FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a chandelier showing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image;

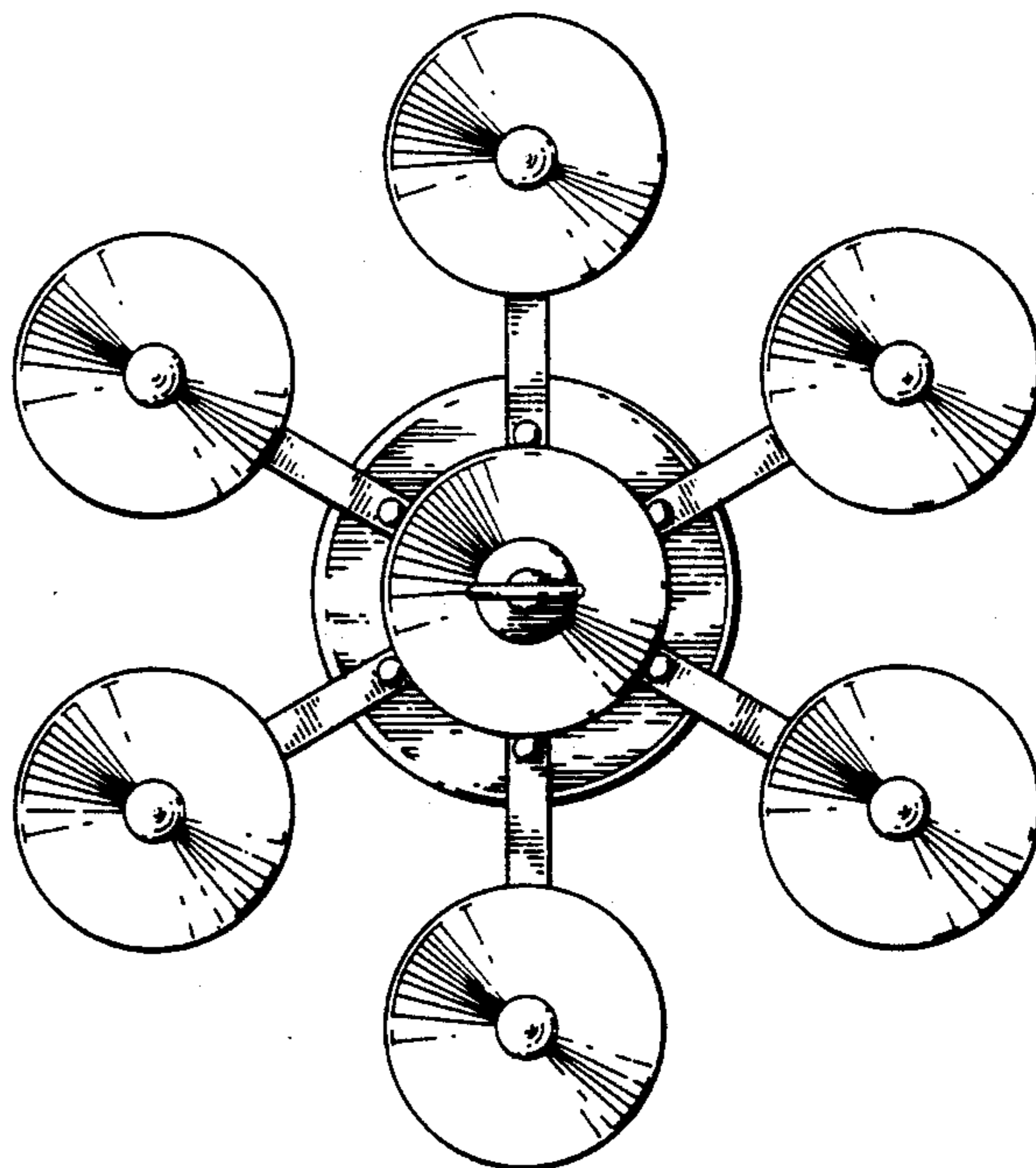
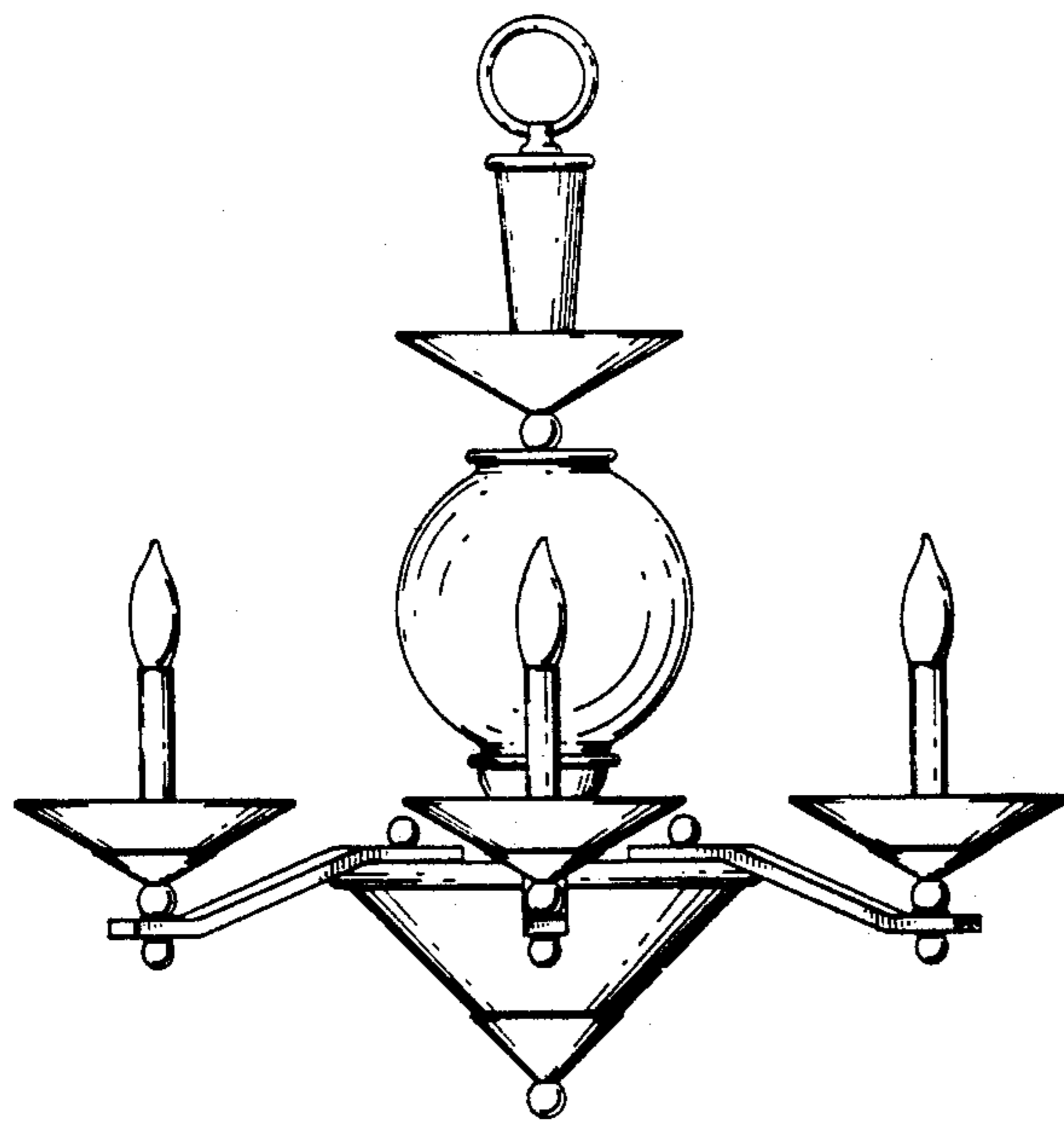
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of said chandelier as seen from the right side of FIG. 1, the side as seen from the left being a mirror image;

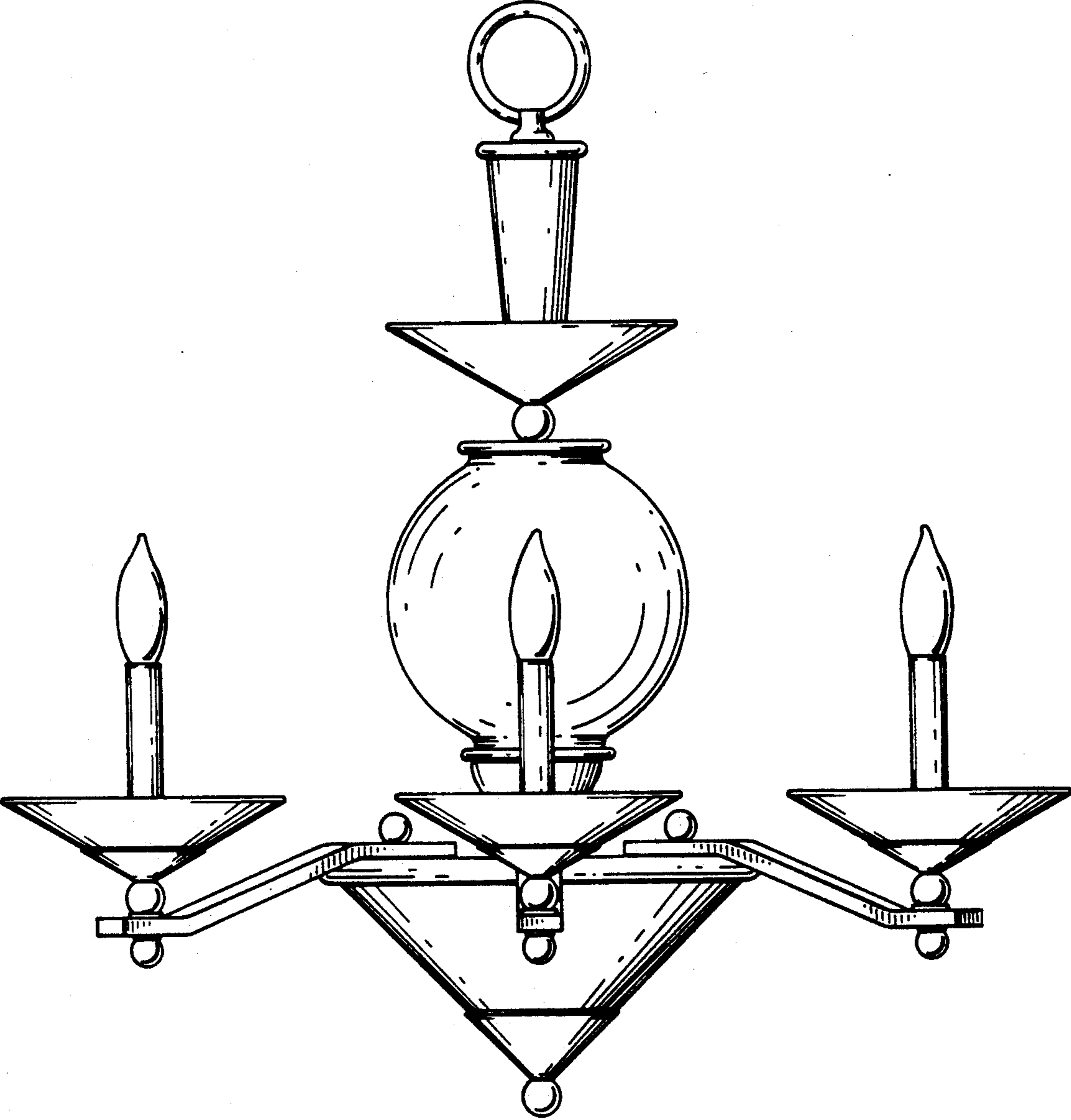
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of said chandelier; and, FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

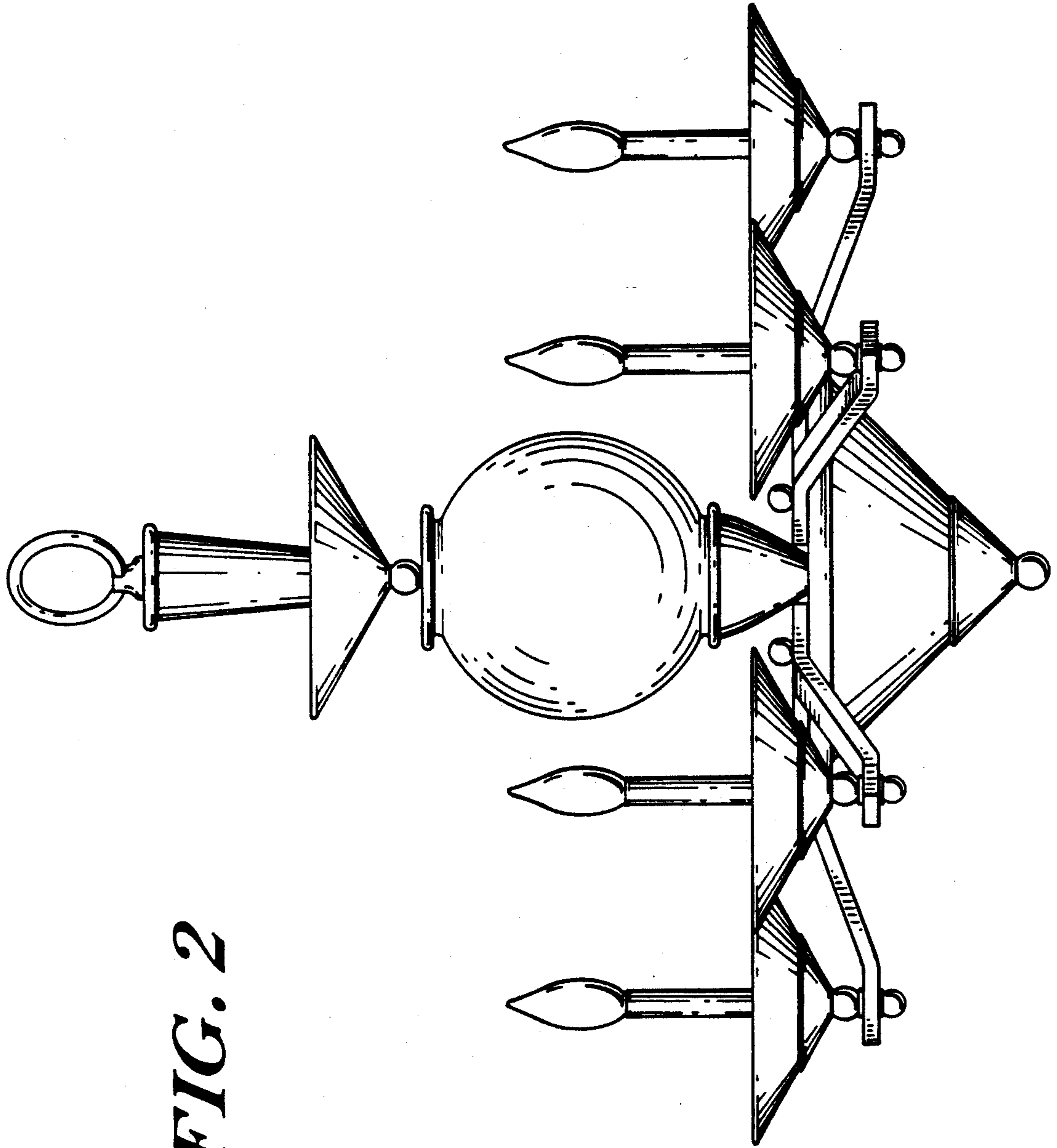

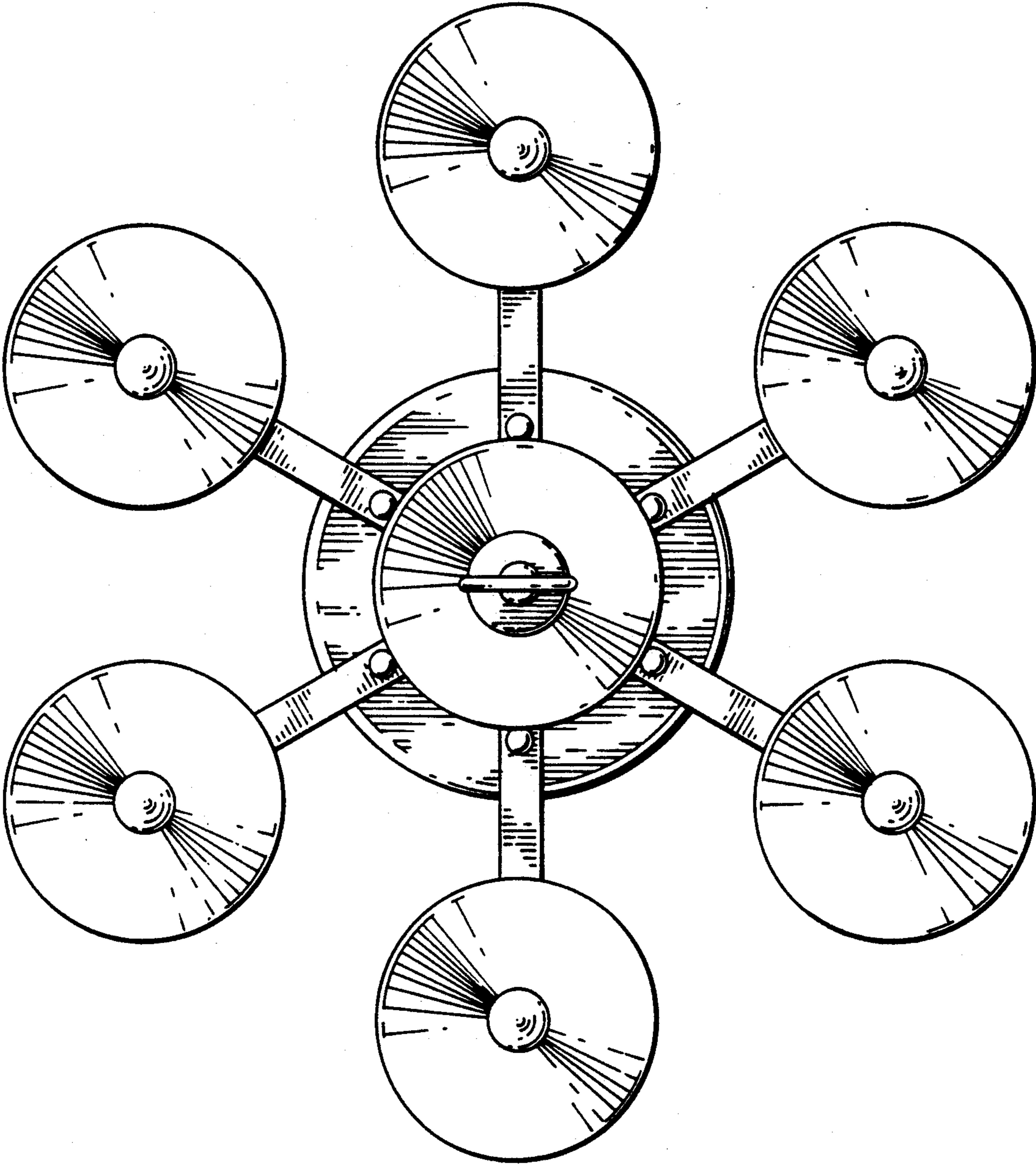

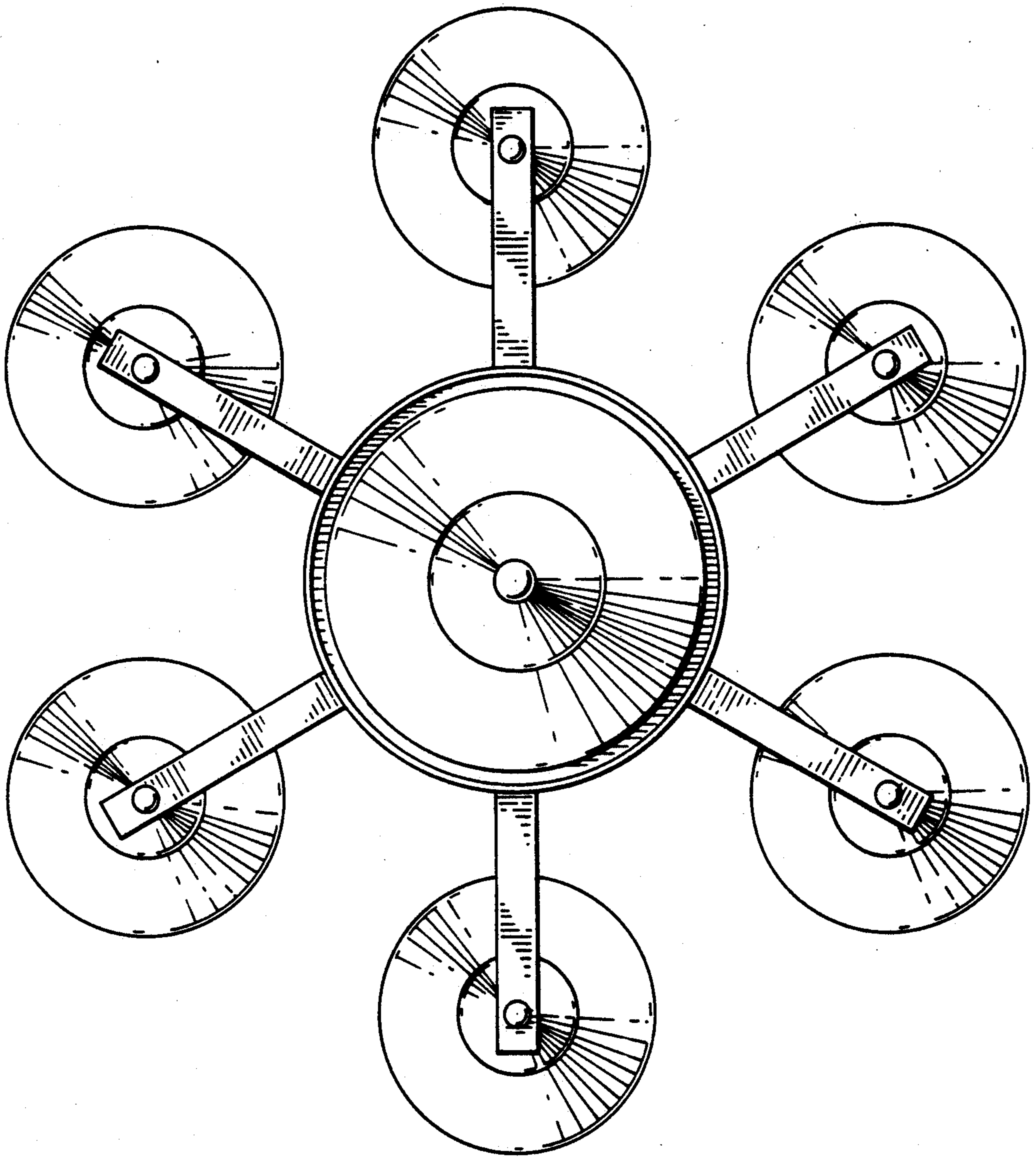
