DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side and rear perspective view of an infant knee pad showing our new design;

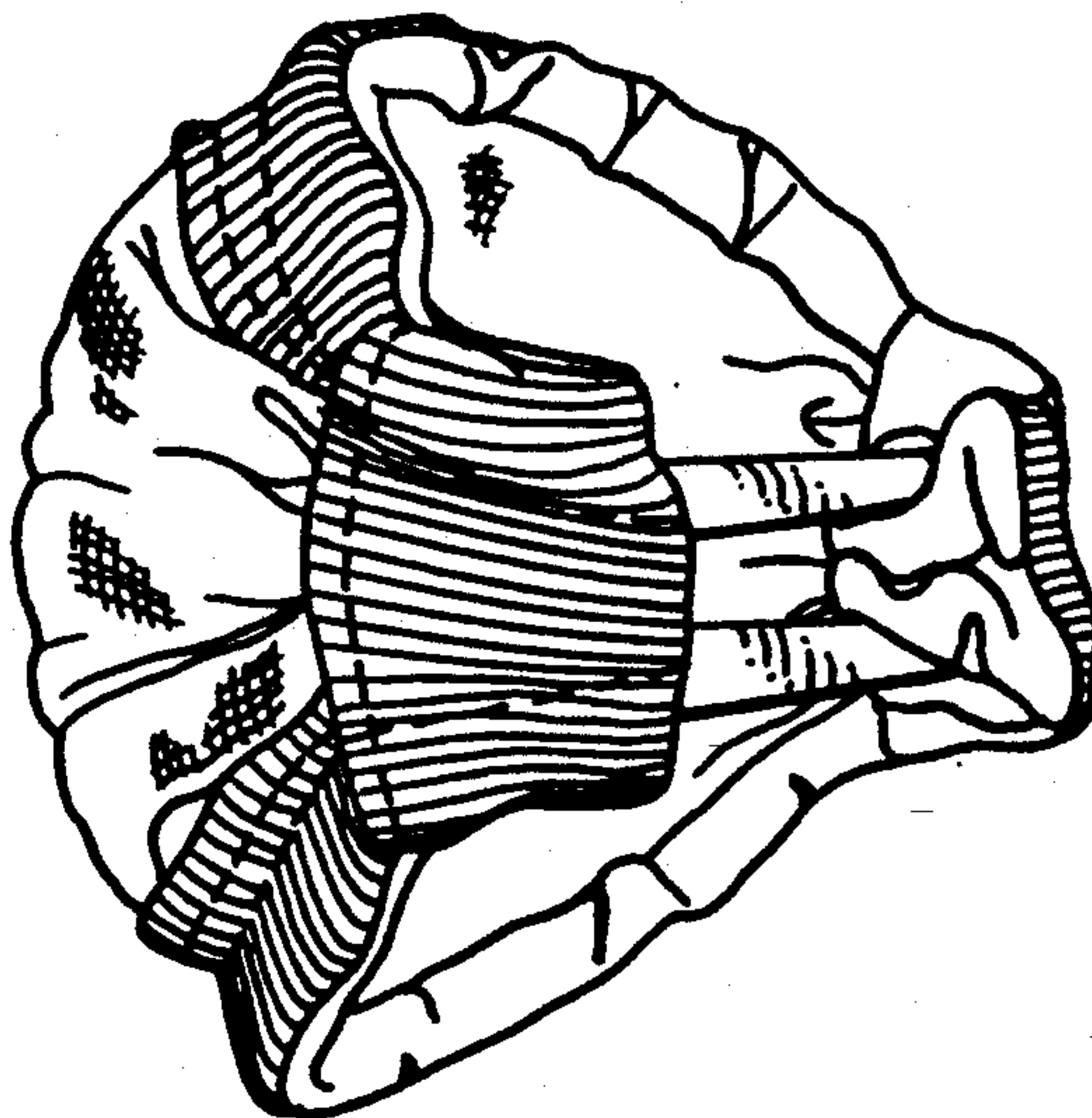
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

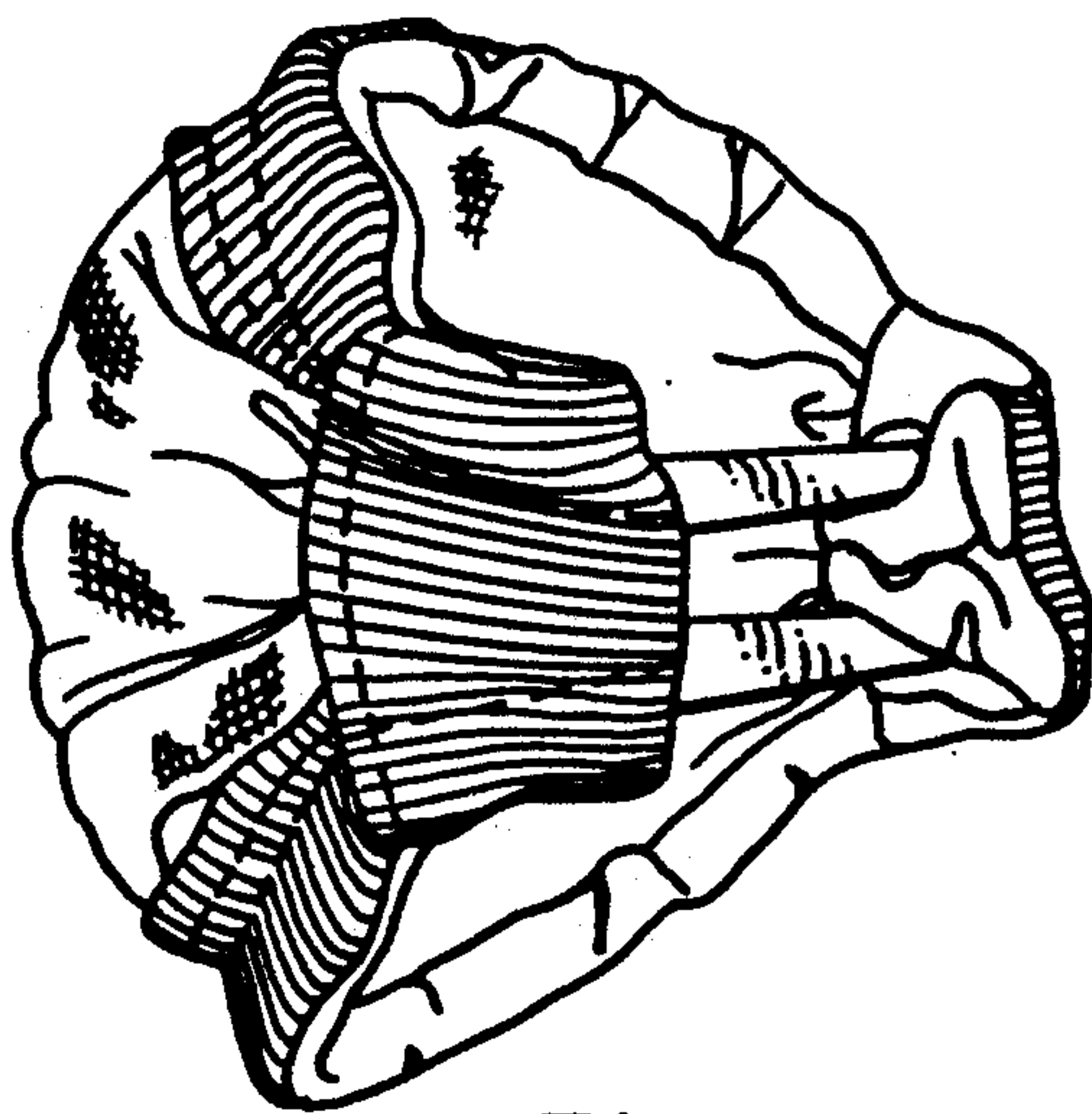

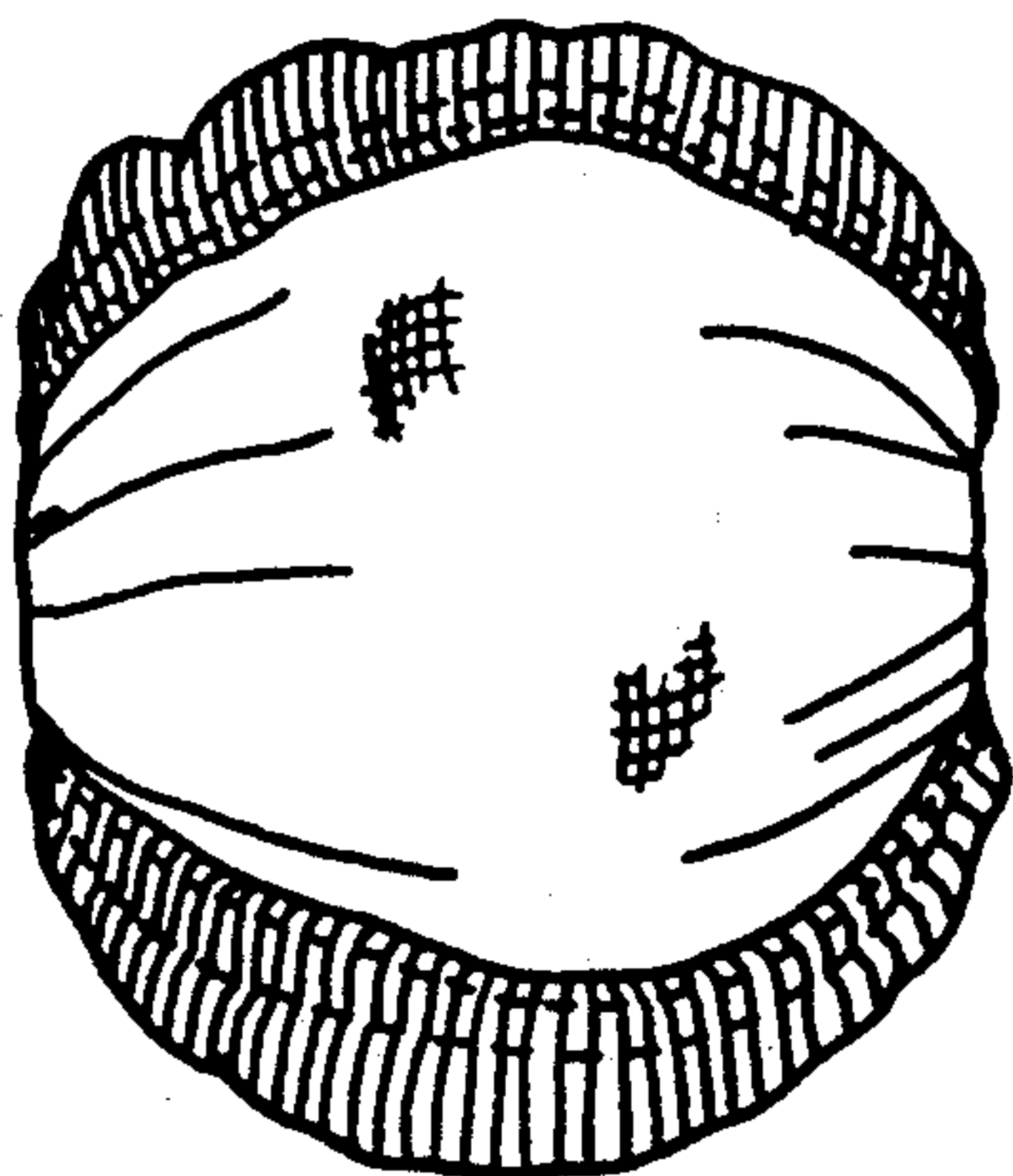

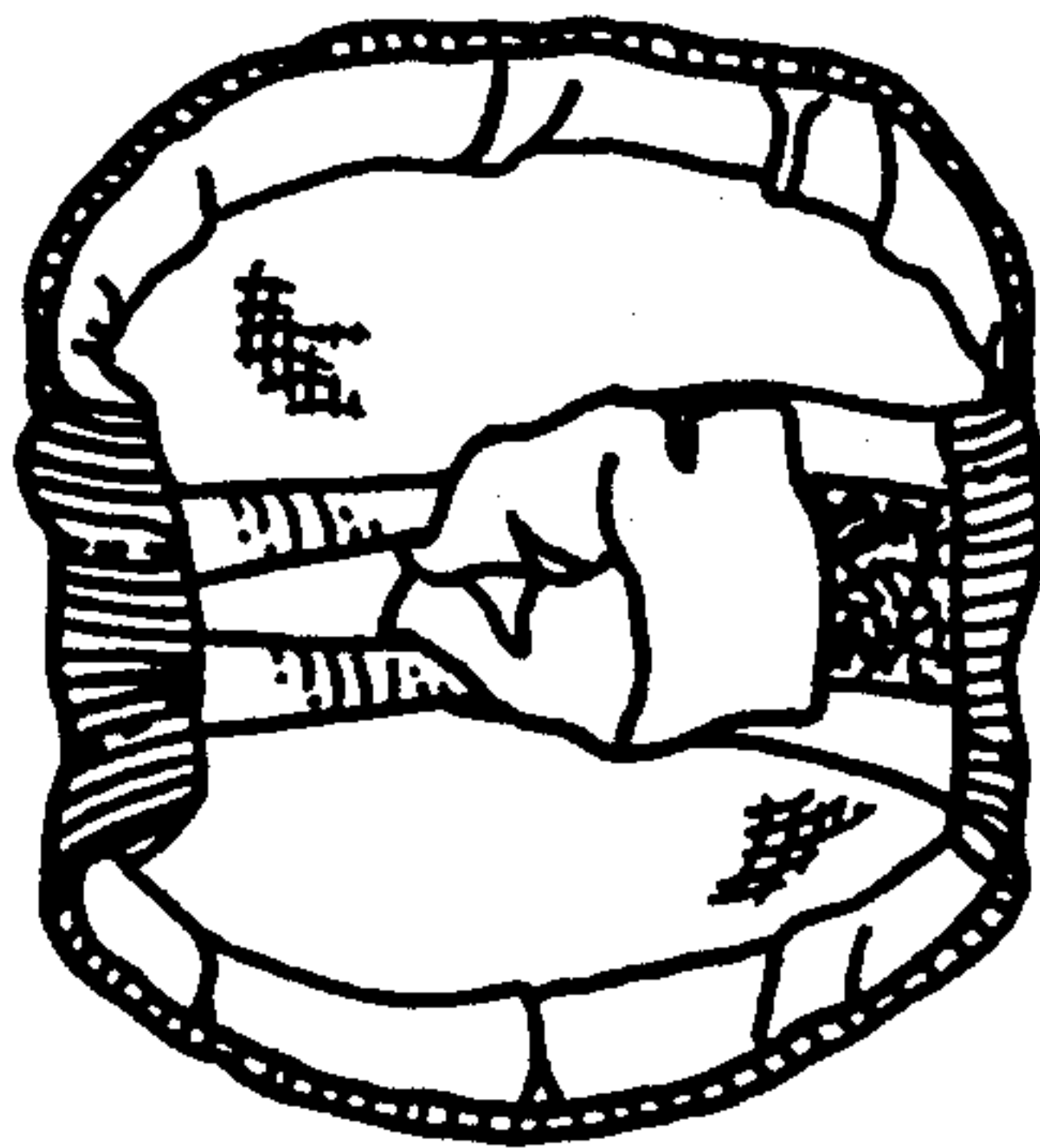

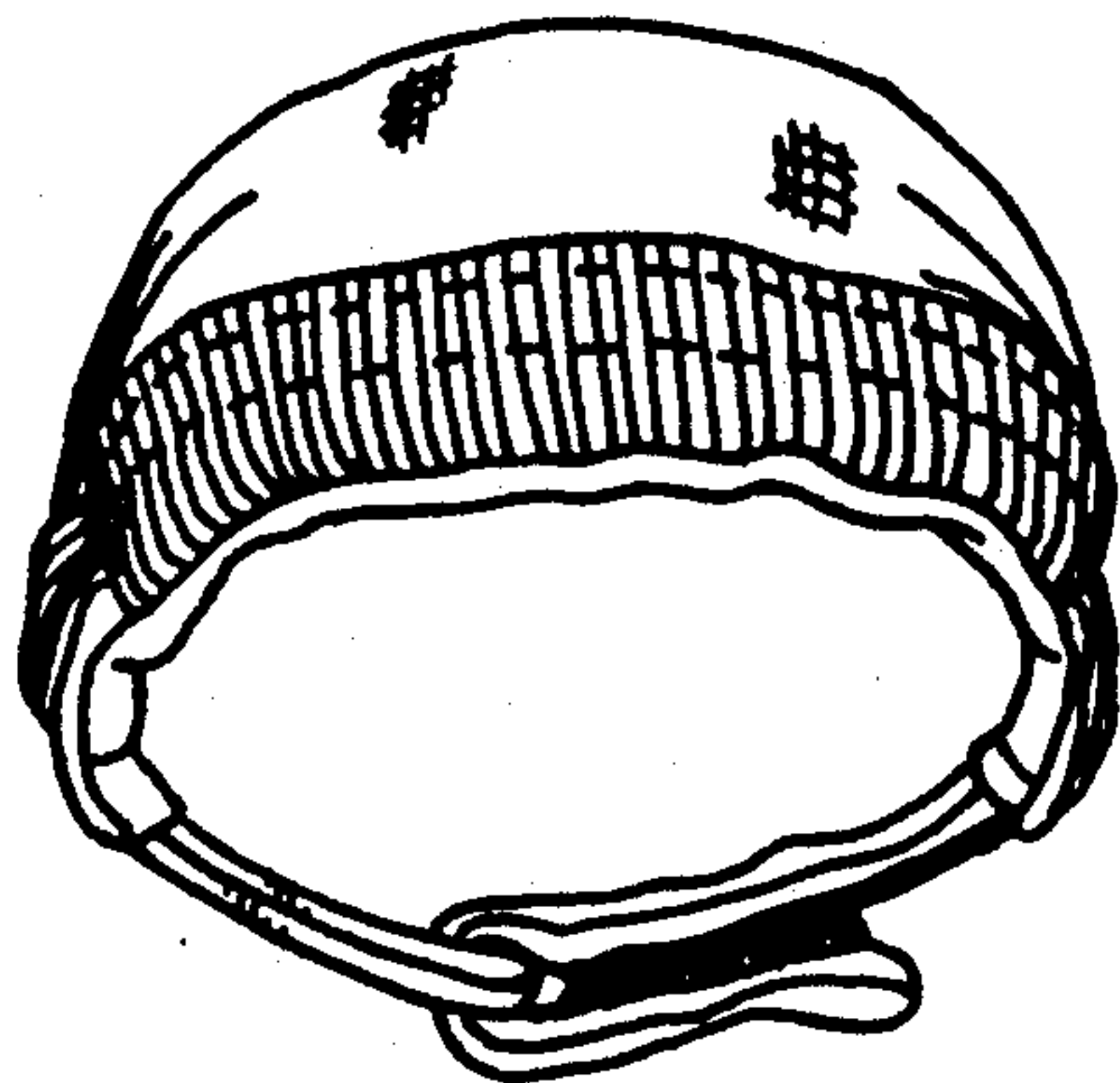

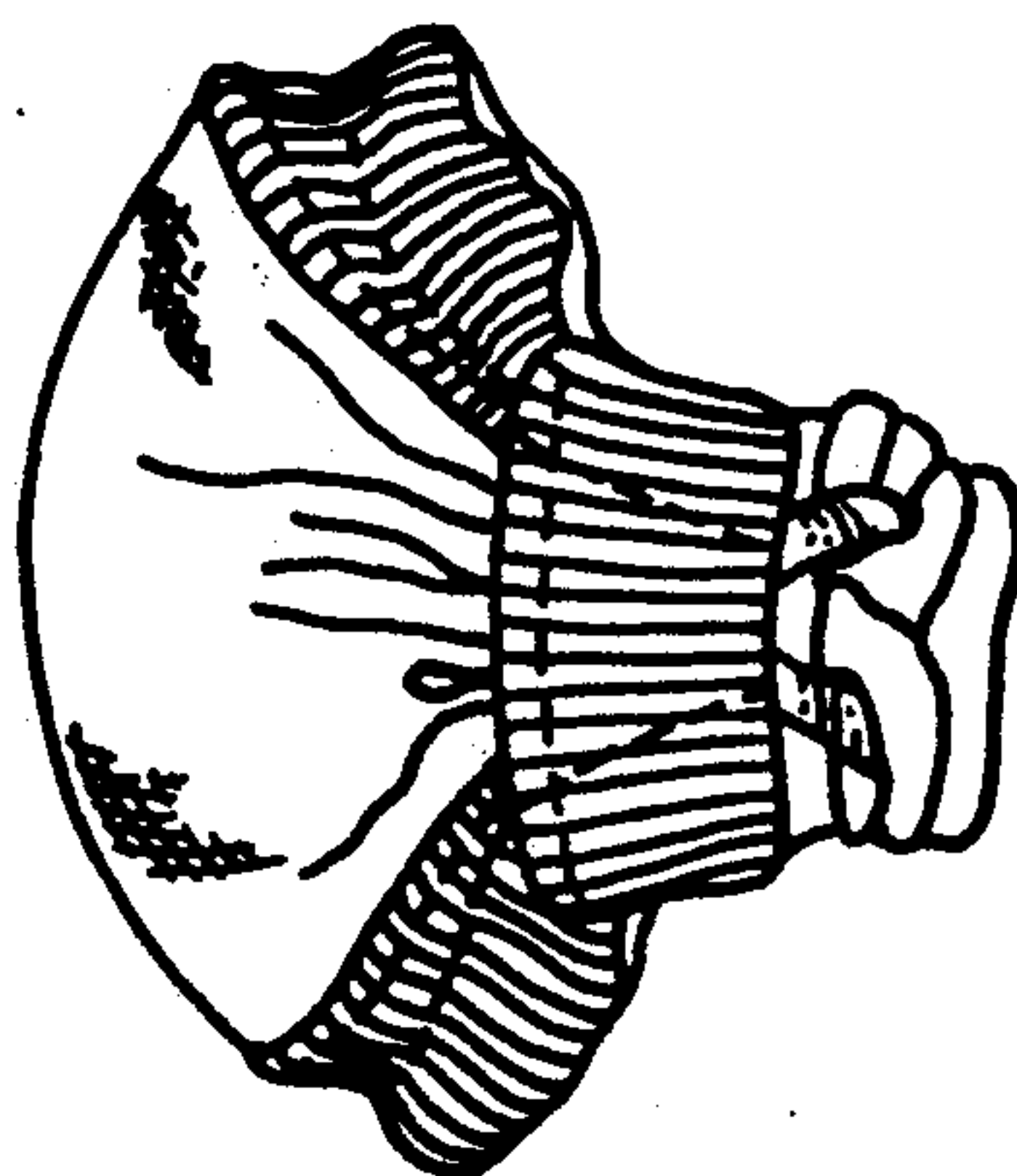
