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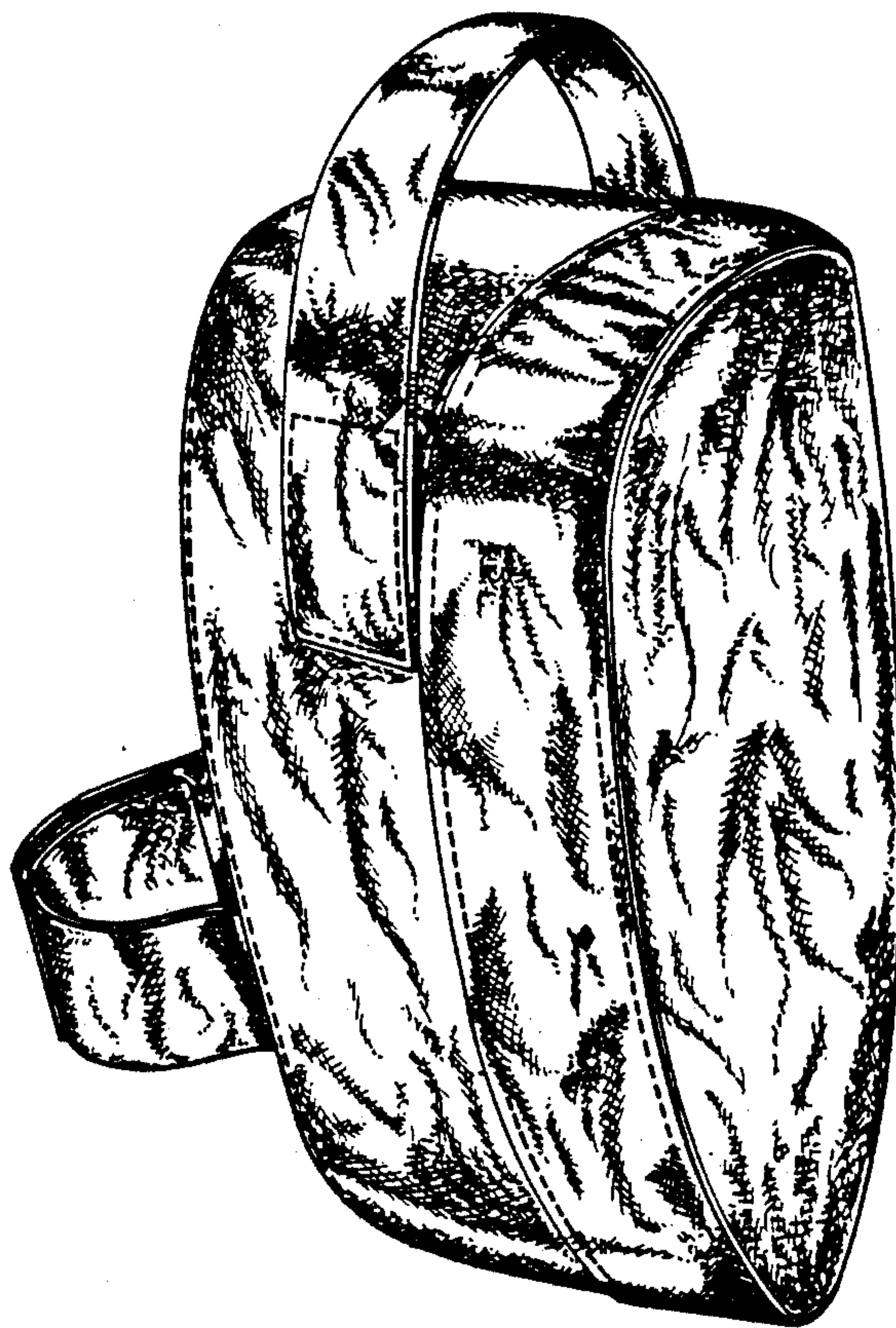
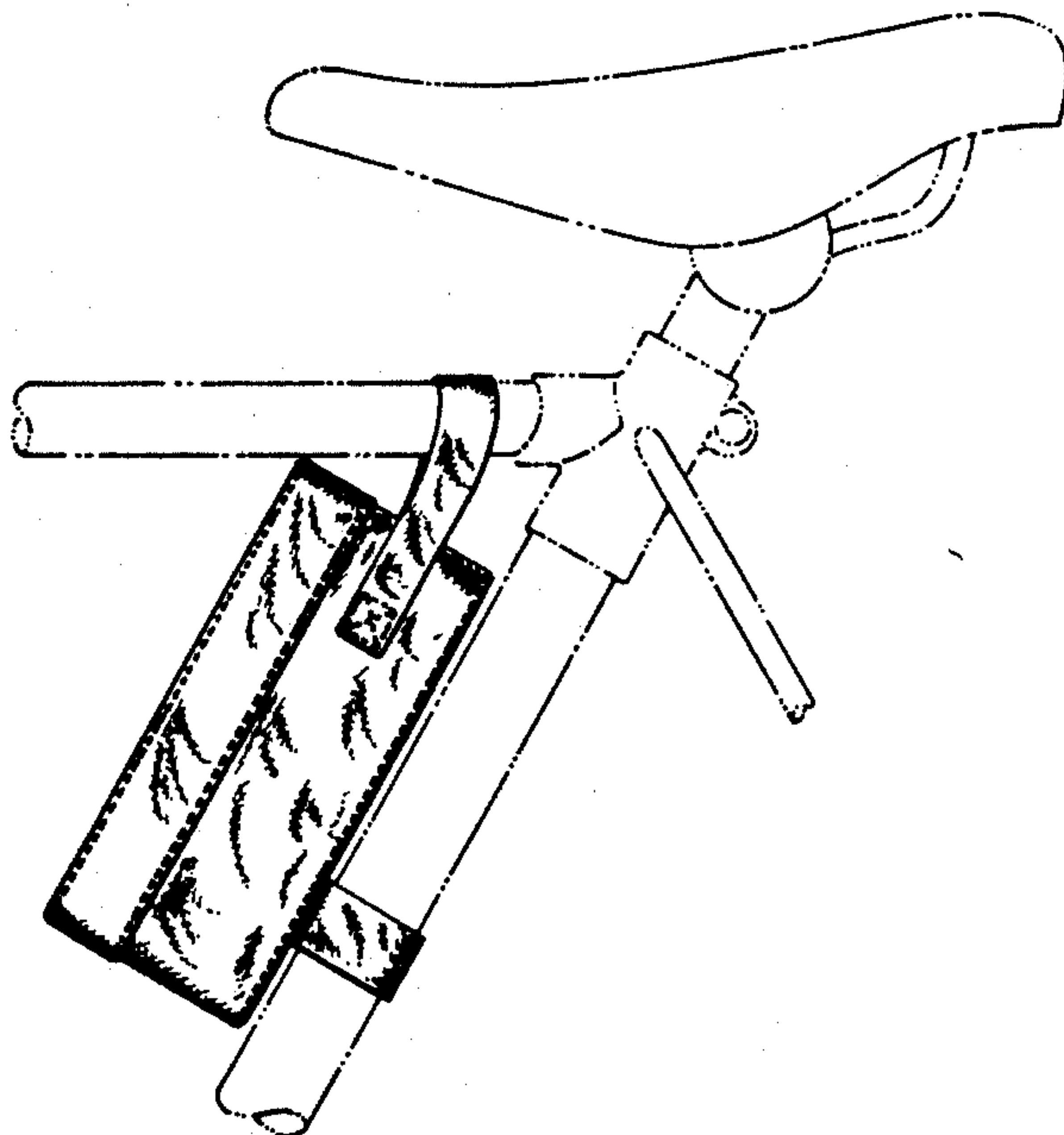

FIG. 7 is an enlarged perspective view showing the top, front and left side thereof.



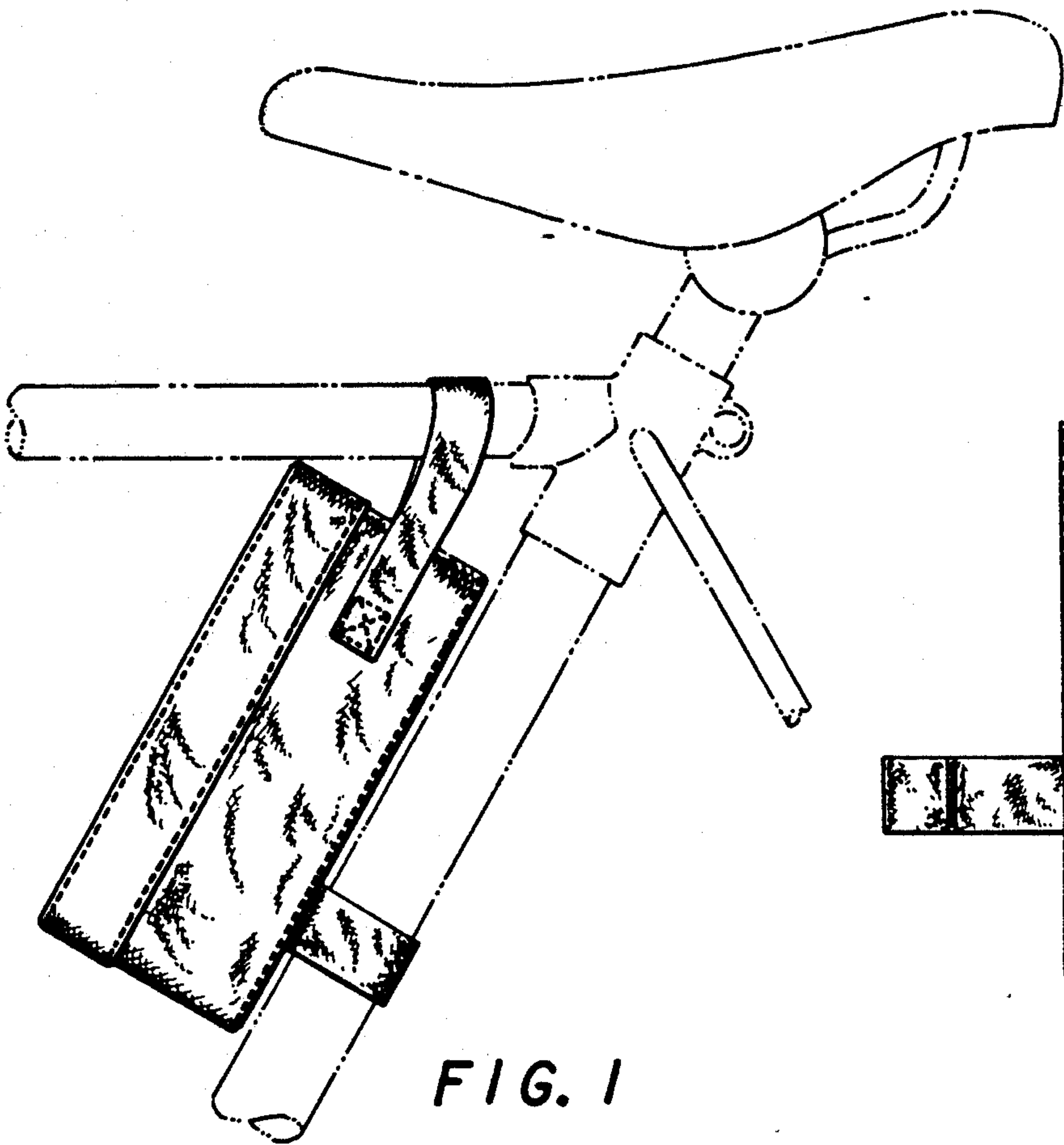

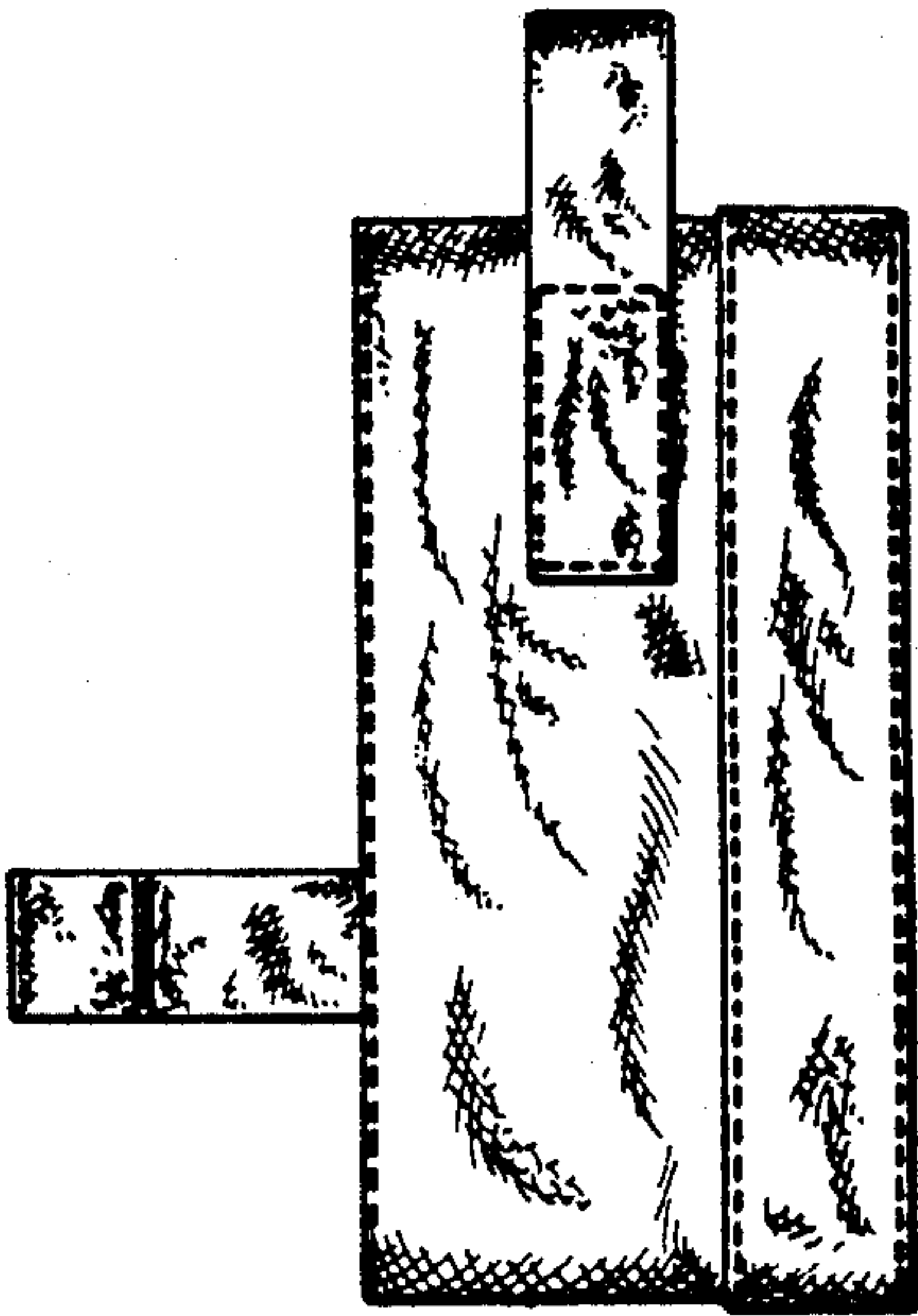

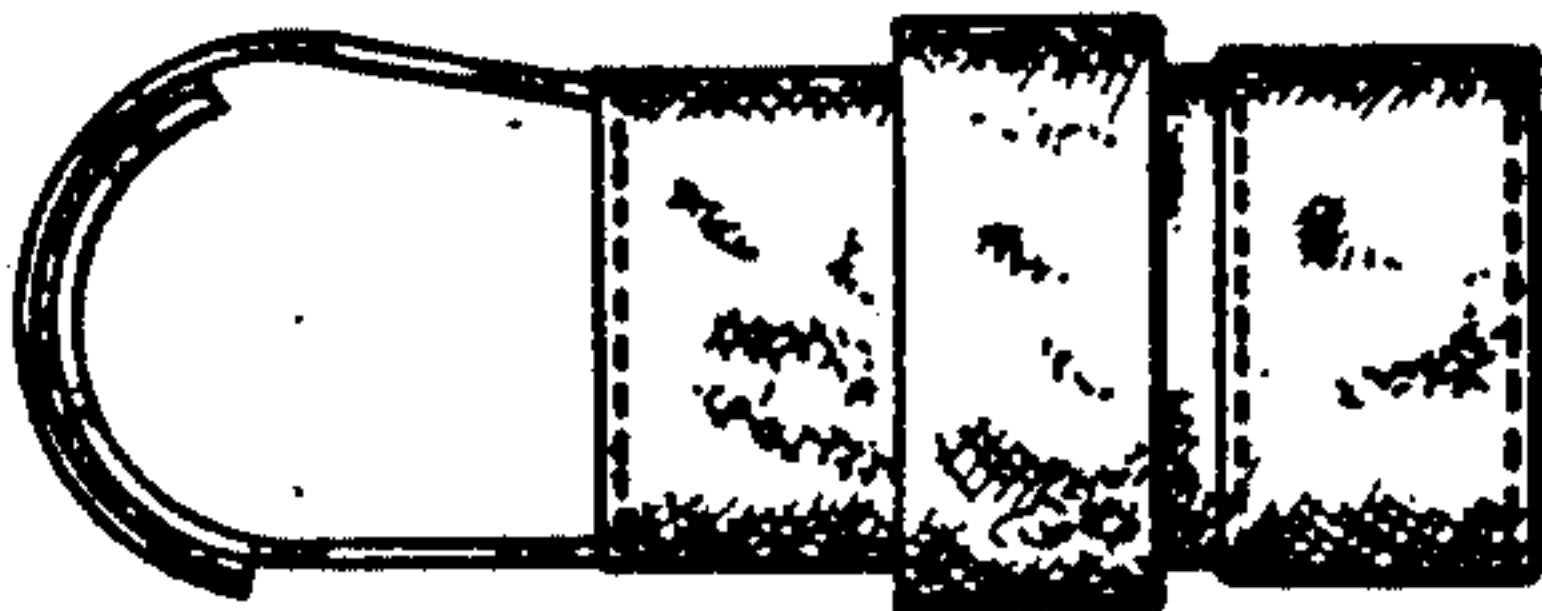

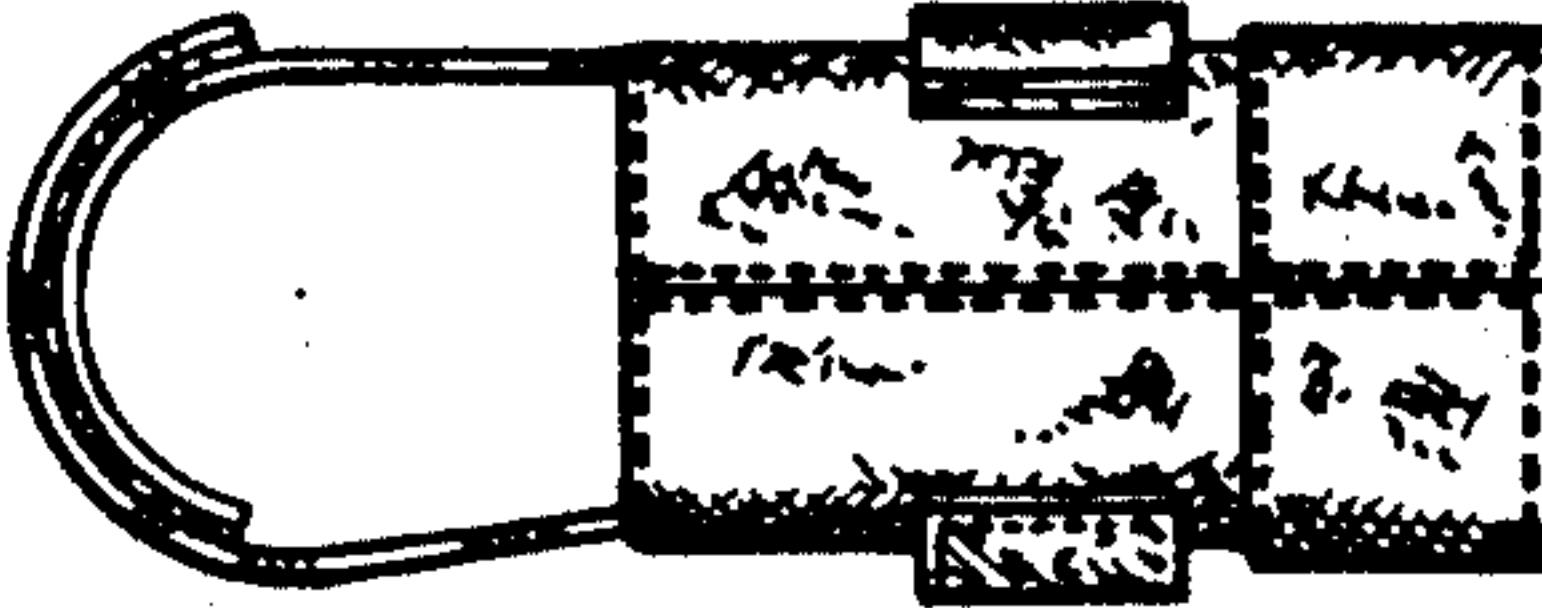

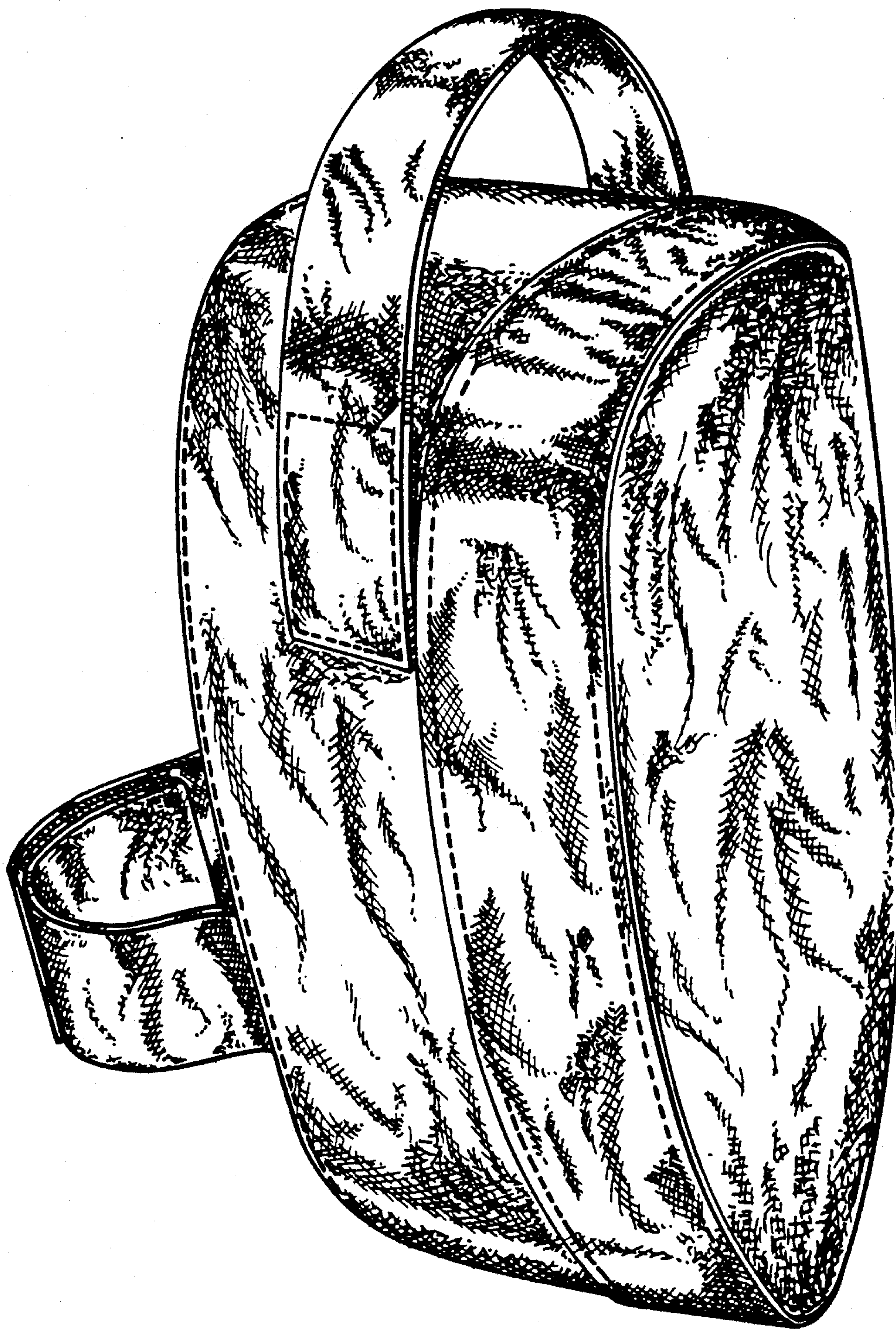
