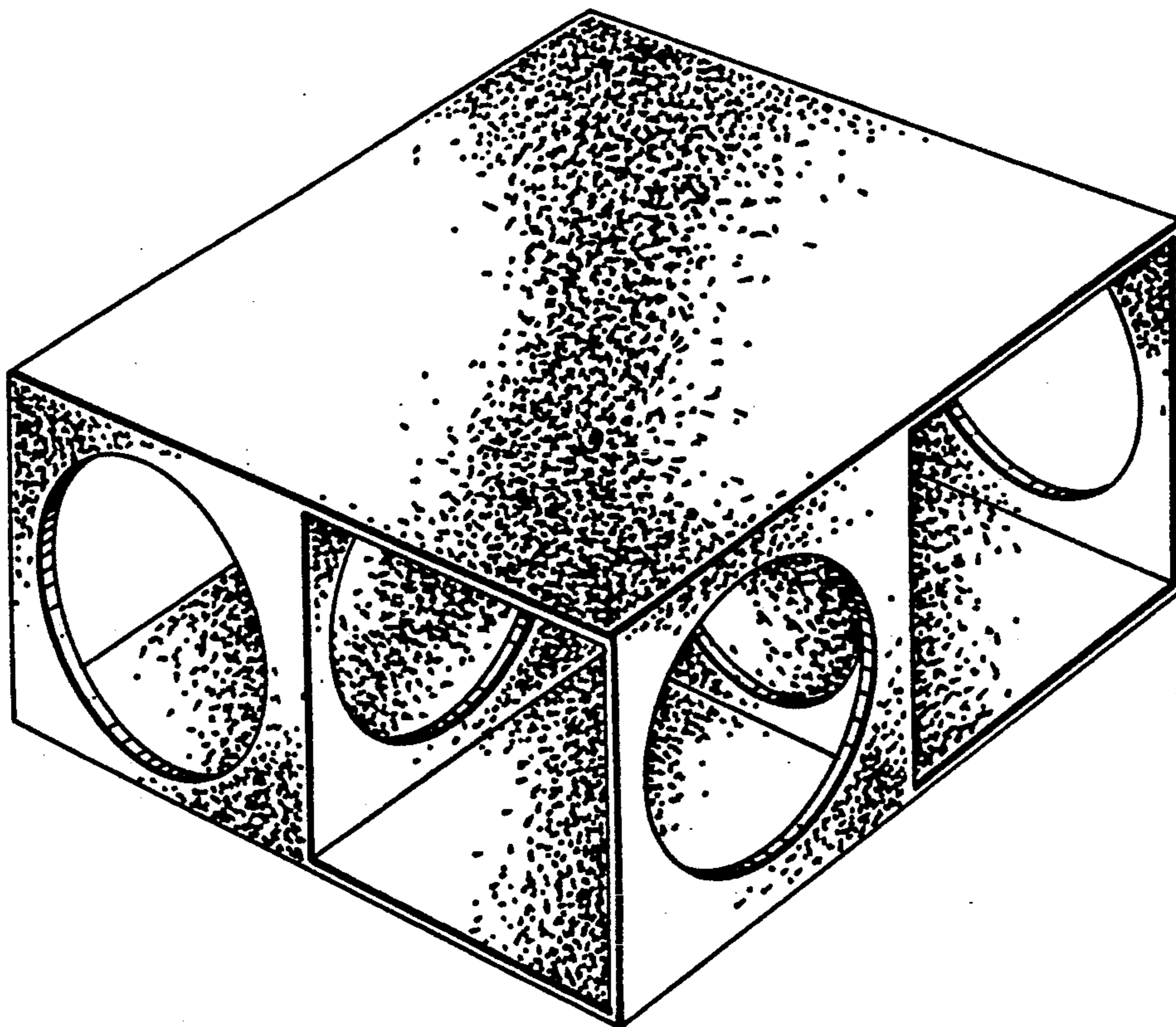

 The top and bottom plan views are drawn at a reduced scale to FIG. 1.



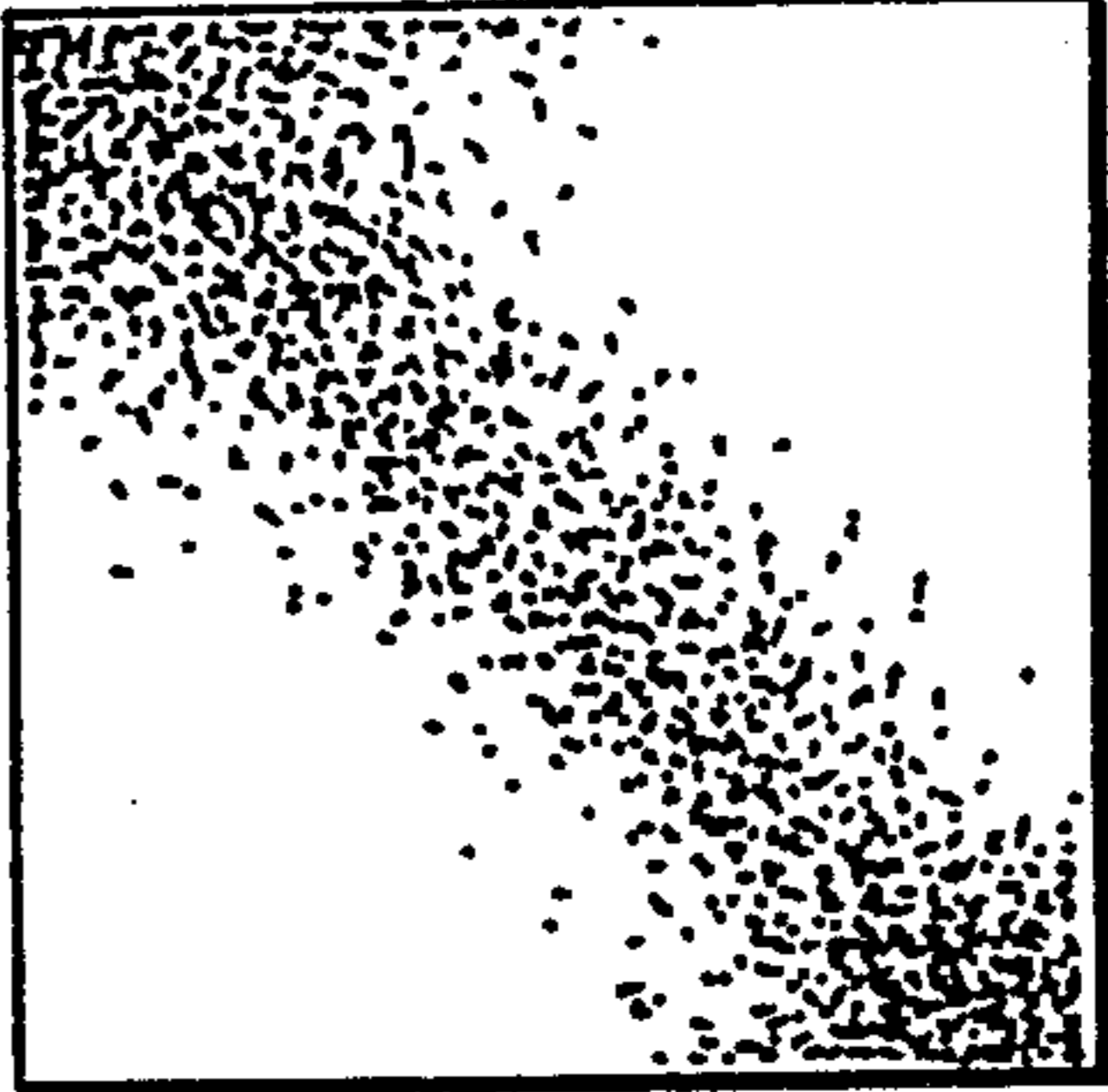
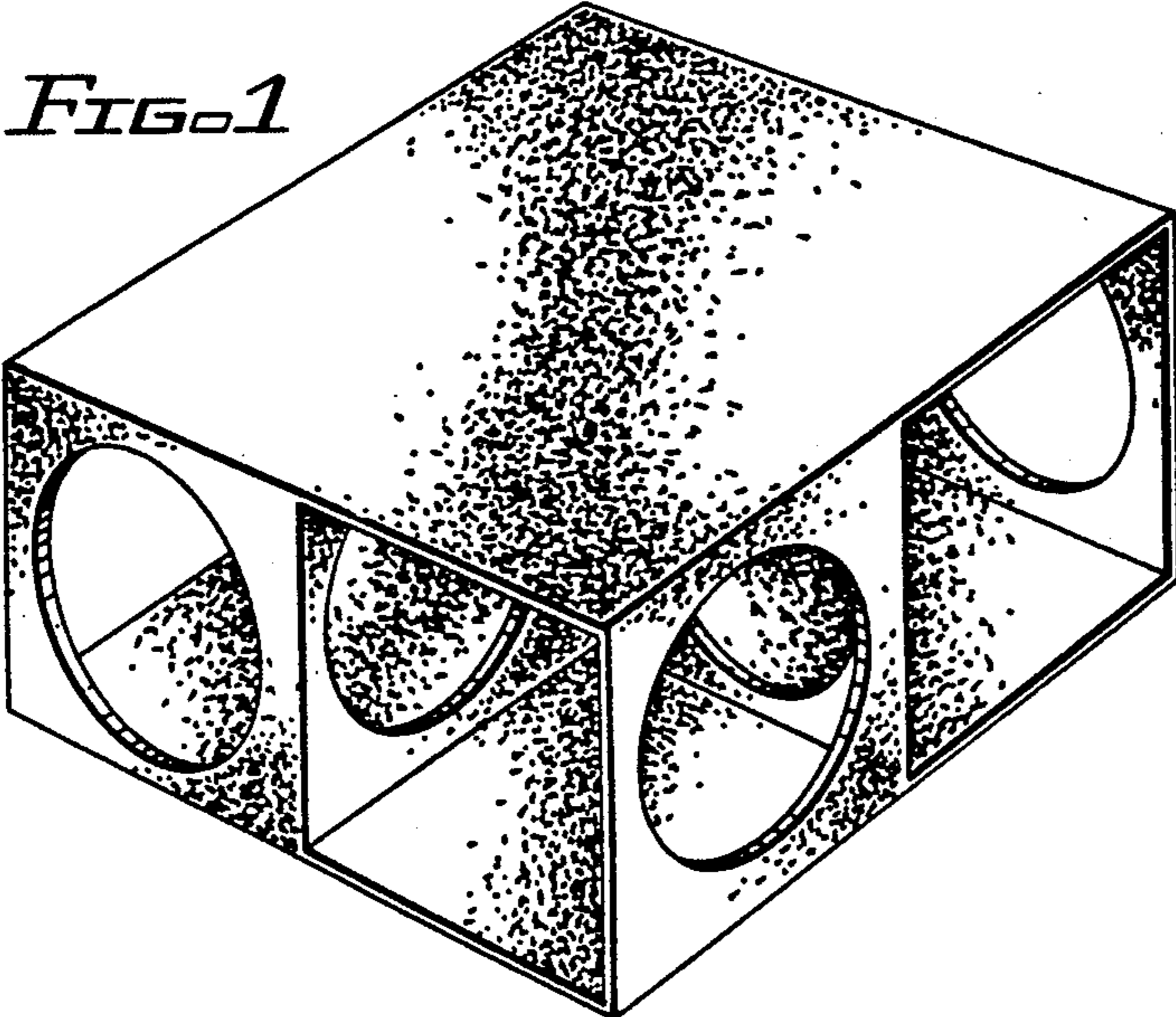

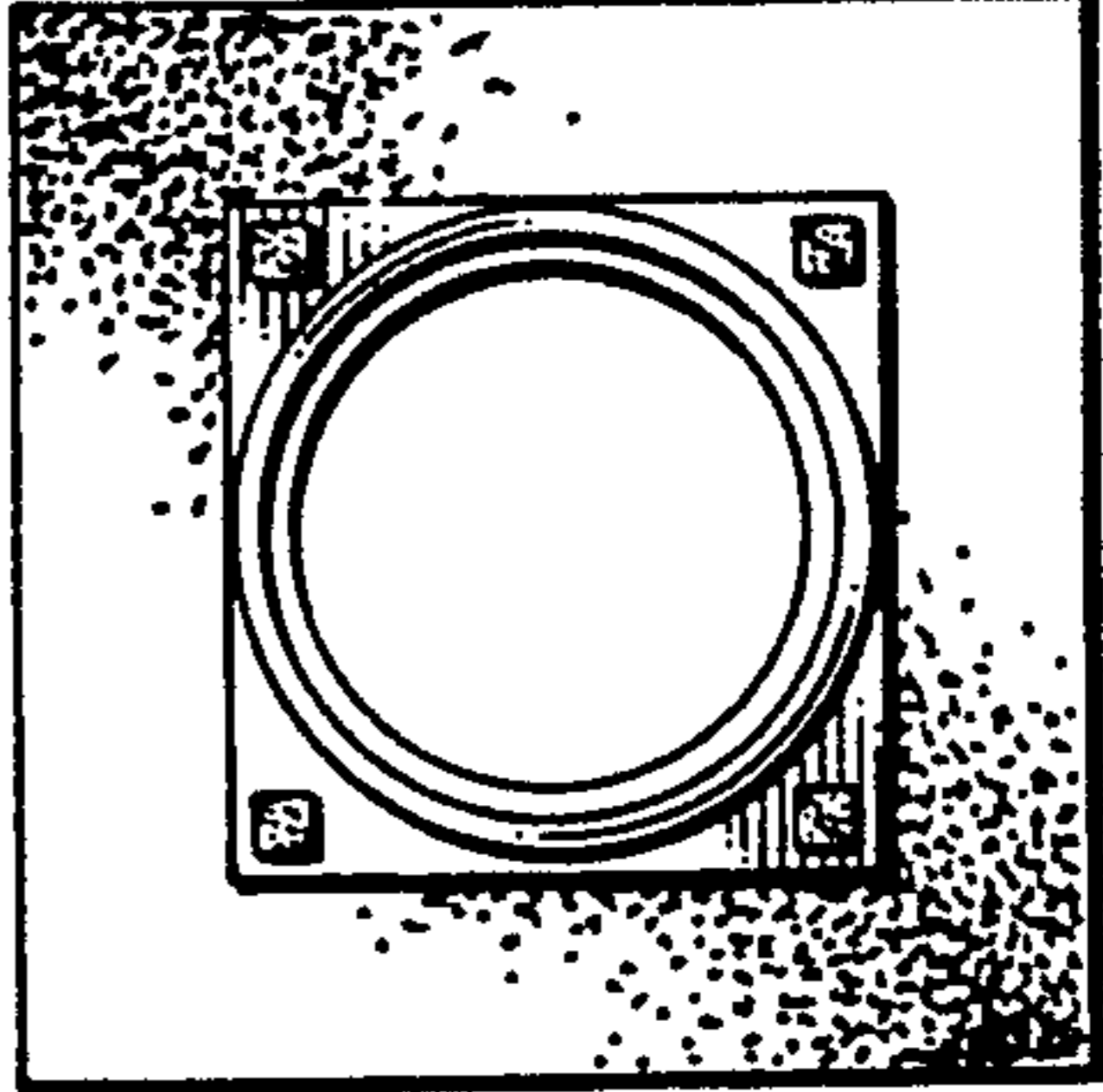

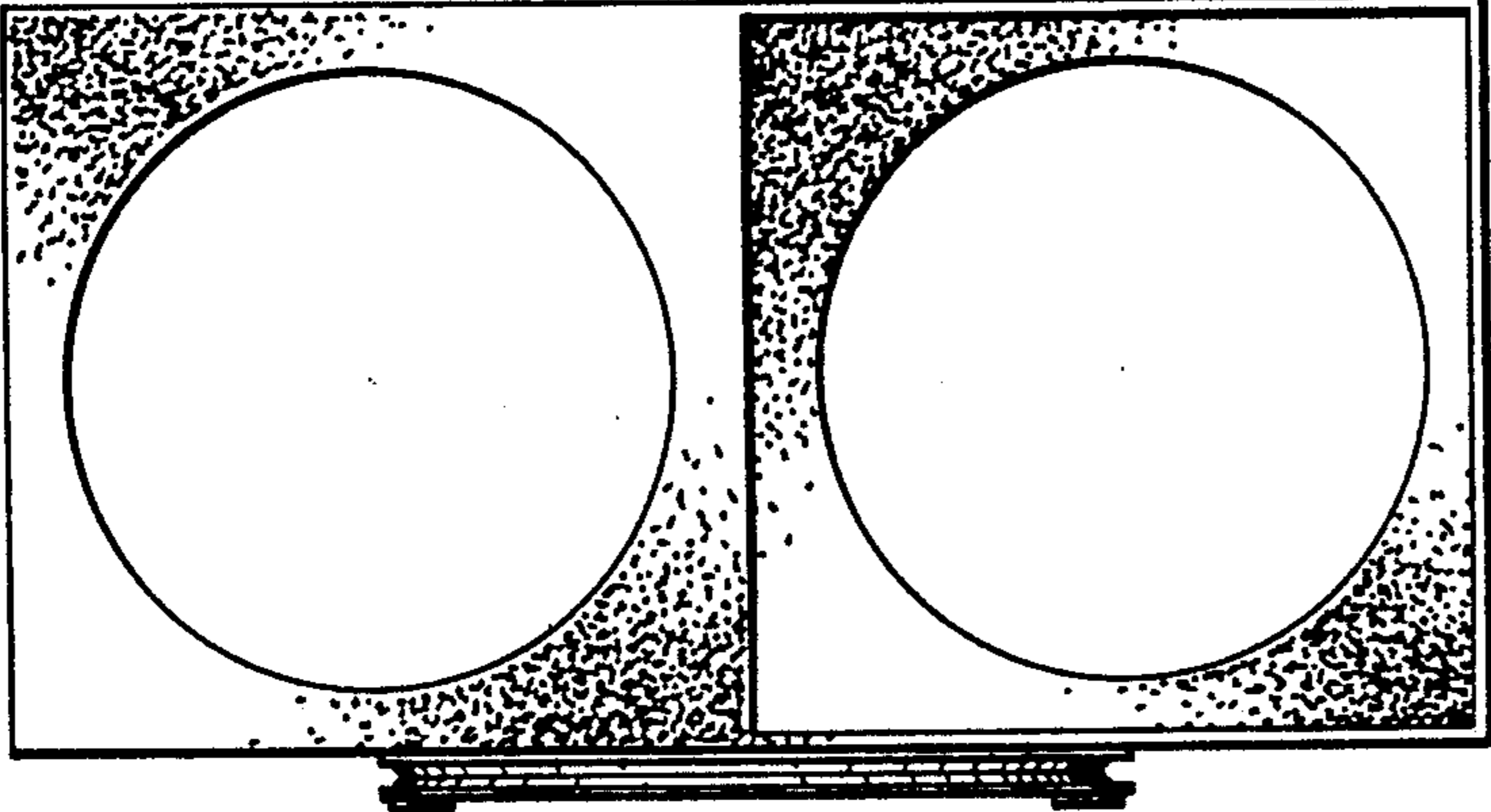

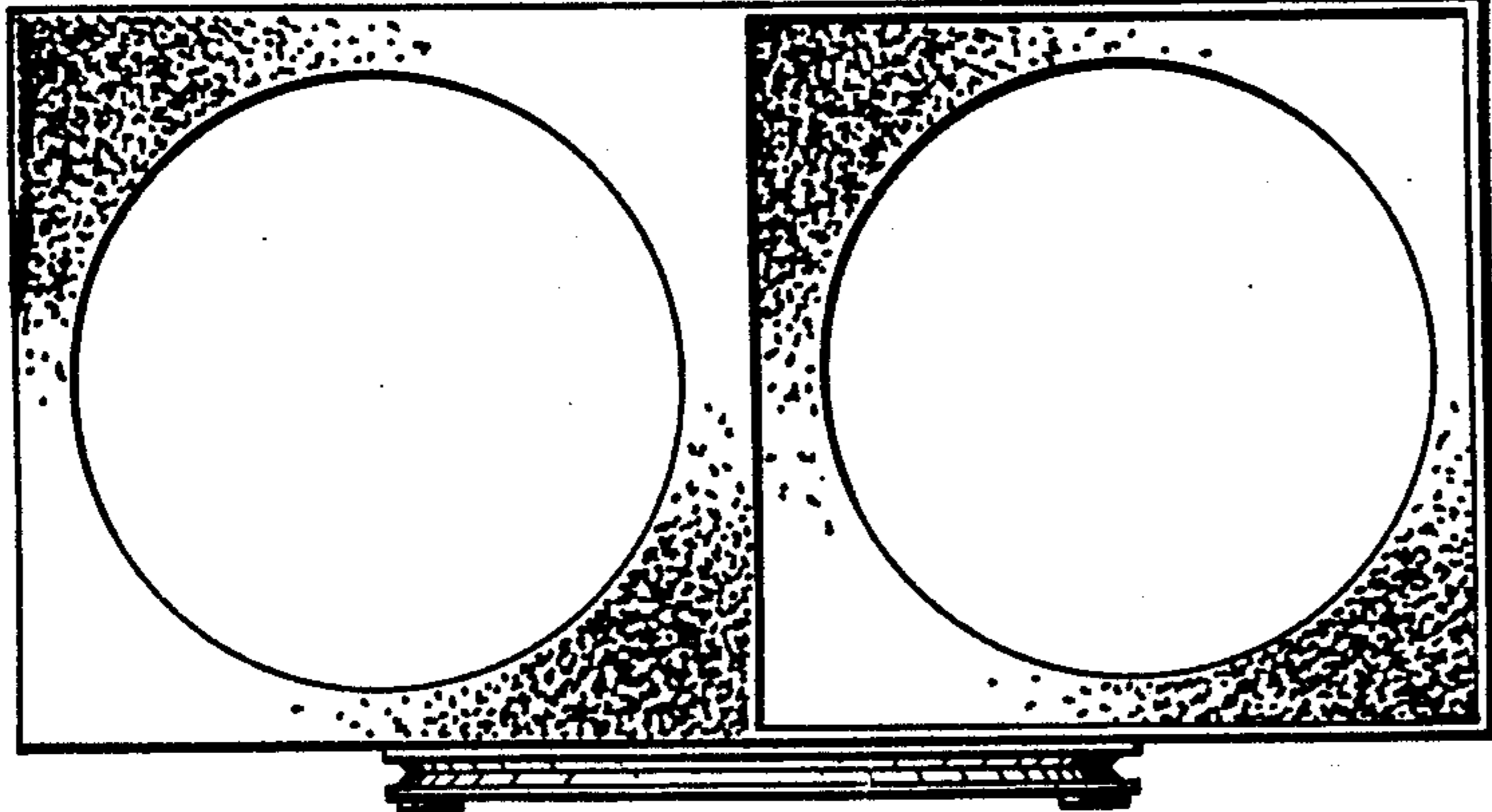
