FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof, with the viewfinder in an alternate position.

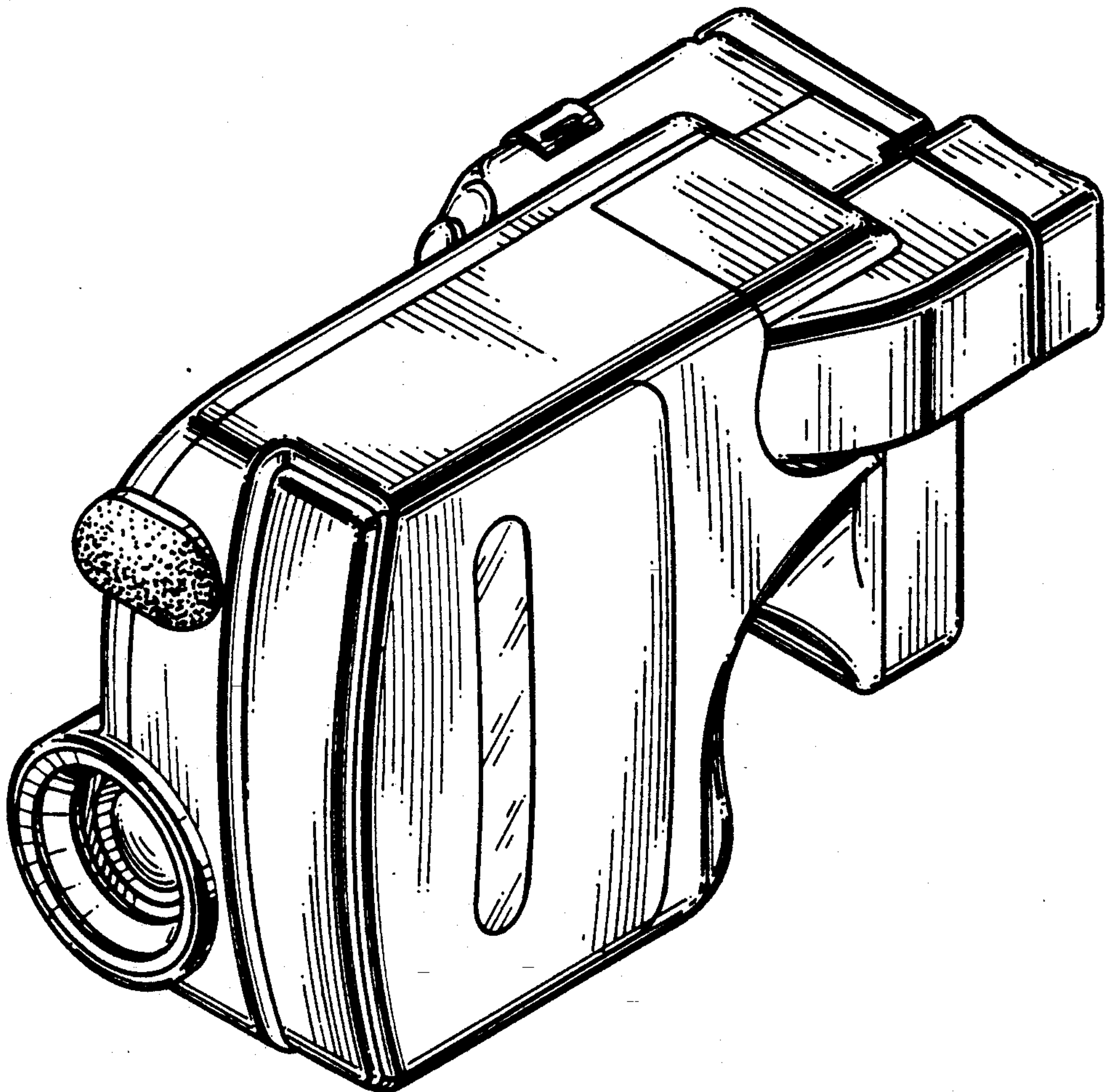

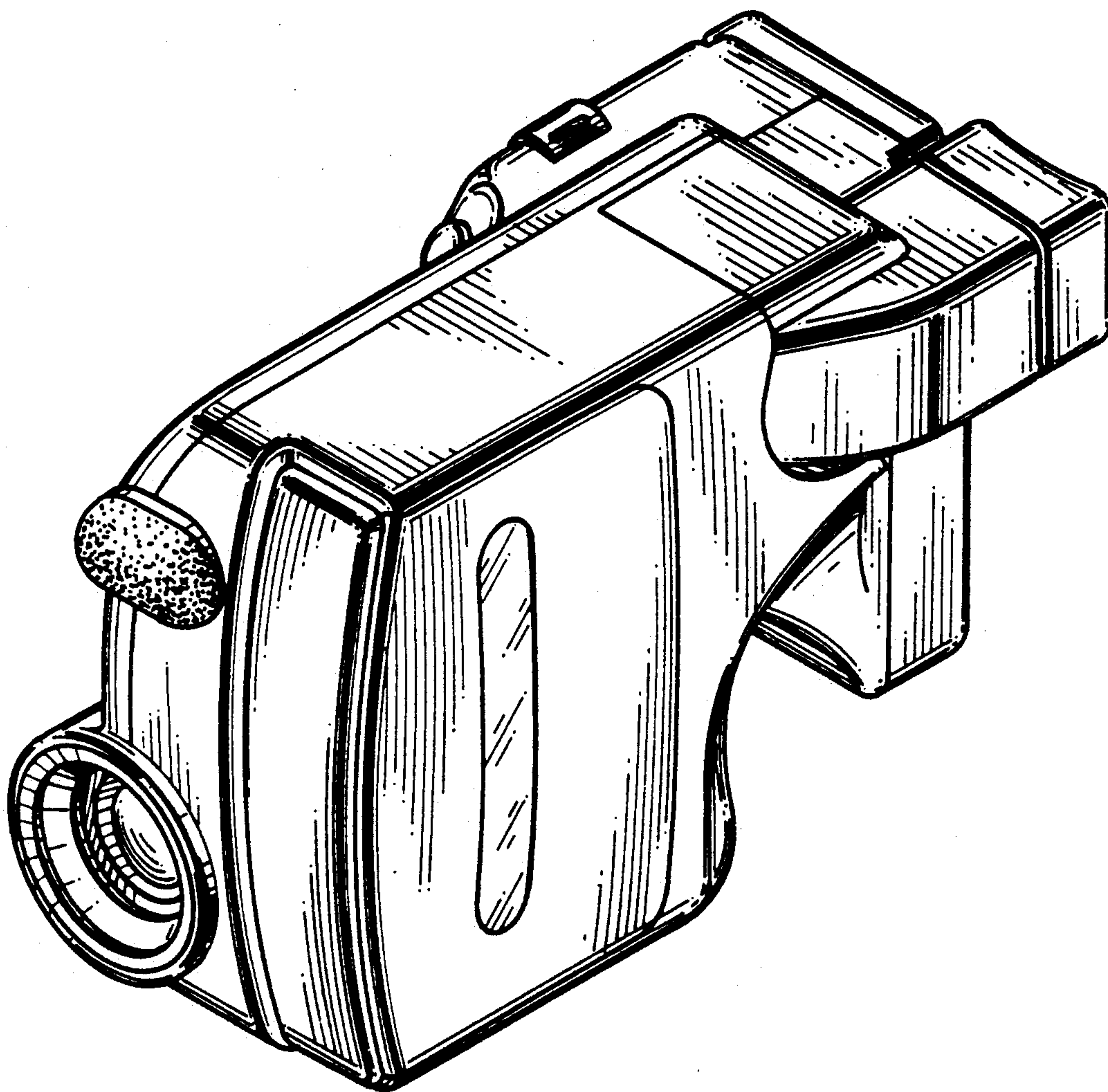

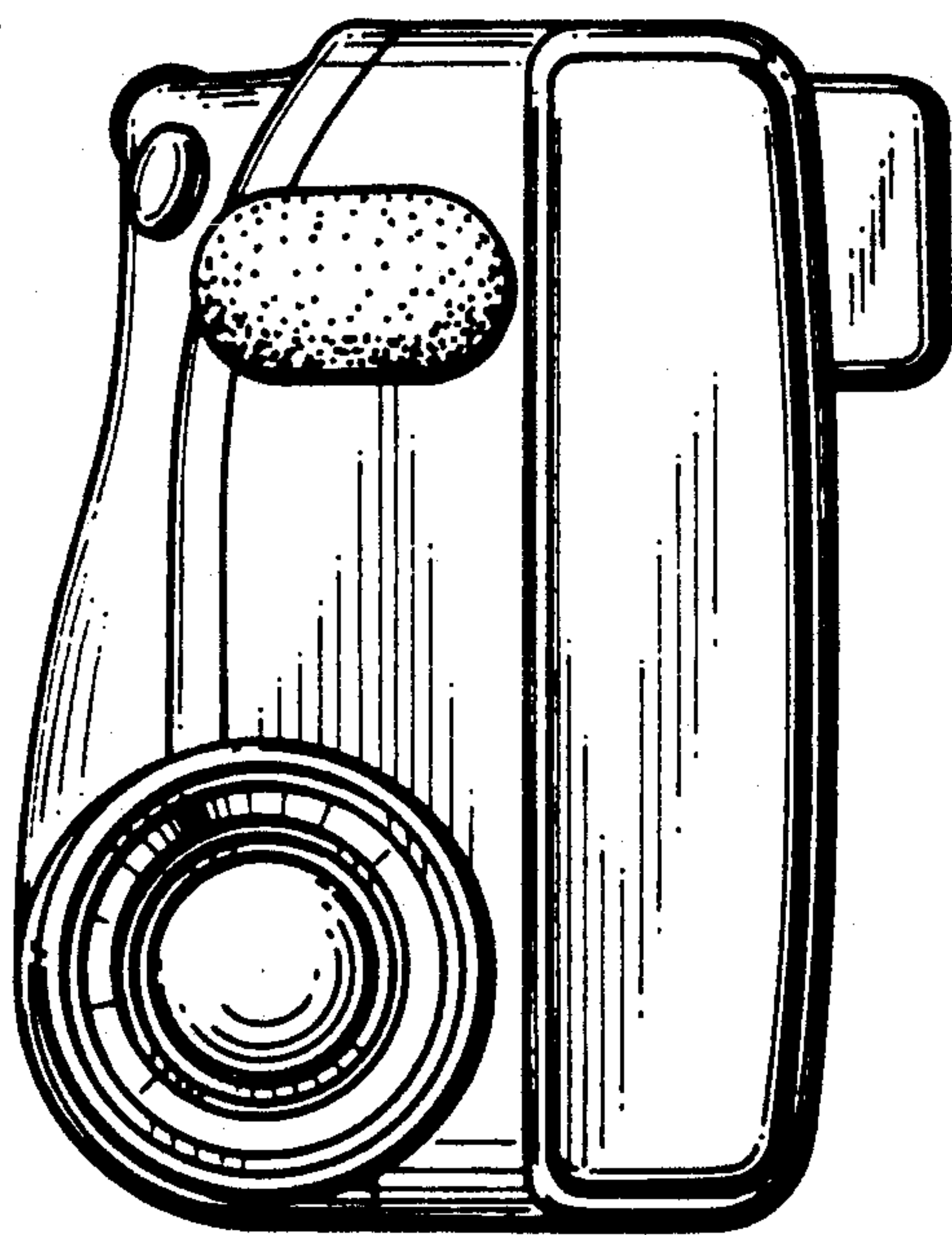

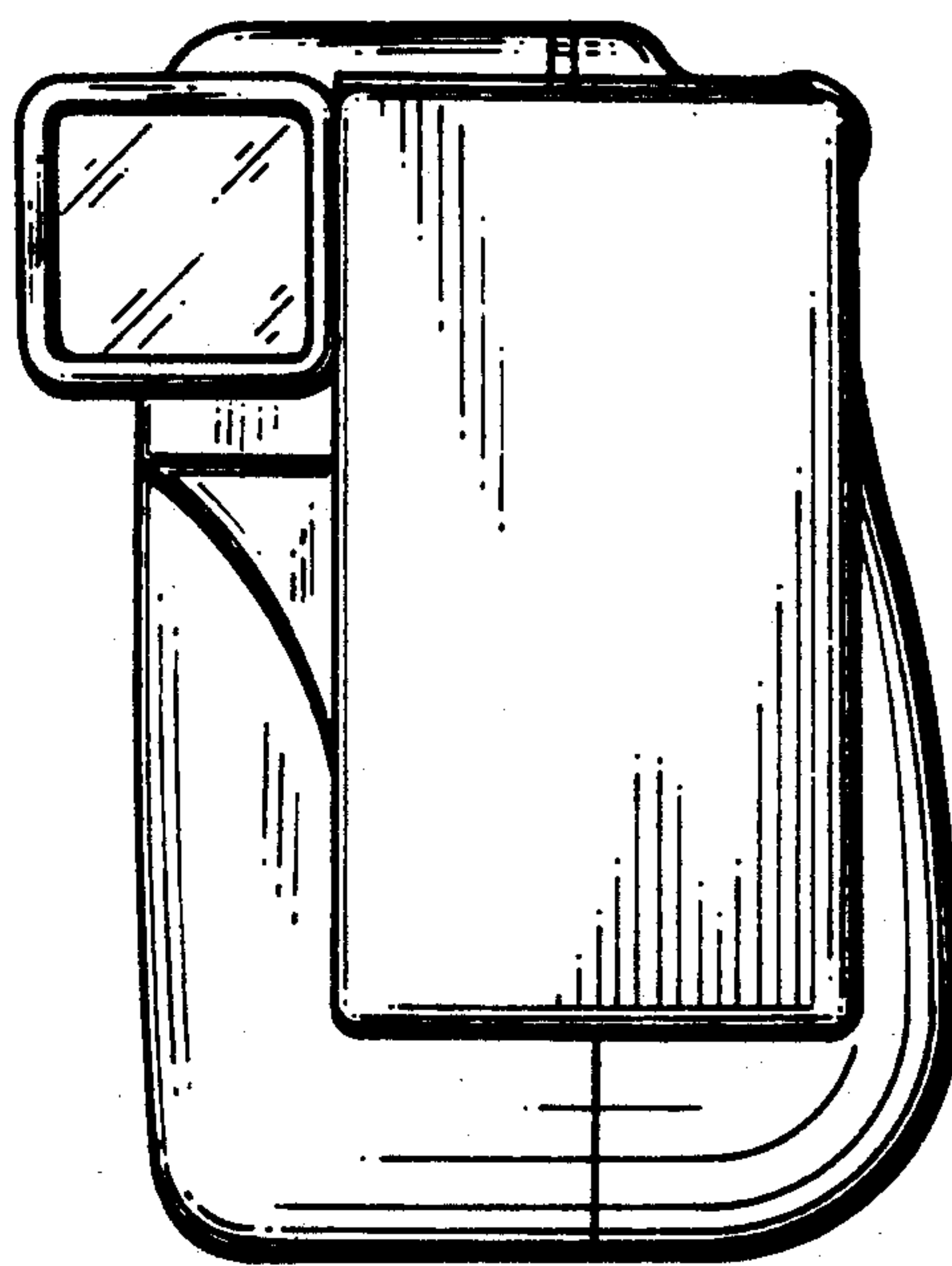

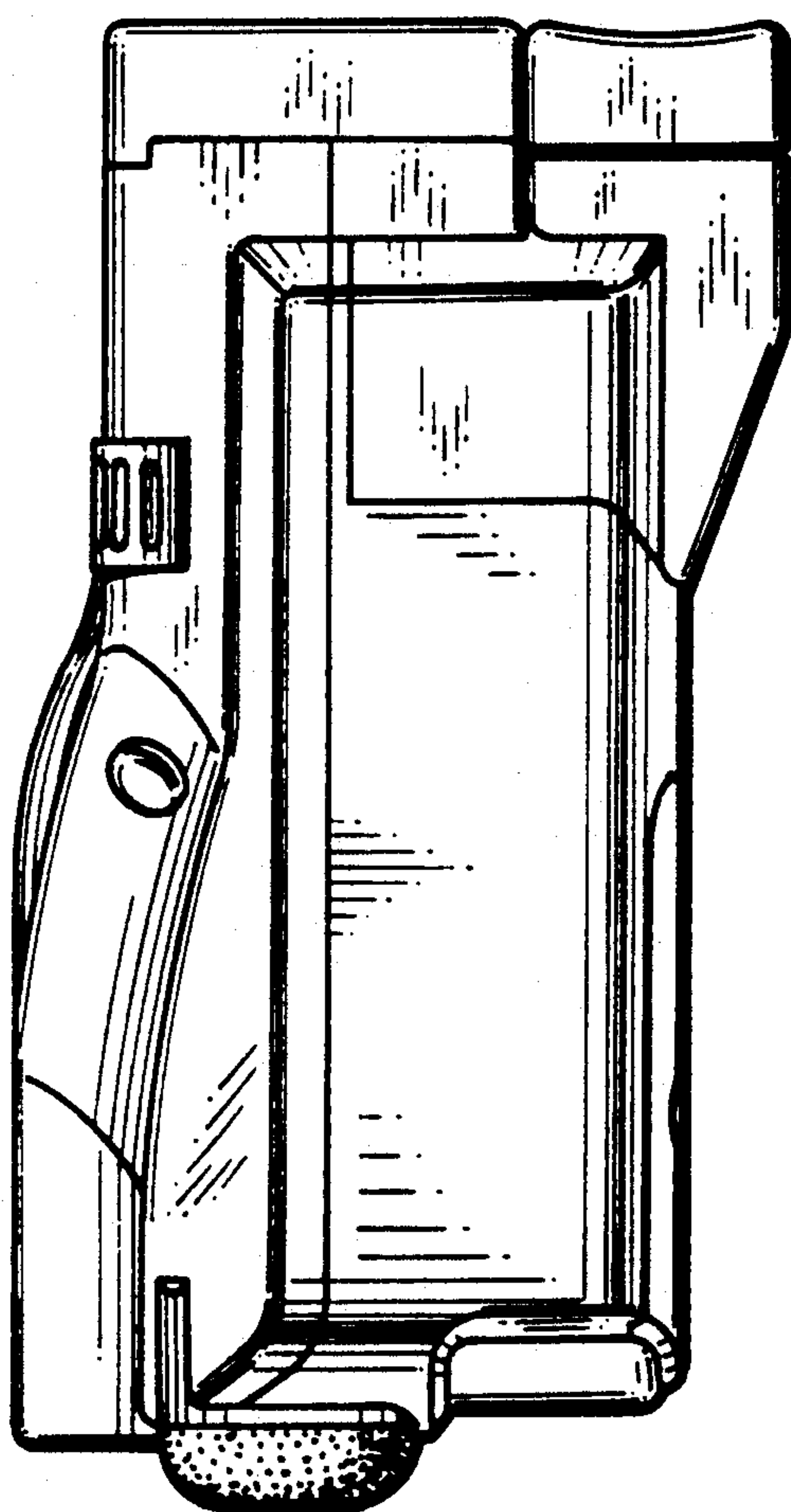

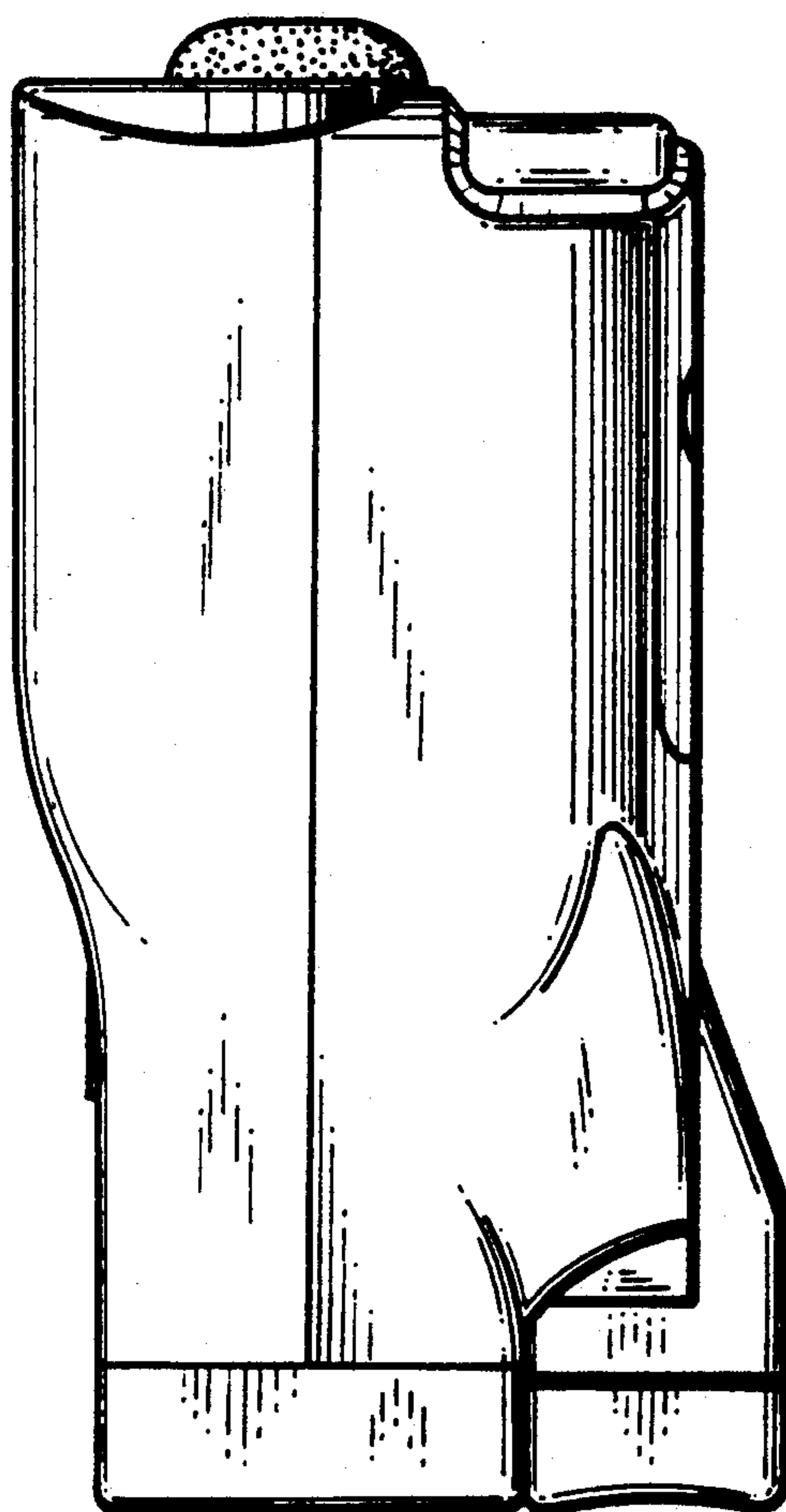

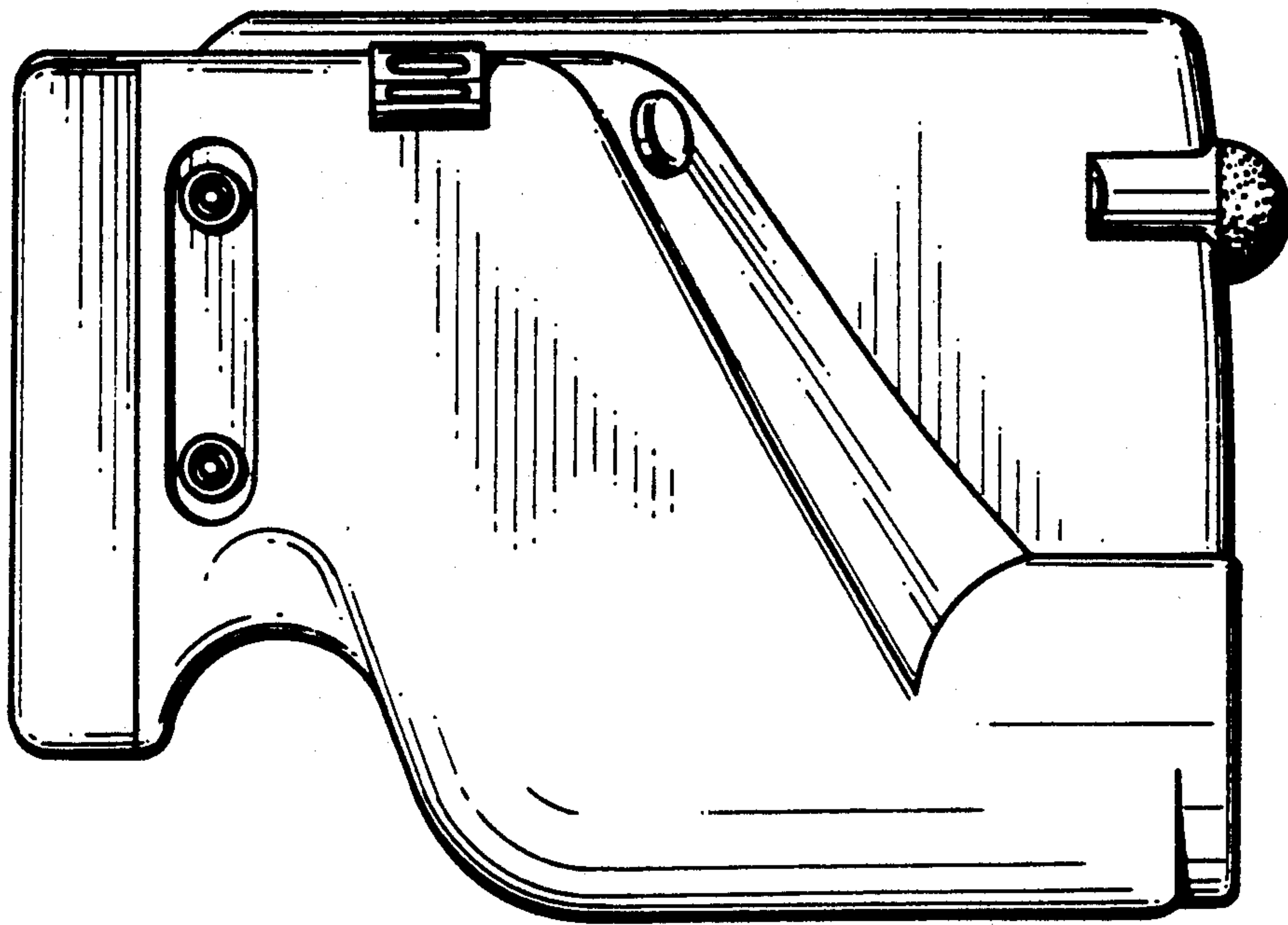

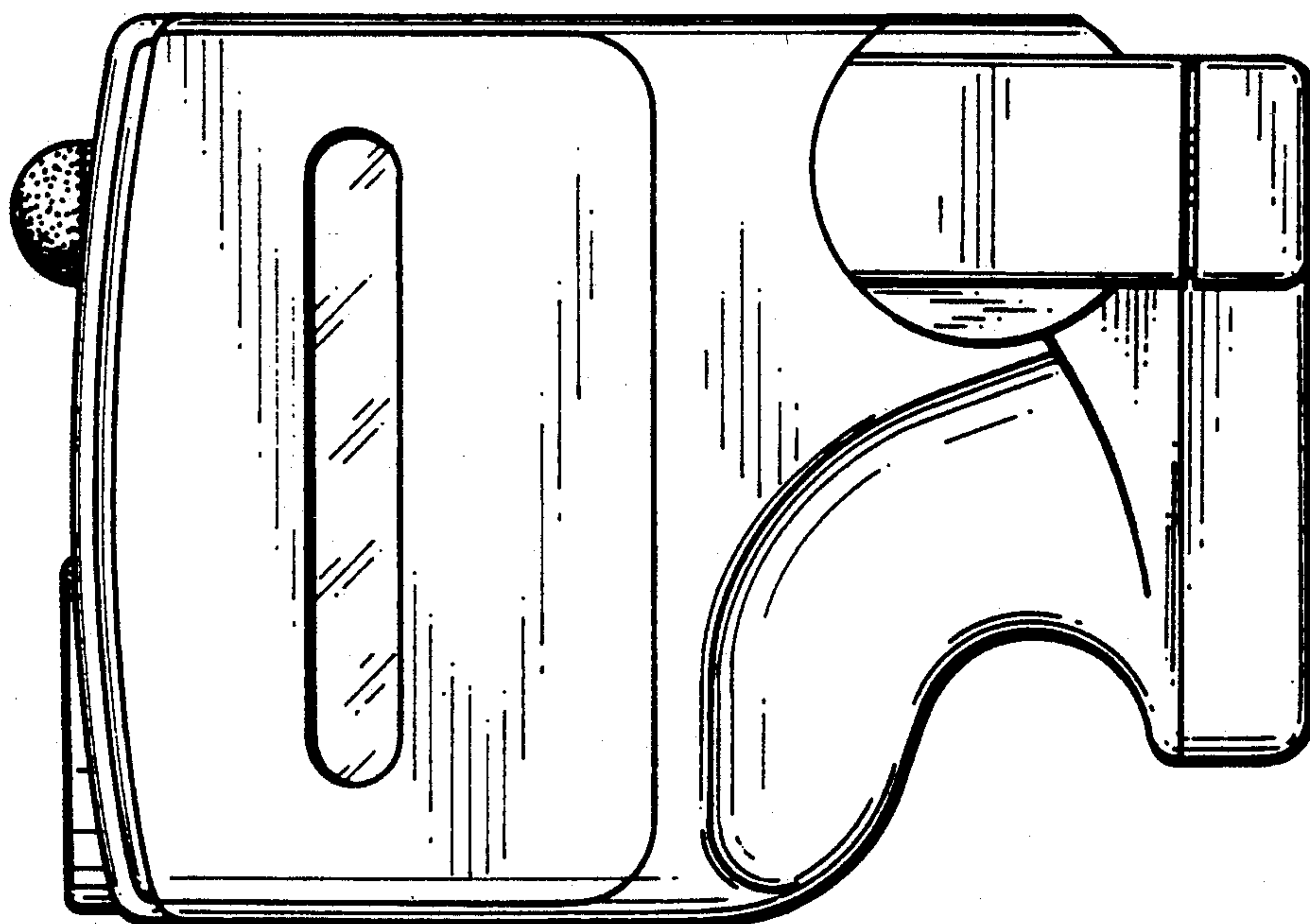
