FIG. 3 is a rear end elevational view thereof;

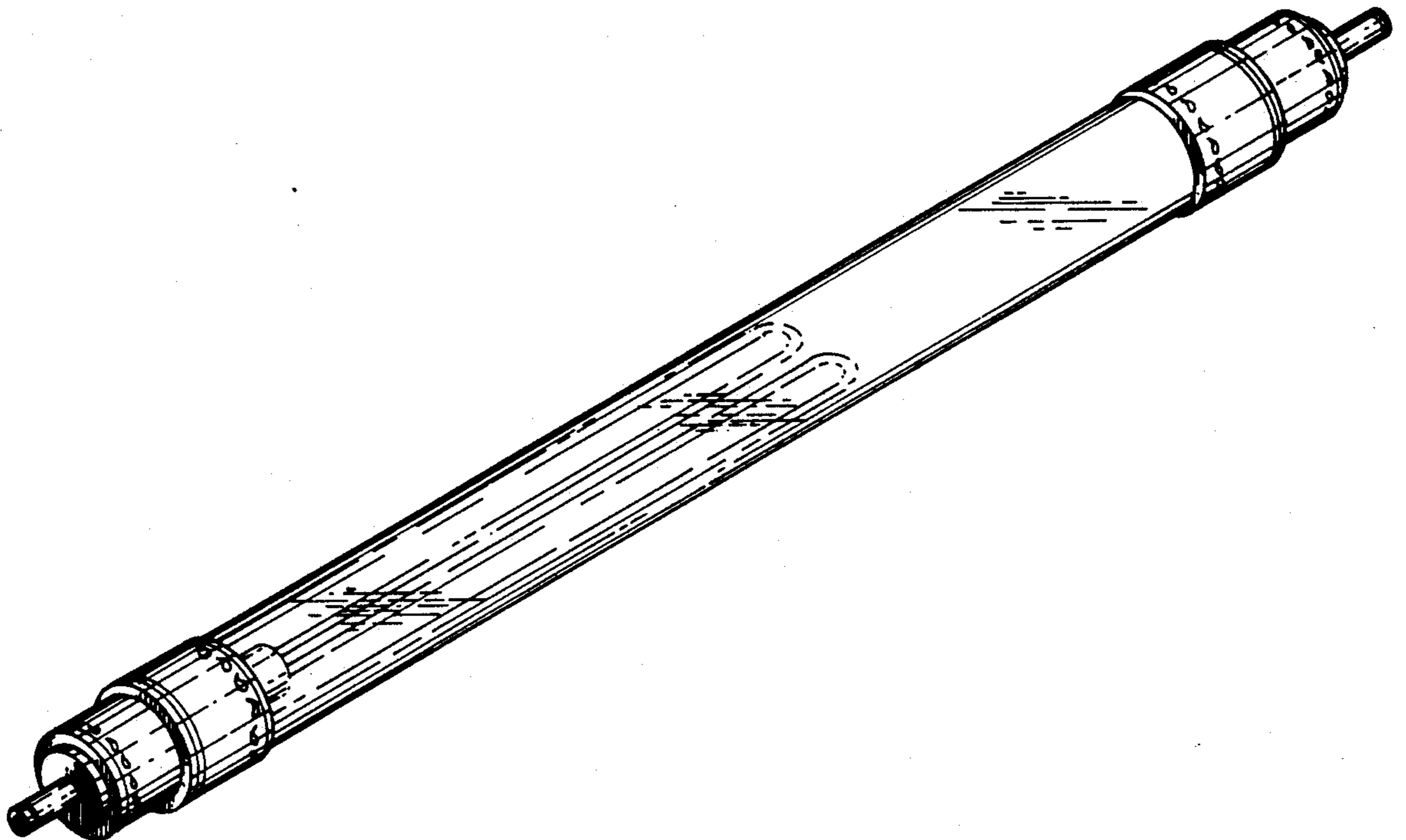
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 4; and,

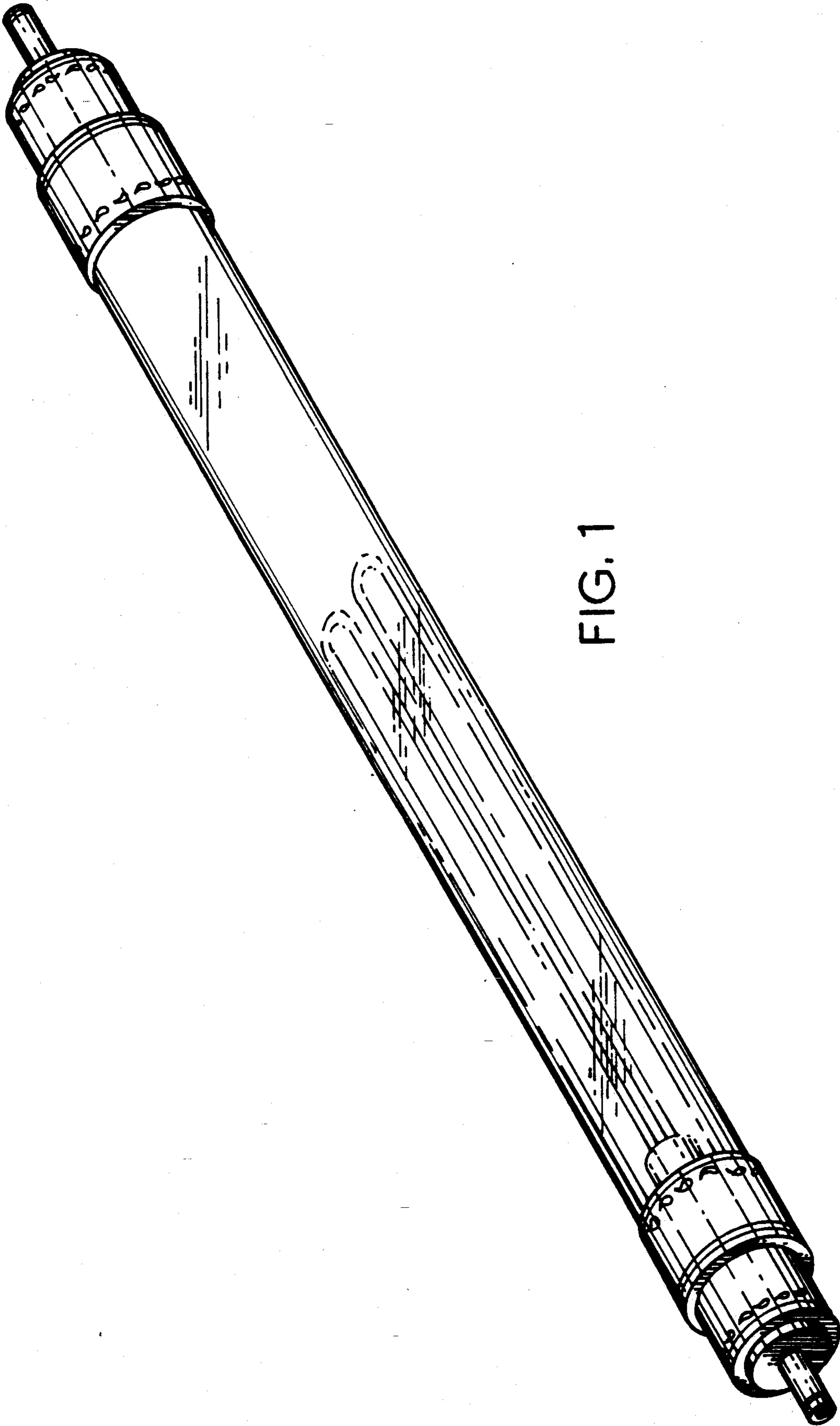

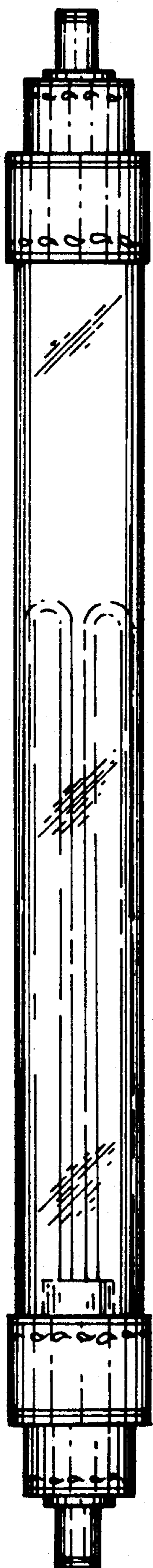

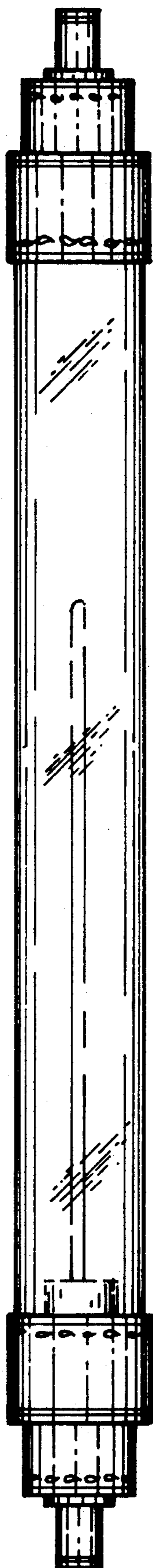

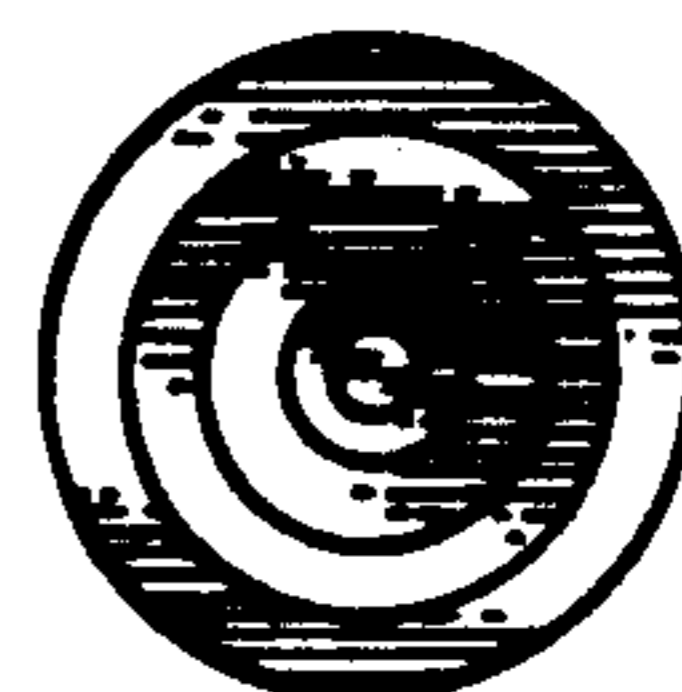
