DESCRIPTION

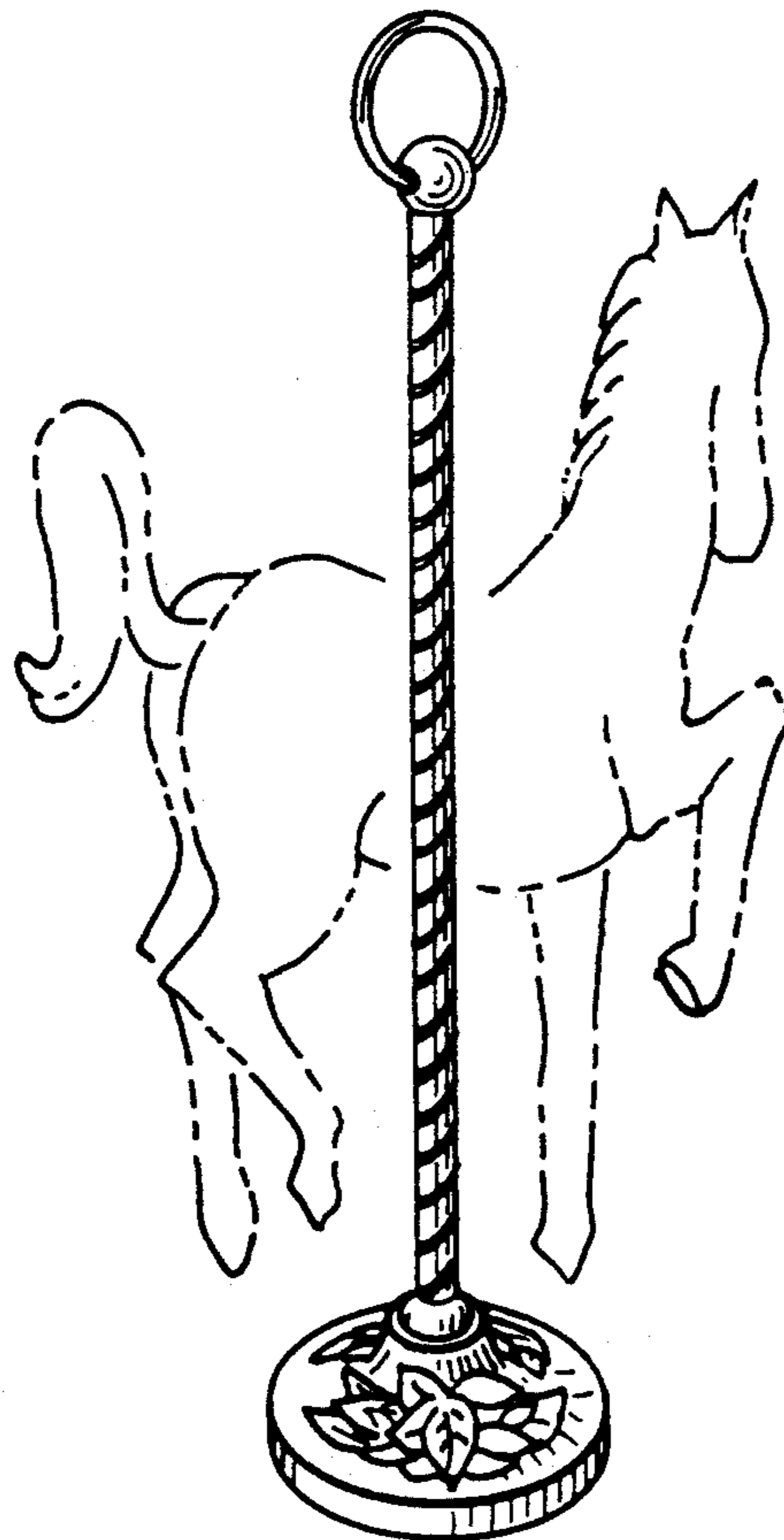
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stand for miniature horses showing my new design, the horse shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged bottom view thereof.



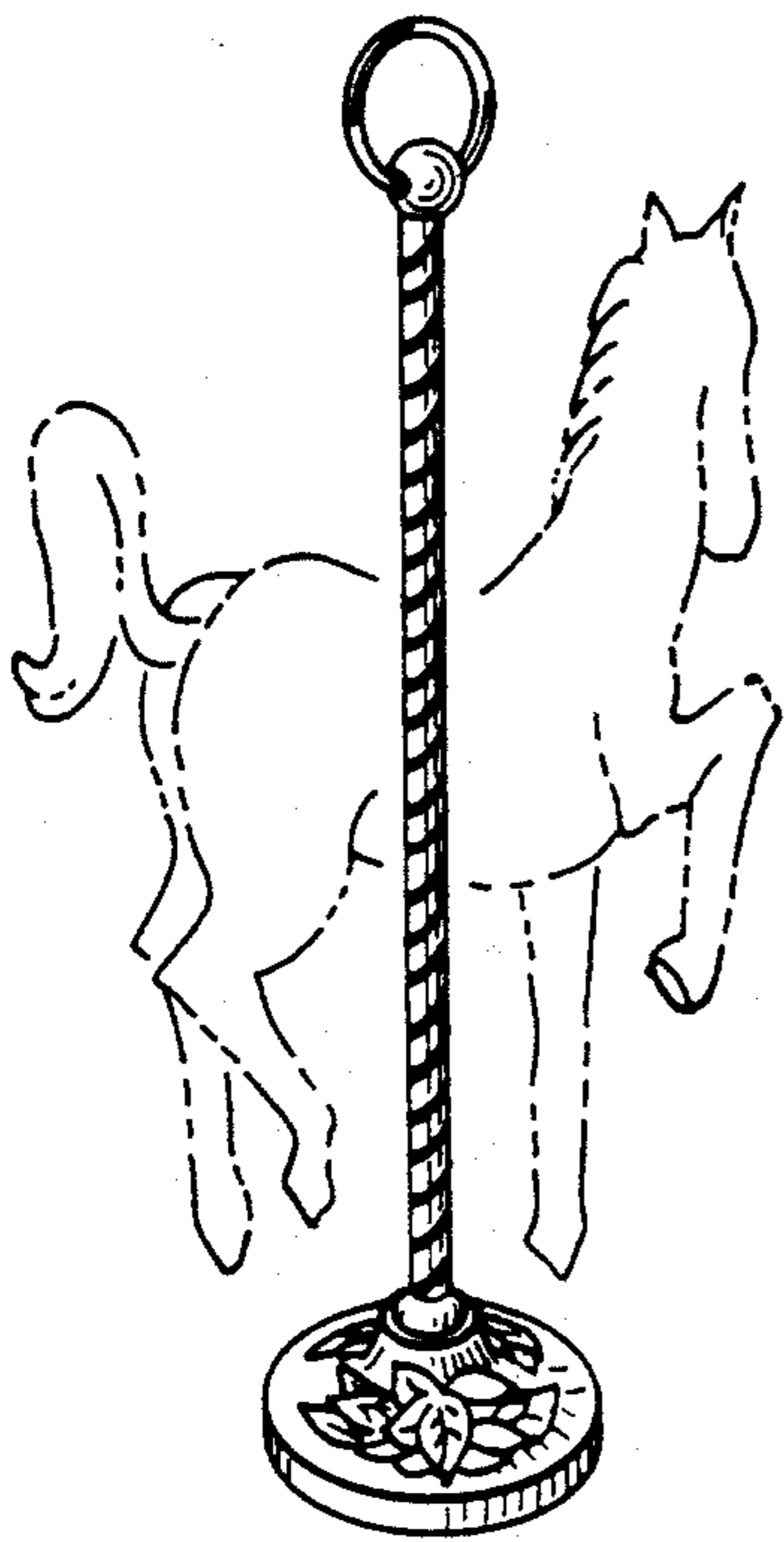

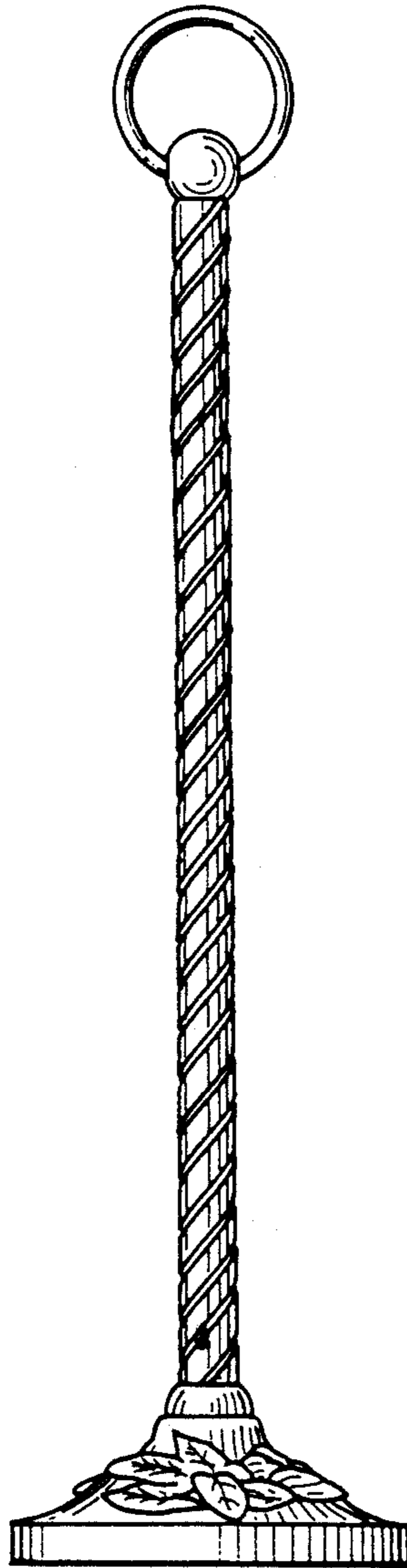

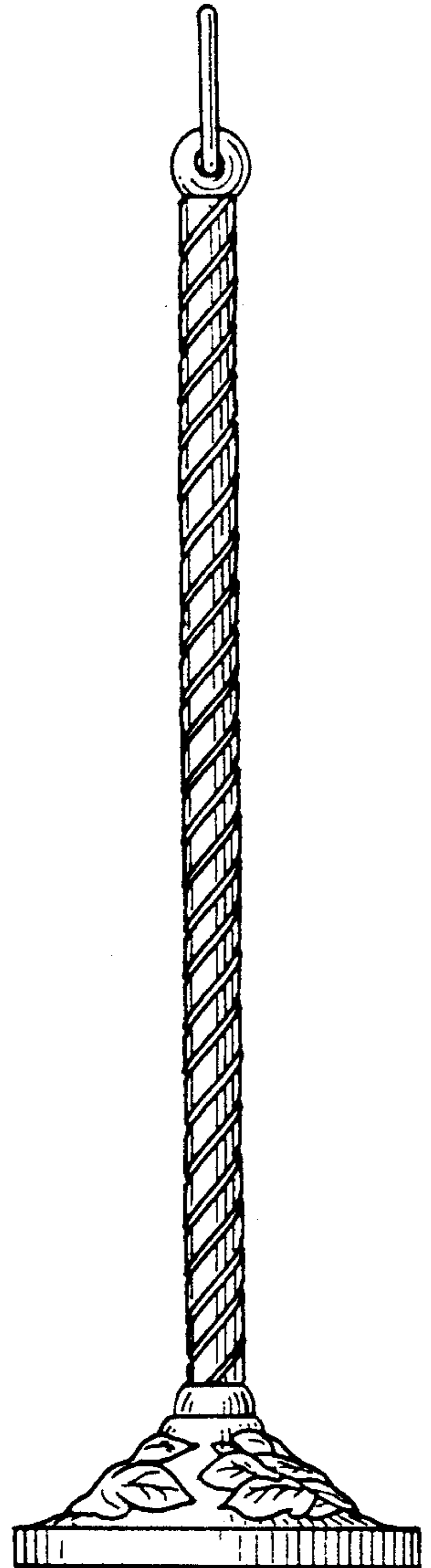

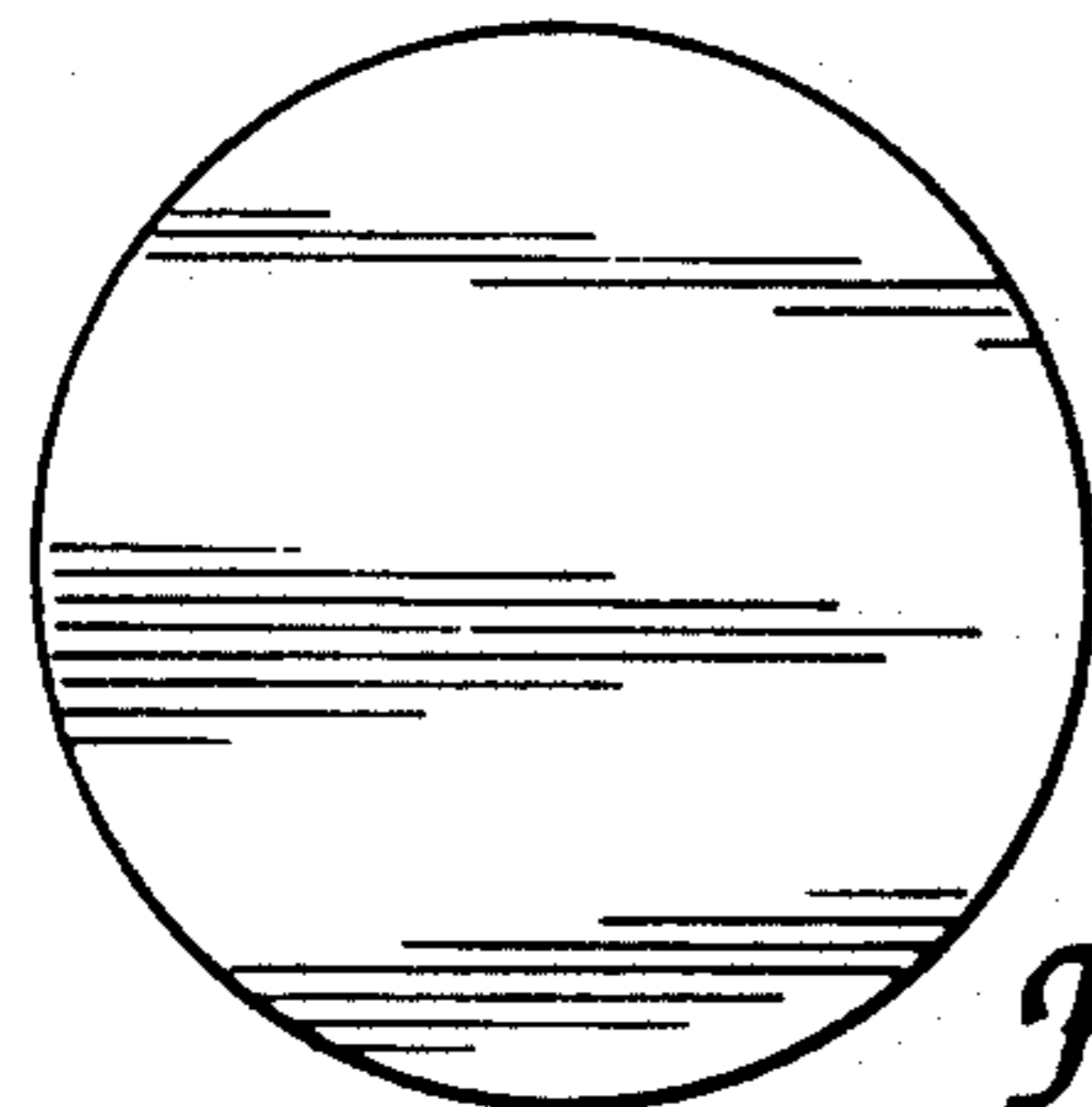
