DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a prospective view of the simulative musical instrument support;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

The broken line showing of a guitar and leg supports is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

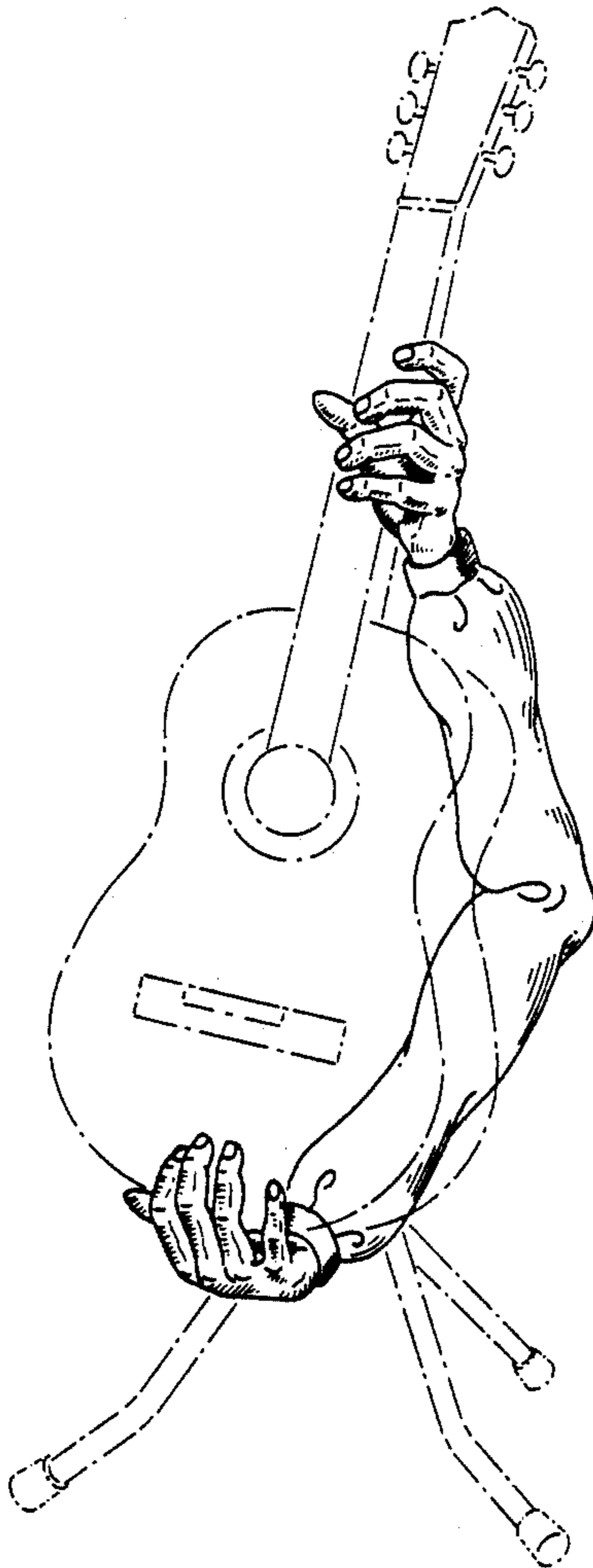

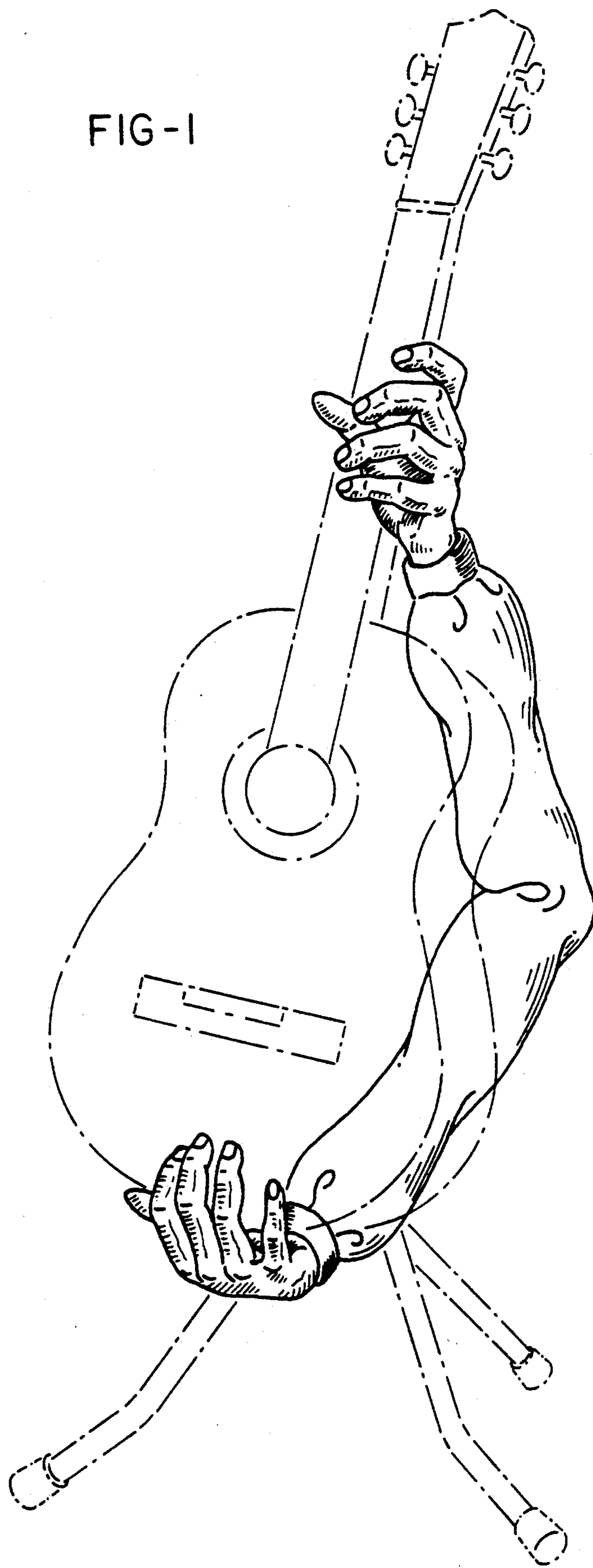

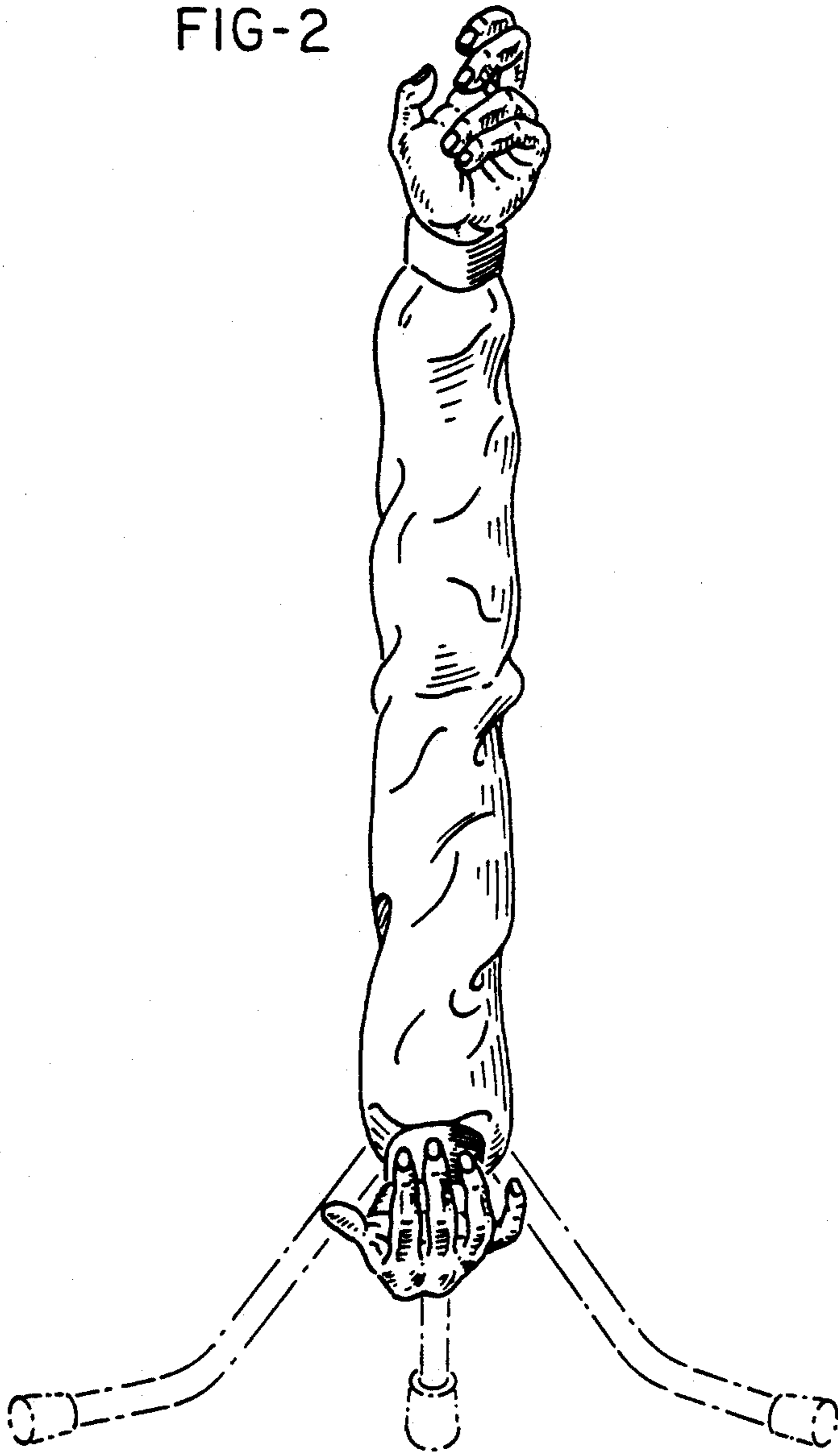

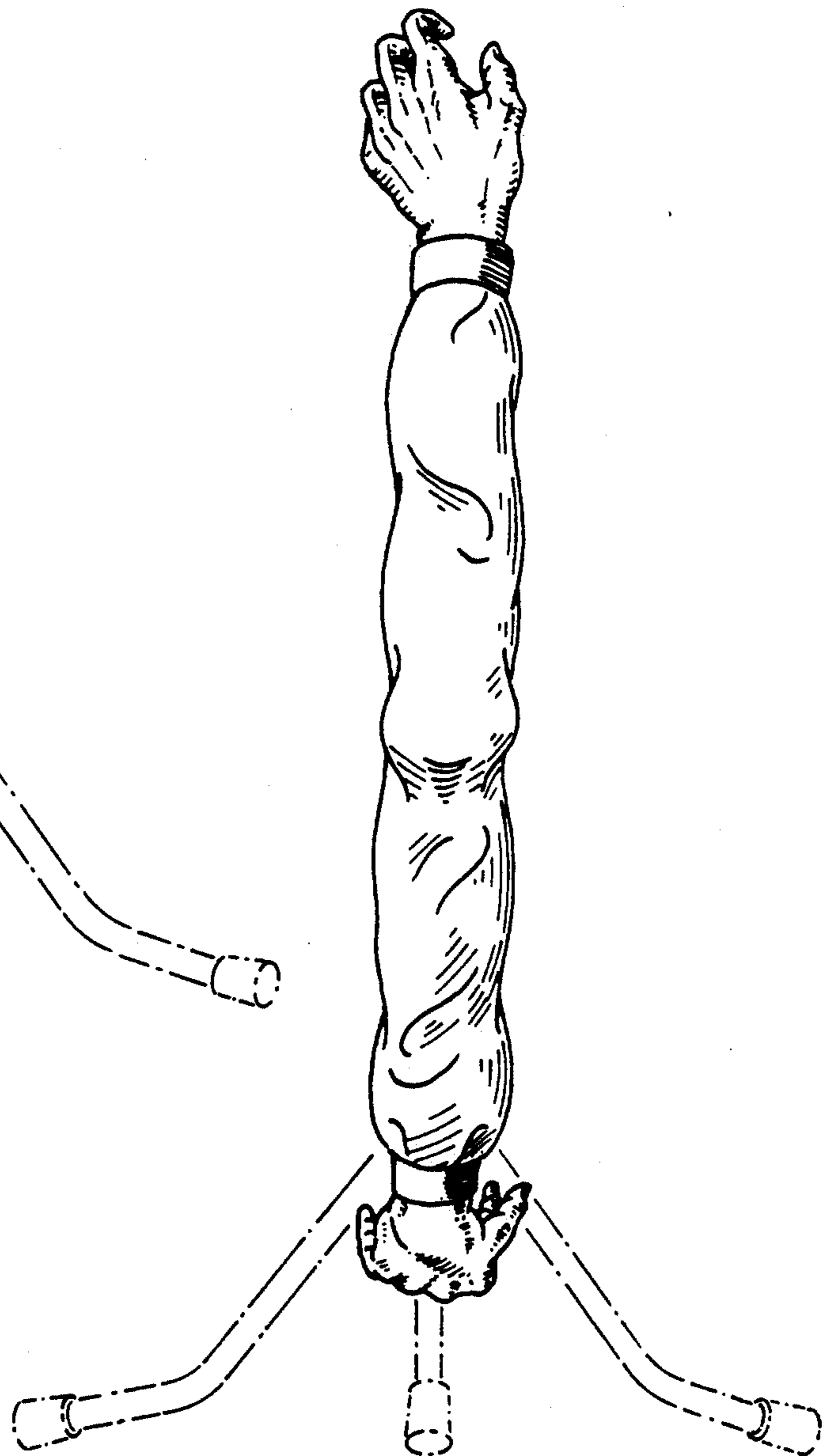

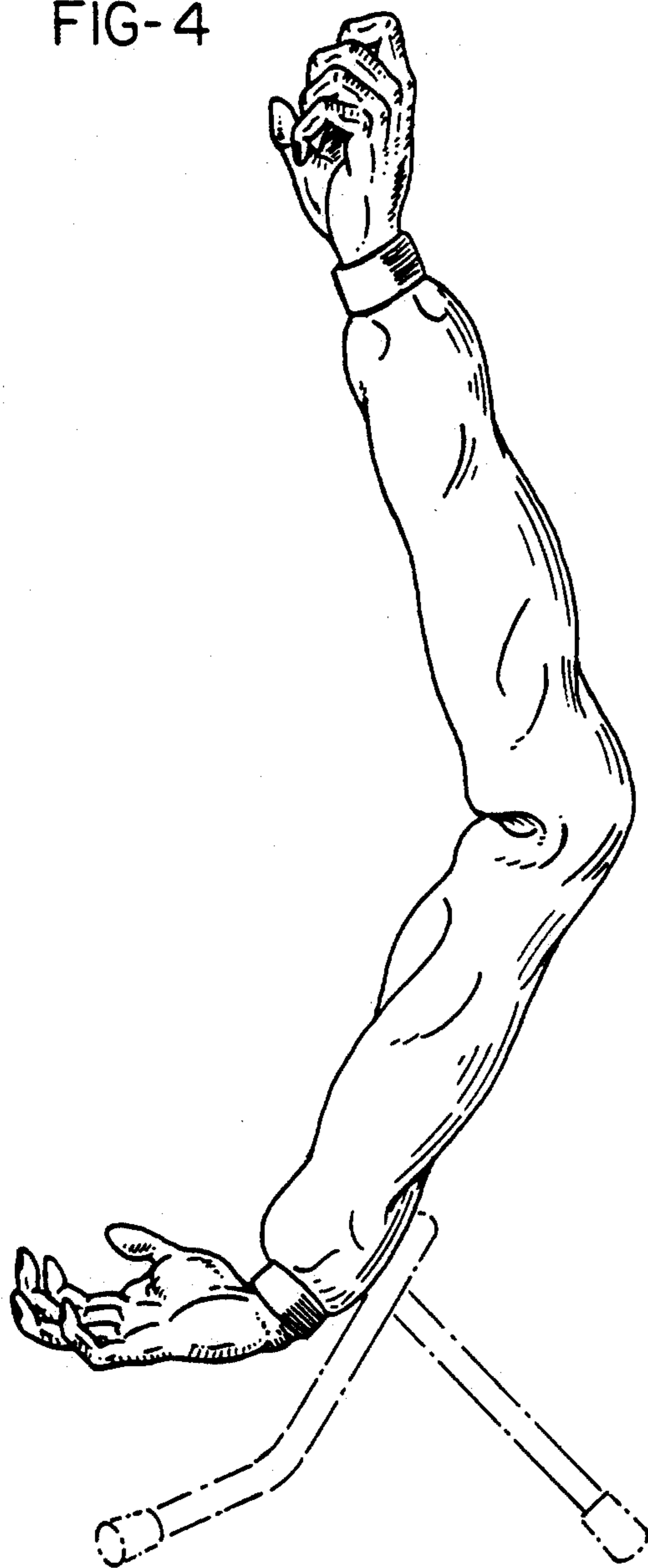

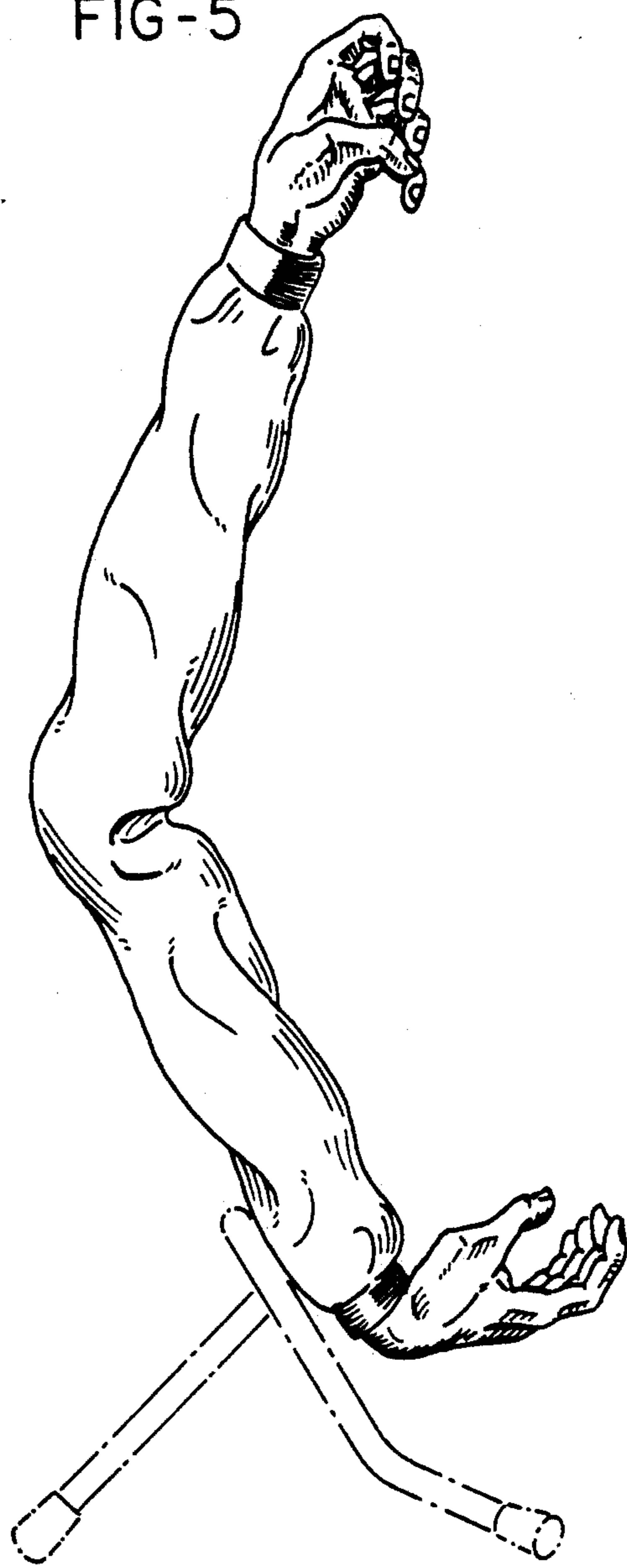
