[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shackle for a yacht toerail, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shackle for a yacht toerail showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof with the opposite side thereof being a mirror image thereof.

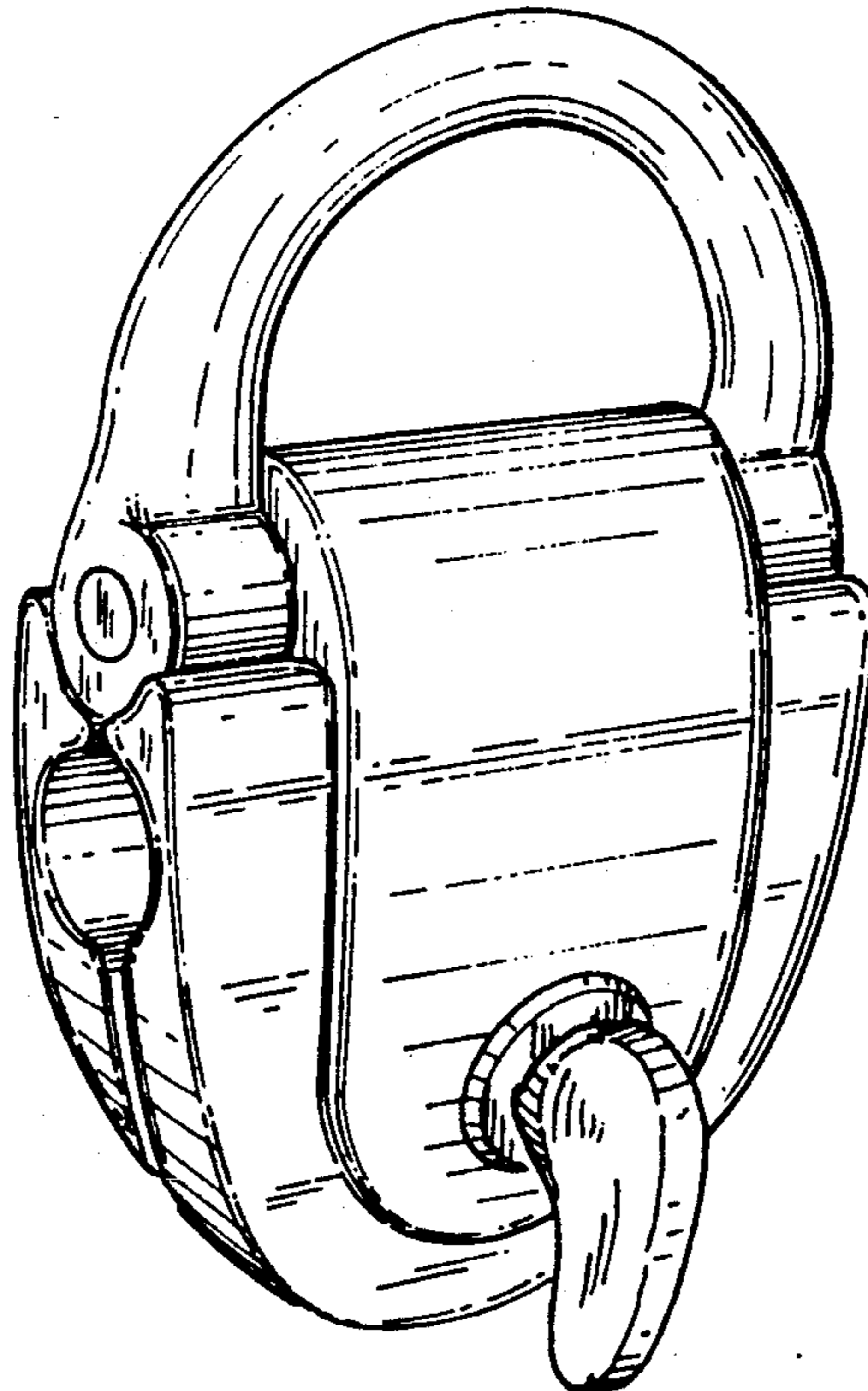

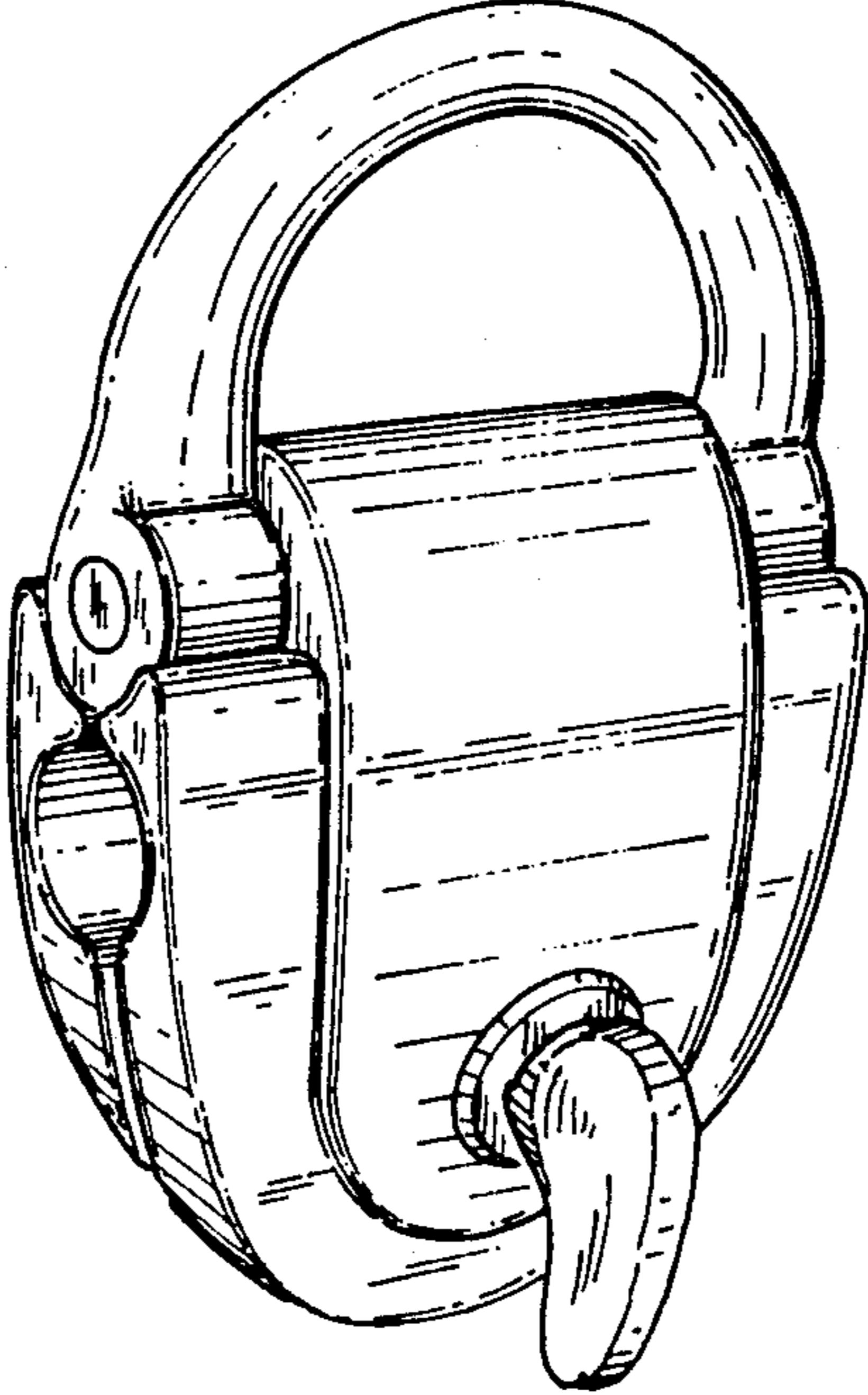

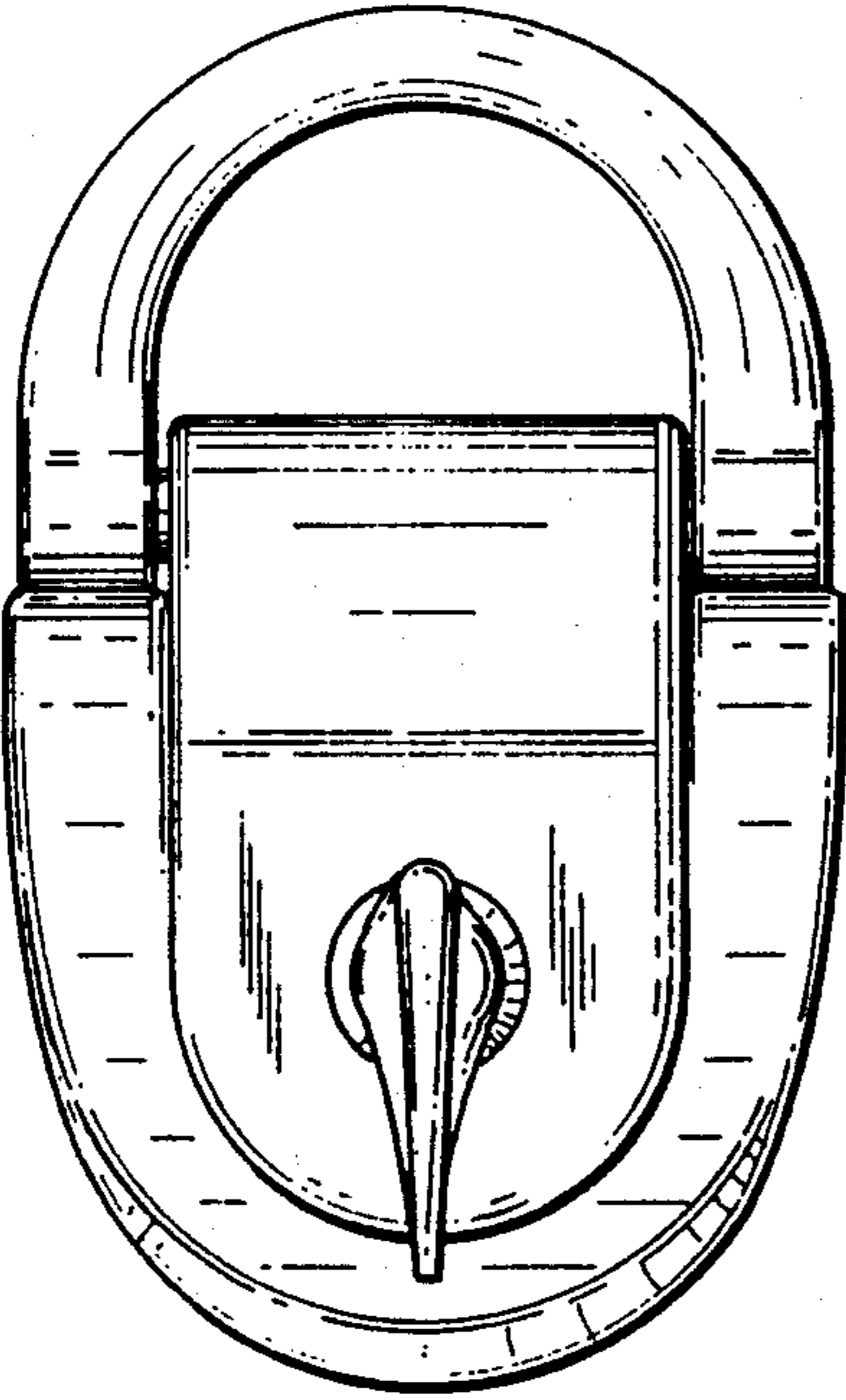
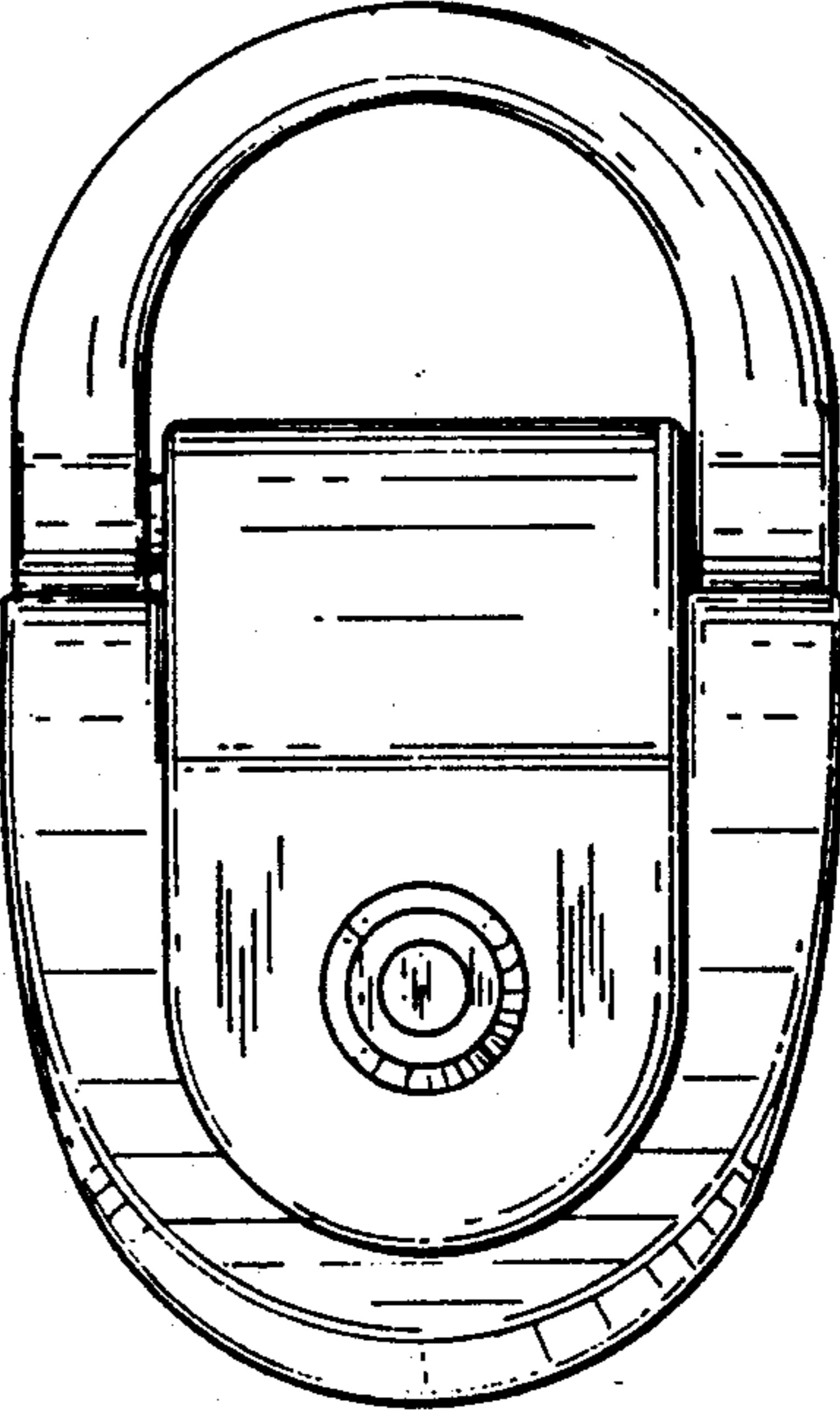

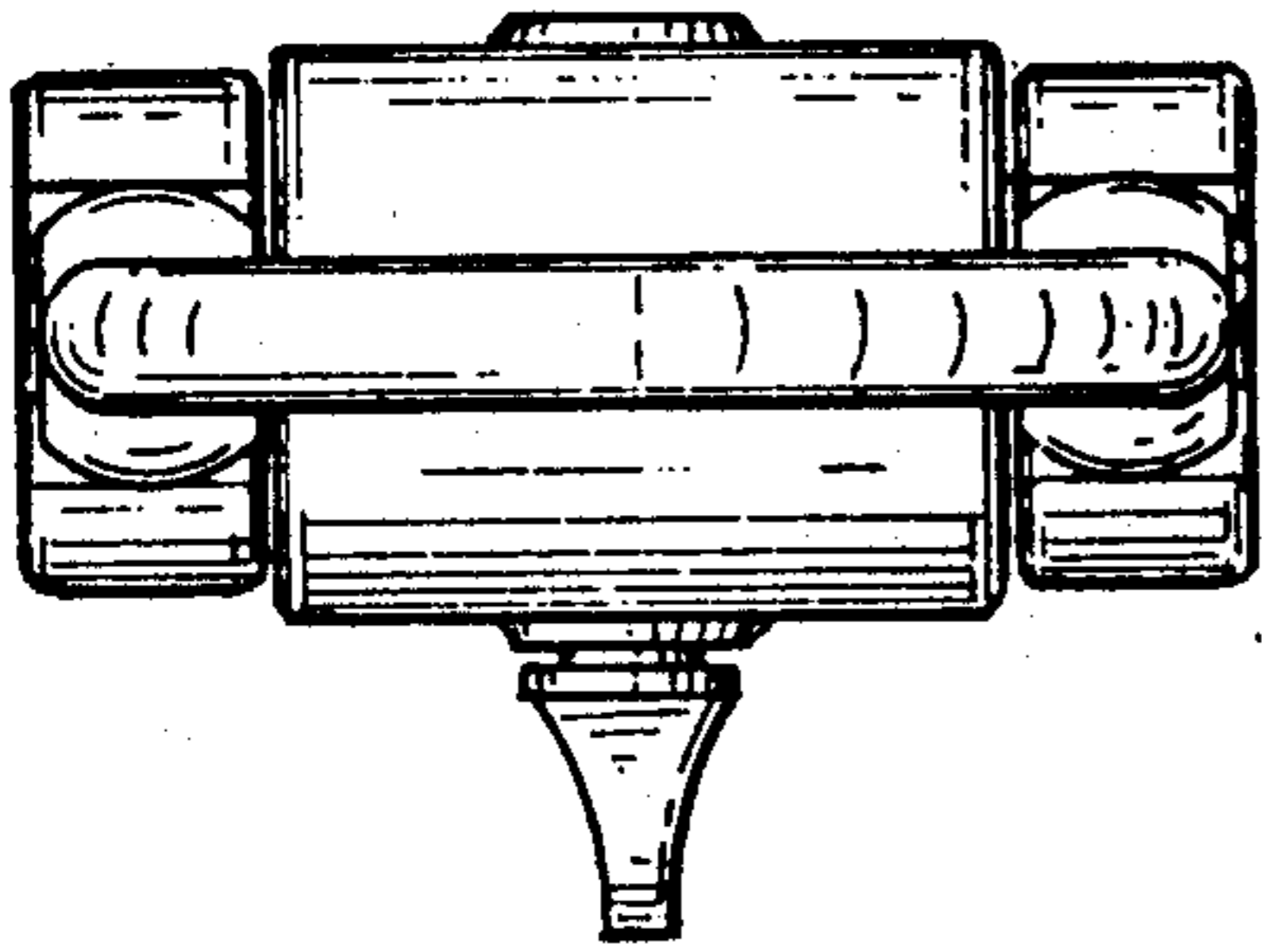

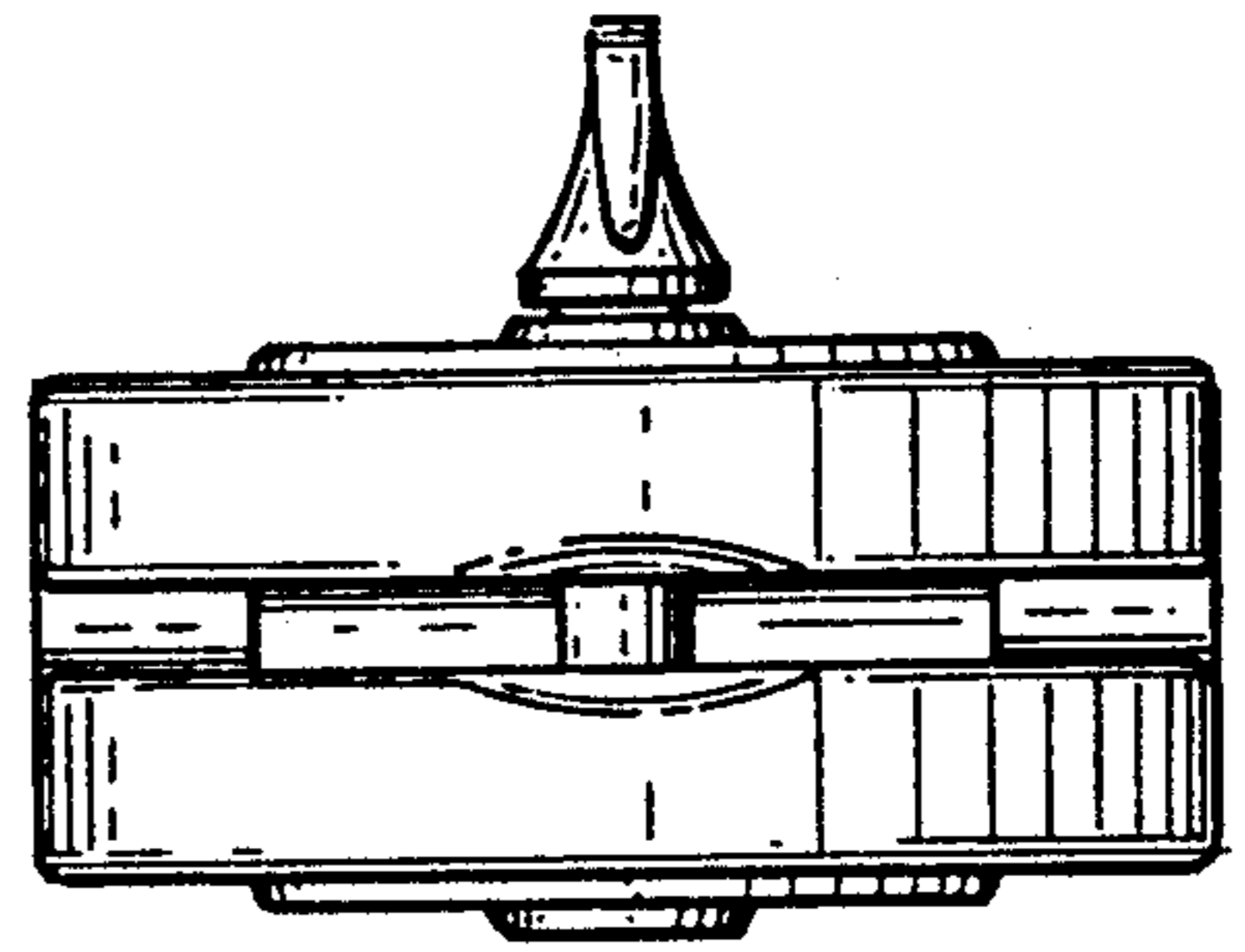

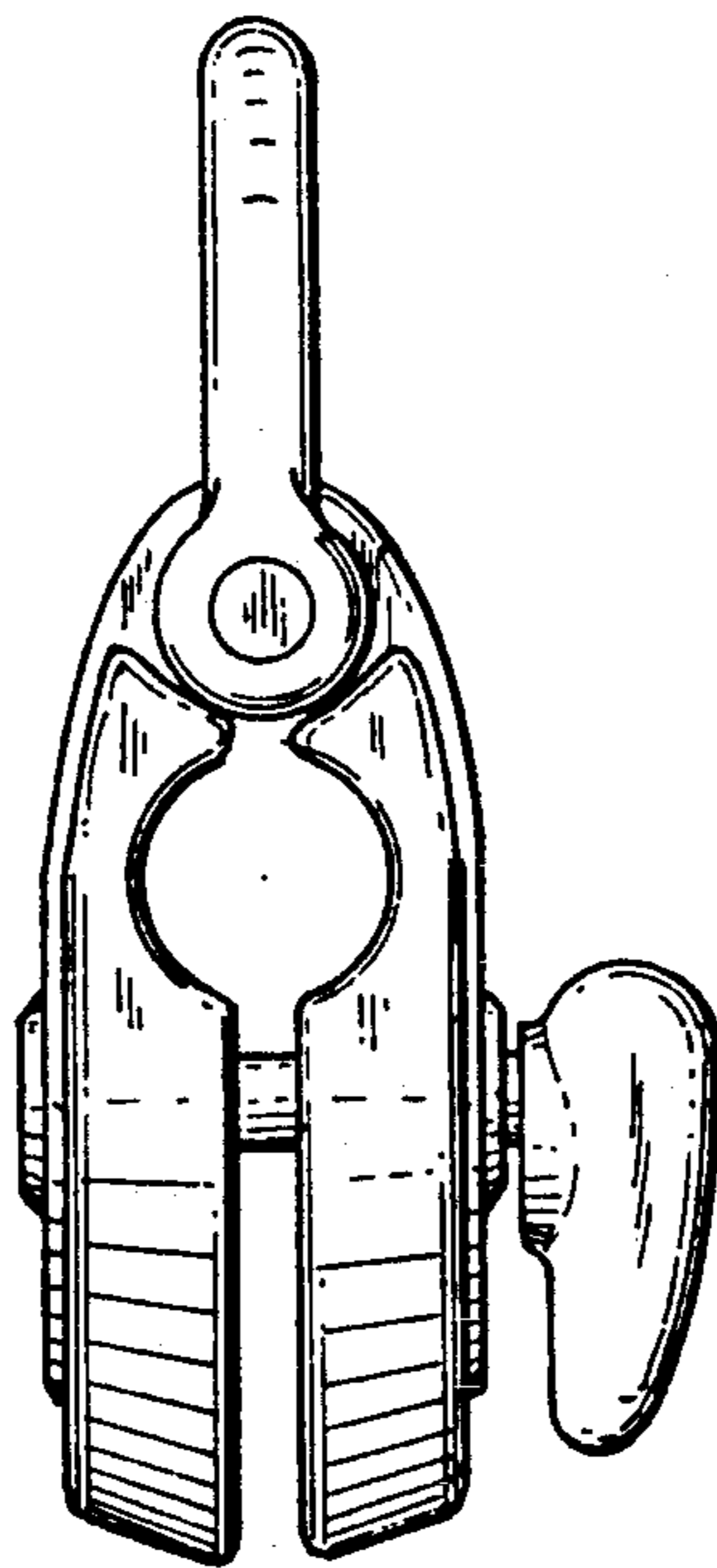
