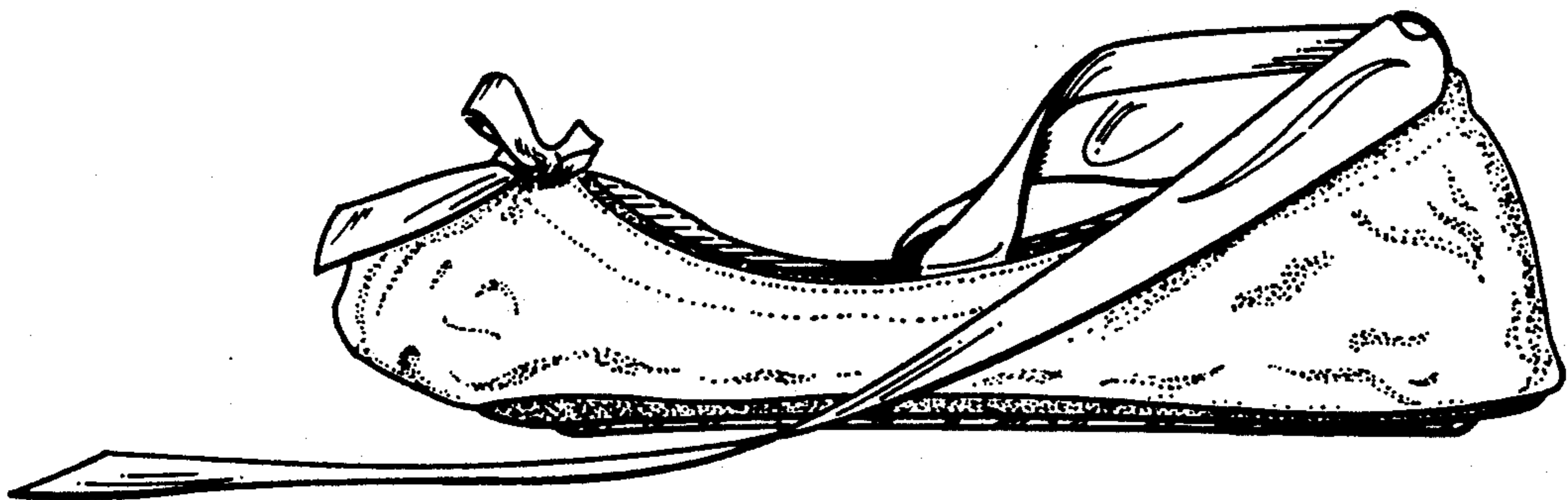

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a child's house slipper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a child's house slipper showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof, the broken line indicating visible stitching therein; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof, the broken lines indicating visible stitching therein; and, FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



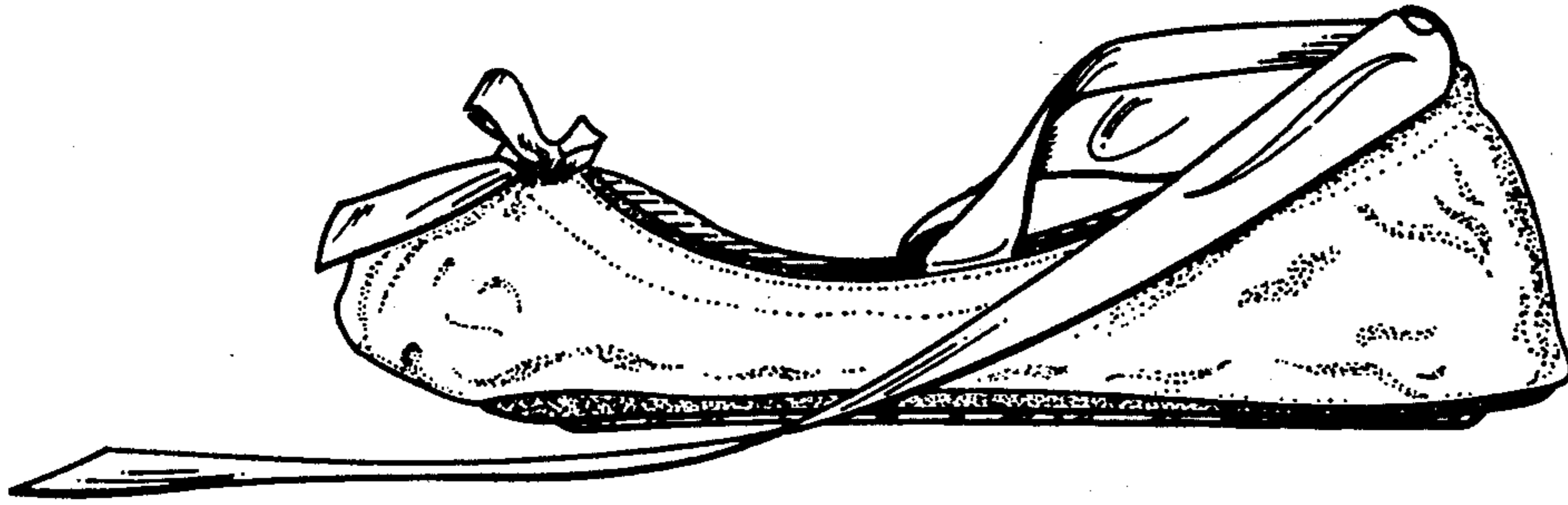

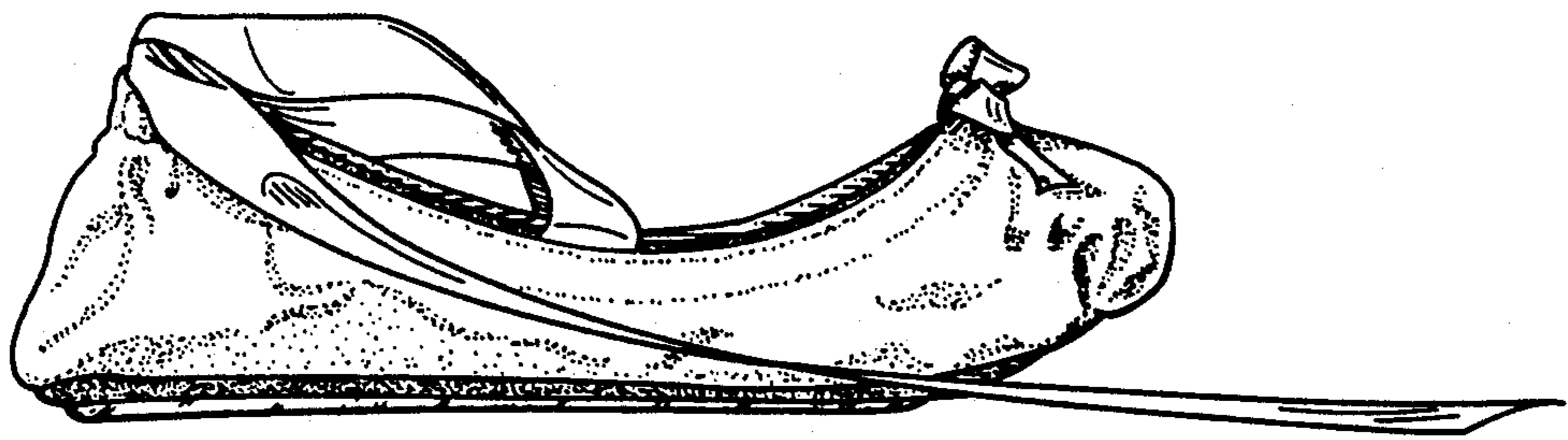

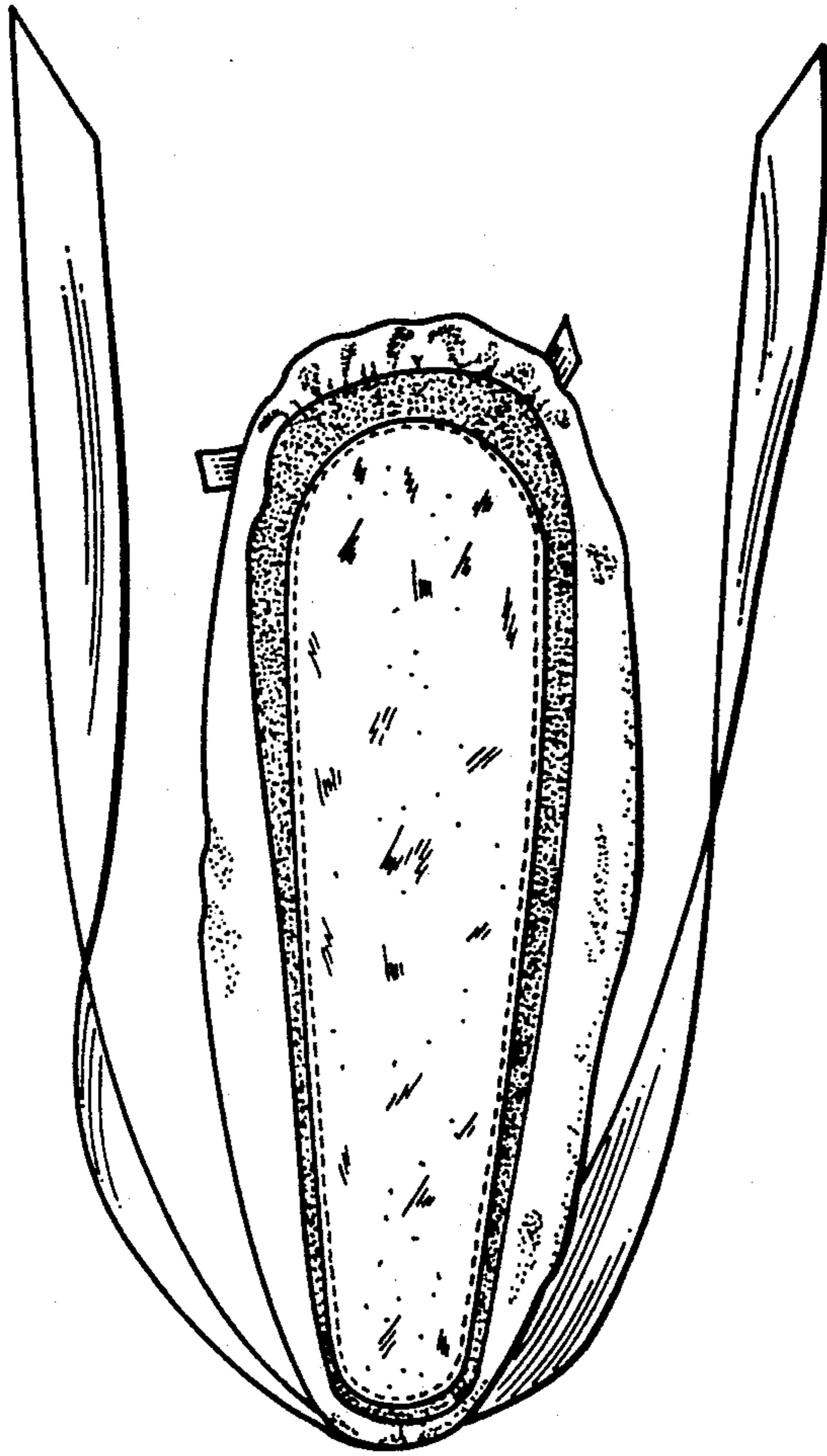

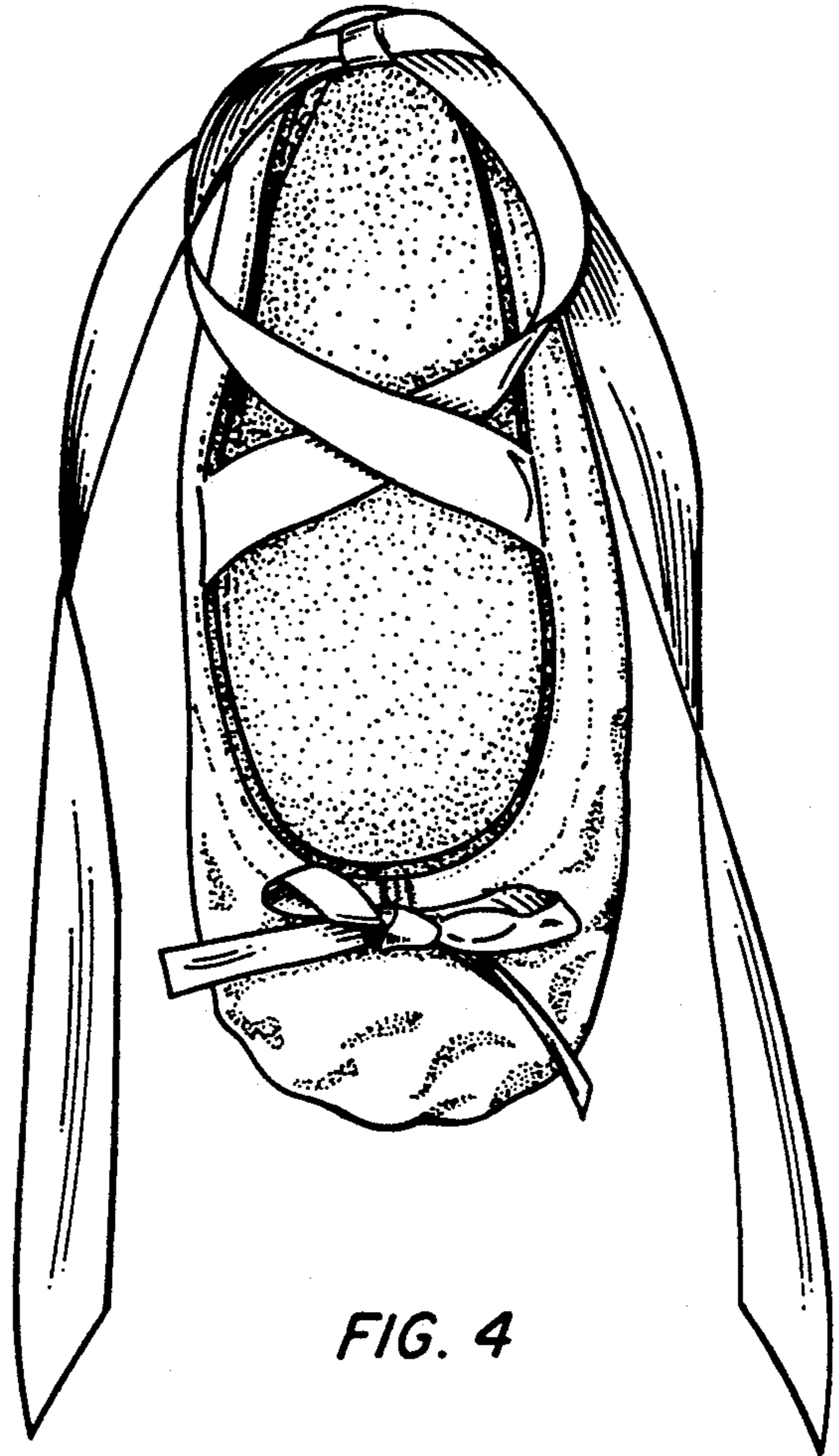

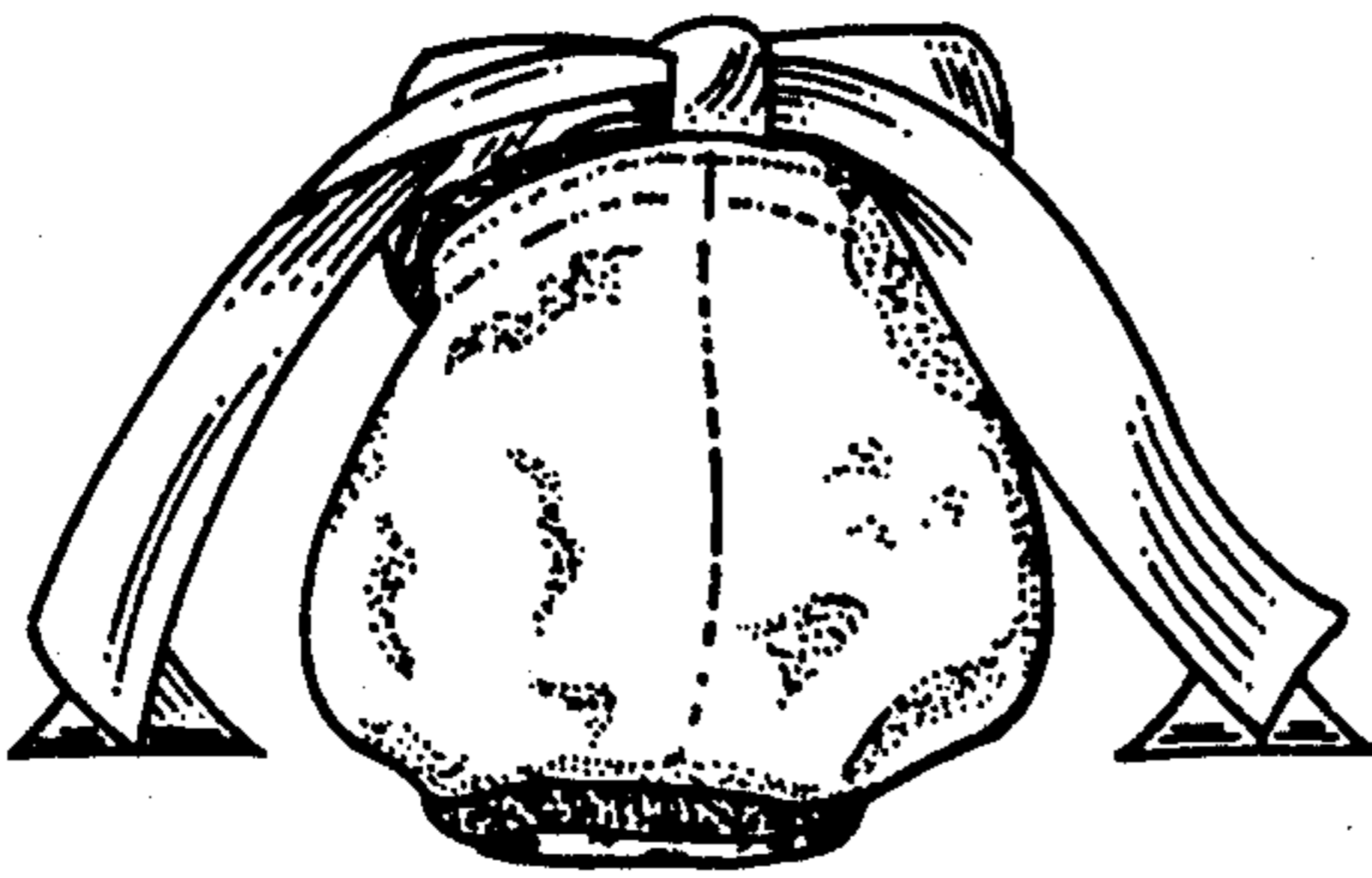
