### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a writing instrument, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a writing instrument showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1:

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the writing instrument of FIG.

FIG. 4 is an enlarged bottom view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged top view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the writing instrument of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design;

FIG. 8 is a side view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7:

FIG. 9 is a rear view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7:

FIG. 10 is an enlarged bottom view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;


FIG. 11 is an enlarged top view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;


FIG. 12 is a perspective view of the writing instrument of FIG. 7;


FIG. 13 is an enlarged, fragmentary, front elevational view of FIG. 1; and,

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the particularly configured clip member as best illustrated in FIGS. 12, 13 and 14.












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







