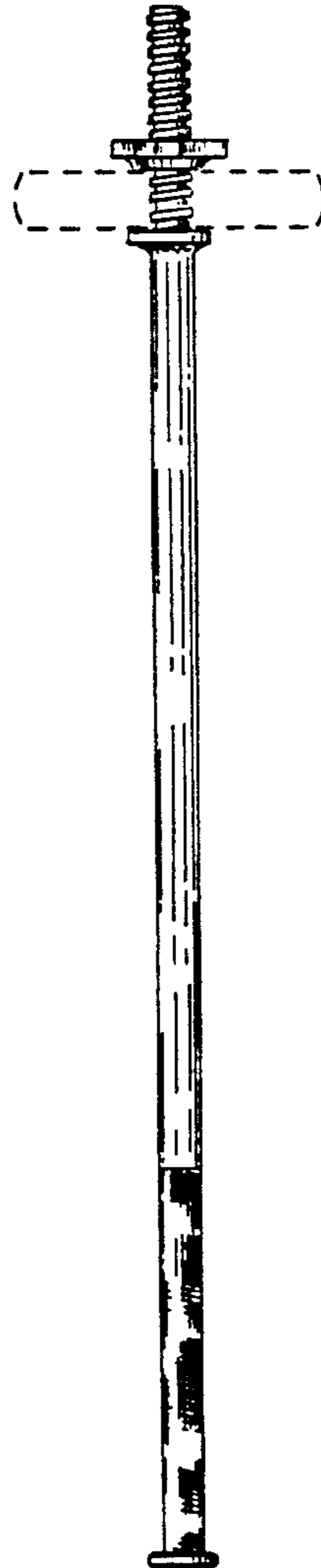
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a practice bat, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof shown on enlarged scale, all other sides being identical; and,

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken line showing a weight in FIG. 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



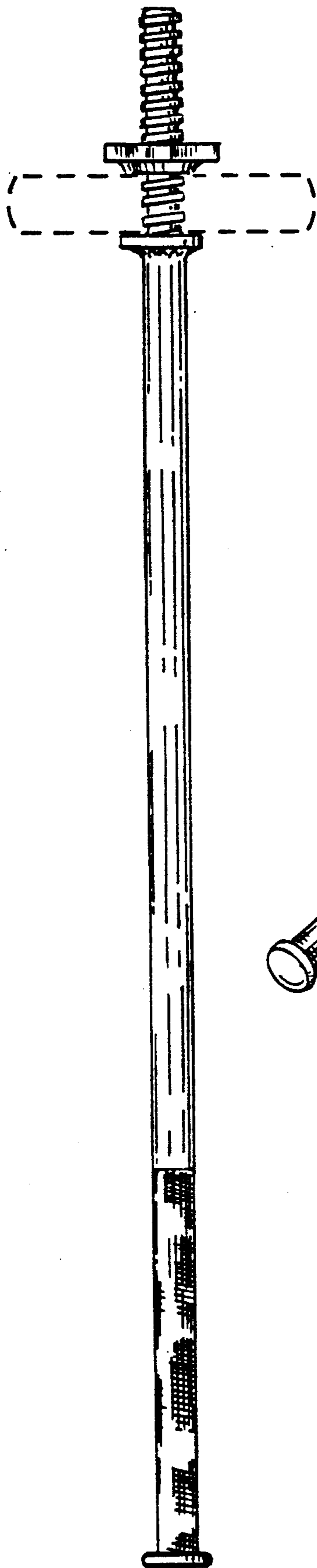

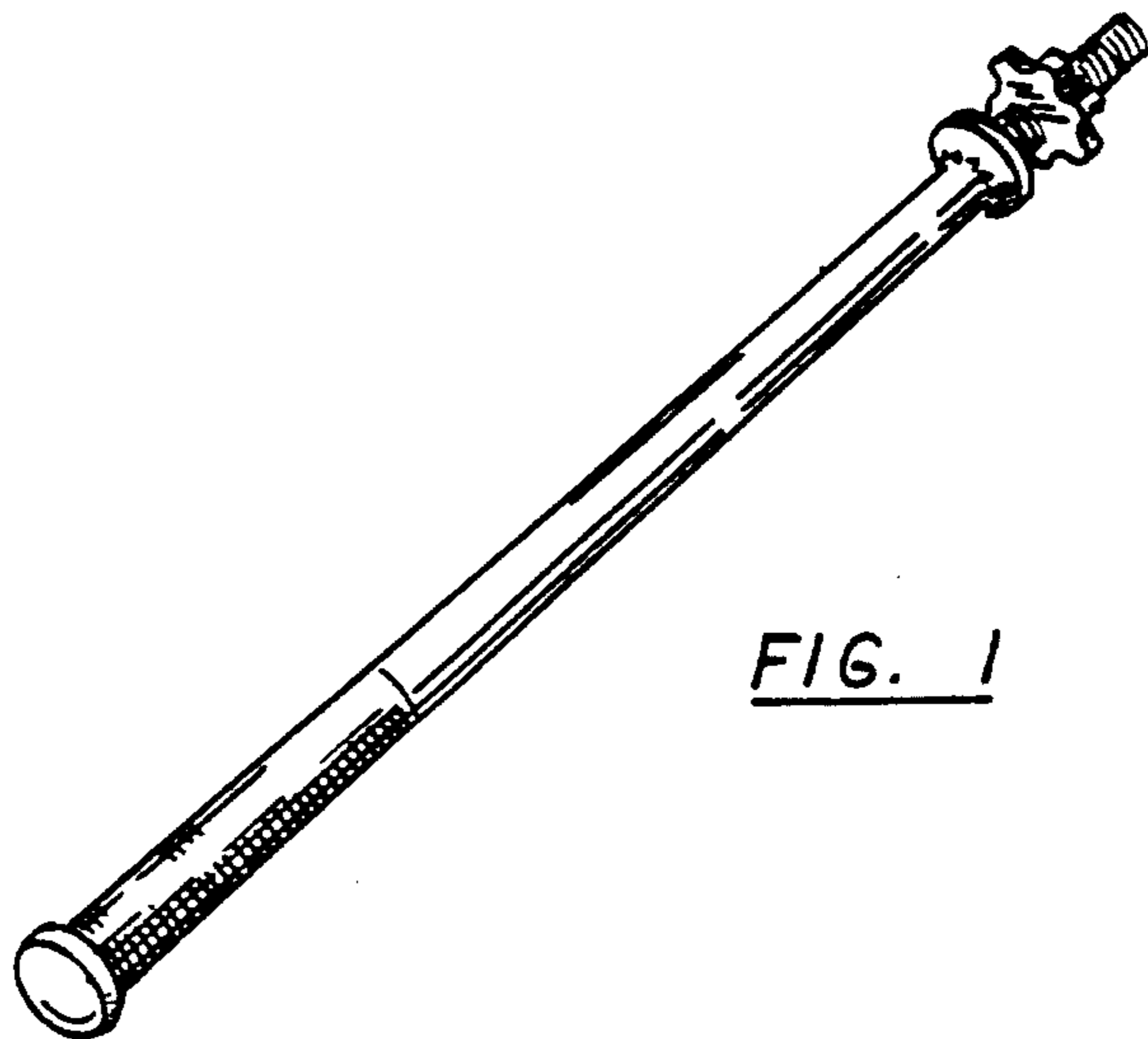

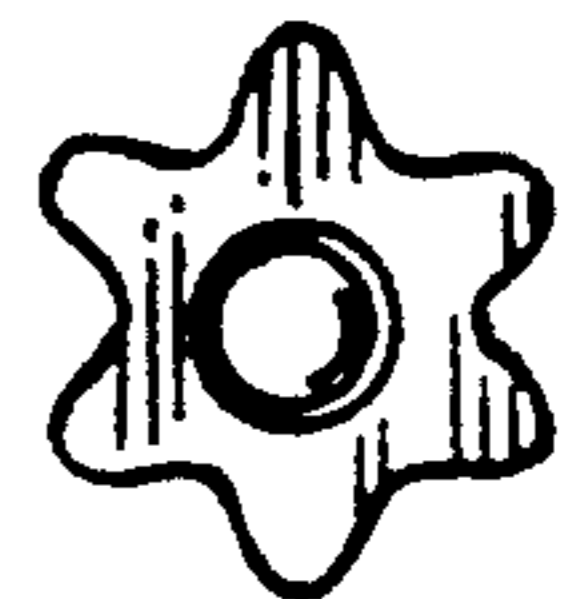
