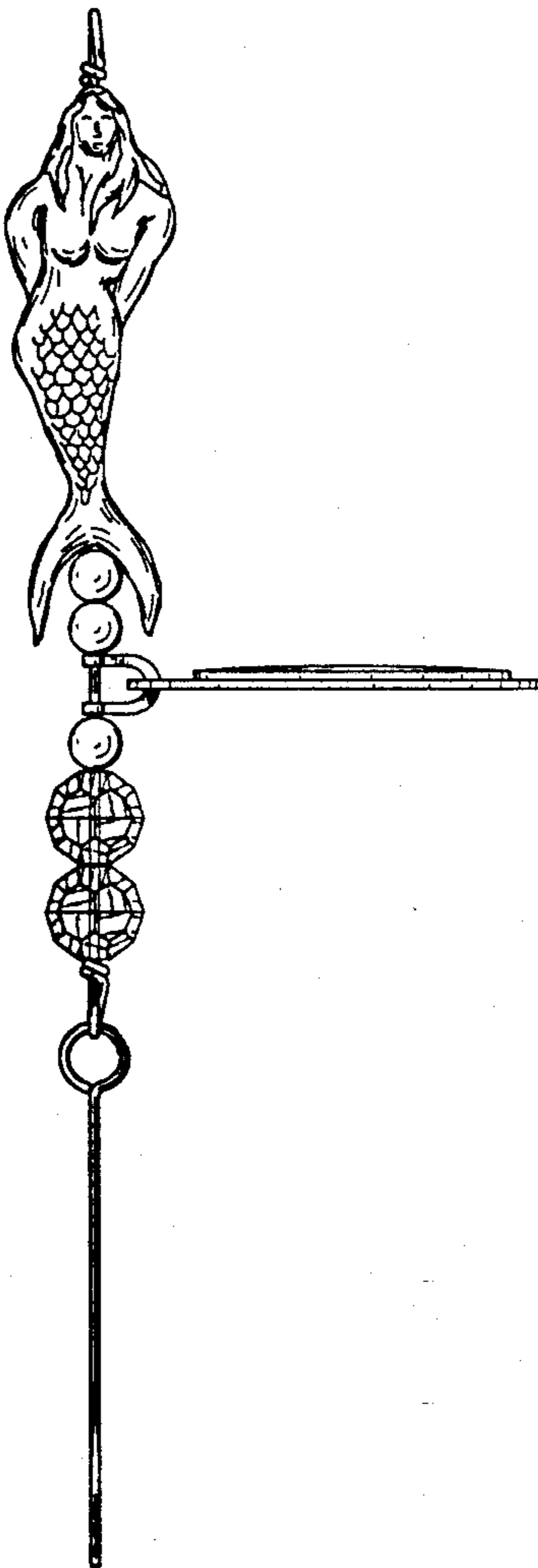

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a mermaid fishing lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a mermaid fishing lure, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a fragmentary perspective view of the spinner illustrating the concave lower side thereof.



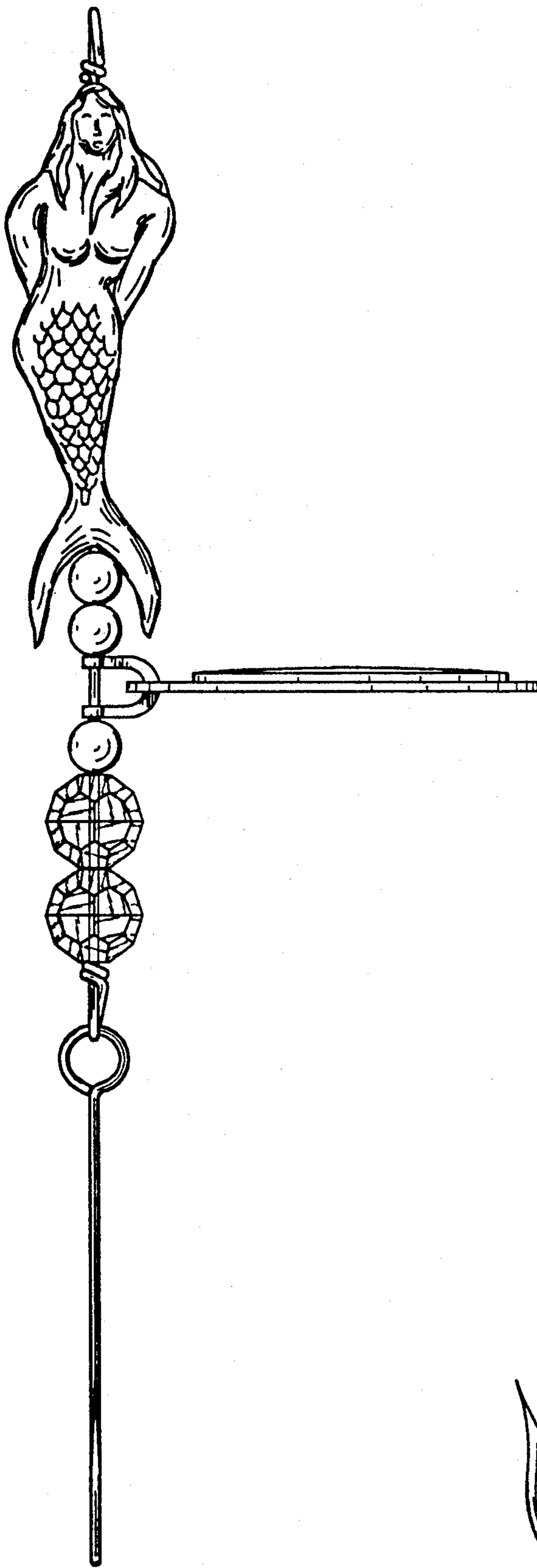

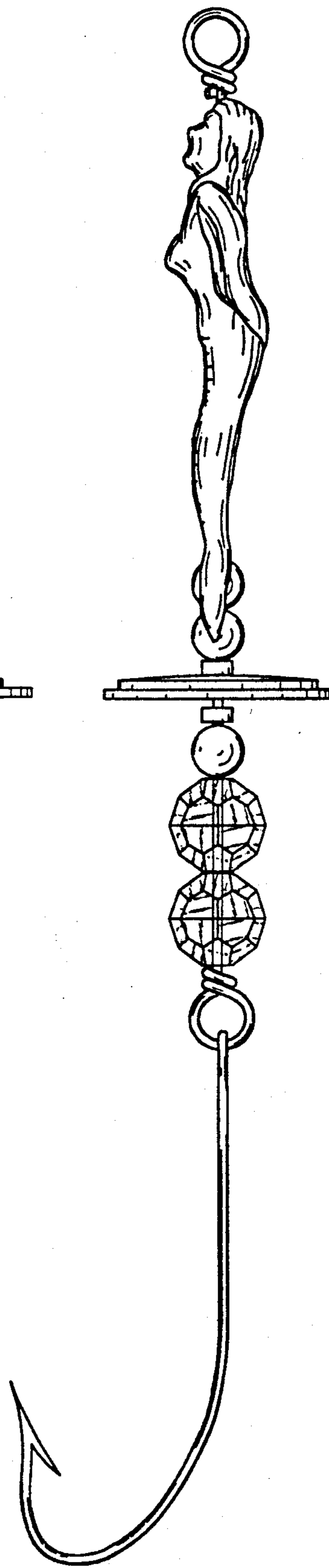

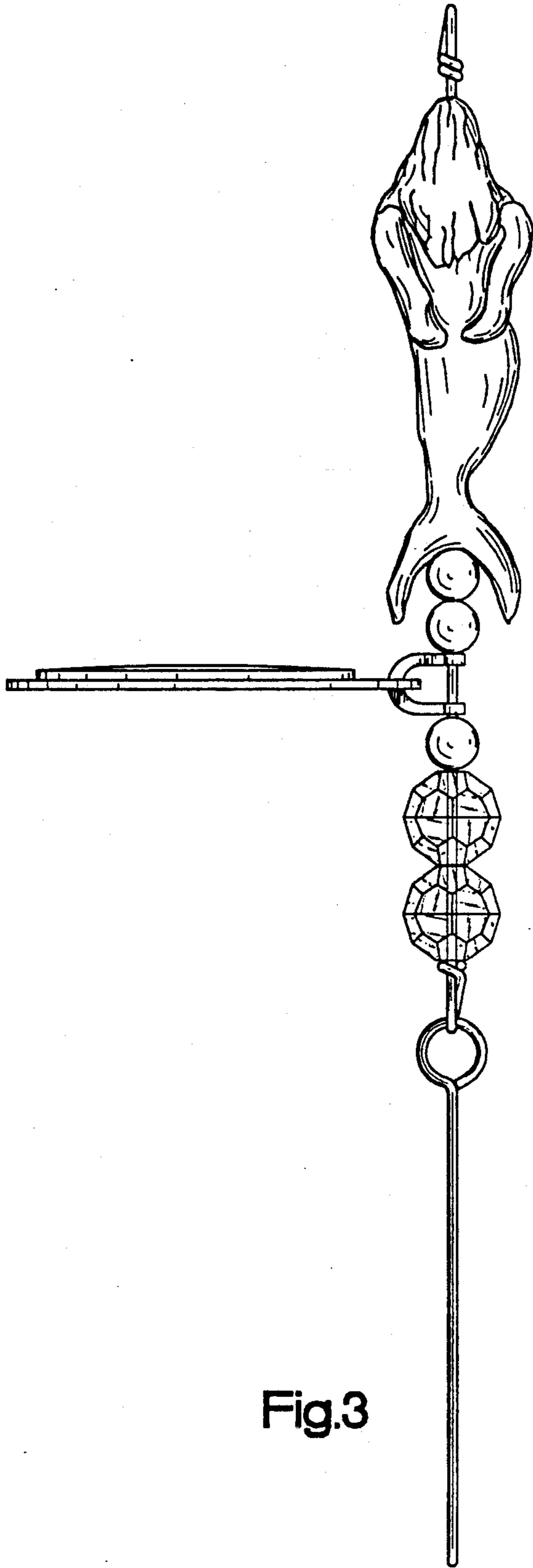

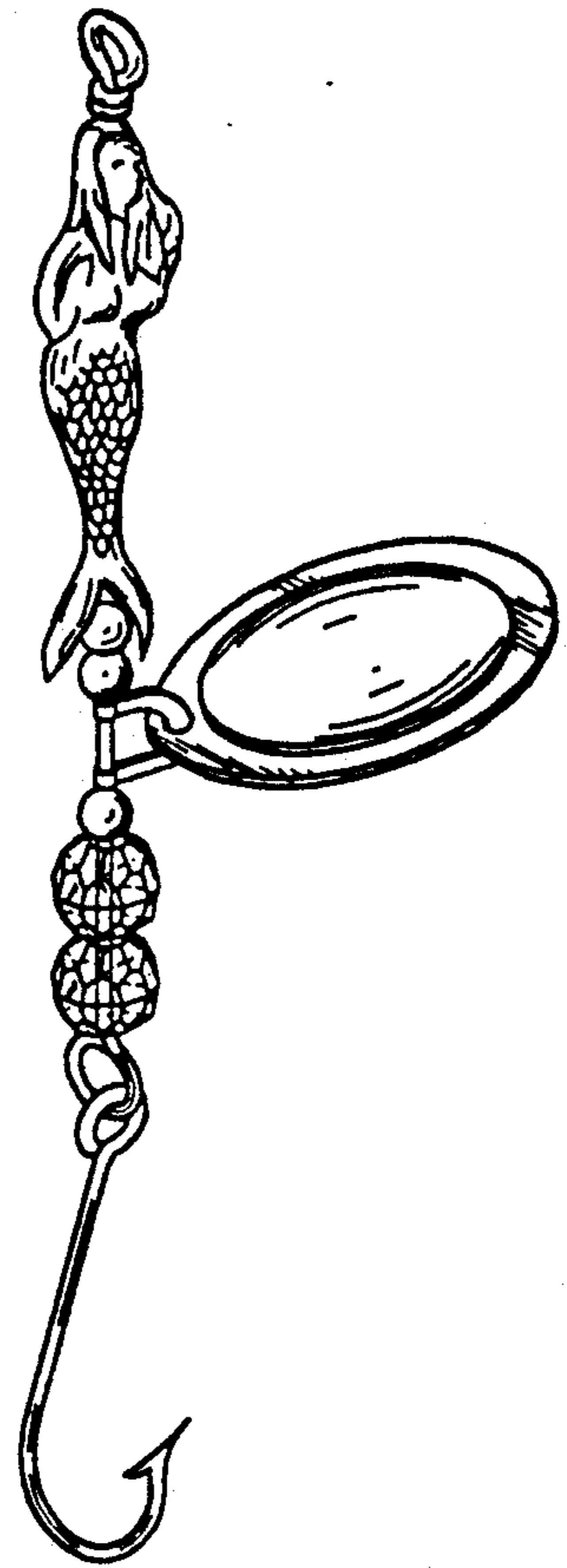

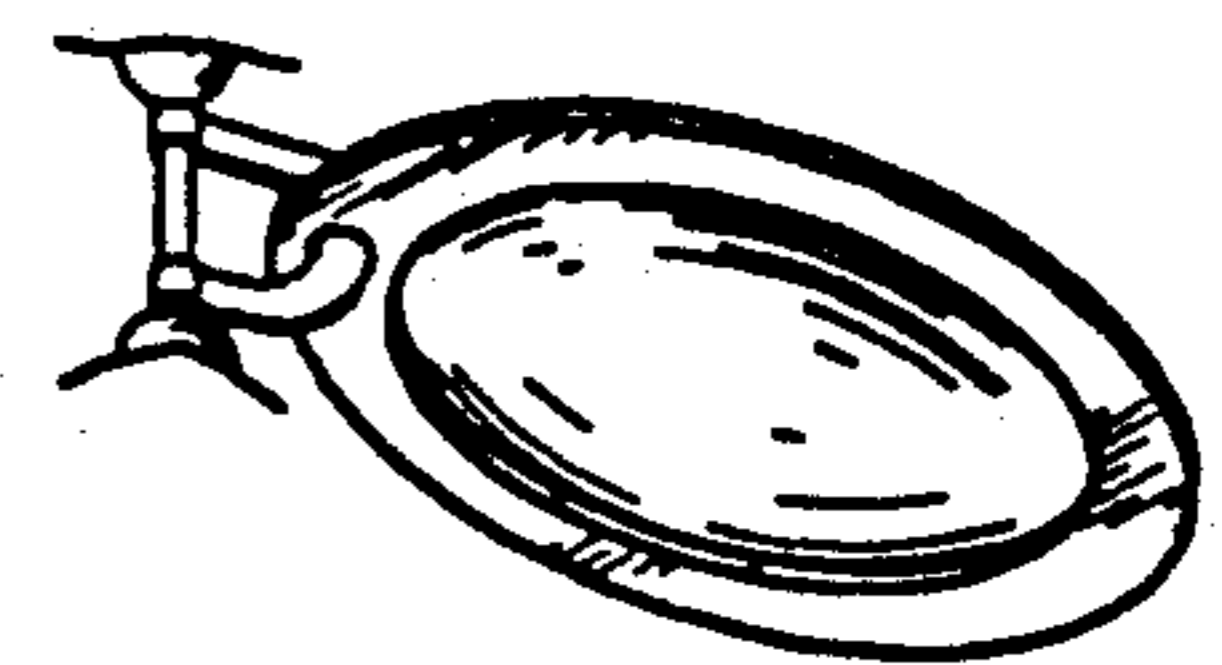
