FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of a second embodiment thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image, the front view being identical to FIG. 1, the rear view being a mirror image of FIG. 1, and the top view being identical to FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front view of a third embodiment thereof, the rear view being a mirror image;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image;

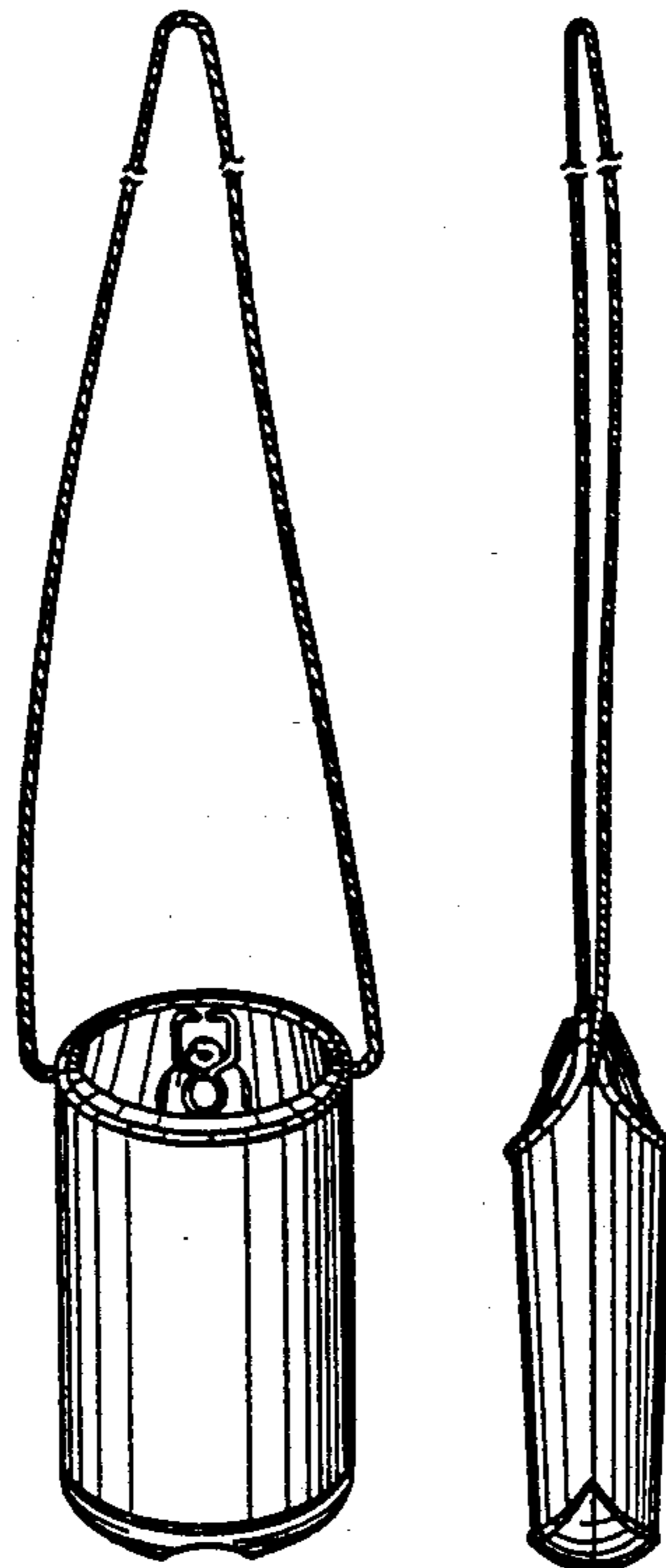
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

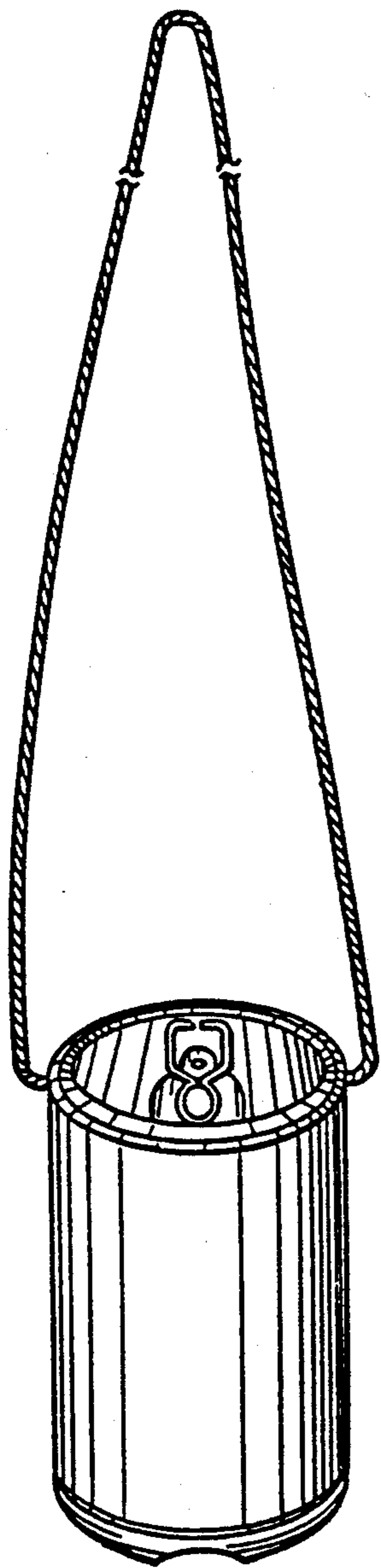

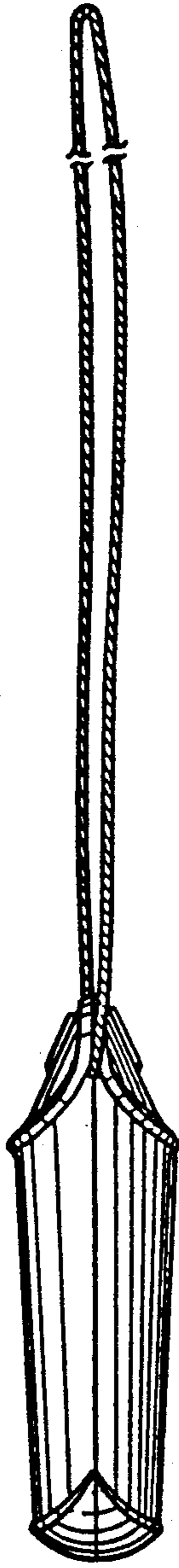

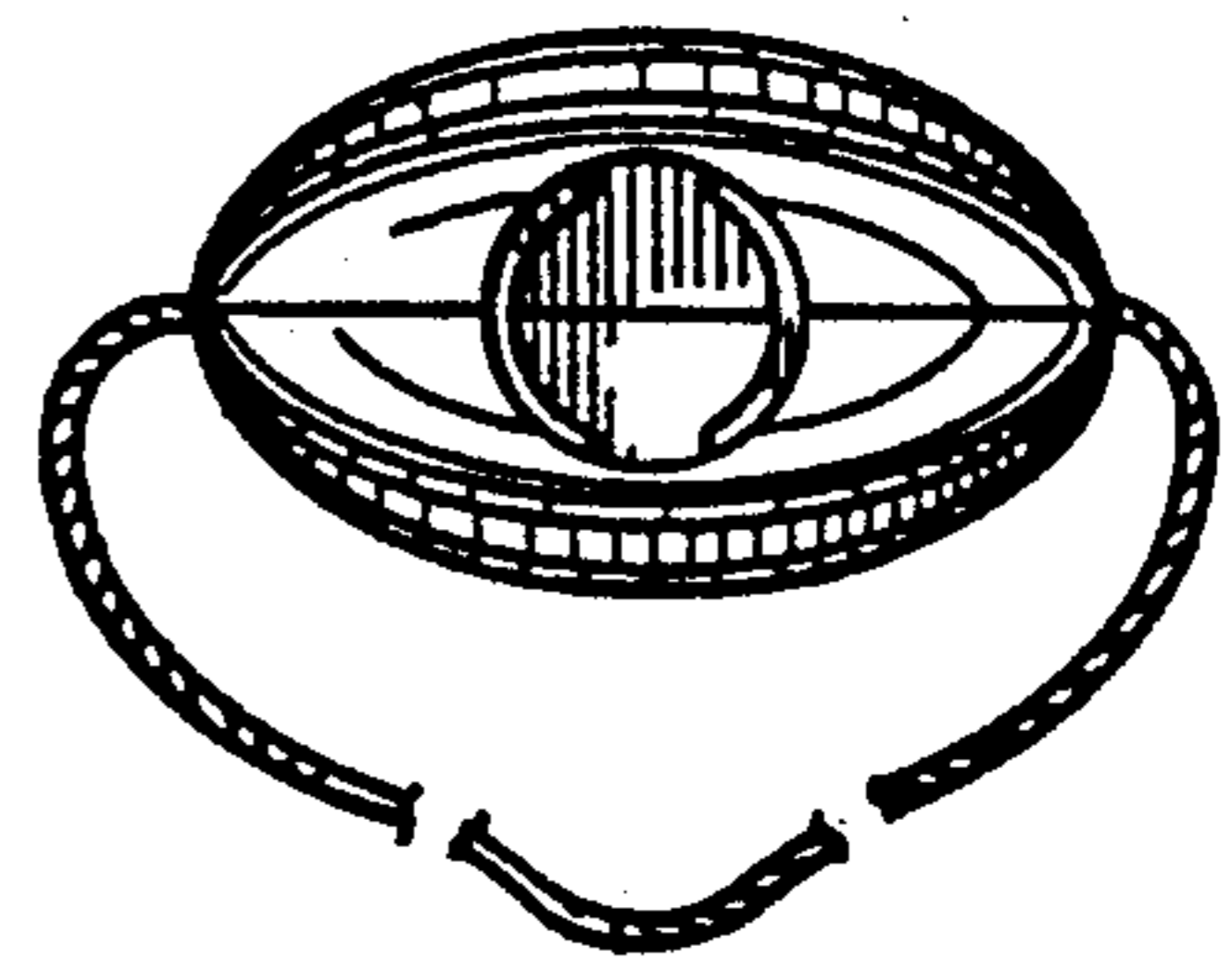

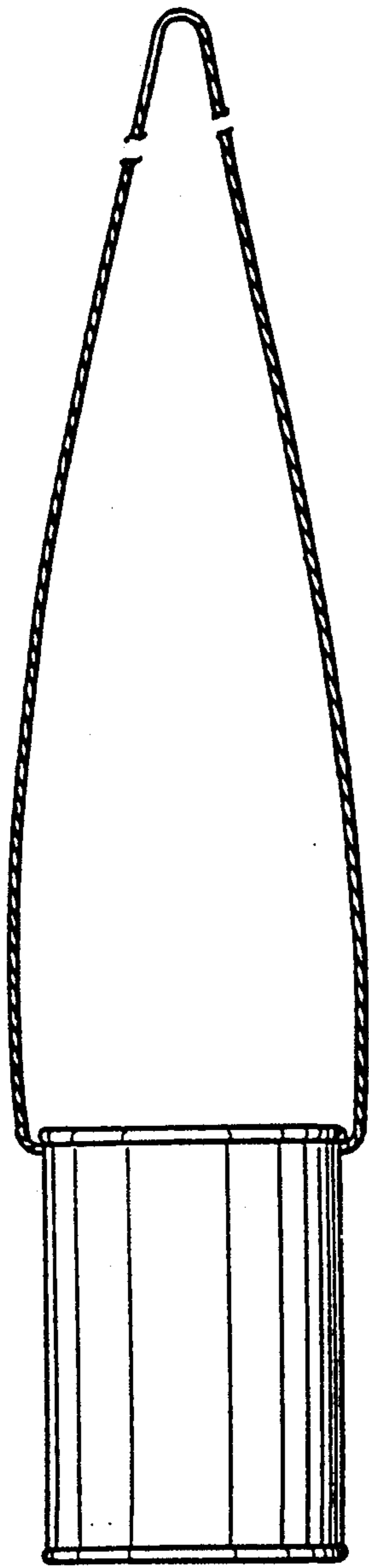

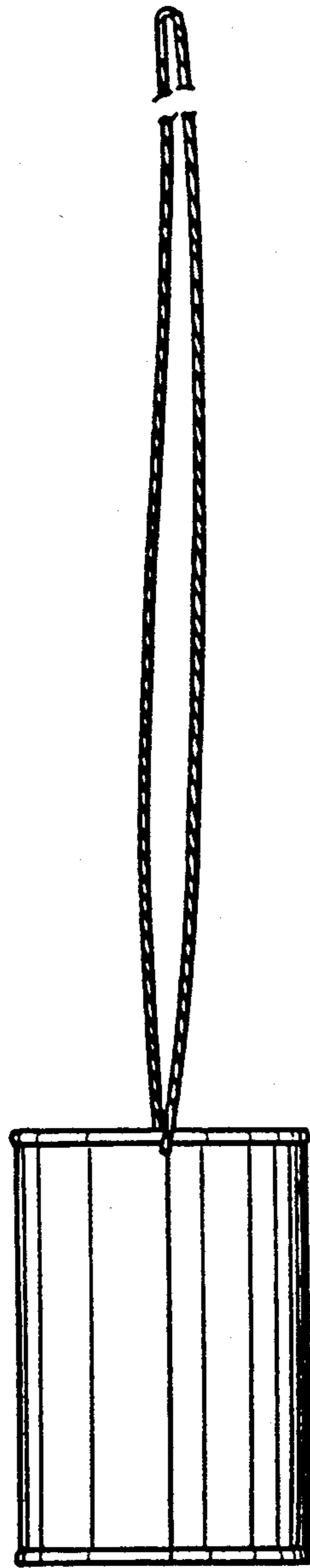

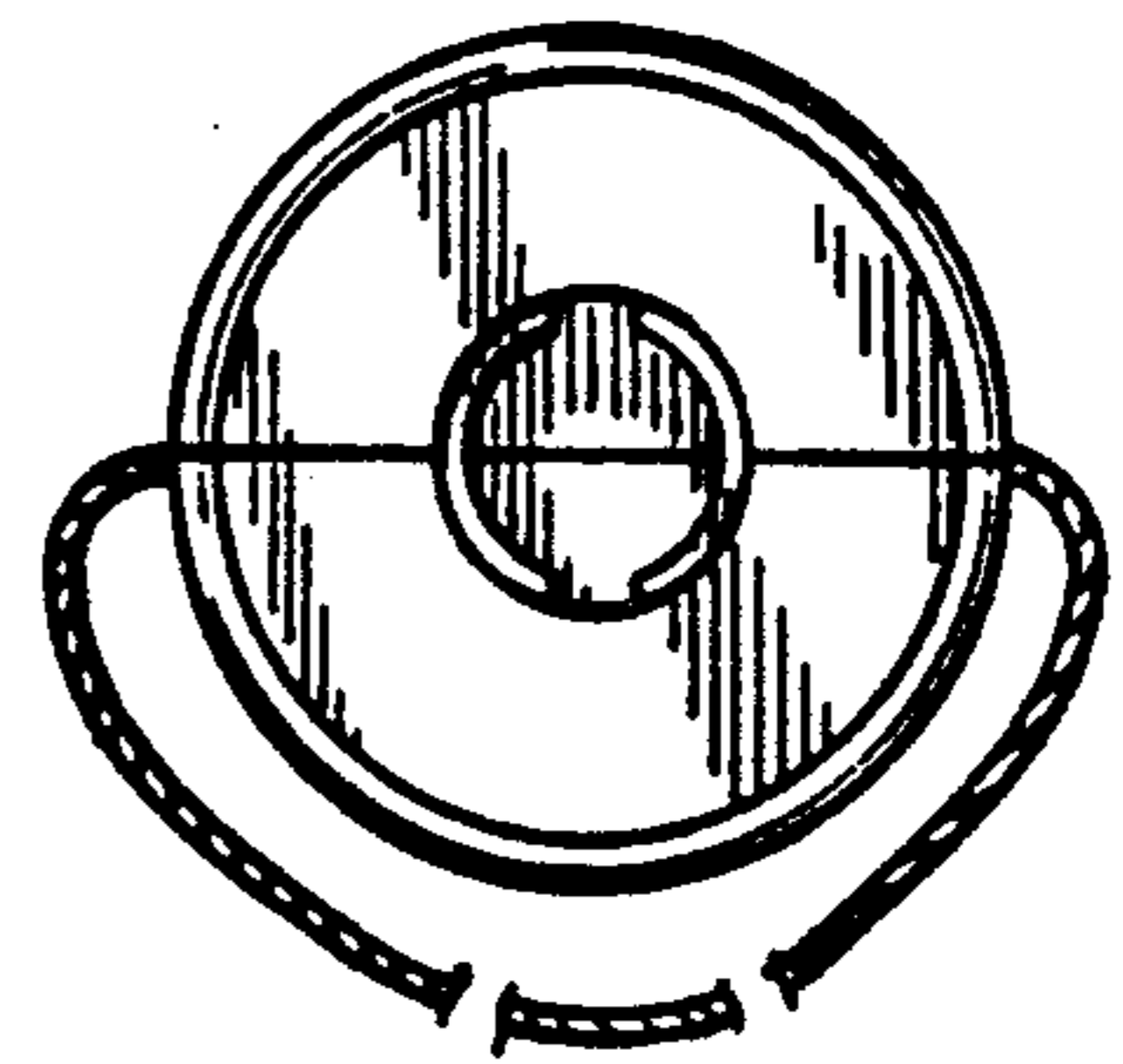

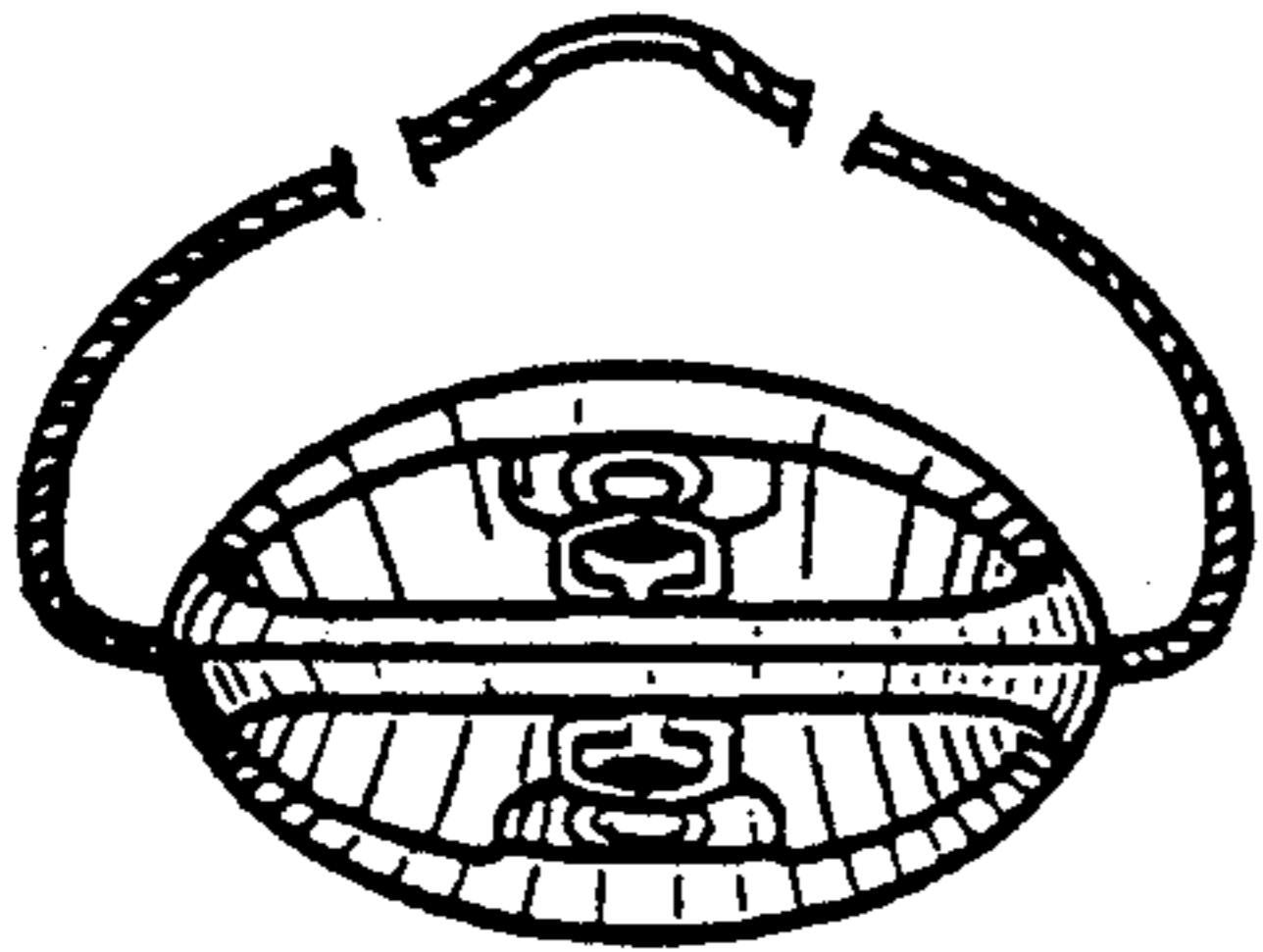

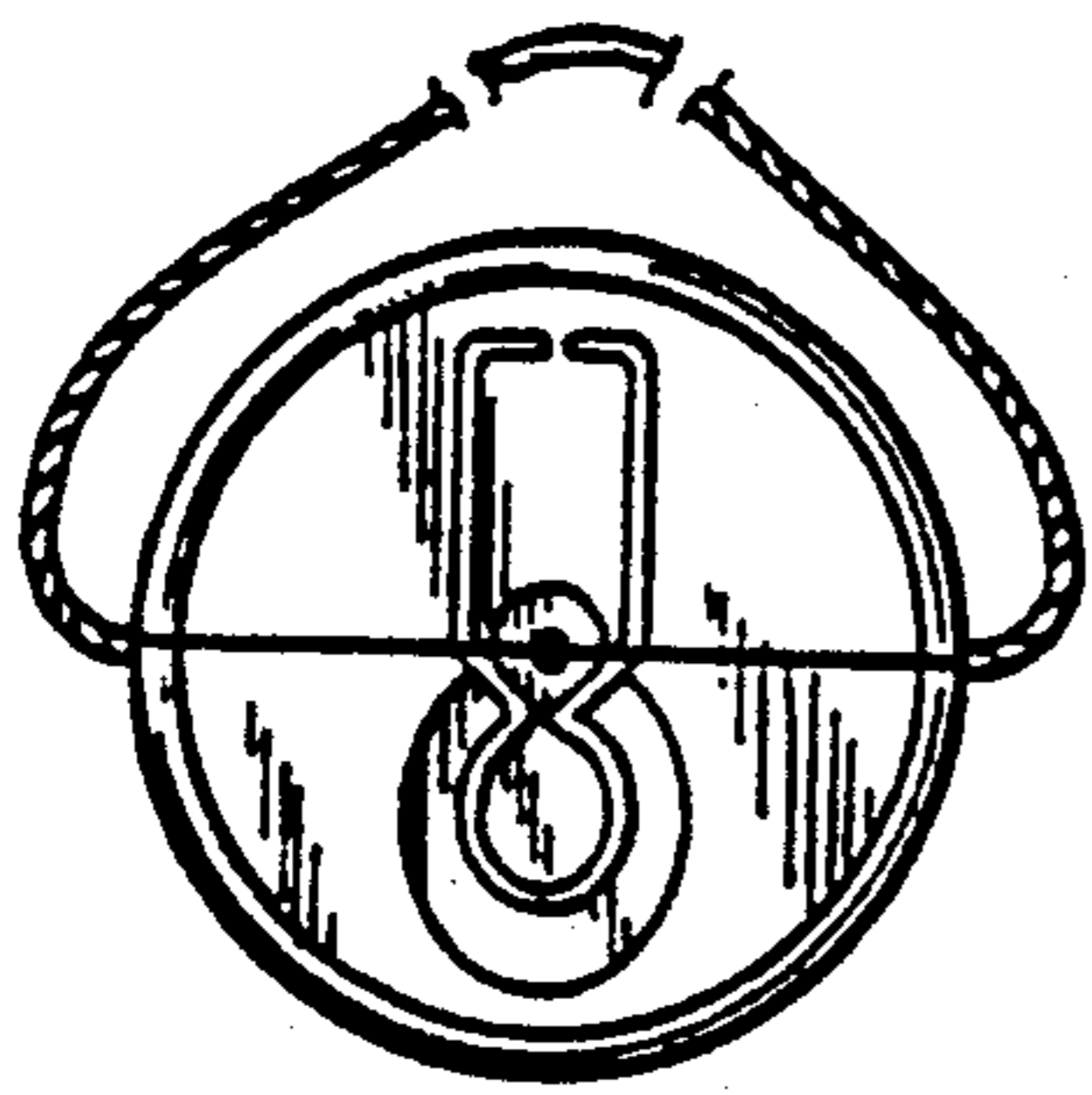

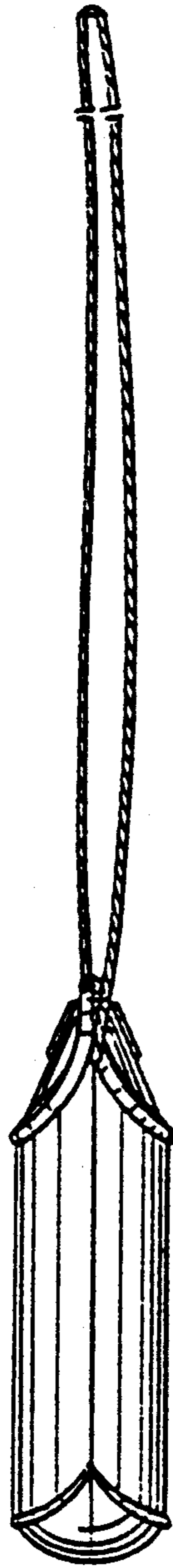

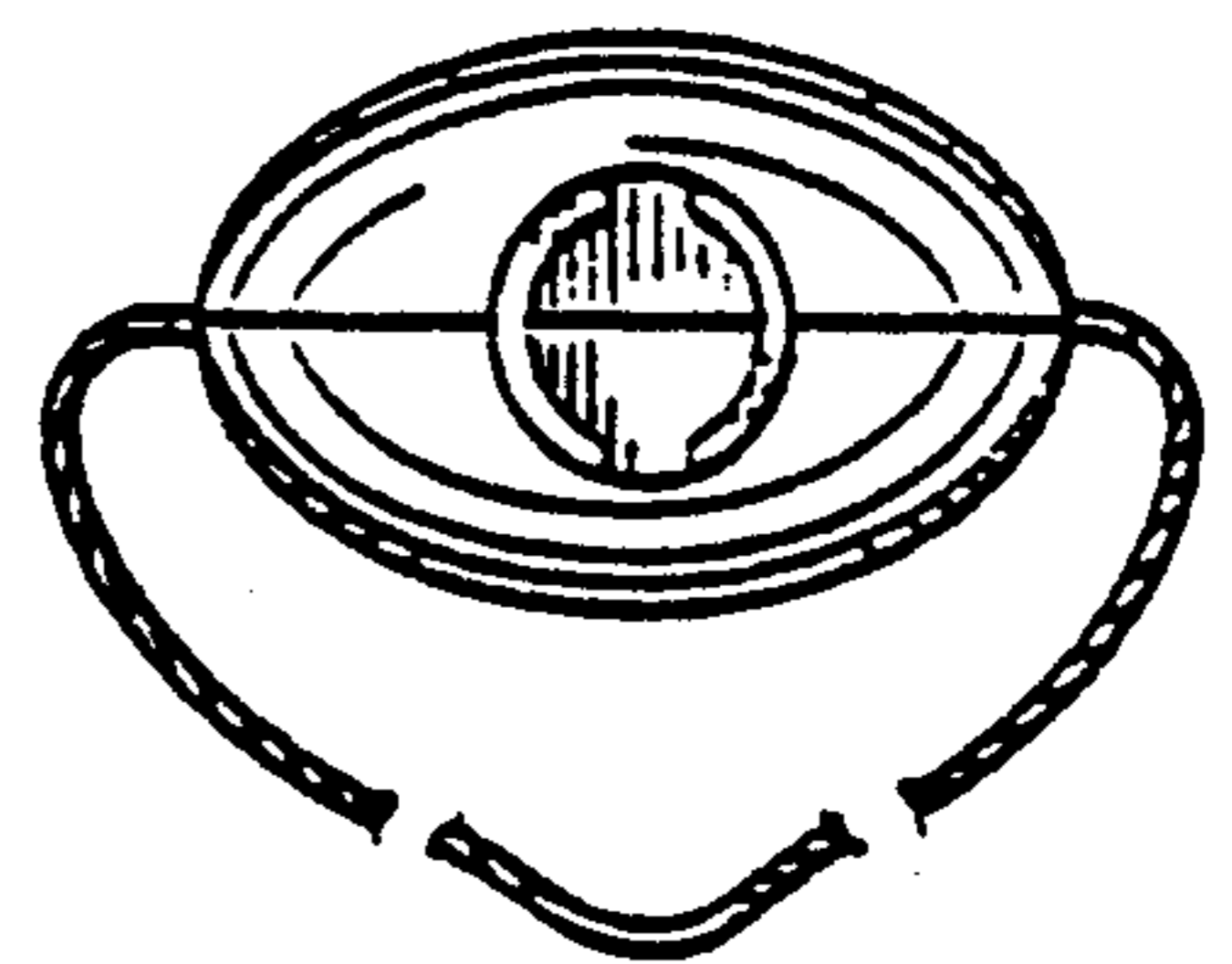
