FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a reflective pet toy showing my new design;

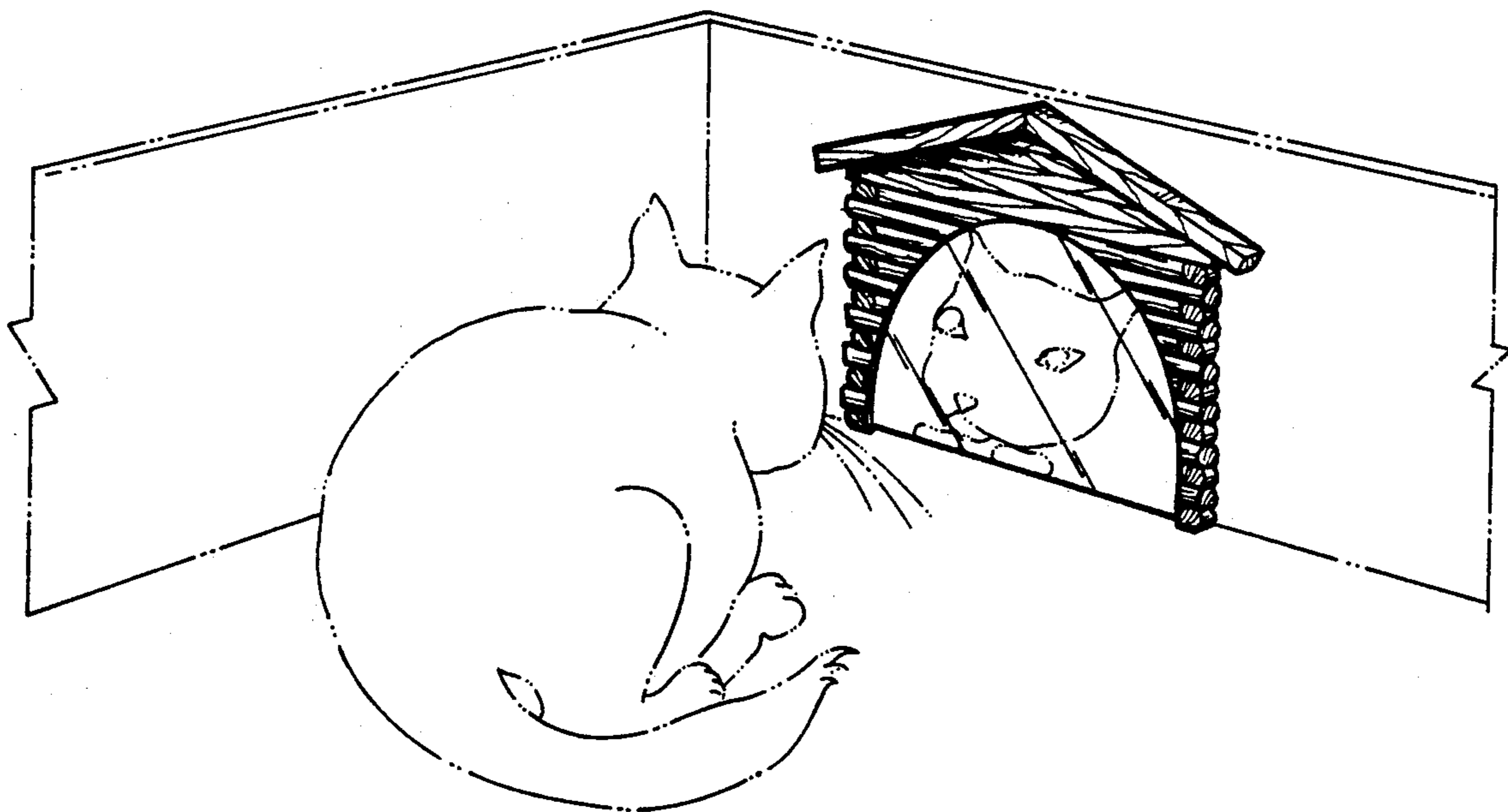
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being identical;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof, the broken lines are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.



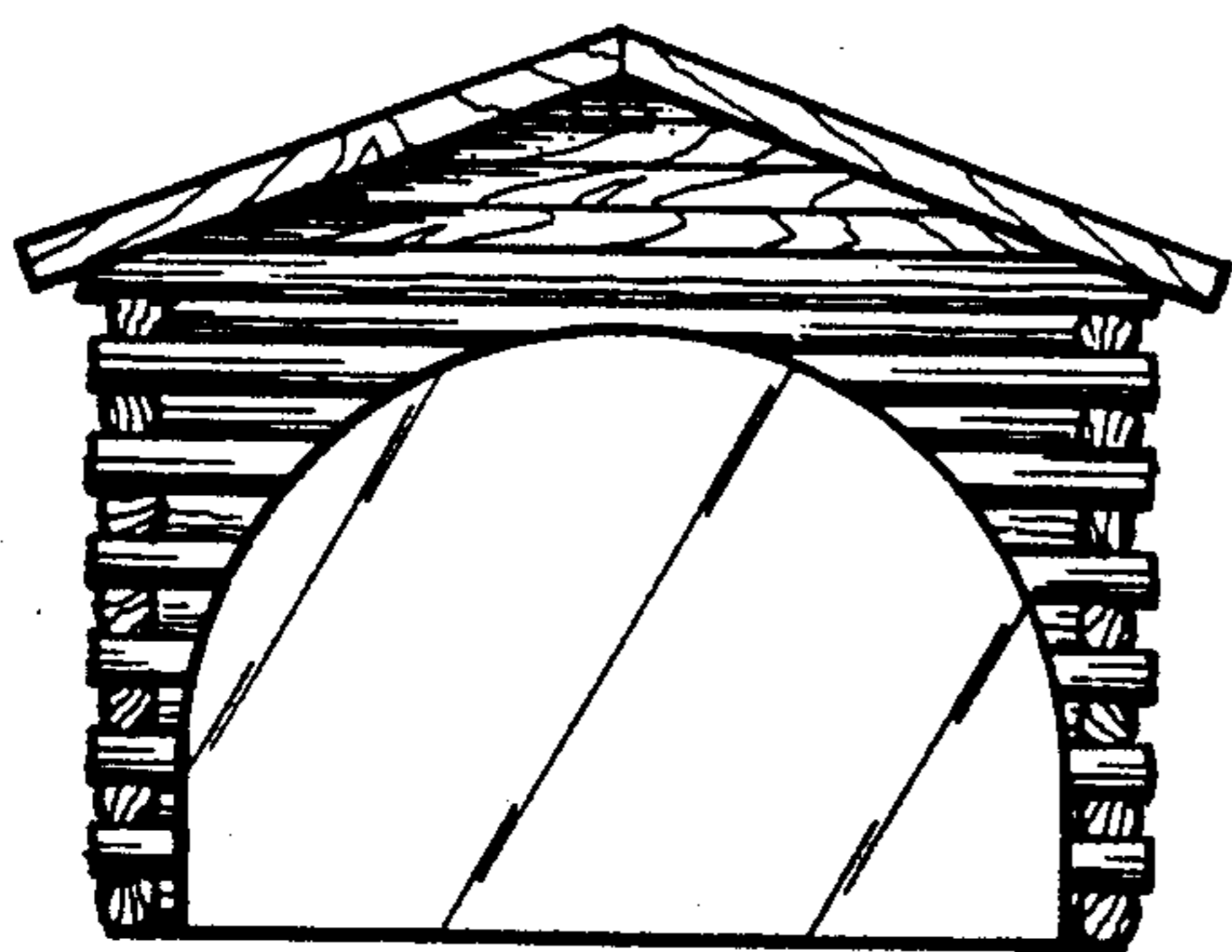

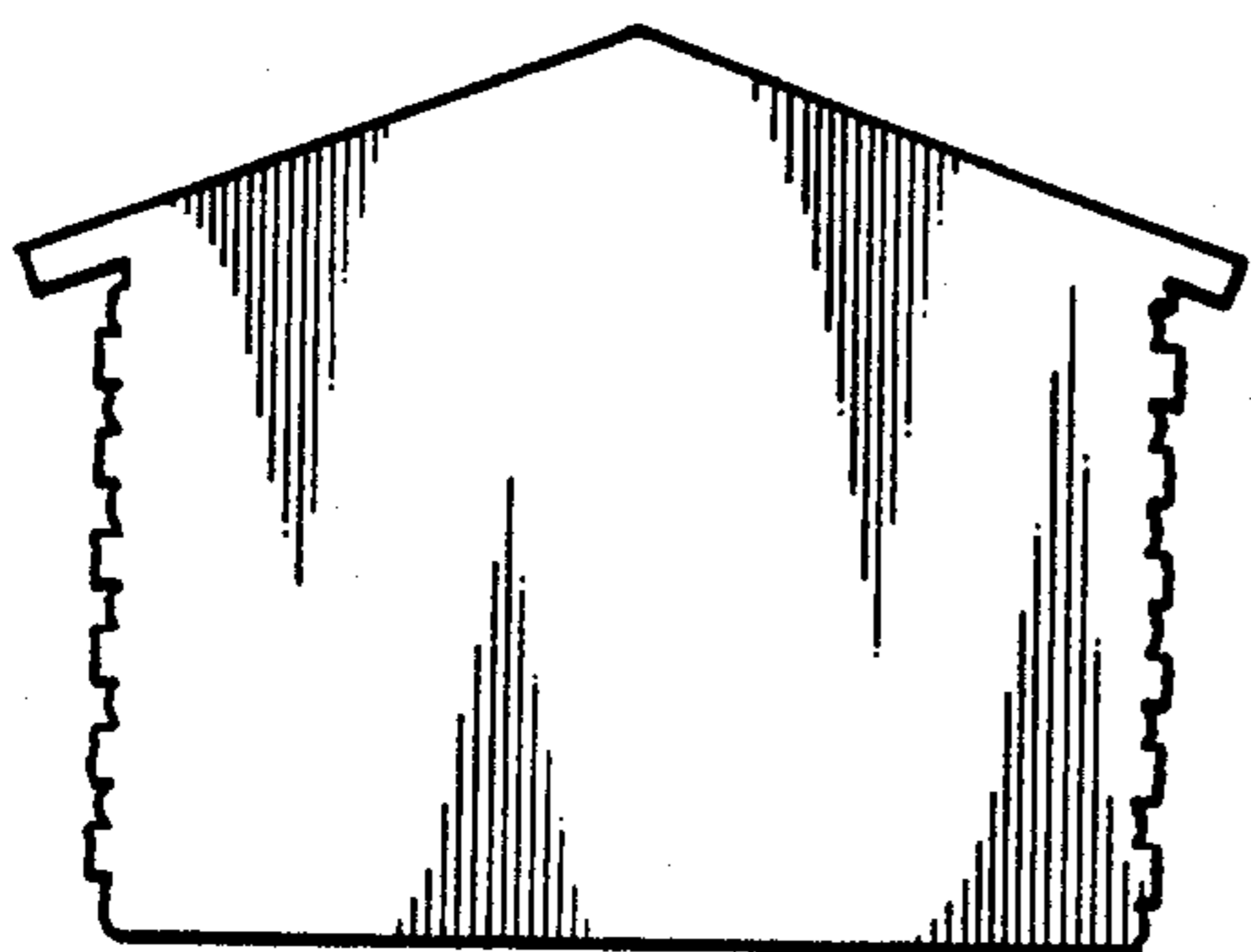

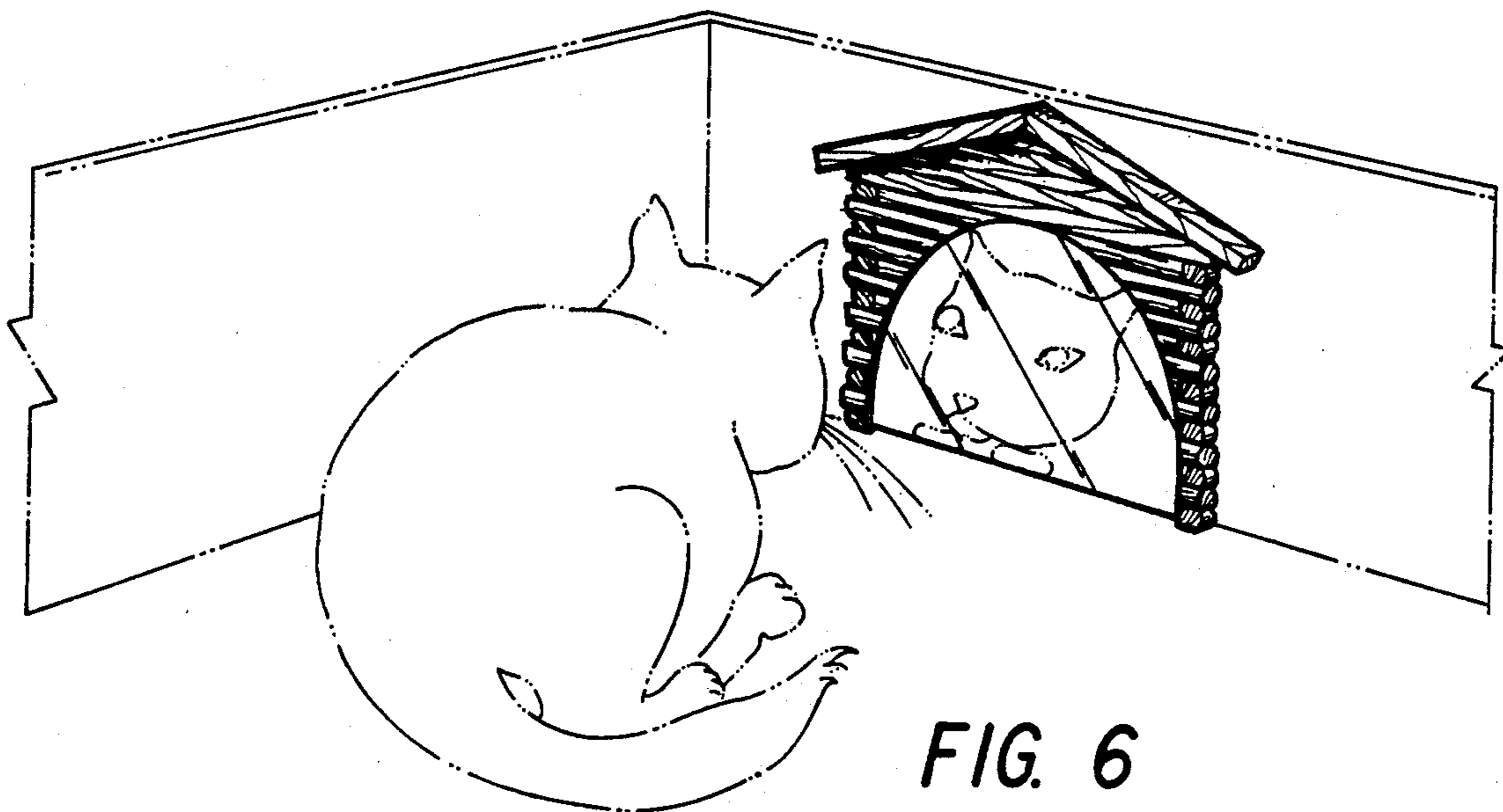
