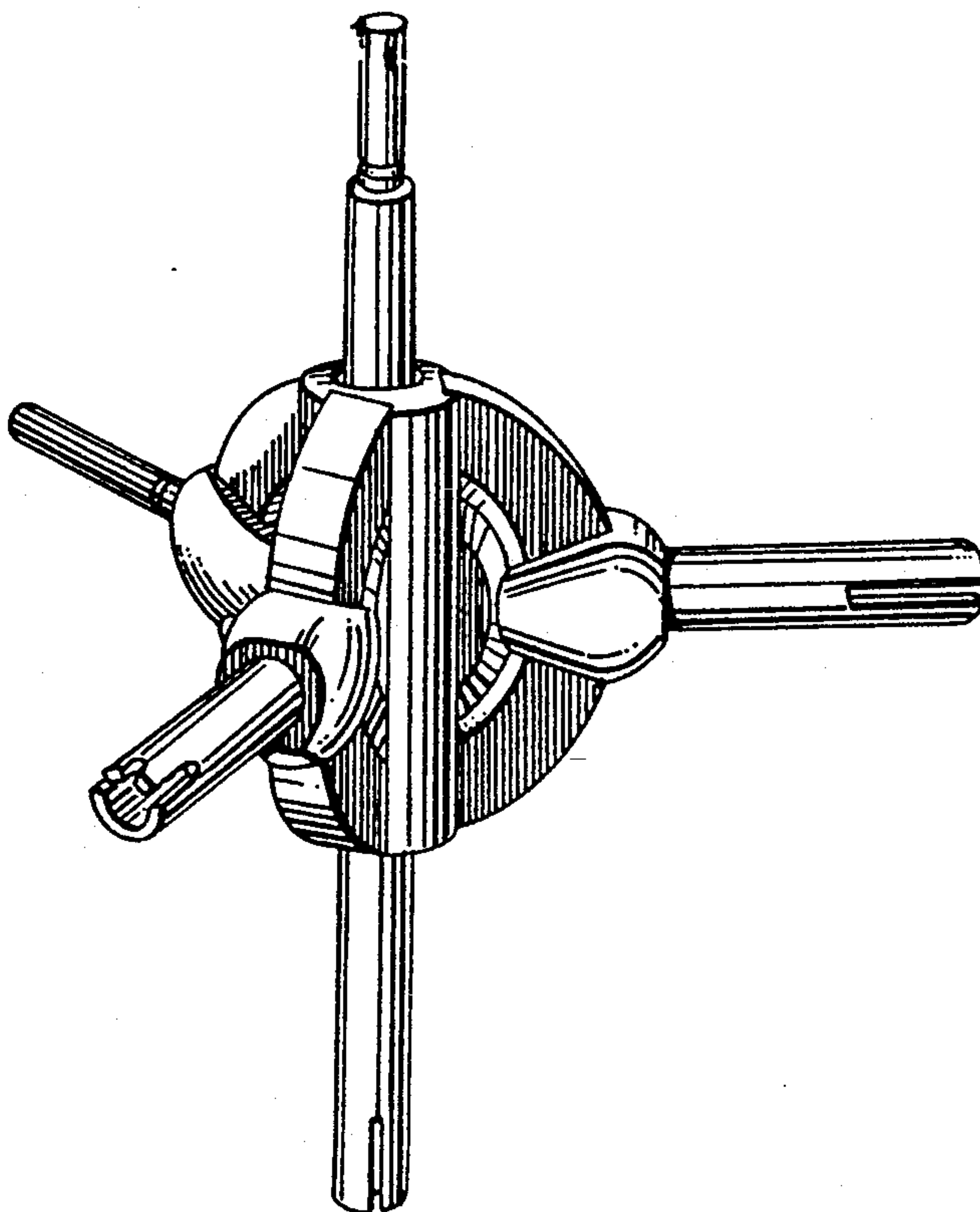

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the molecular model showing one embodiment of our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of a first one-third portion of the embodiment of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of a second one-third portion of the embodiment of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a third one-third portion of the embodiment of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the molecular model showing a second embodiment of our new design; FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of a first one-third portion of the embodiment of FIG. 7; FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of a second one-third portion of the embodiment of FIG. 7; FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of a third one-third portion of the embodiment of FIG. 7; FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 7; and, FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 7.



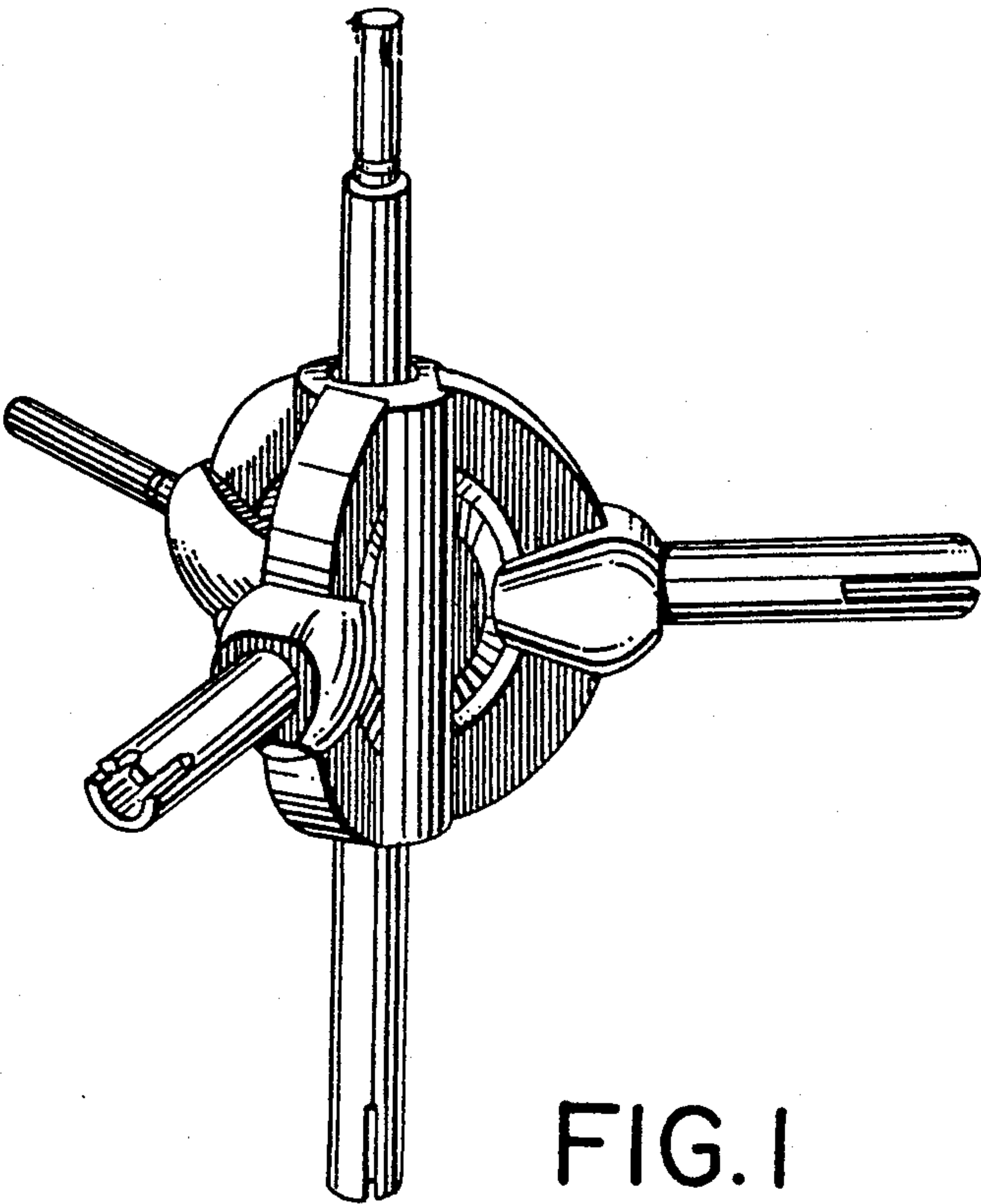

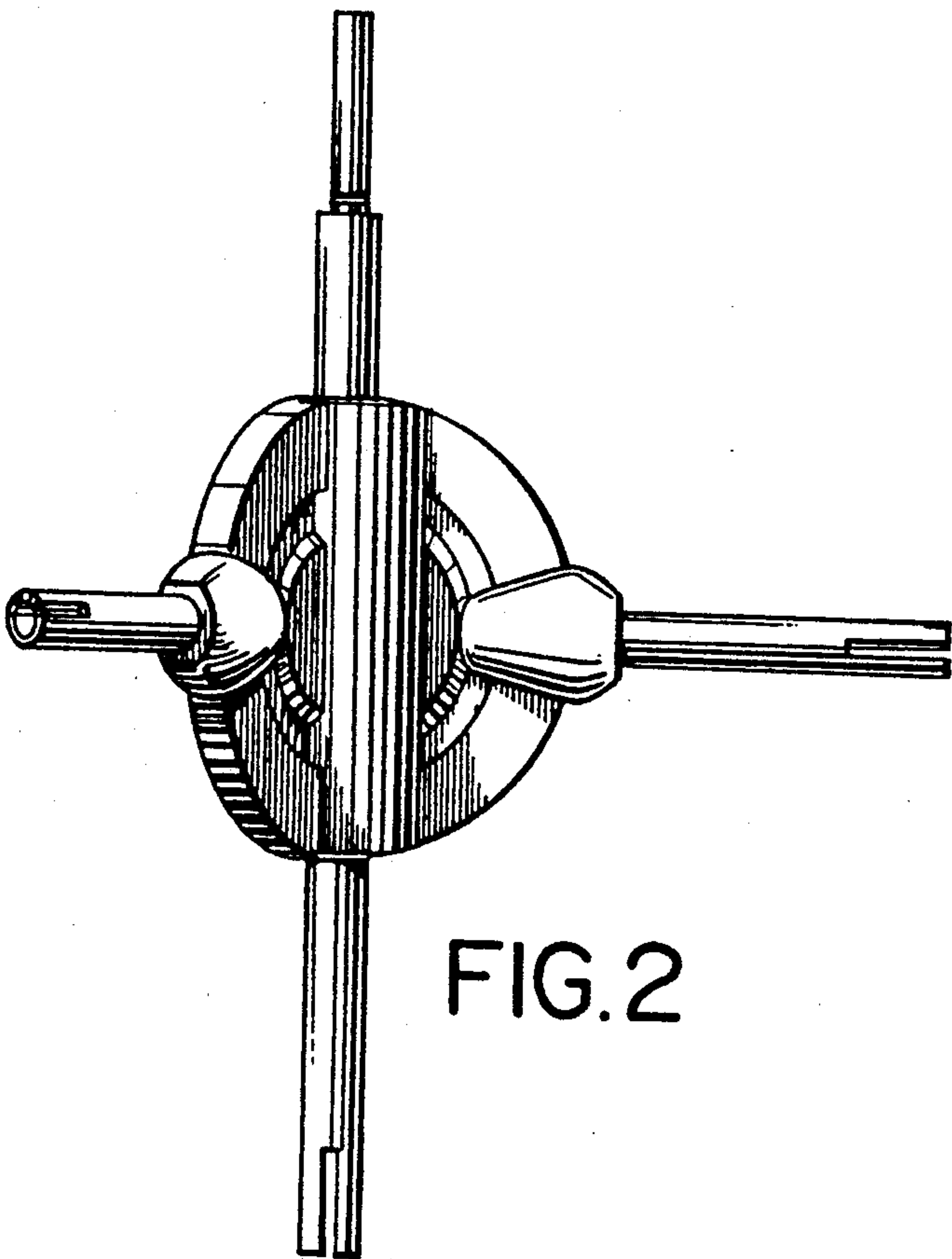
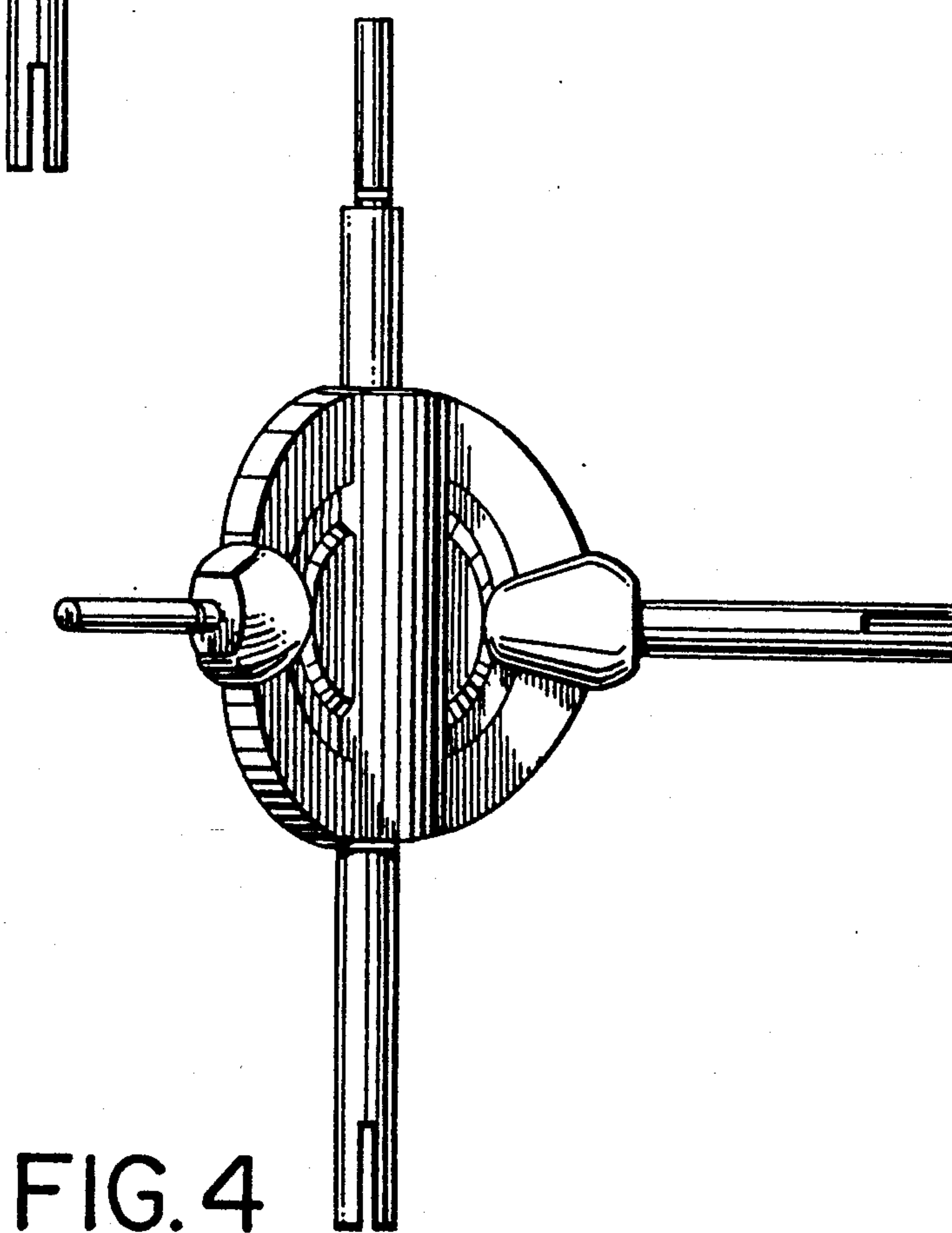
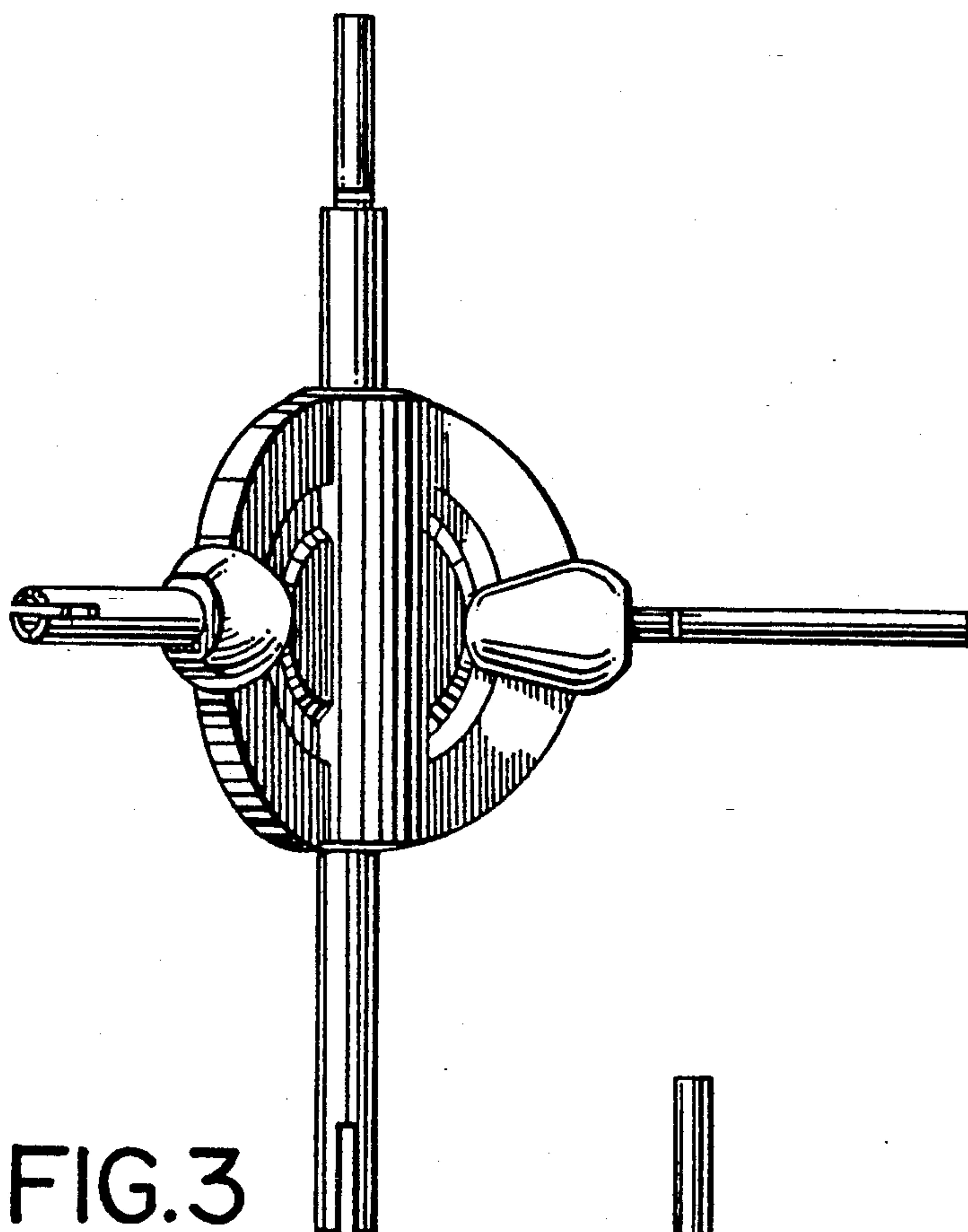

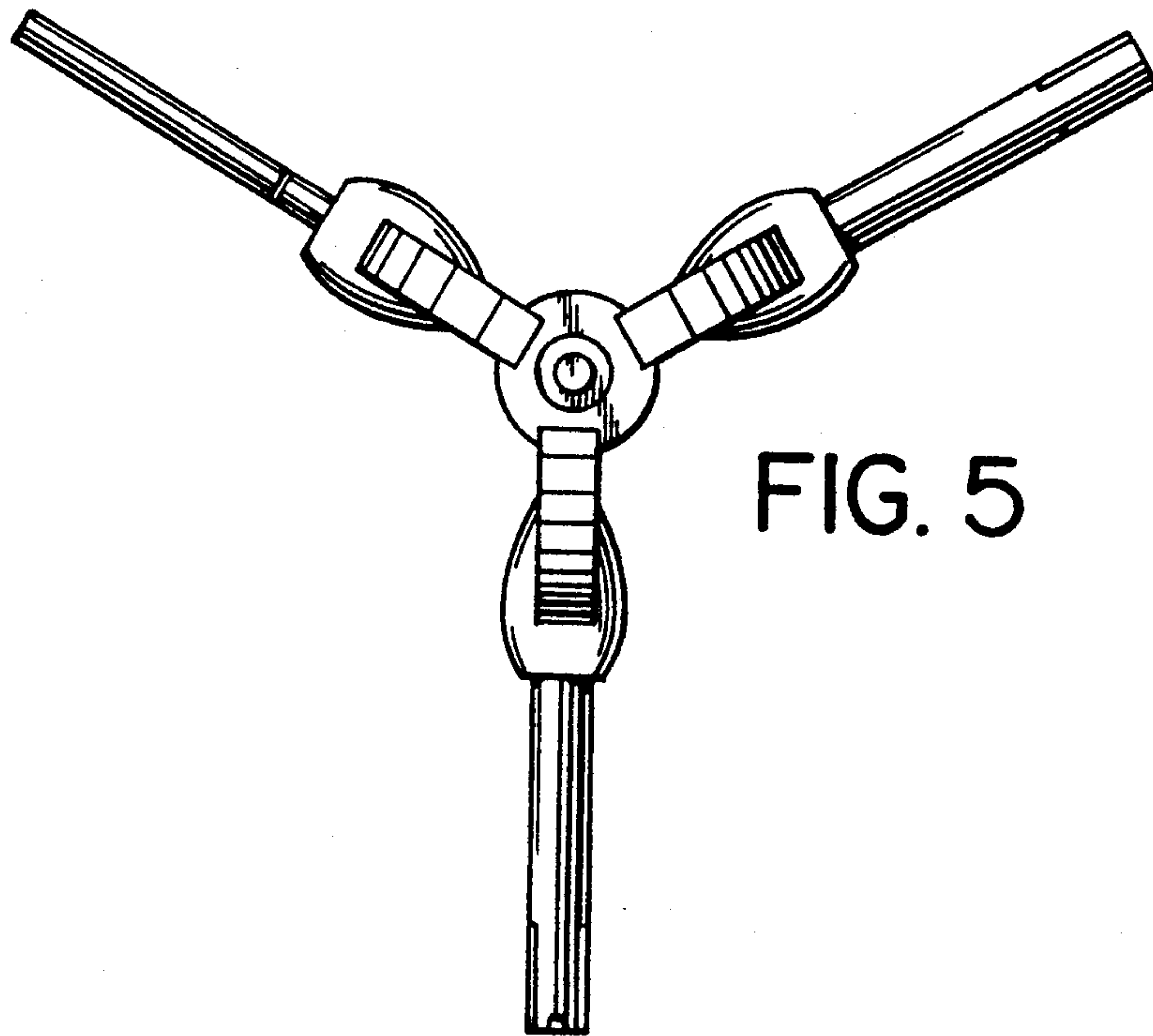

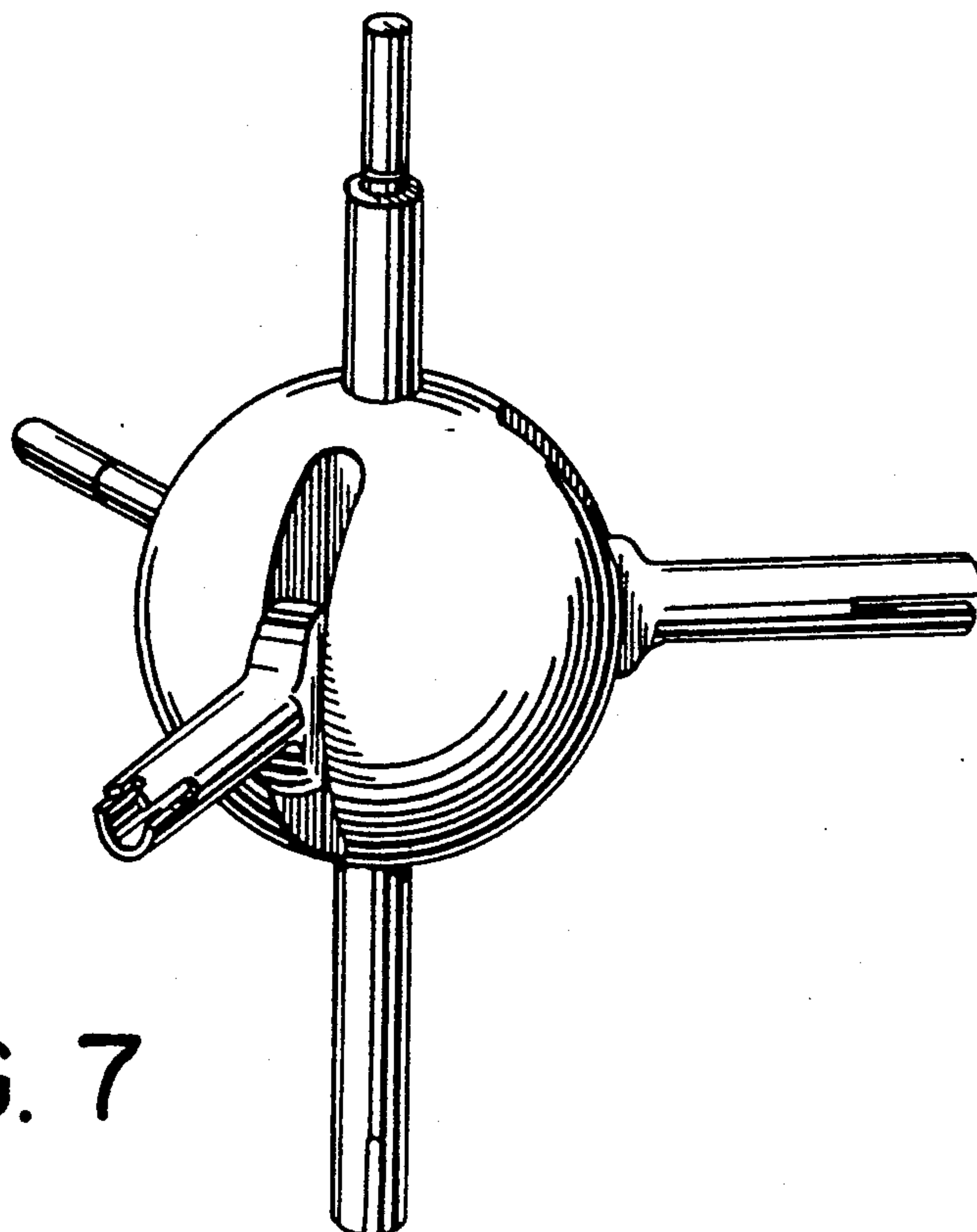

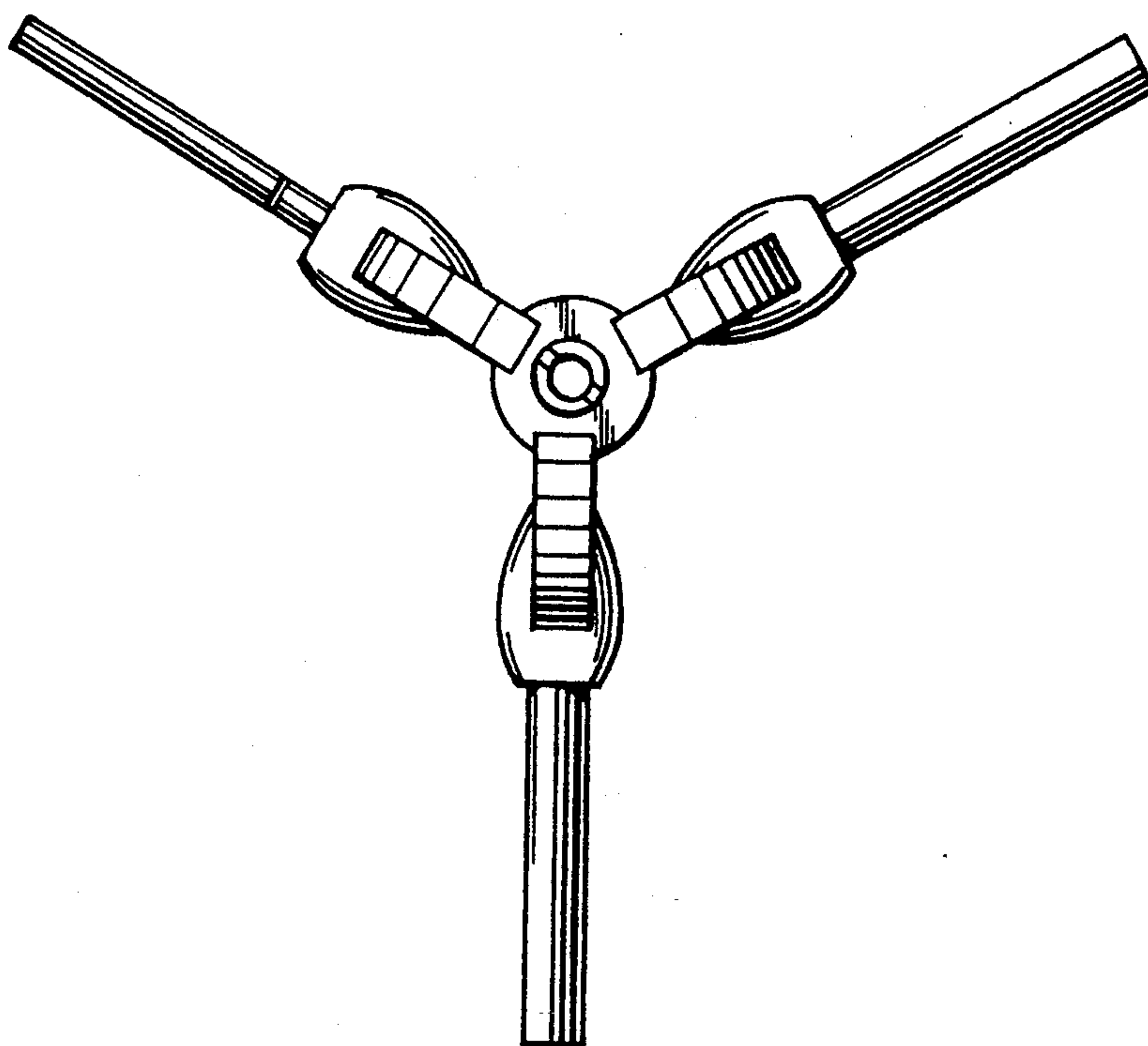

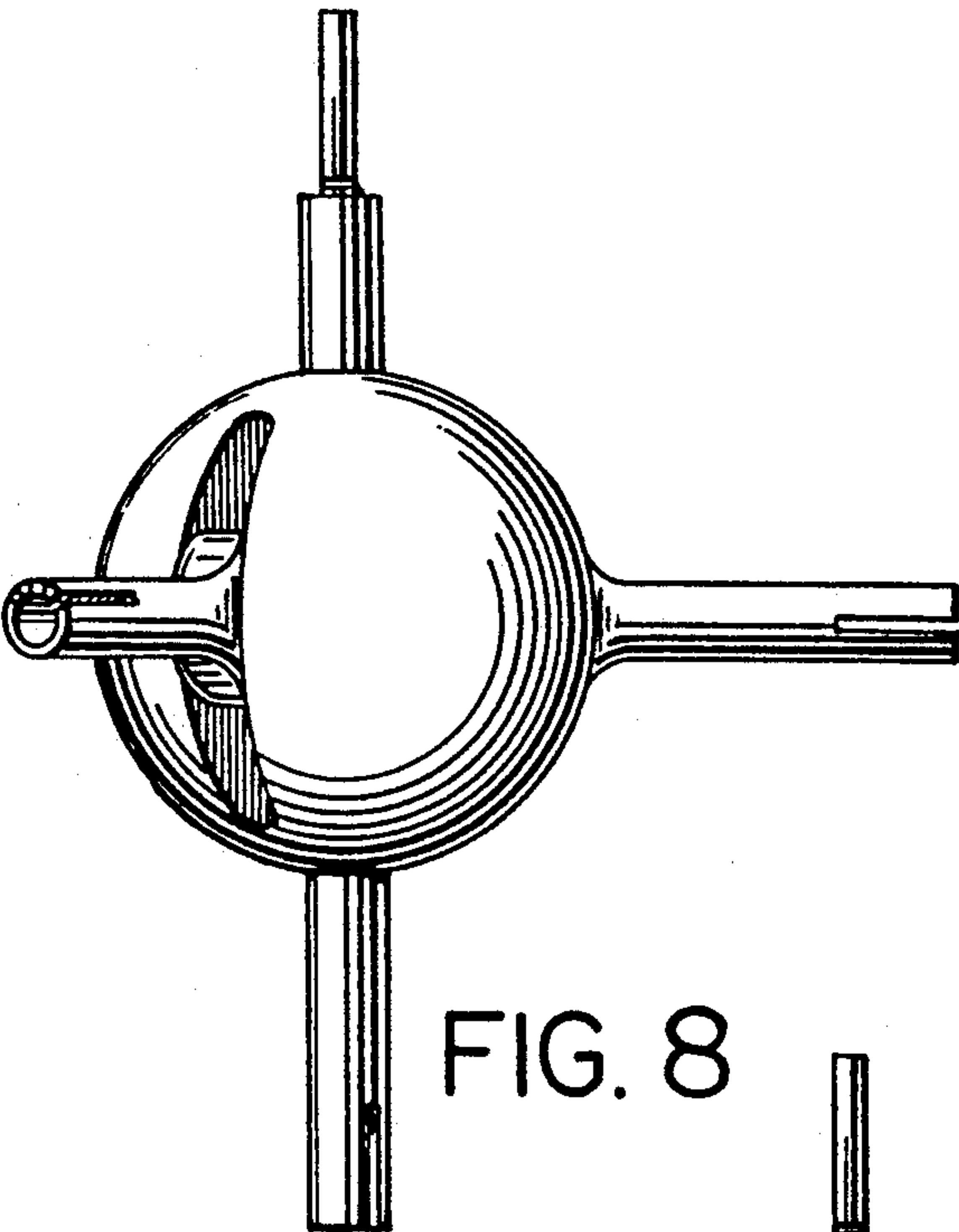

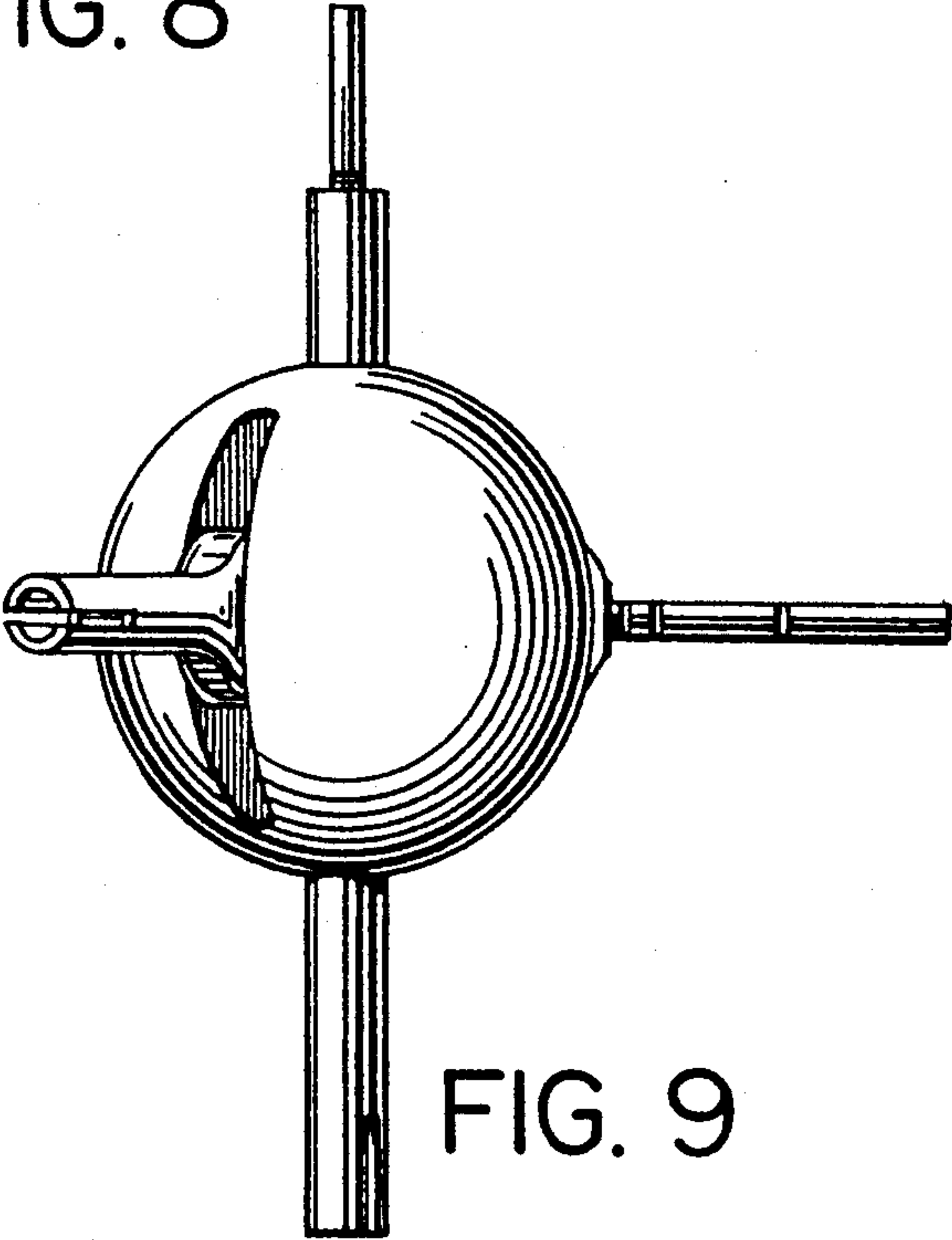

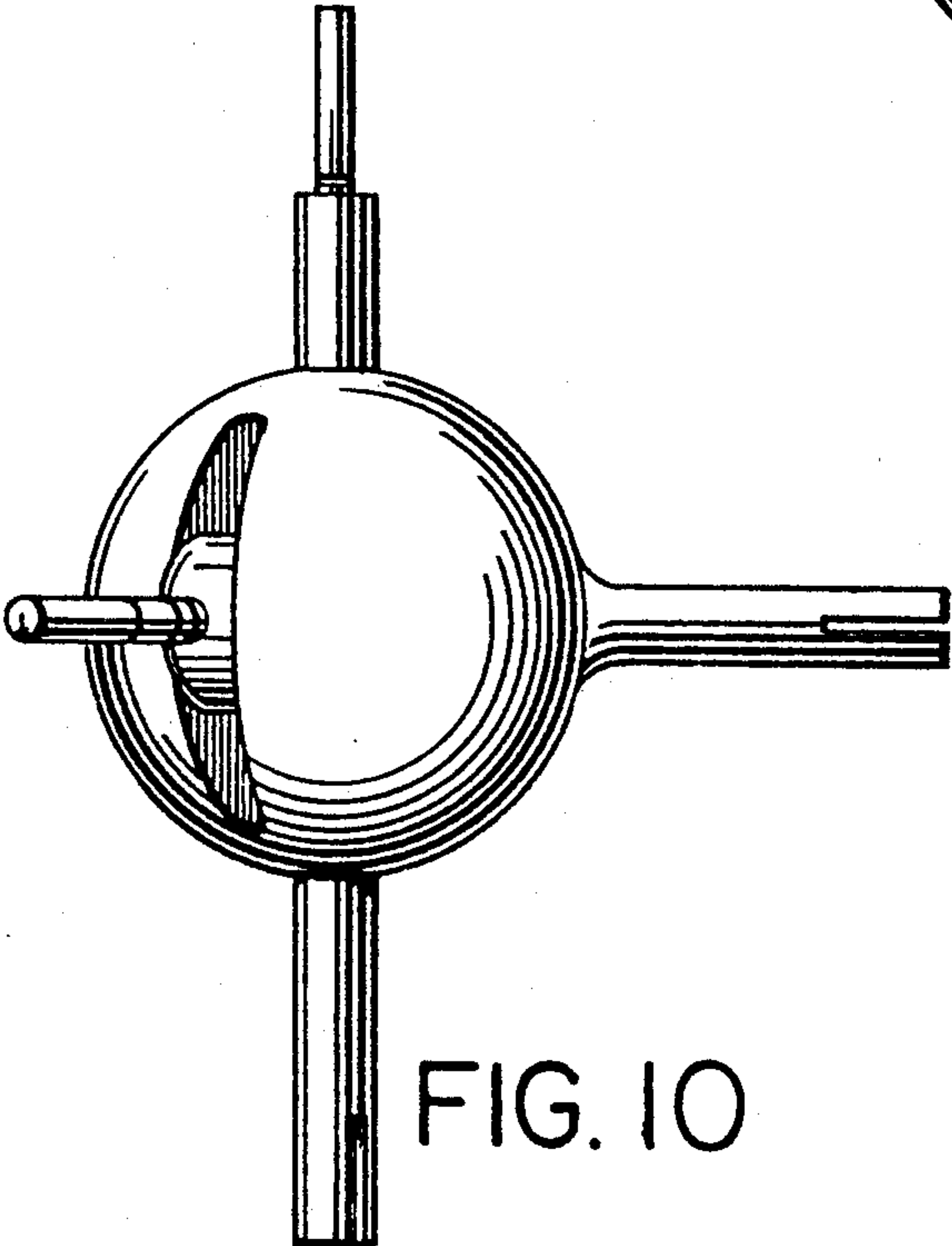

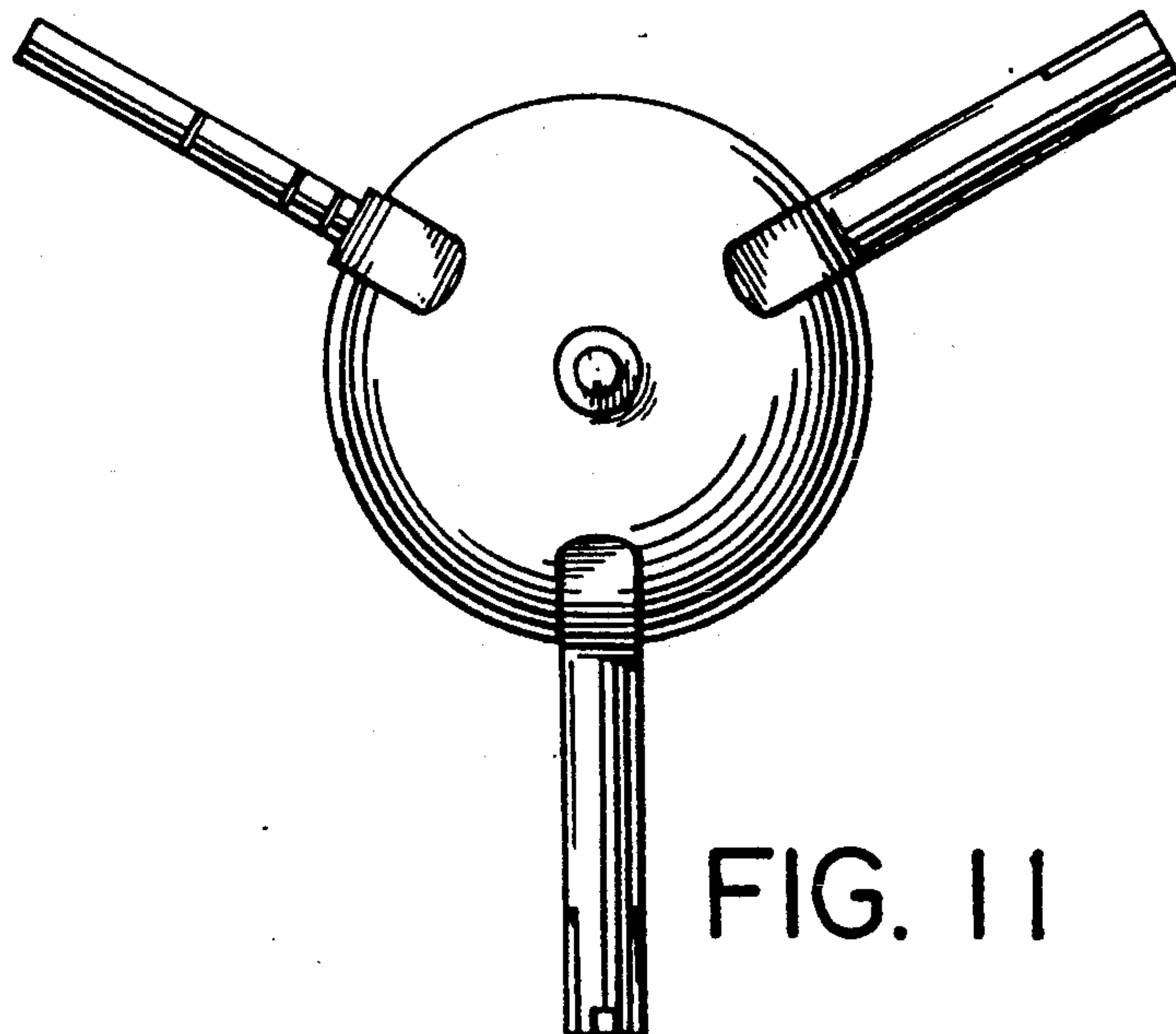

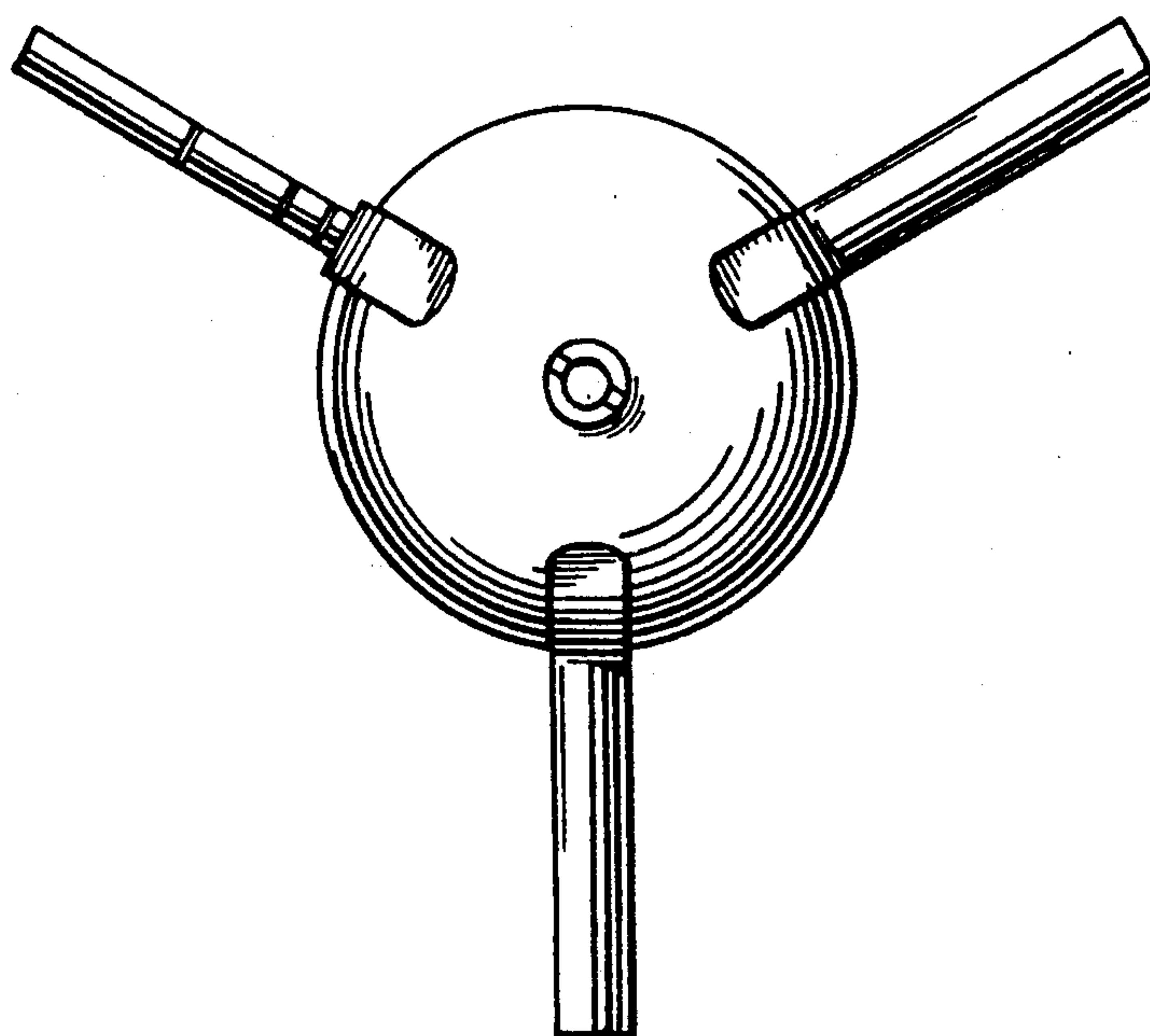
