DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the wristwatch showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is an enlarged, partial front elevational view thereof, the bands being broken away for ease of illustration.

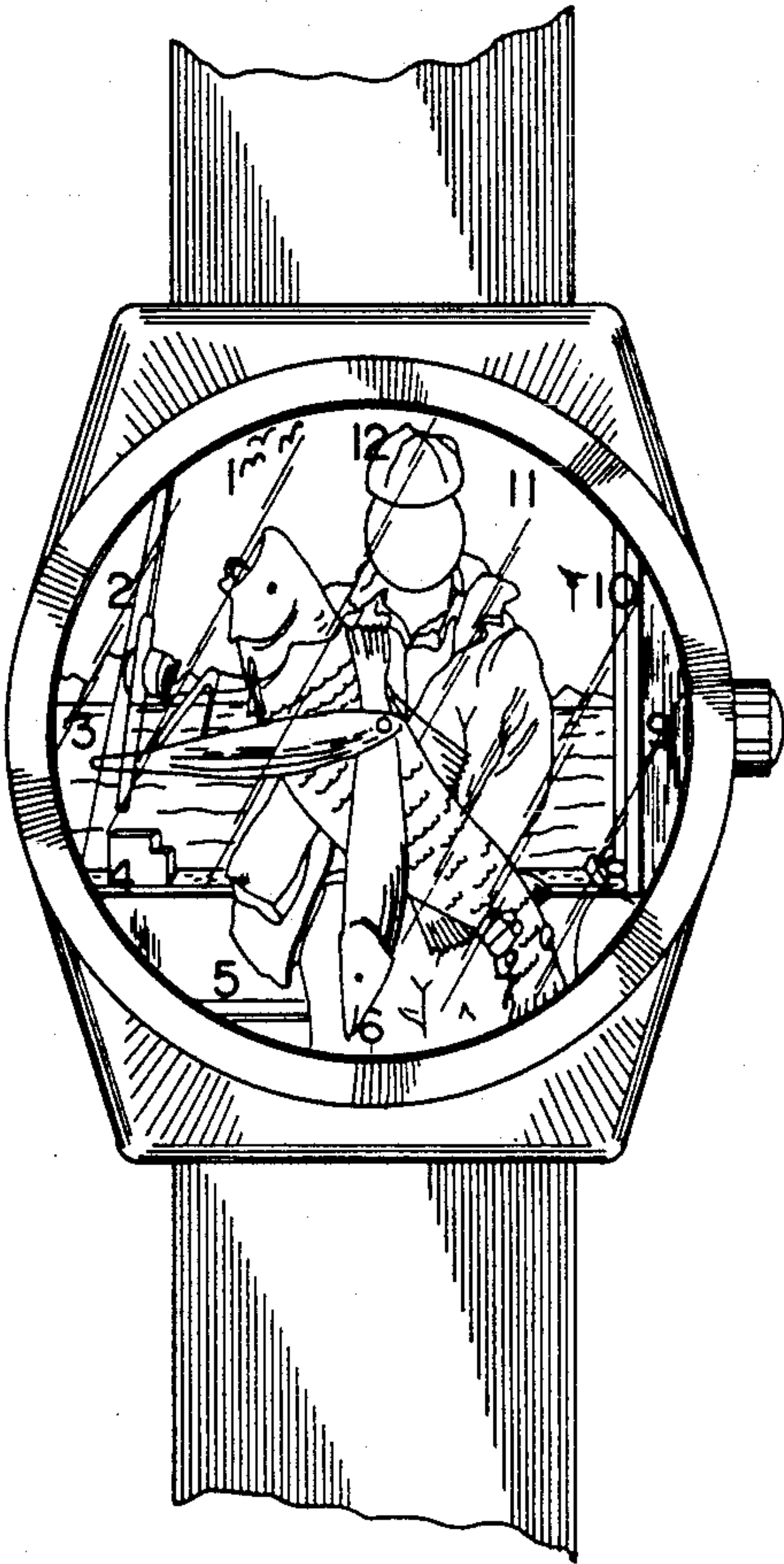

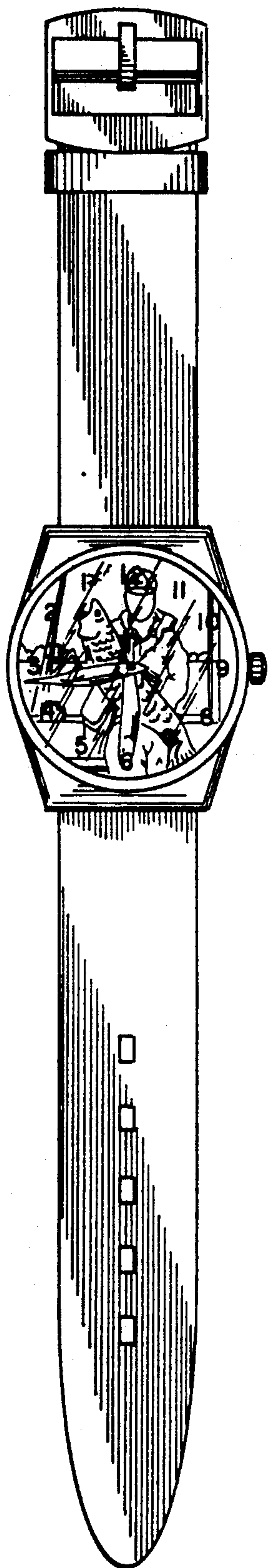

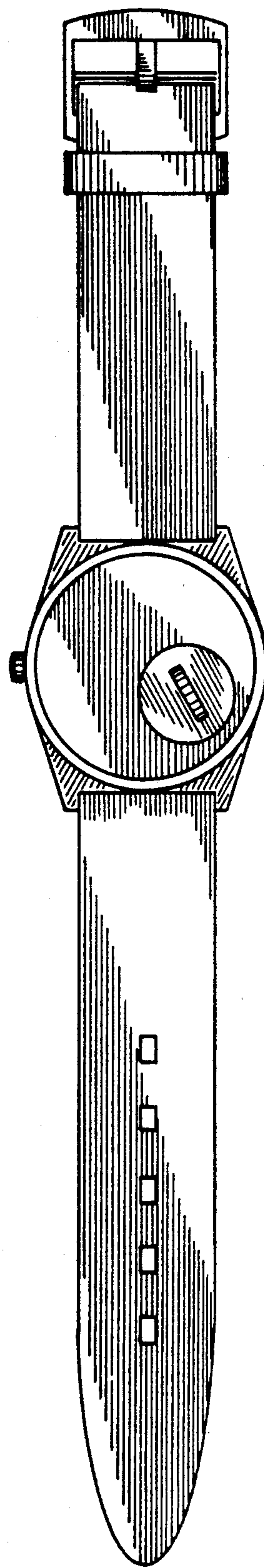

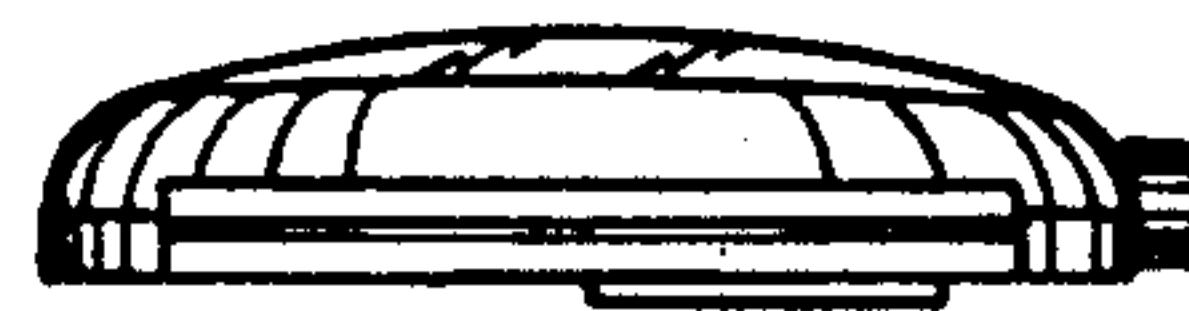
