**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective of an edible spoon showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation thereof.

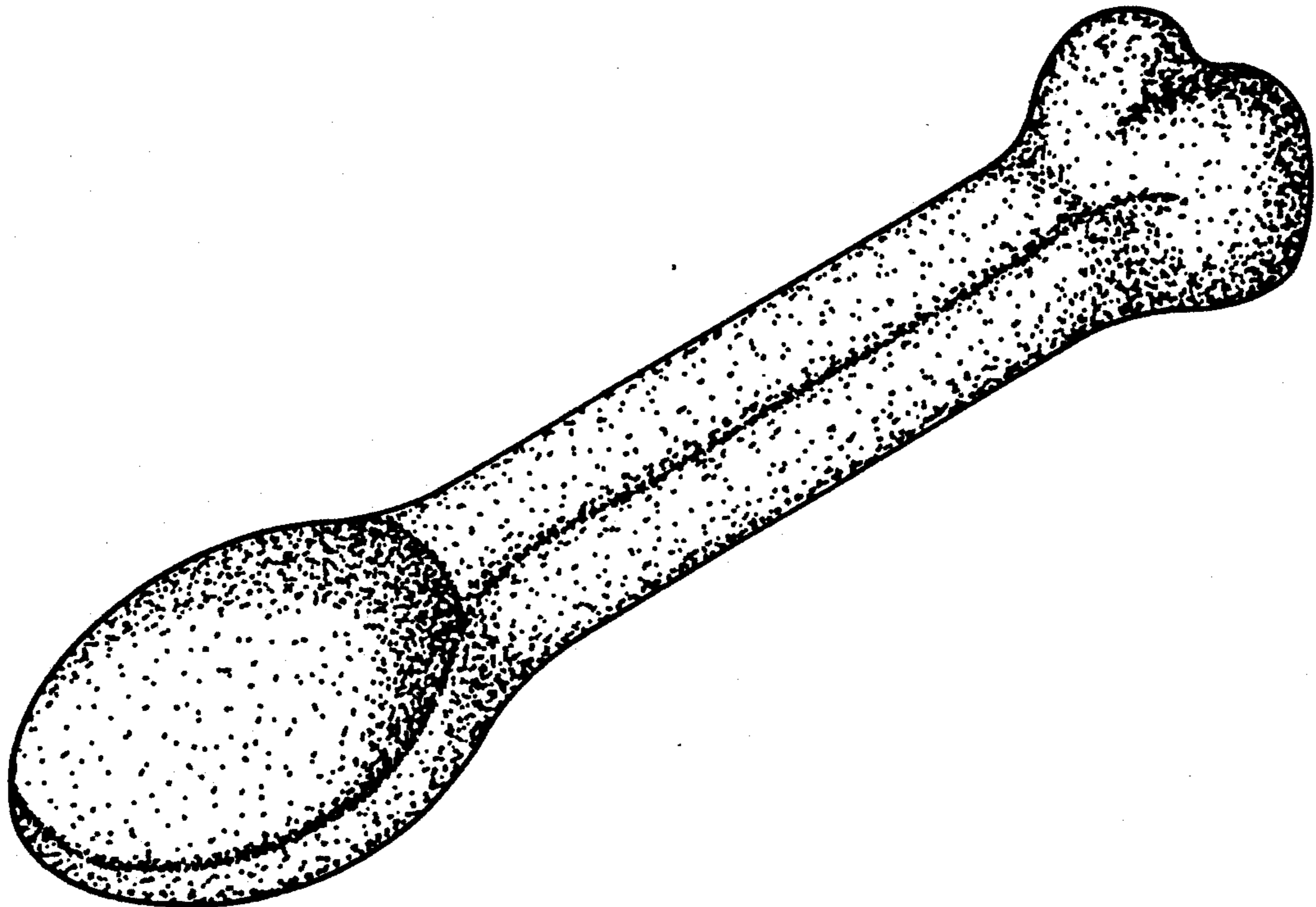

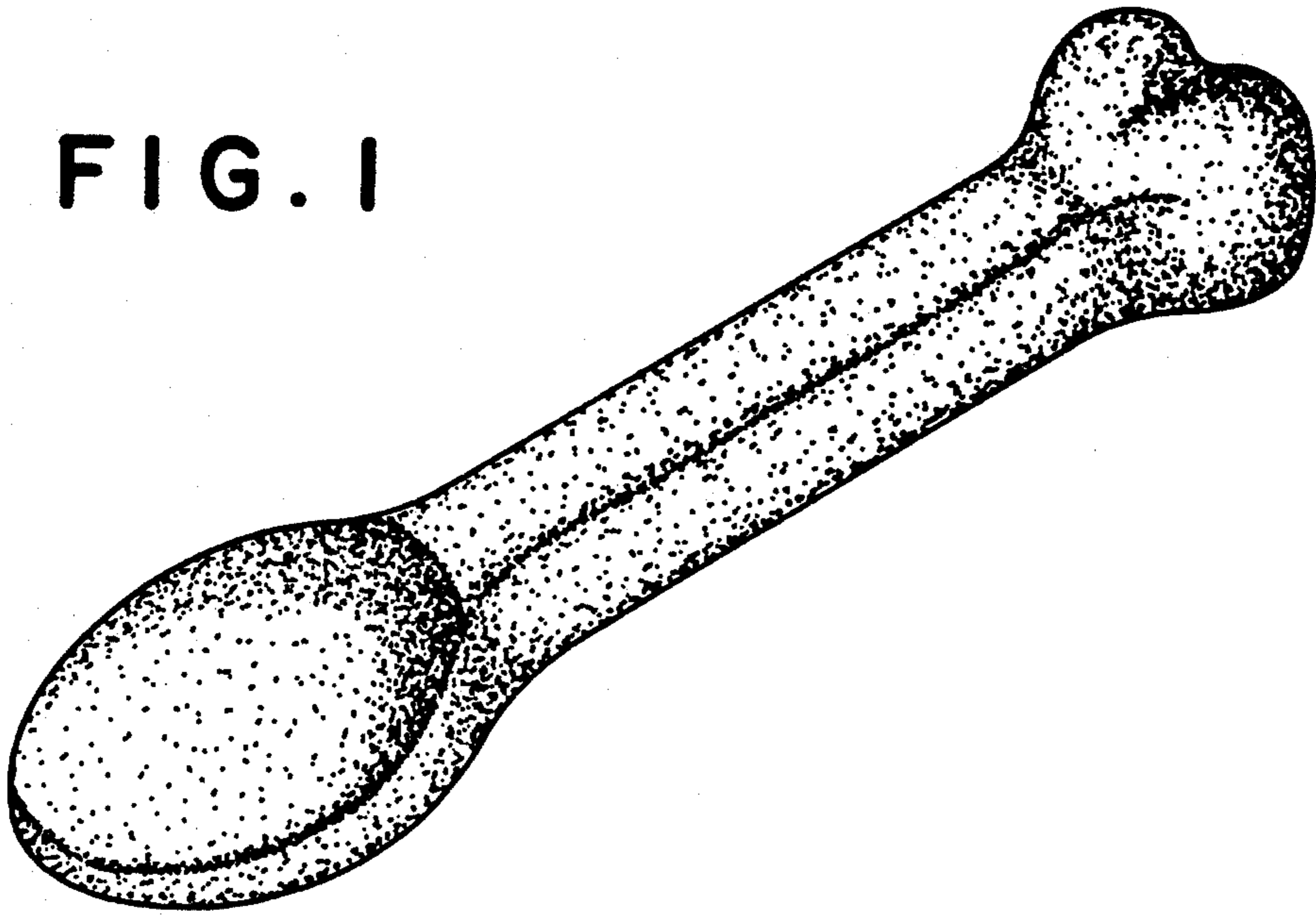

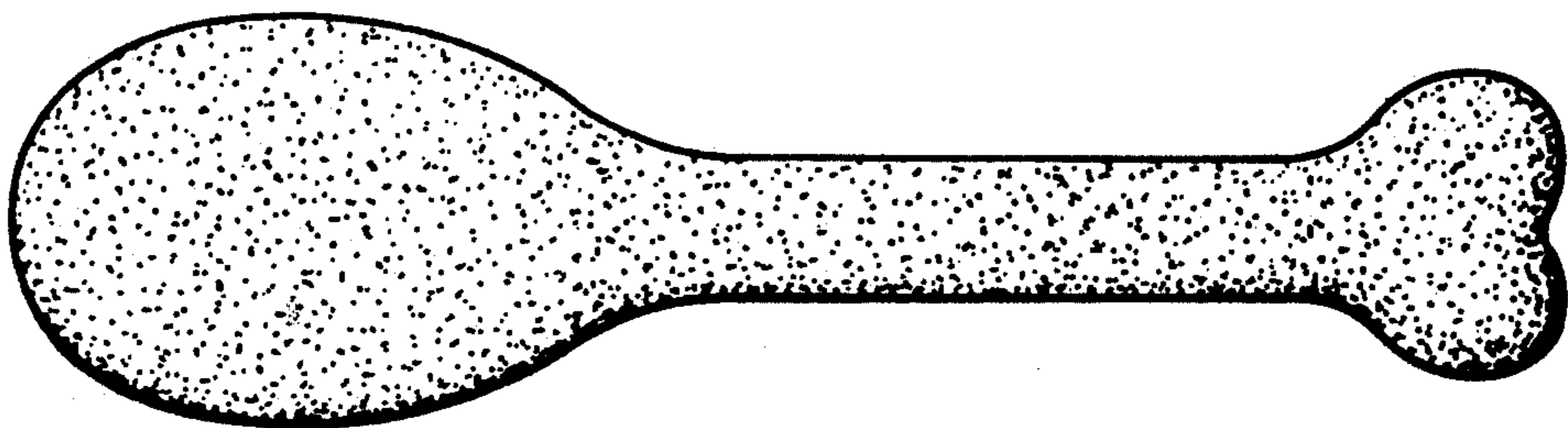

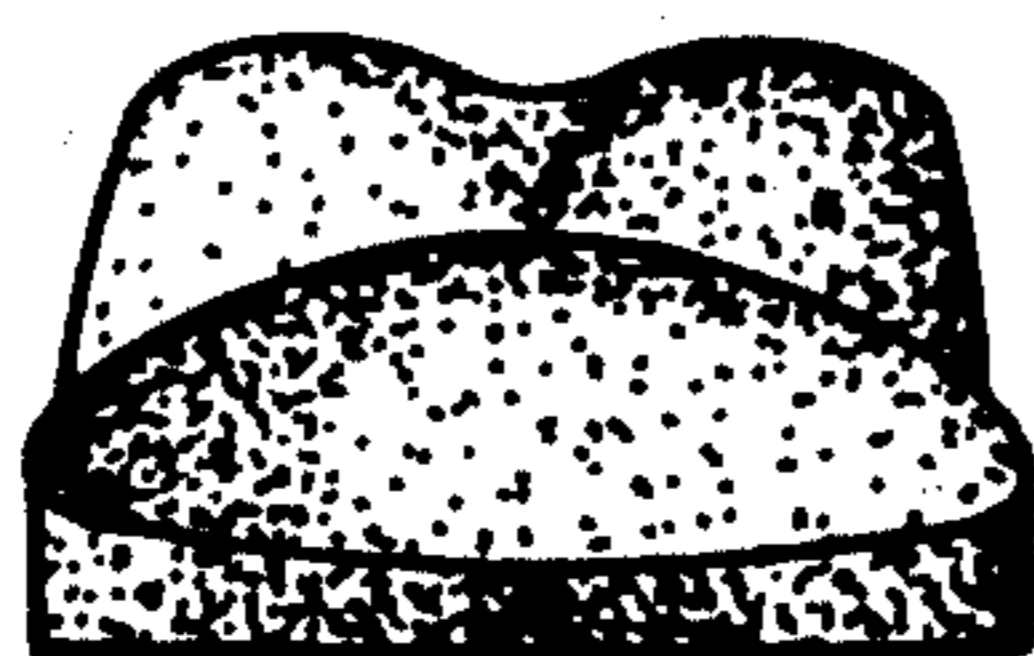
