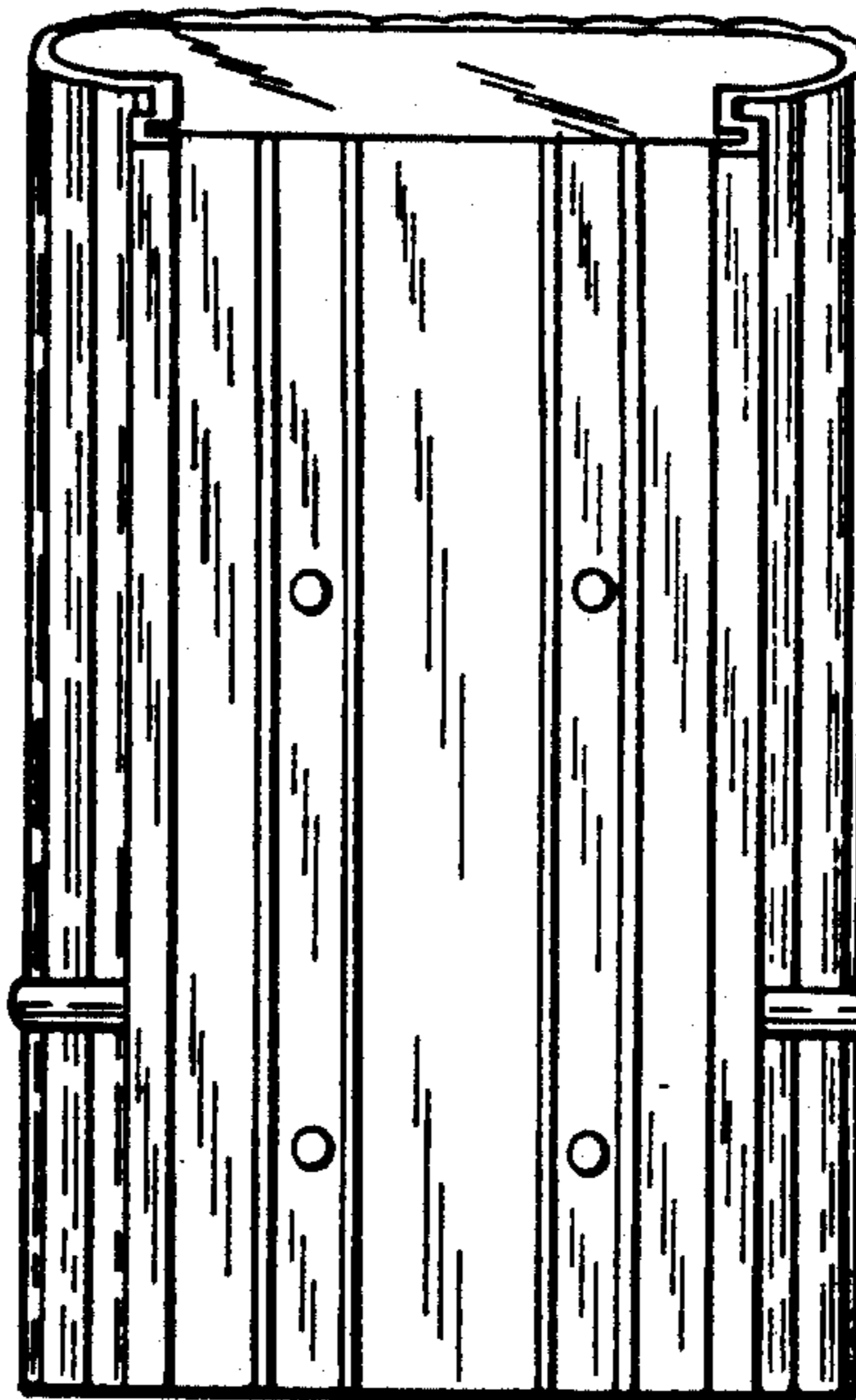
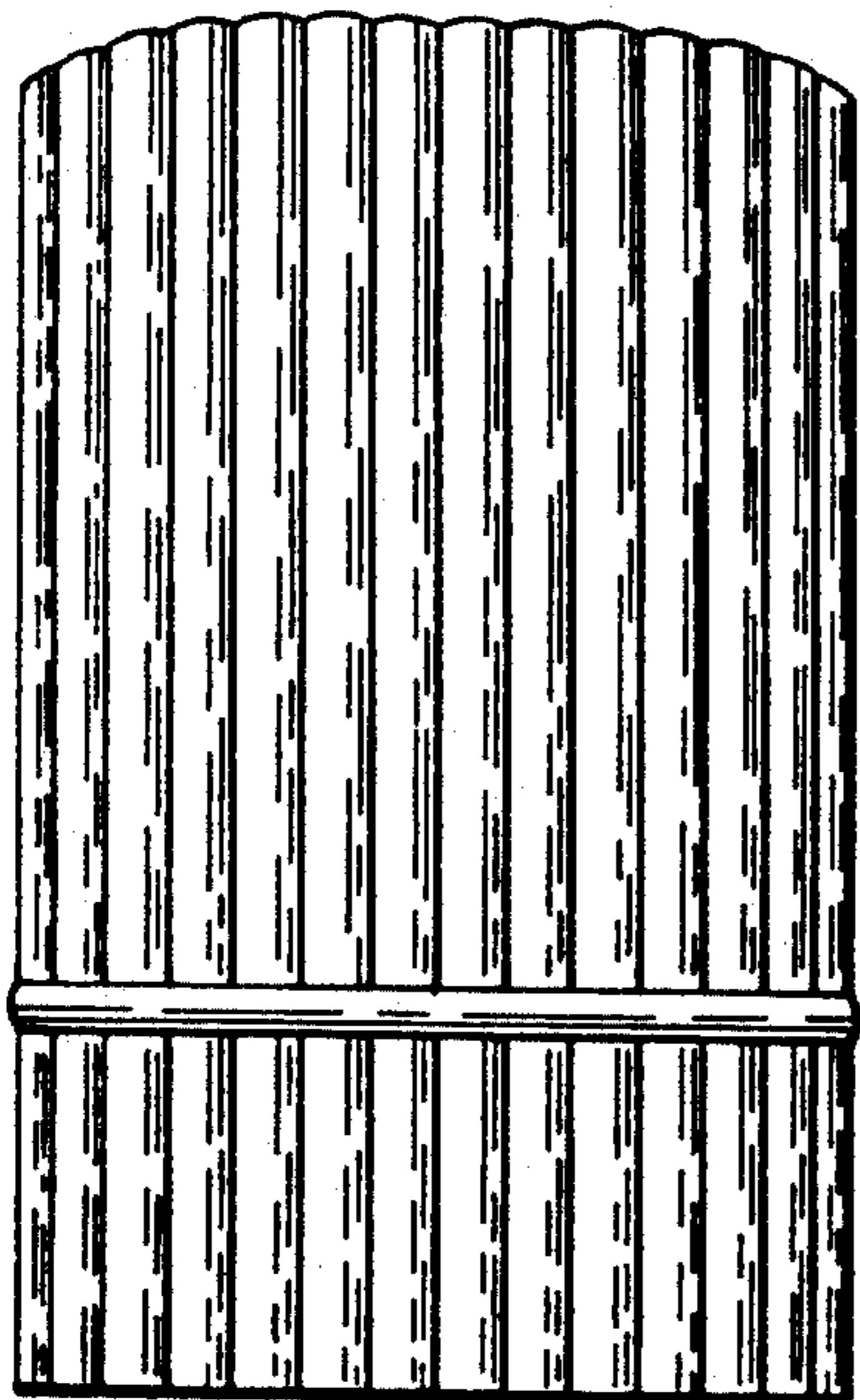
FIG. 4 is a top plan view on an enlarged scale of the

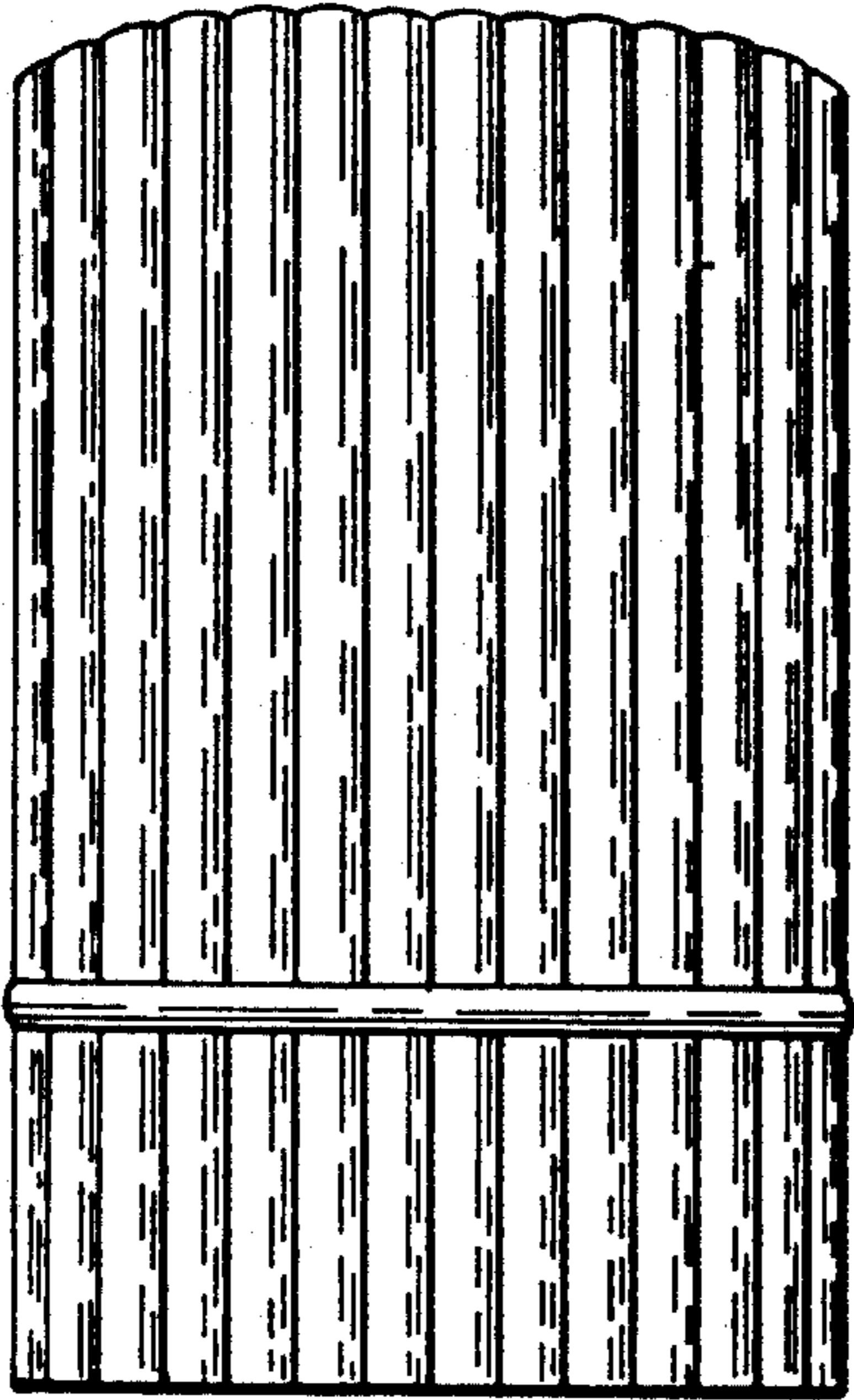

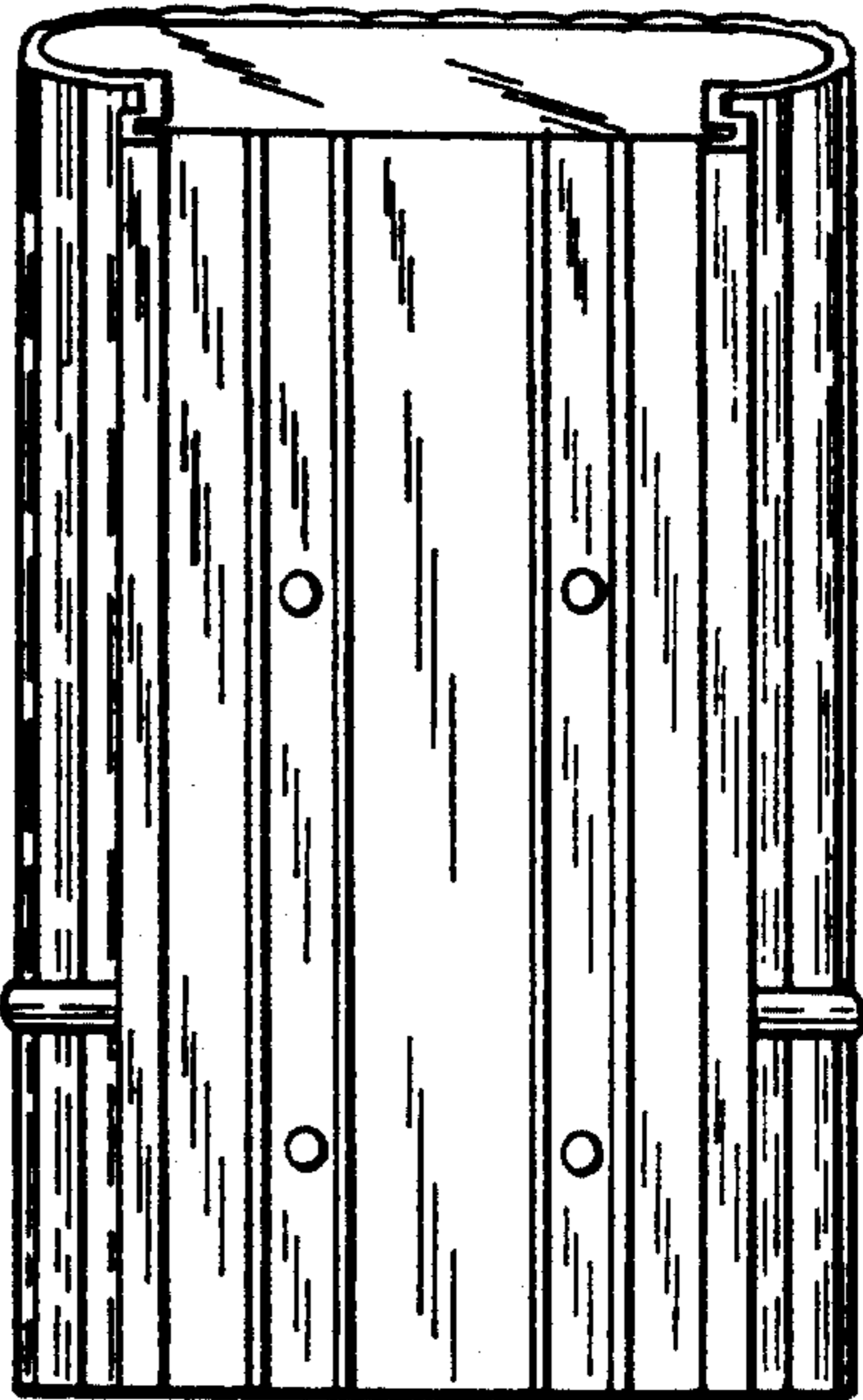

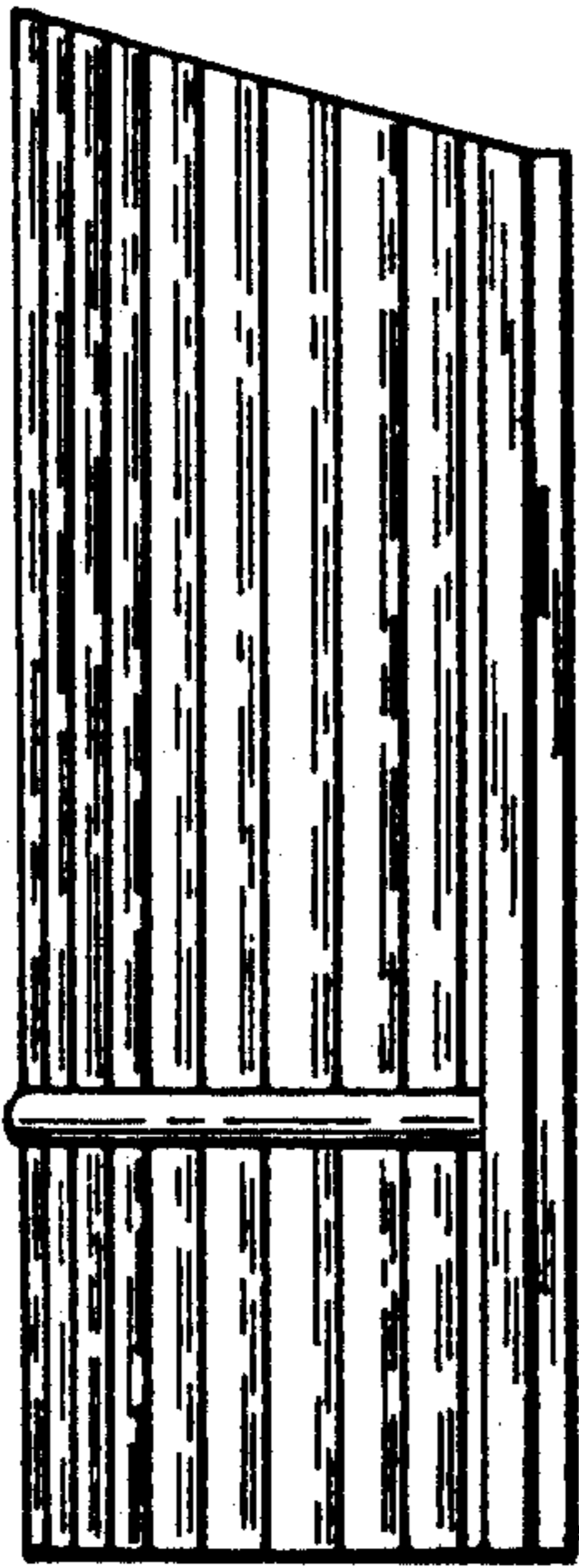

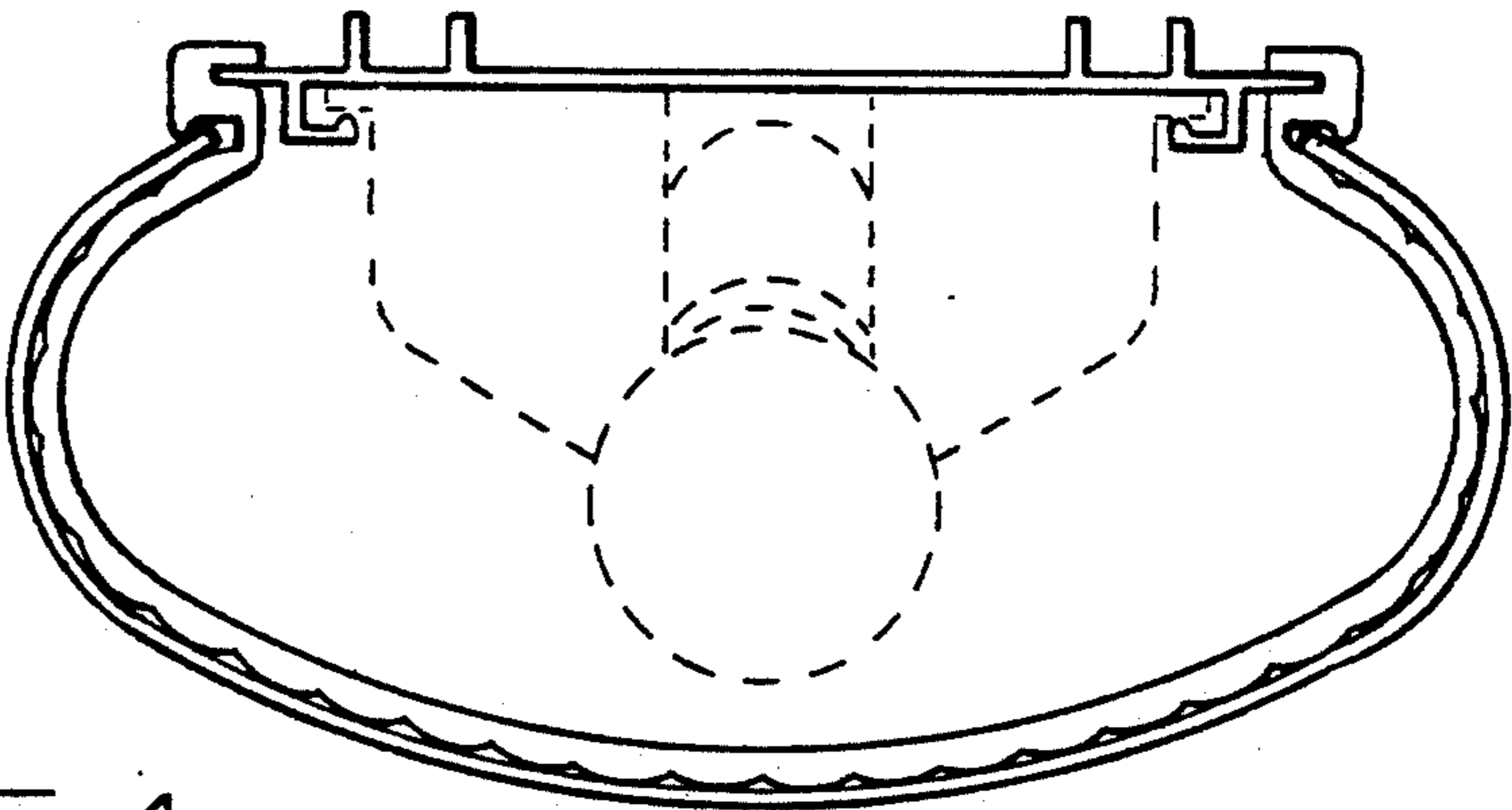

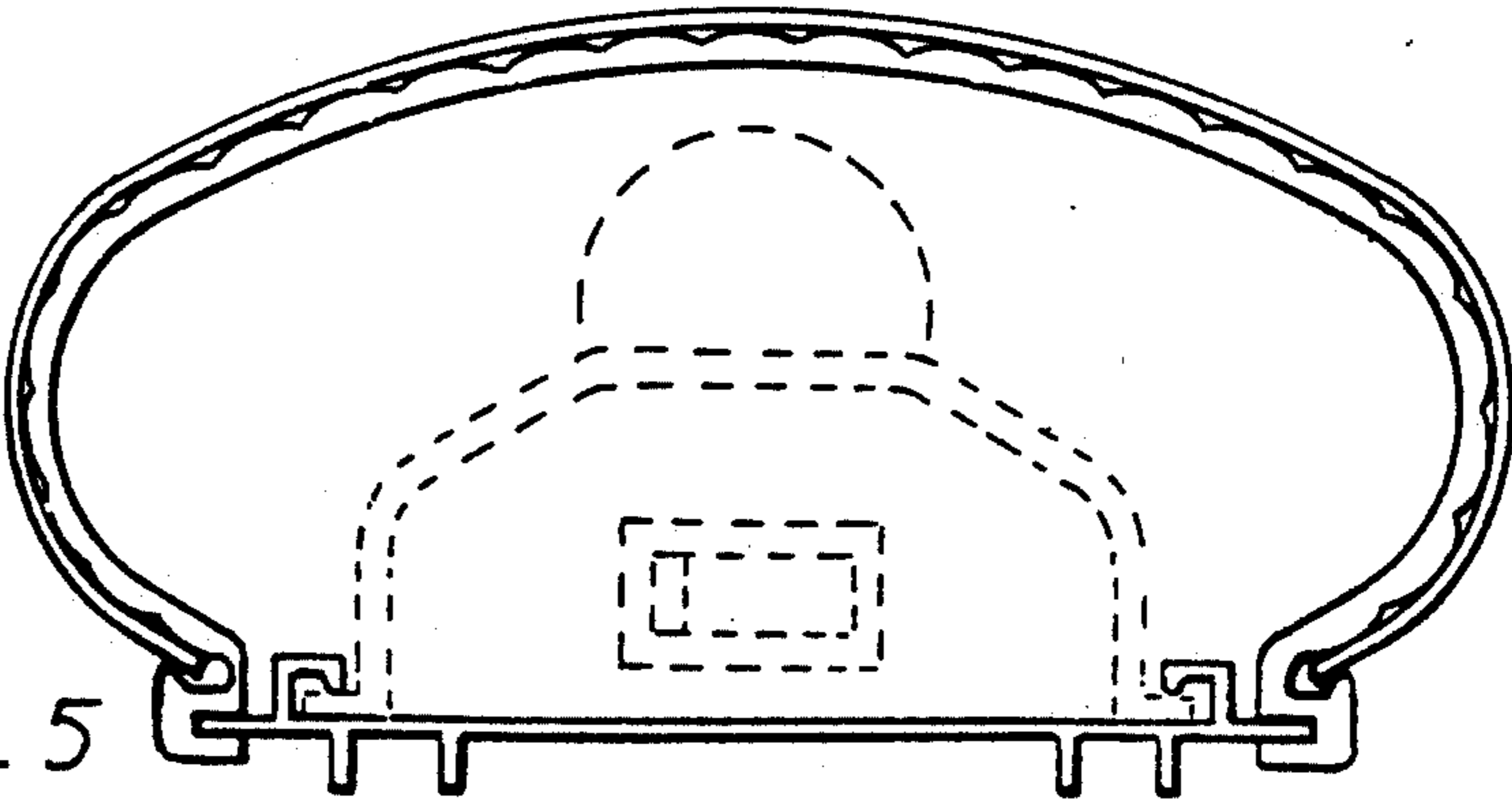
