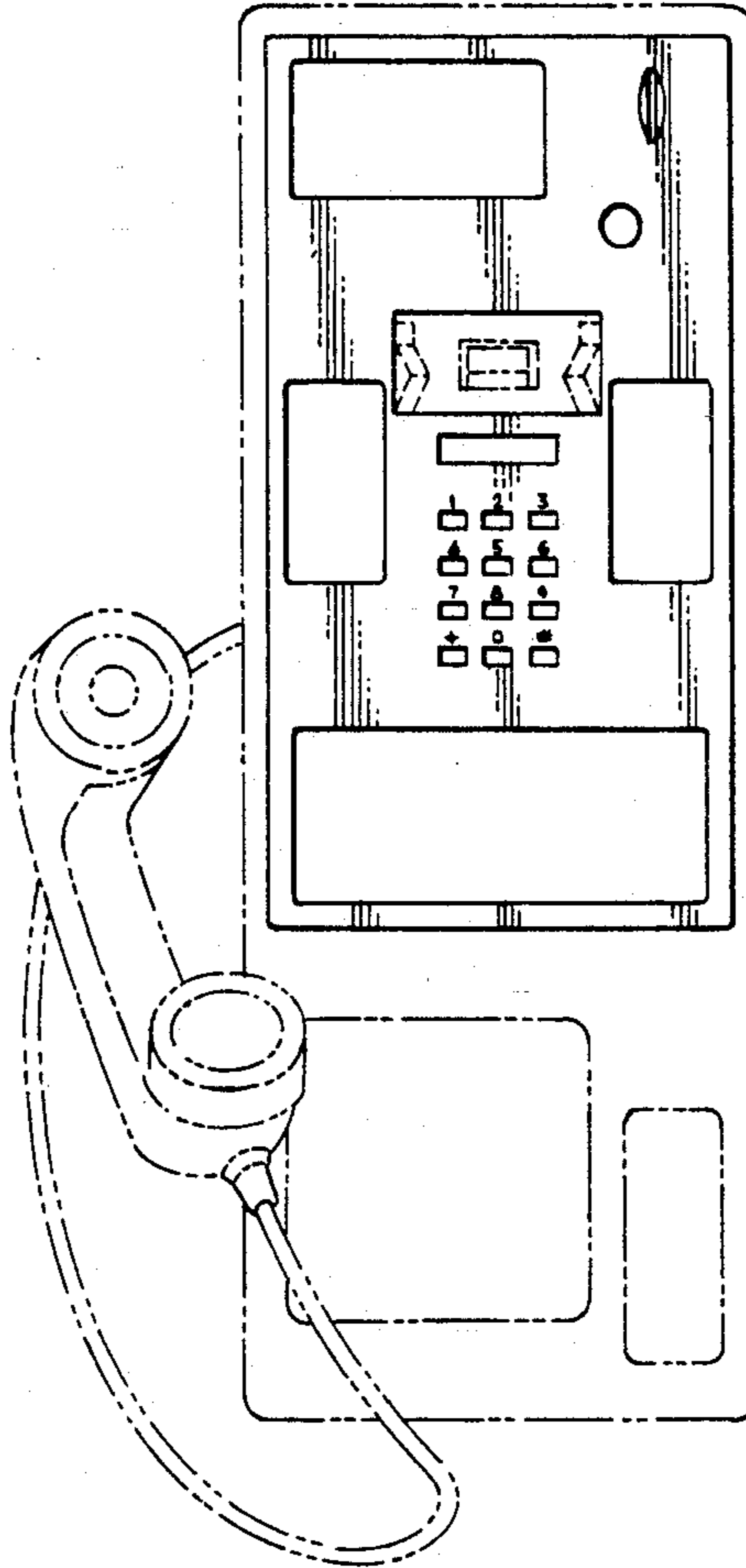

The broken line showing of the telephone box, telephone transmitter-receiver instrument and cord, etc. is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



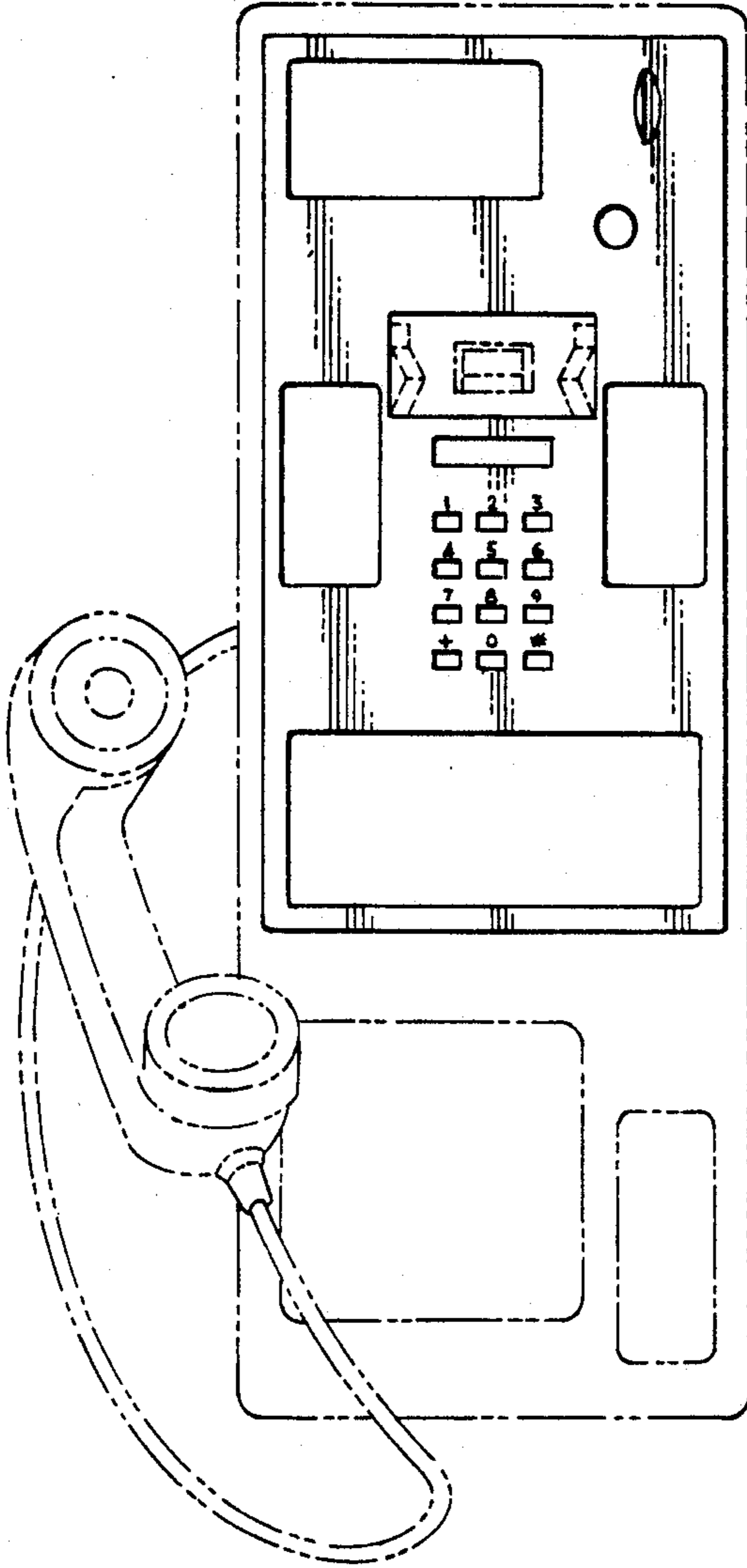

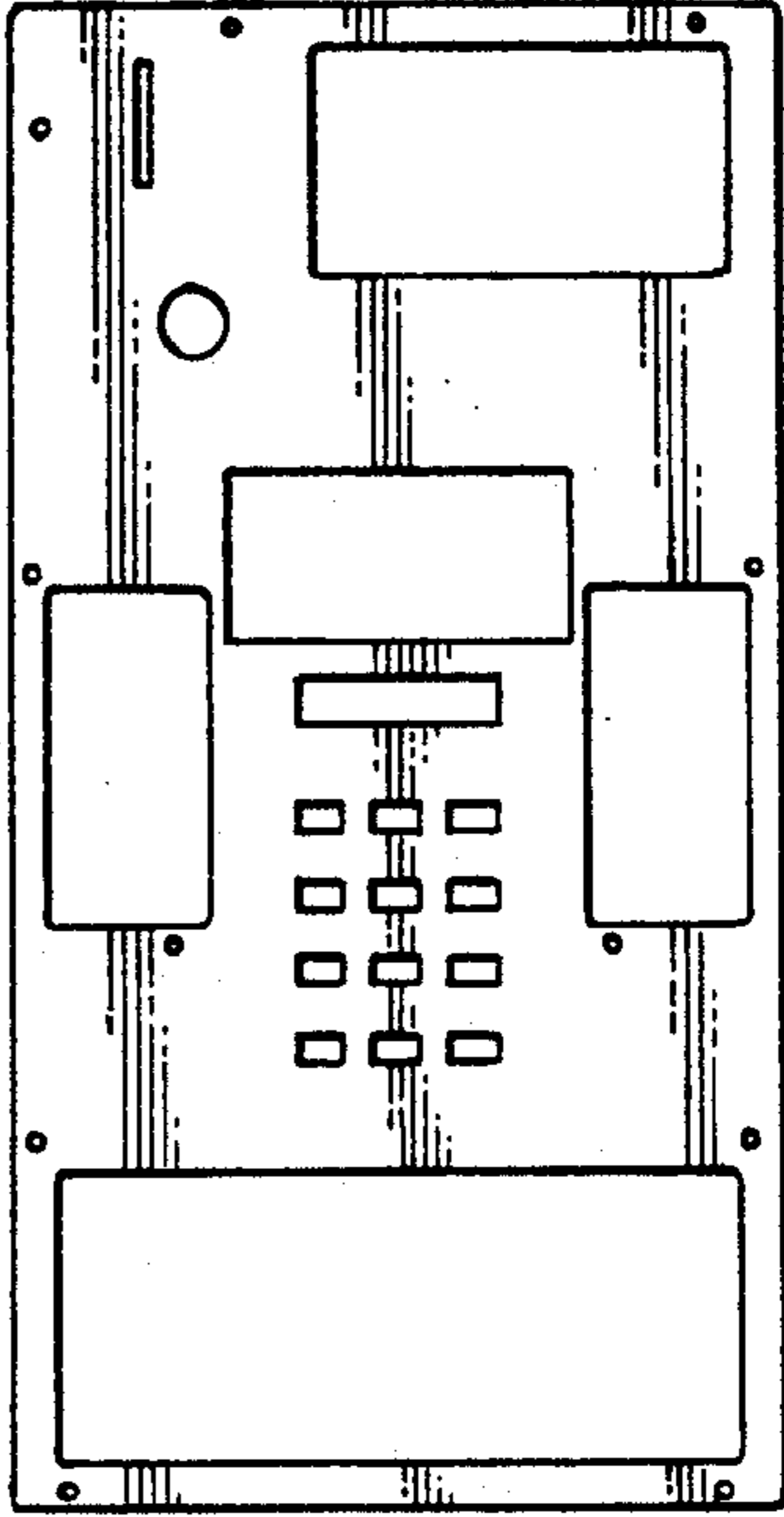

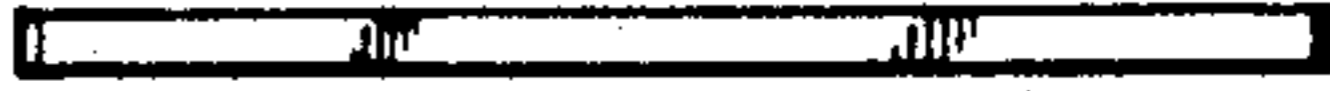
