[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a marine air mattress with expandable bladder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top (or bottom) plan view of the novel marine air mattress with expandable bladder; FIG. 2 is a frontal elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side (either) elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof on a reduced scale. The broken line showing of environmental structure shown in FIG. 5, is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

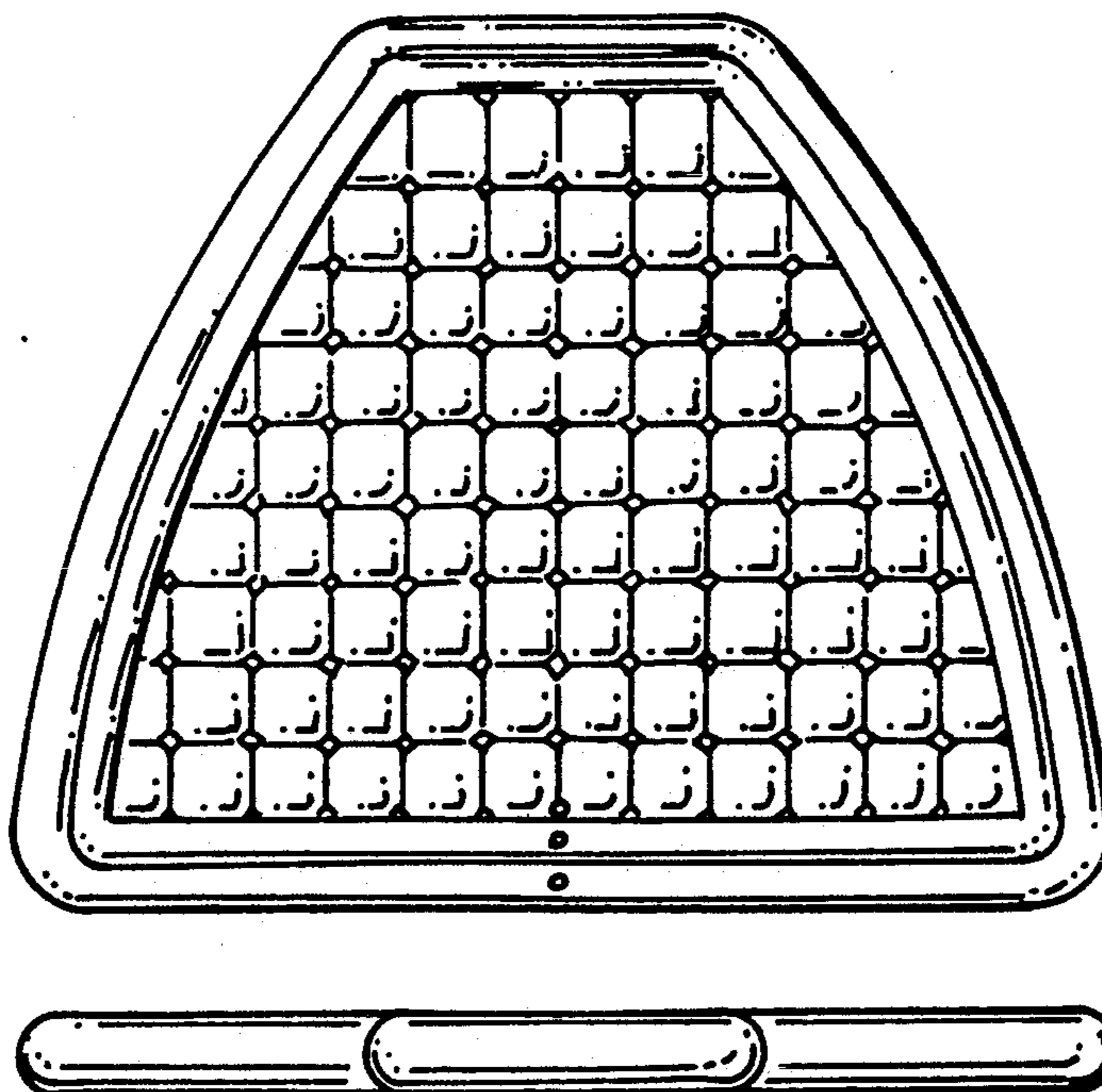

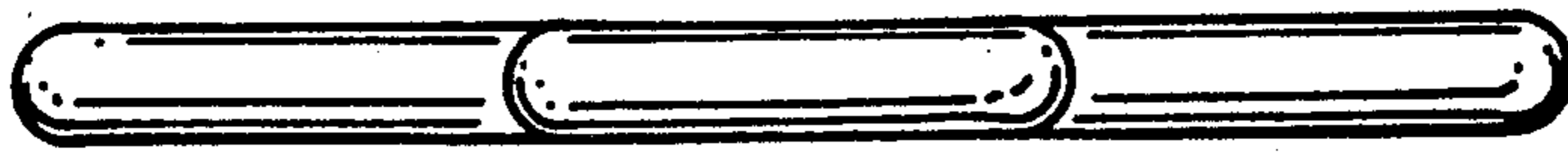

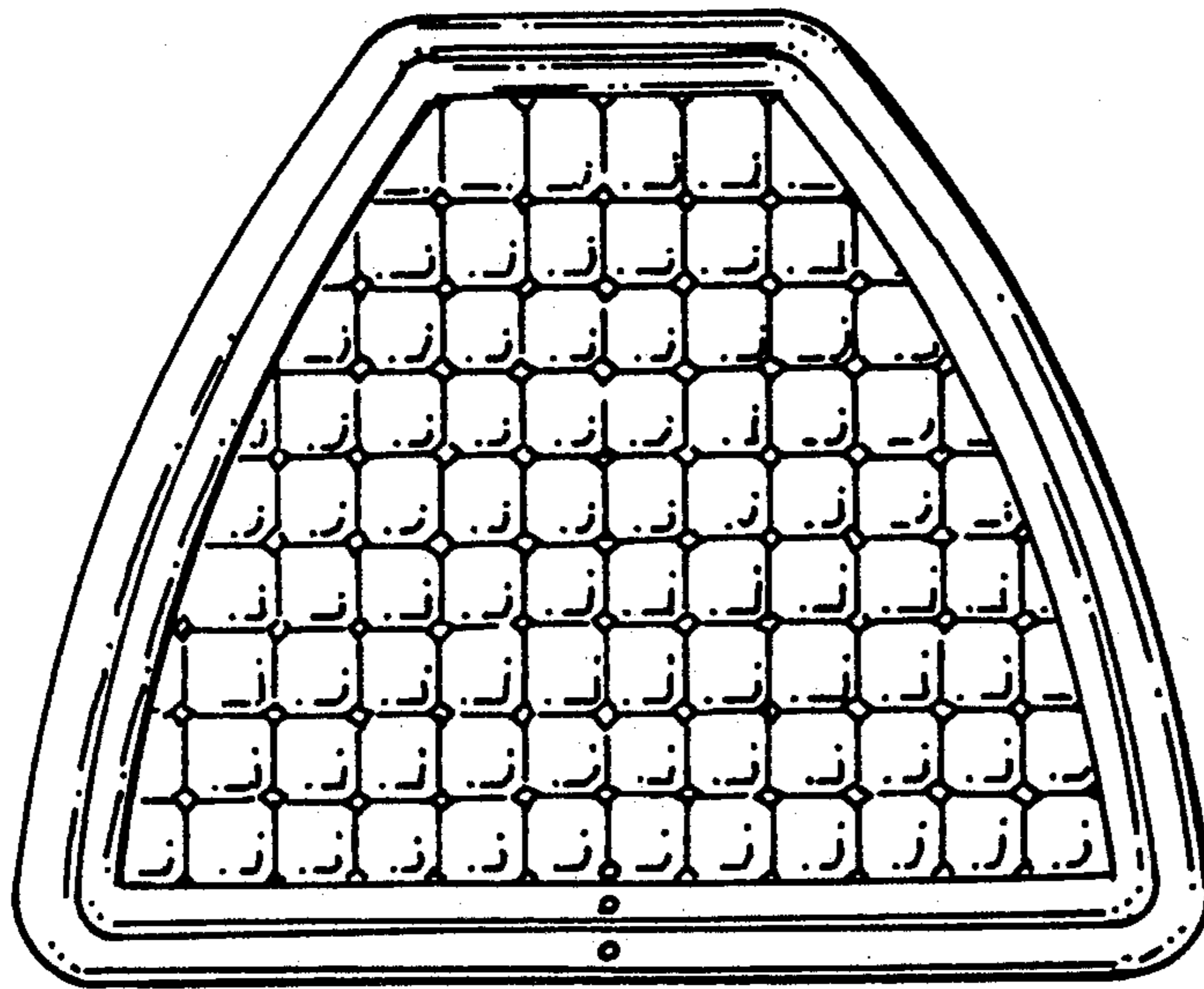
