FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a golf swing guide showing my new design, the bottom plan view being a mirror image of that shown;

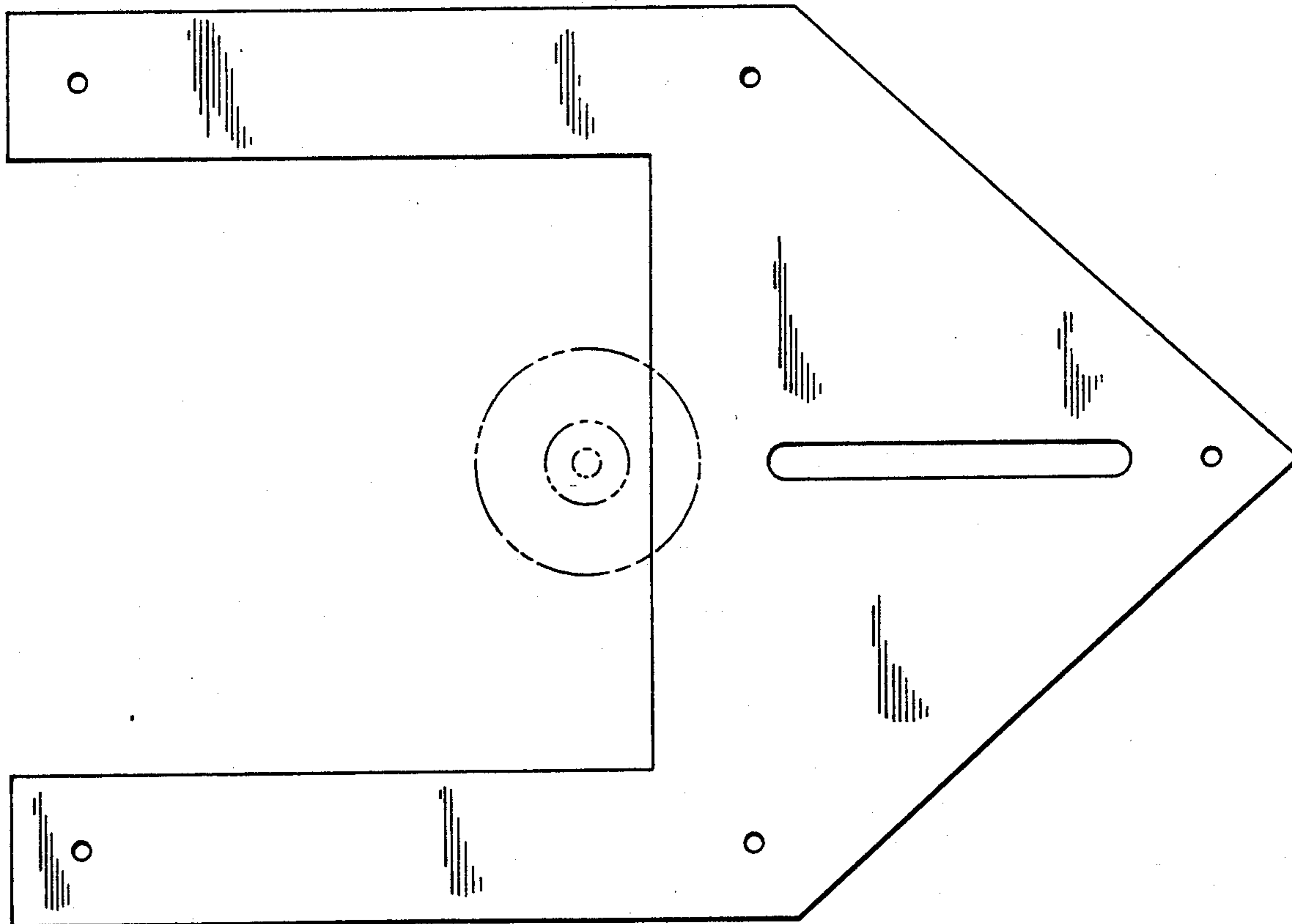
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of my new design as seen from the right-hand side of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation view being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 4 is an alternate top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a side elevation view of my new design as seen from the right-hand side of FIG. 4.

The broken line showing a golf ball and golf tee in FIGS. 1 and 4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



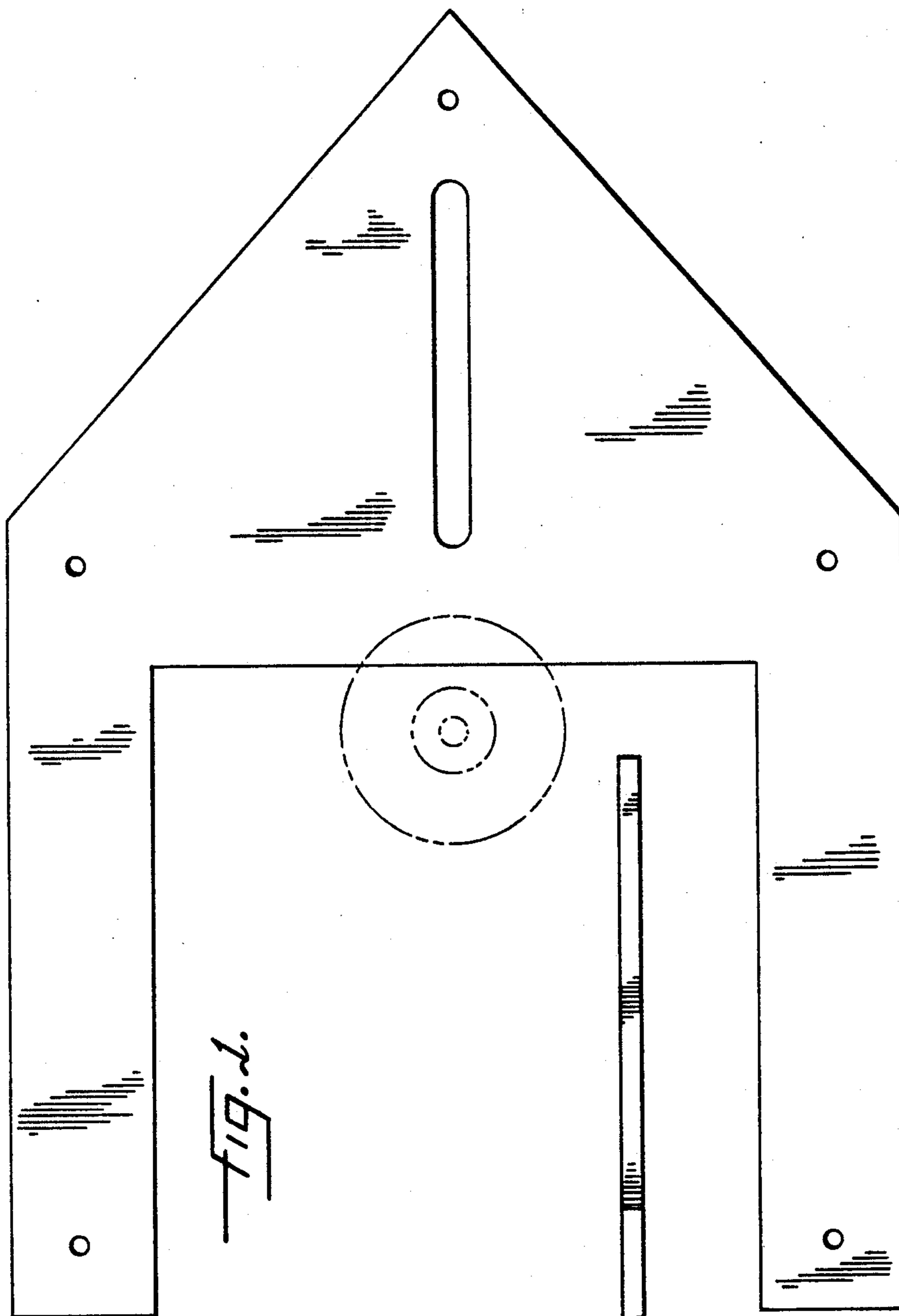
