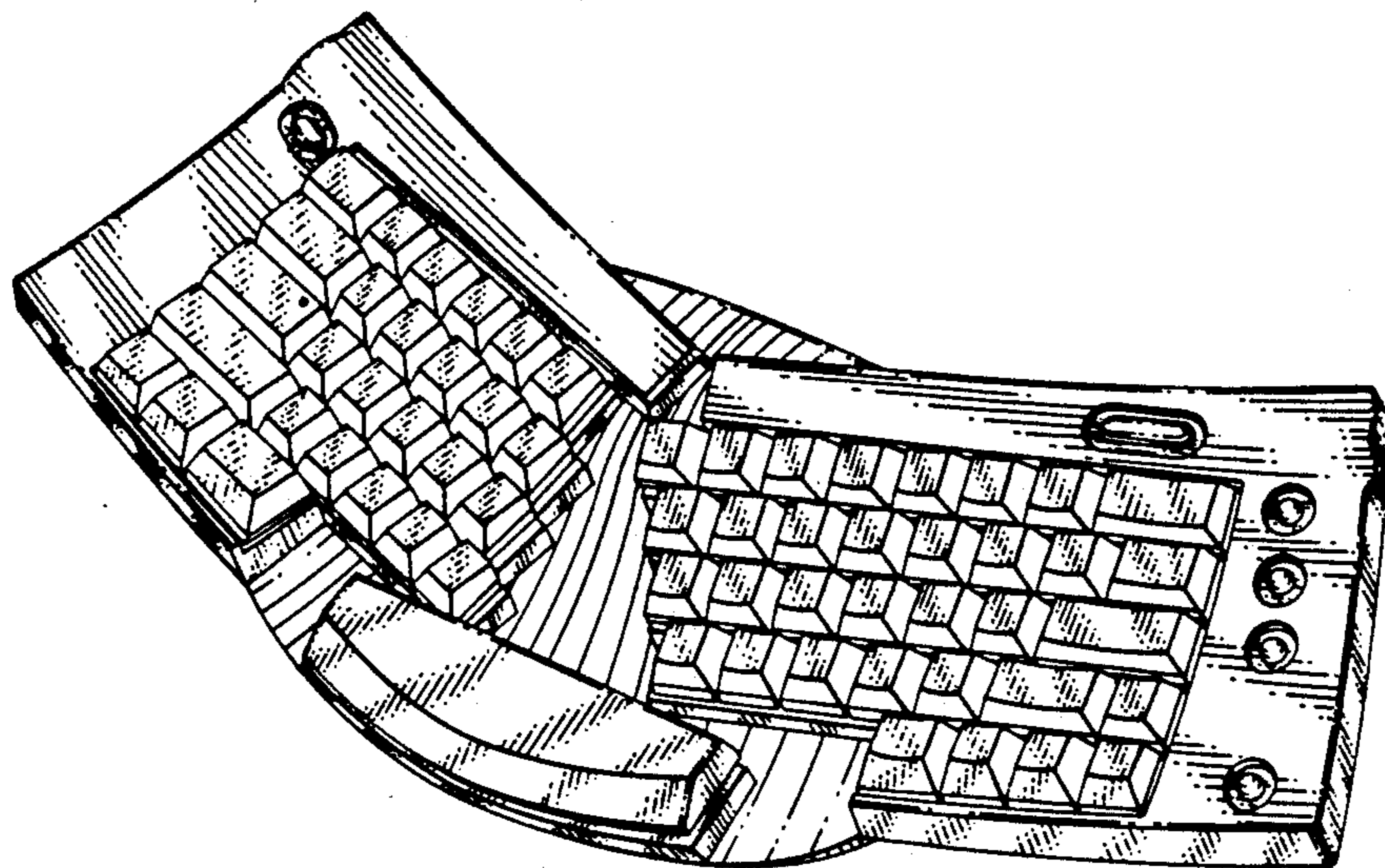
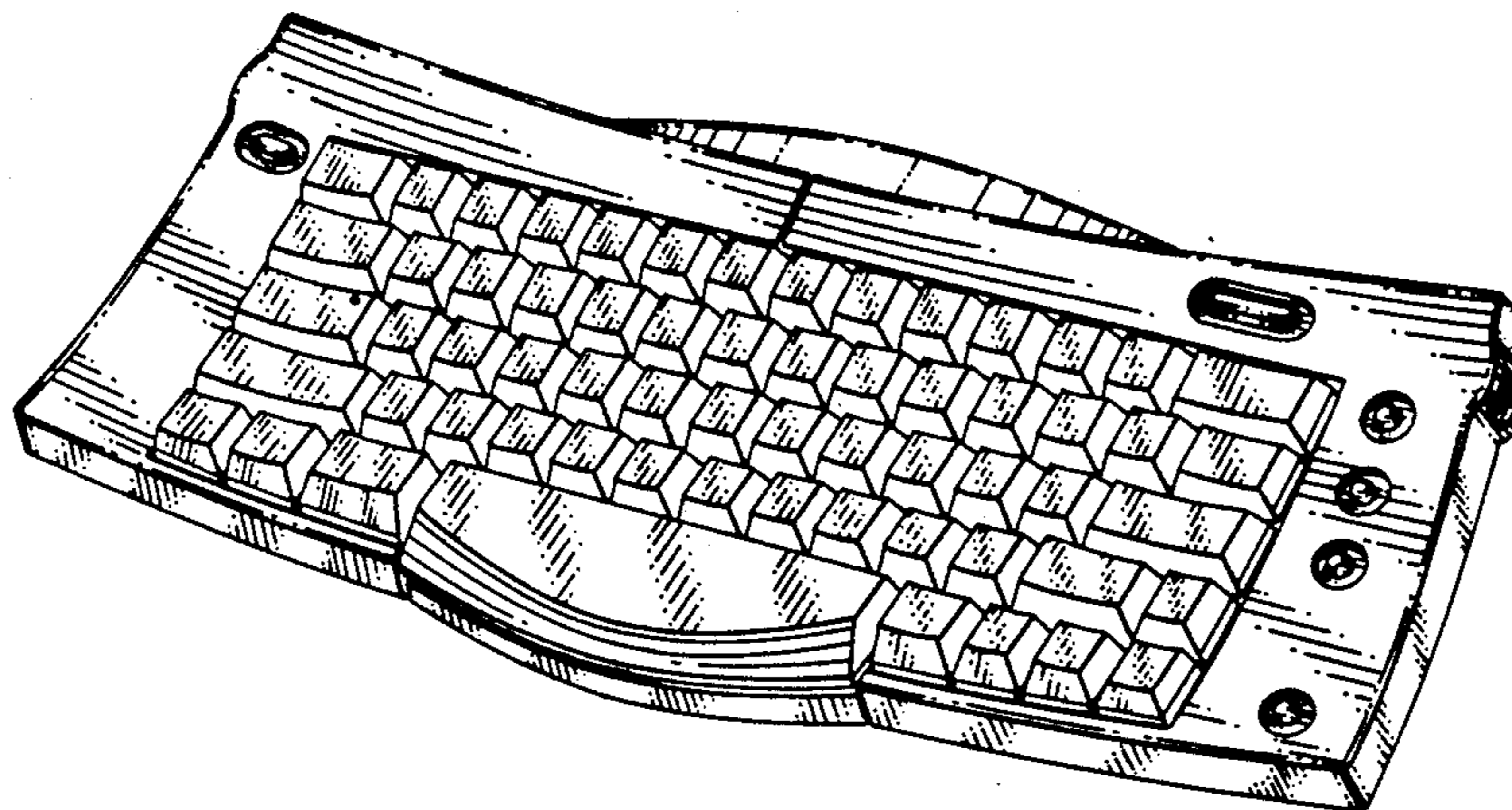

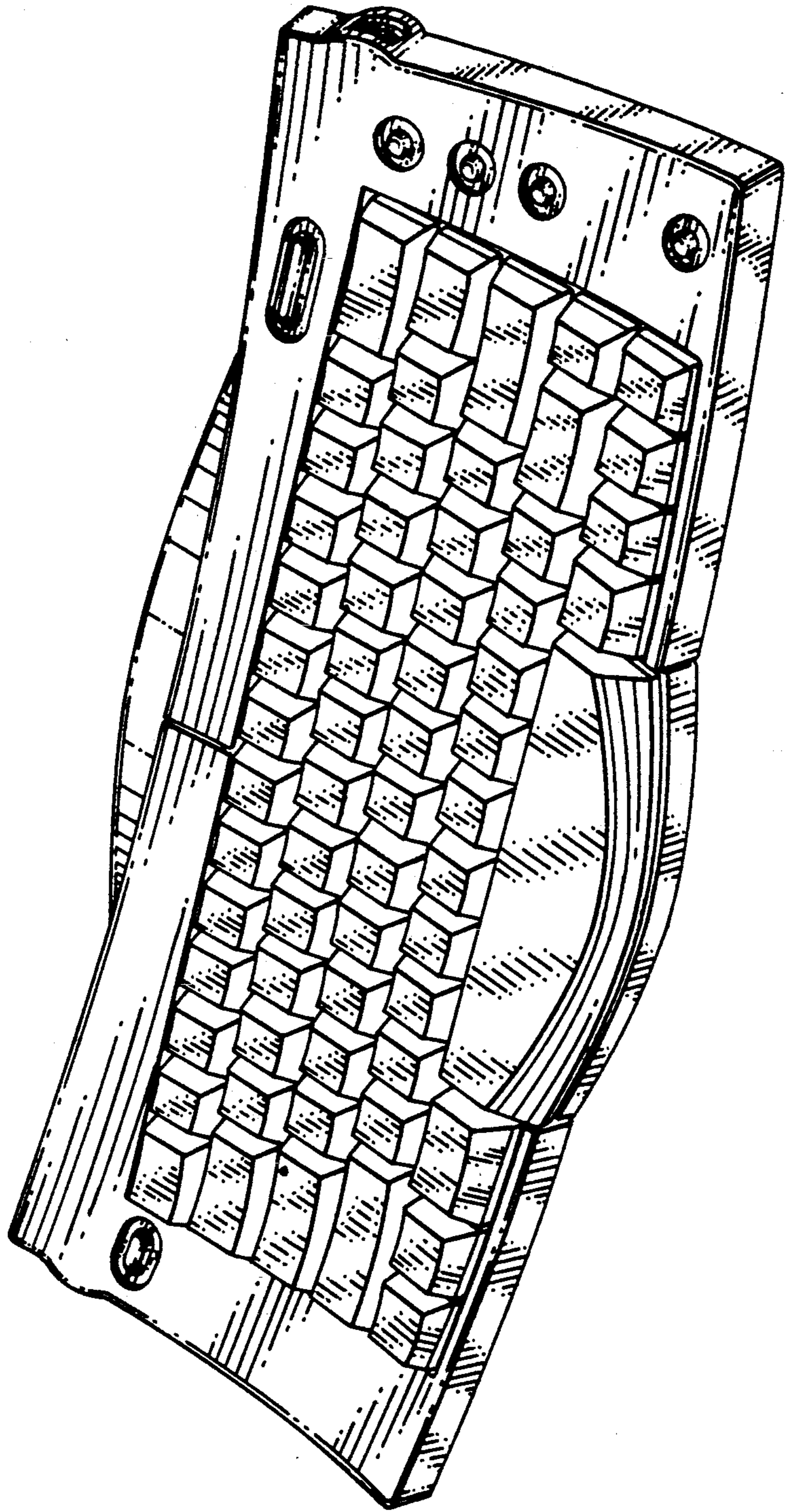
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right side perspective view of a computer keyboard showing our new design;

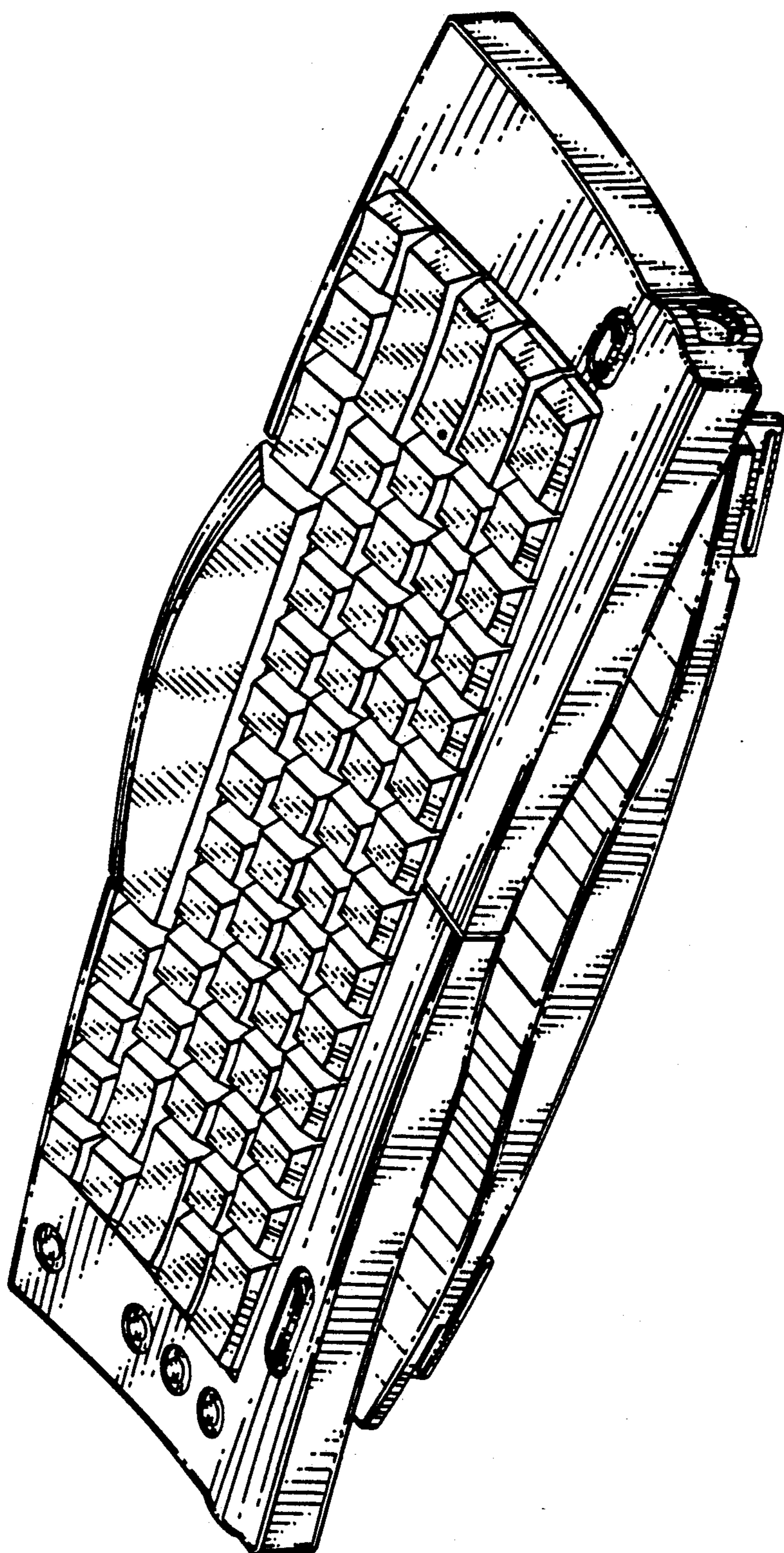

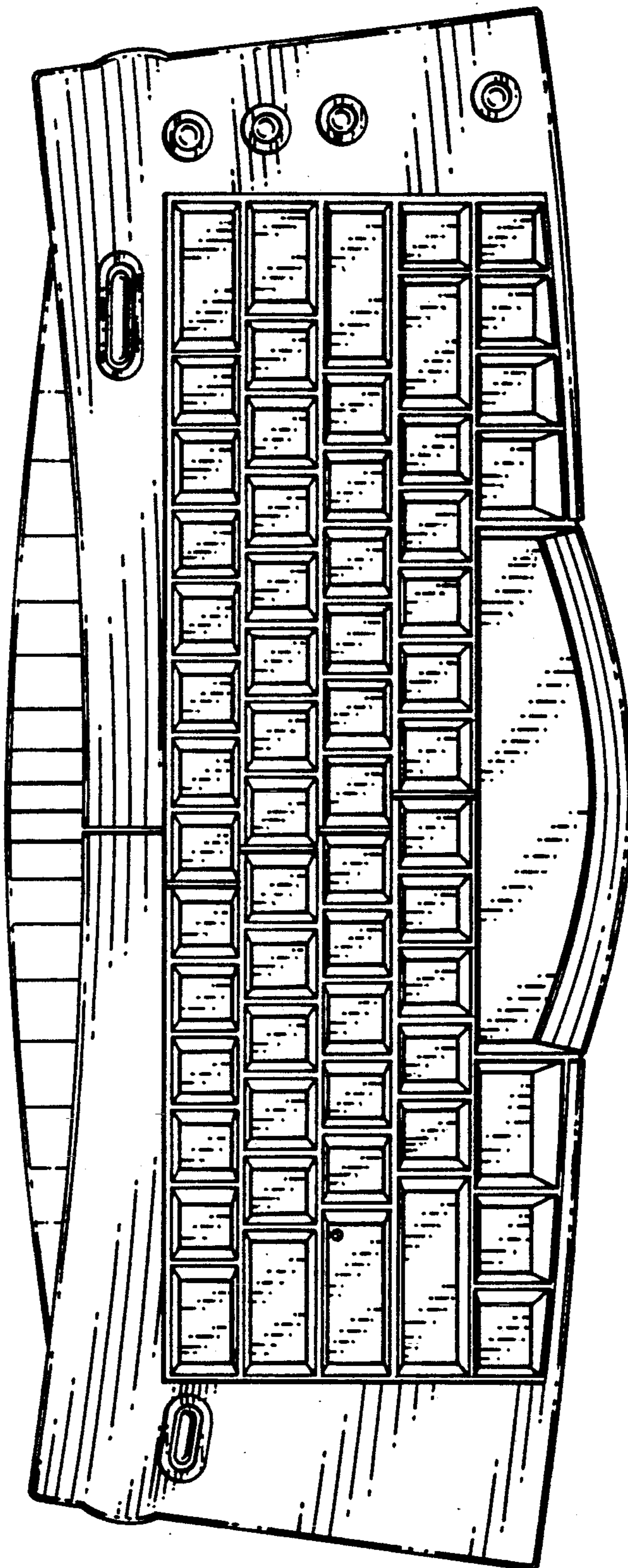

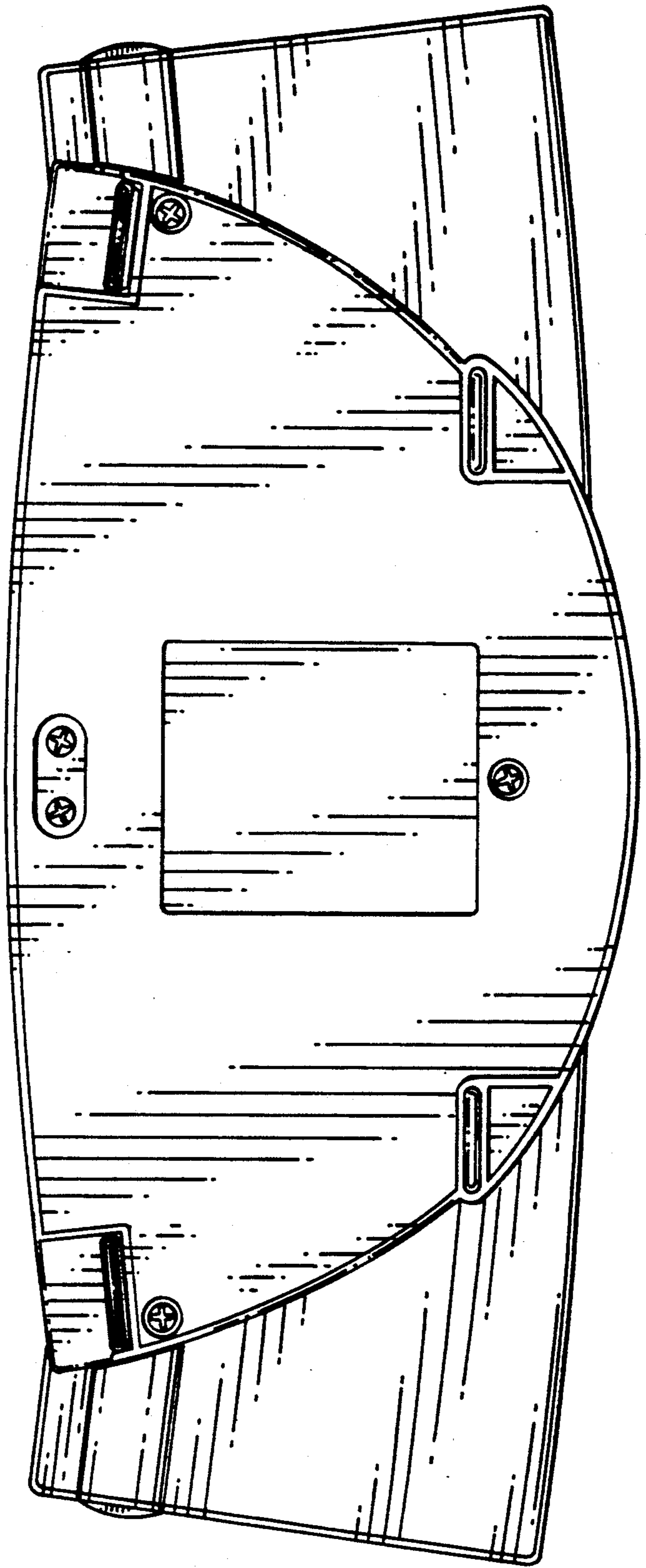

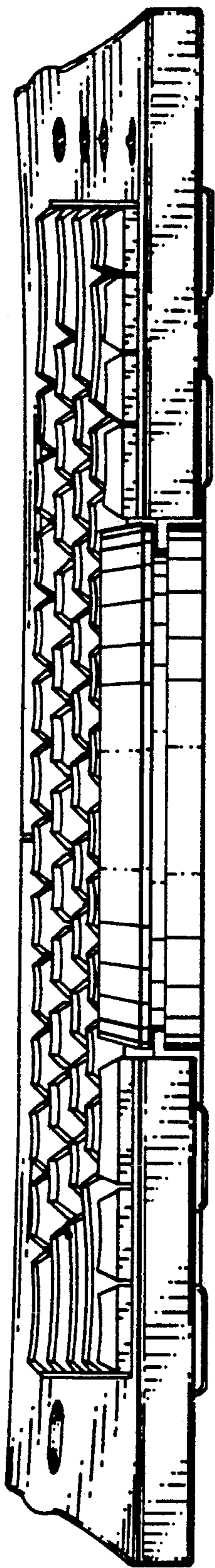

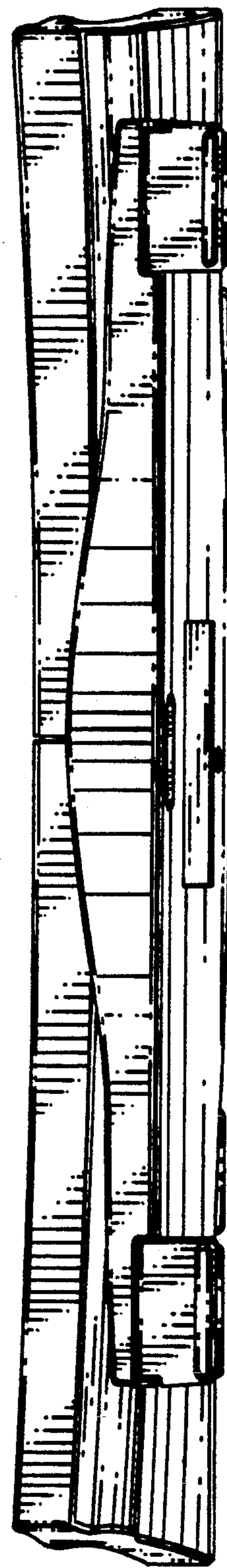

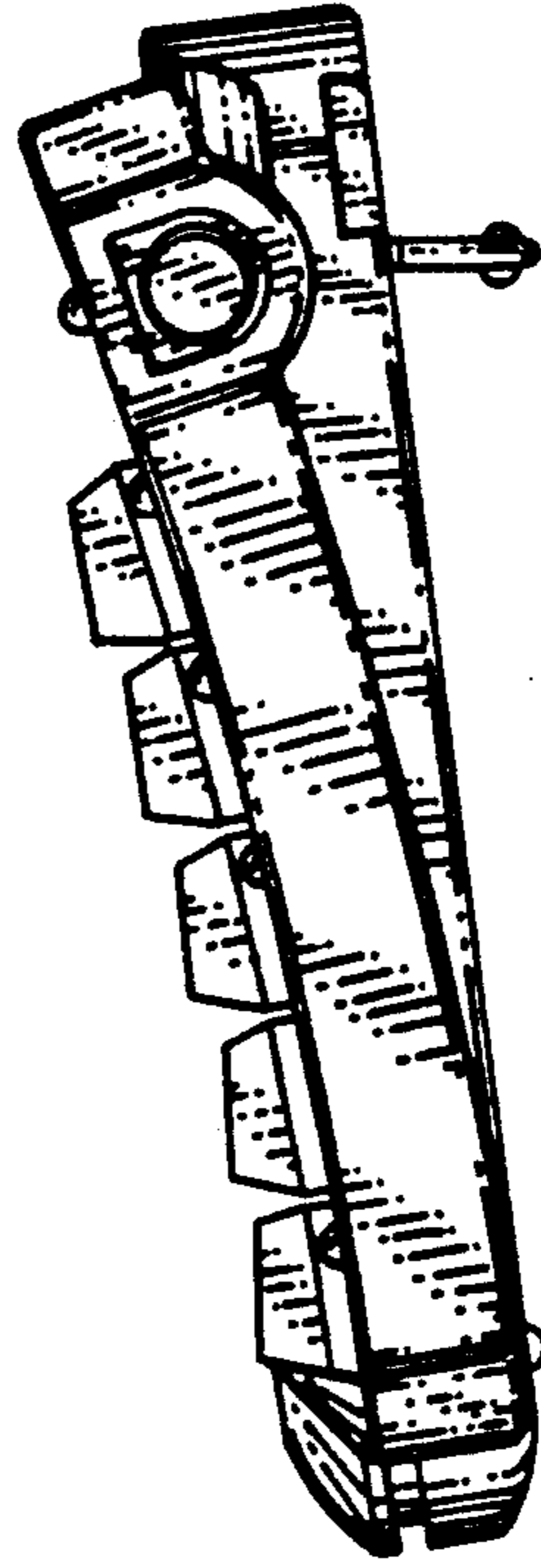
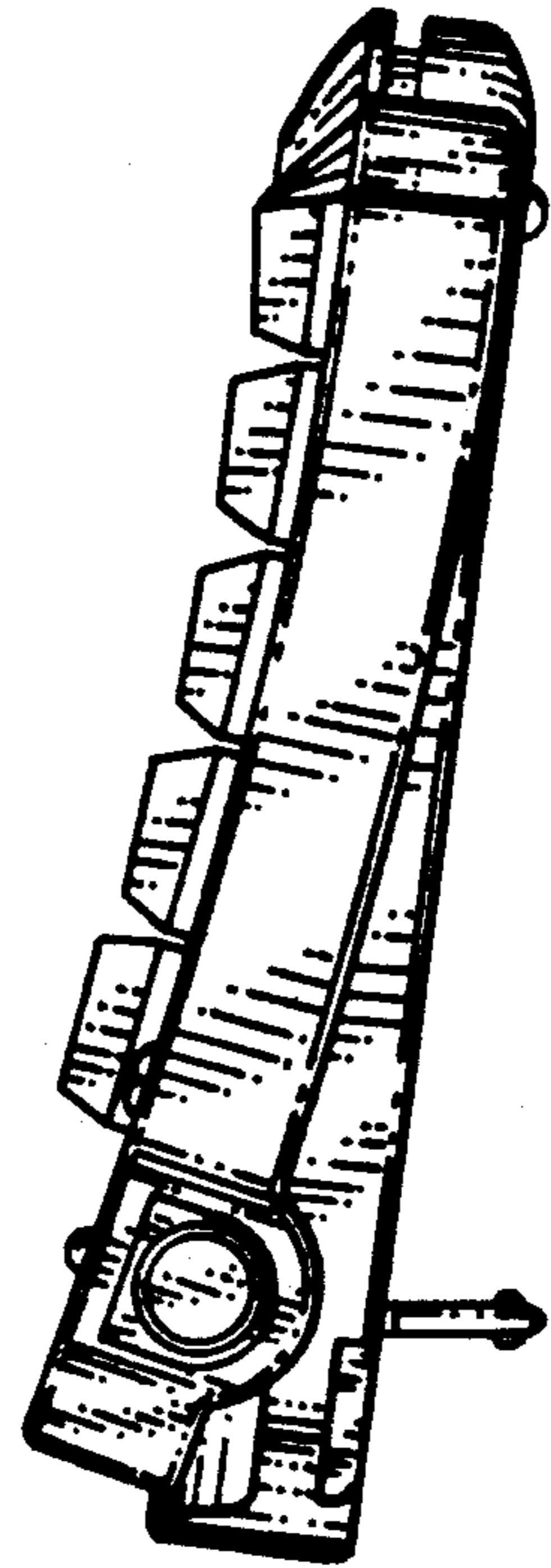

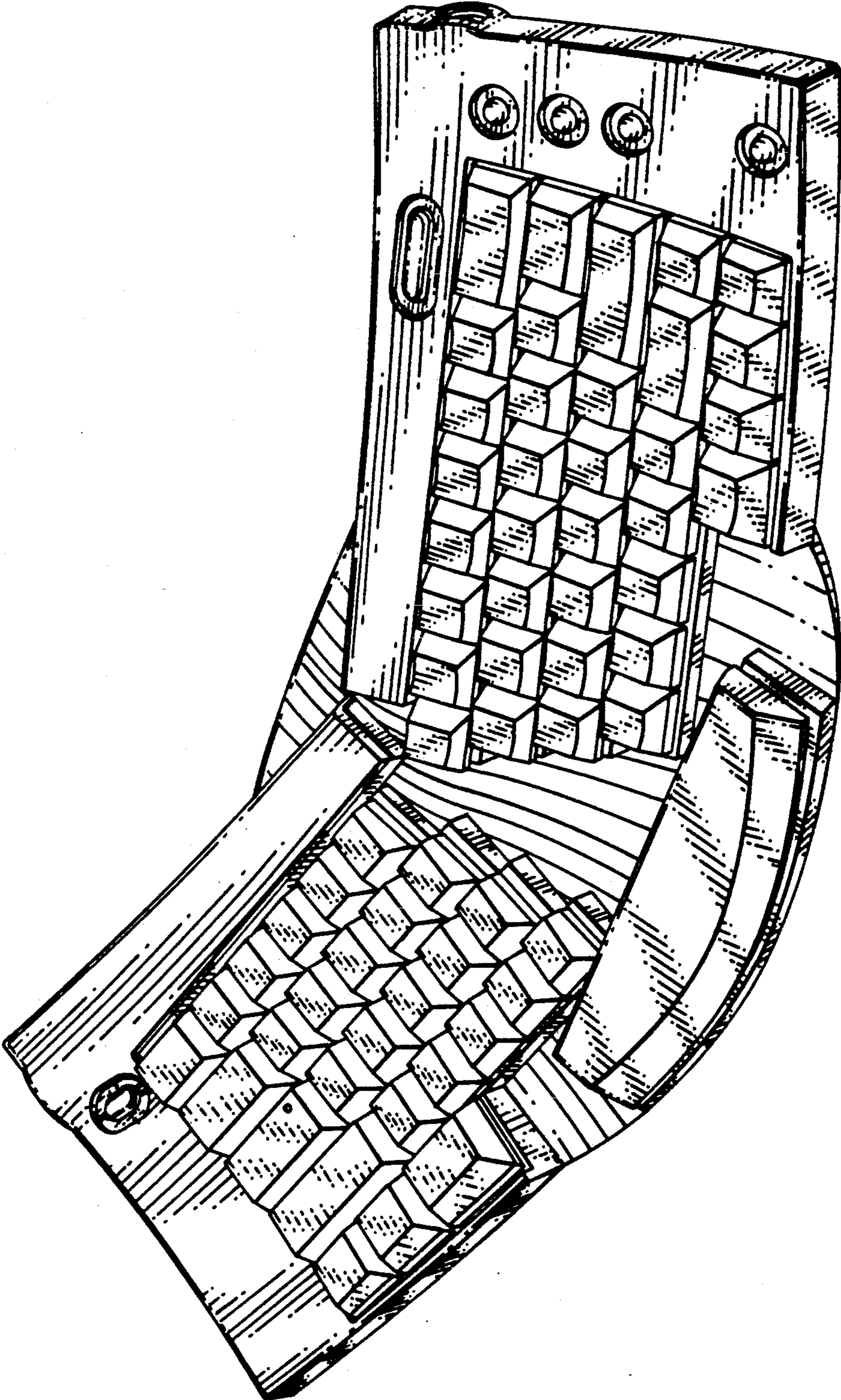

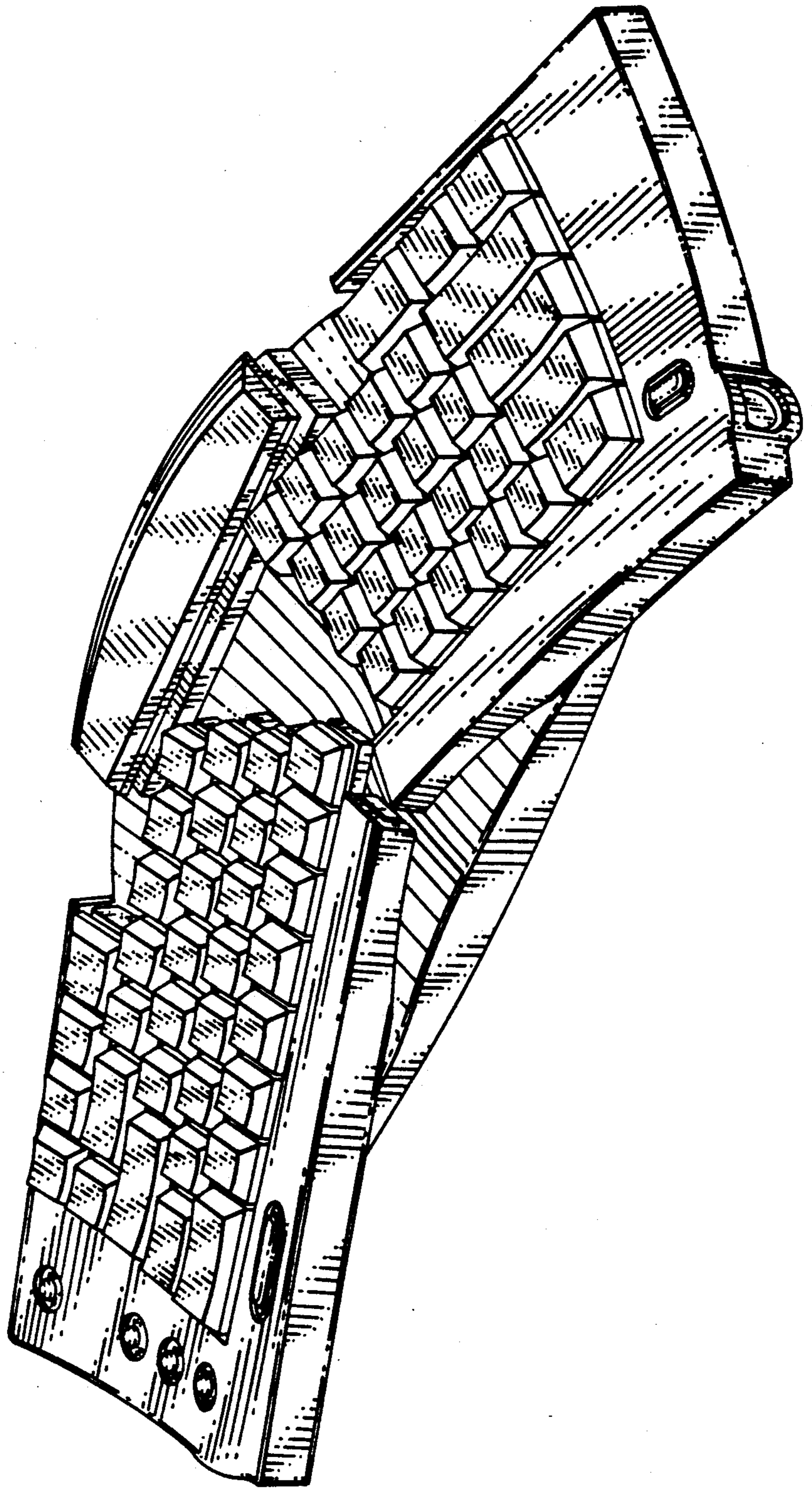
