FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view;


FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view.


The broken line showing in FIGS. 1, 2, 5 and 6 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.













