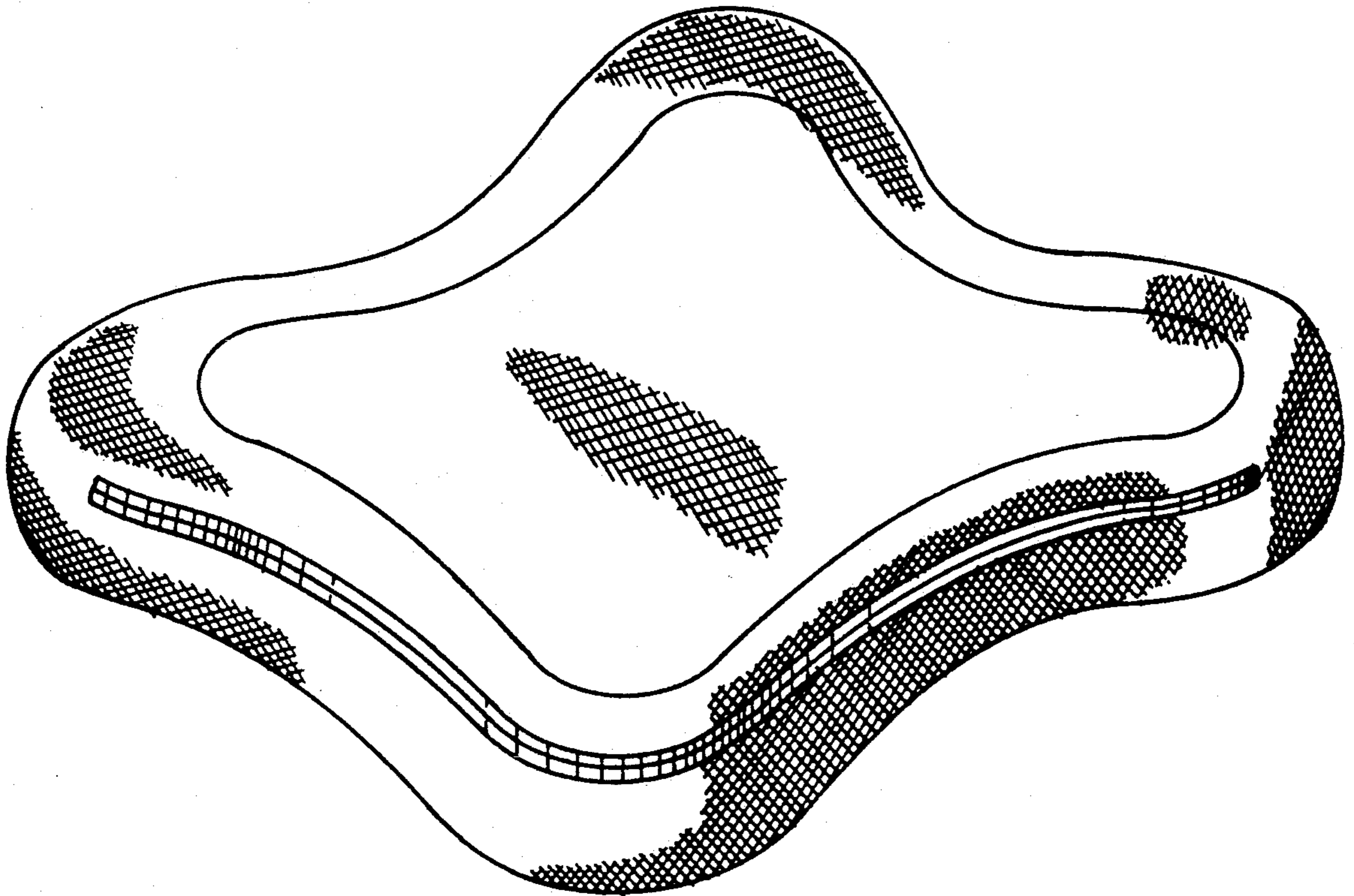

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pillow for use in treating injuries, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and front perspective view of a pillow for use in treating injuries showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a typical side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 4; and, FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom view being a mirror image of the top view shown in FIG. 5. The criss-cross pattern fragmentarily shown in FIGS. 1-5, is understood to extend throughout the pillow.



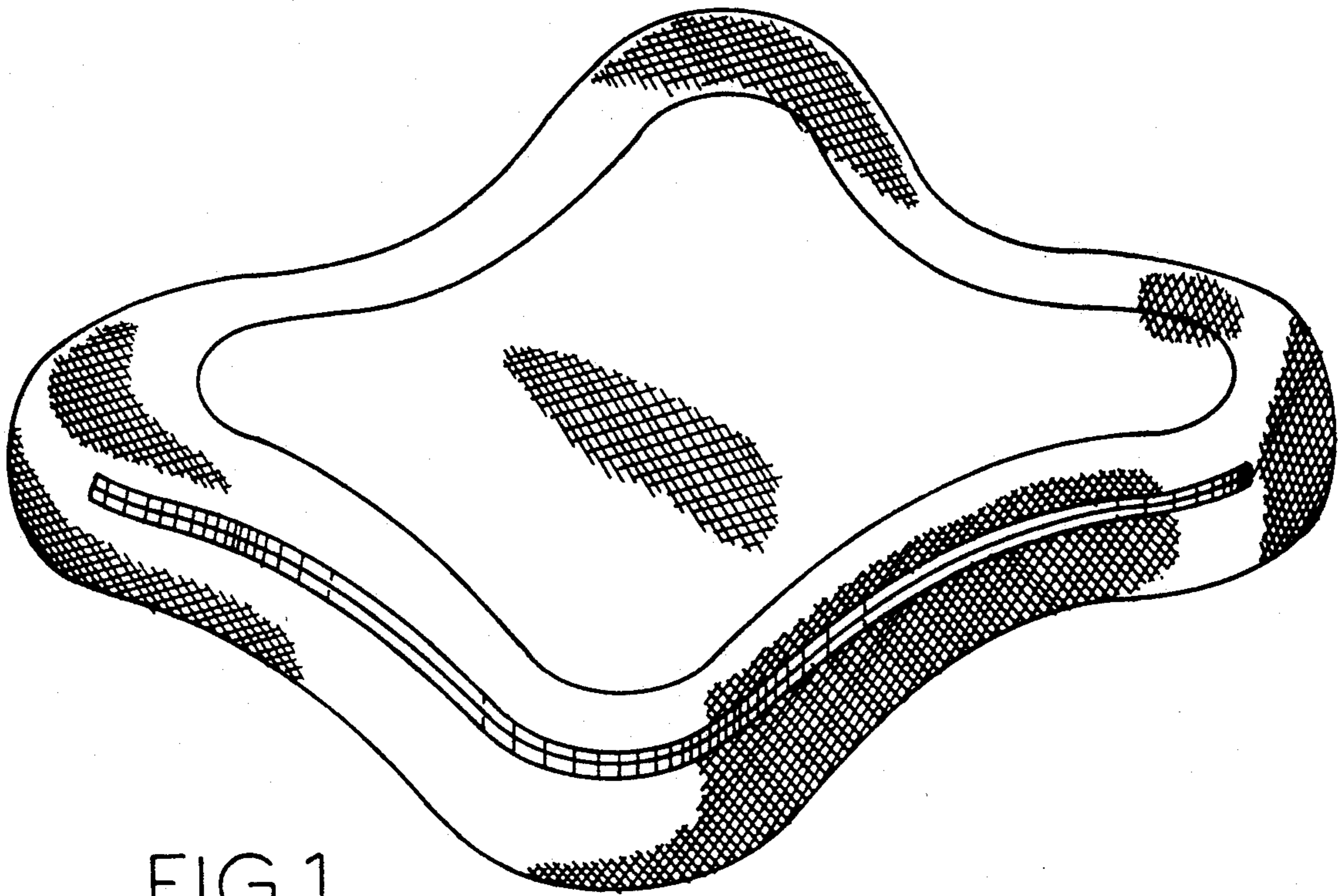

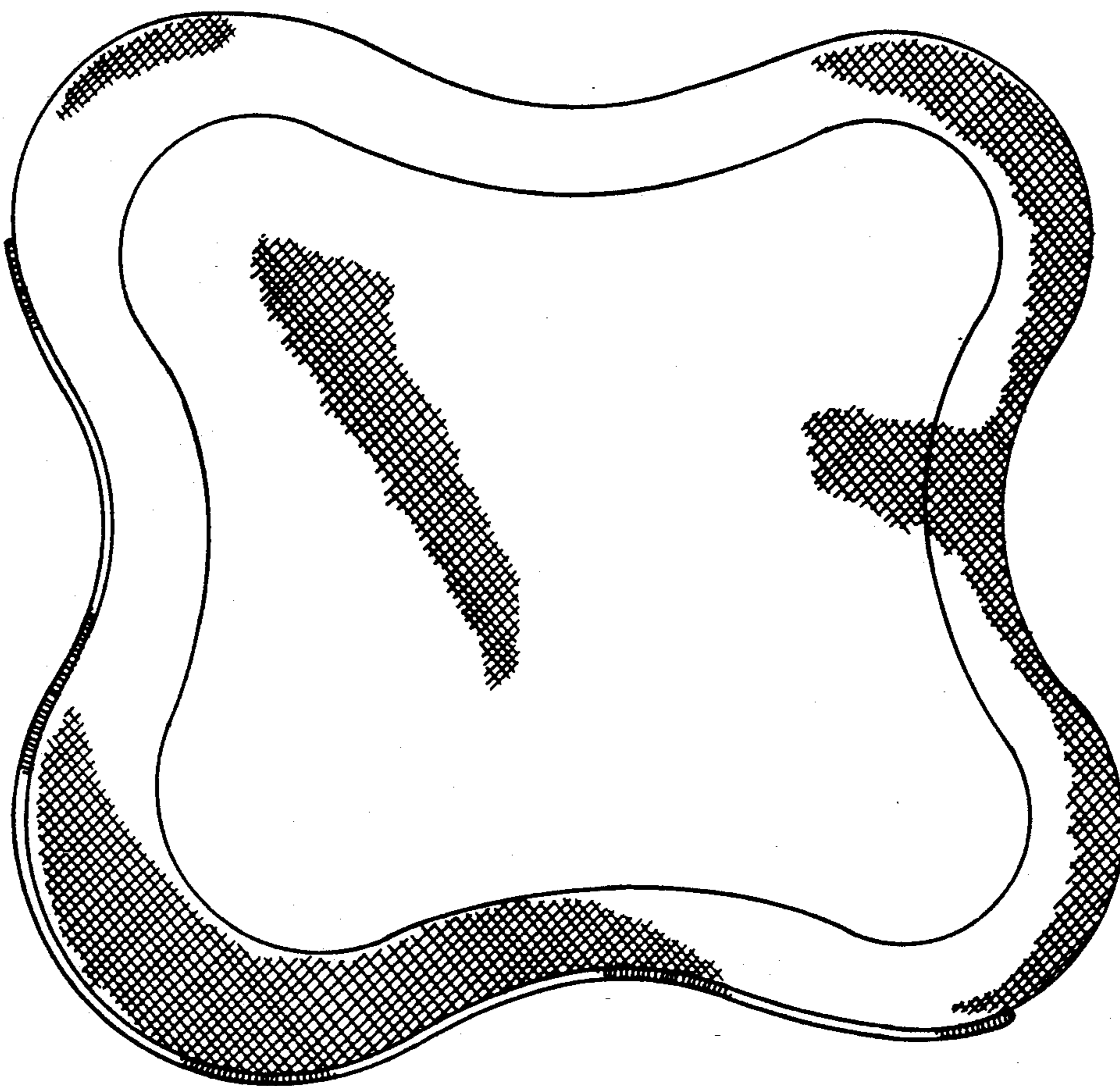

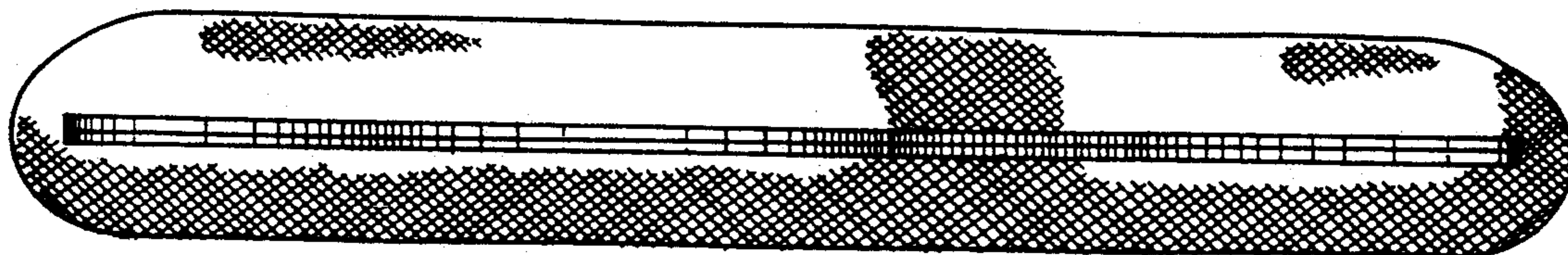

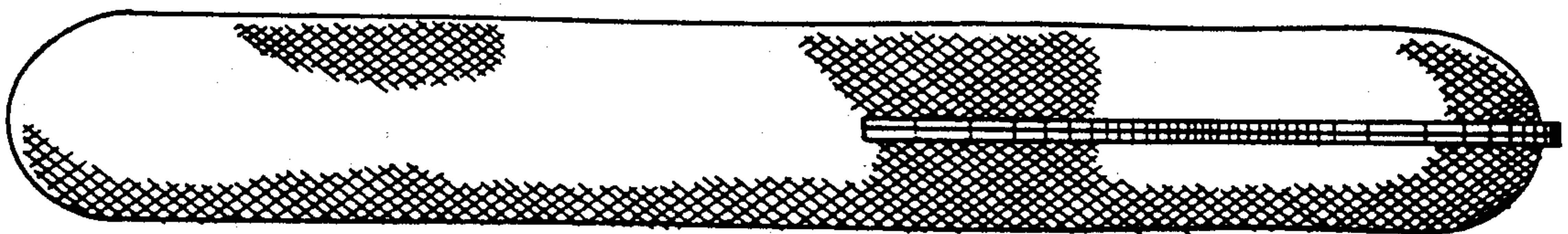
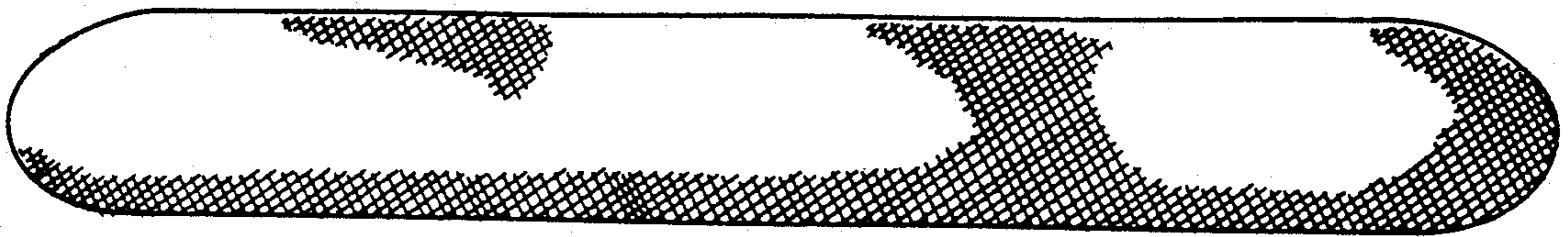
