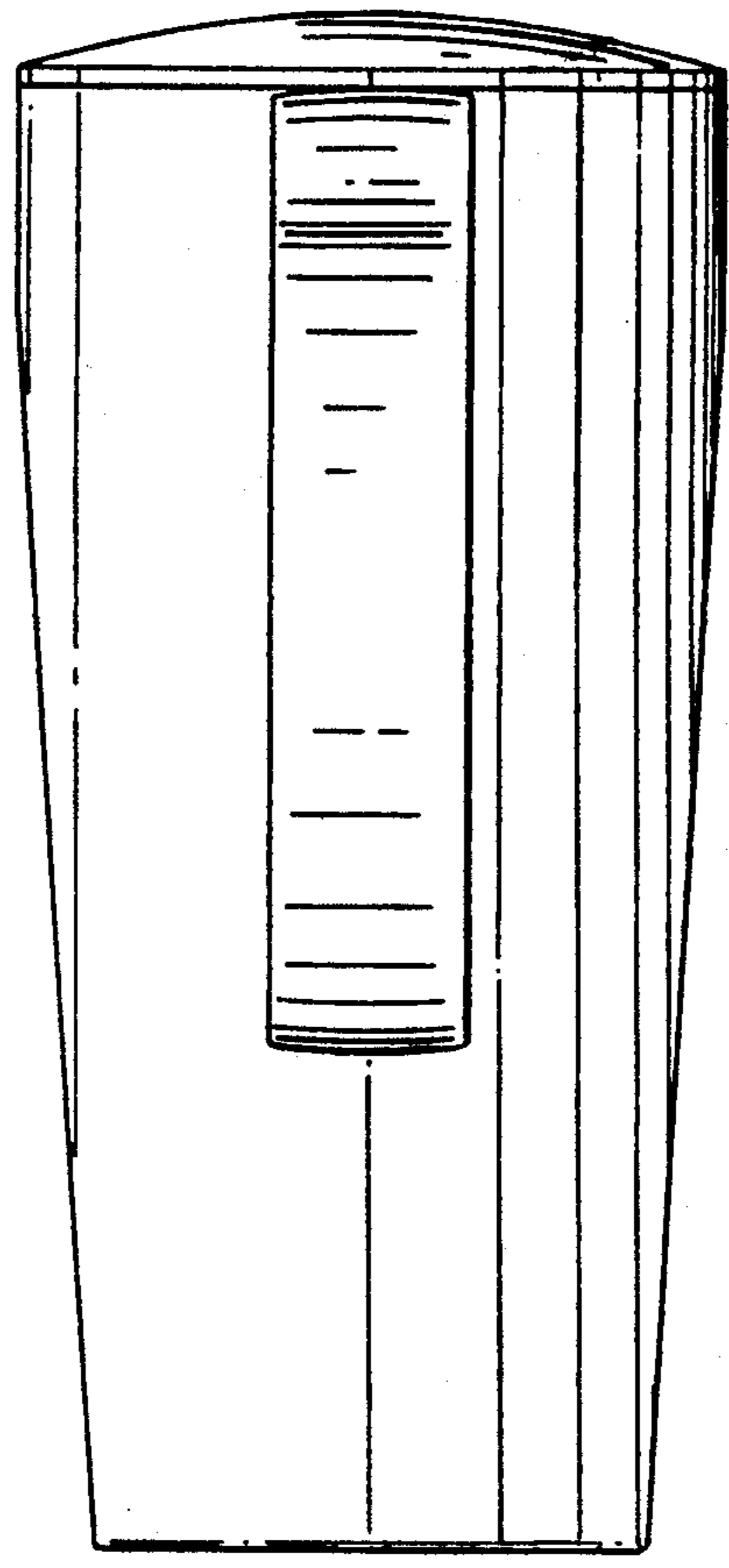

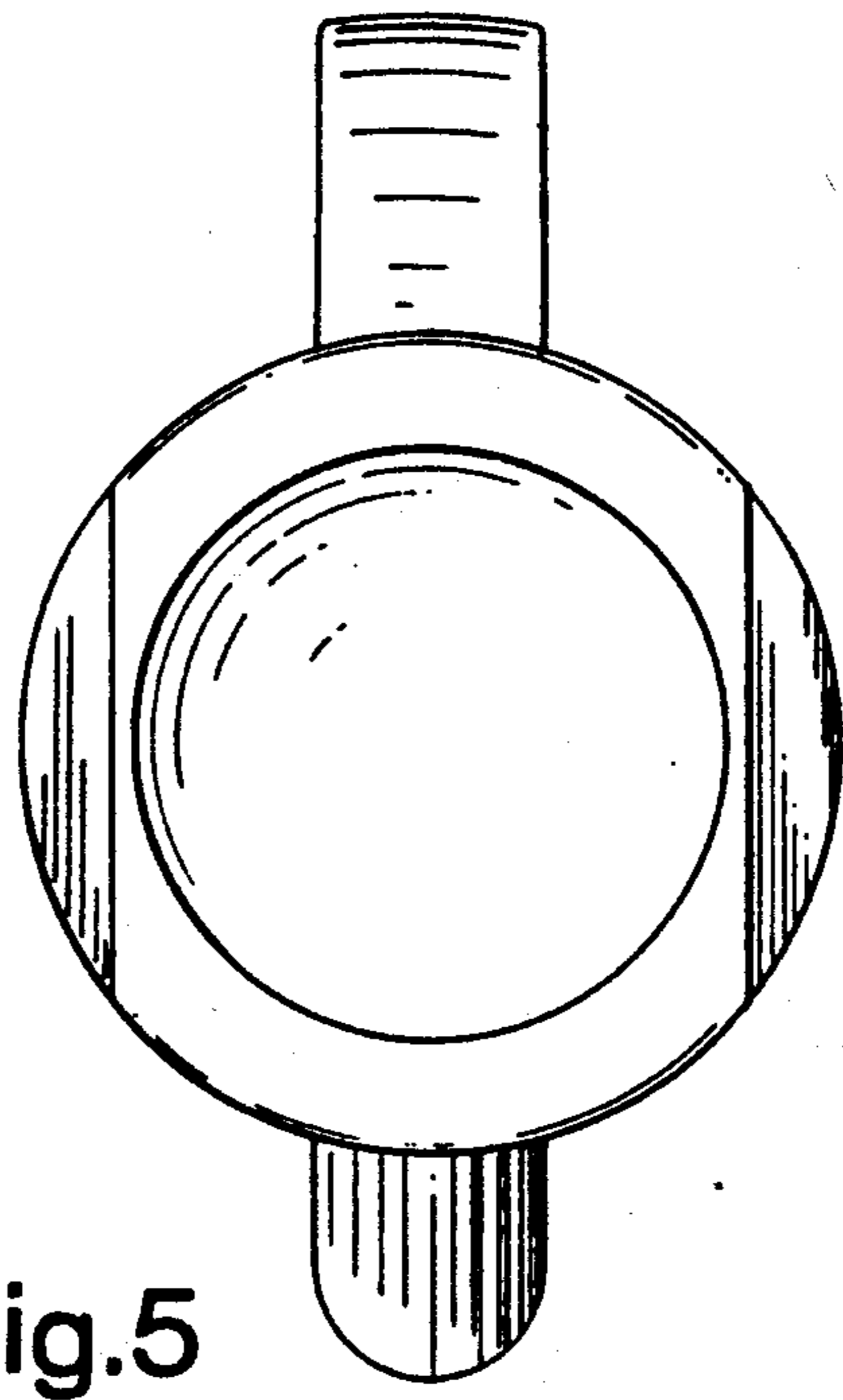
