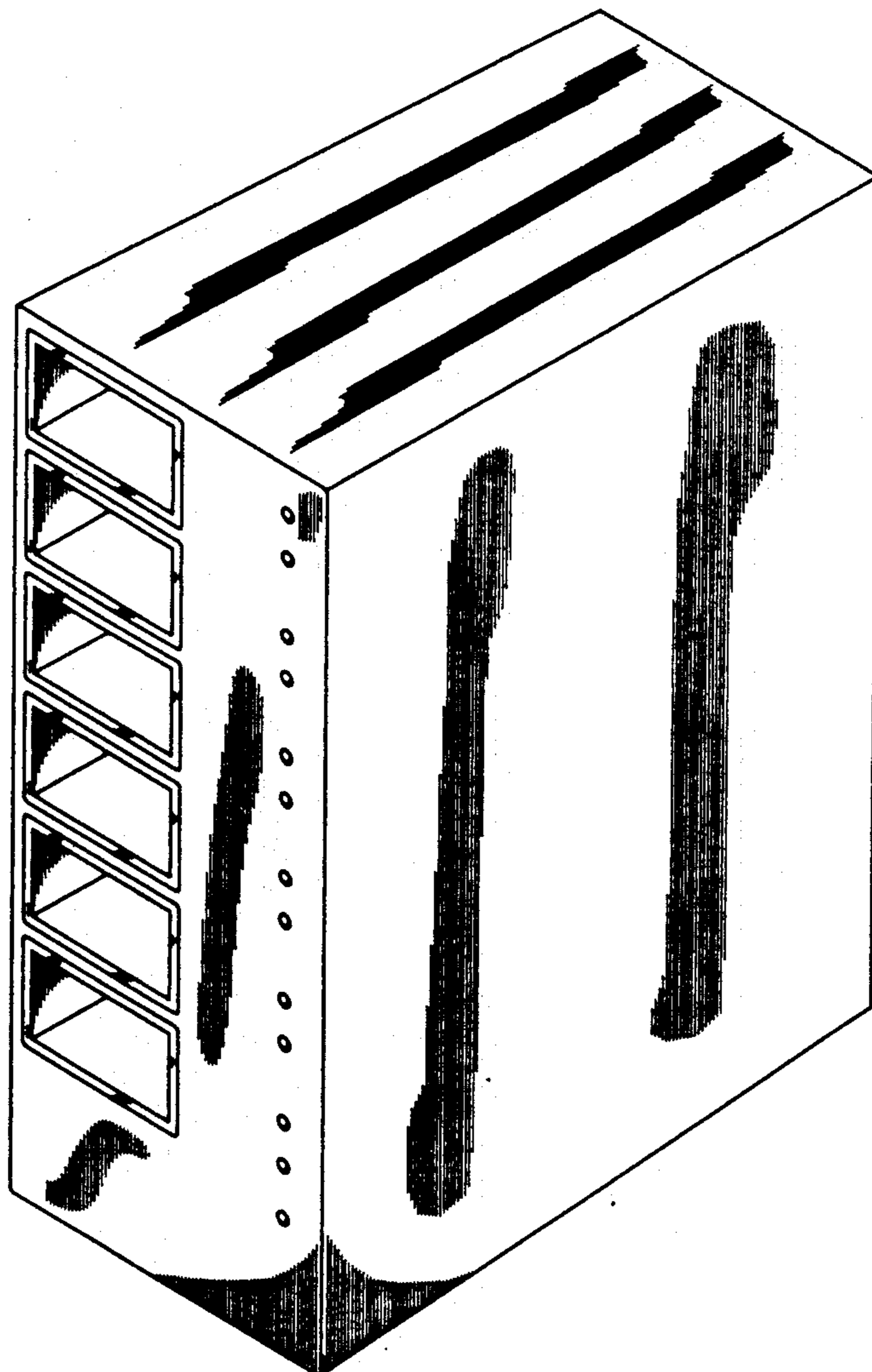

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a battery charger showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front and upper right perspective view thereof.



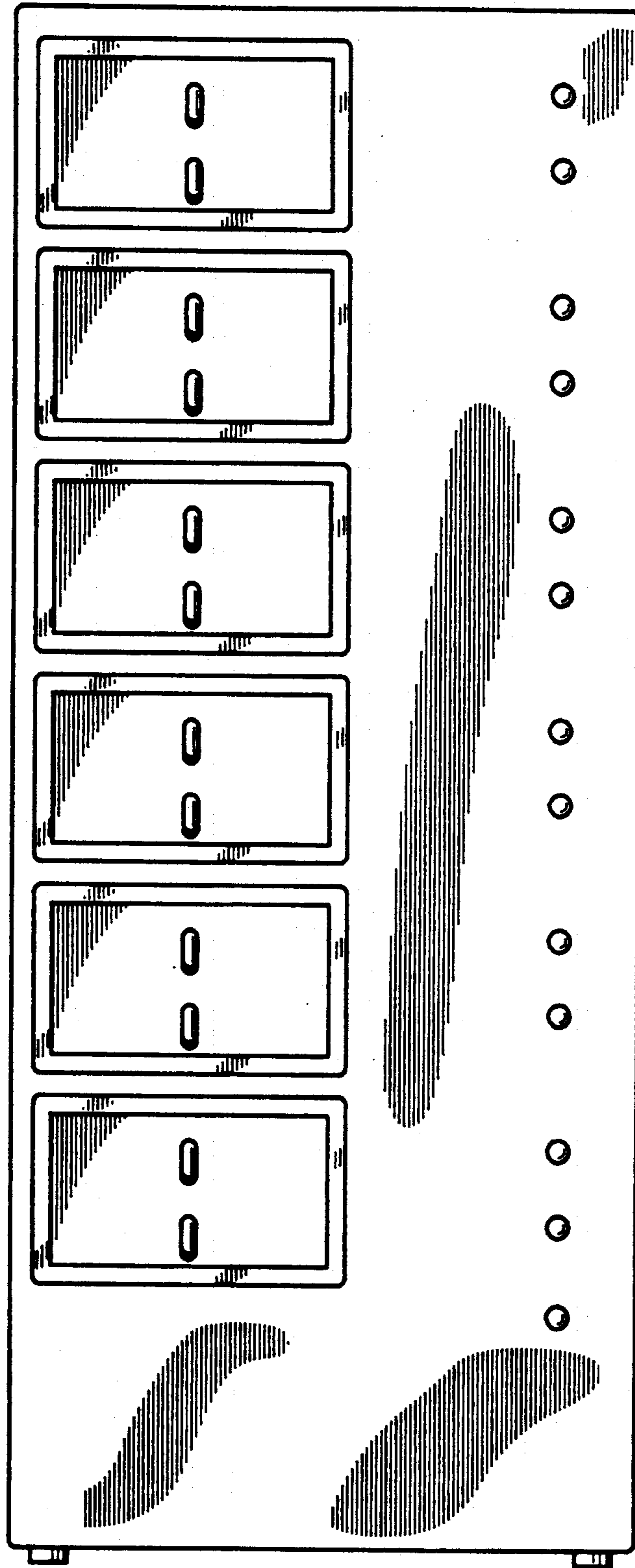

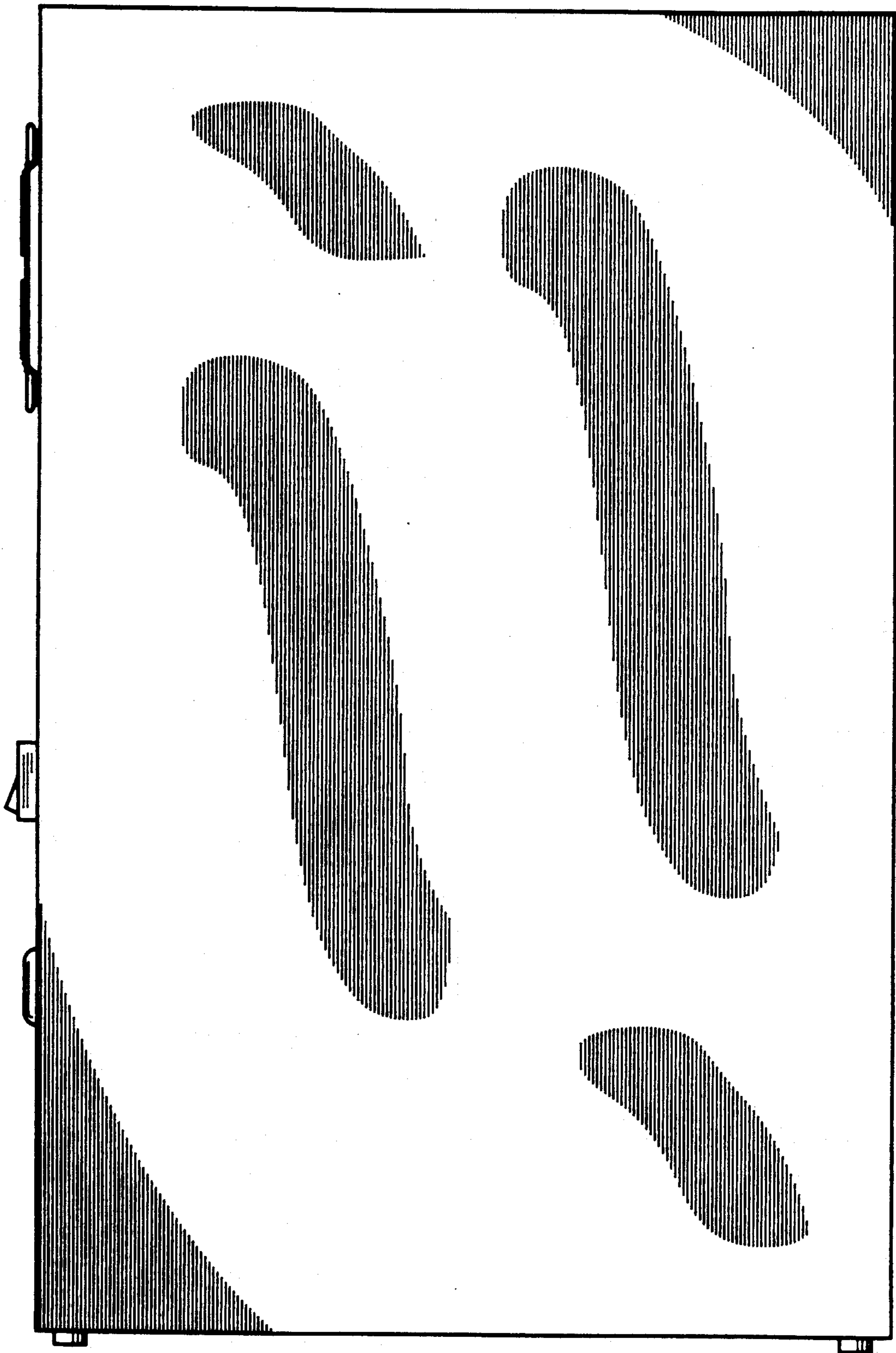

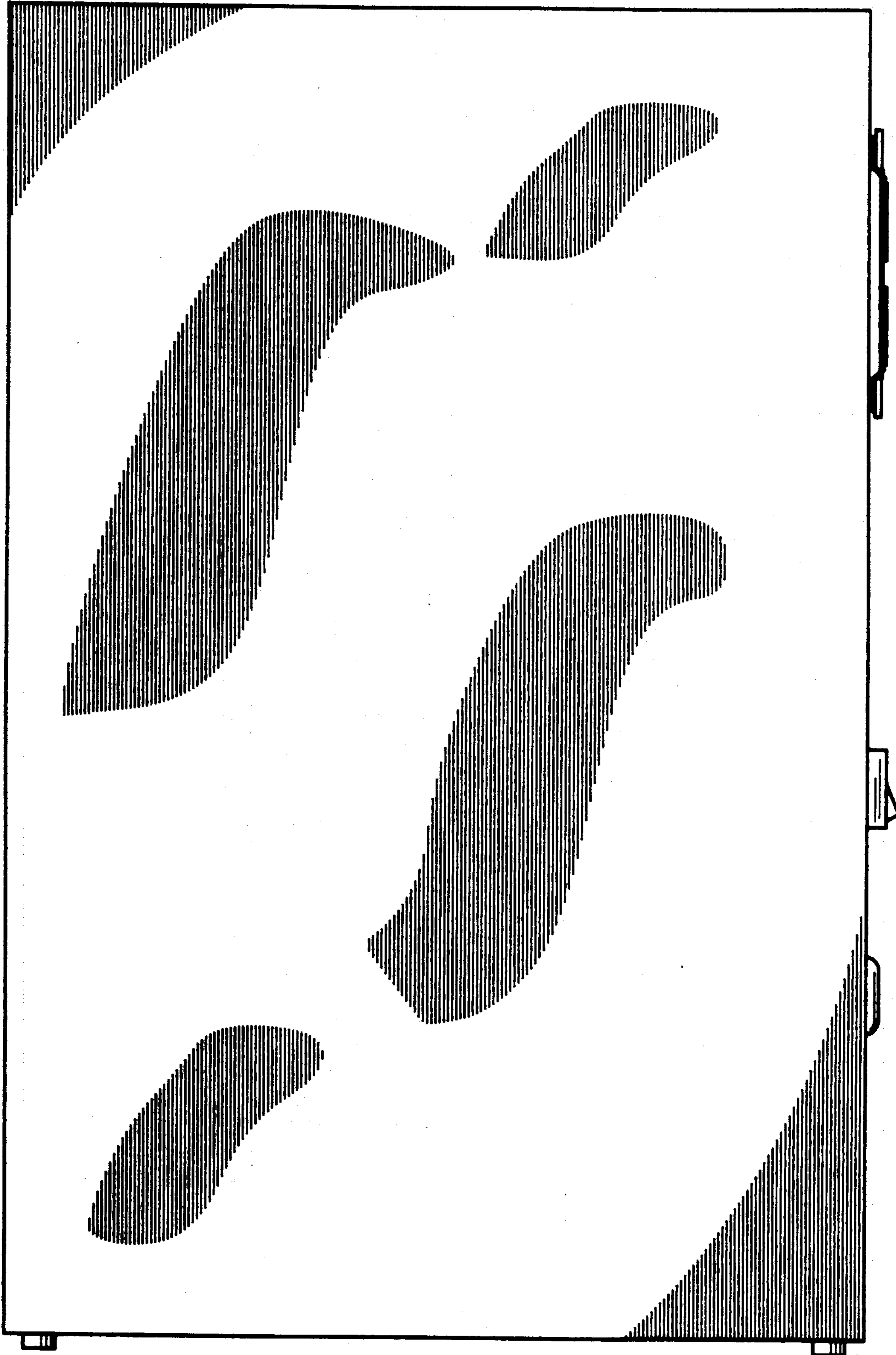

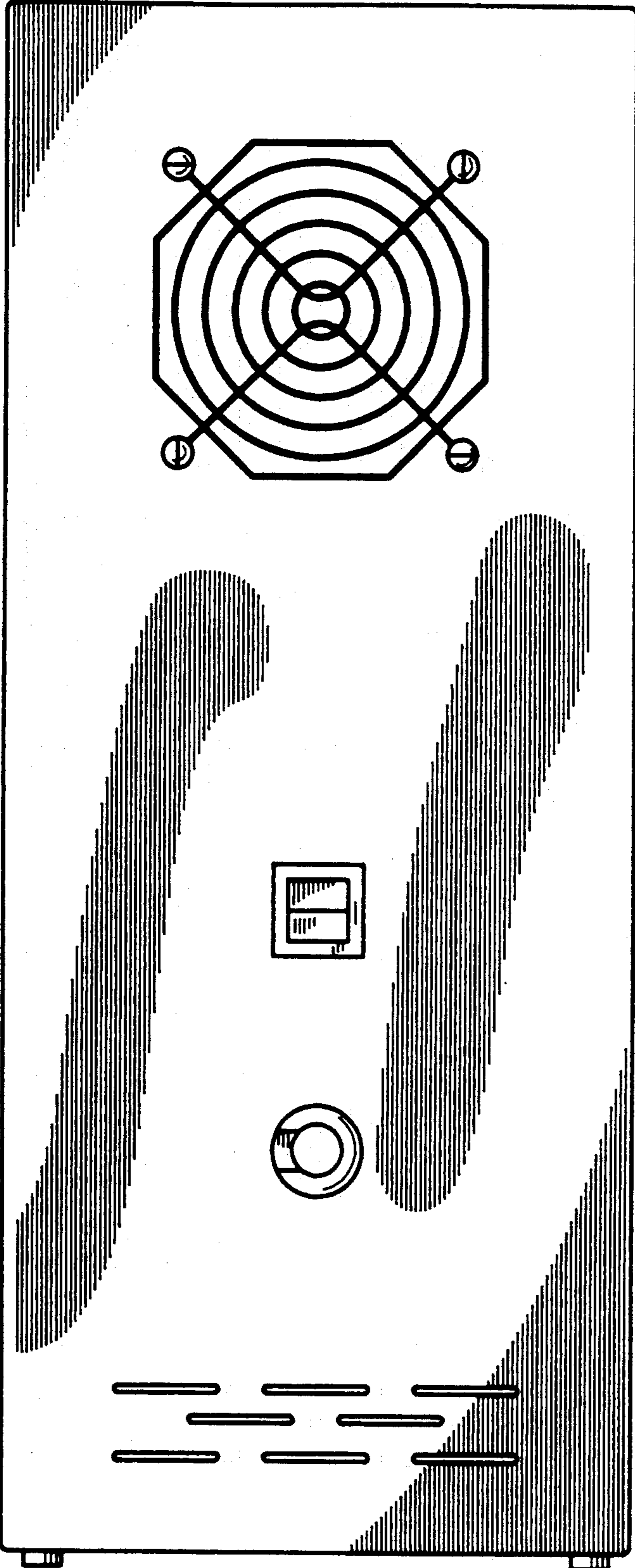

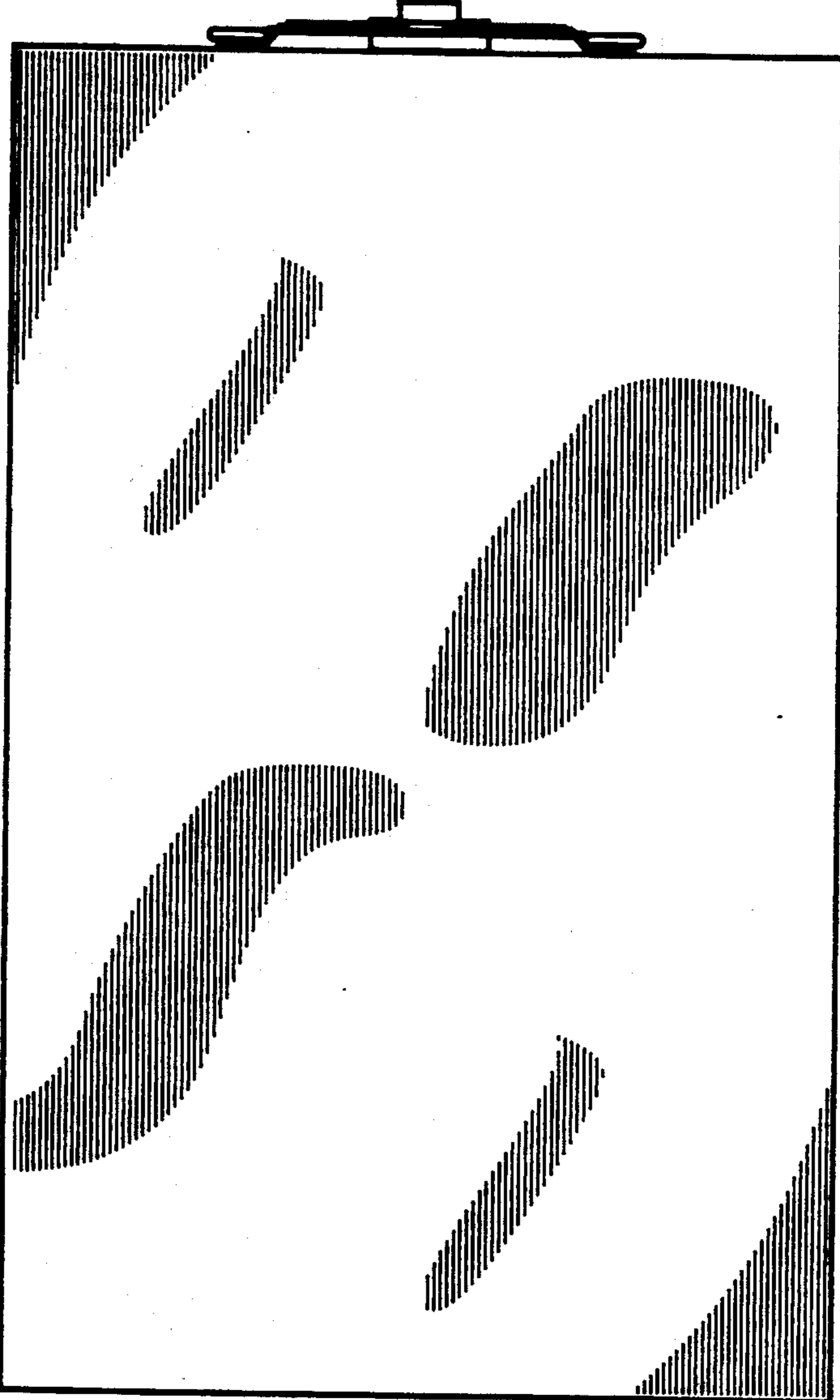

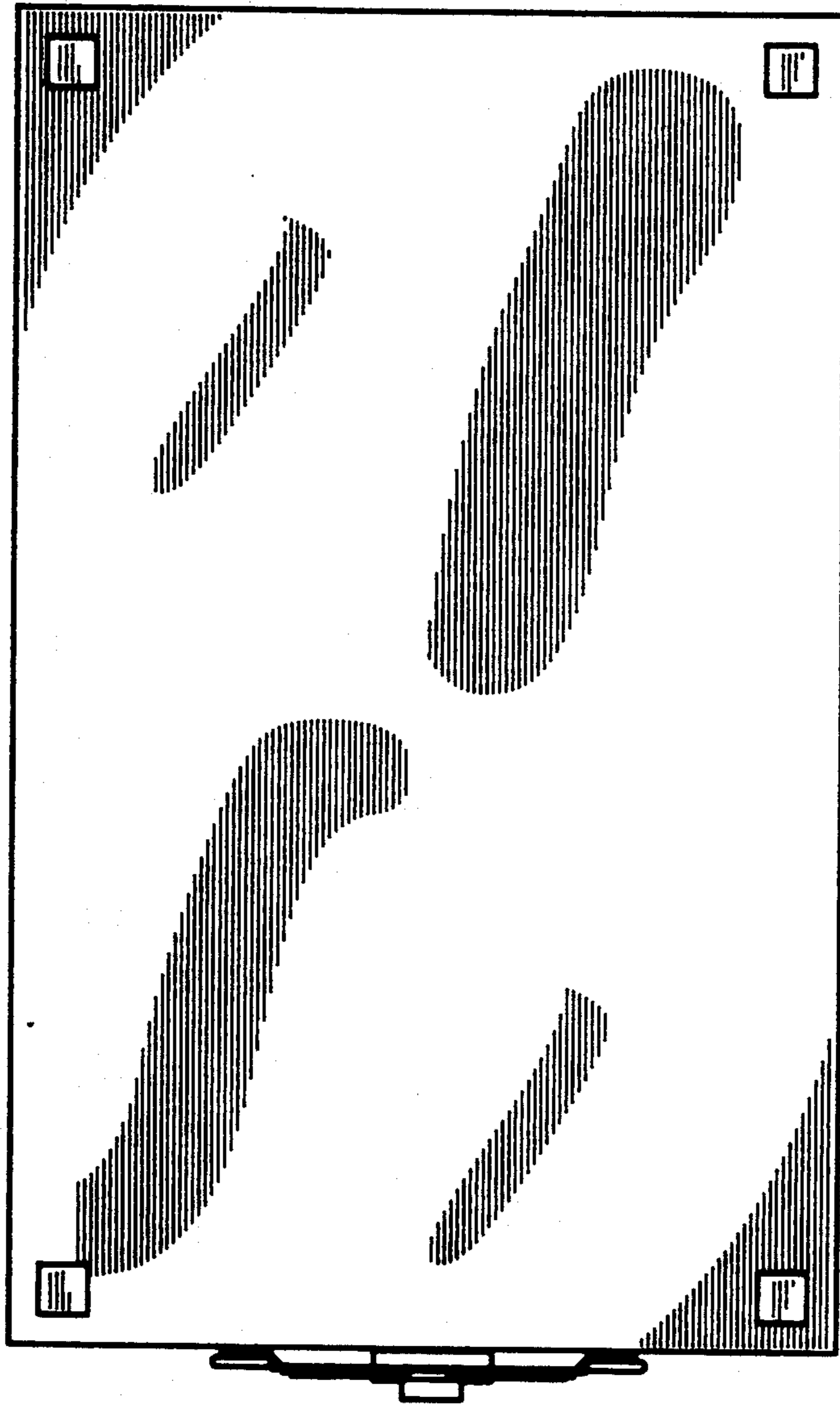

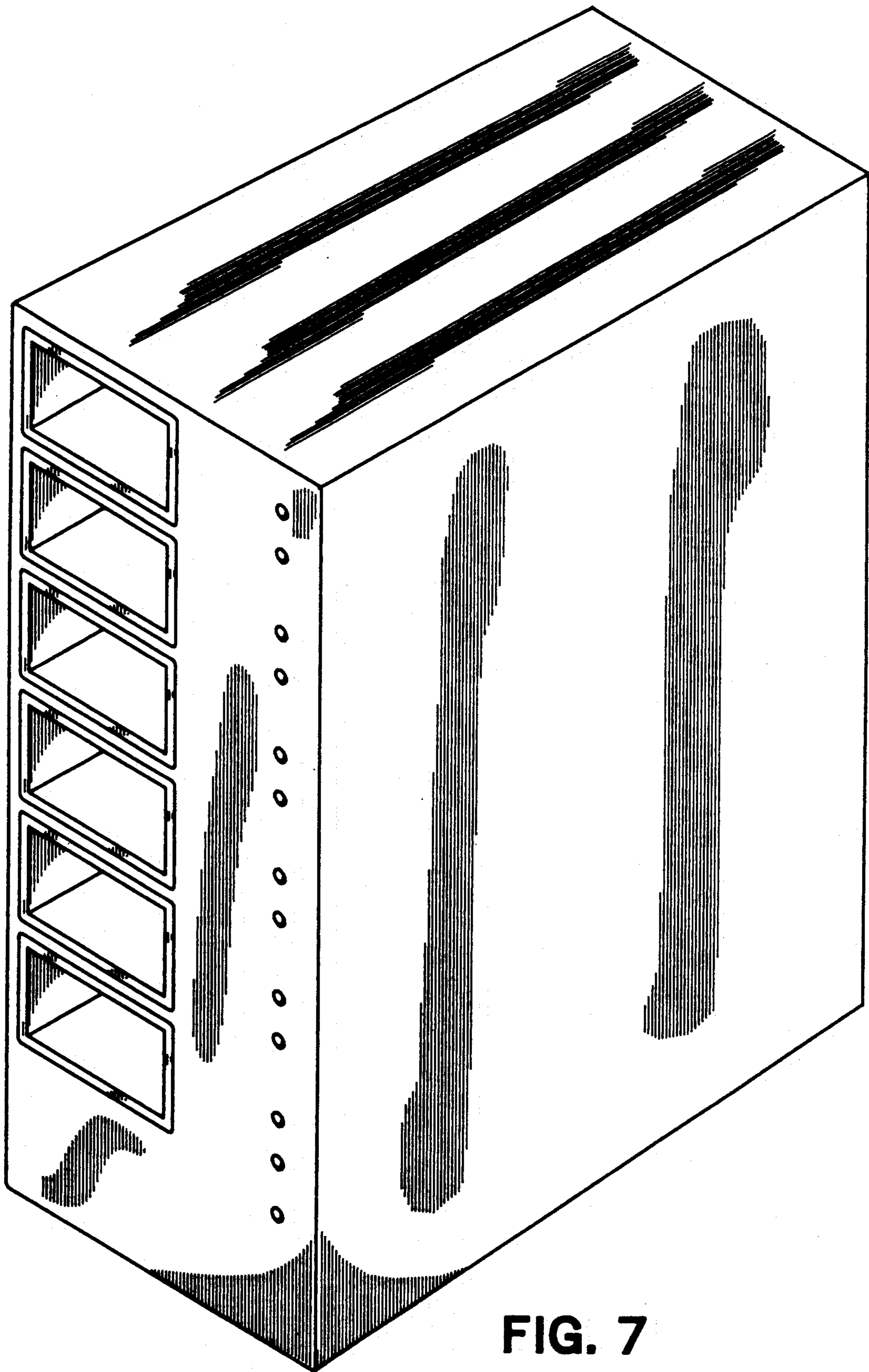
