FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of the FIG. 9 embodiment of my design.

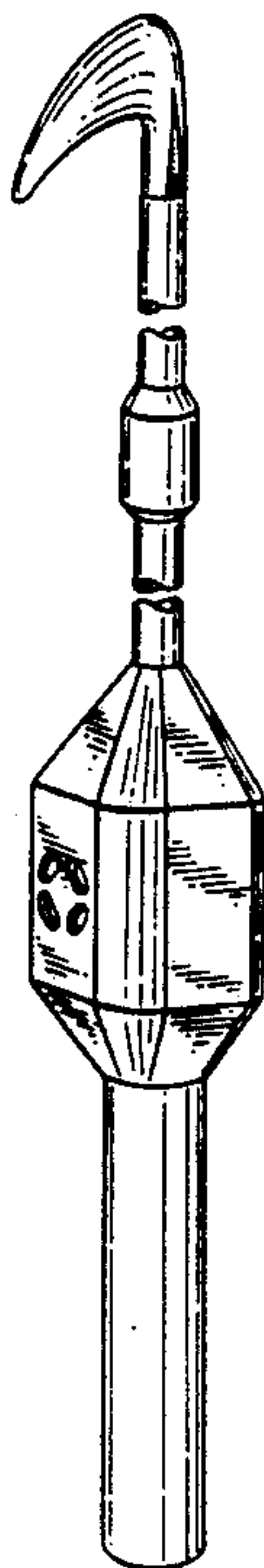

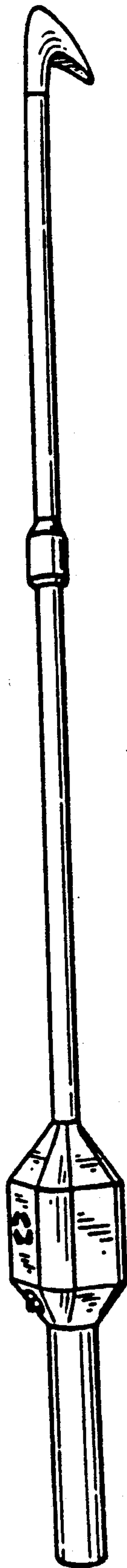

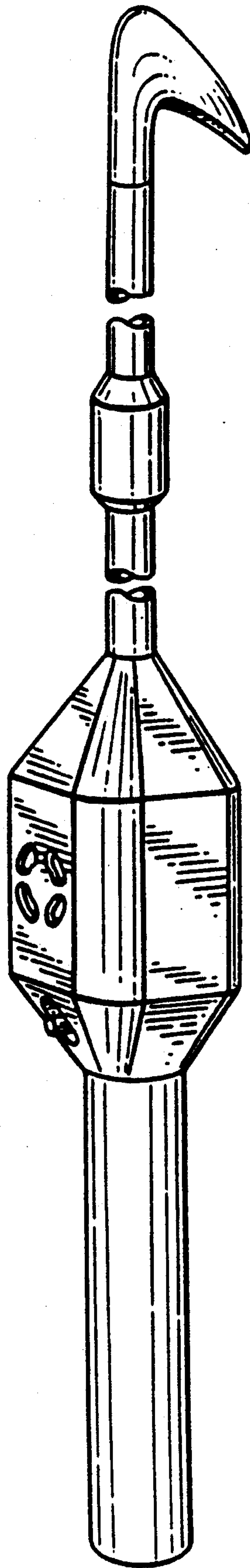

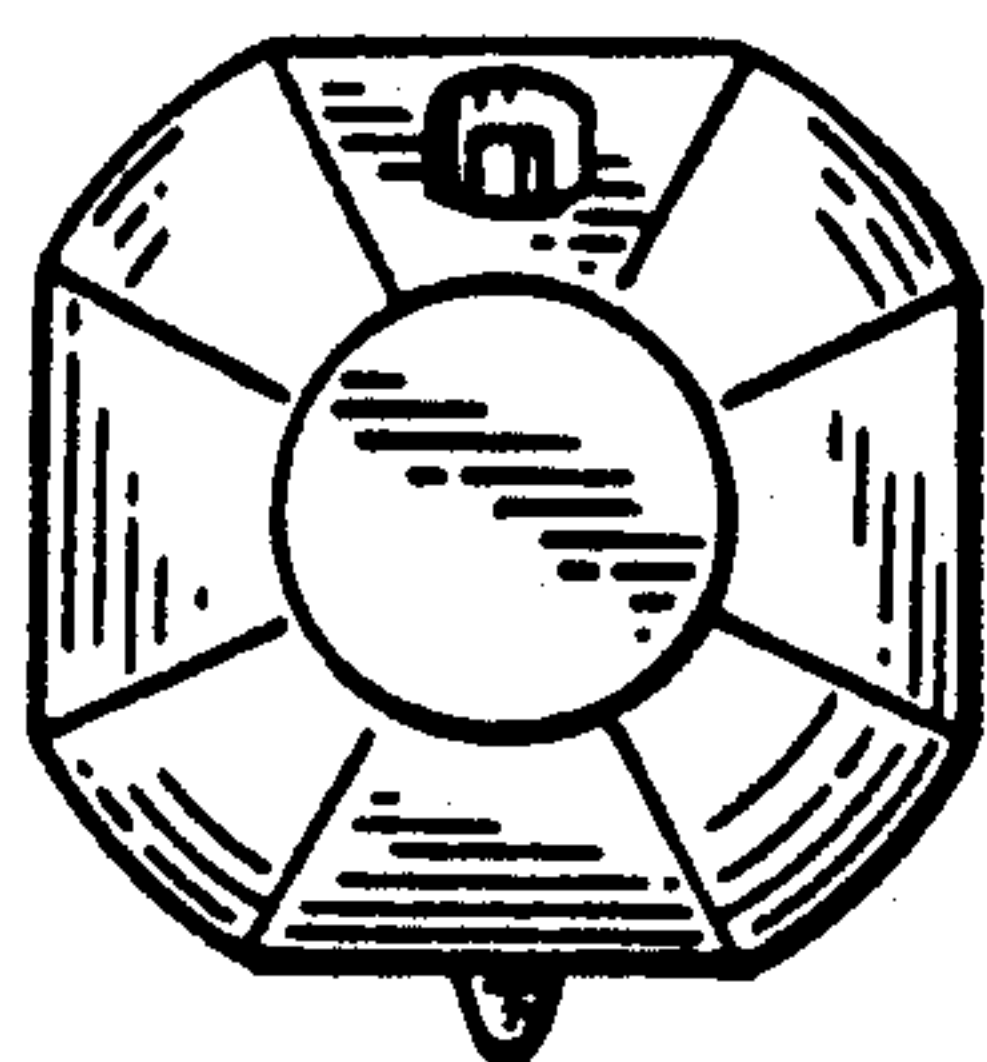

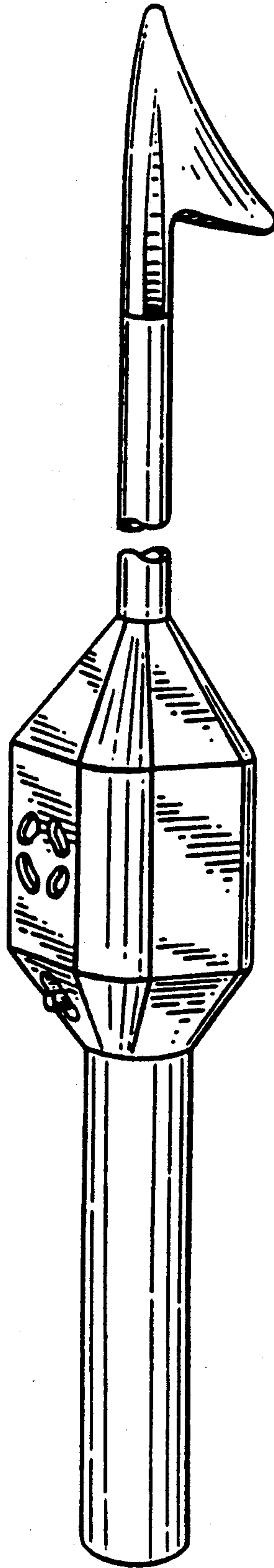
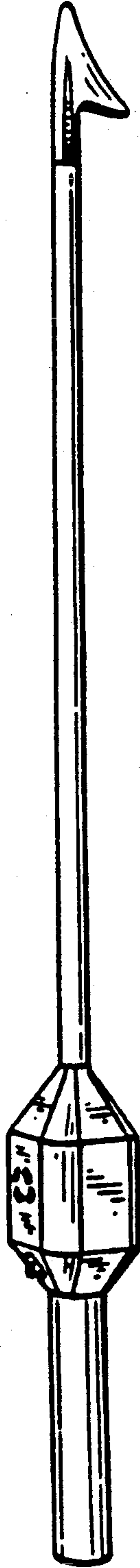

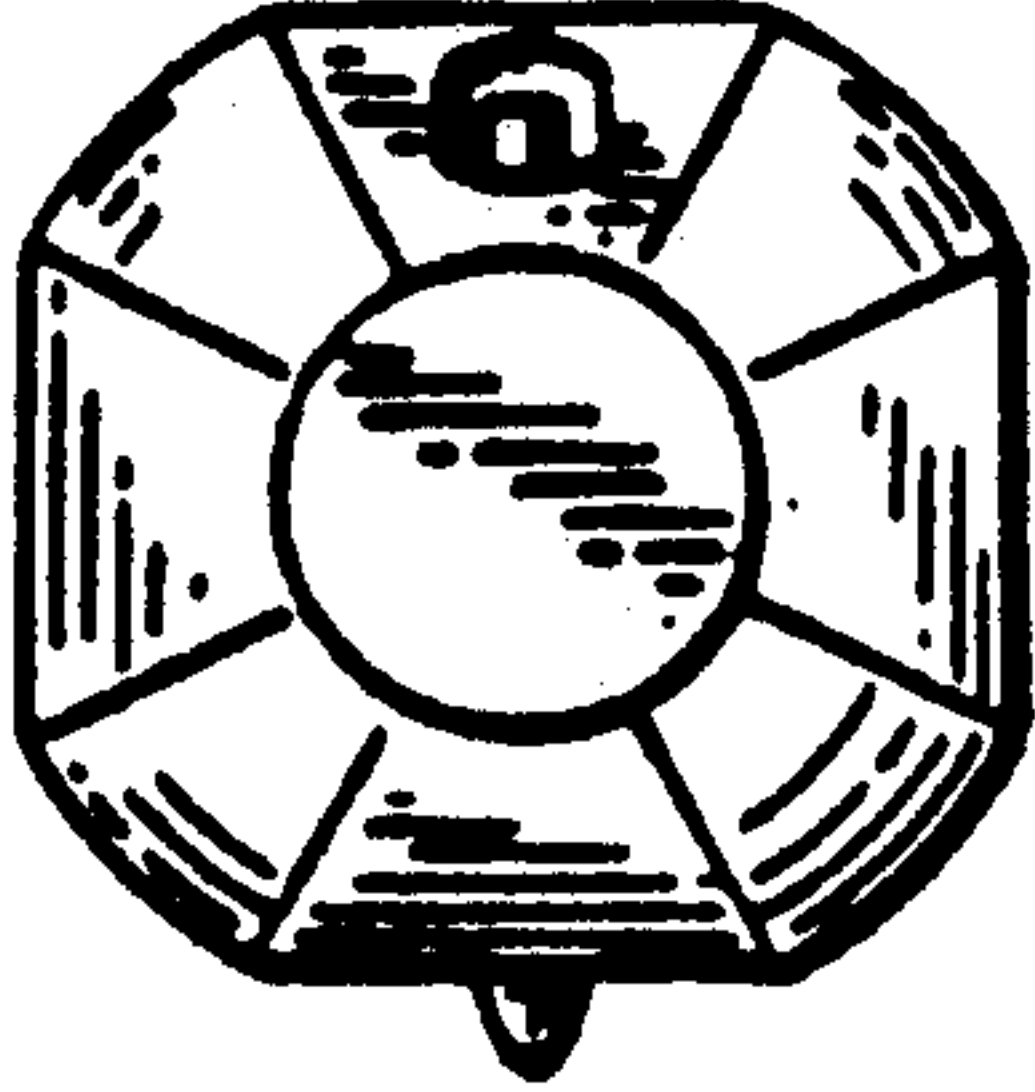

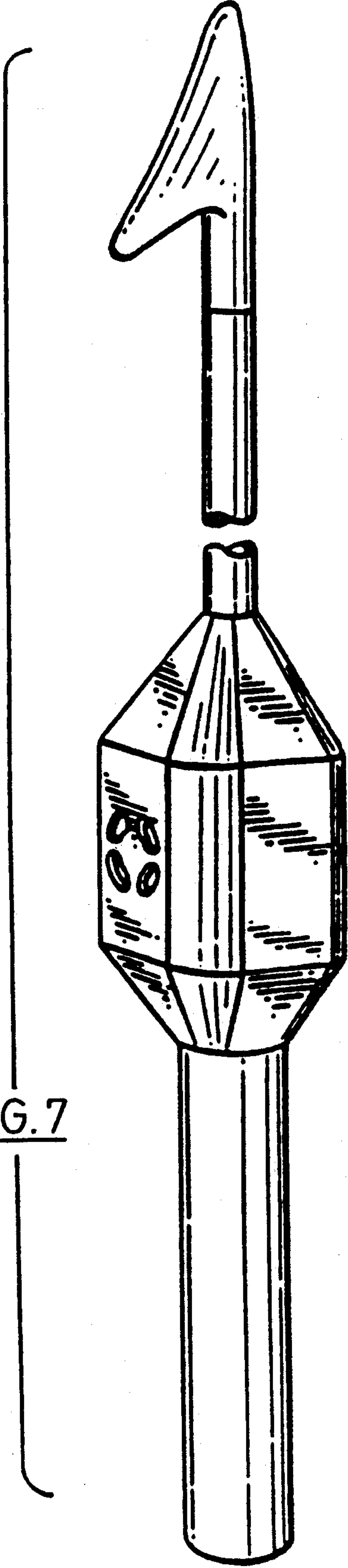

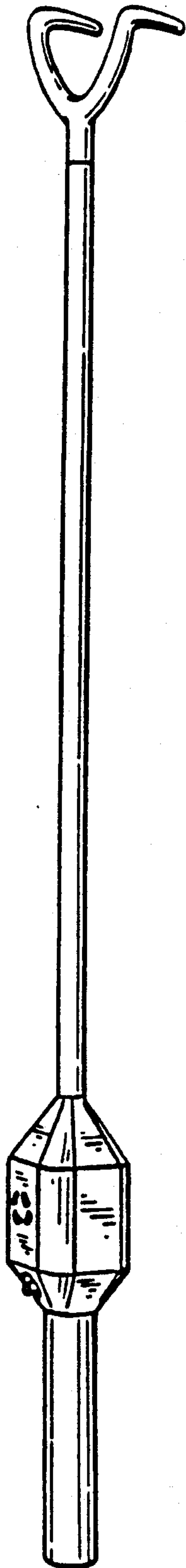

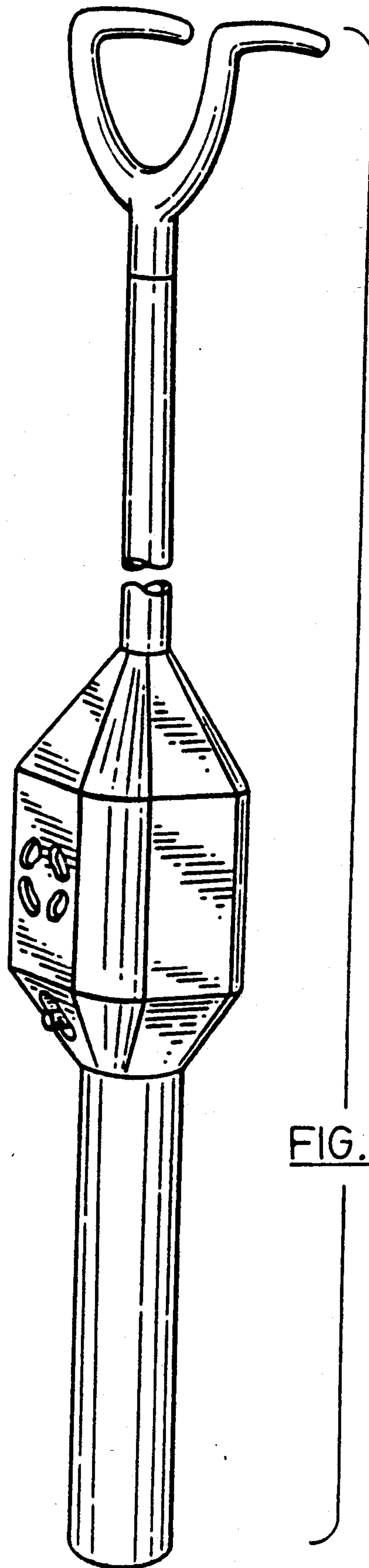

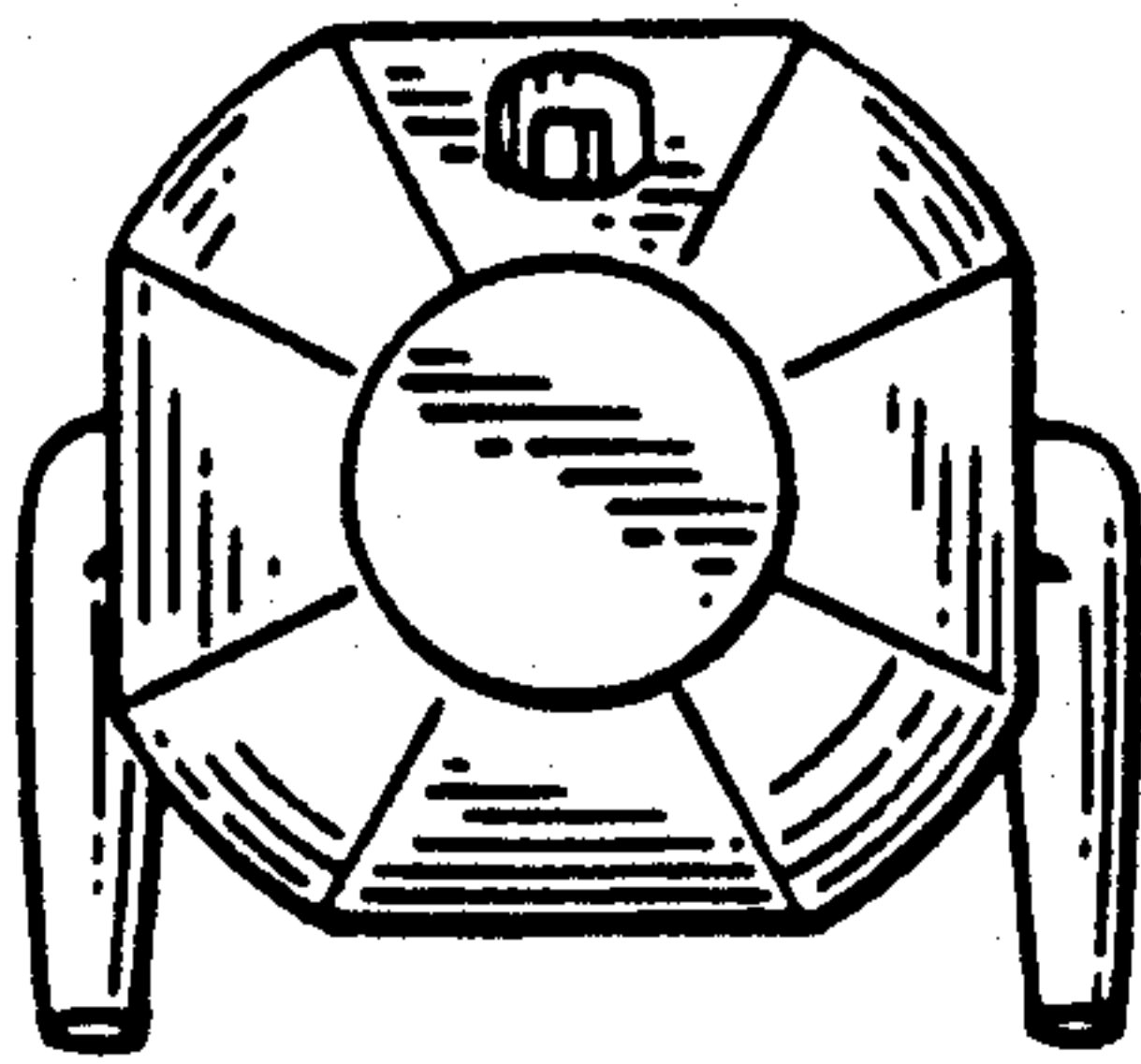
