FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of a shoe upper showing my new design;

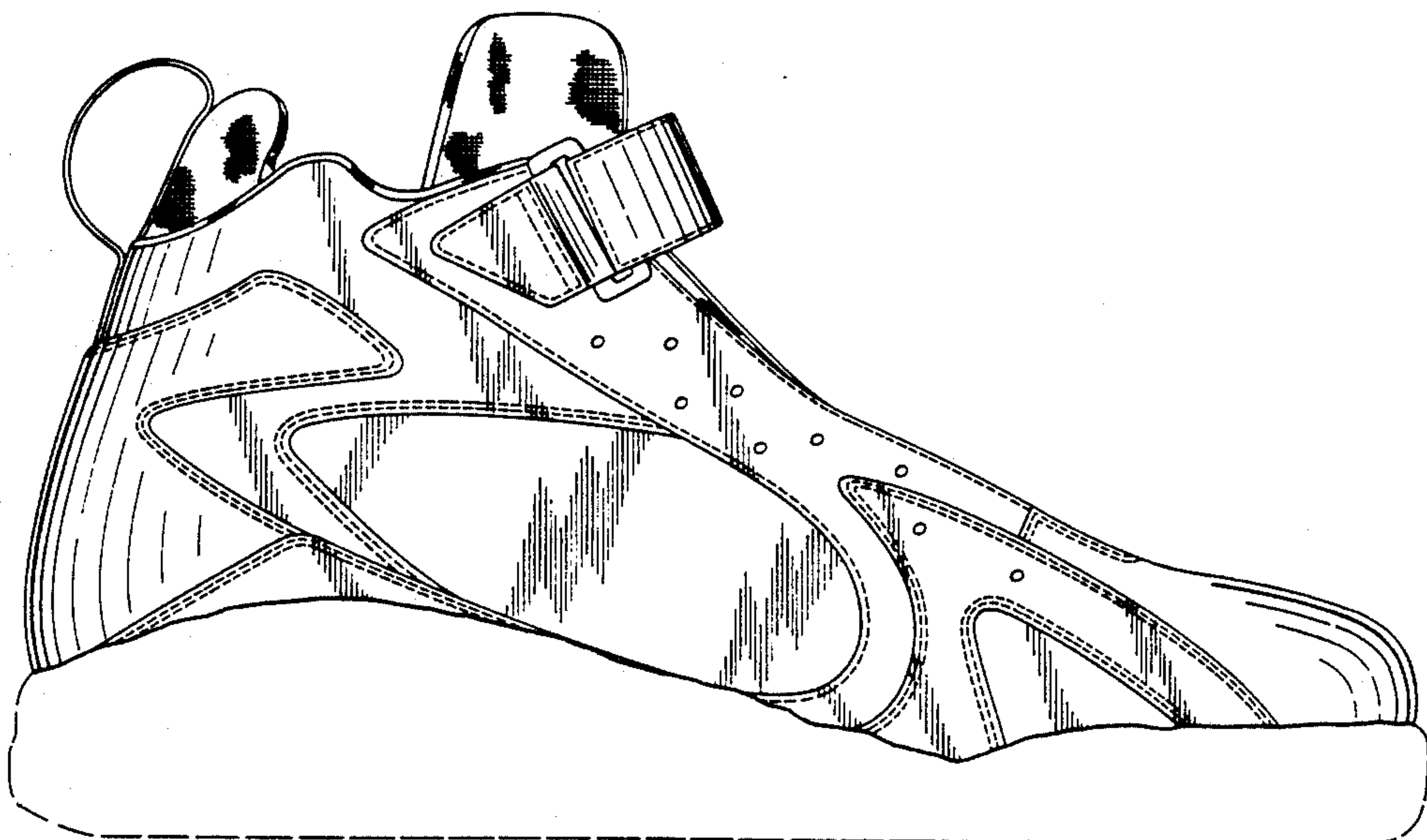
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;

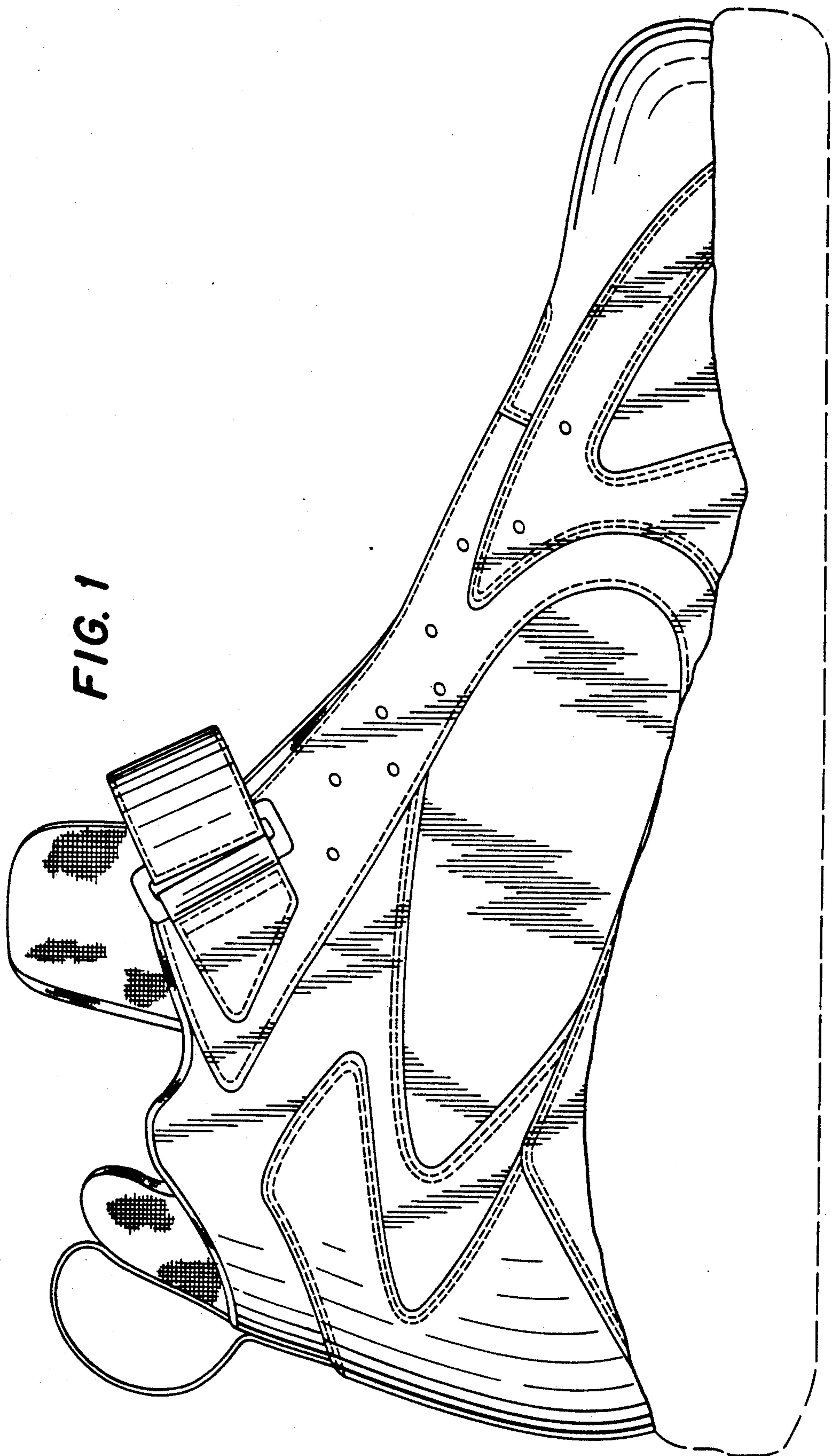

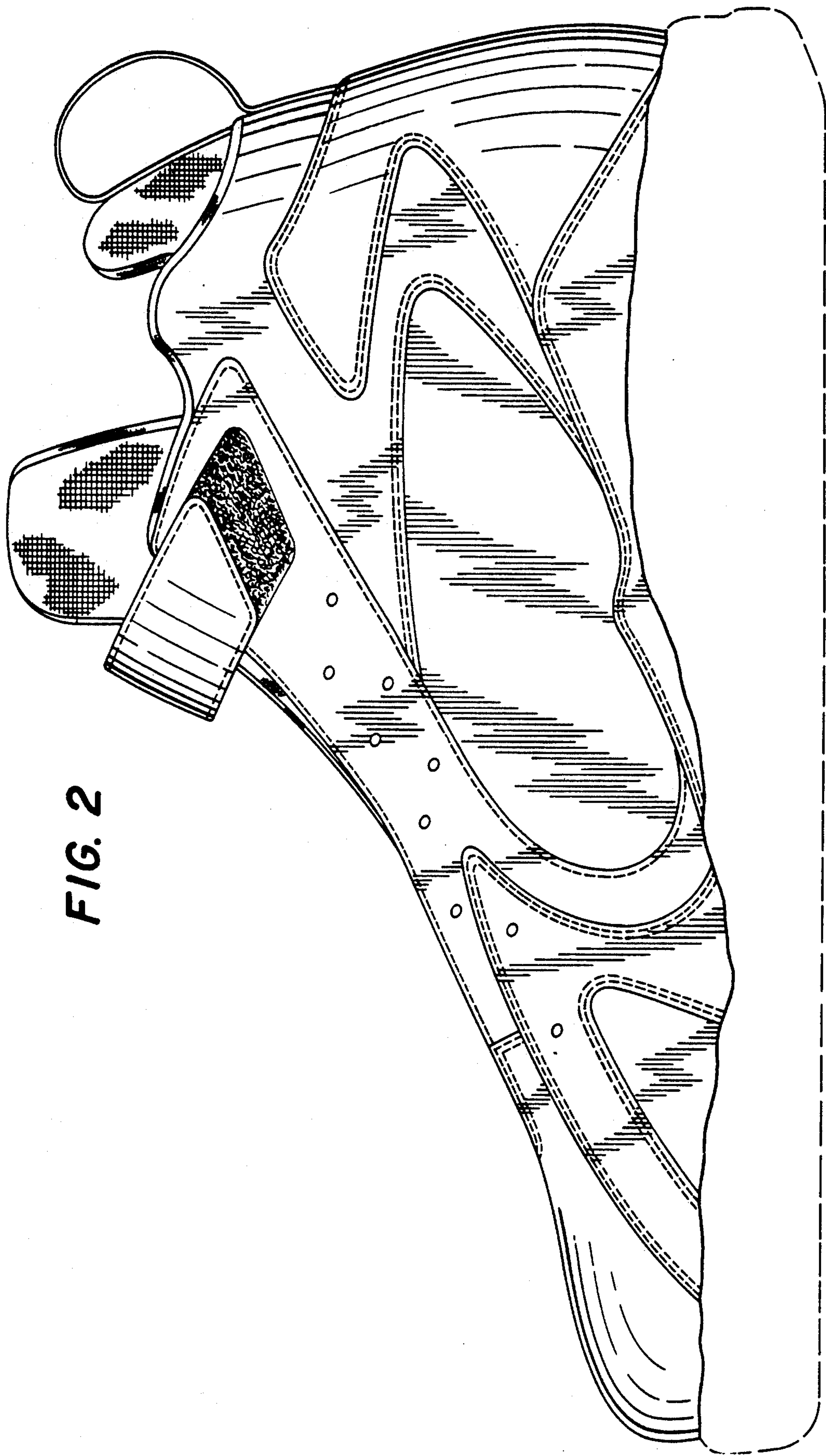

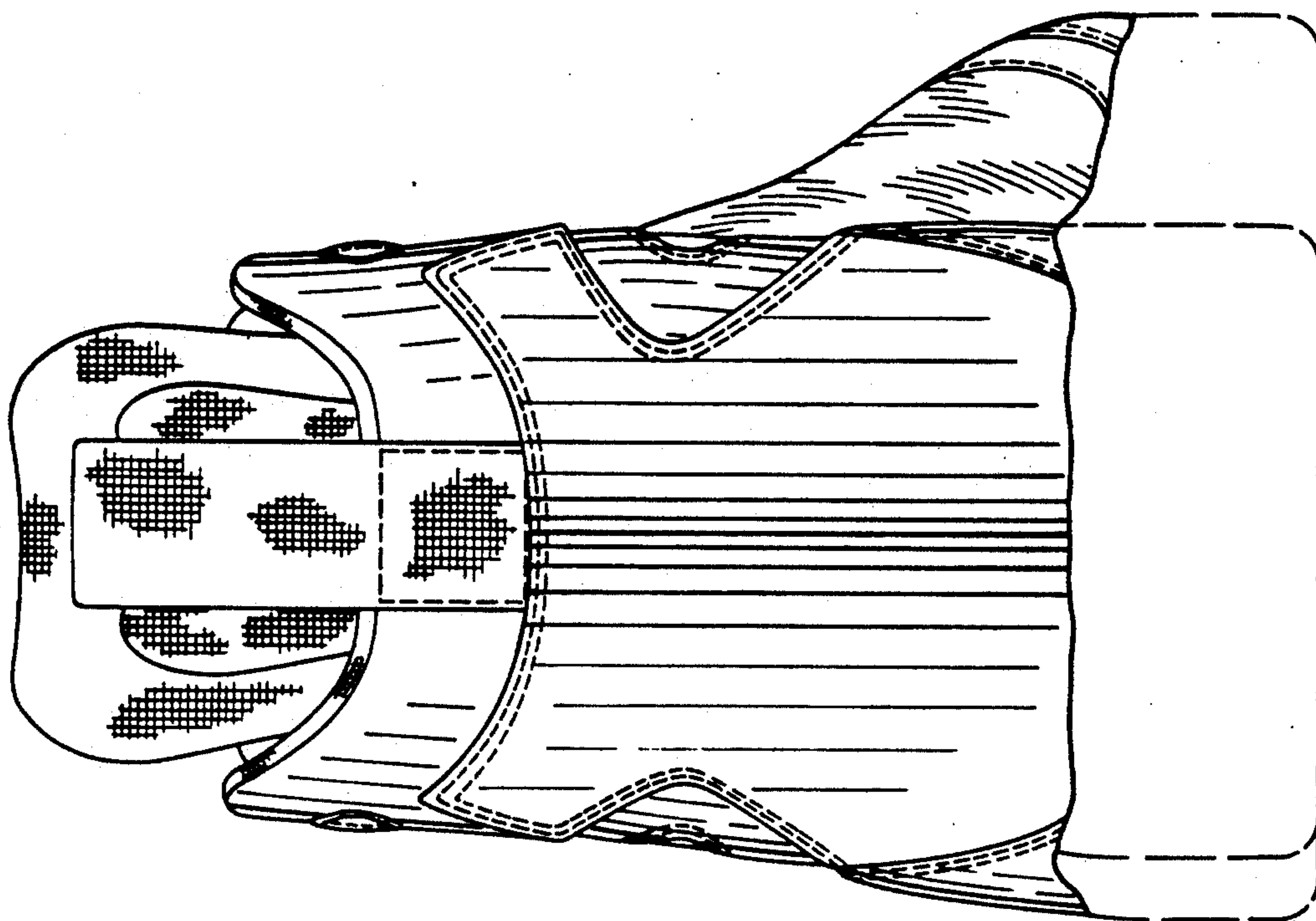

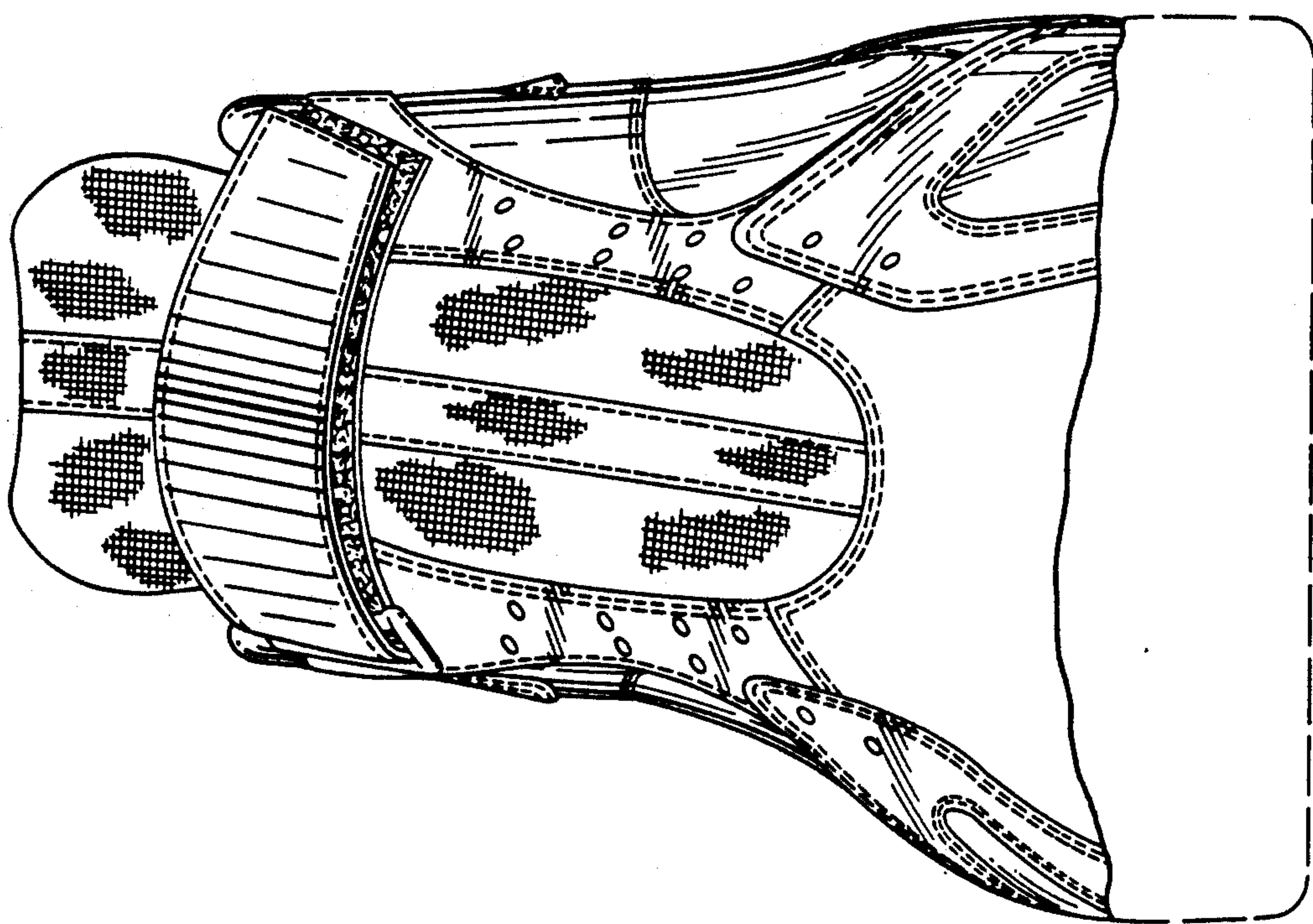
