FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

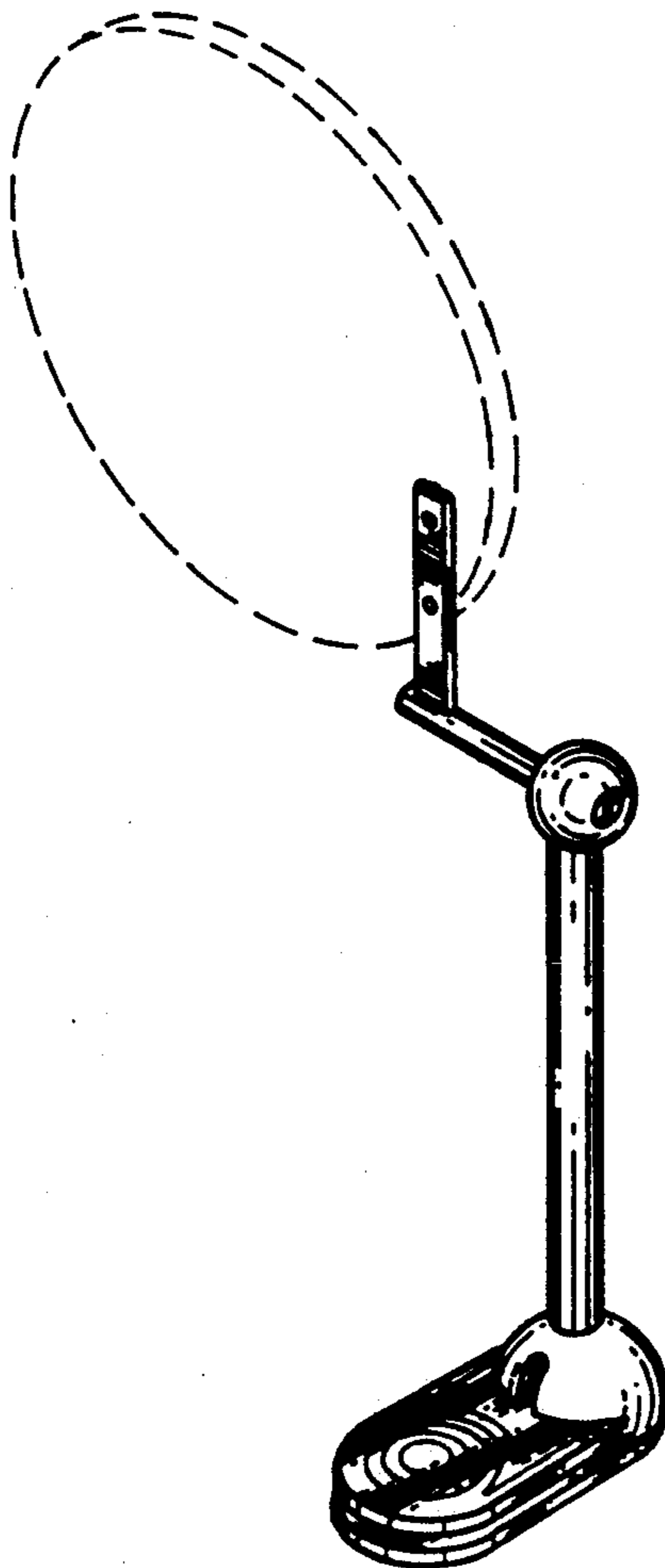
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

The broken line representation of a toilet seat in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.



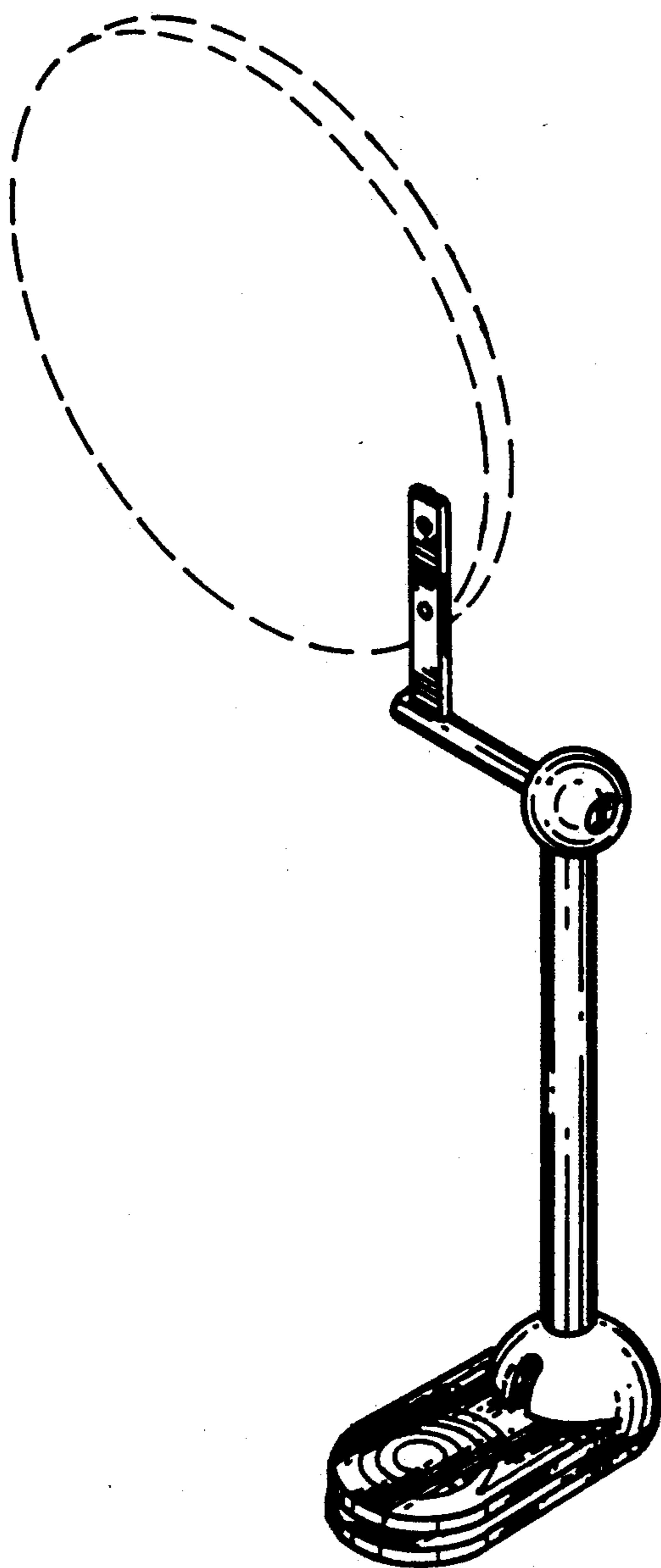

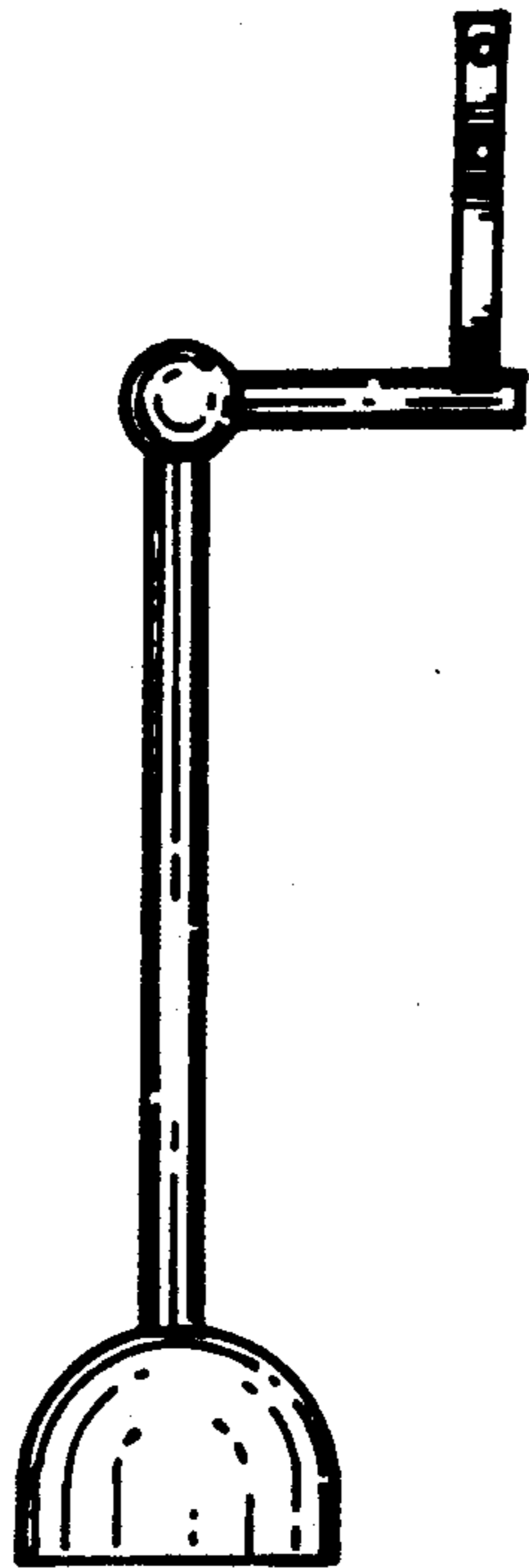
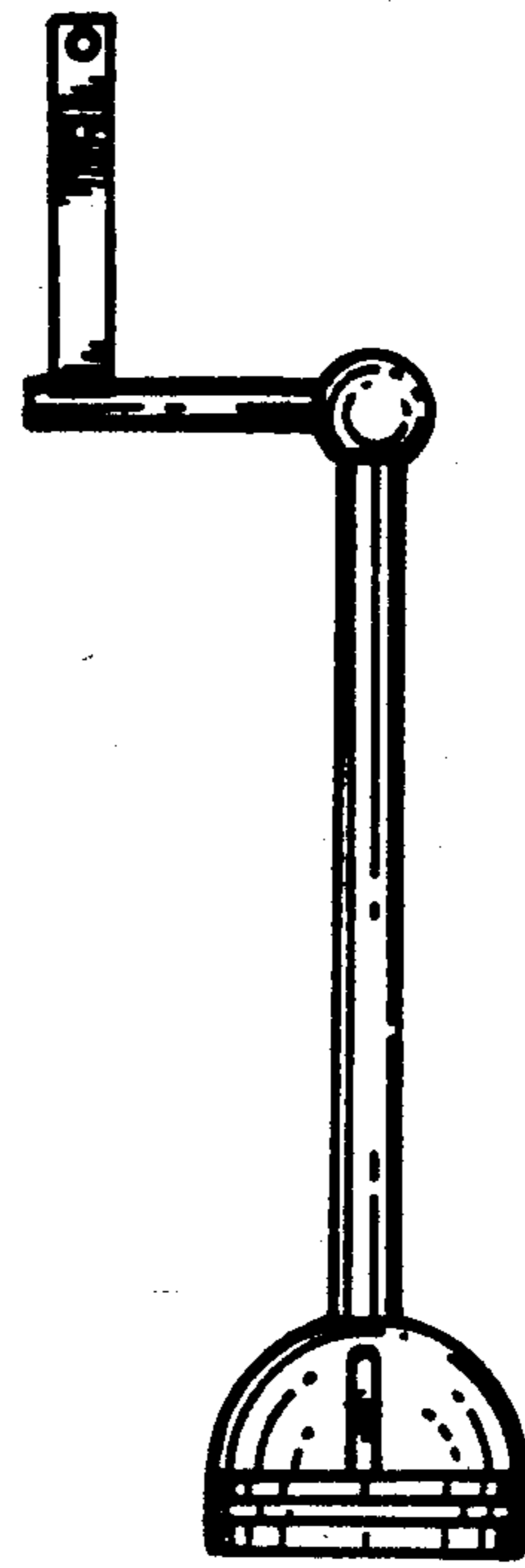

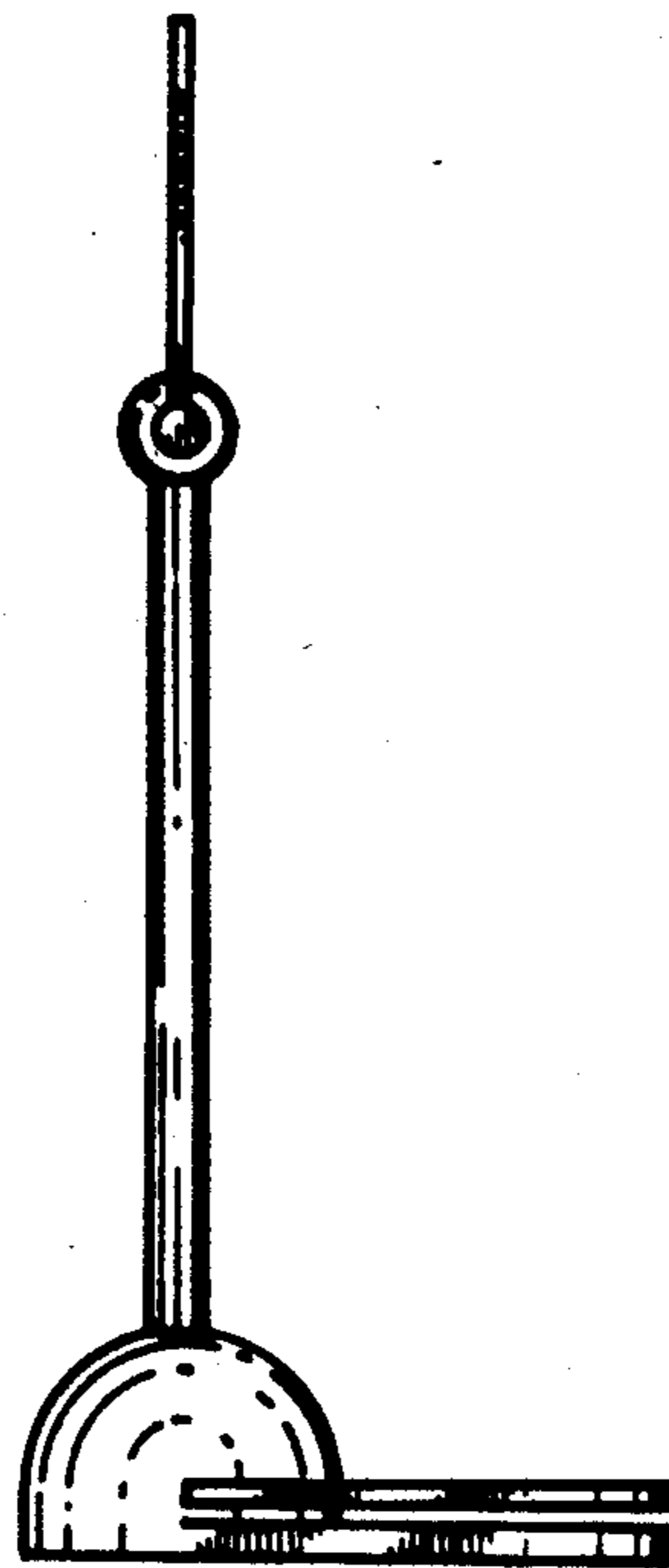

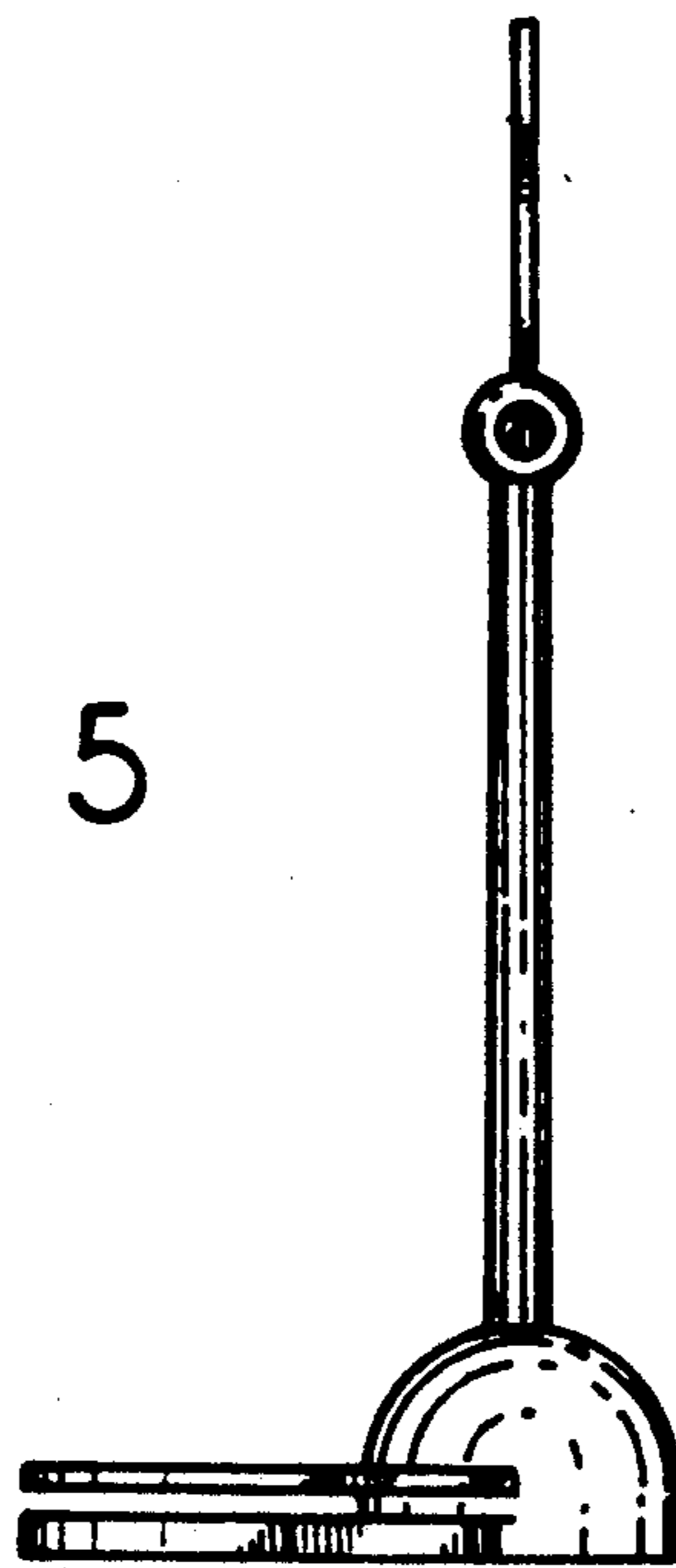

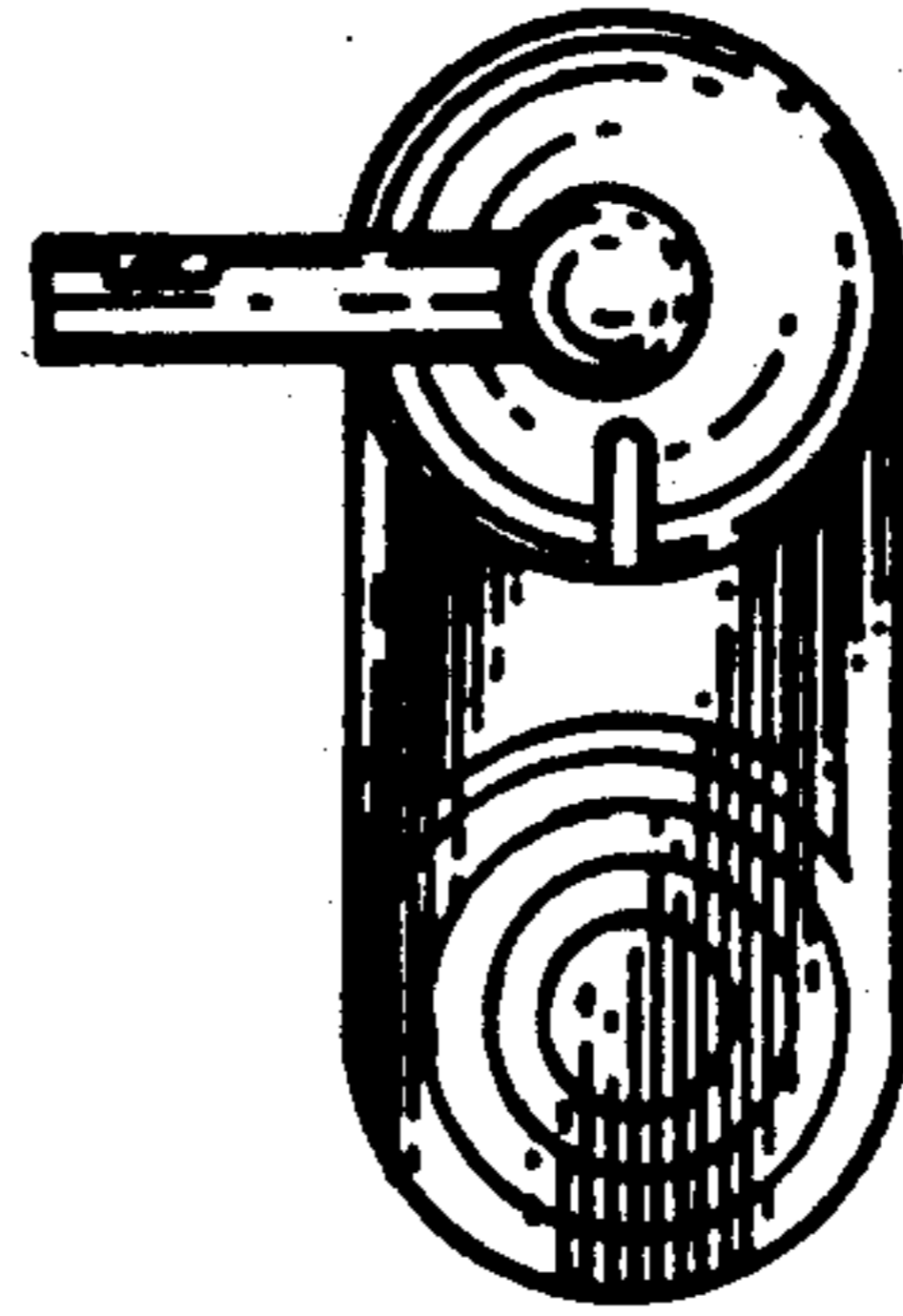
