The ornamental design for a scoop, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a scoop showing our new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is an elevational view from the other side thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof;  
 FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view of an alternate embodiment, the remaining views being similar to FIGS. 1-7;  
 FIG. 9 is a top plan view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1;  
 FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of FIG. 9;  
 FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9;  
 FIG. 12 is an elevational view from the other side of FIG. 10;  
 FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 9;  
 FIG. 14 is a front elevational view of FIG. 9; and,  
 FIG. 15 is a perspective view of FIG. 9.

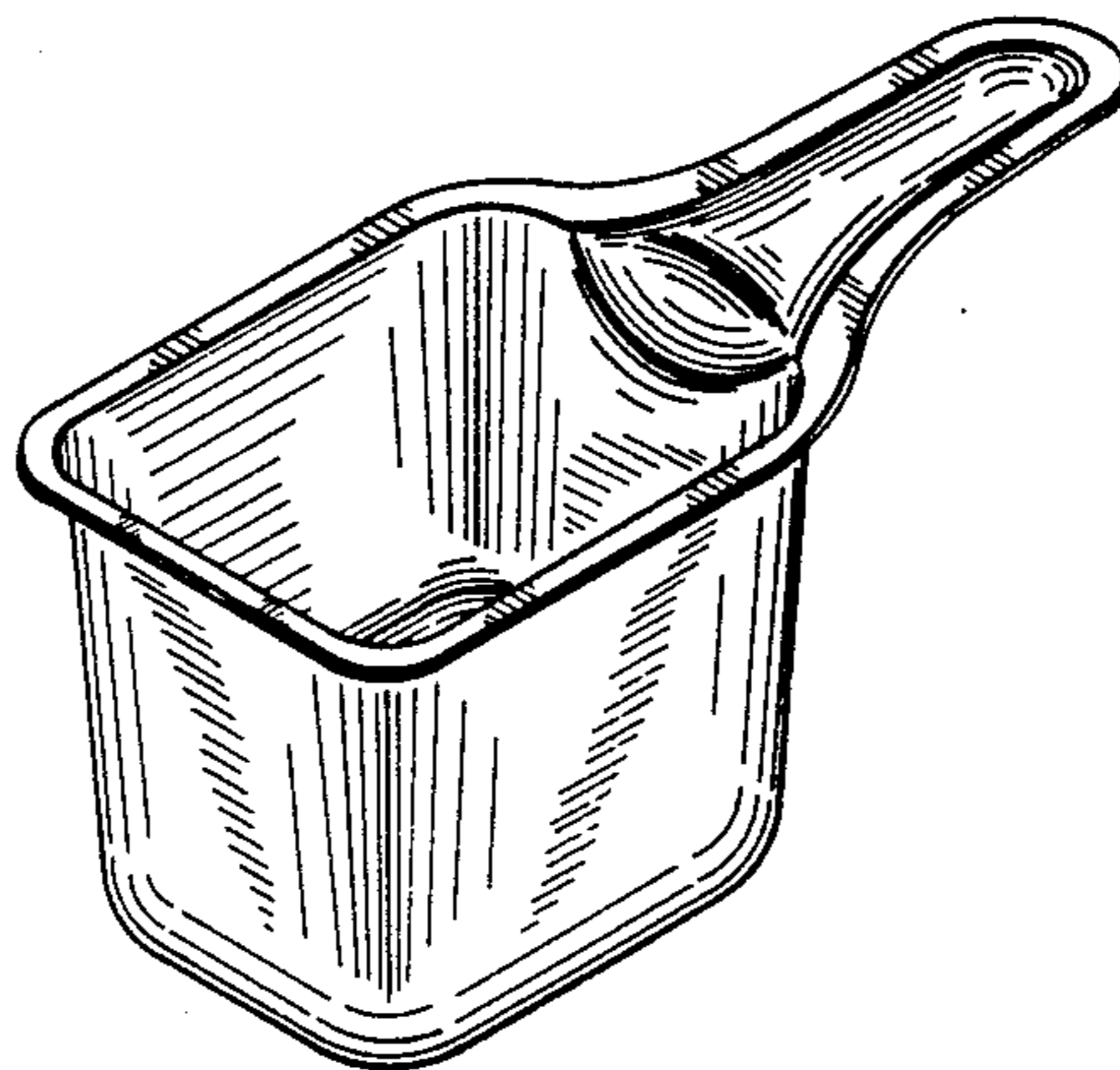
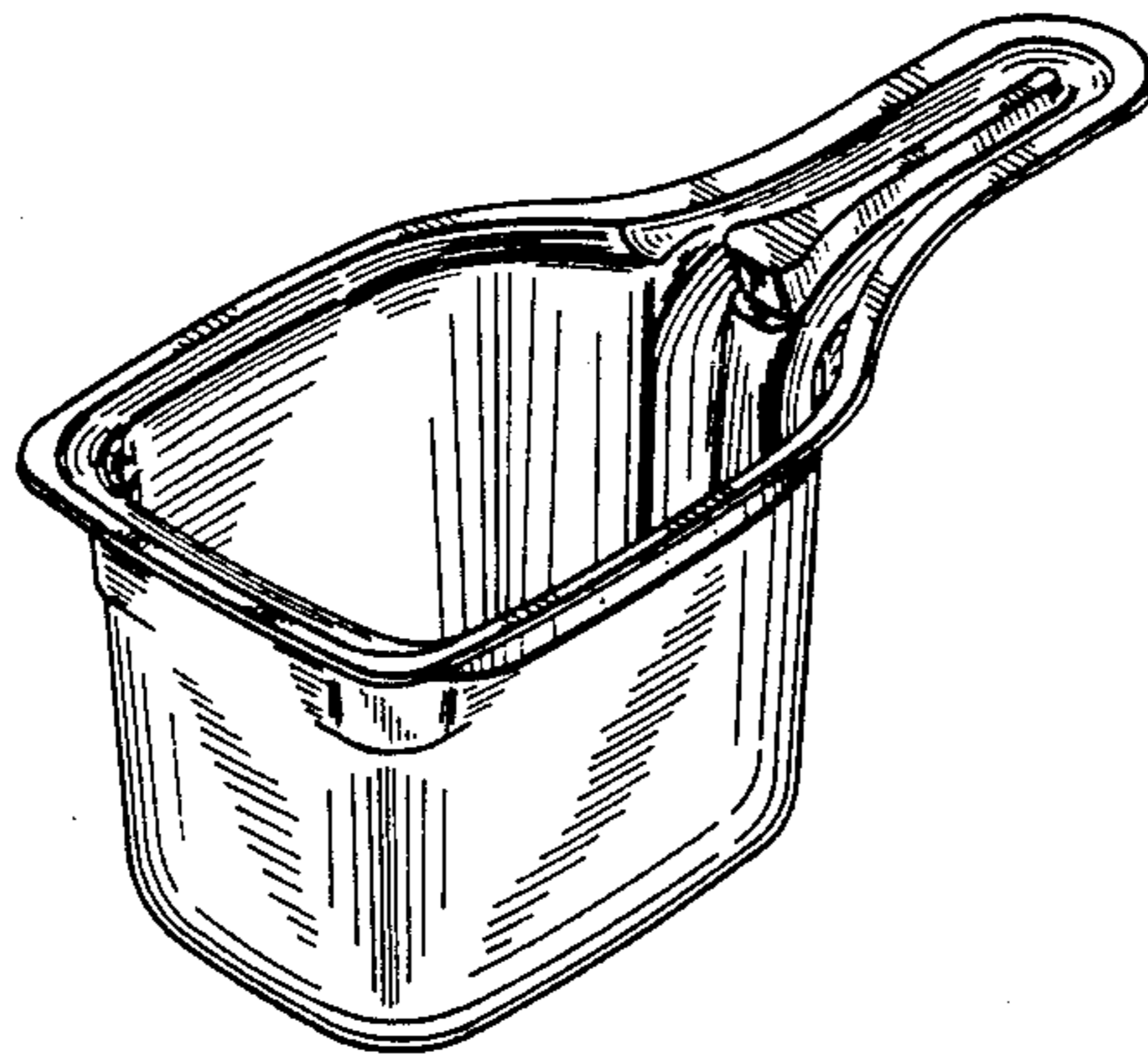

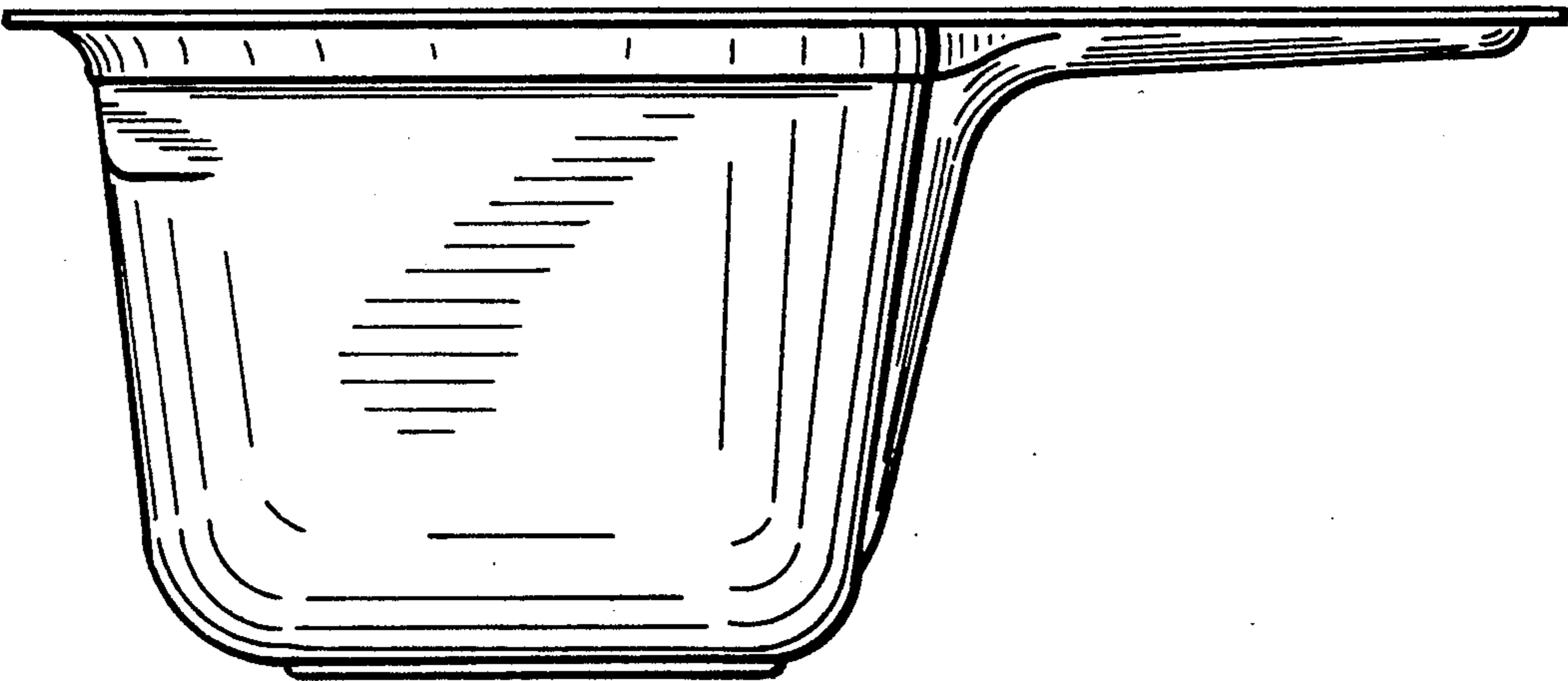
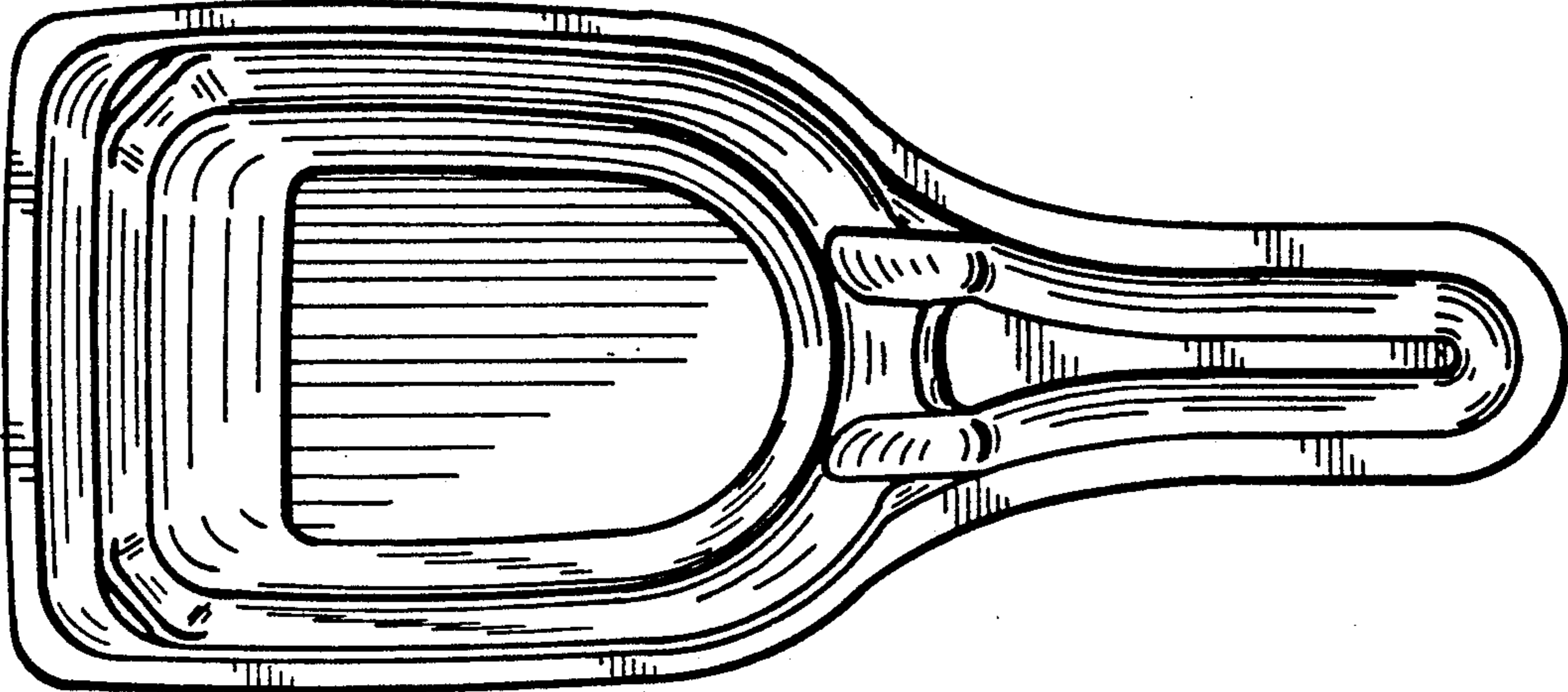

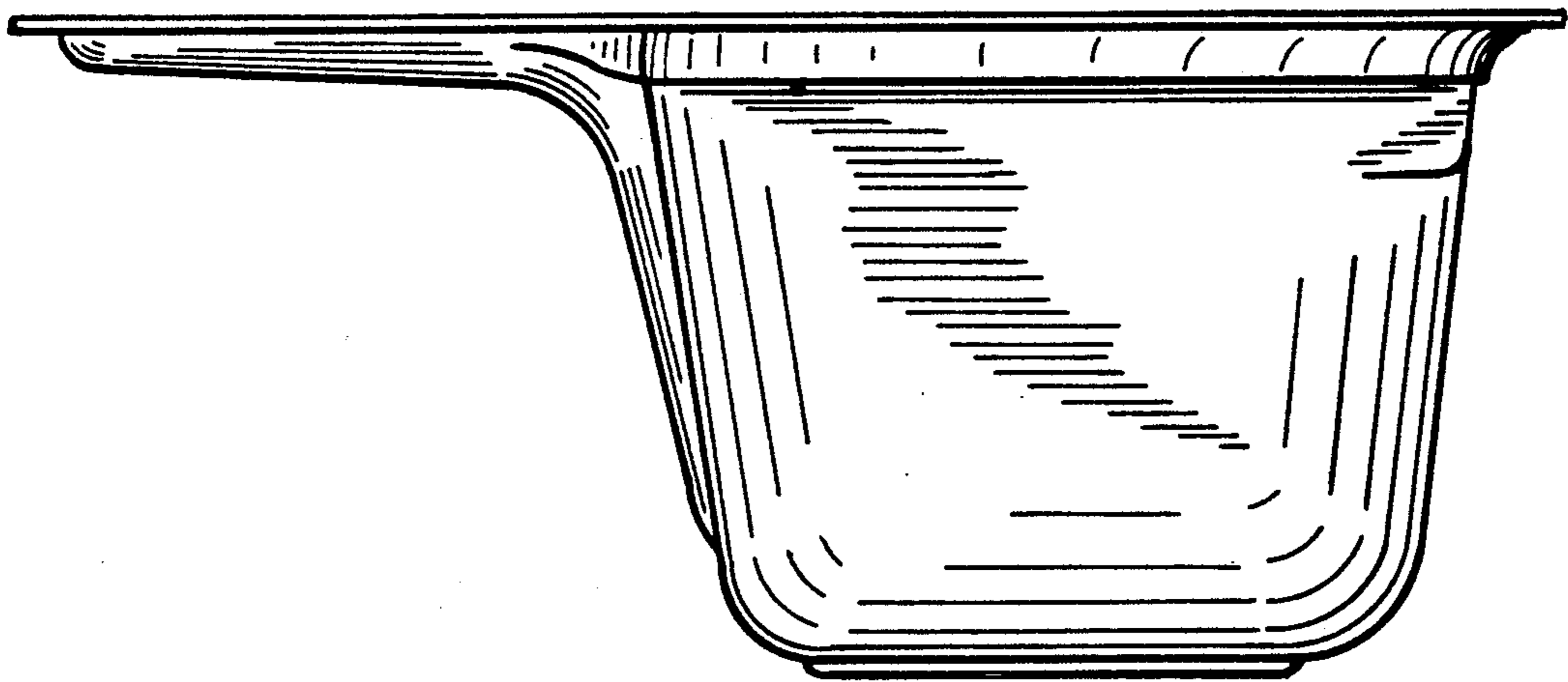
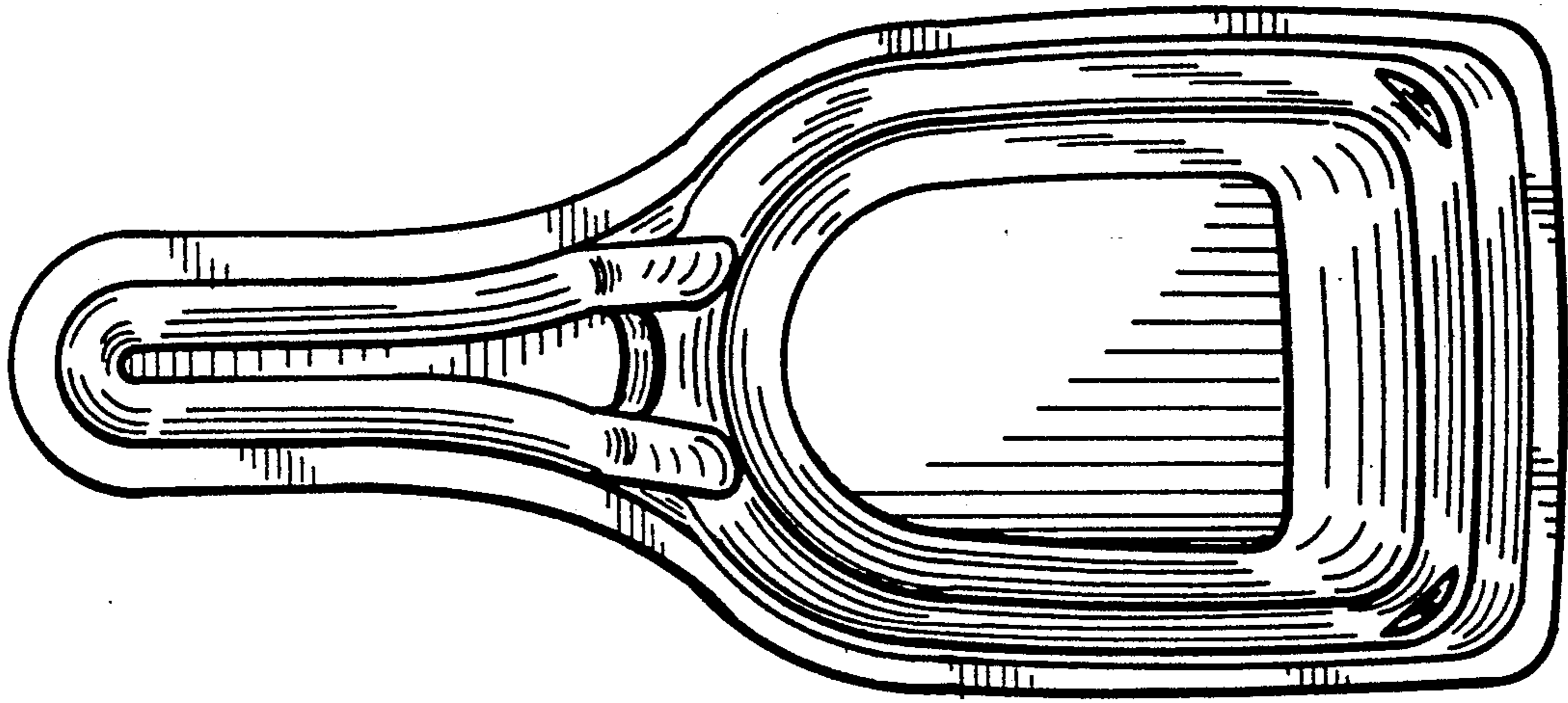

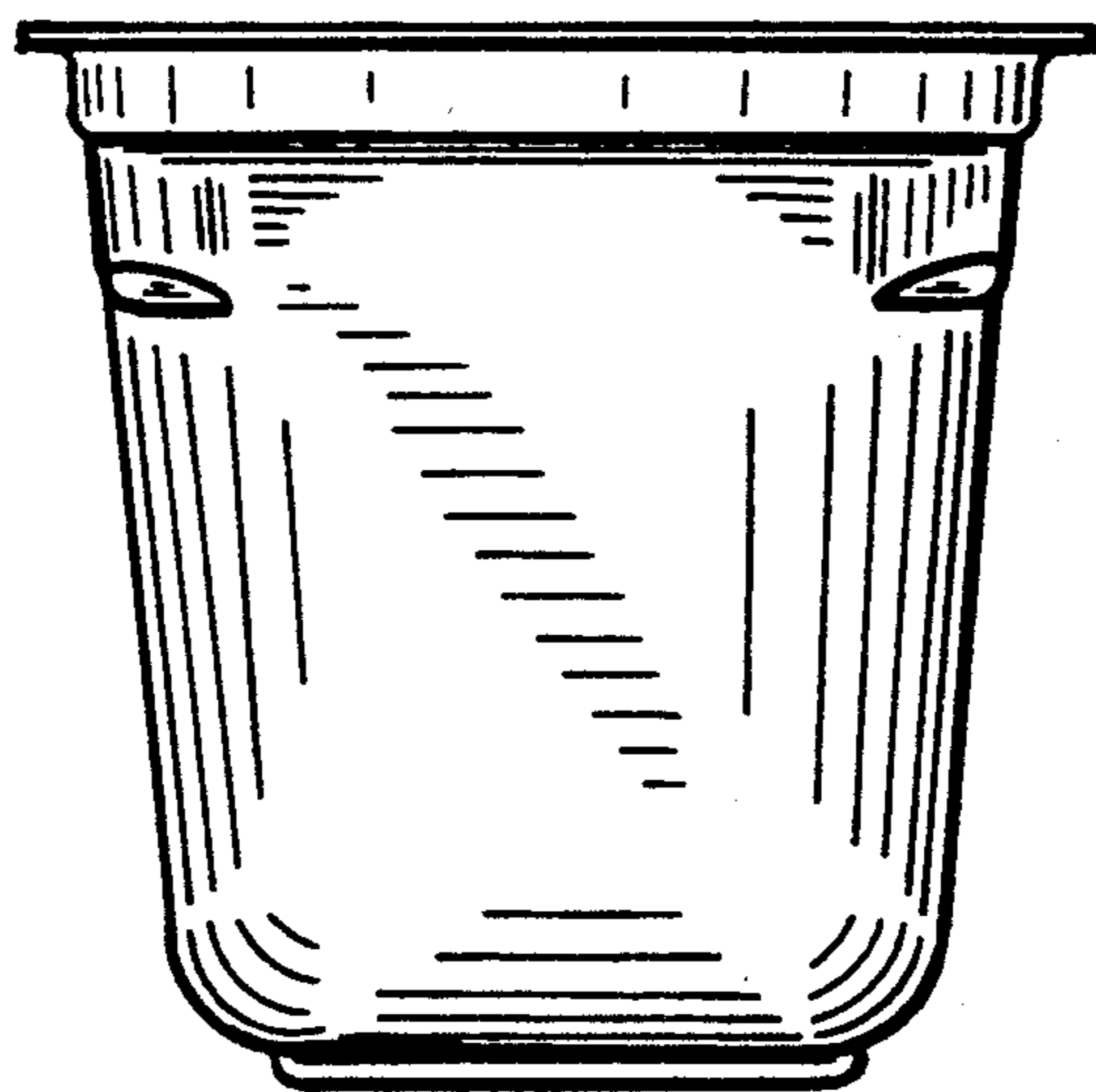
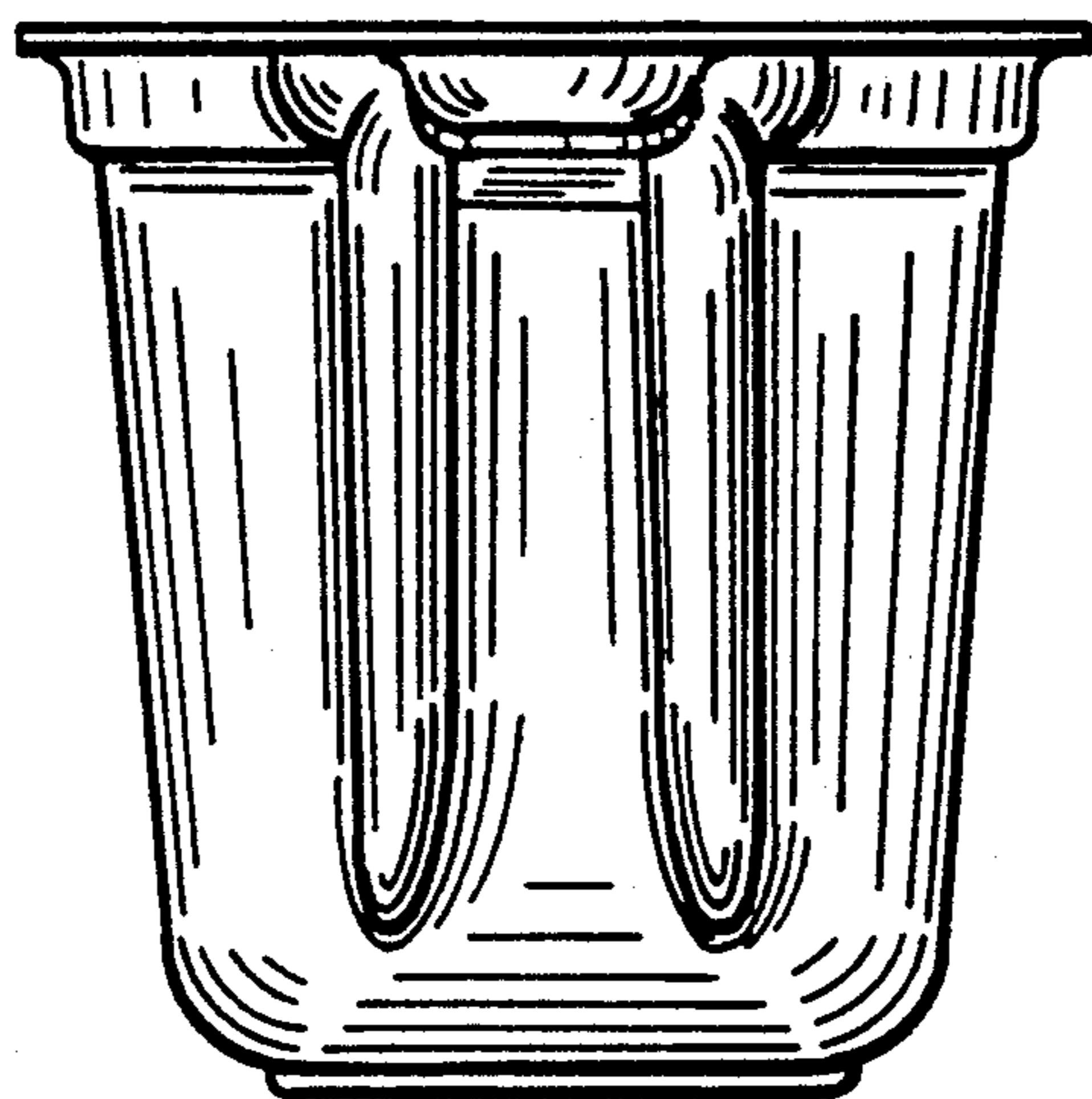

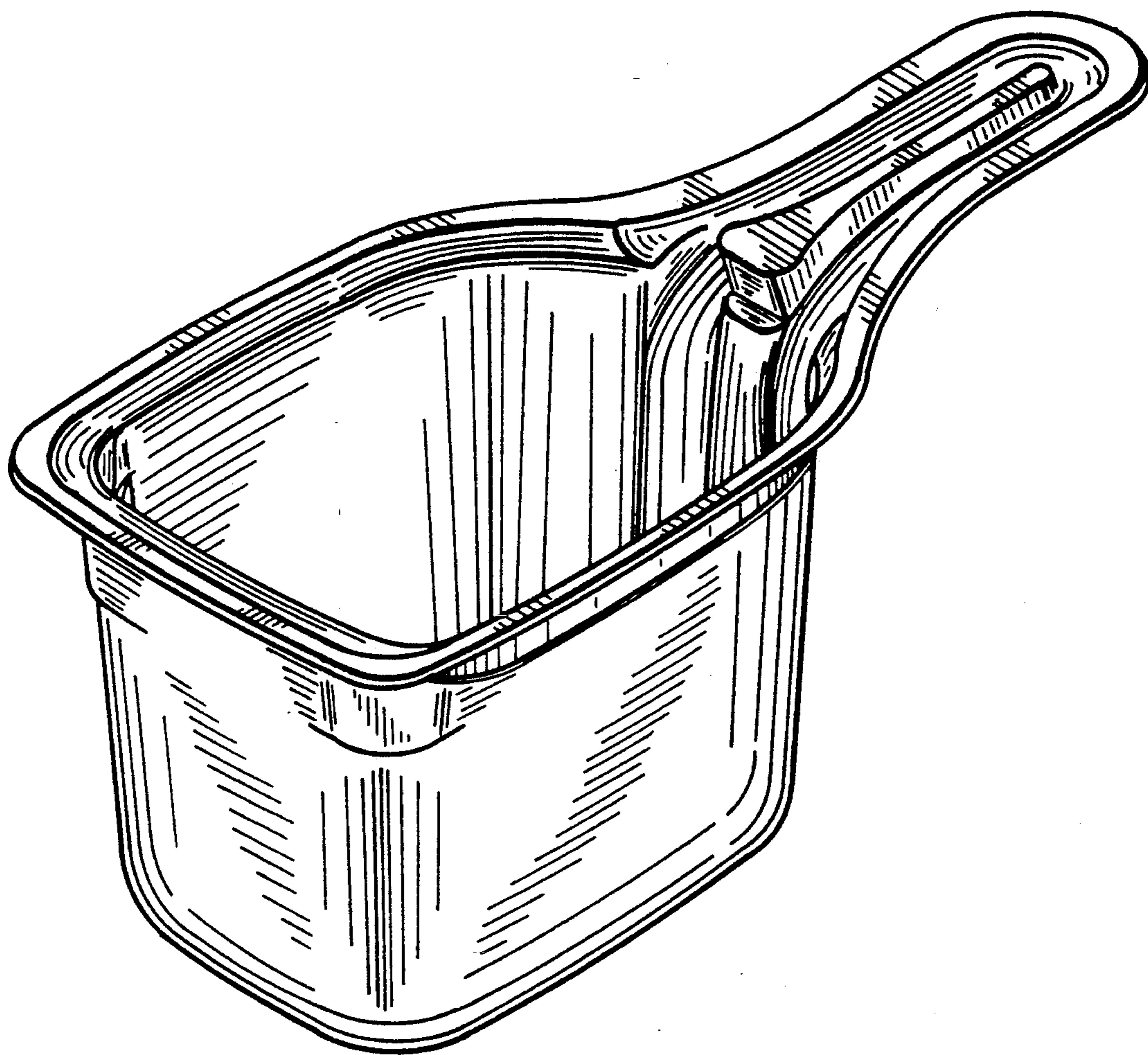

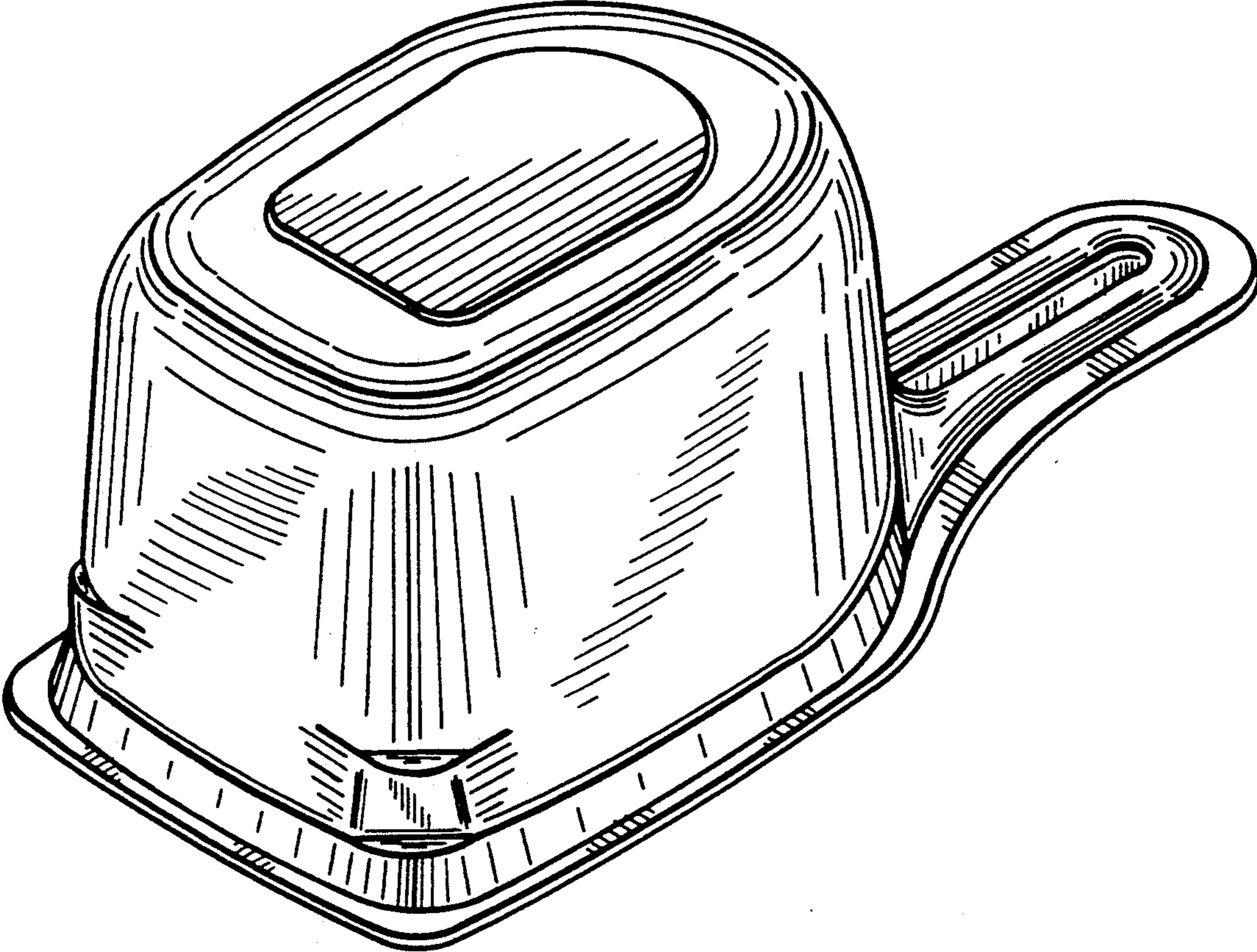

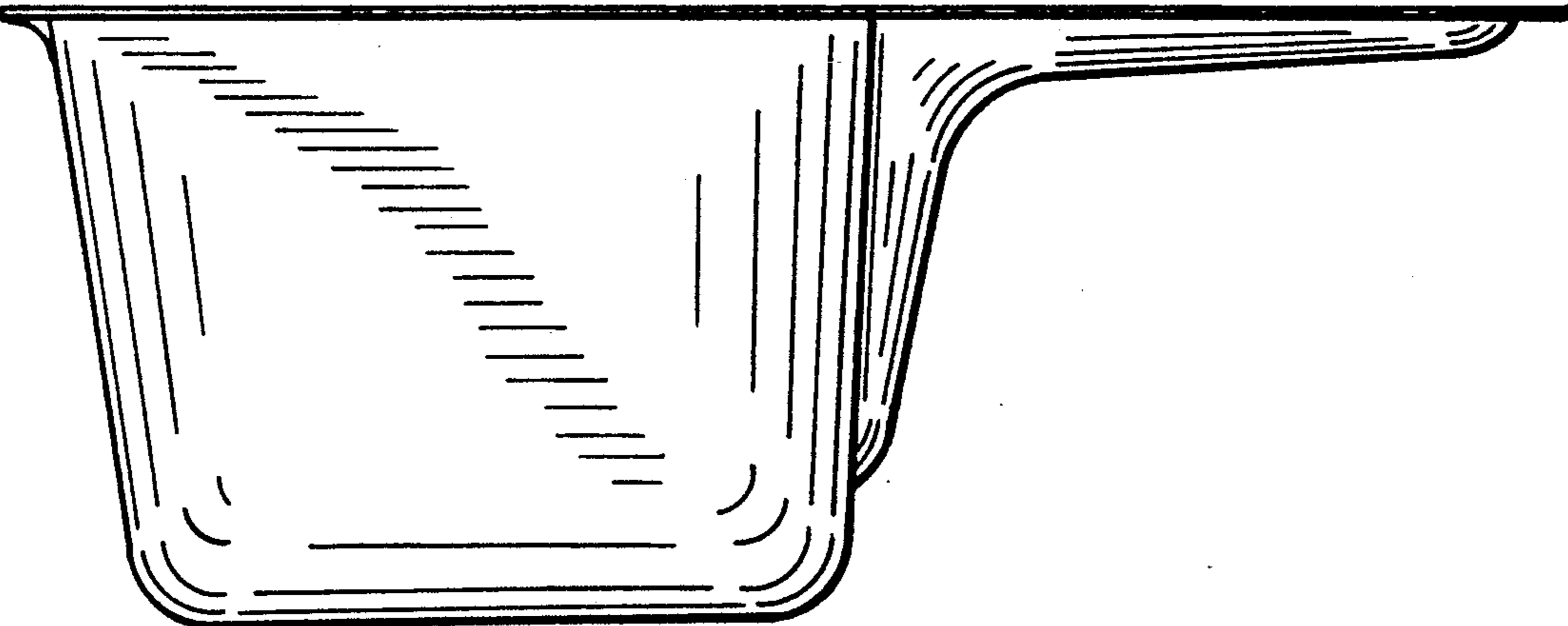
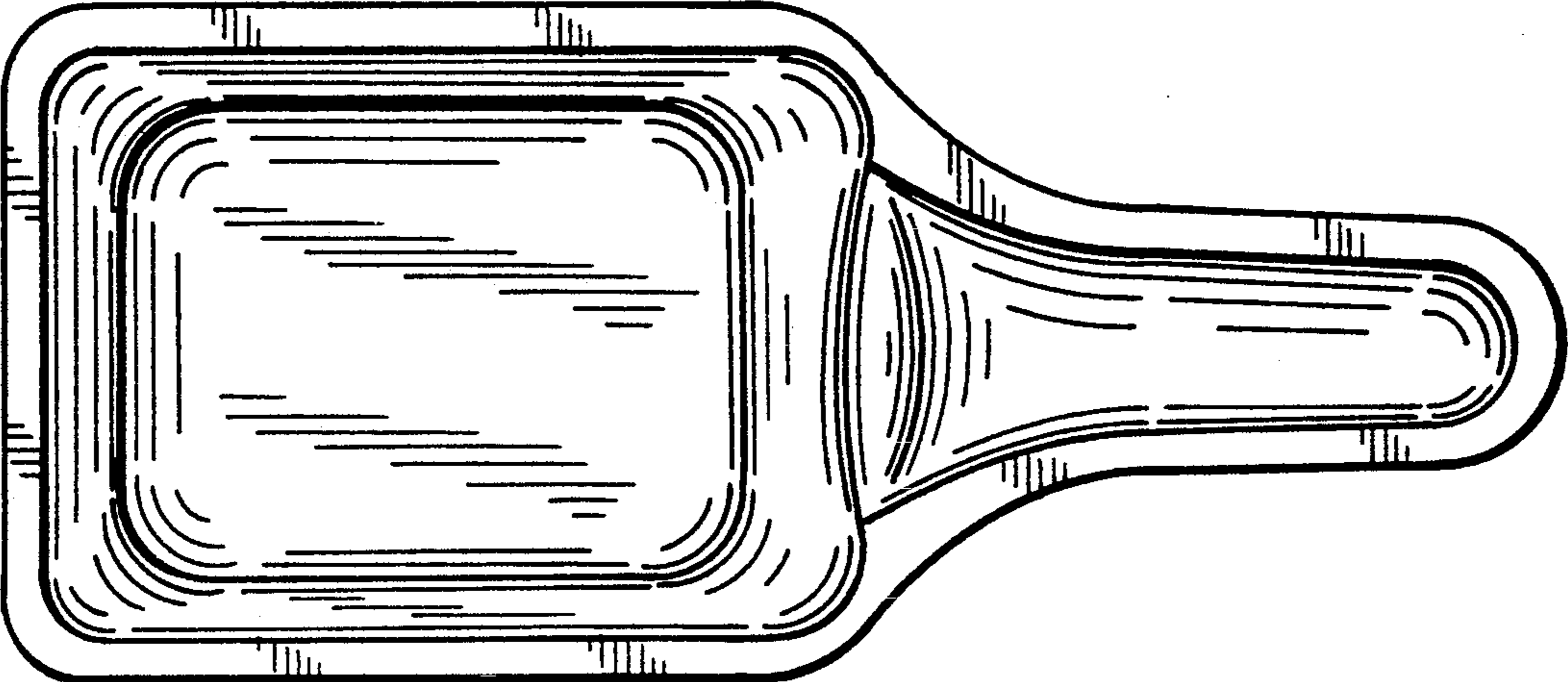

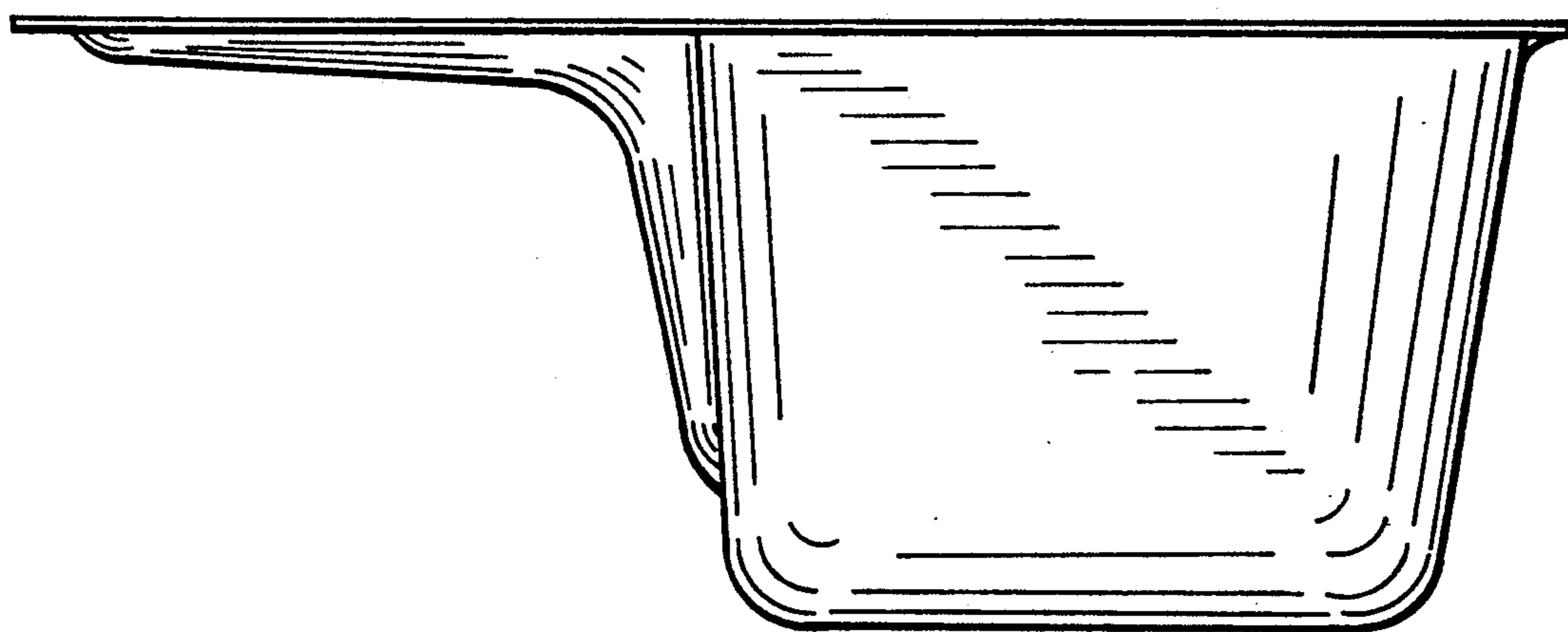
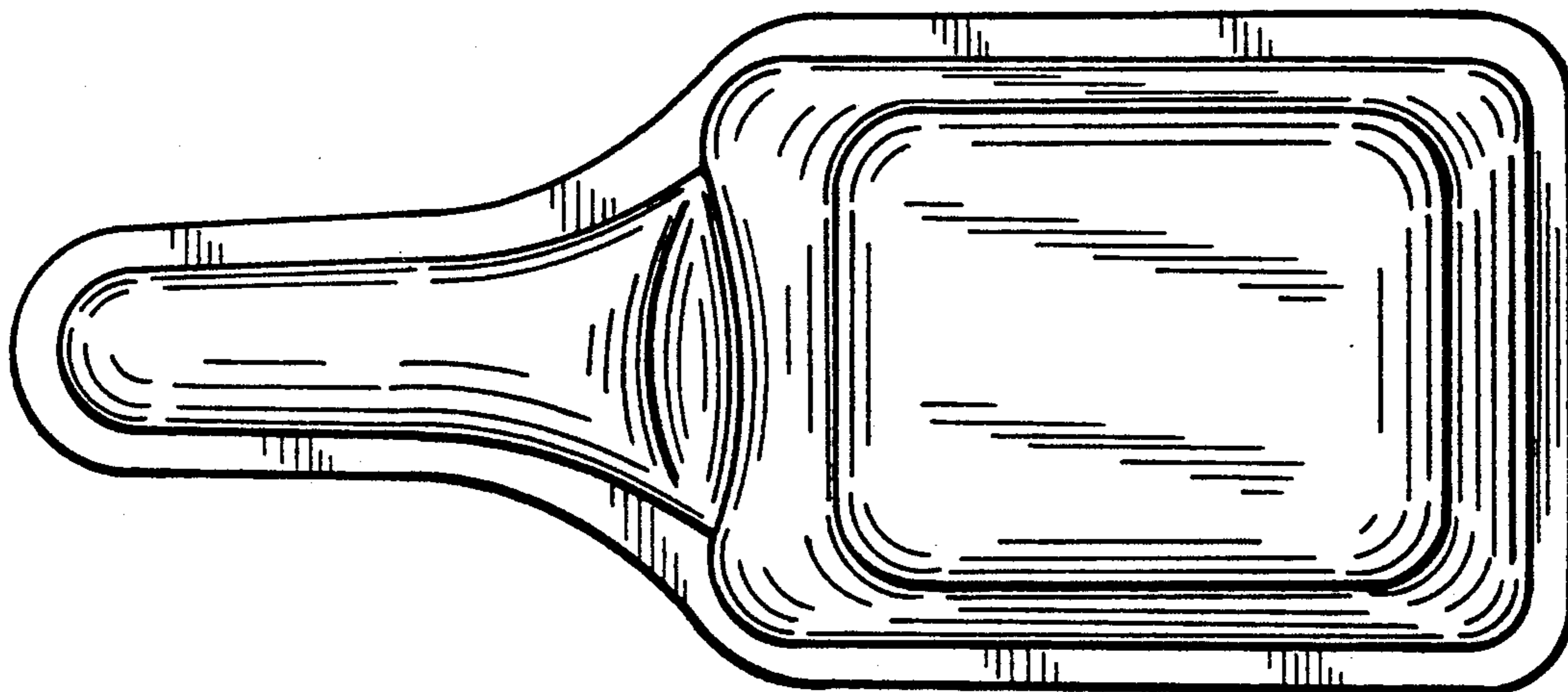
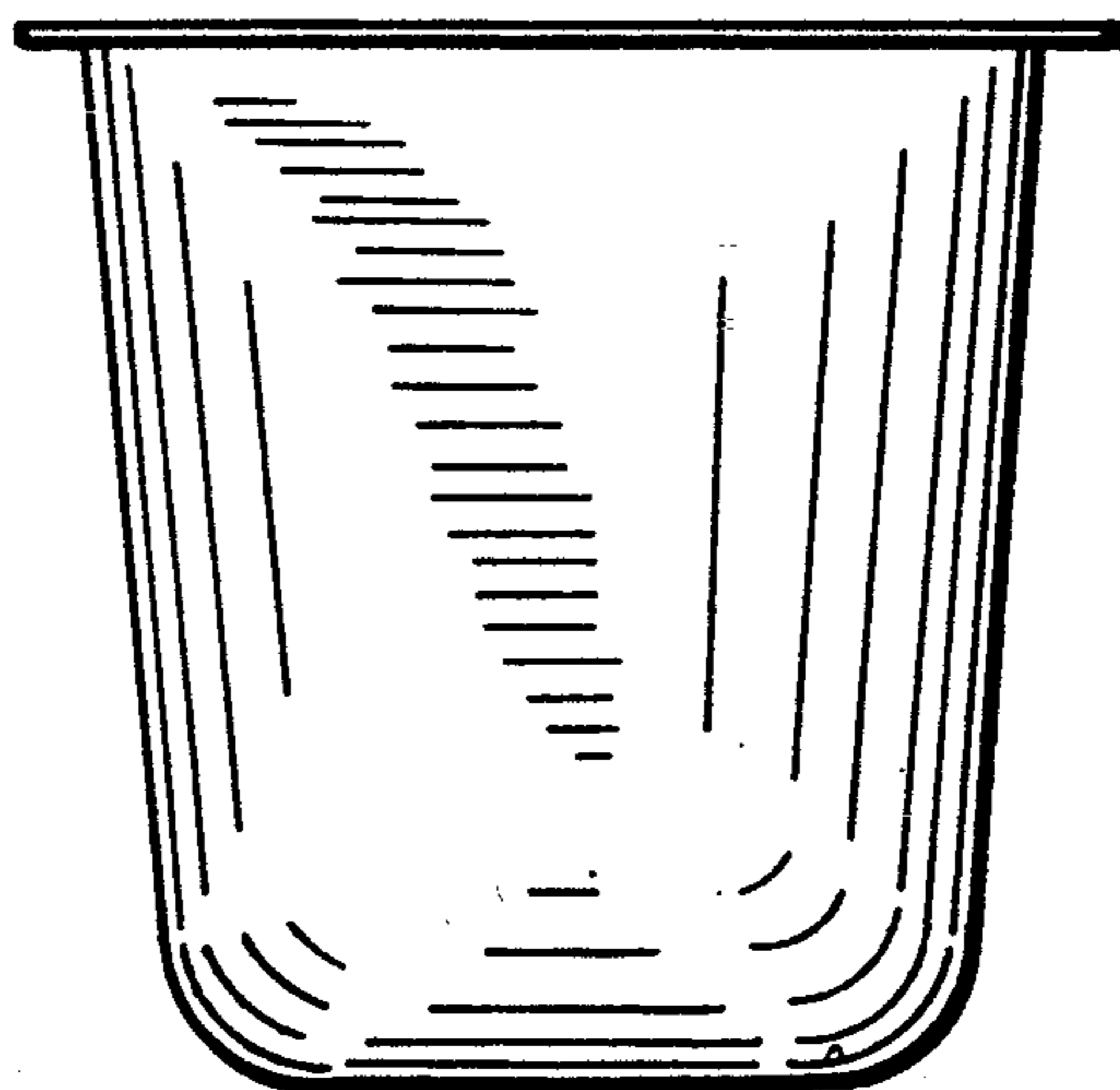
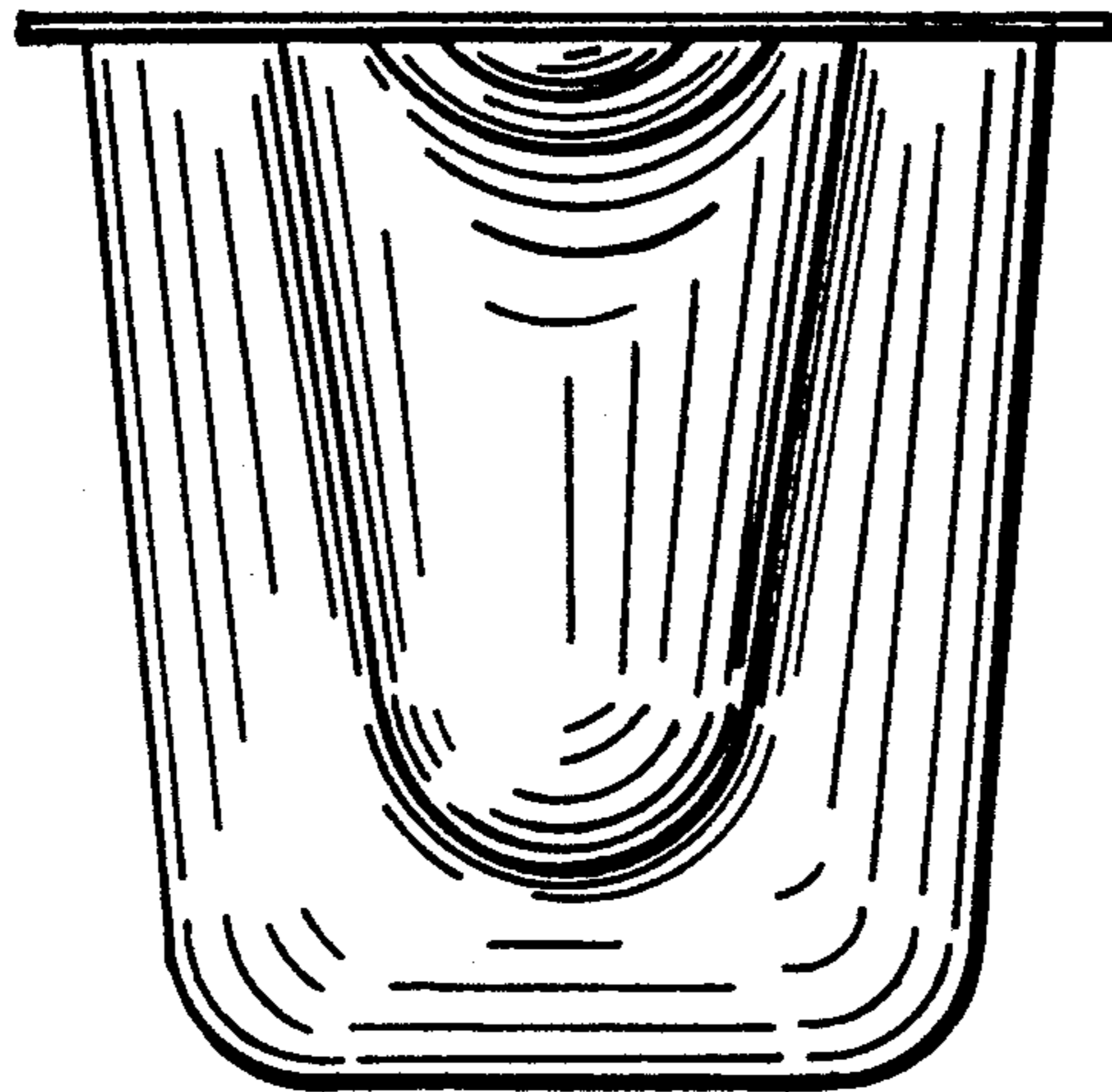
